DESCRIPTION

FIG. 2 is a back elevation view of the crutch.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the crutch.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the crutch.

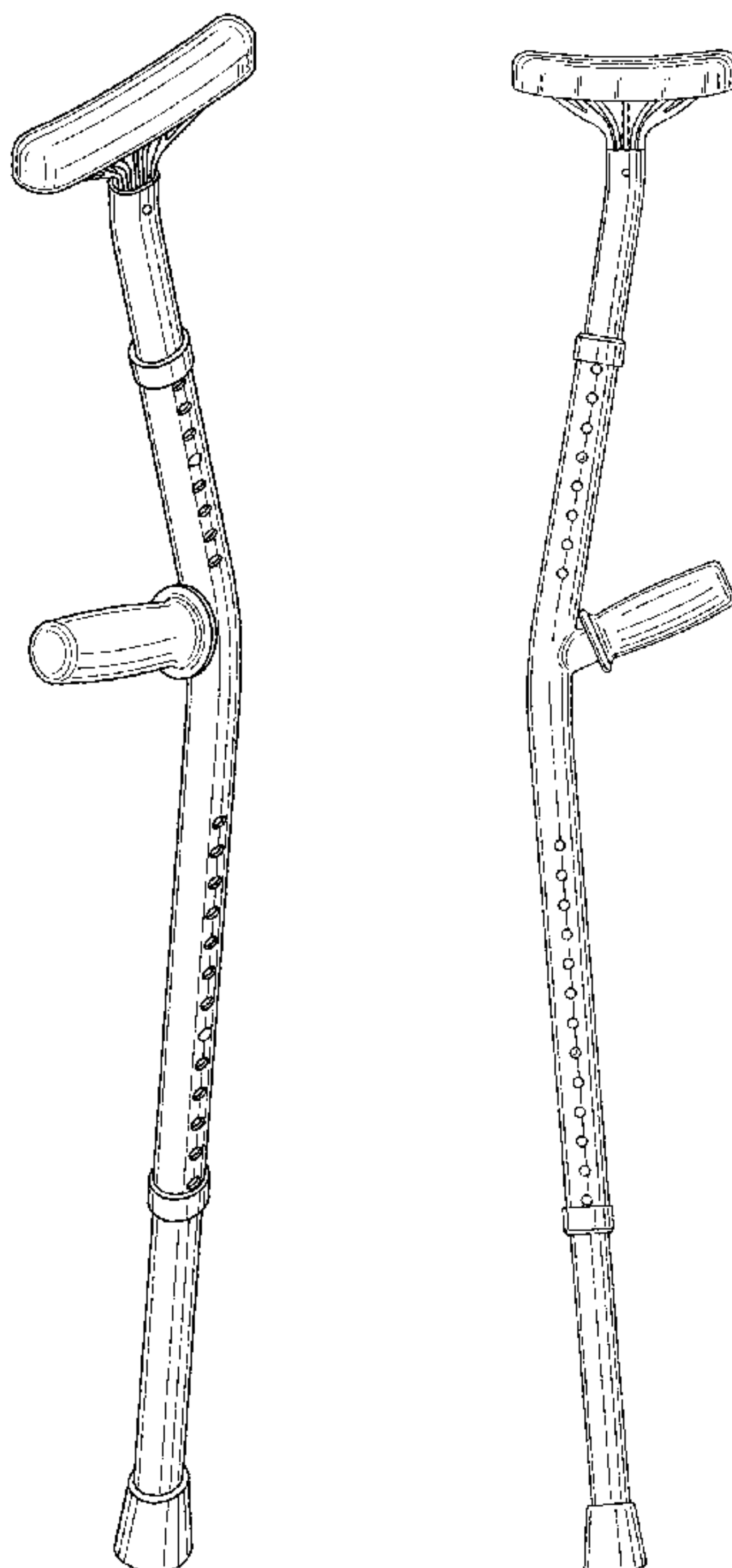
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the crutch.

