**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an appendage protector, show-  
ing my new design in condition of use;

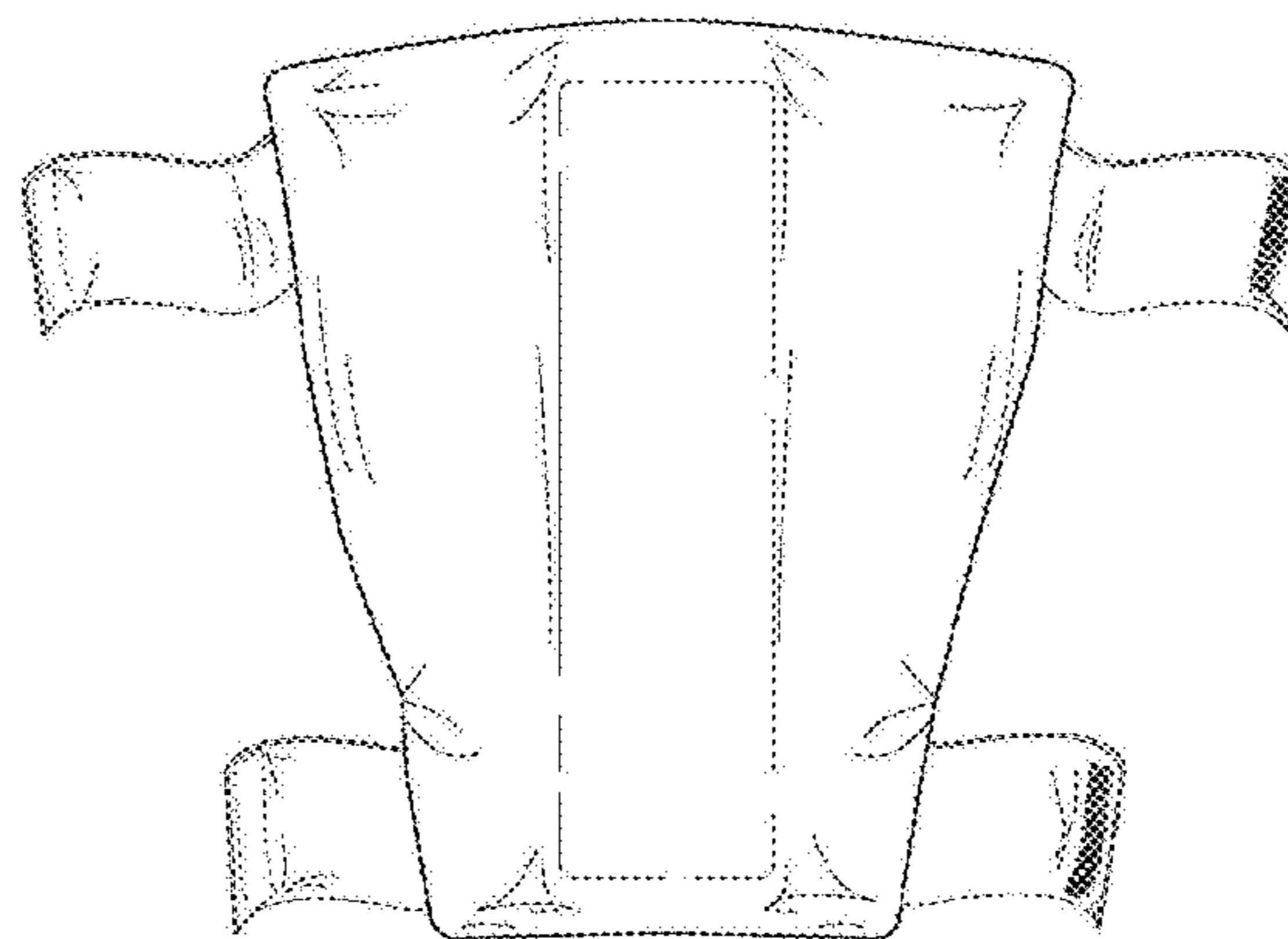
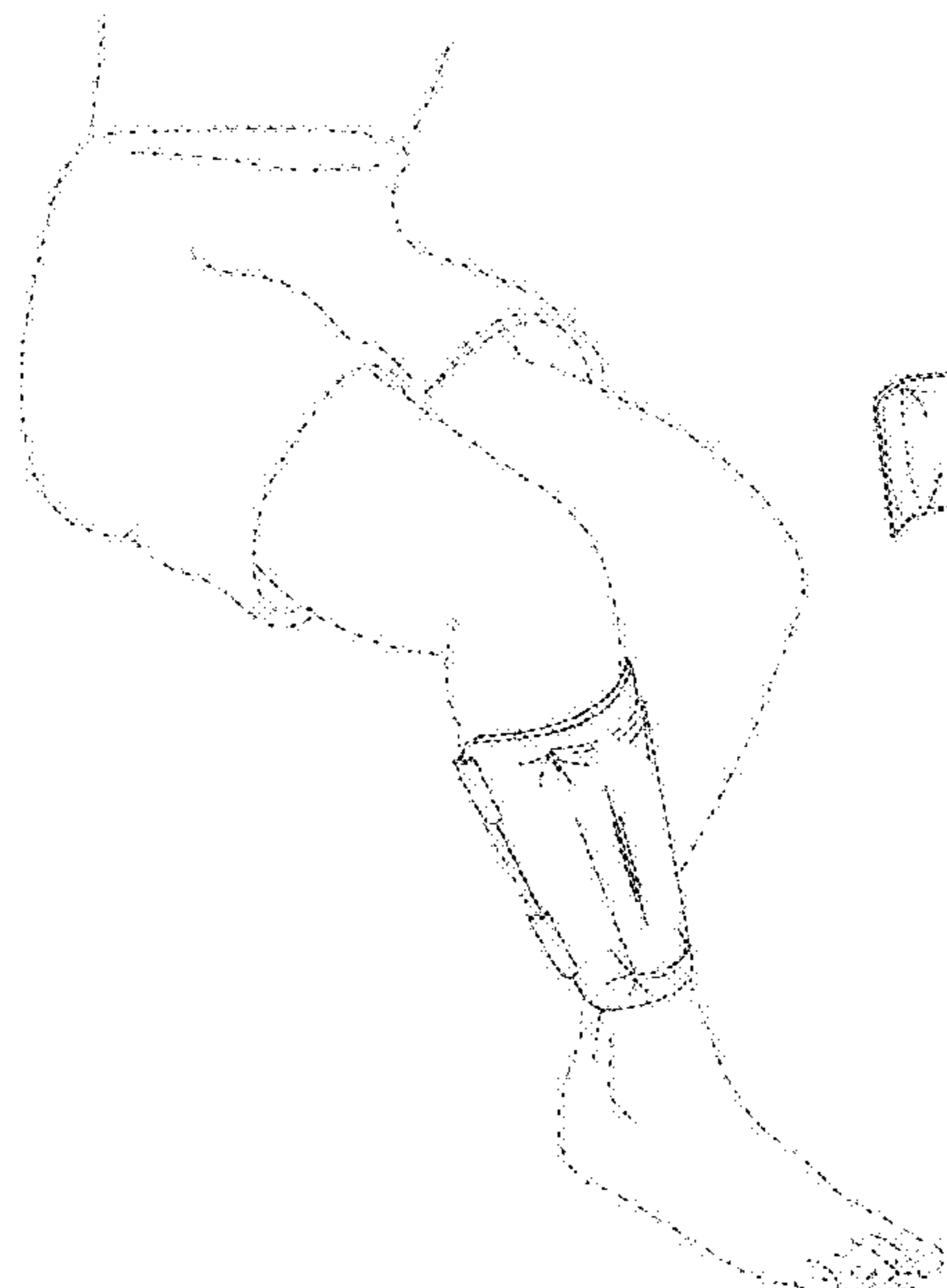
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the appendage protector in an open

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the appendage protector;

purpose of illustrating environment that forms no part of the  
claimed design. The broken line on the appendage protector  
represents claimed stitching.

