3a-3b in FIG. 2 in an open state;

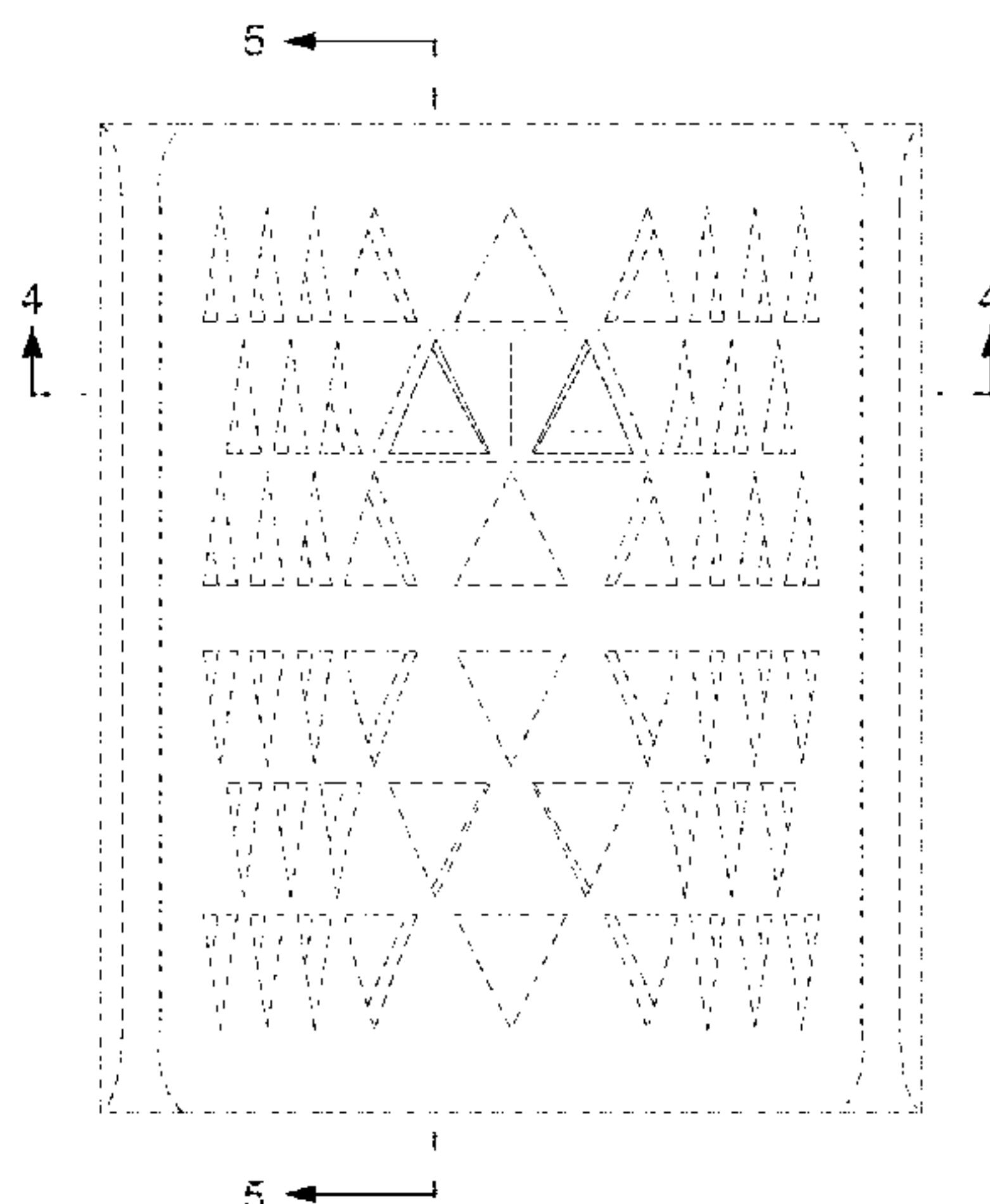
