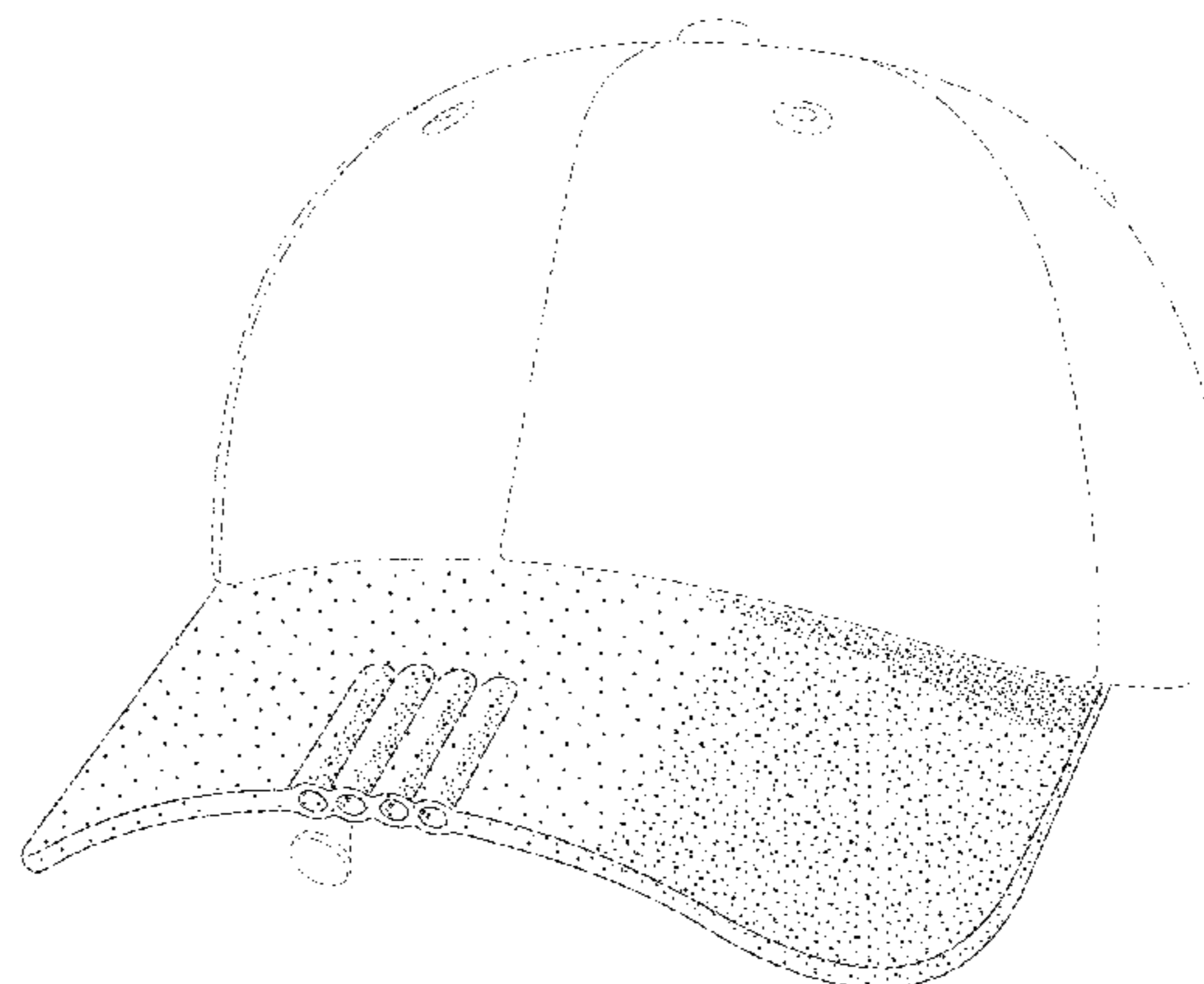
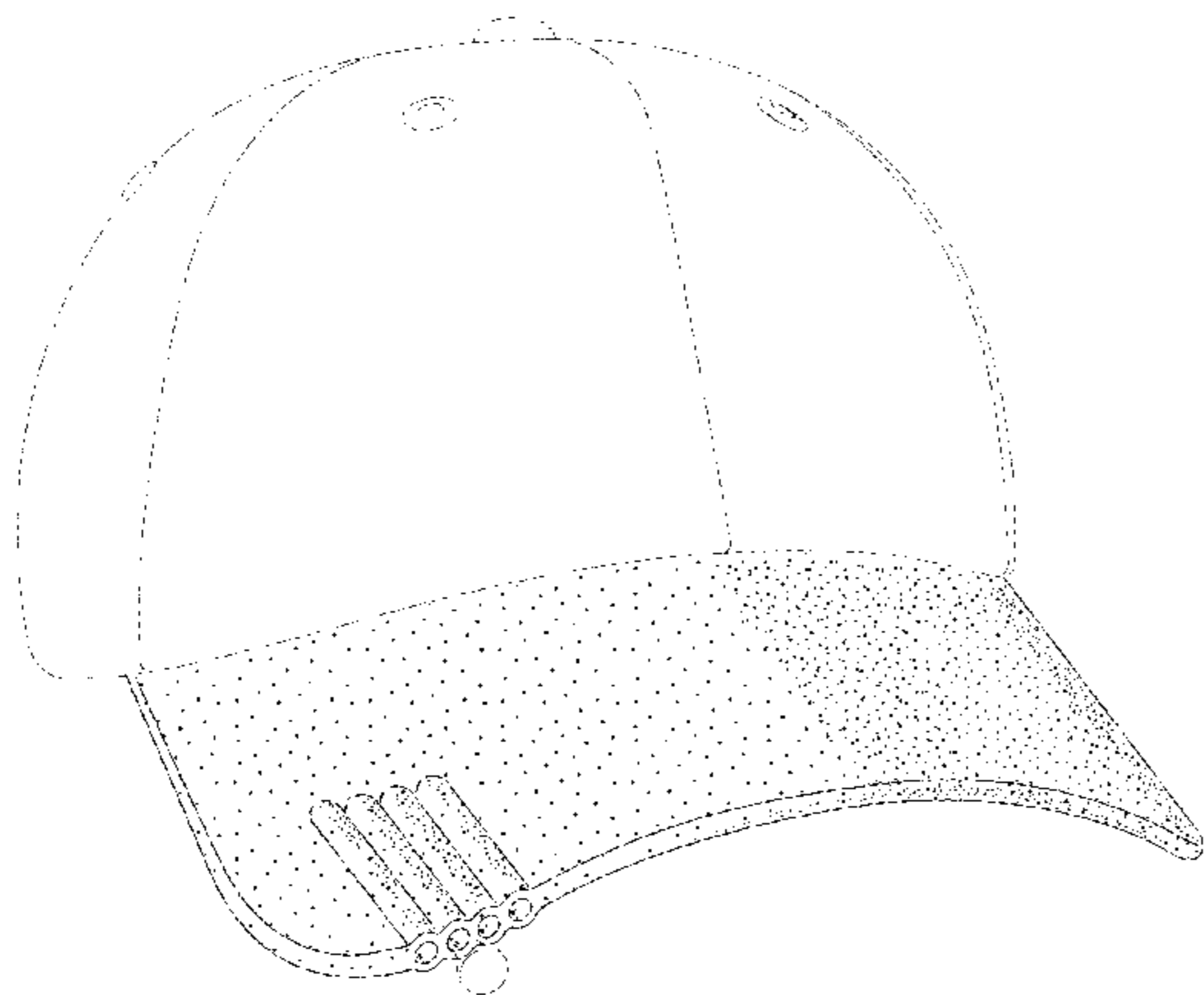

(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for golf headwear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of golf headwear embodying a first embodiment of the design; FIG. 2 is a right front perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a right front perspective view of golf headwear embodying a second embodiment of the design; FIG. 9 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 10 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 11 is left front perspective view of golf headwear embodying a third embodiment of the design; FIG. 12 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 13 is a front elevation view thereof; and, FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof. The stippling technique applied along the brim of the headwear is representative of shading. The broken lines showing the headwear crown and the golf tees represent environmental subject matter that form no part of the claimed design.

