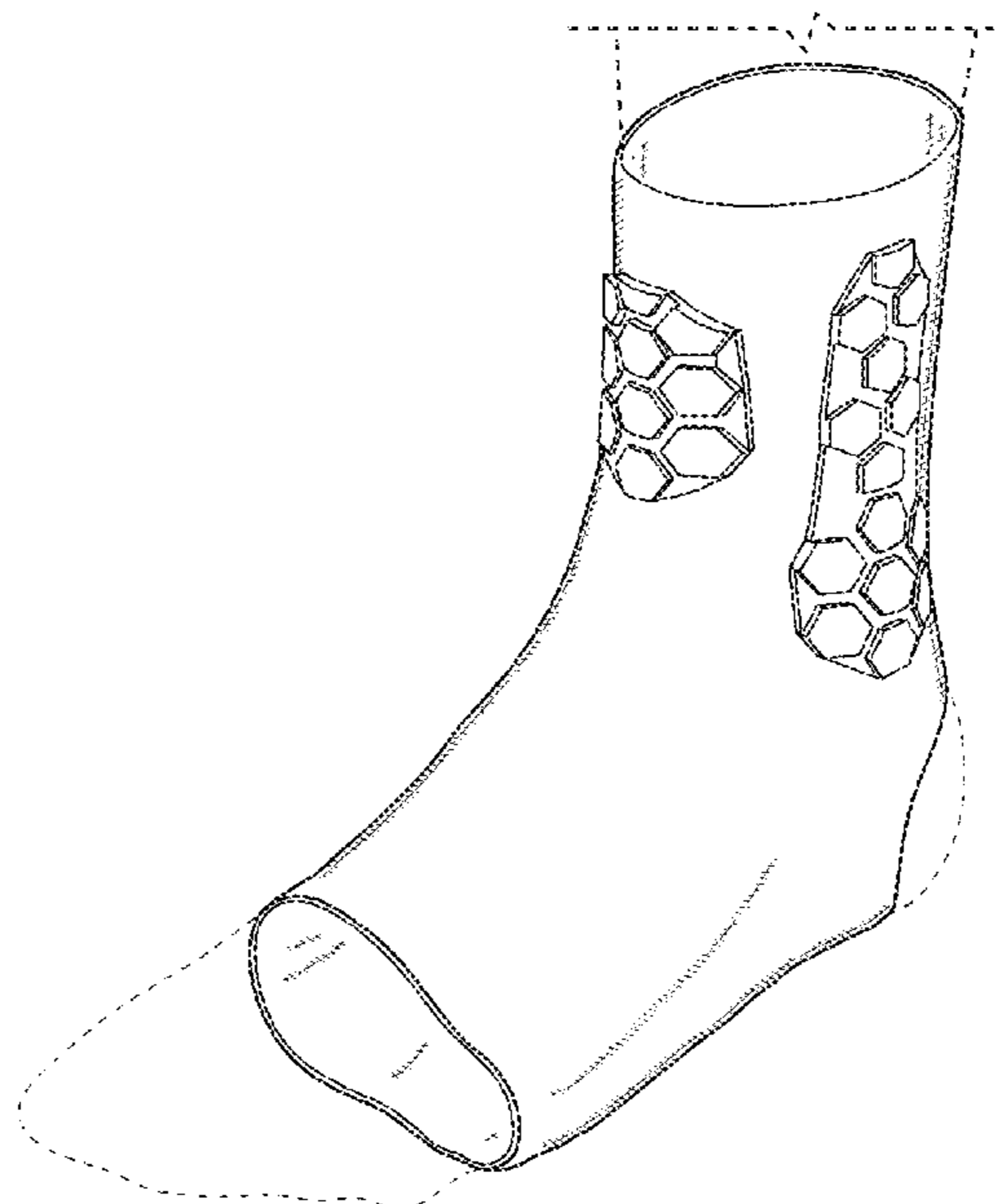

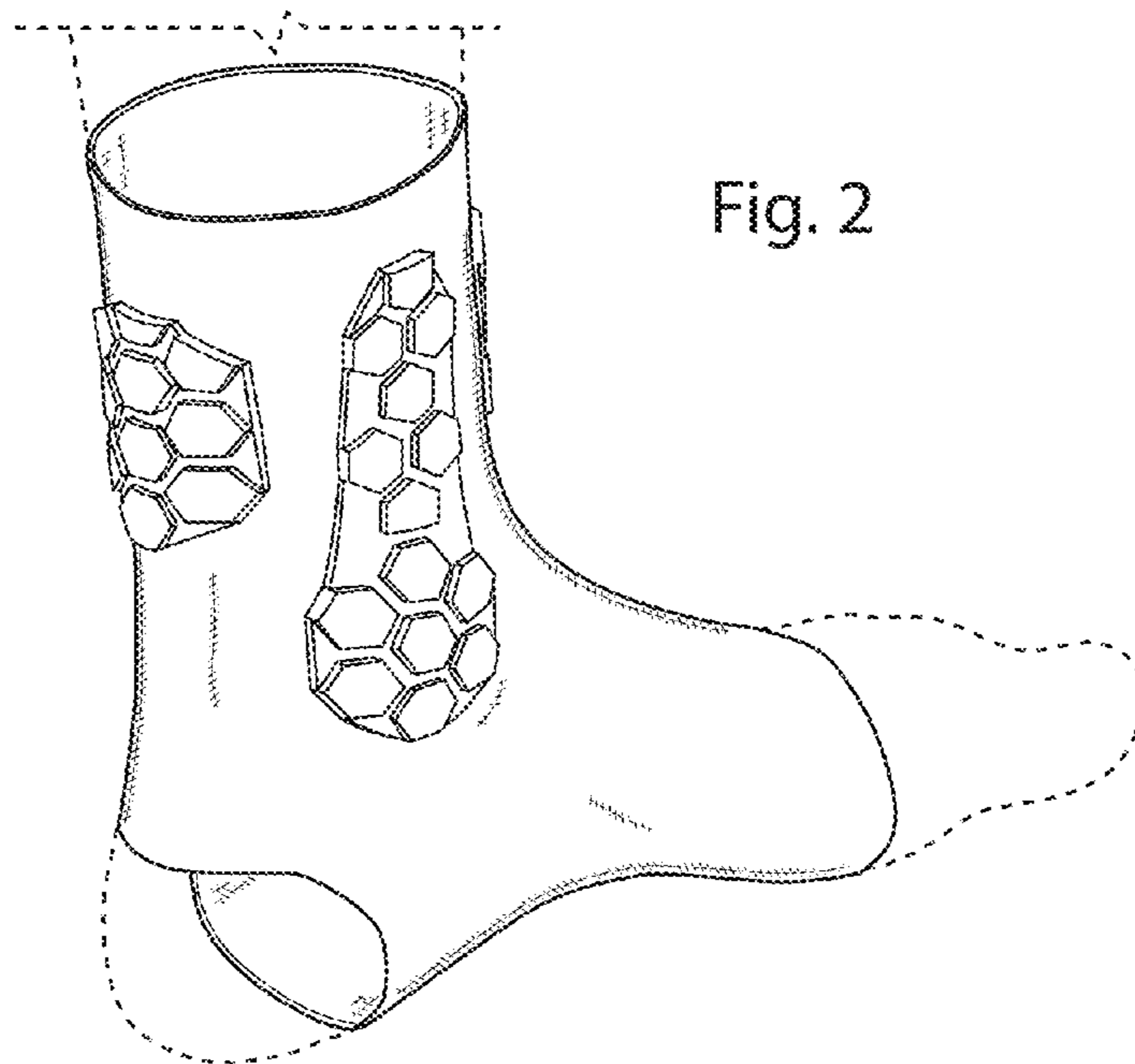
