FIG. 4 is a rear view of the merchandise hook of FIG. 1.

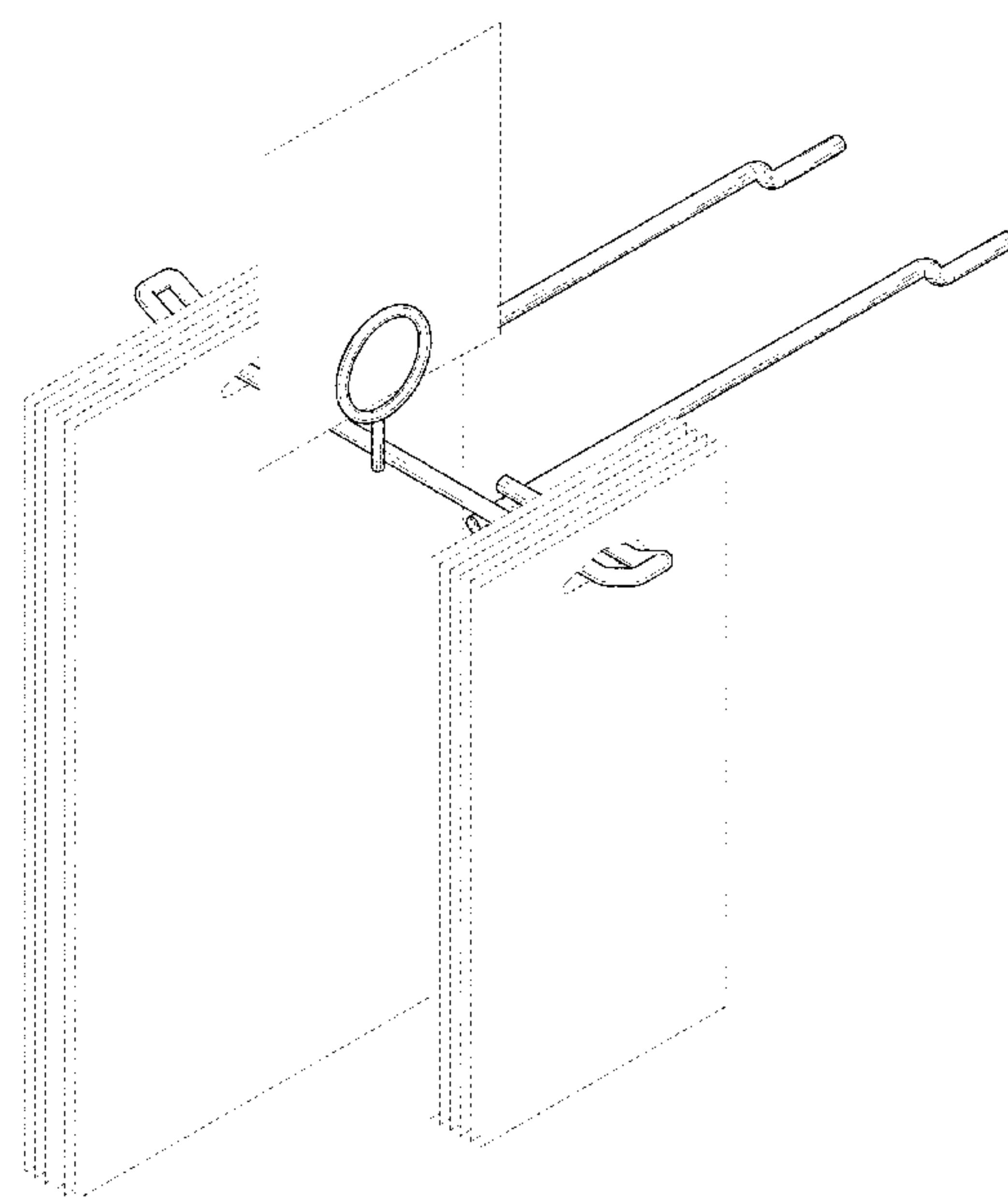