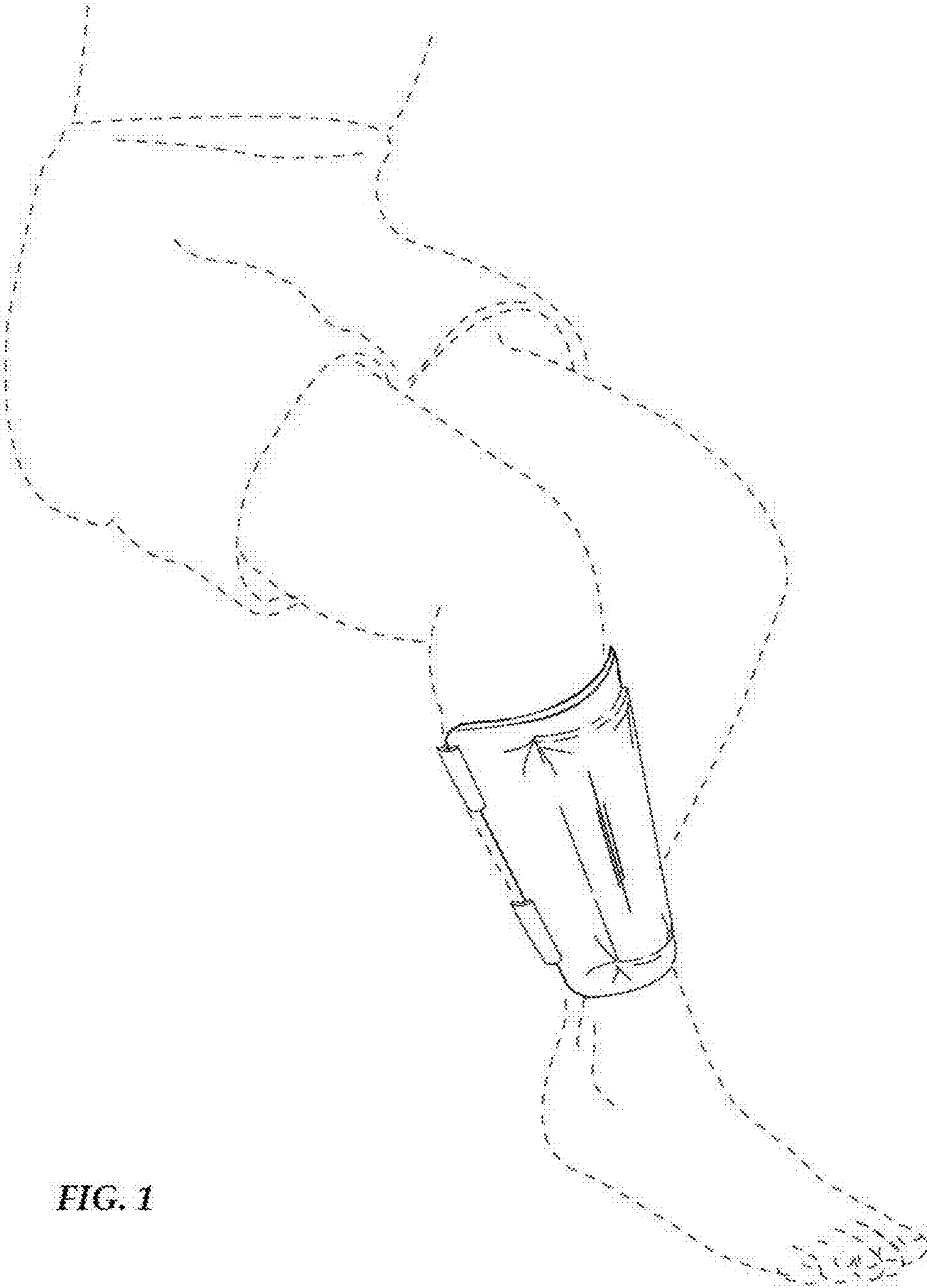