FIG. 7 is an enlarged view thereof, showing the area marked

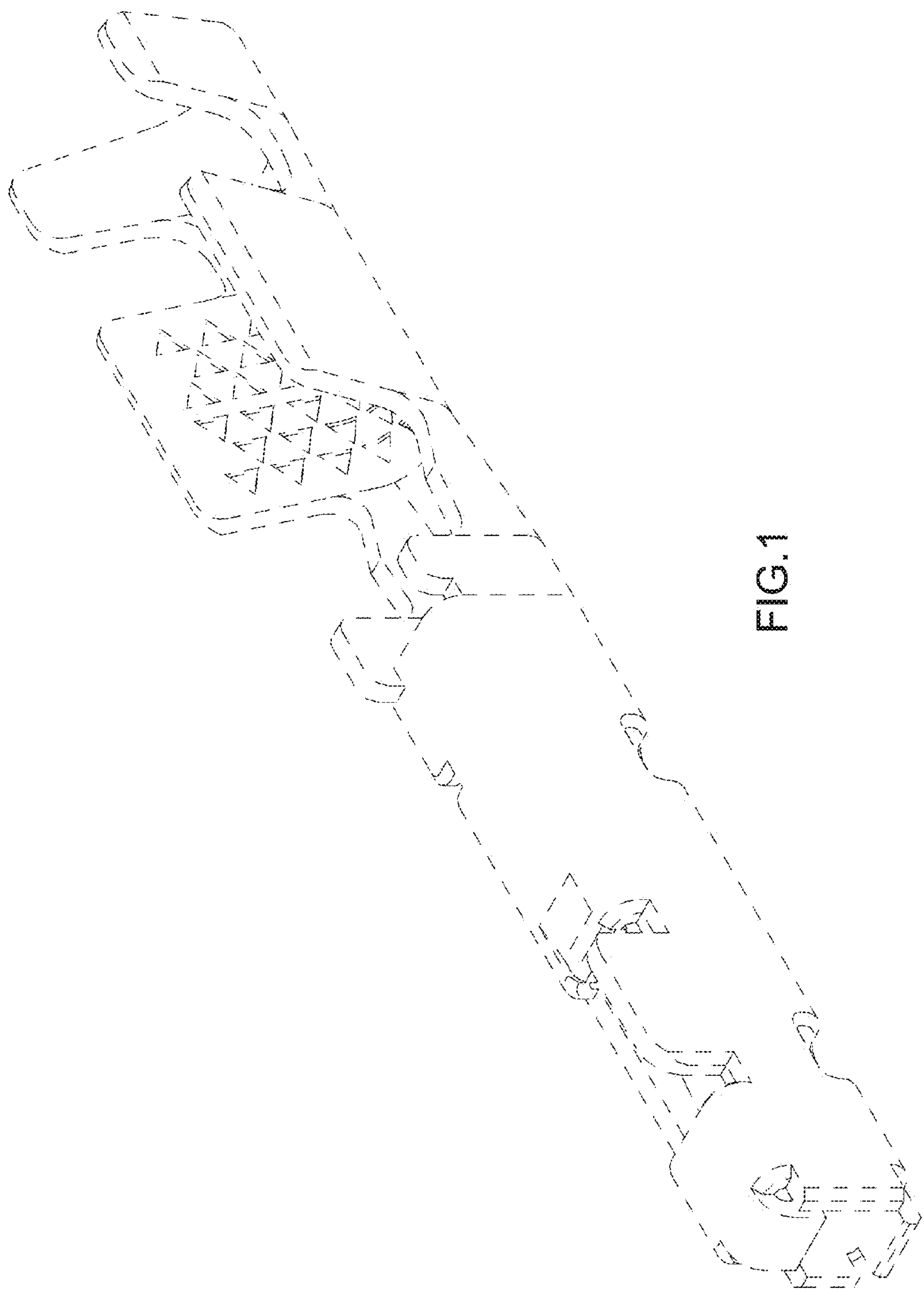