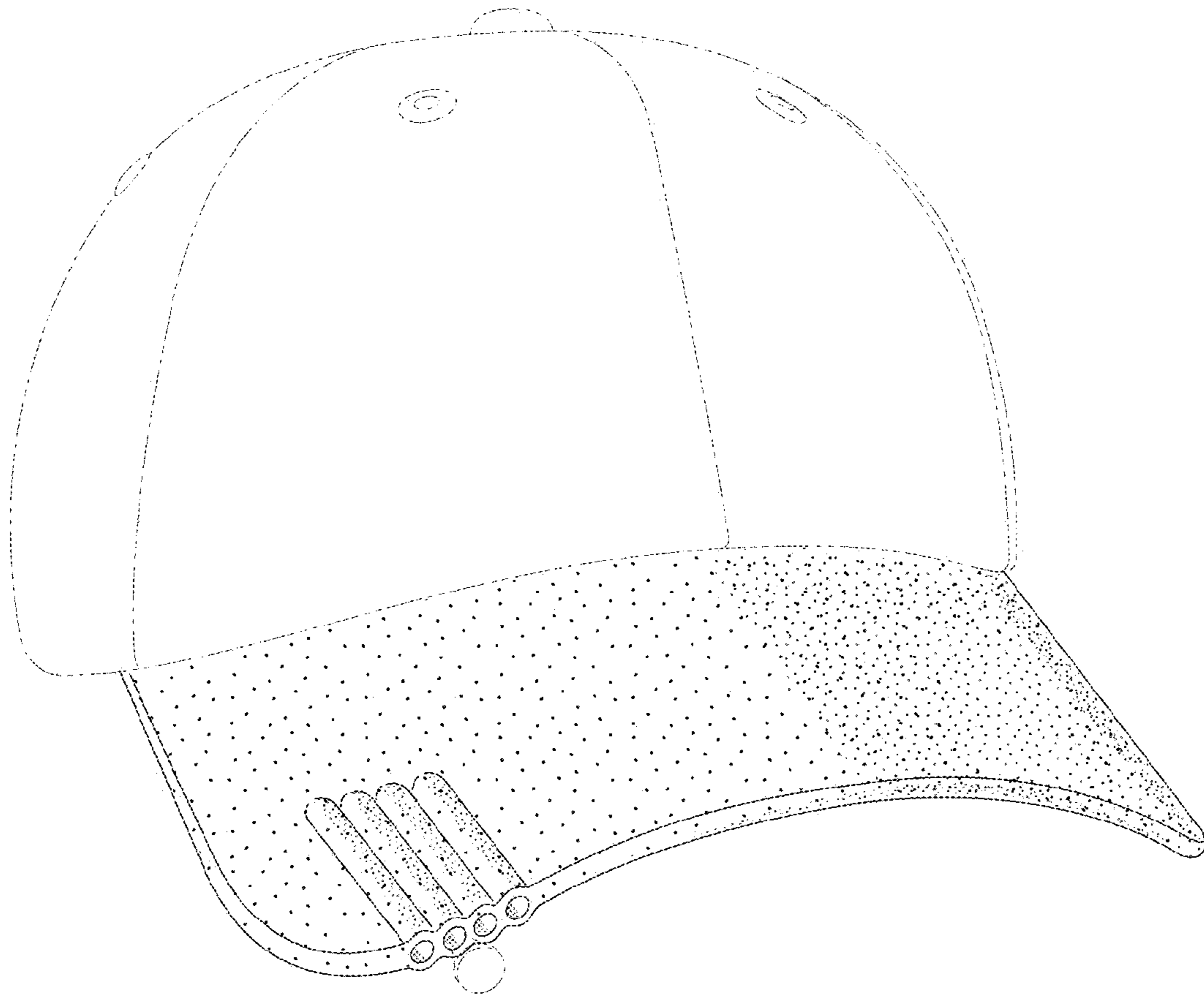

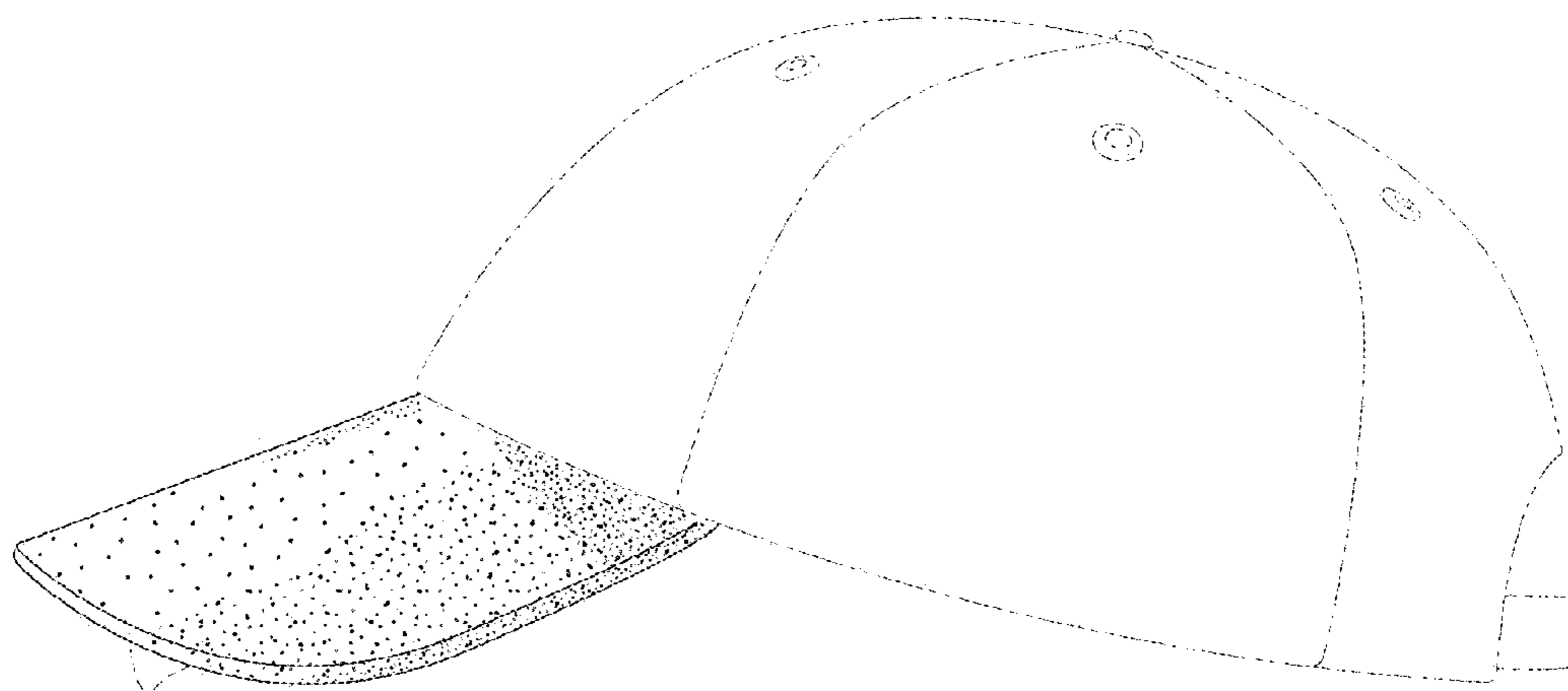

