(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pilot helmet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a pilot helmet shown in a flat, unassembled state, shown with attachable visor and mouthpiece according to my new design, the component pieces of which are shown separately for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the helmet thereof, but shown in an assembled state, without the visor and mouthpiece components for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the helmet thereof, shown in an assembled state, with the visor component attached. The mouthpiece component is not shown for ease of illustration; FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the helmet thereof, shown in an assembled state, with the visor and mouthpiece components attached;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the helmet thereof, shown in an assembled state, with the visor component attached. The mouthpiece component is not shown for ease of illustration; FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof, shown in an assembled state;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof, shown in an assembled state;

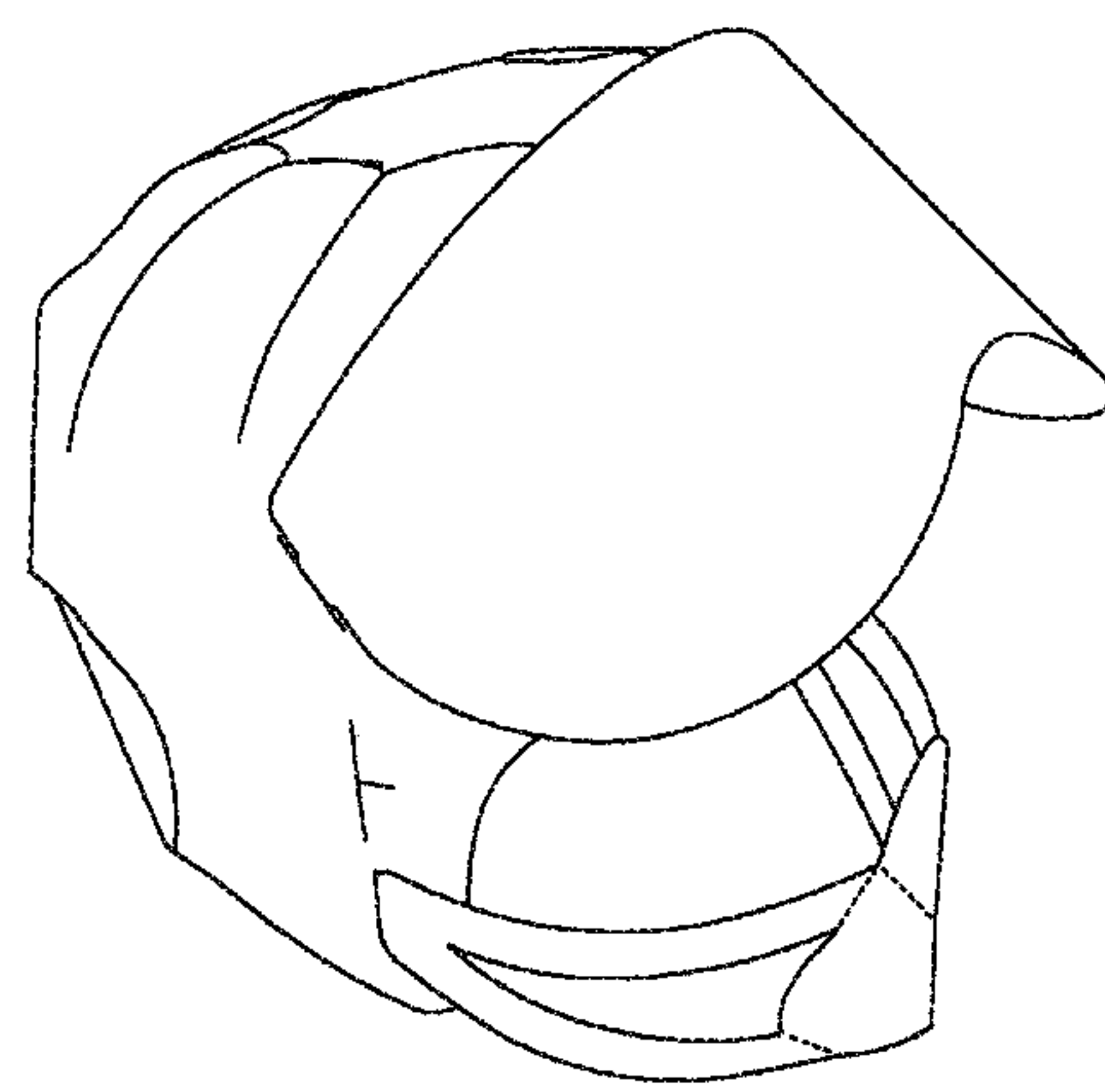
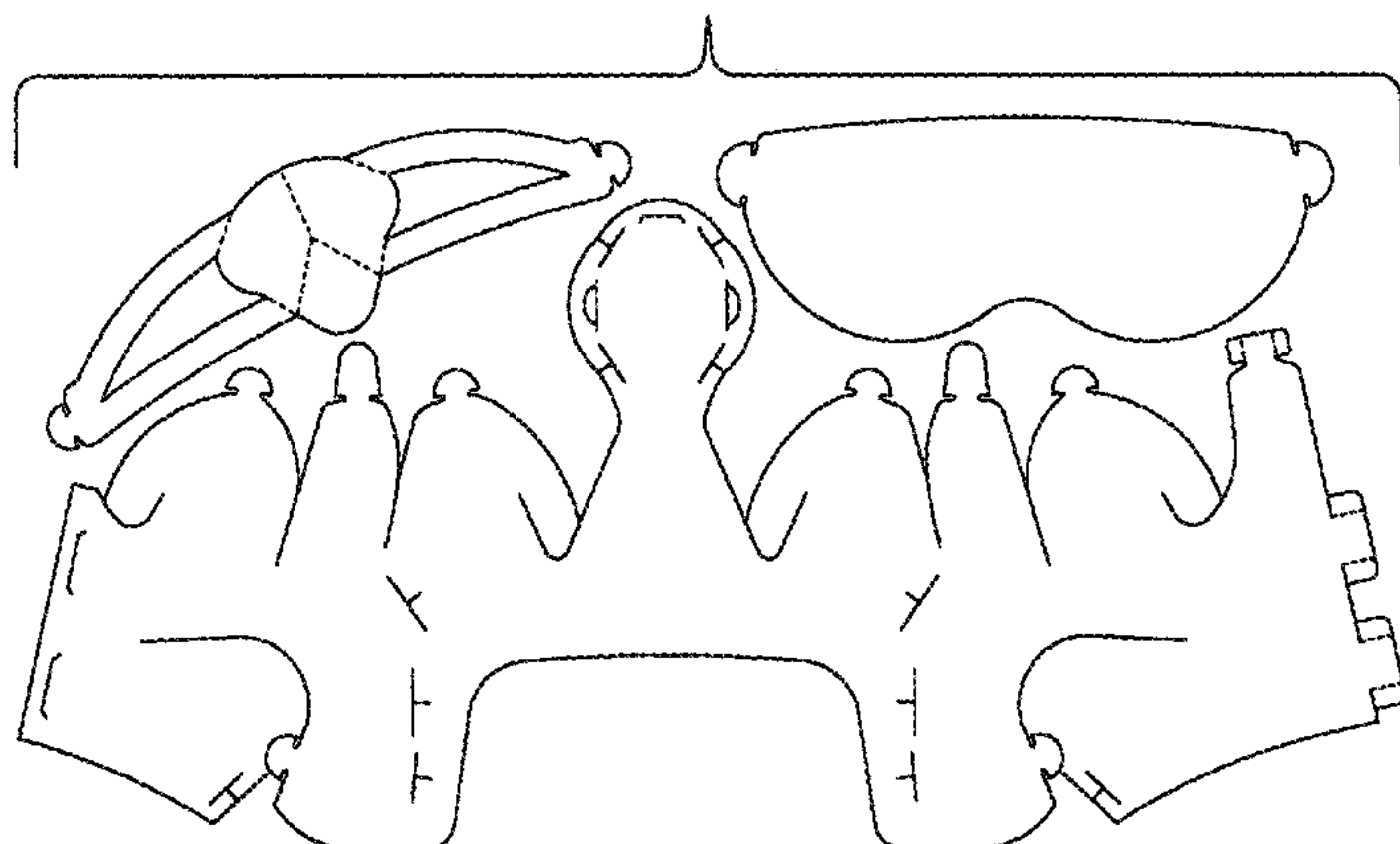
FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view thereof, shown in an assembled state;