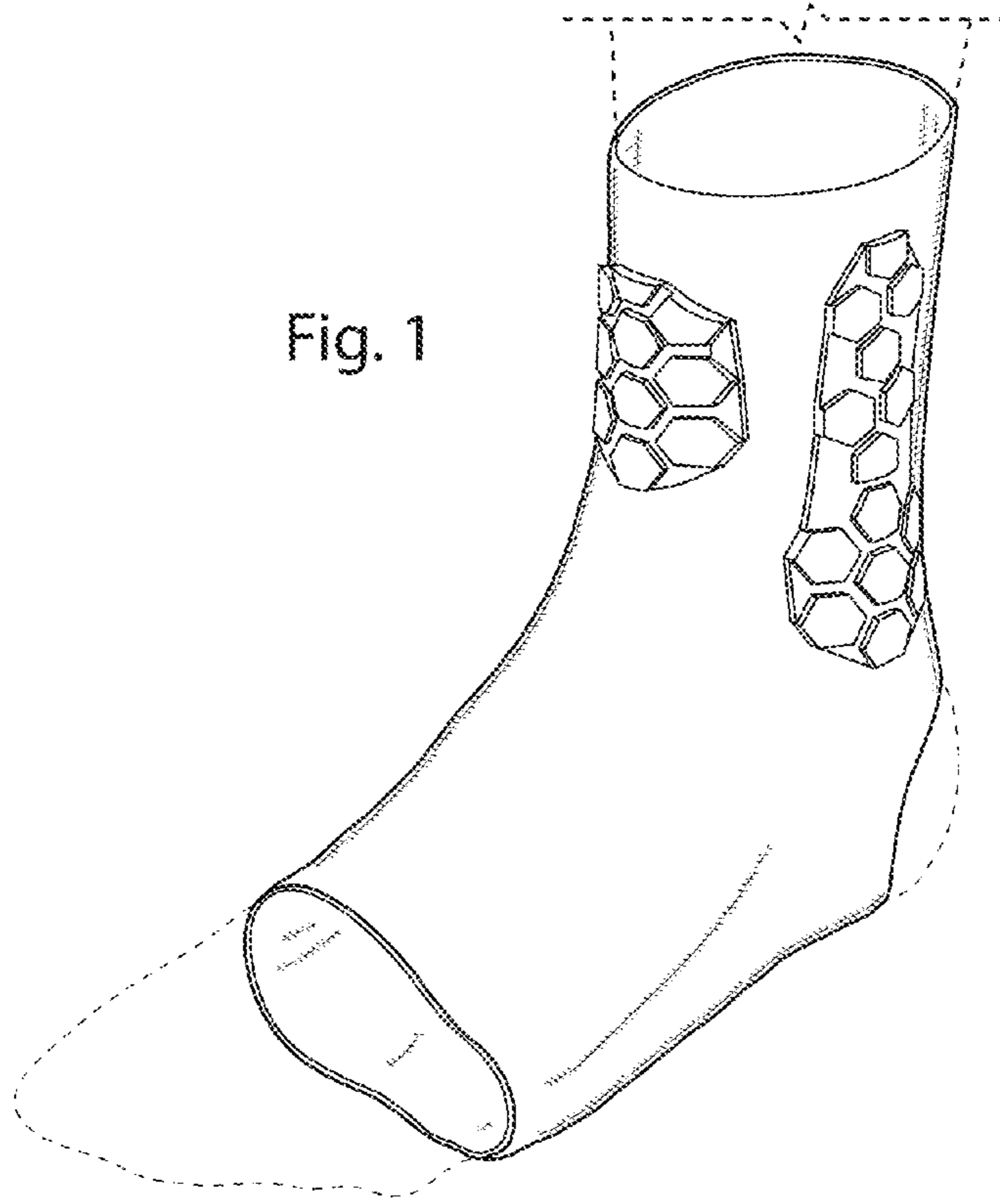
The ornamental design for an ankle guard, as shown and described.