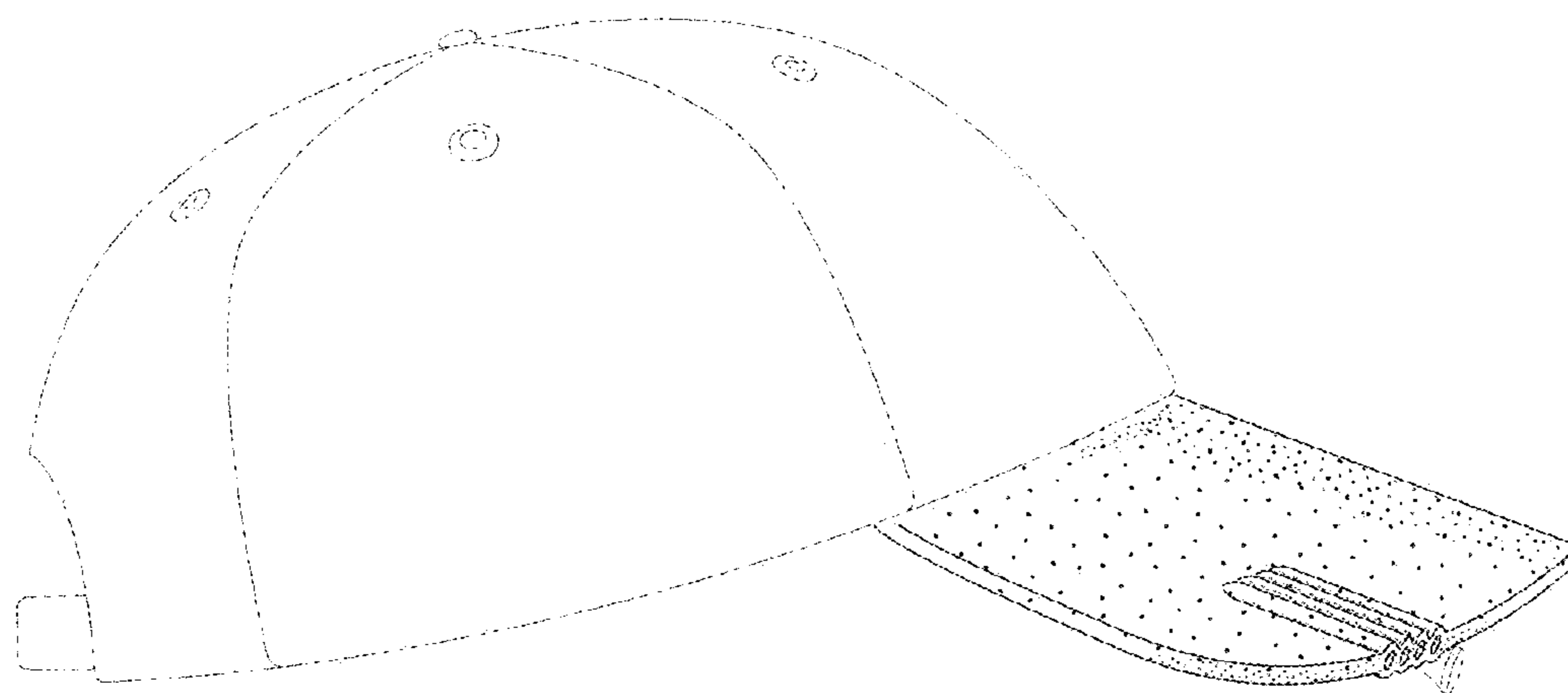