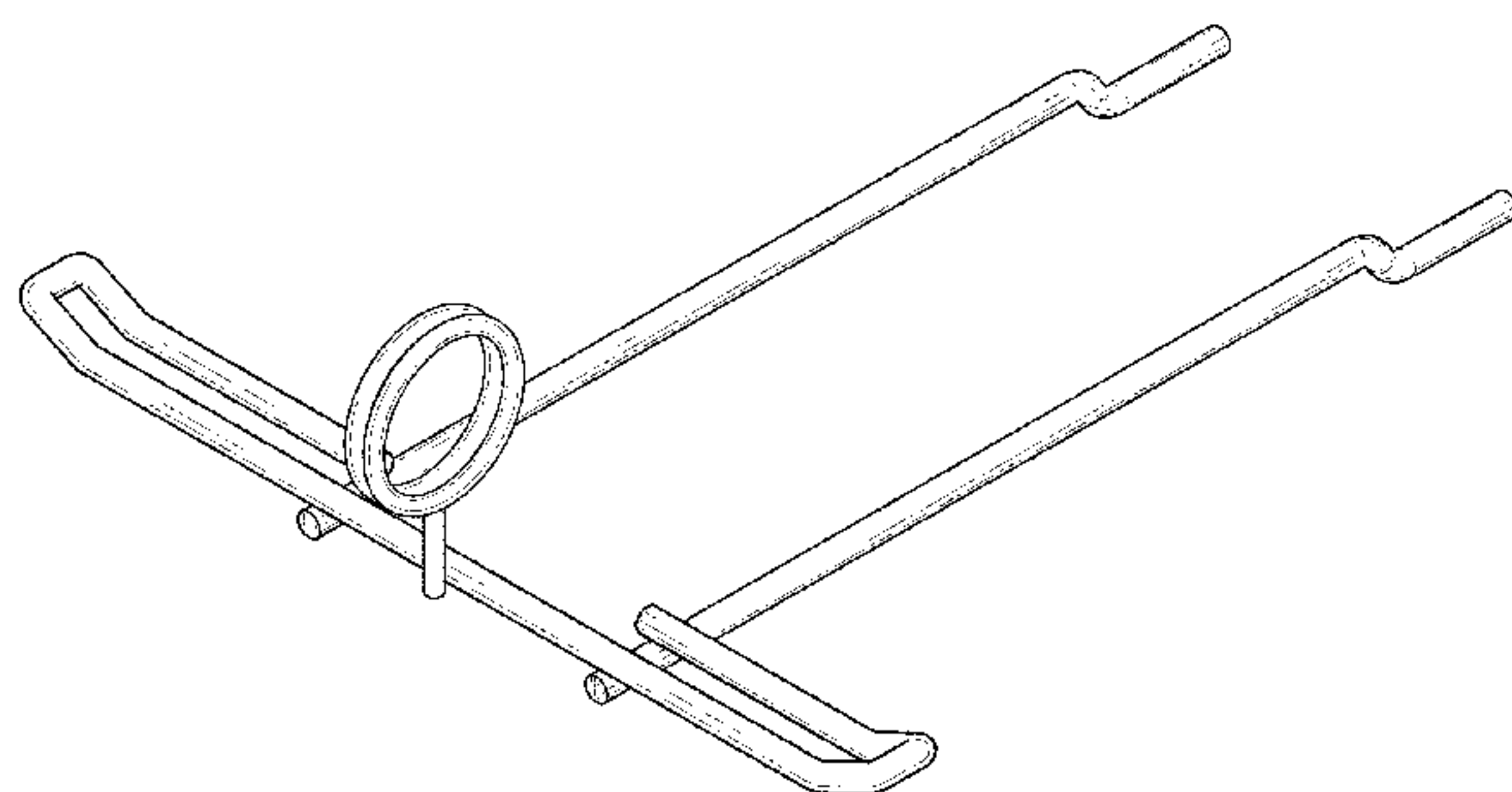
FIG. 5 is a top view of the merchandise hook of FIG. 1.