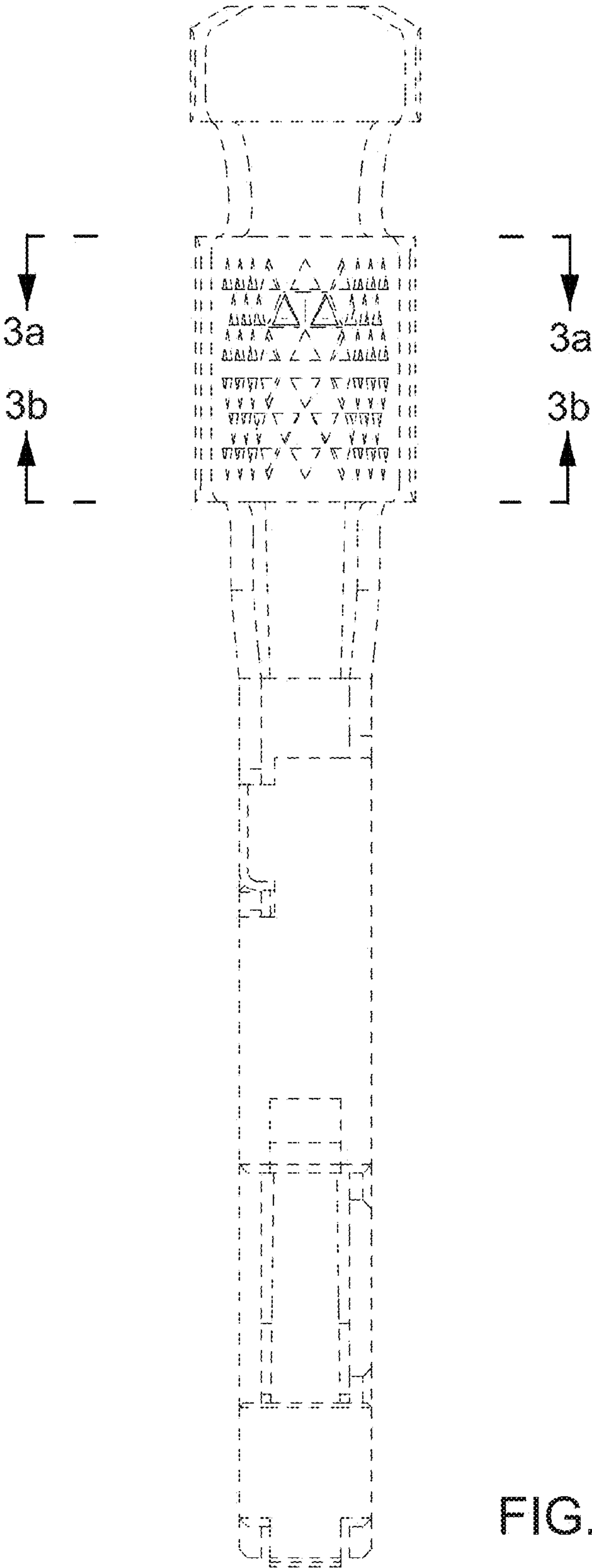

