DESCRIPTION

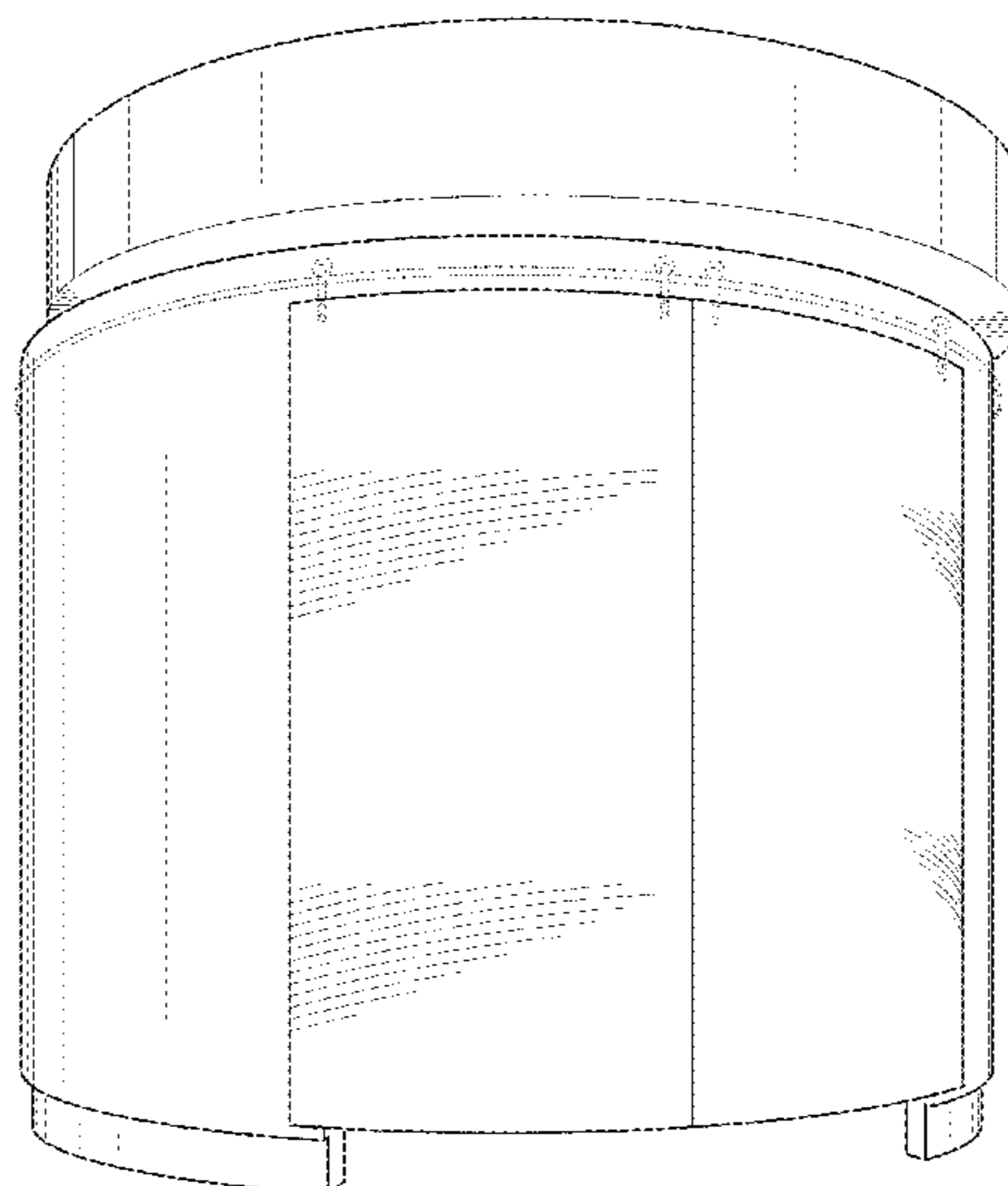
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a privacy booth embodying the new design.