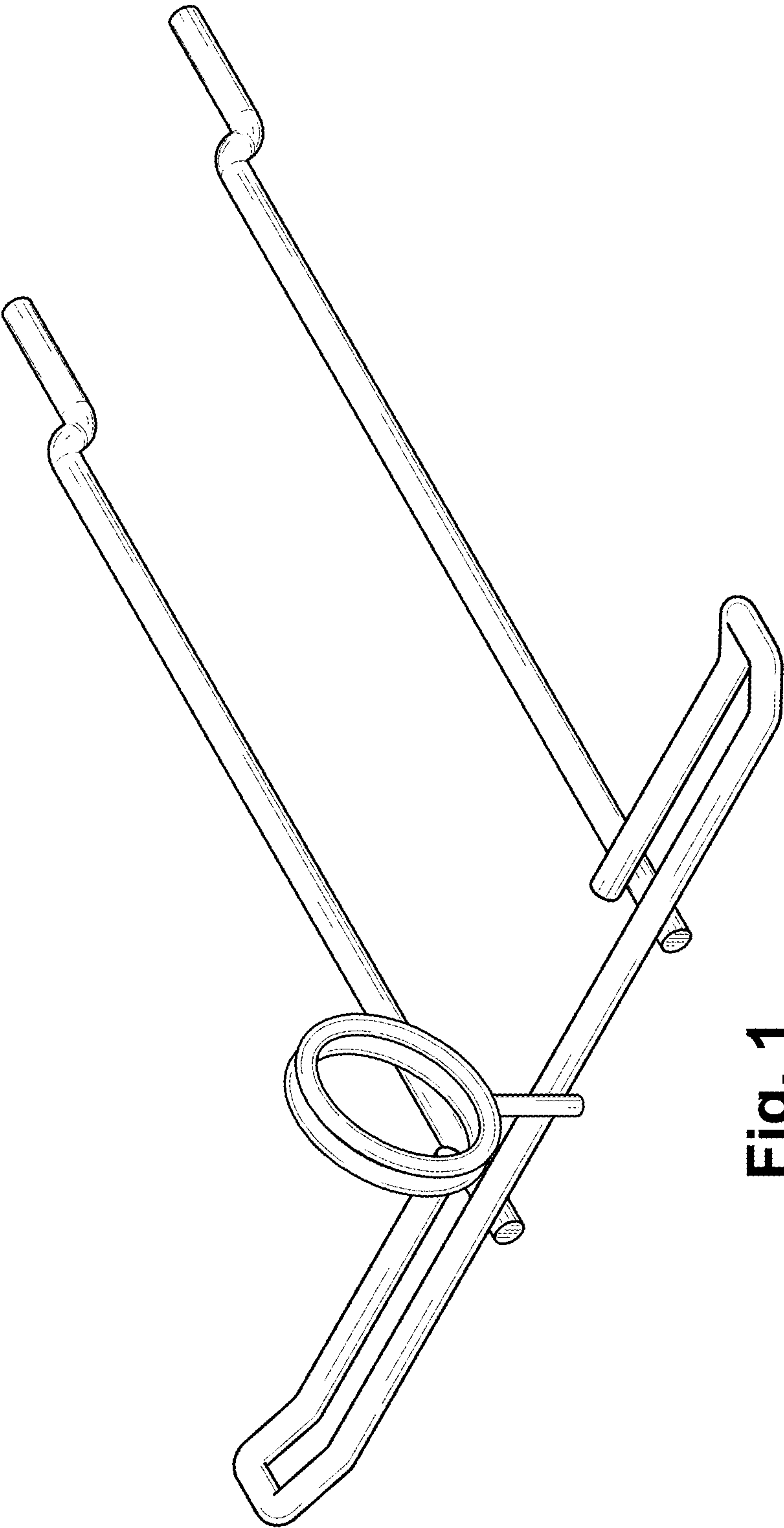