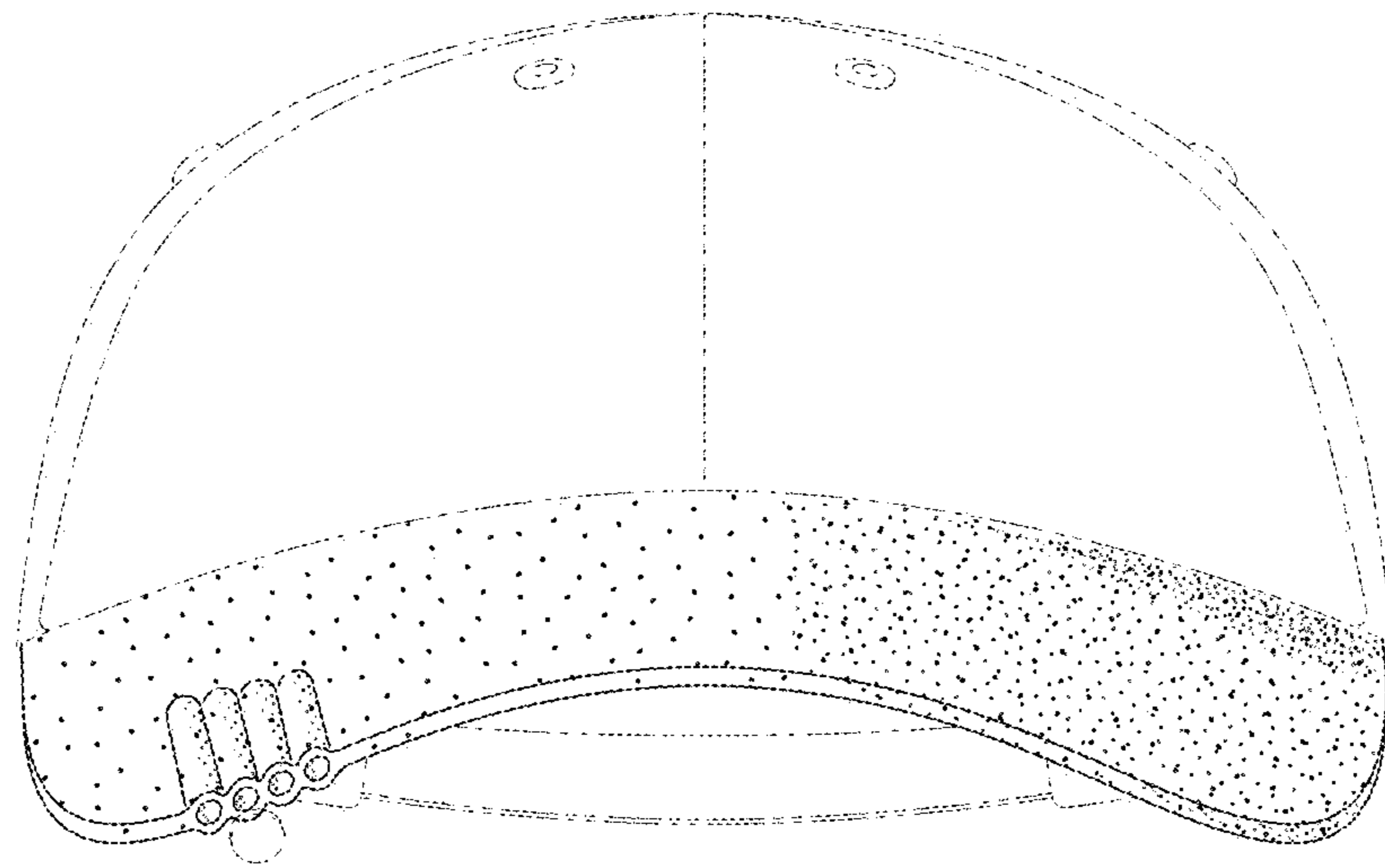

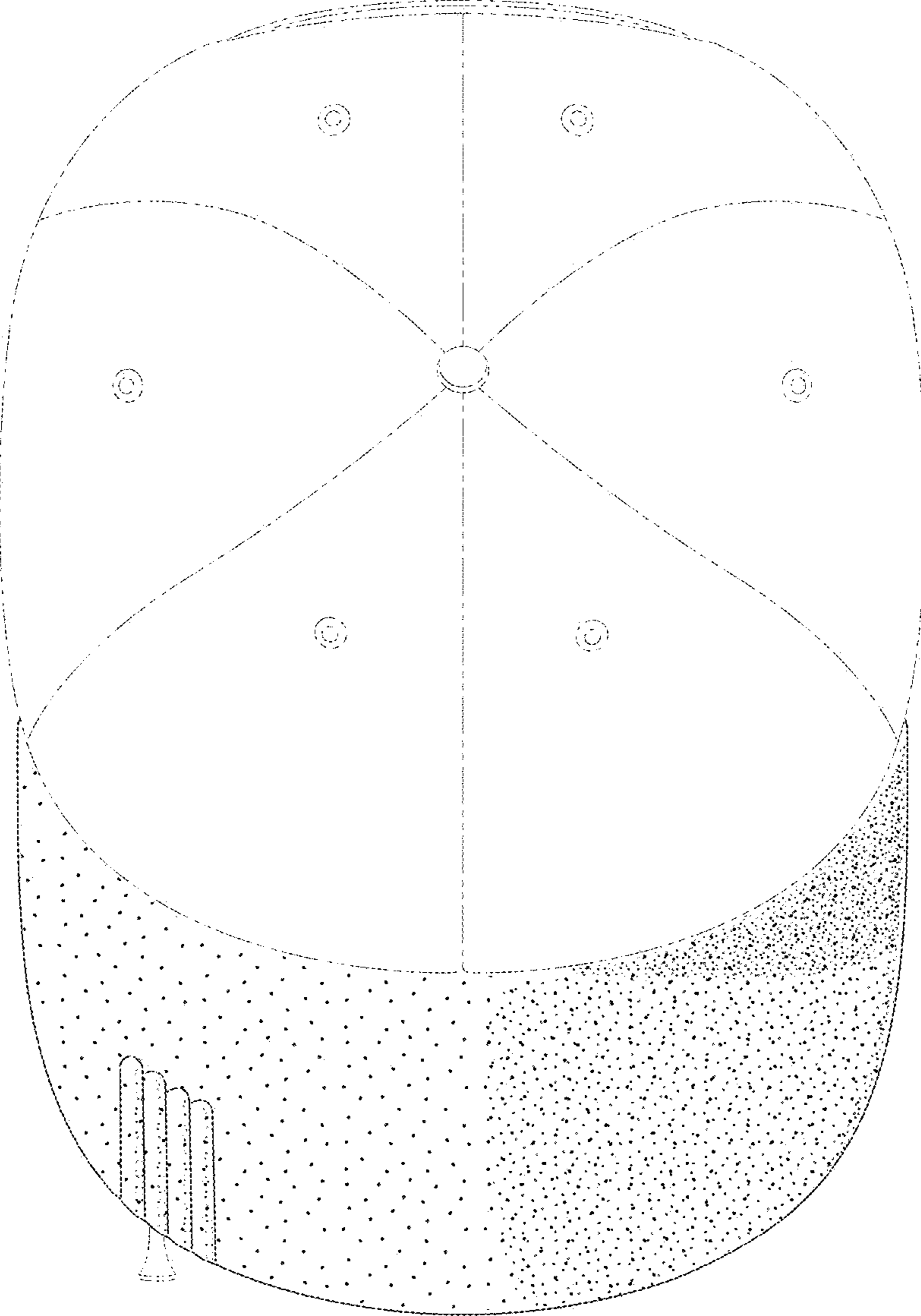

