(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a back scratcher, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the back scratcher of the present design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the back scratcher as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the back scratcher as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the back scratcher as shown in FIG. 1;

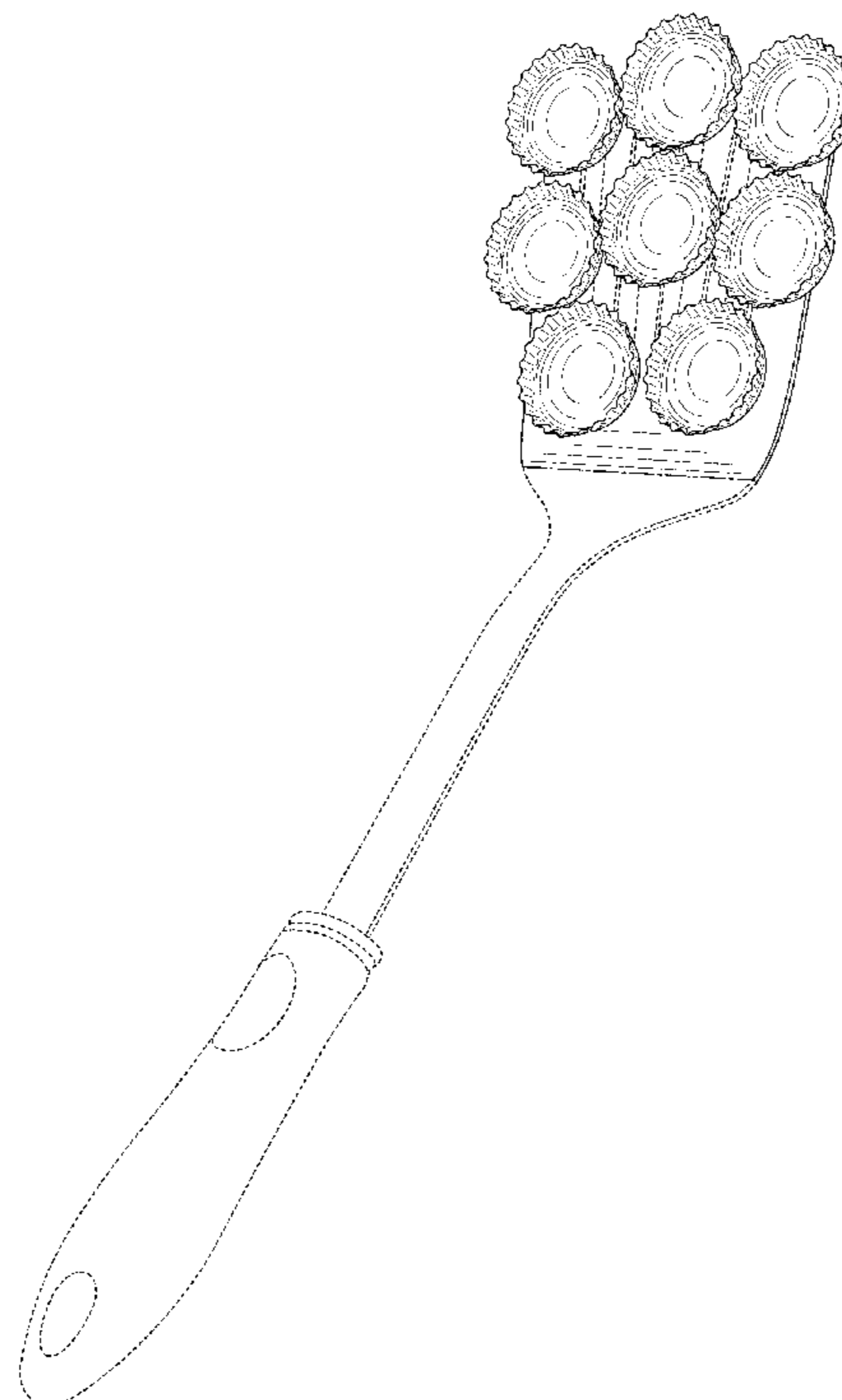
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