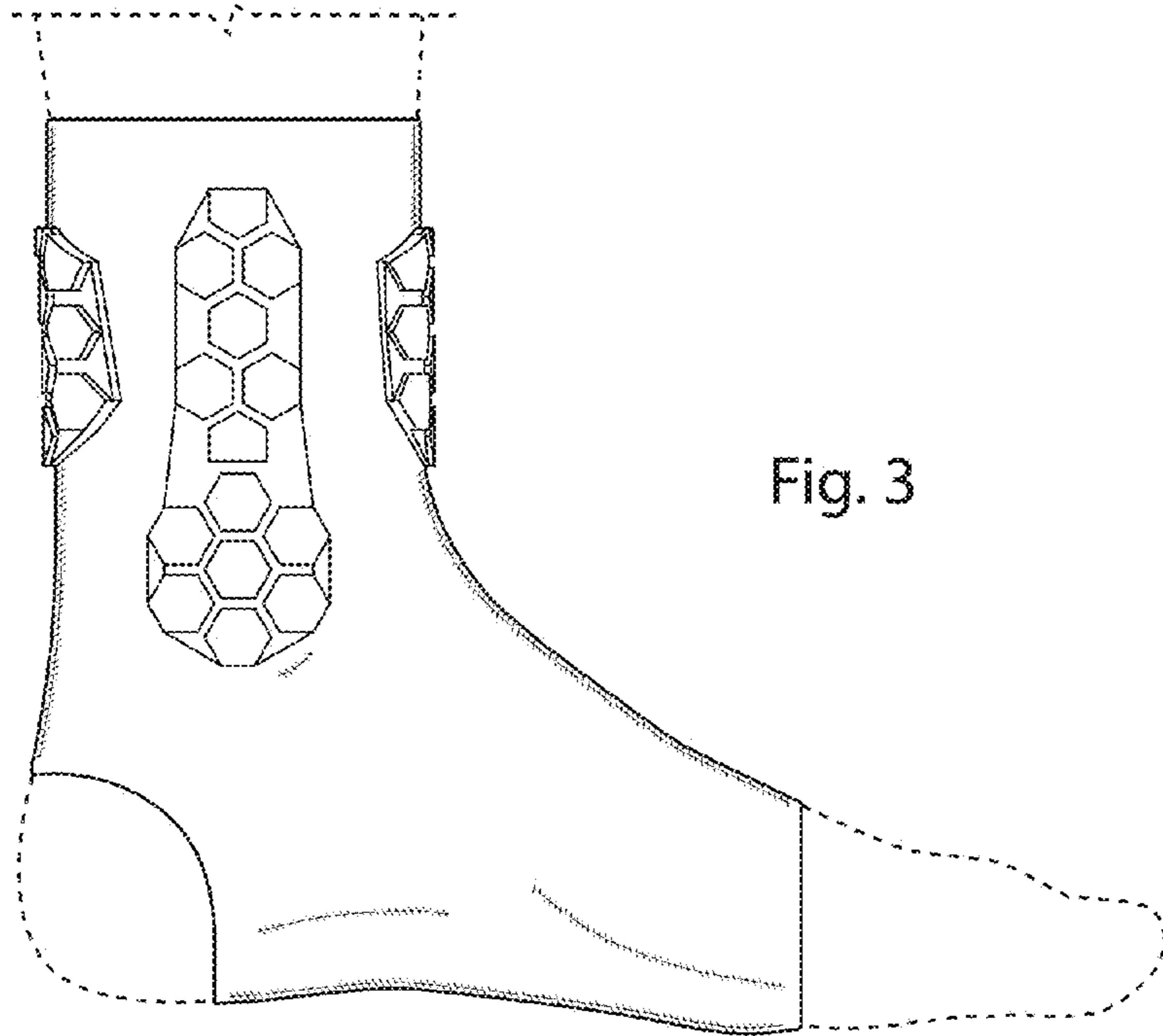