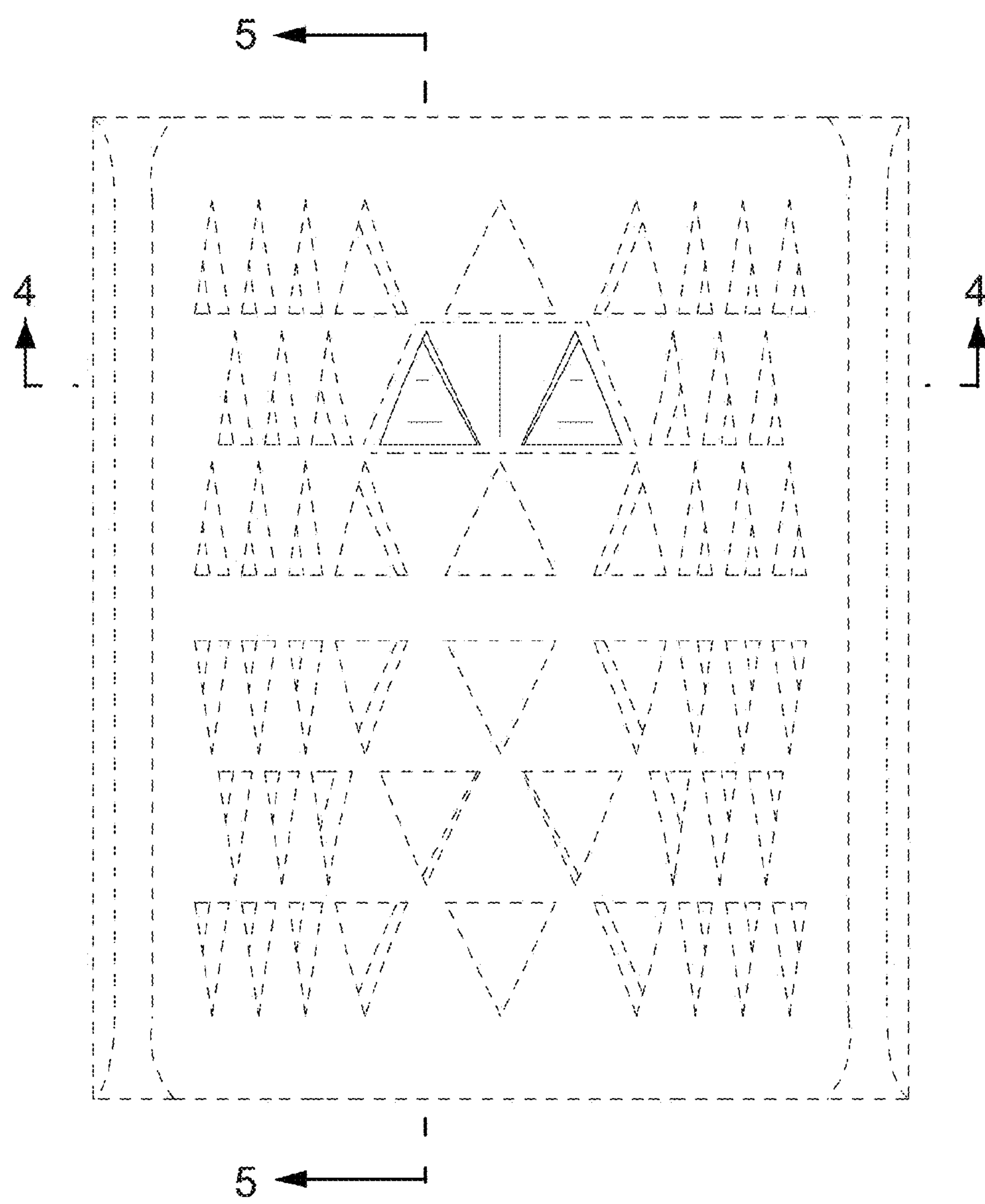

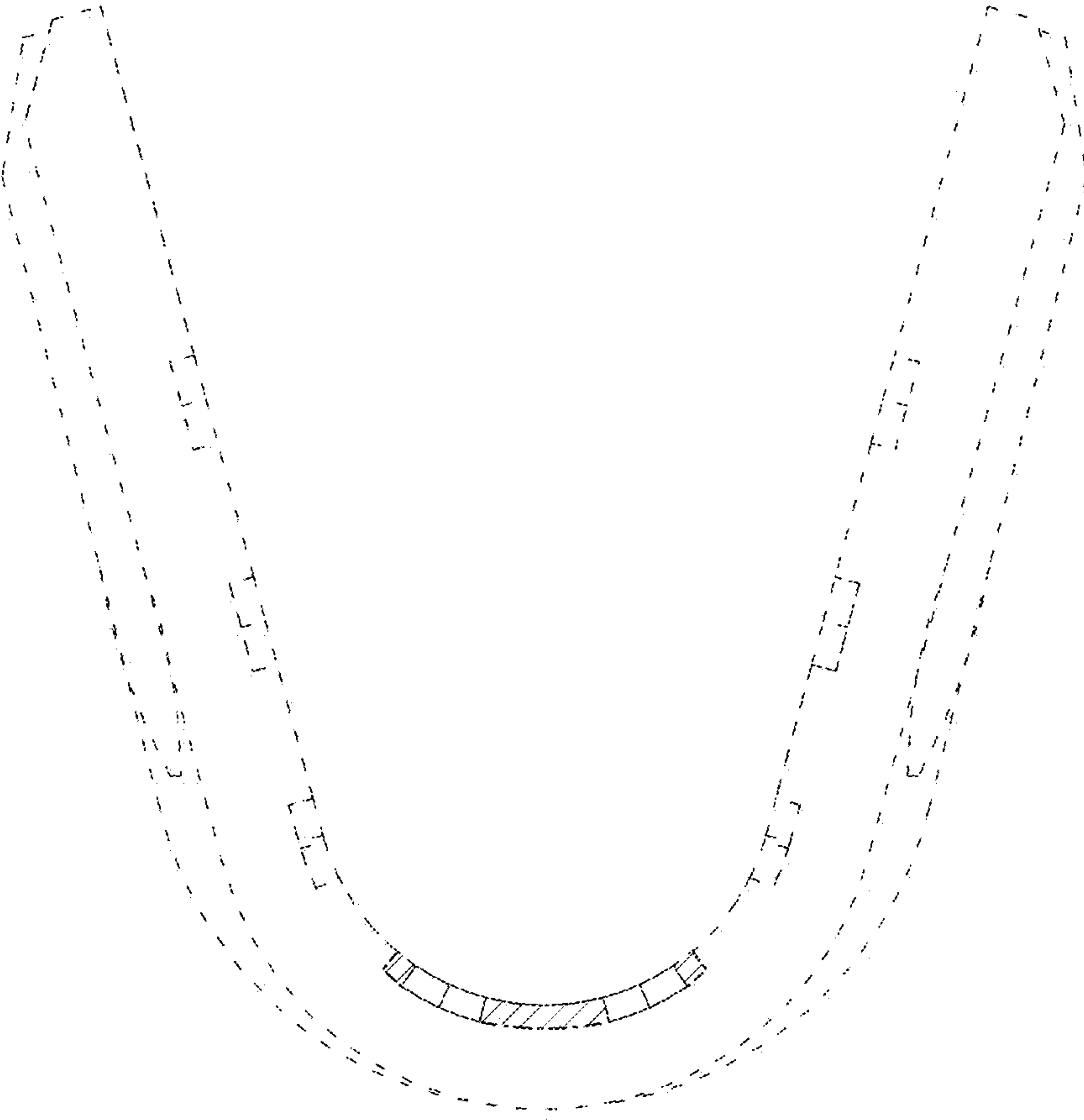