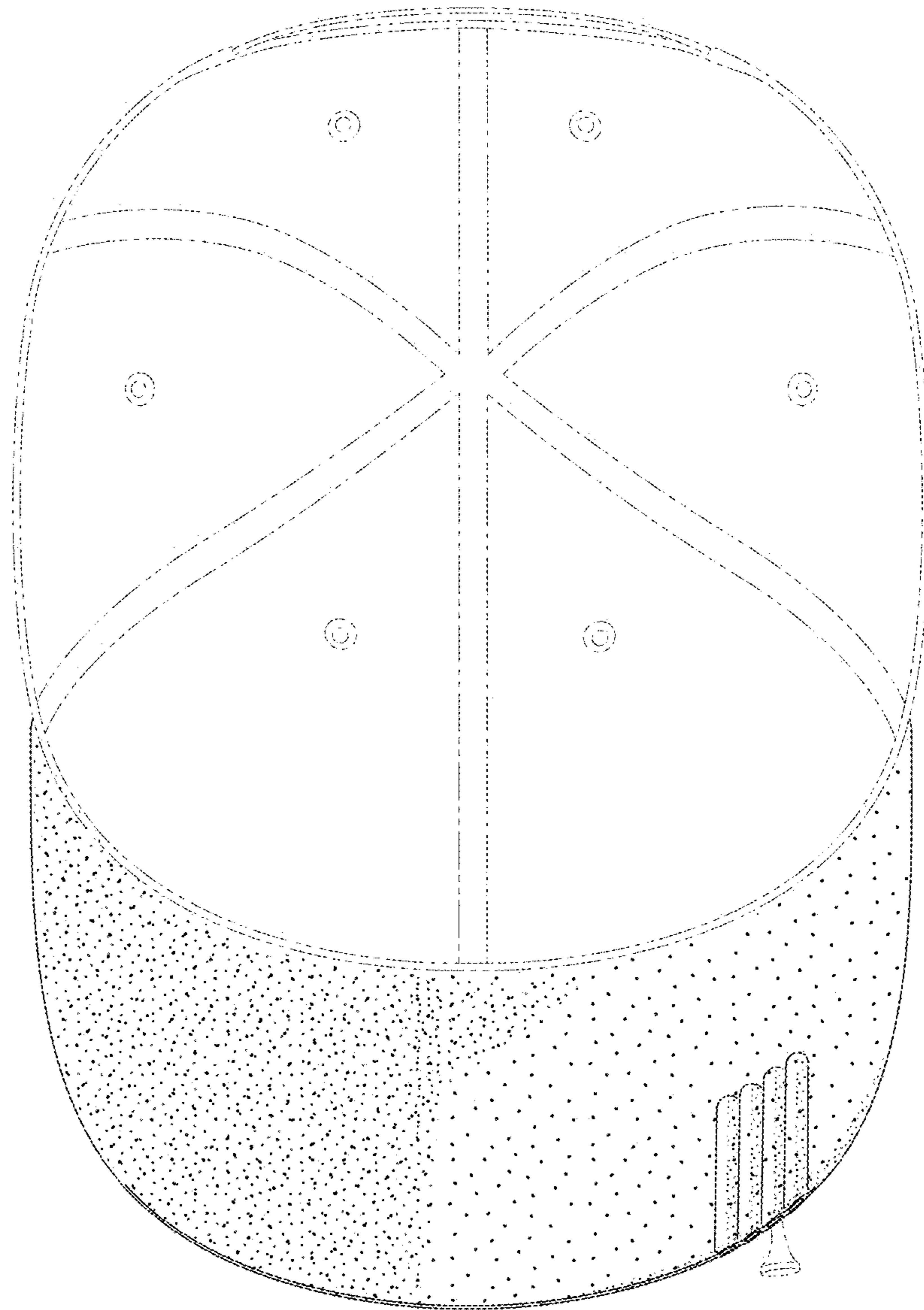

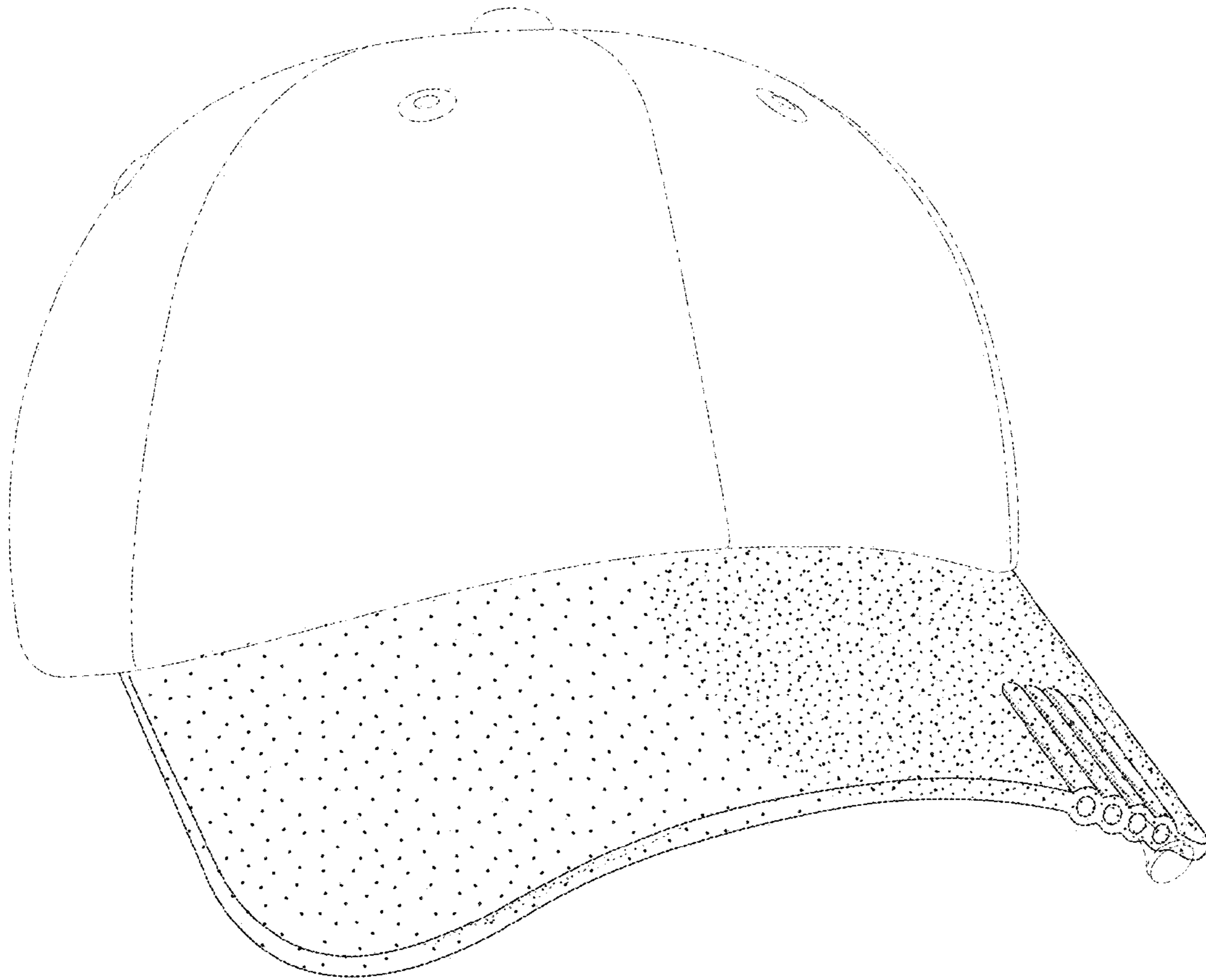