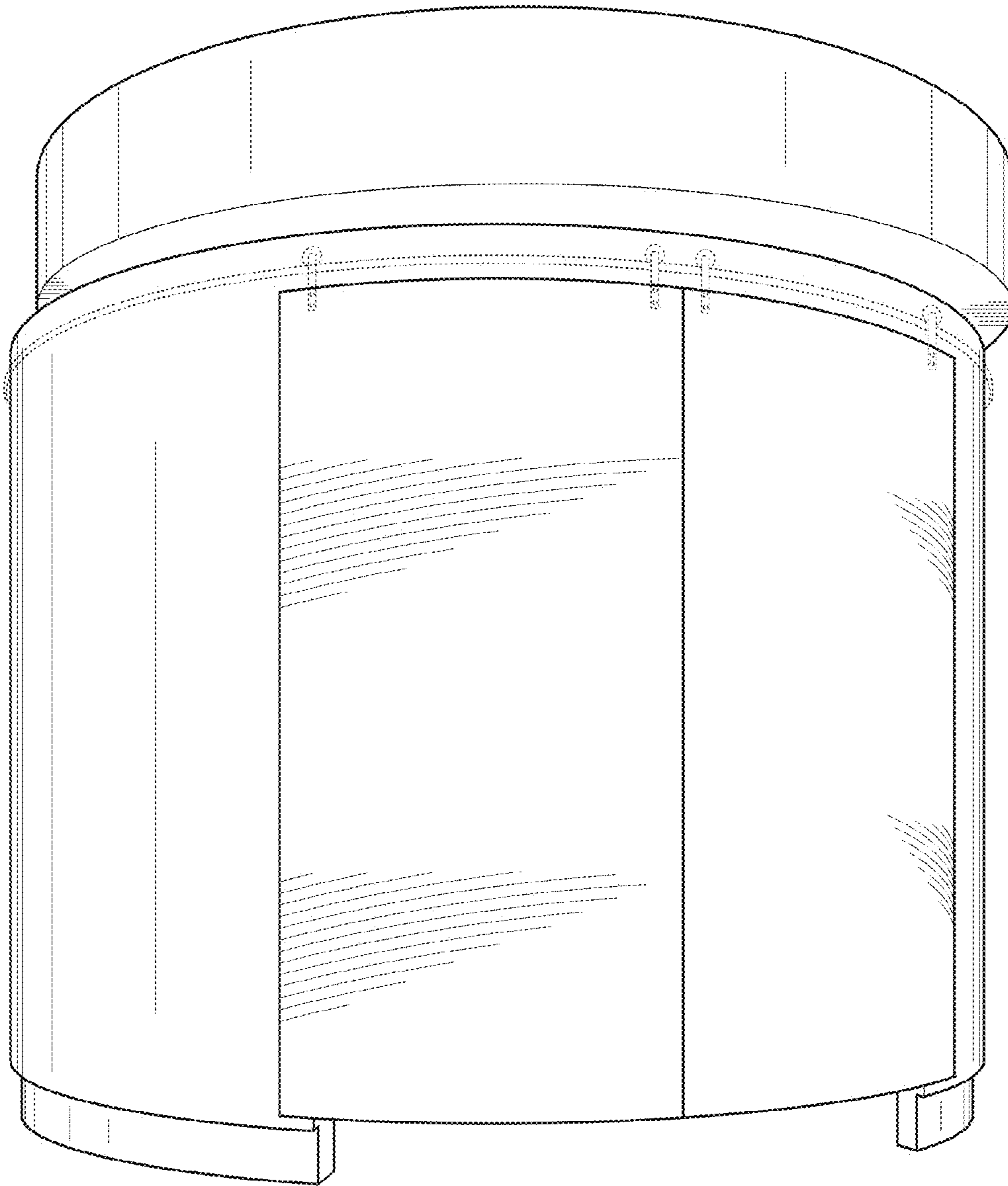