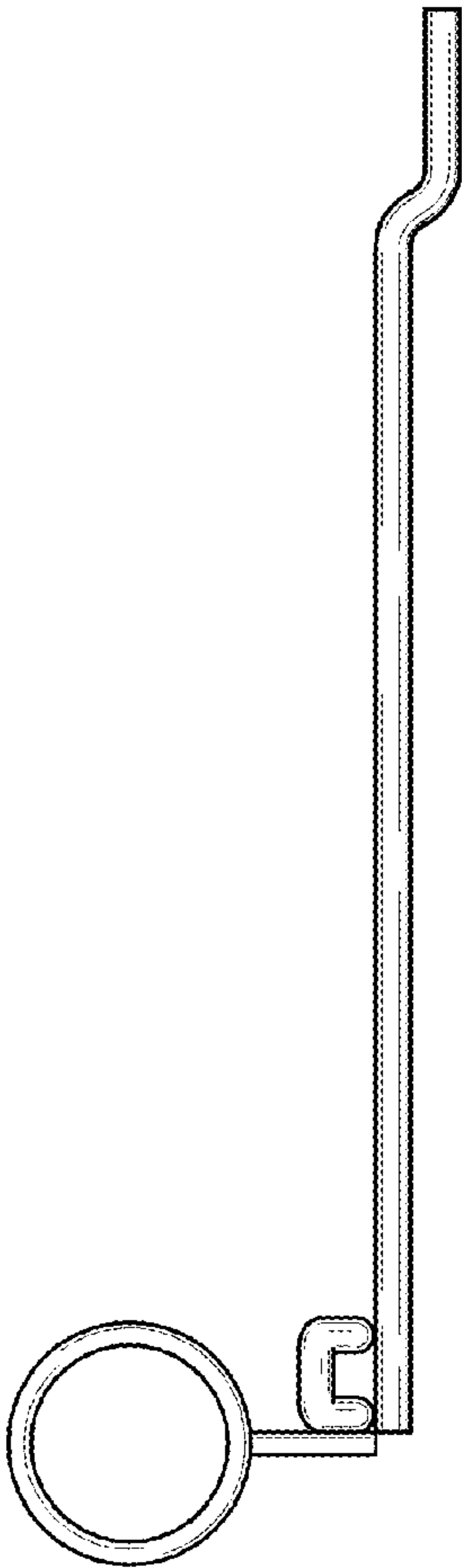