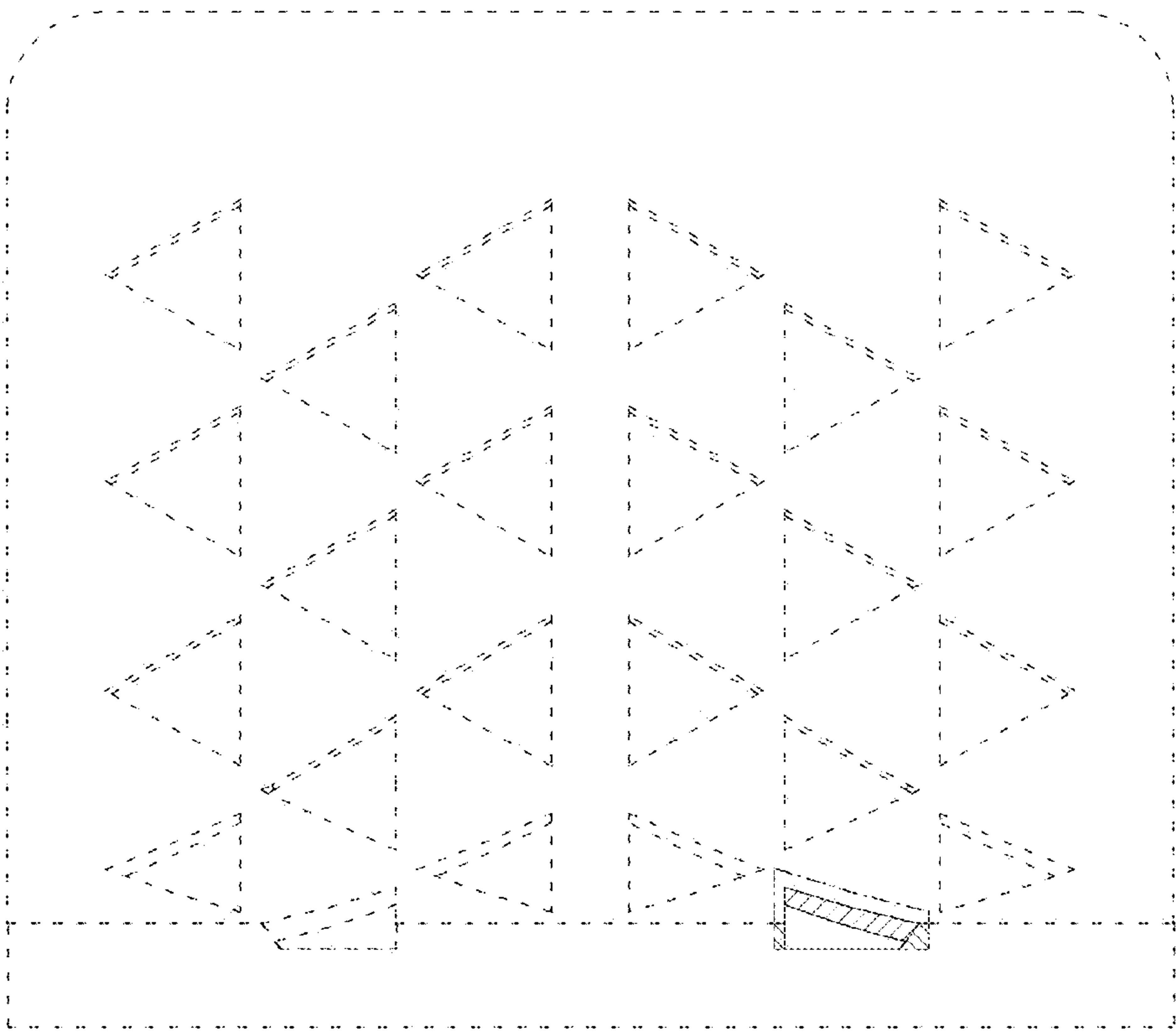