the back scratcher as shown in FIG. 1;

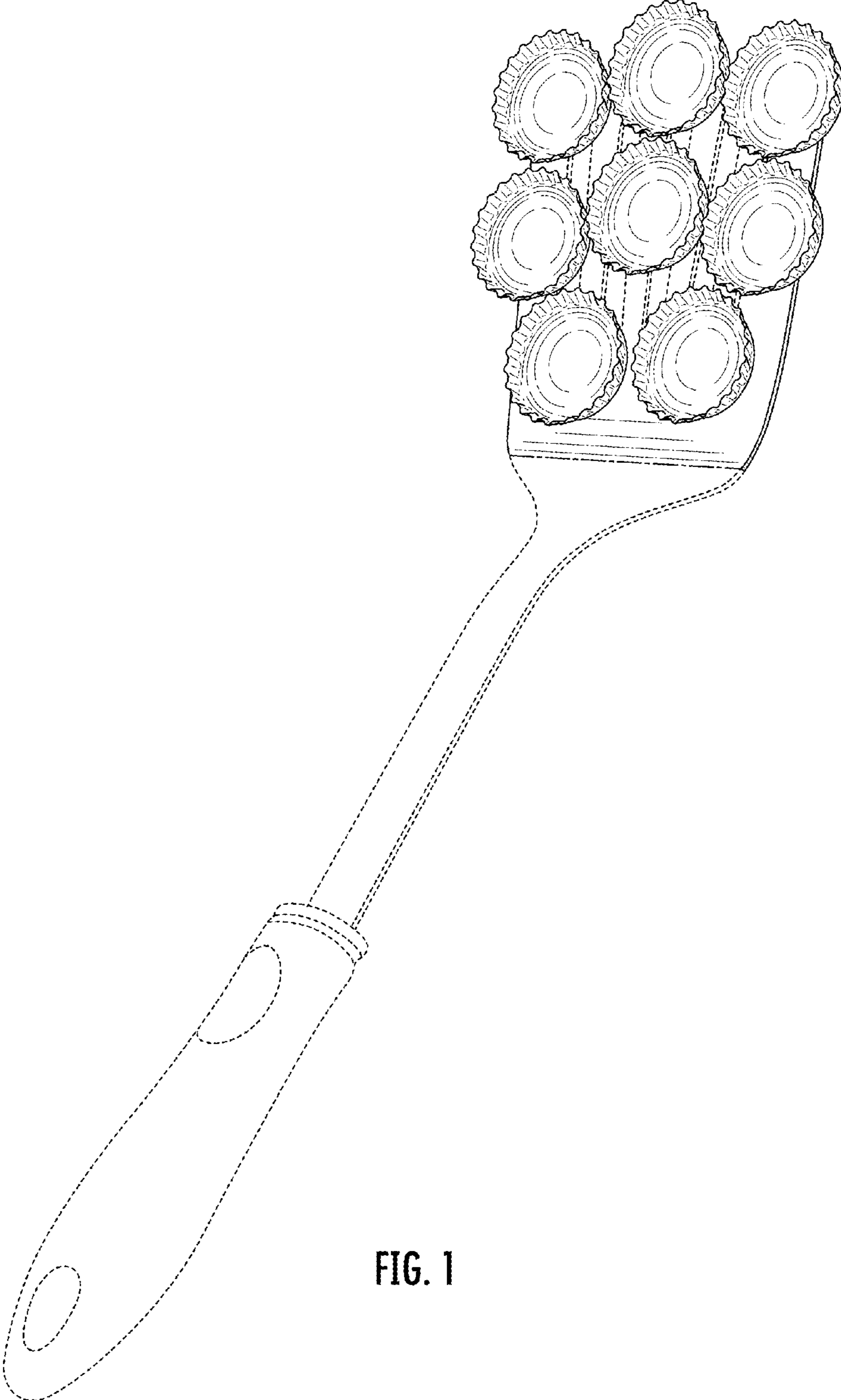