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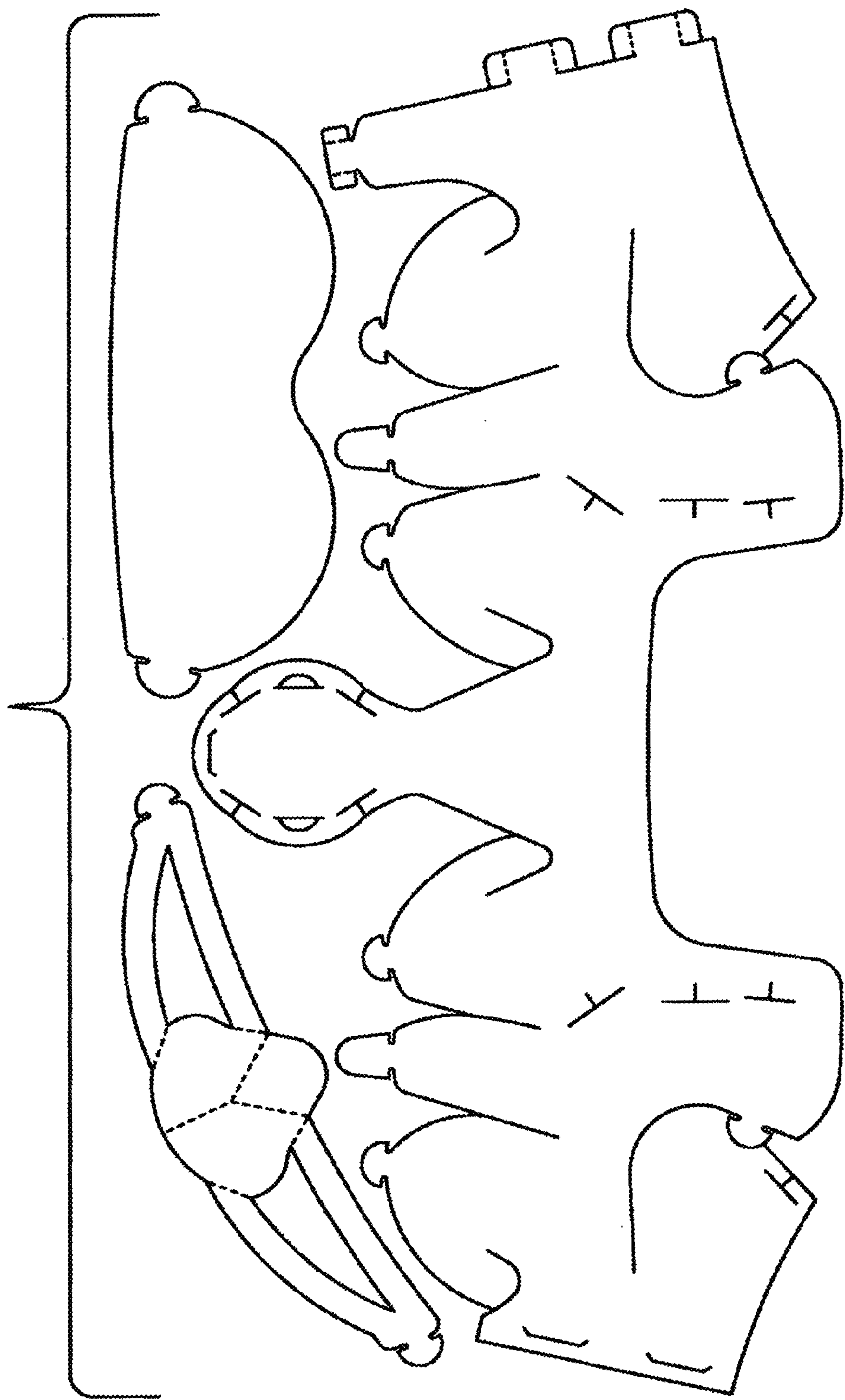

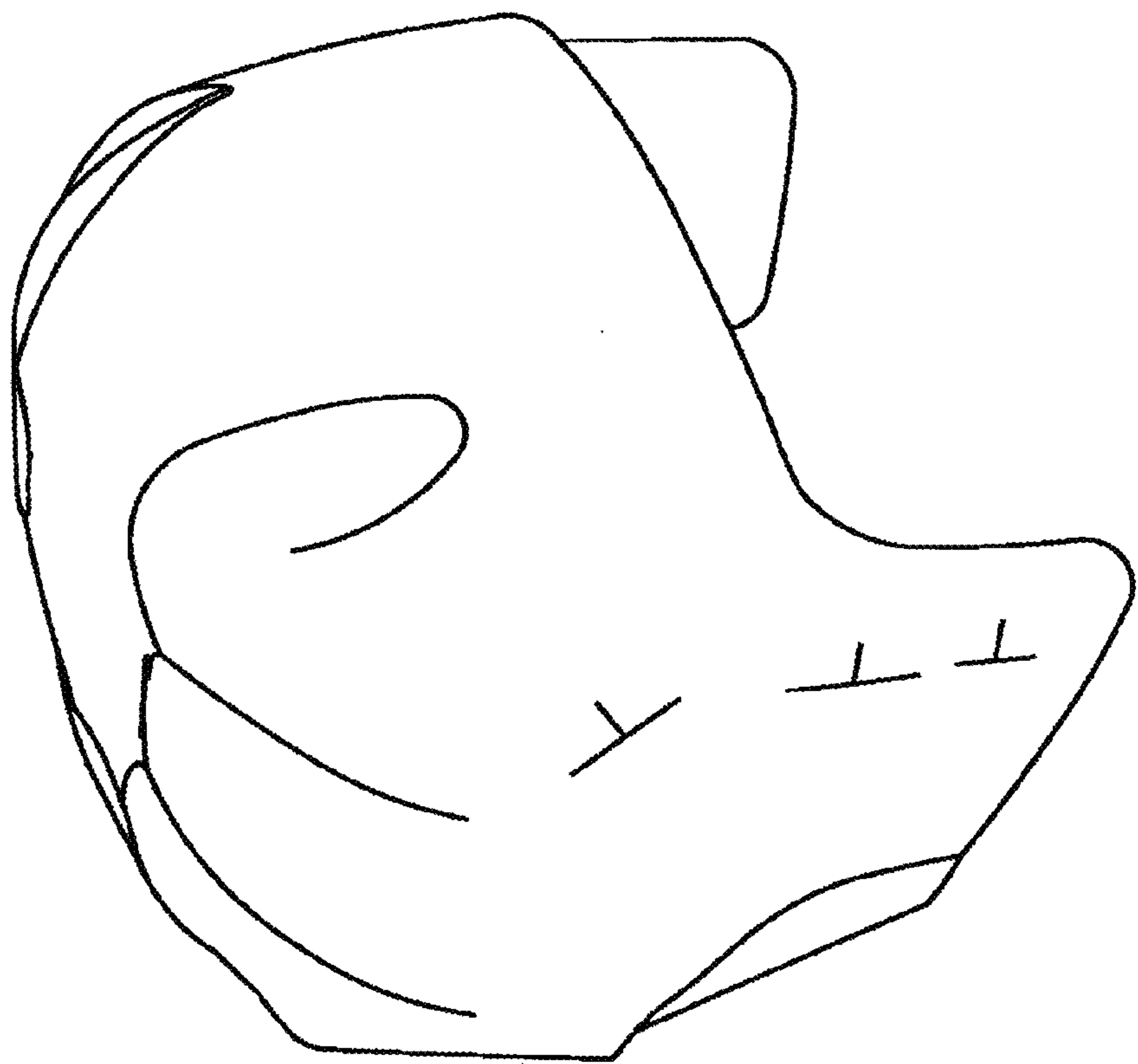

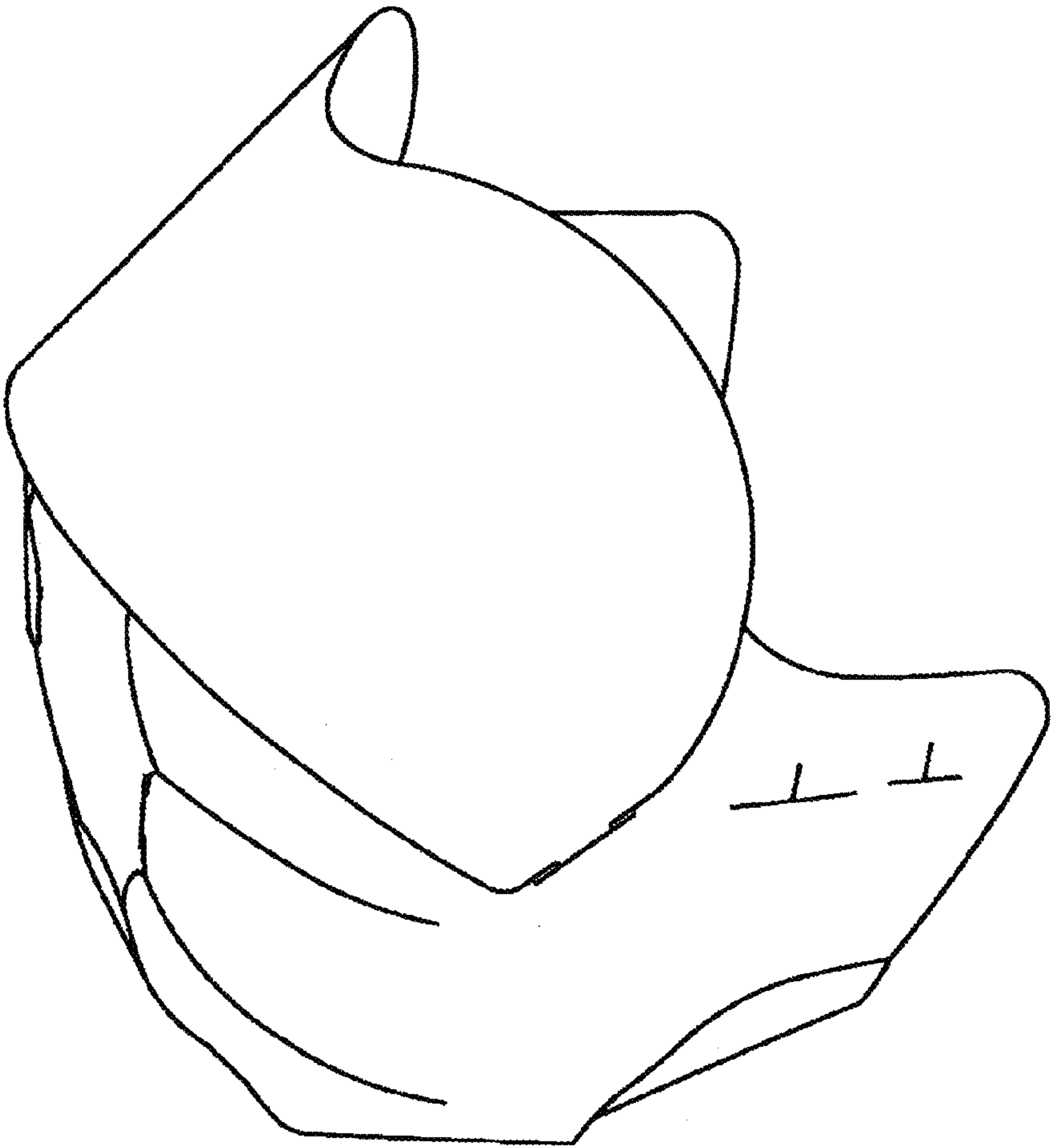

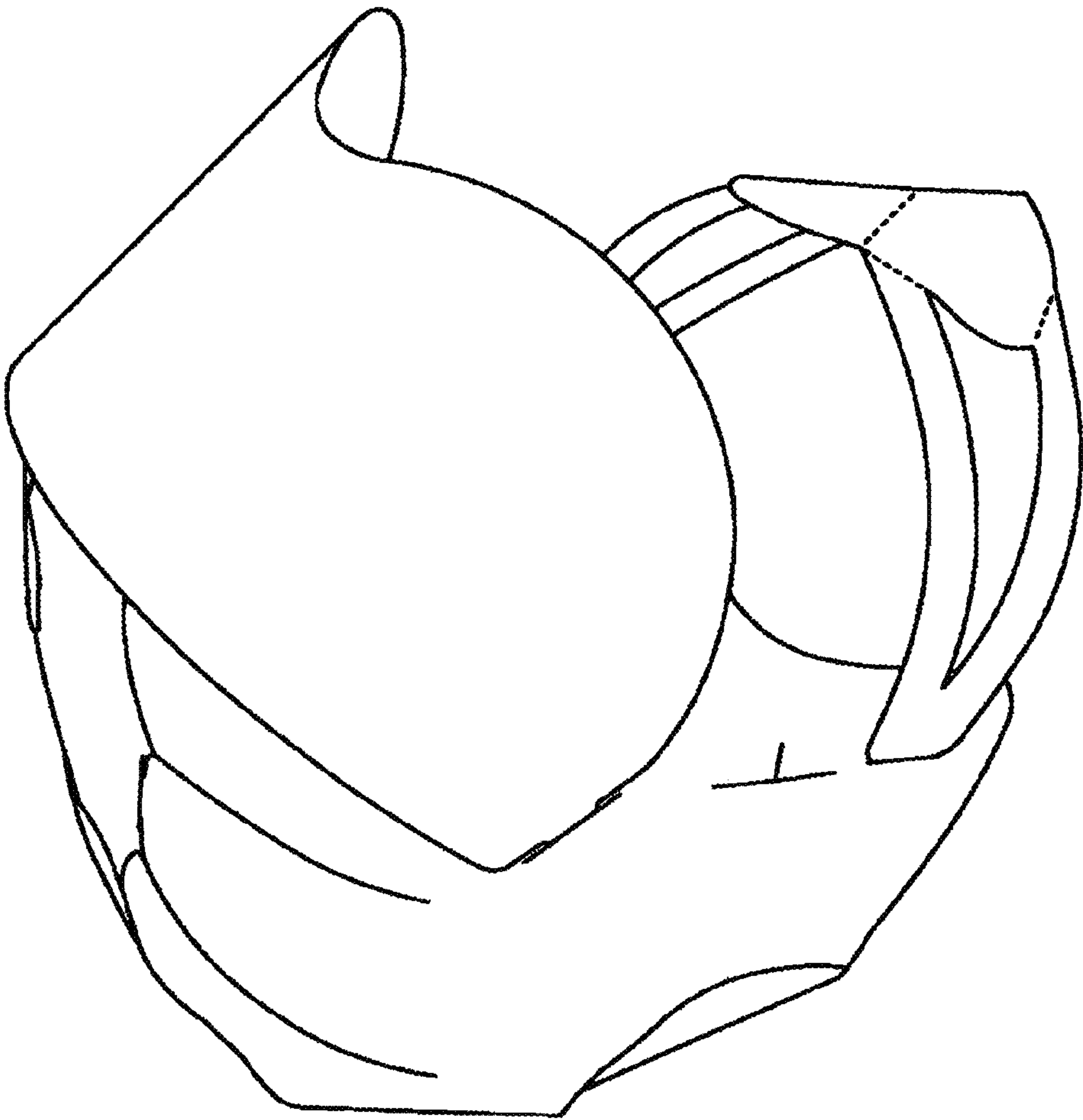

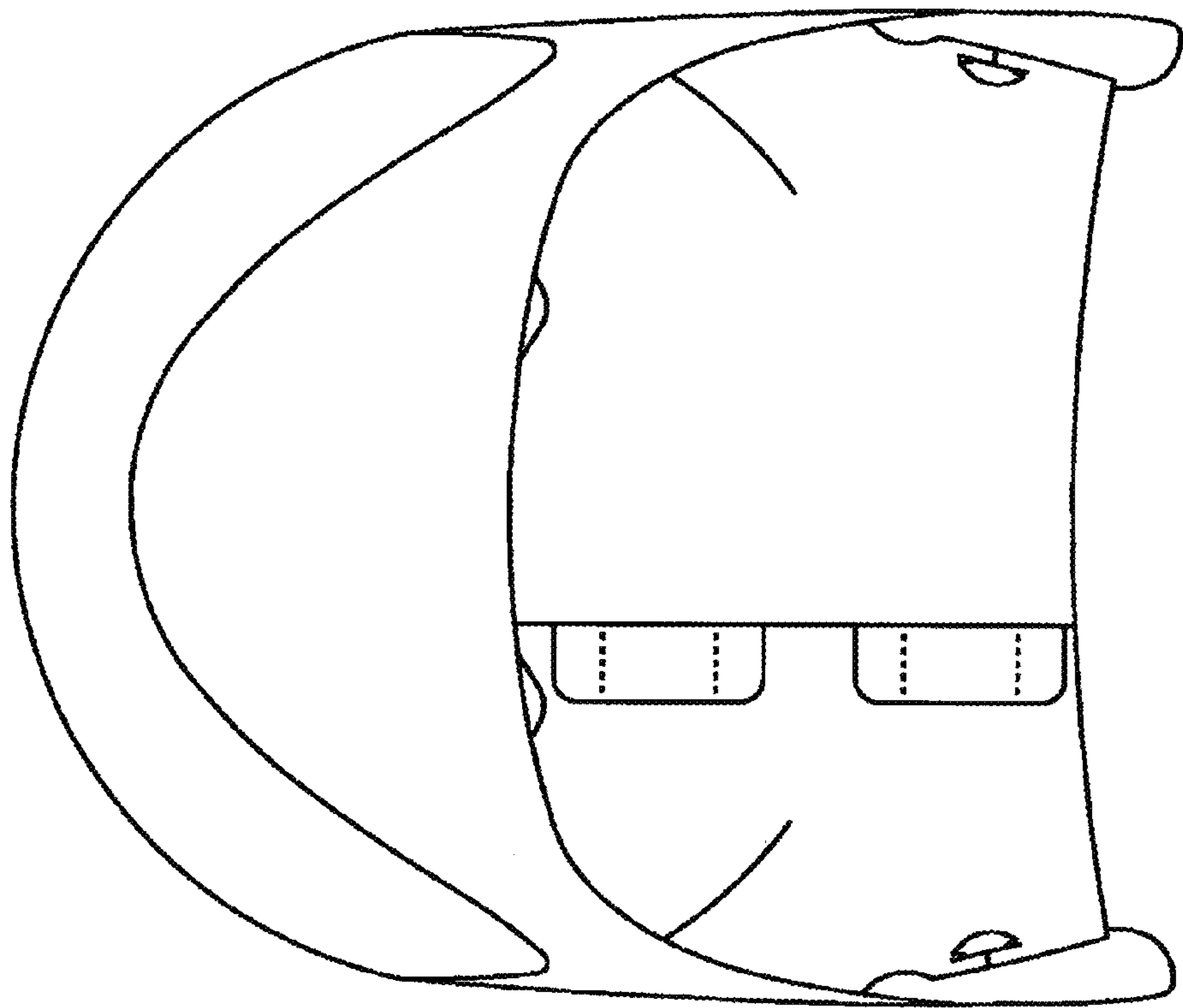