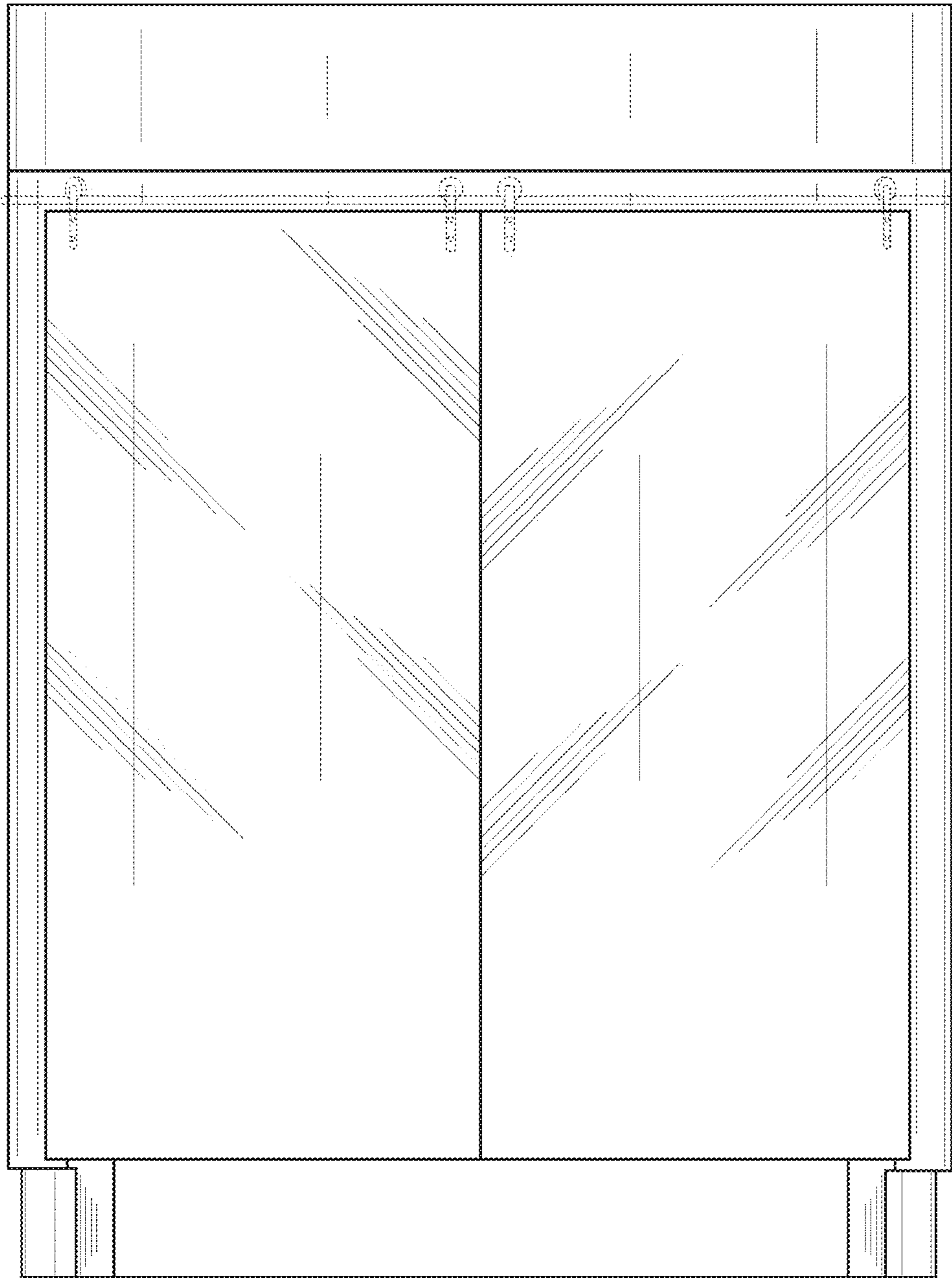