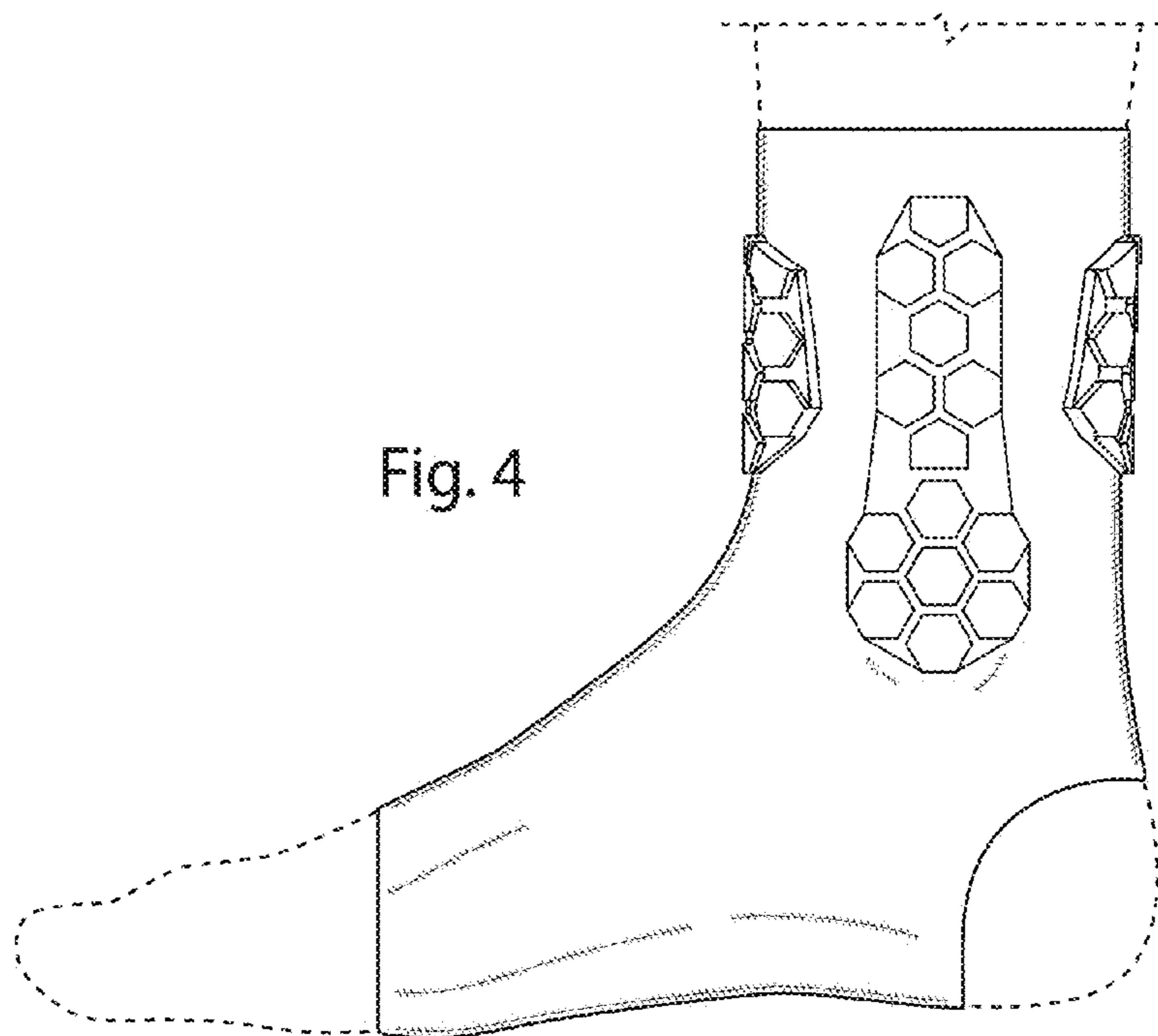