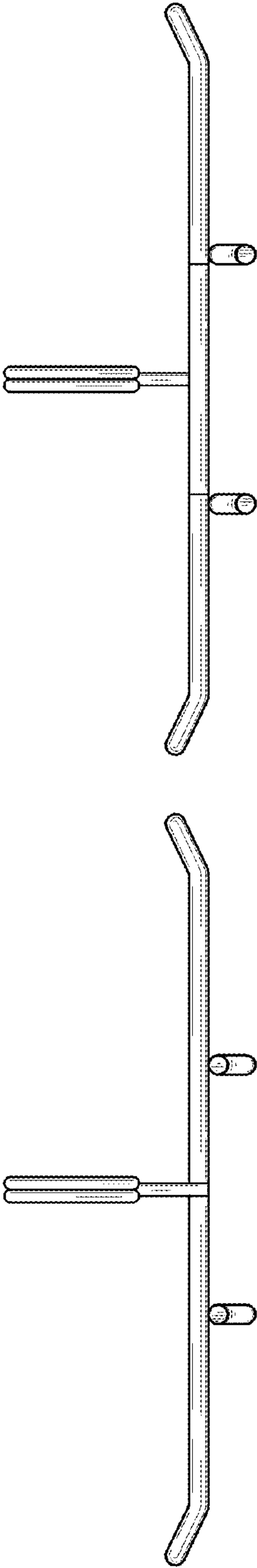

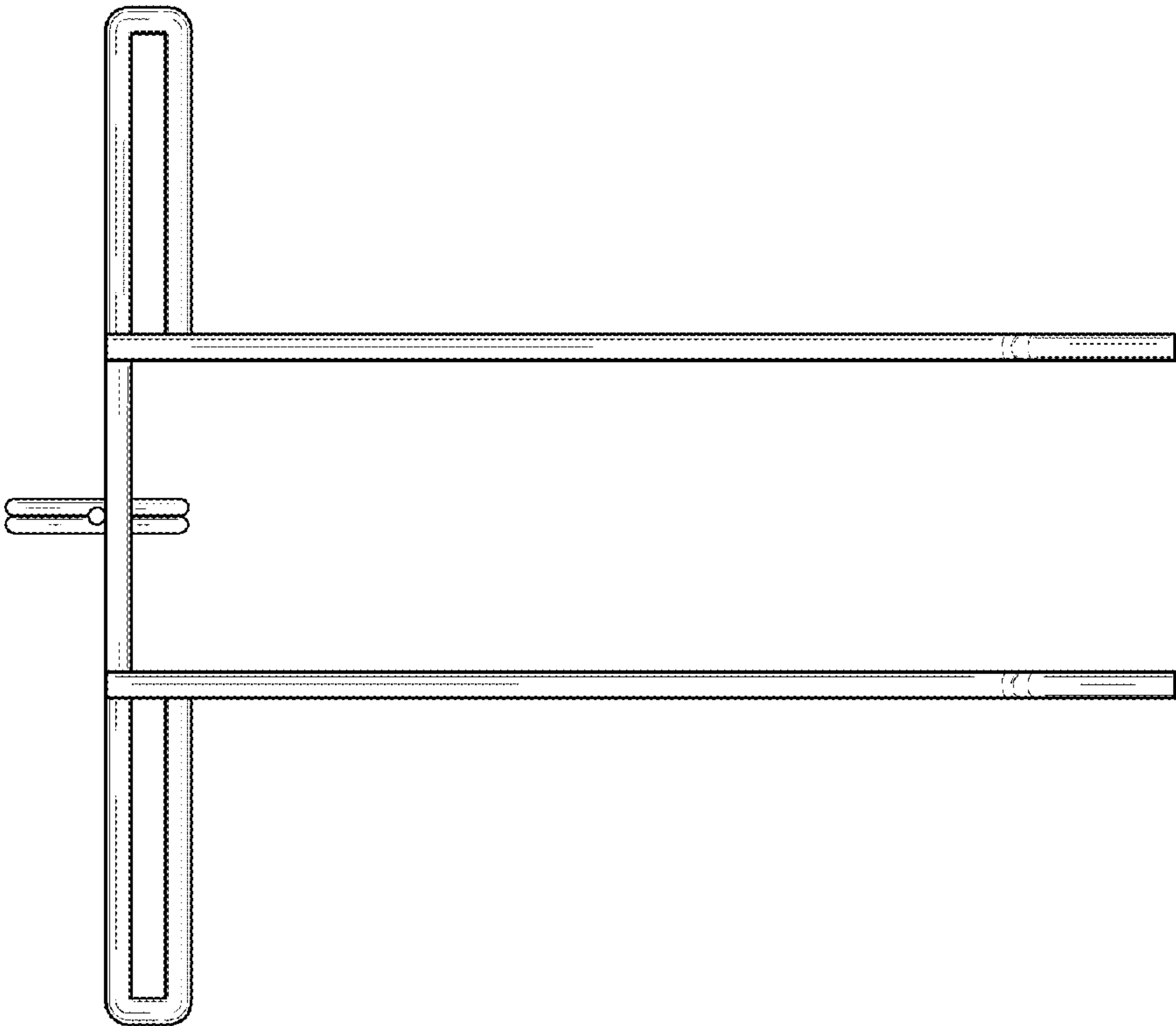