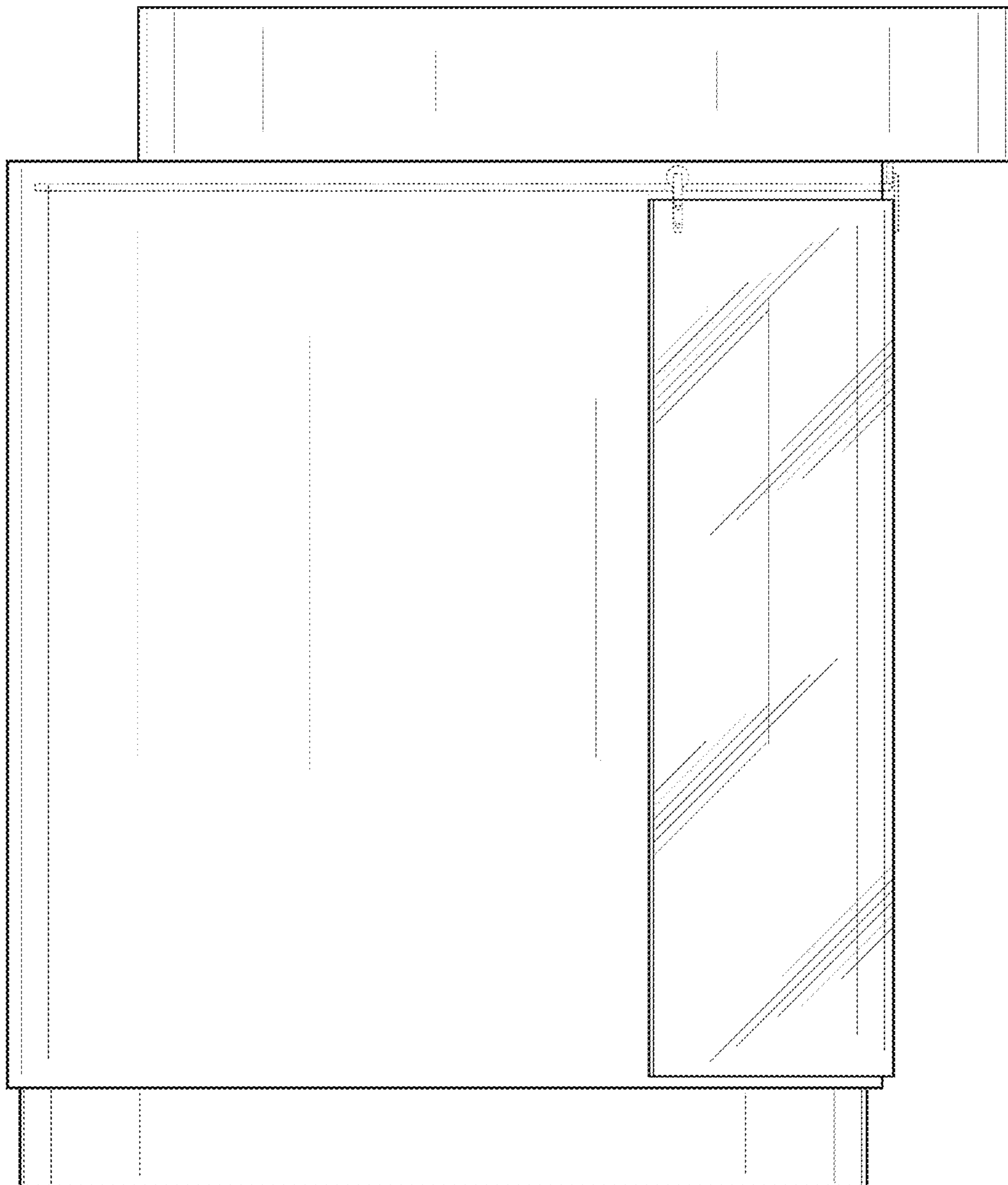