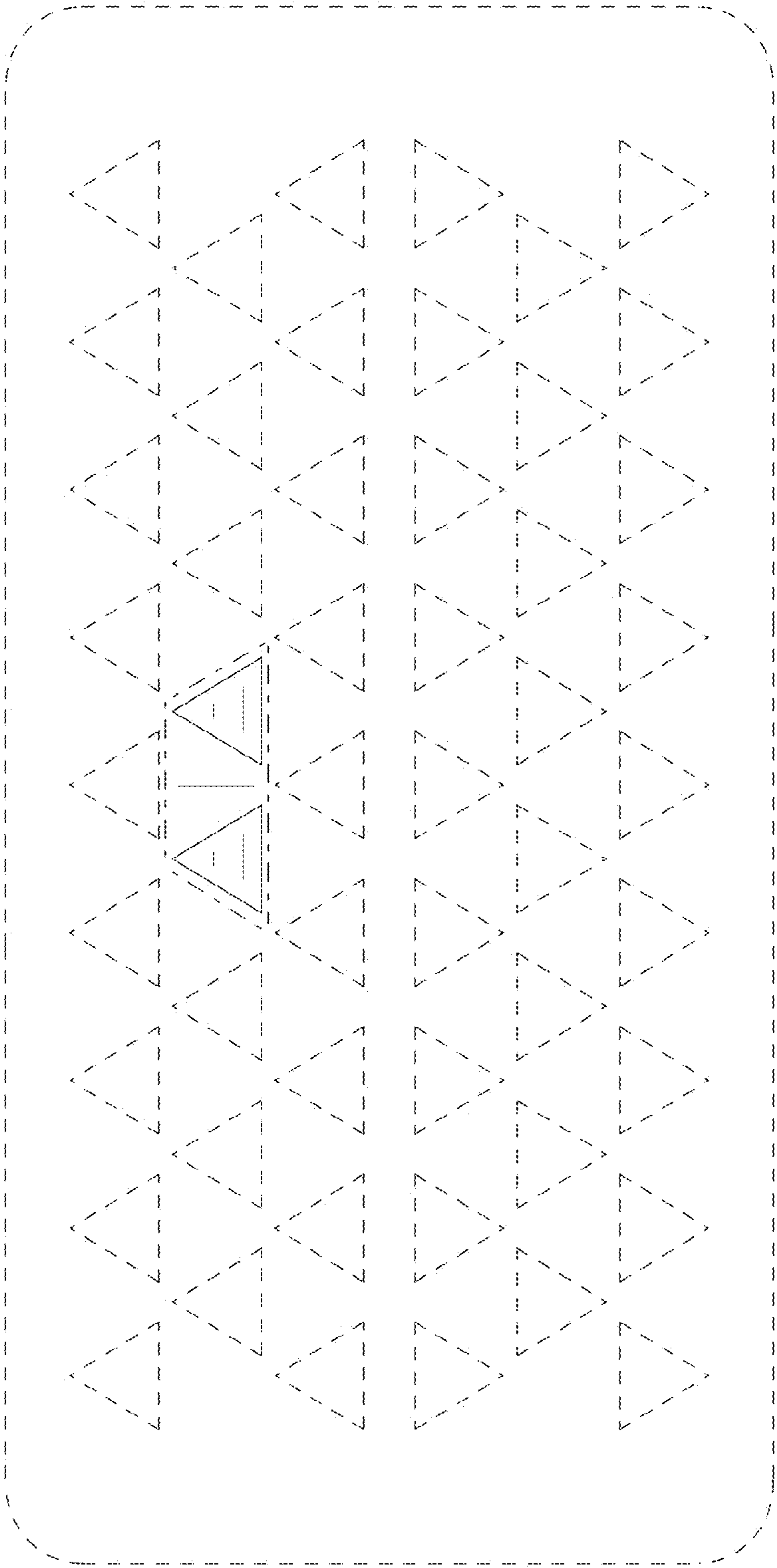

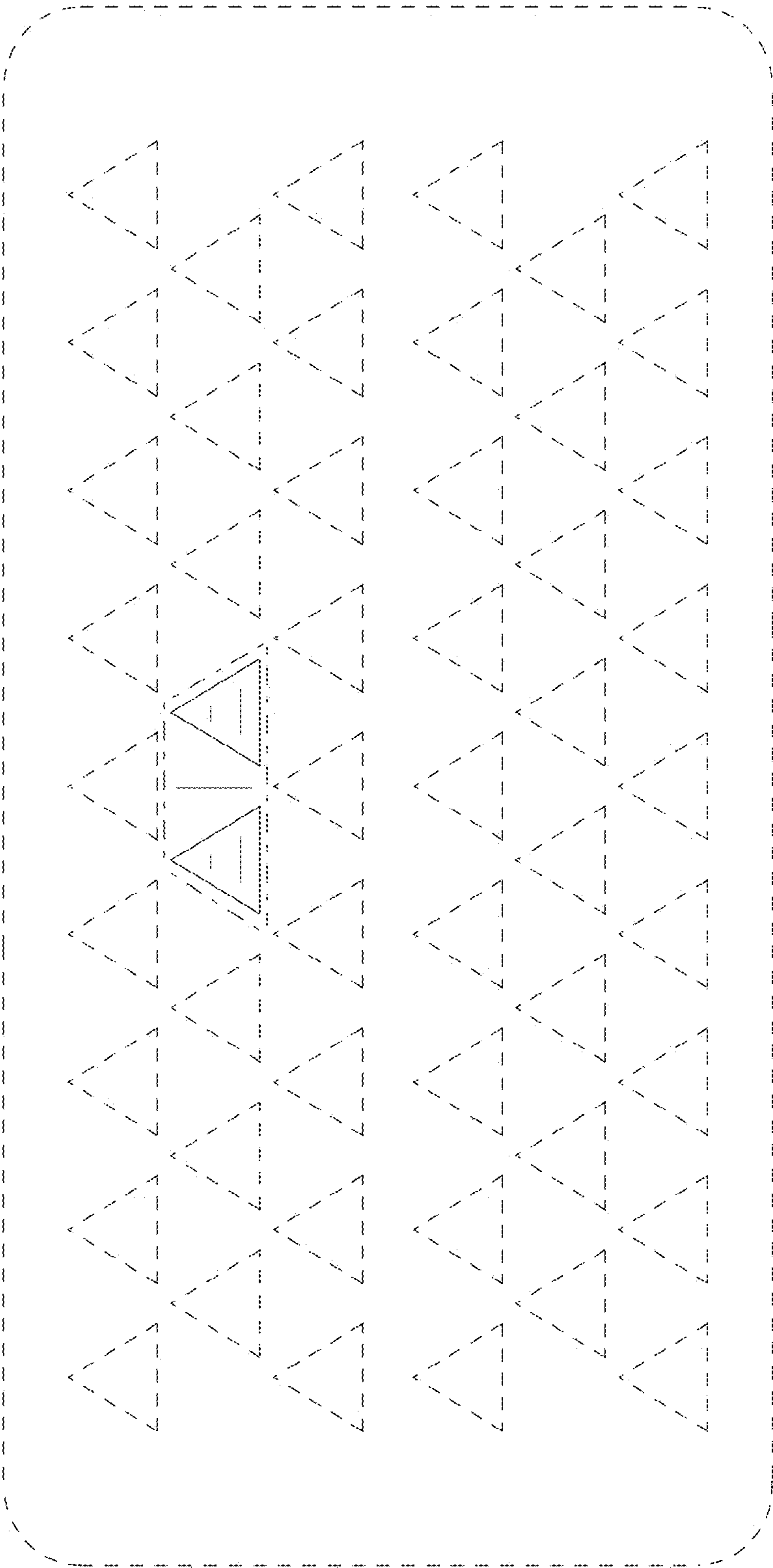