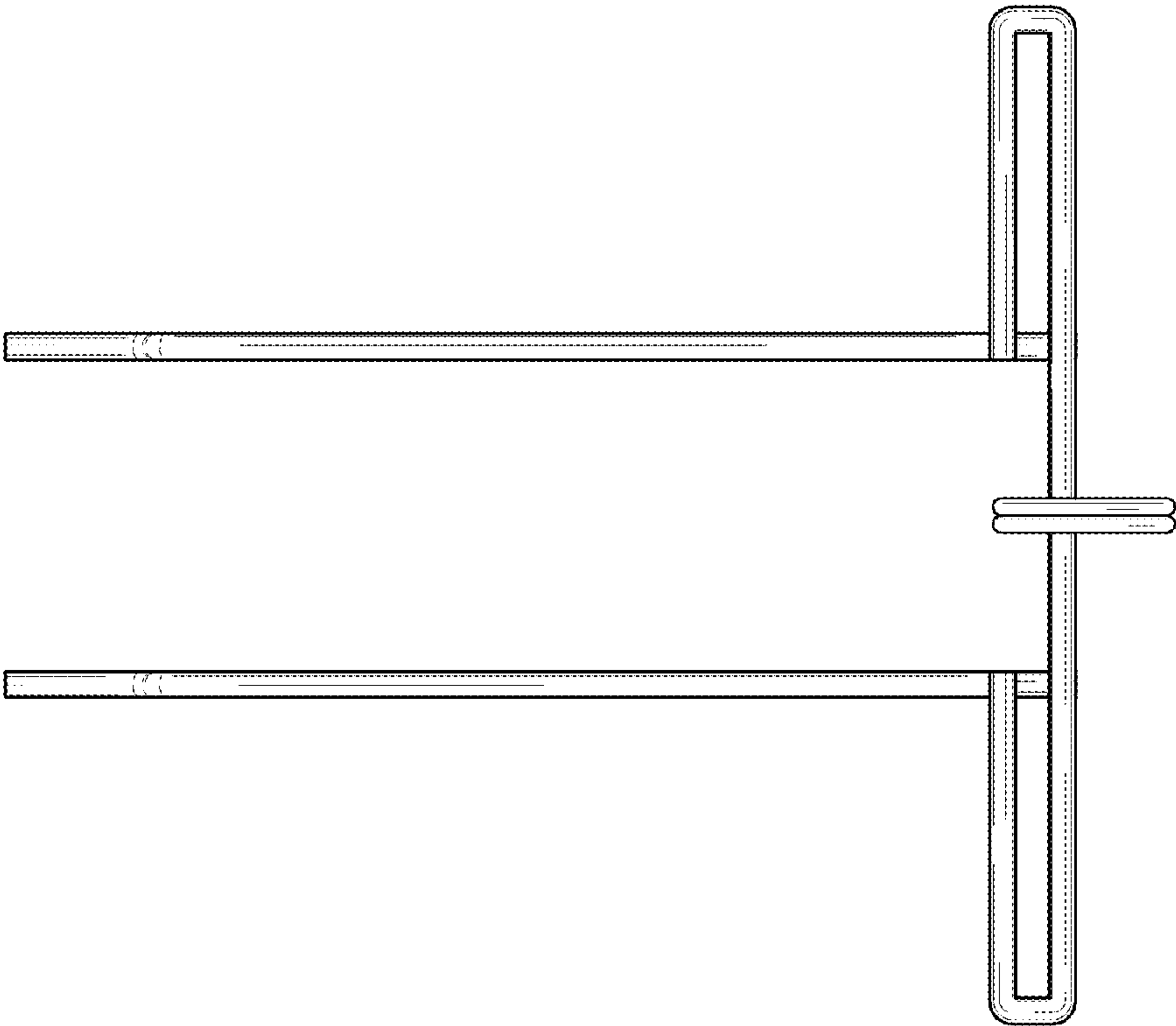