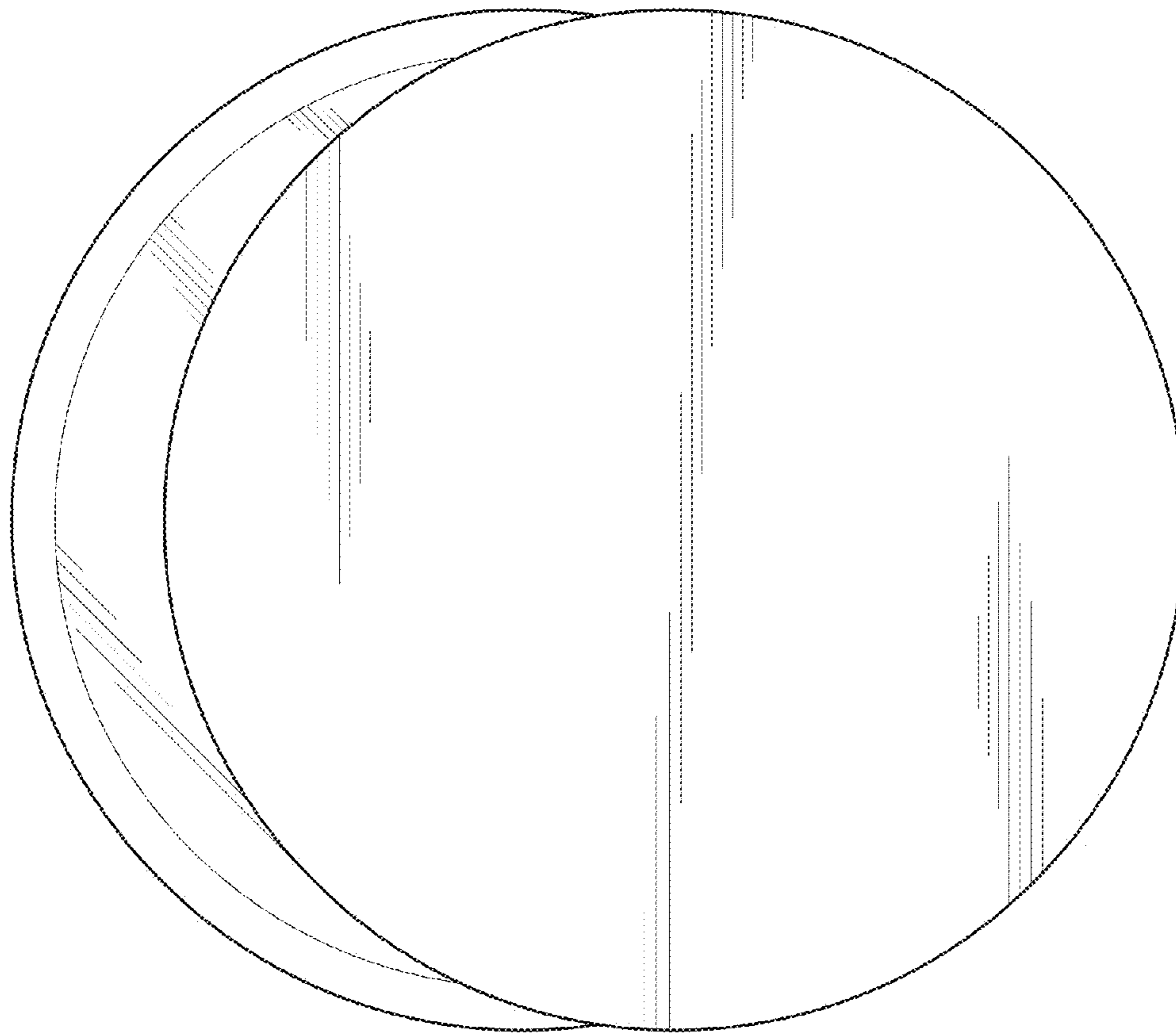