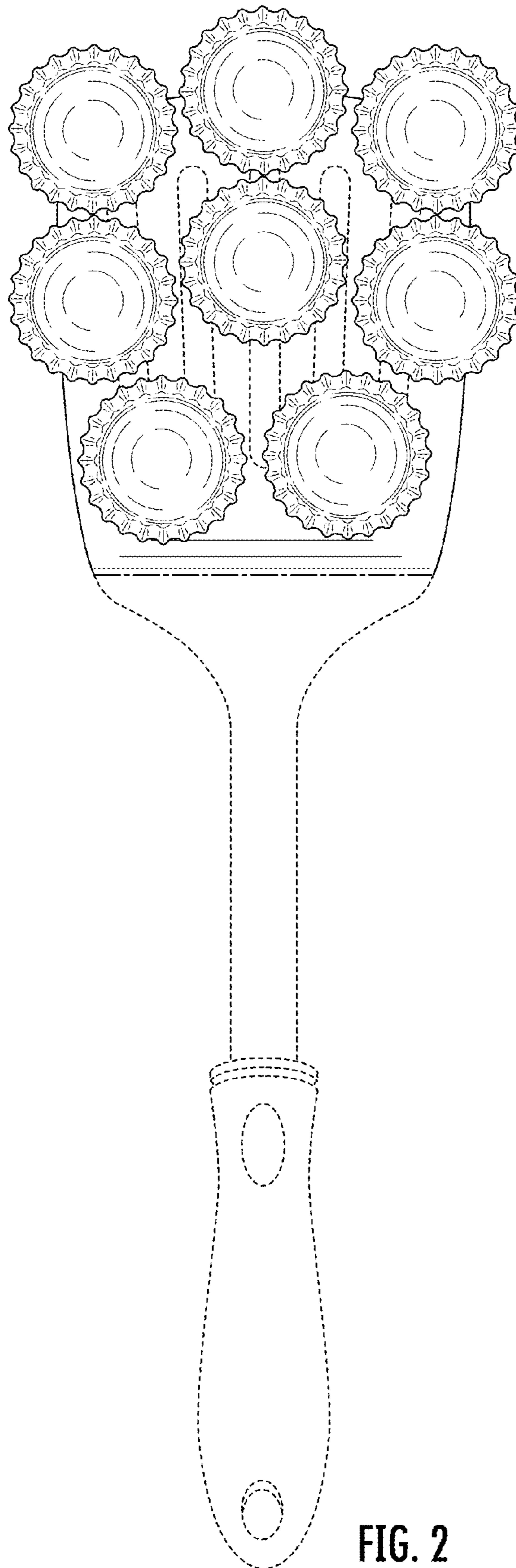

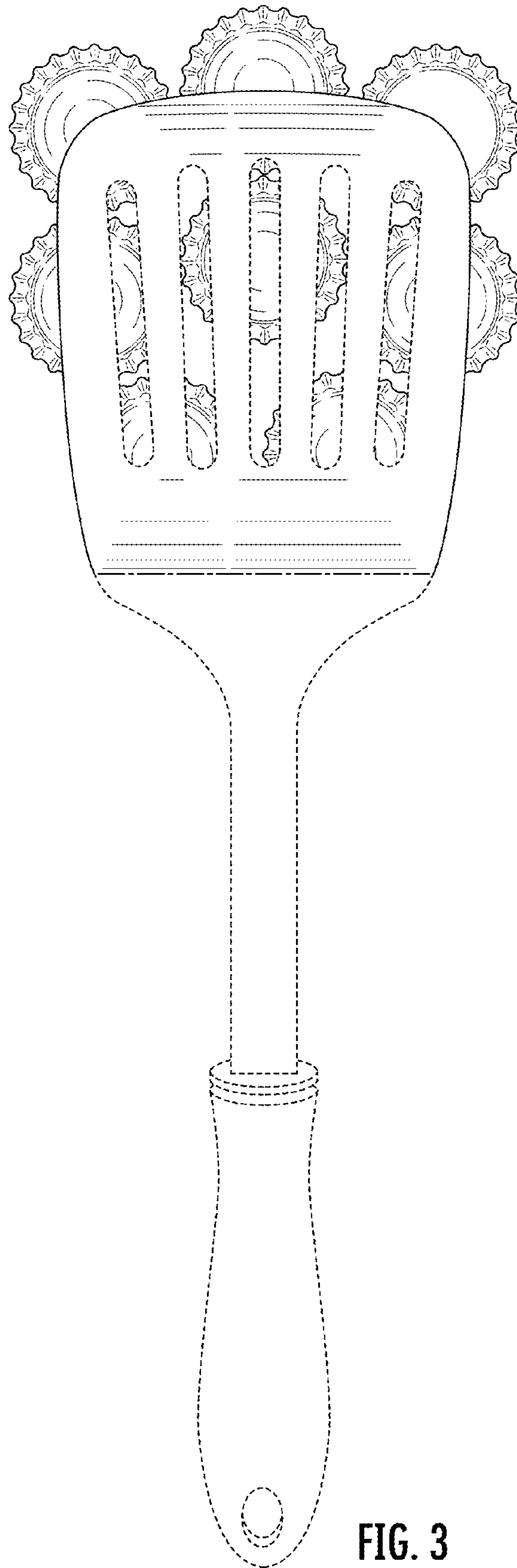

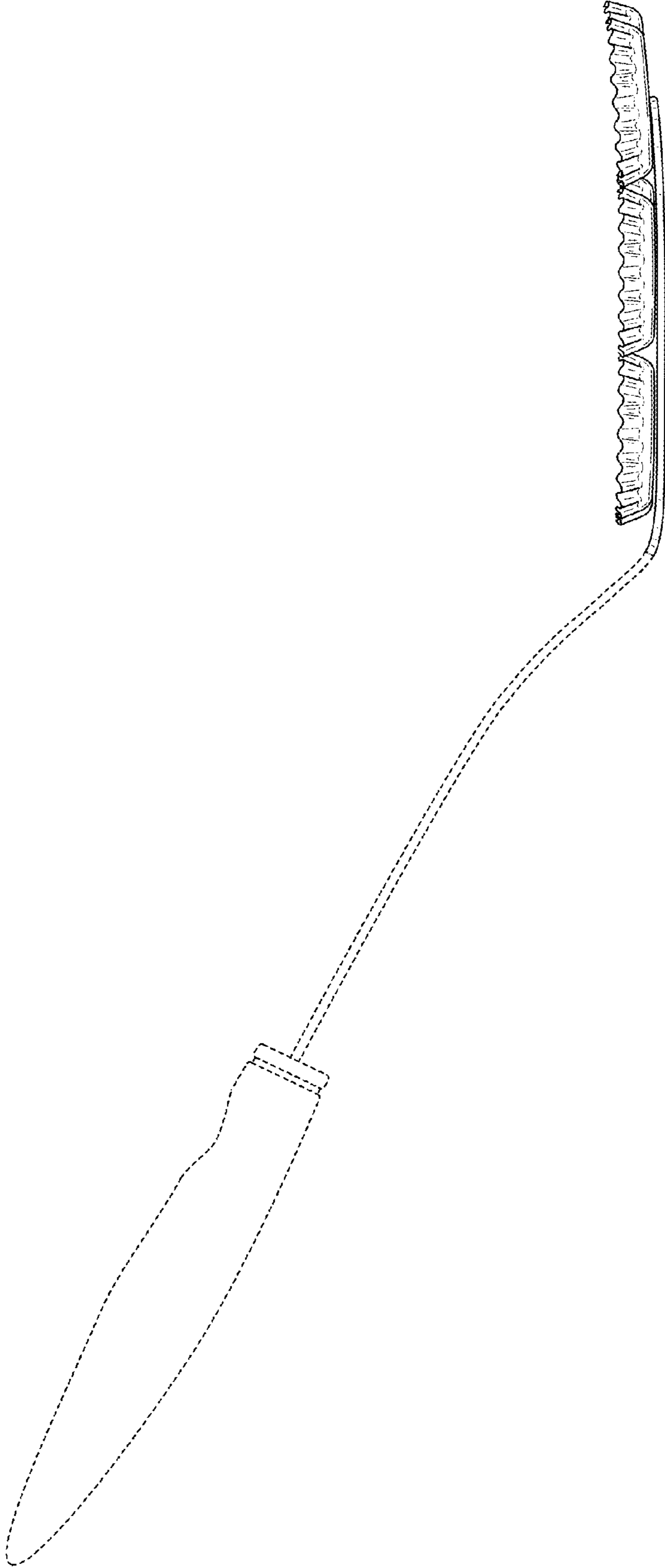