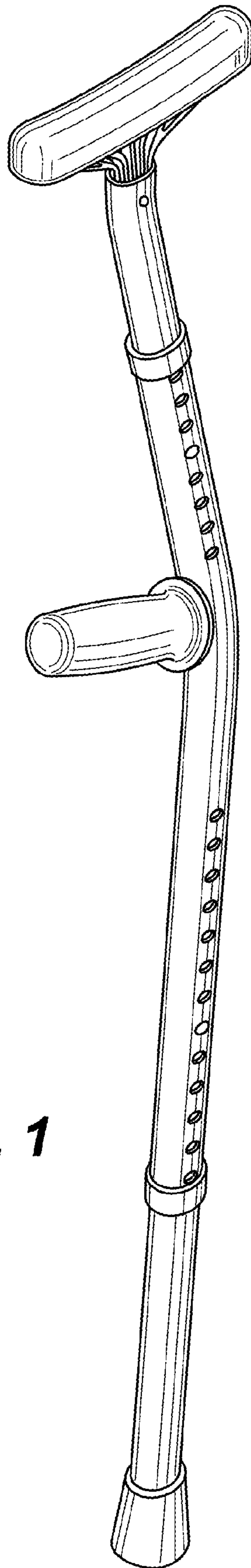

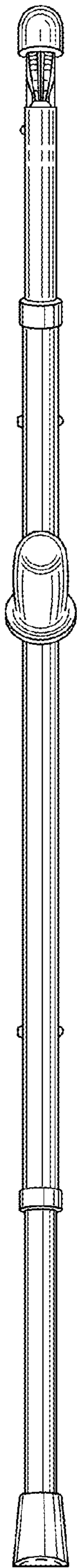

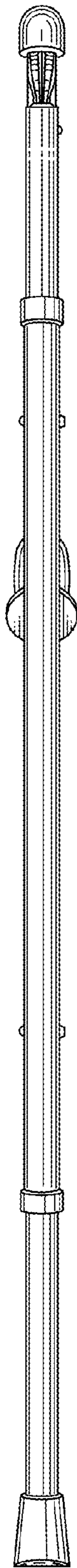

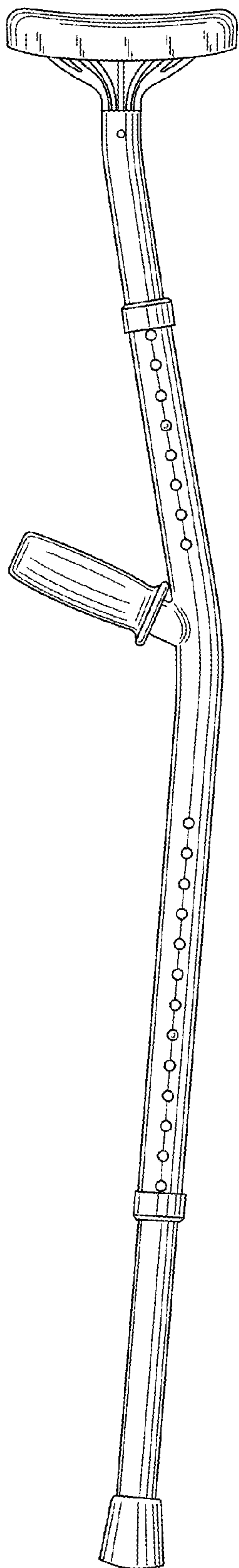

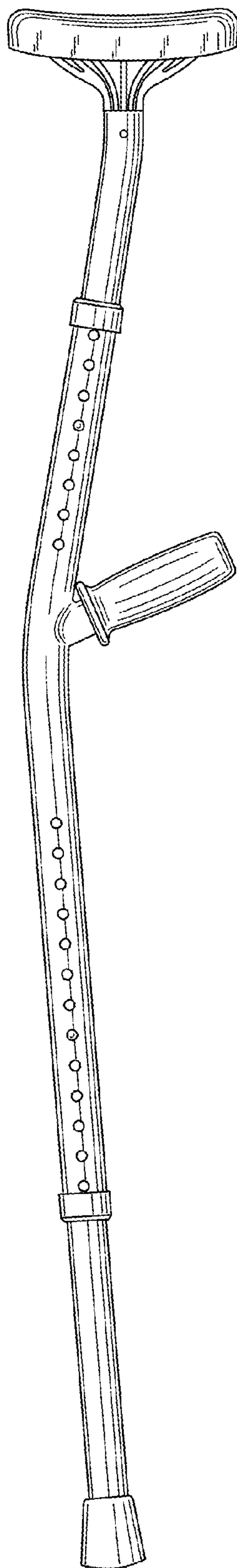

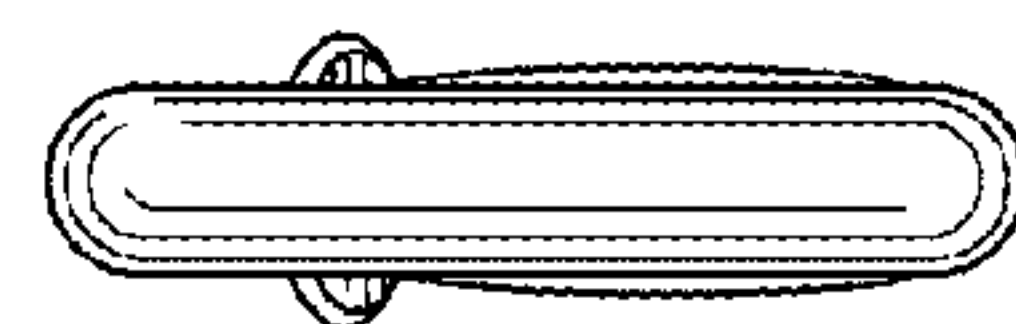

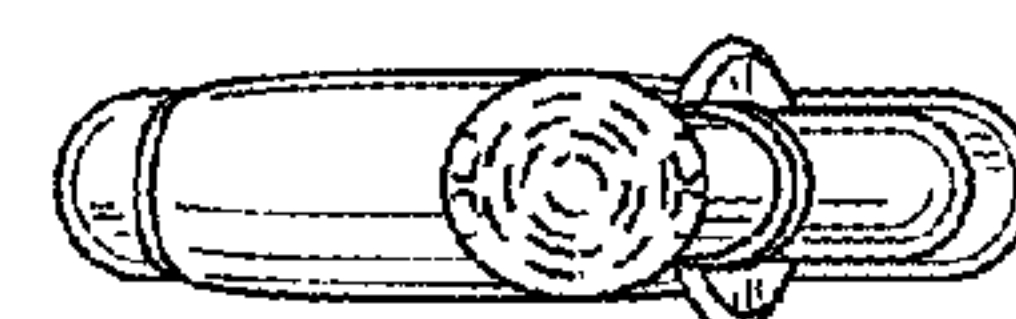