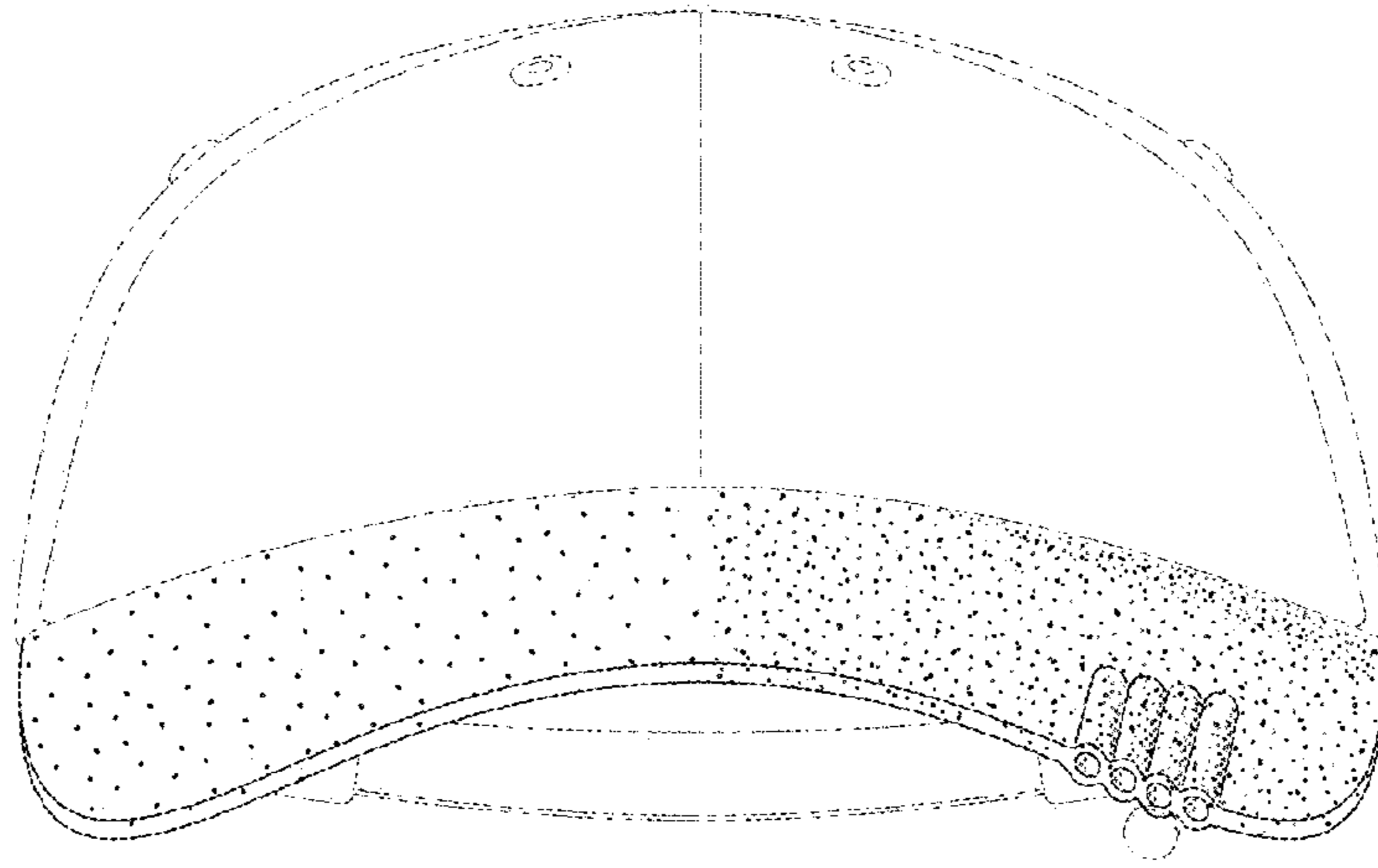

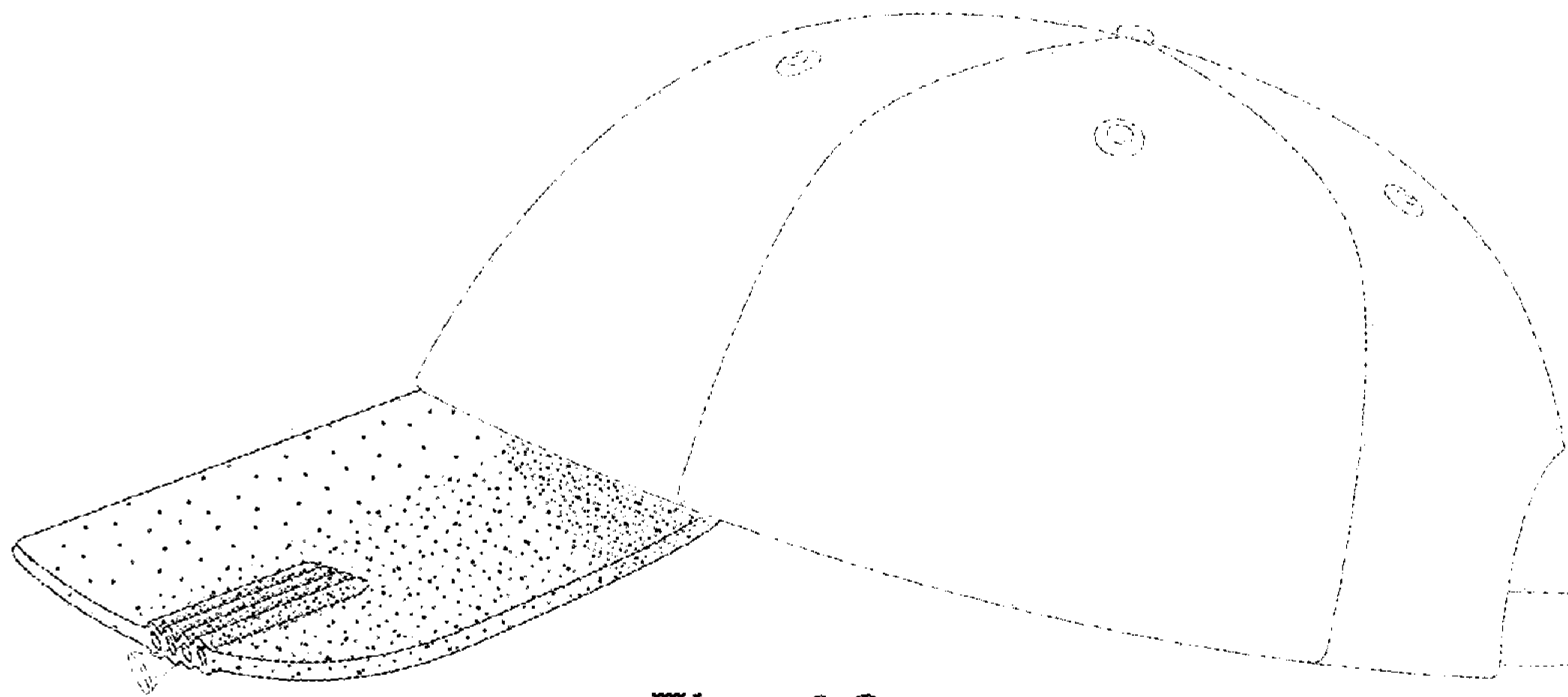