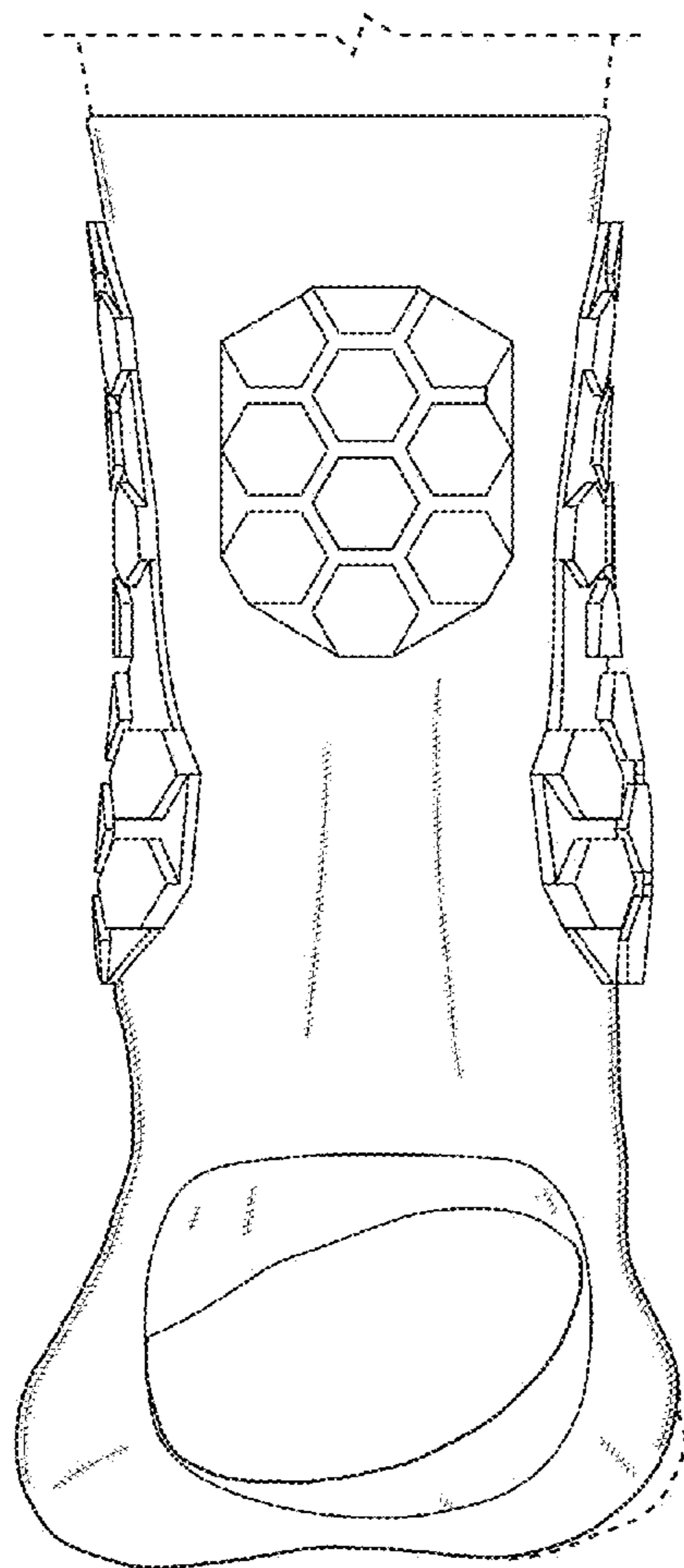

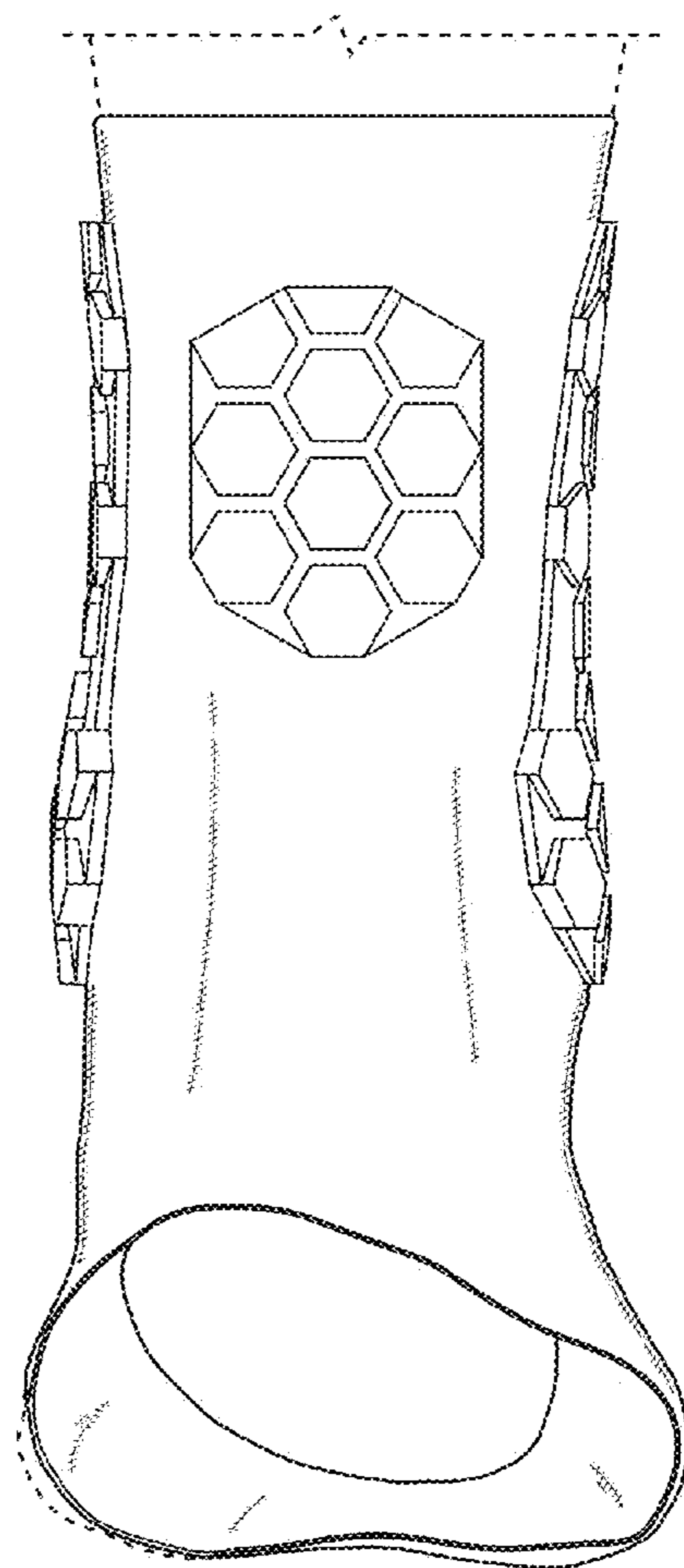