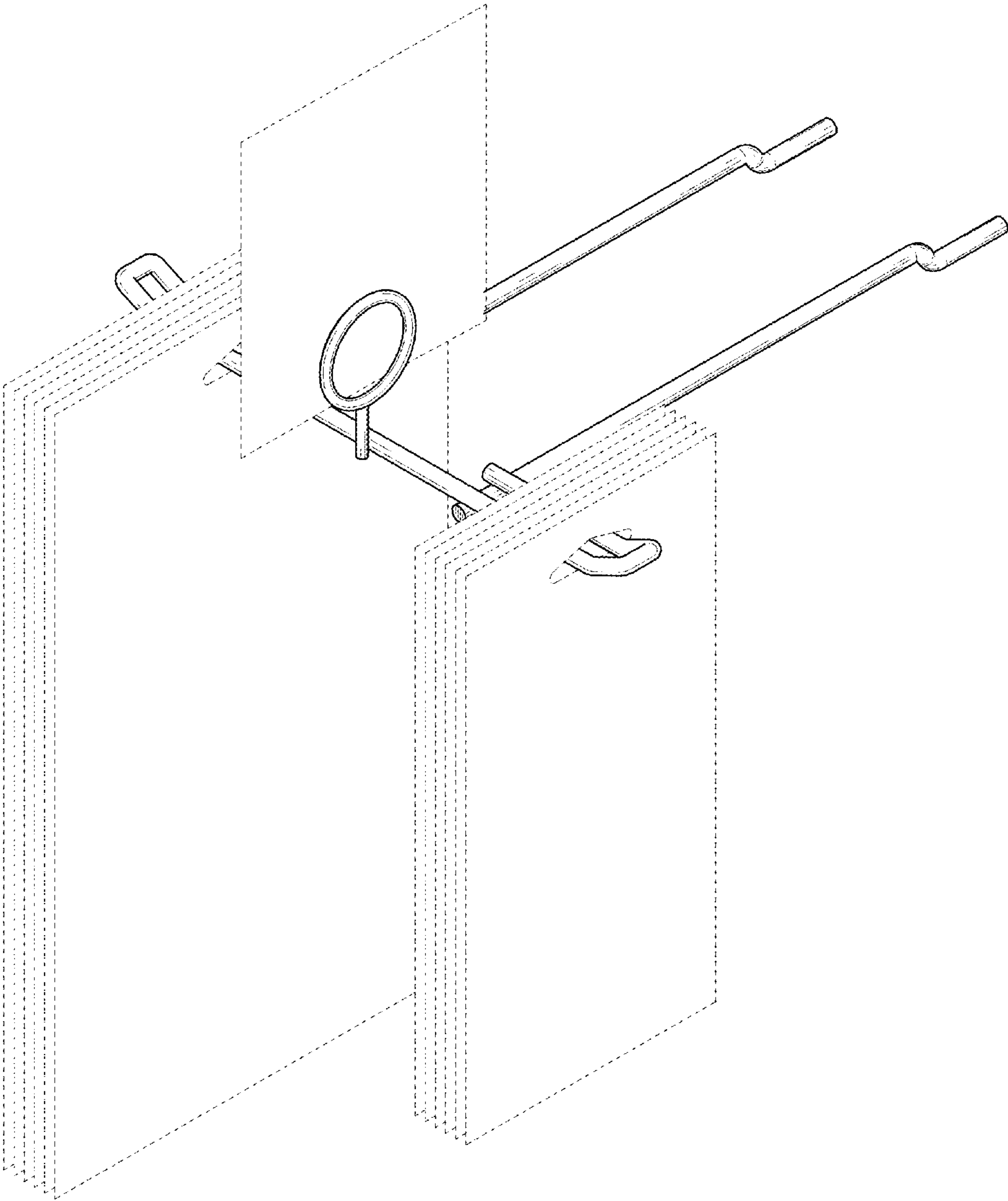