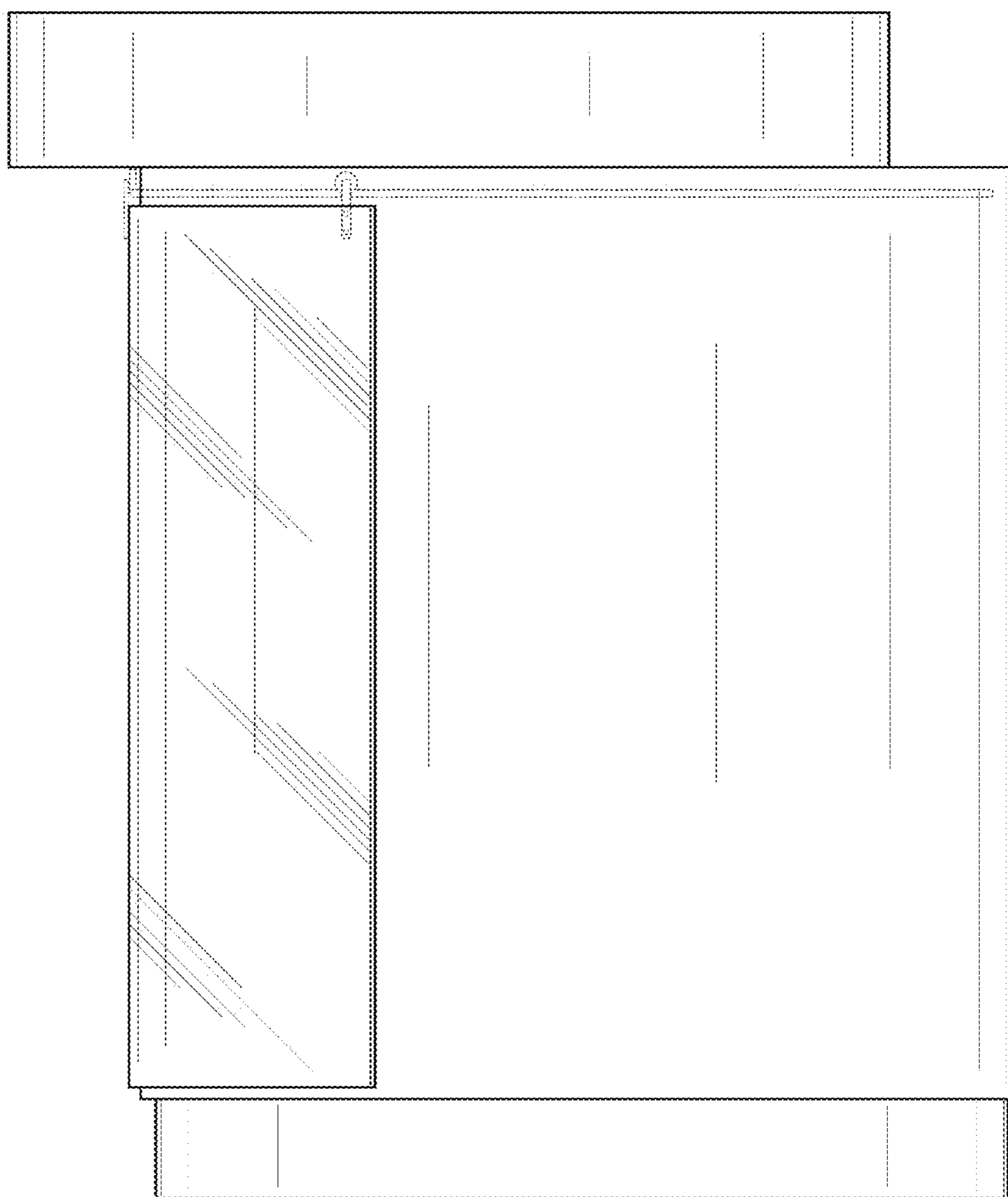