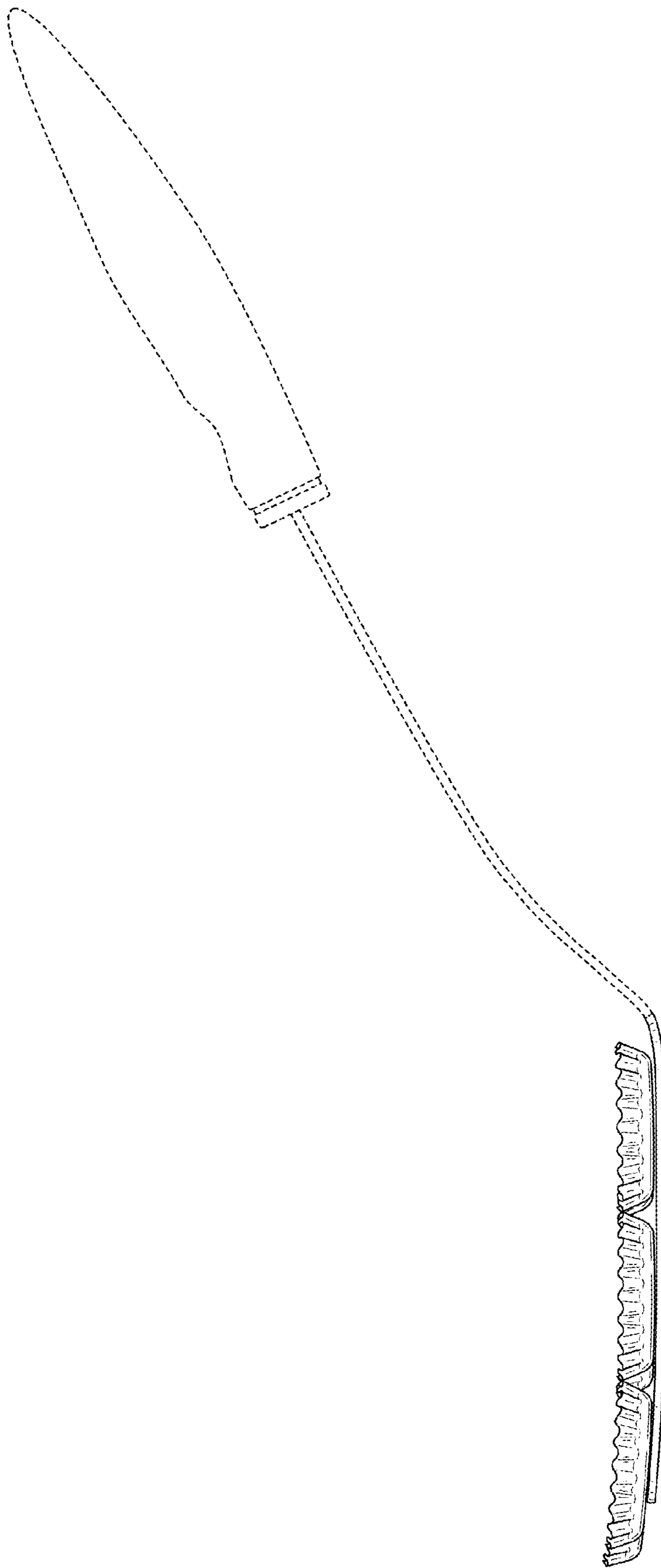

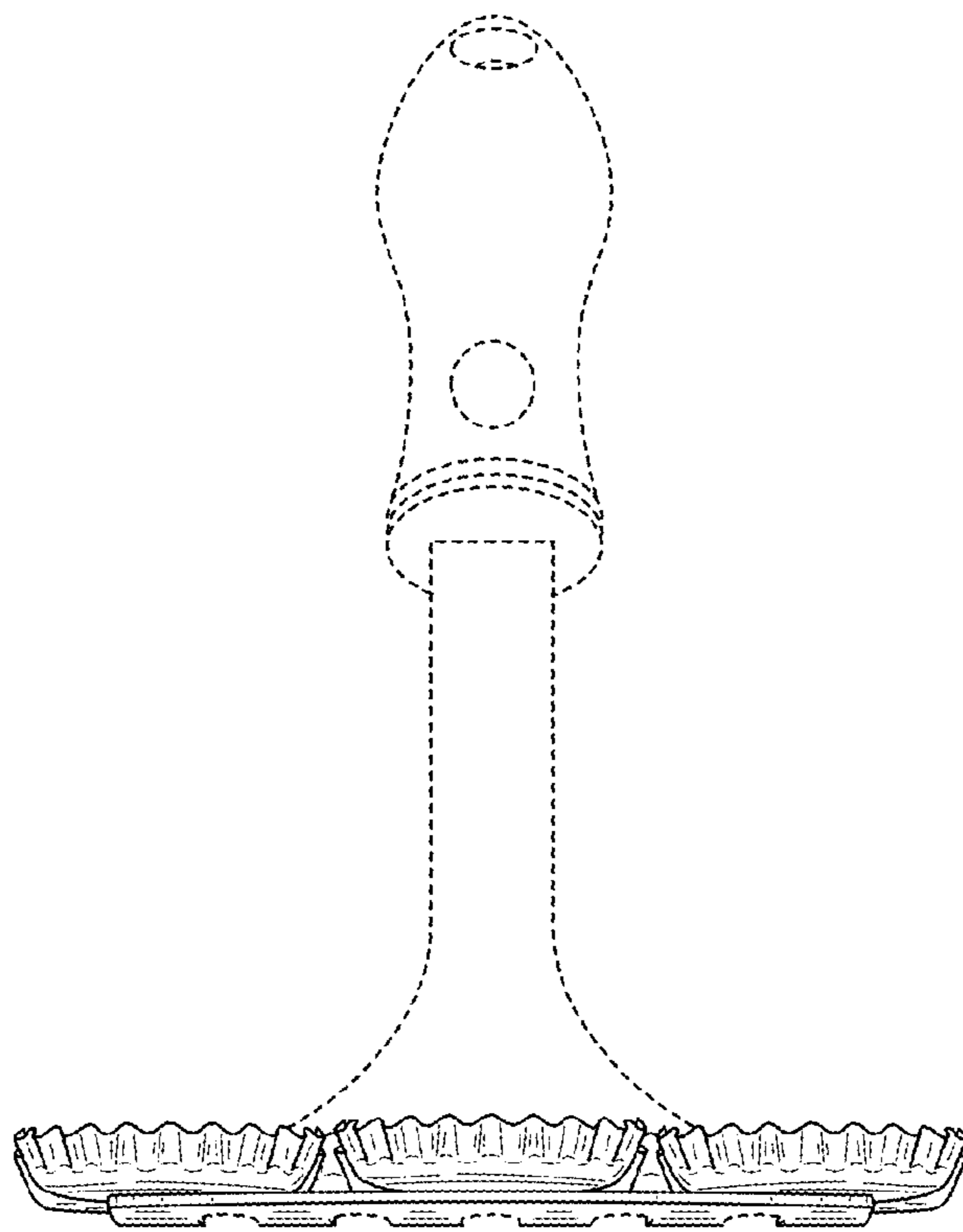

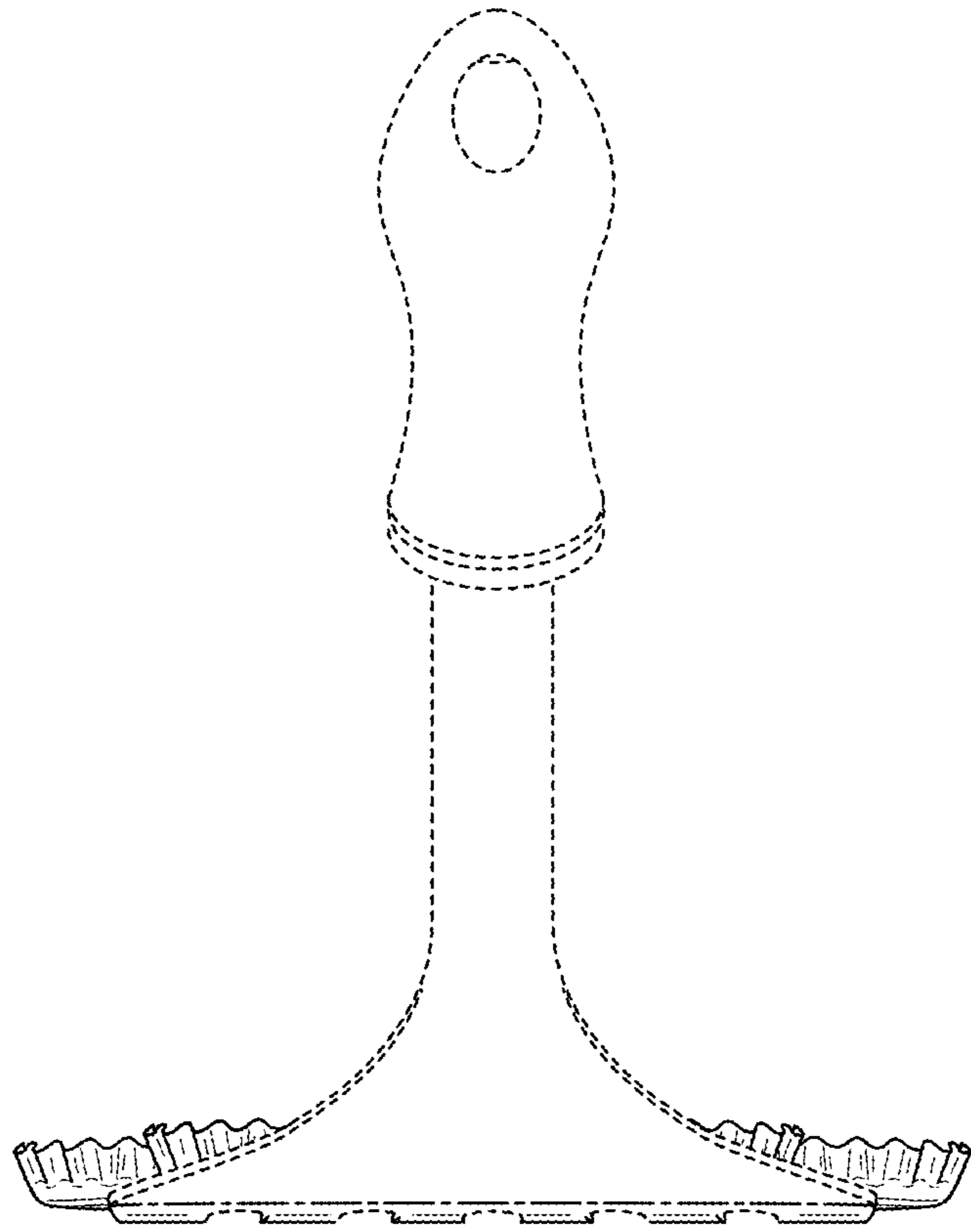