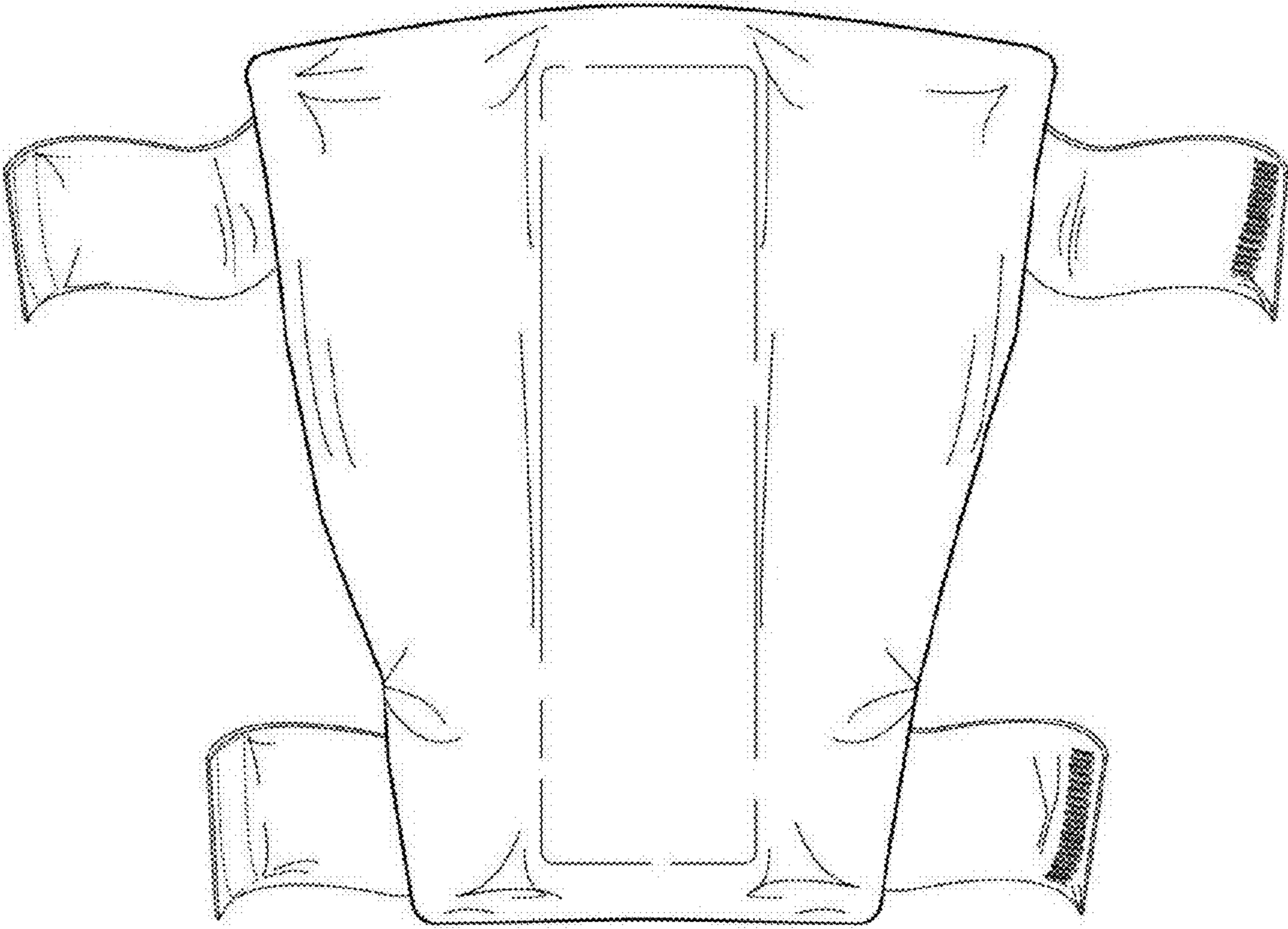
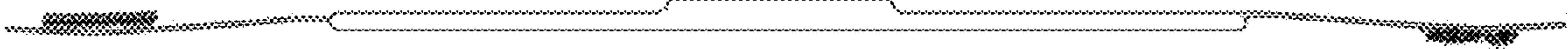