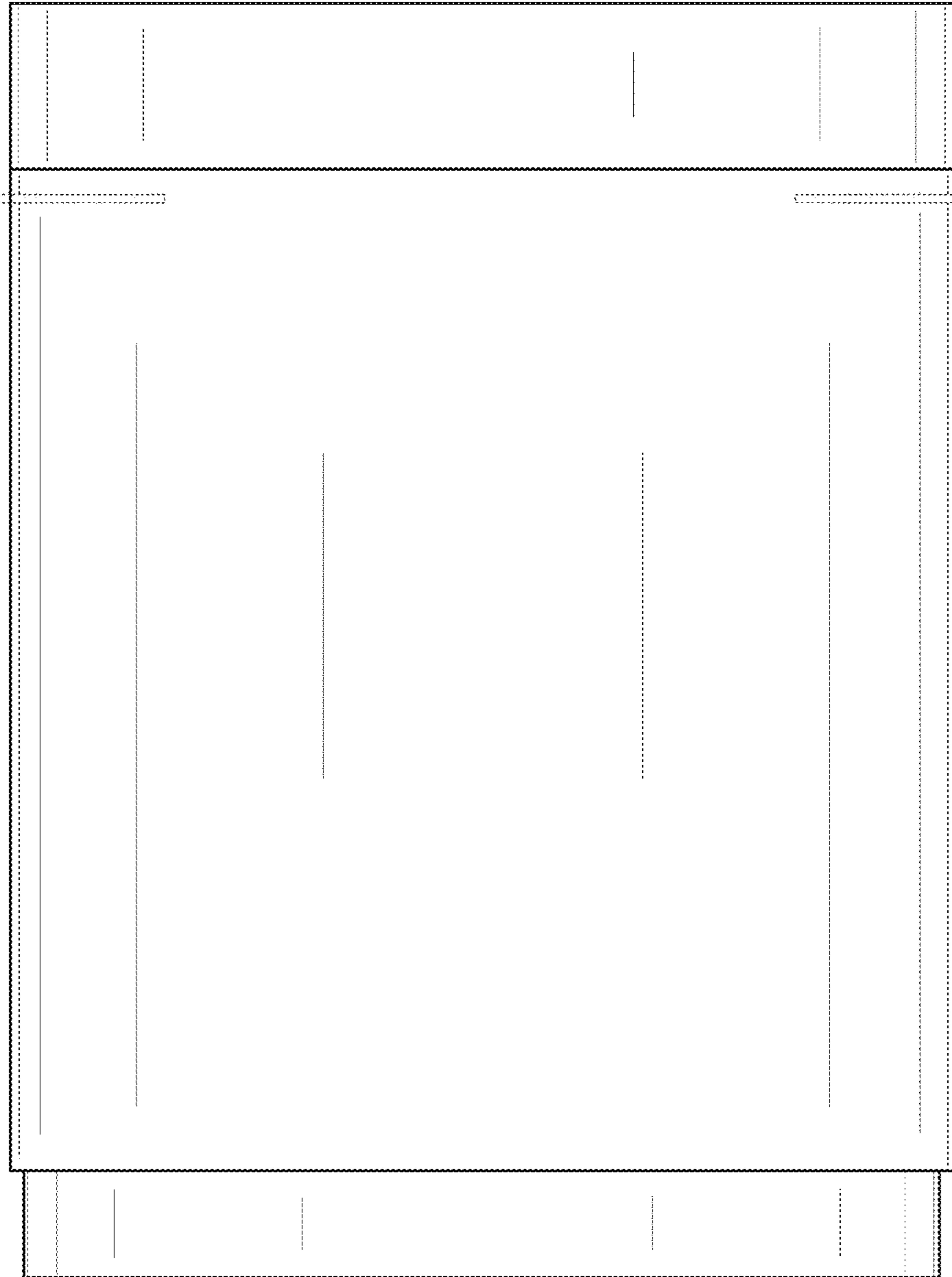