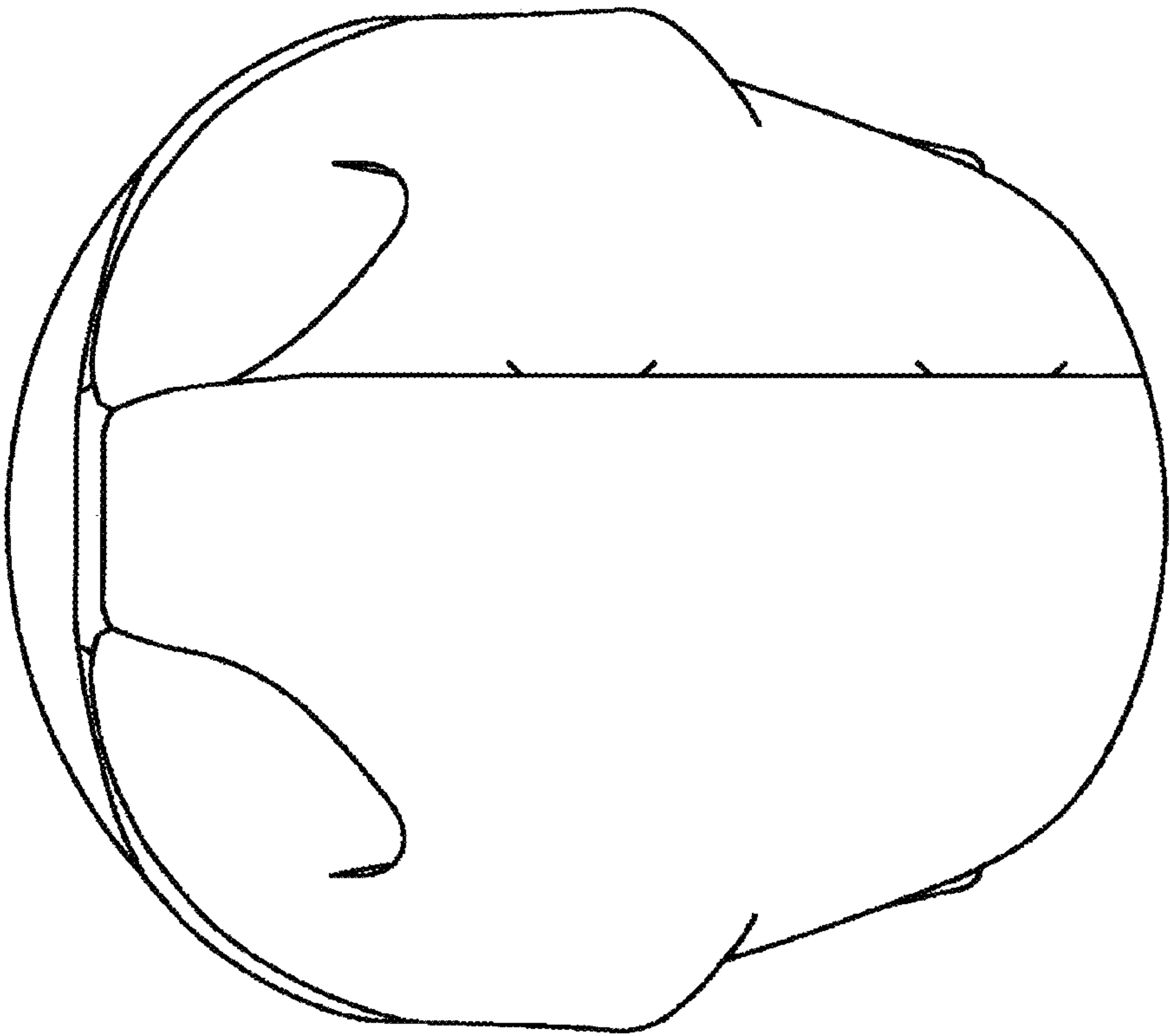

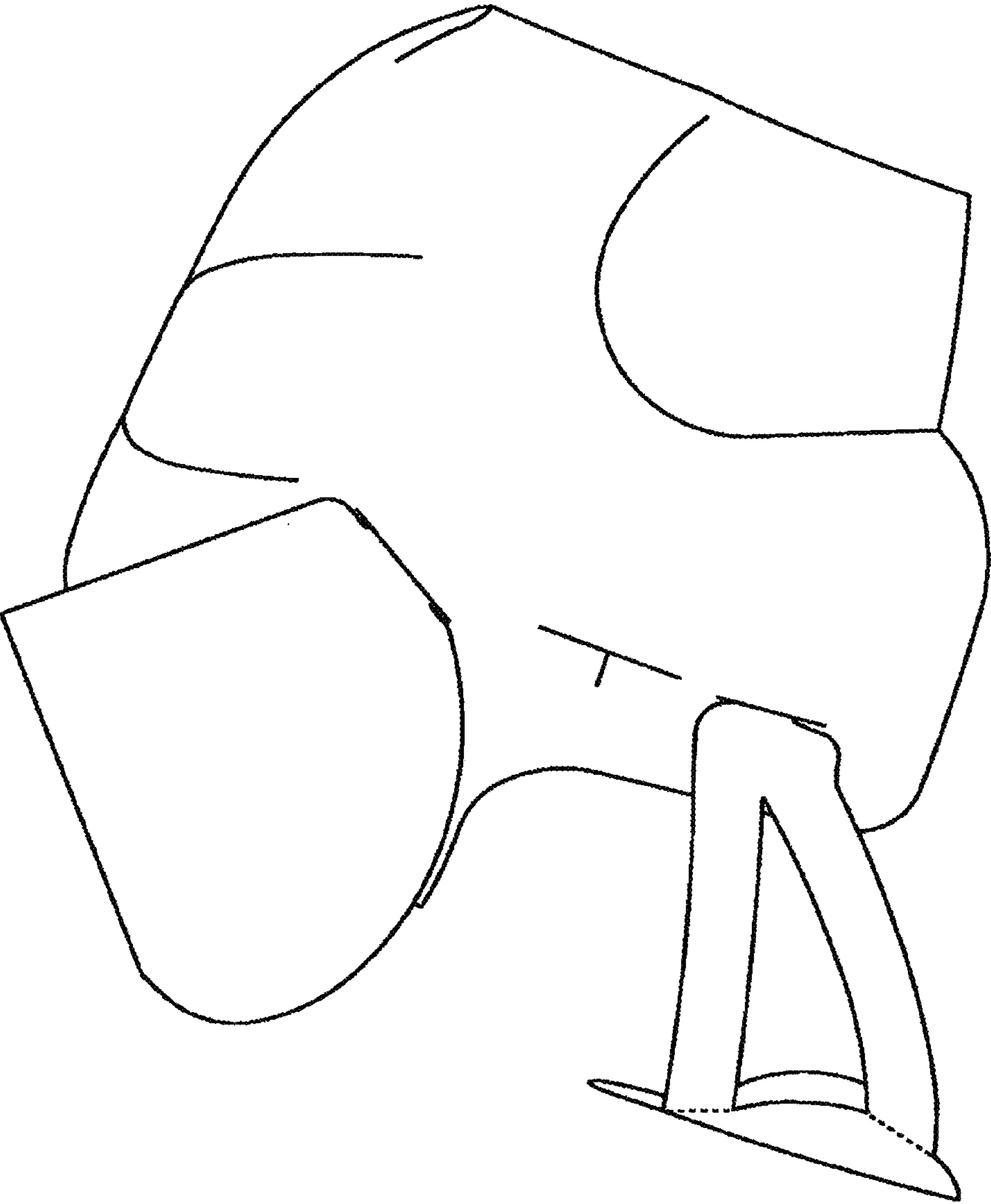

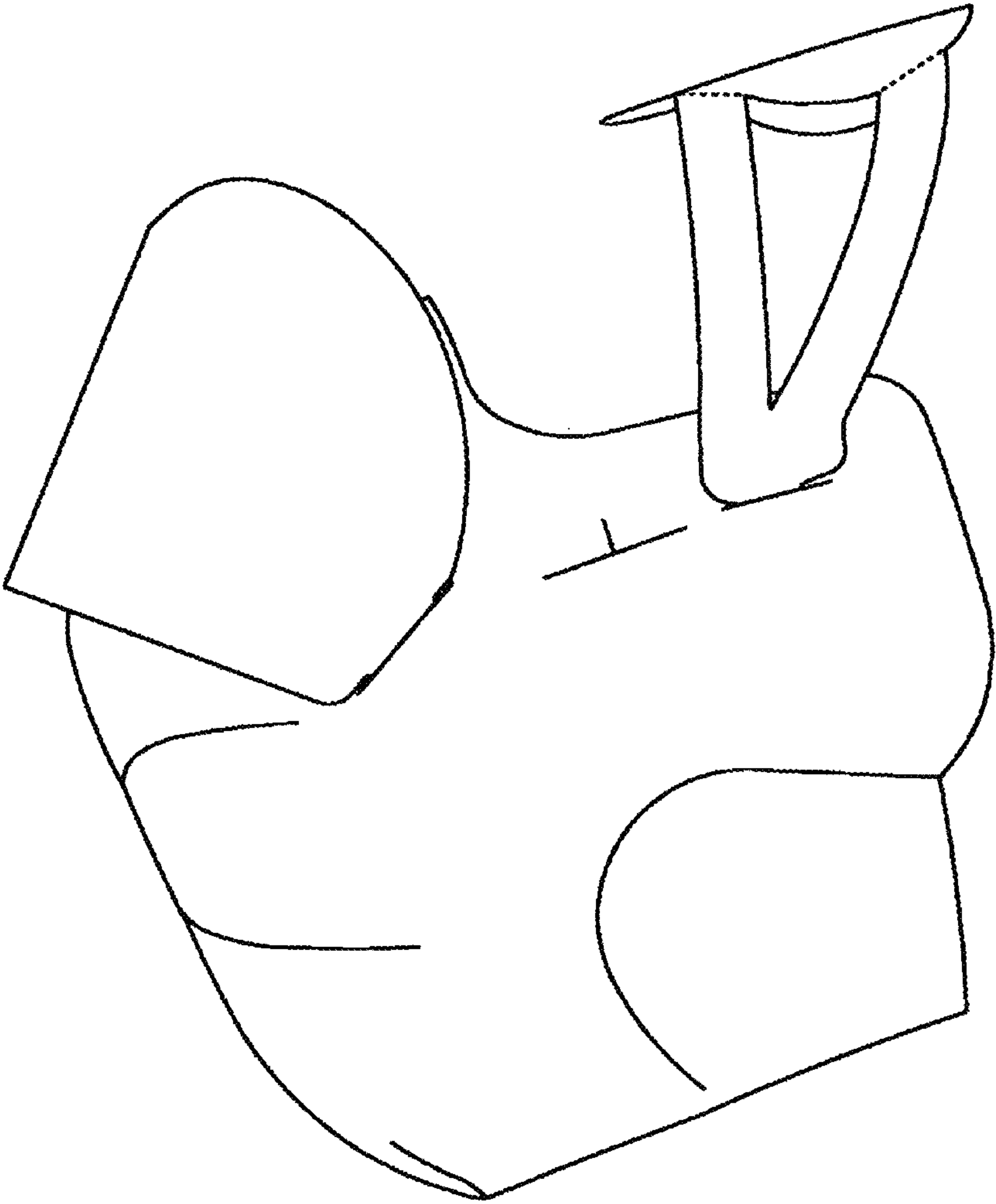
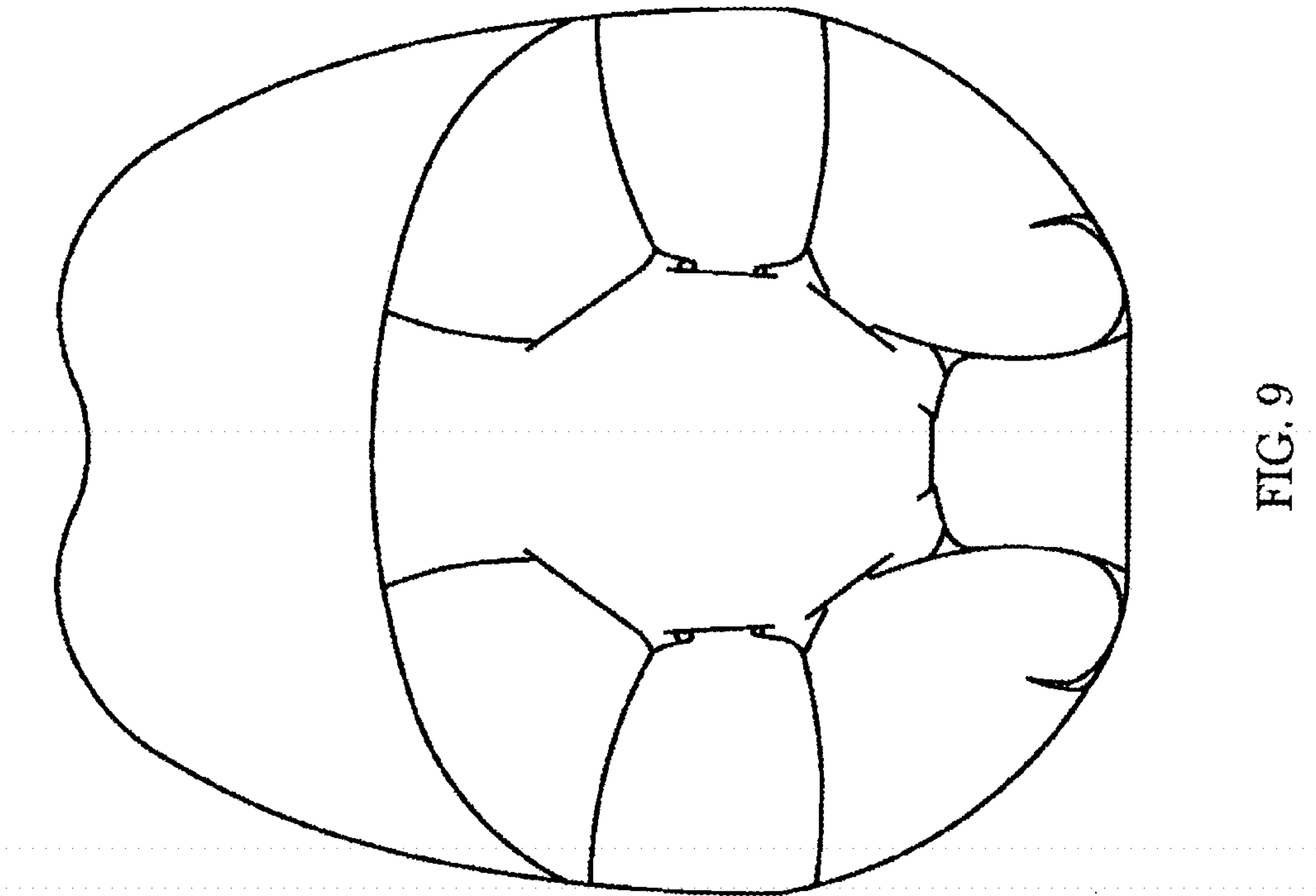

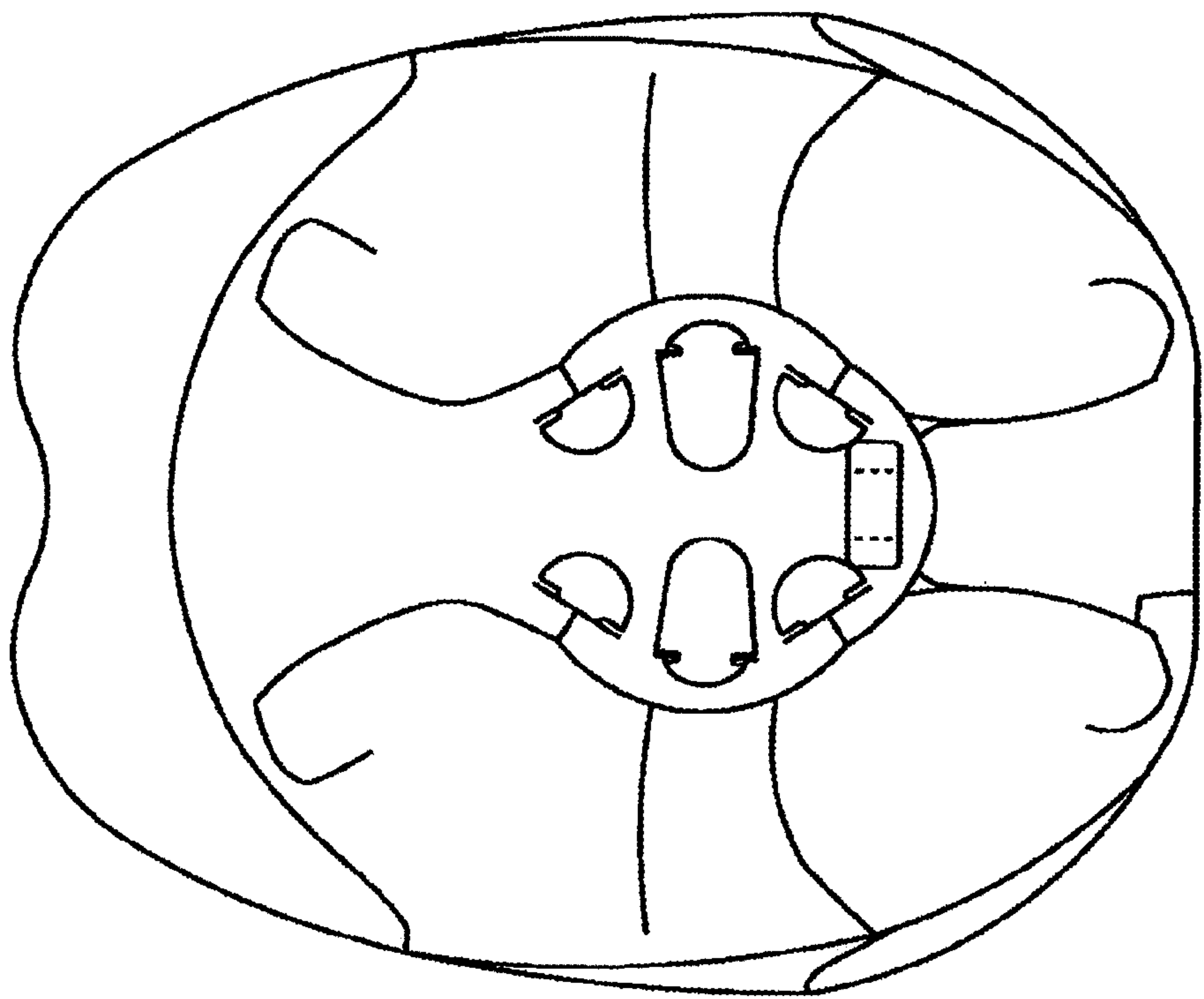