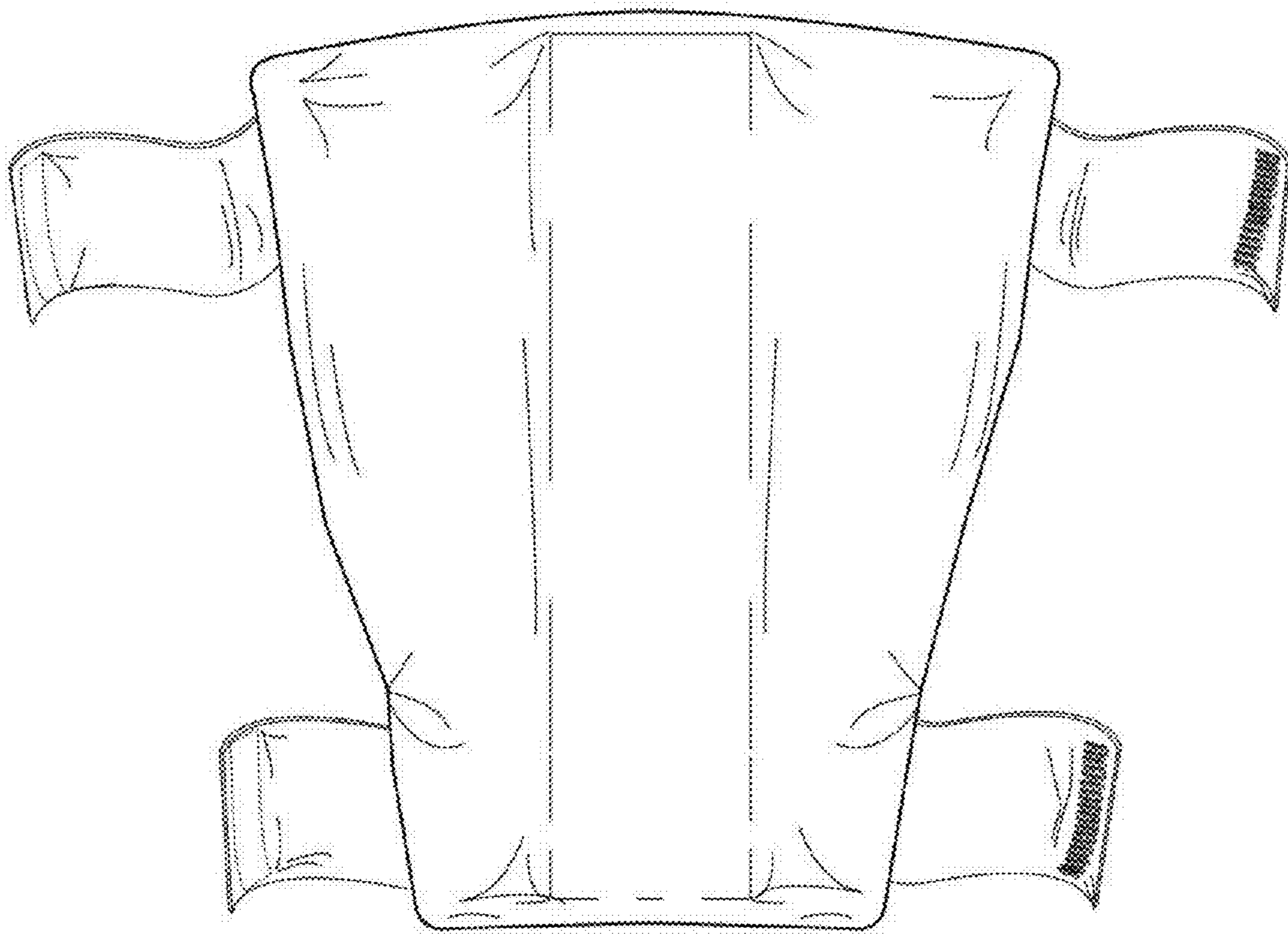