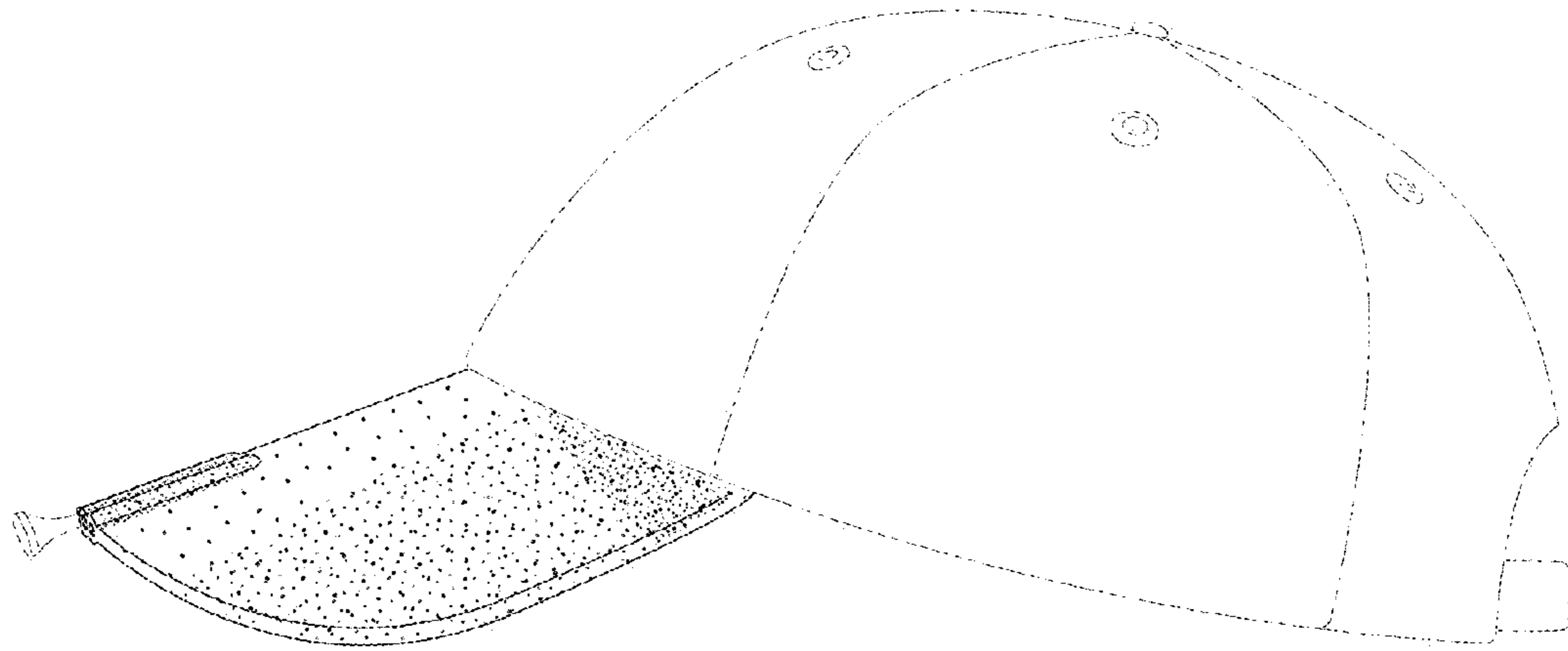