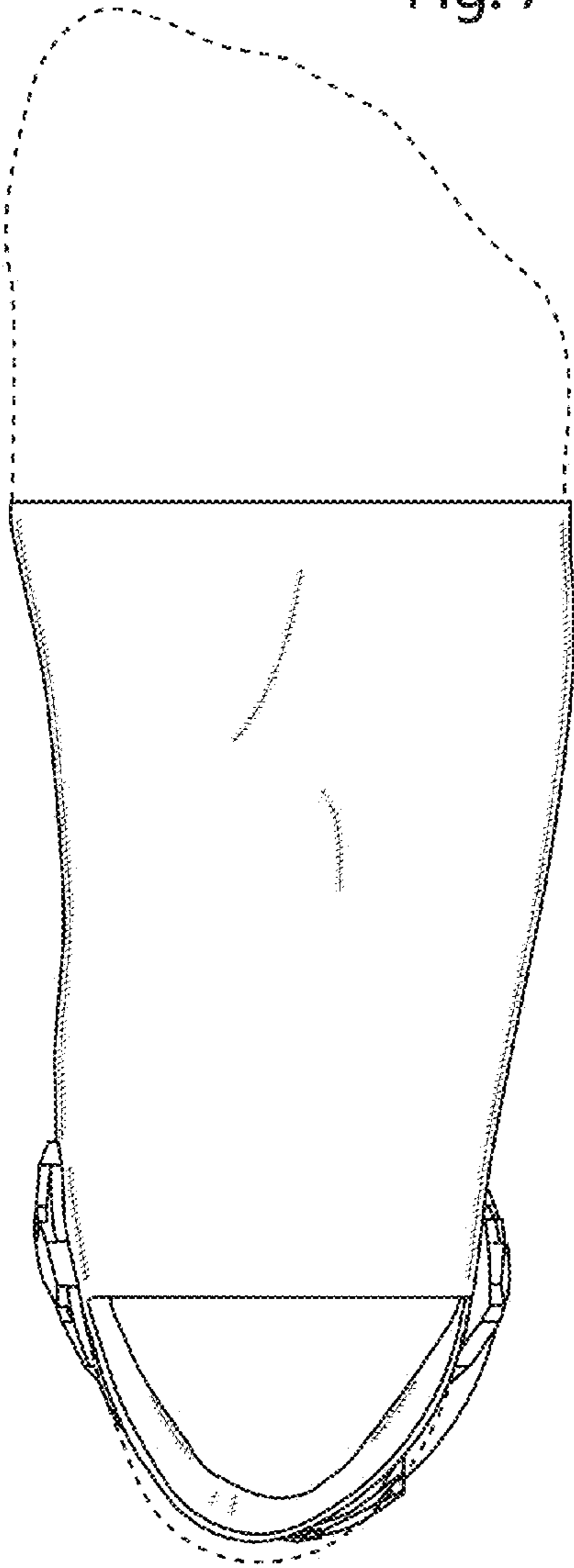