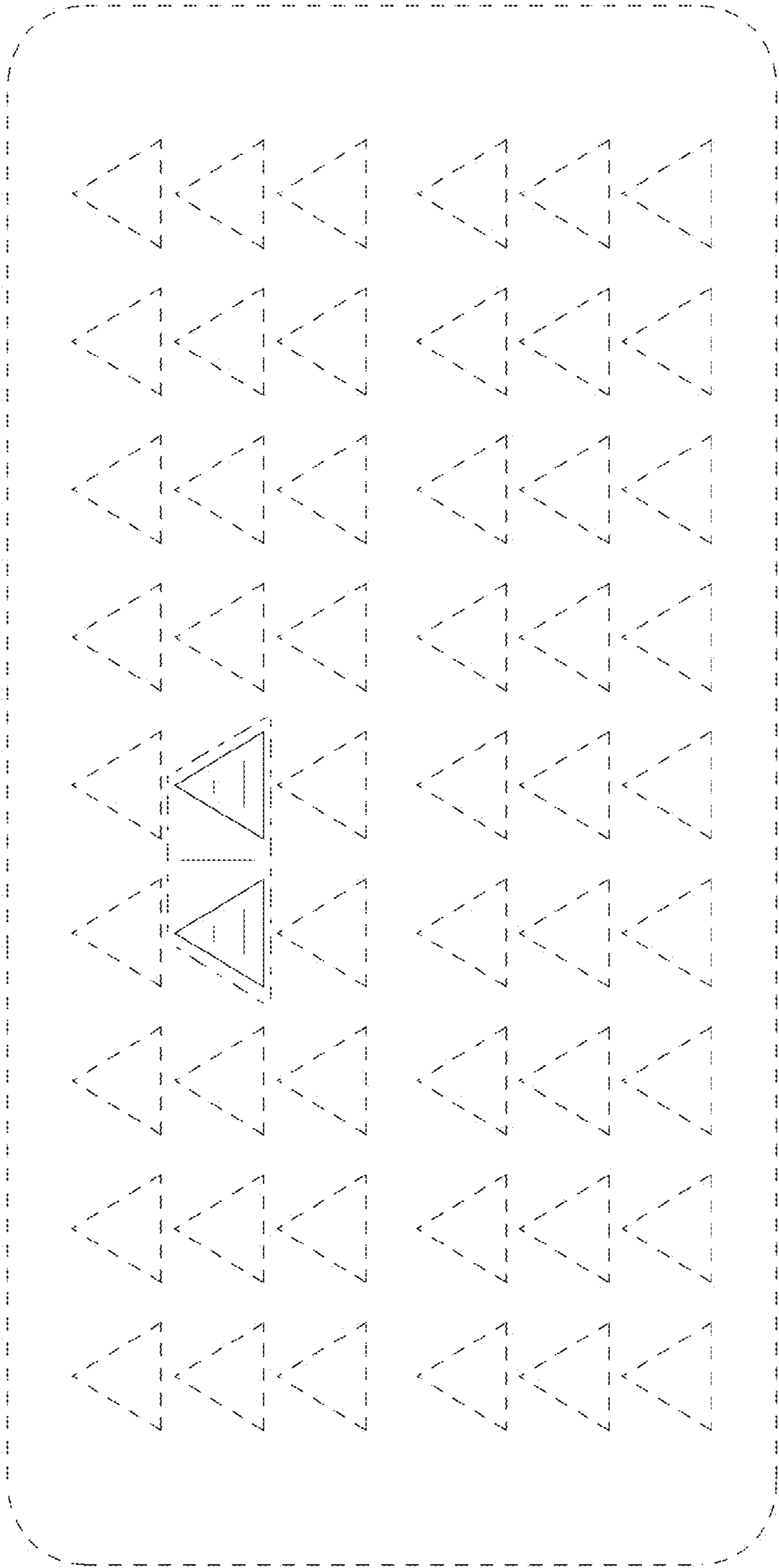