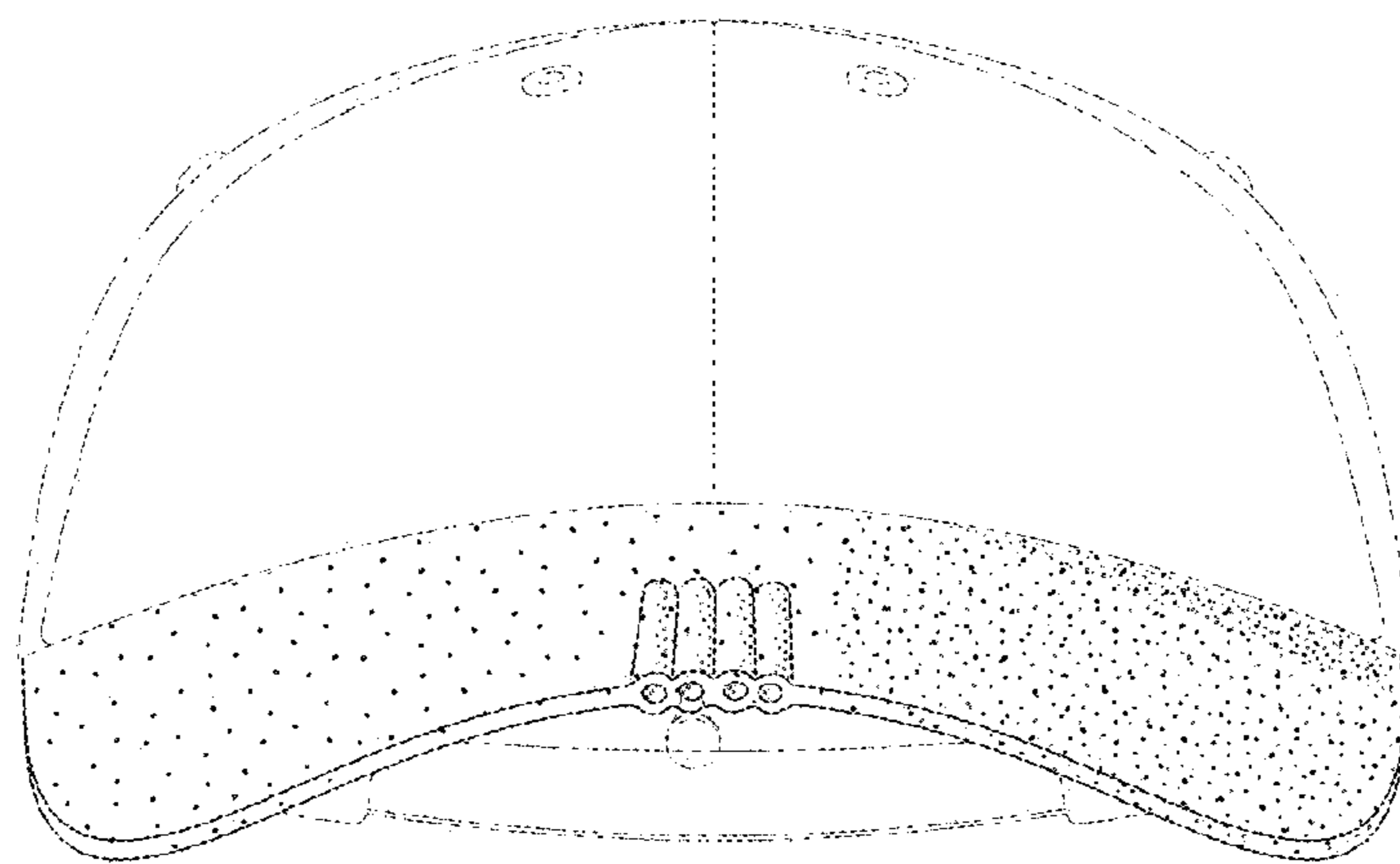

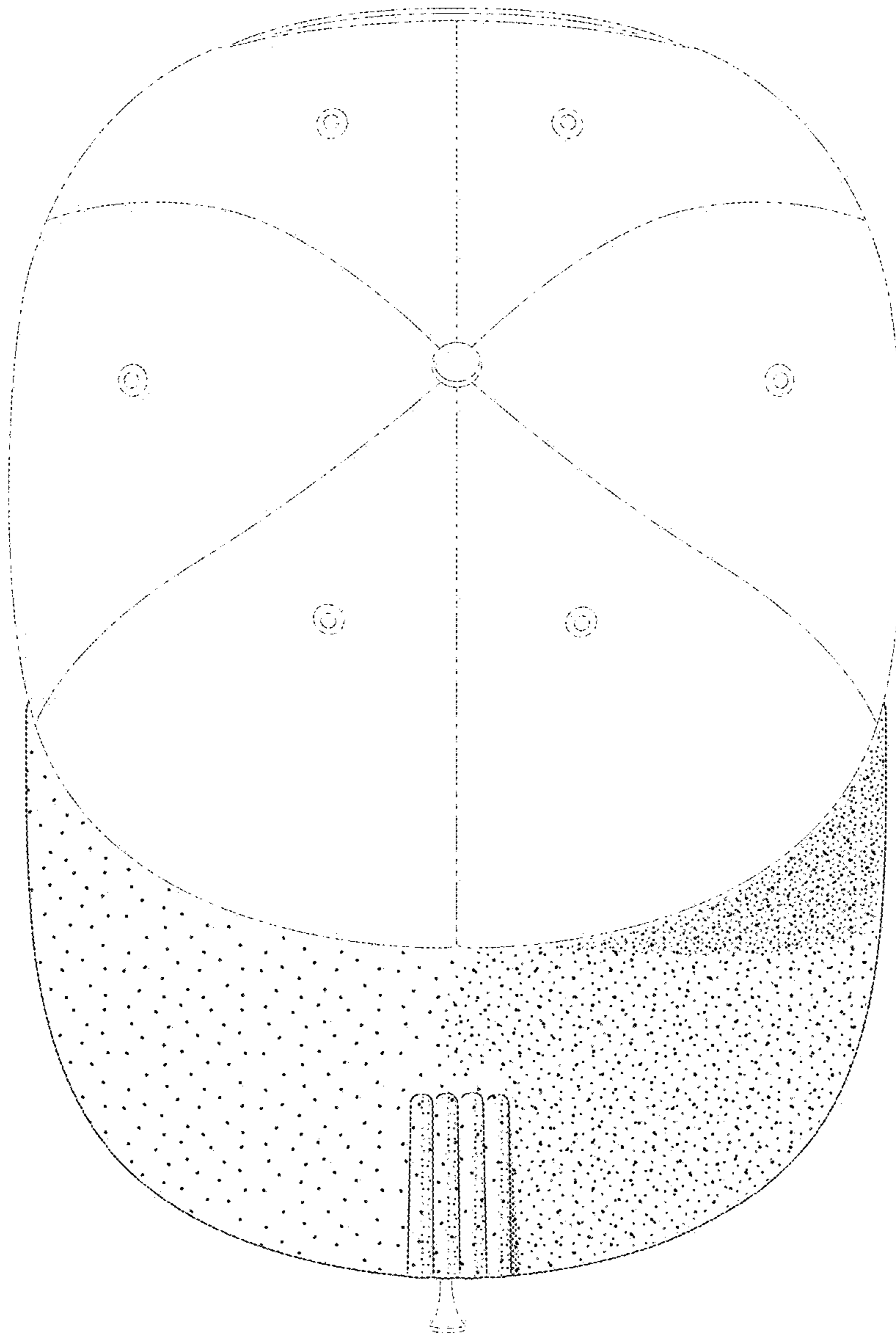
