(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a divider, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a frontal perspective view of a divider in accordance
with my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the divider of FIG. 1
showing the design, the opposite side being a mirror image
thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the divider of FIG. 1 showing the
design;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a side of the divider of FIG. 1
showing the design, the opposite side being a mirror image
thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the divider of FIG. 1 showing
the design.

The divider is illustrated with a symbolic break in its length.
The appearance of the article at the center between the break
lines forms no part of the claimed design.

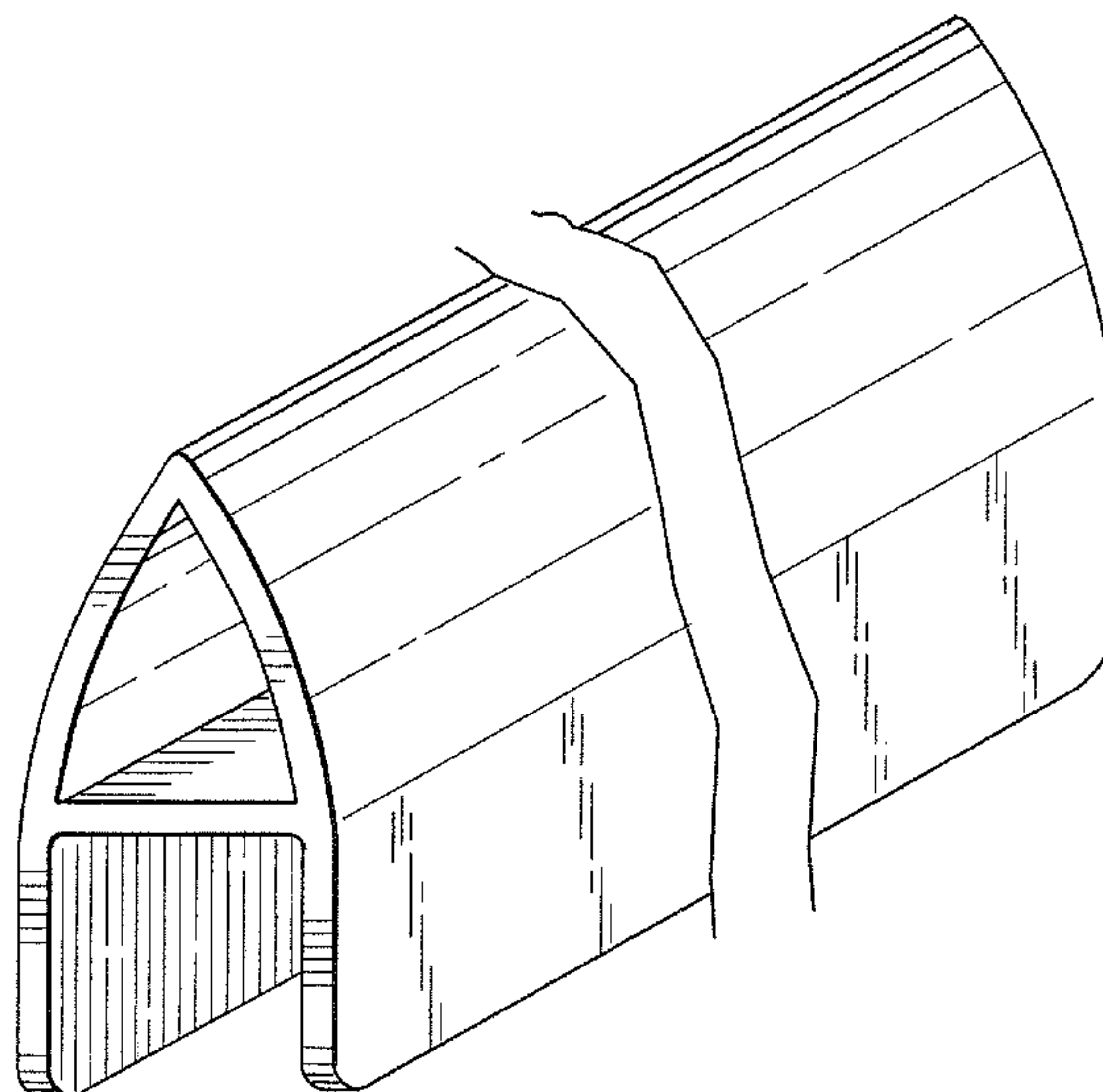

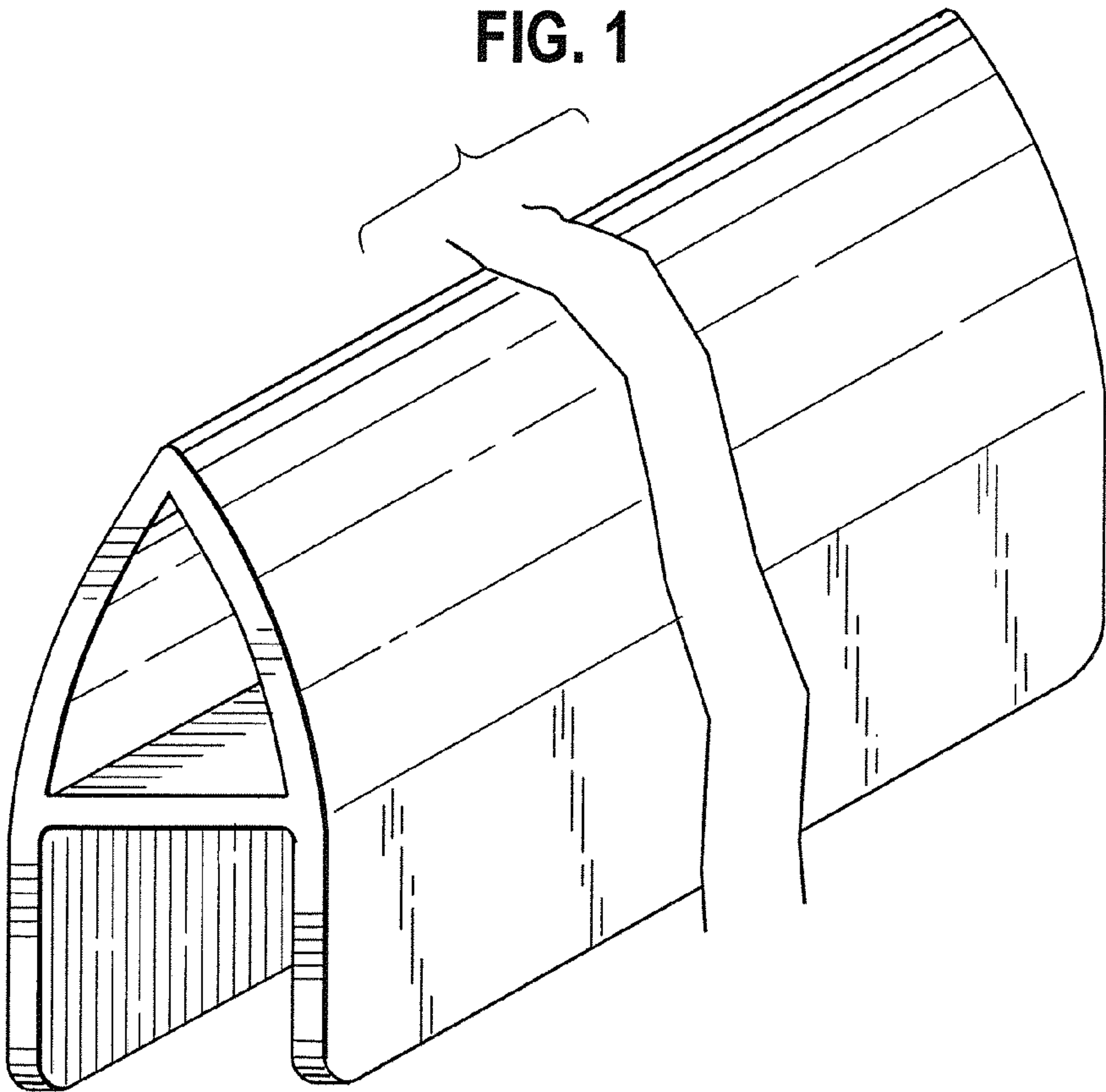

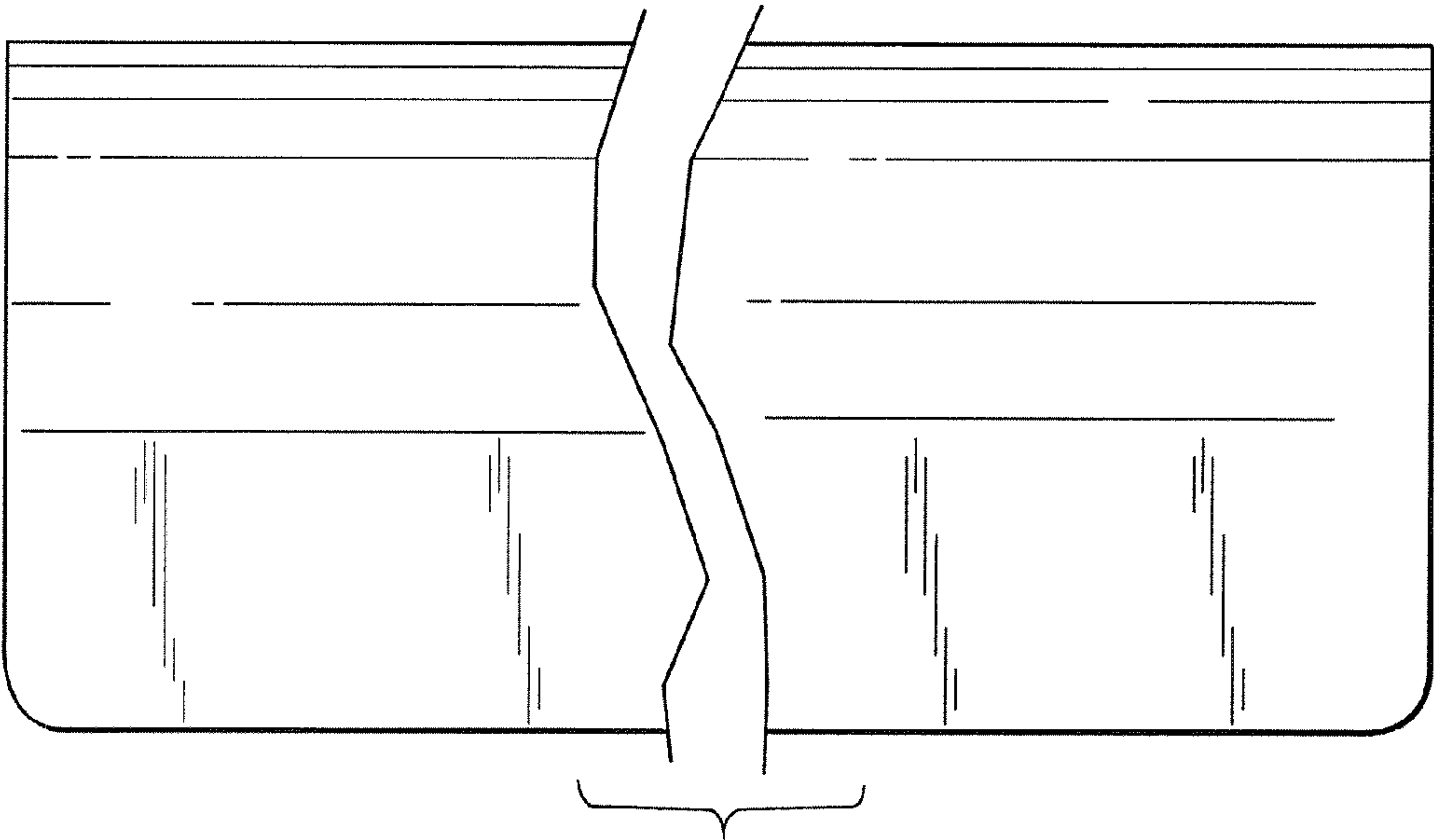

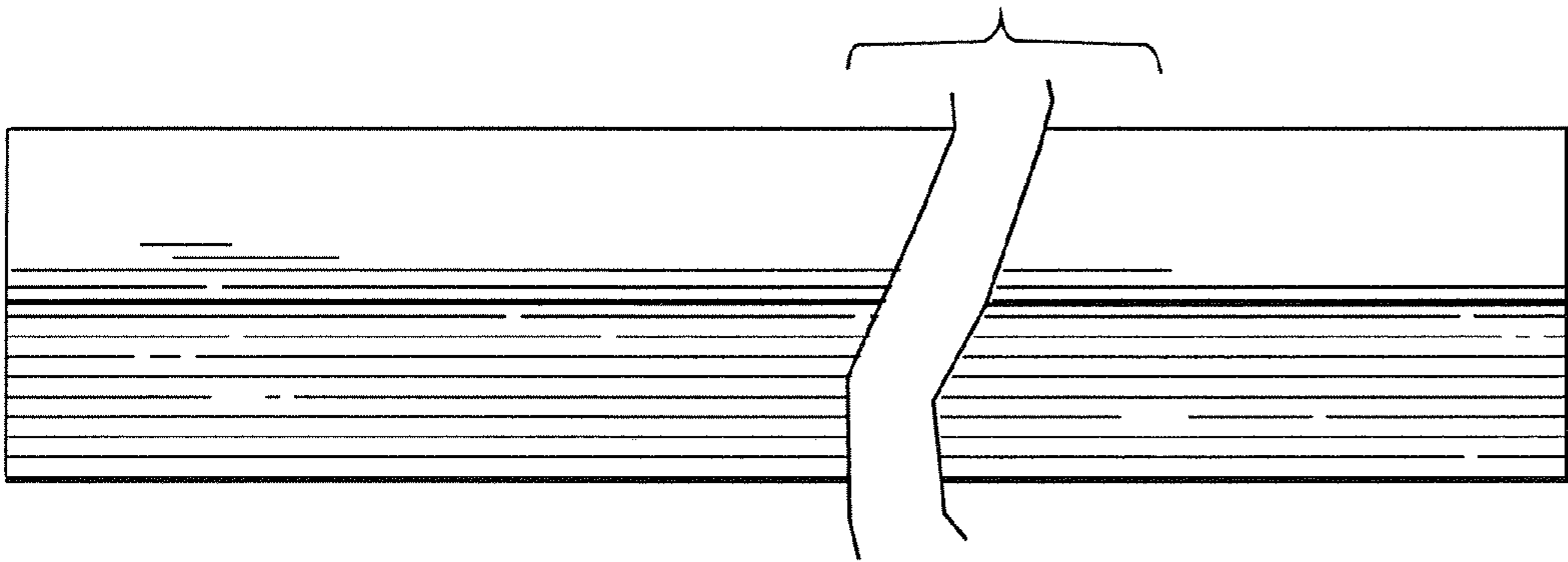

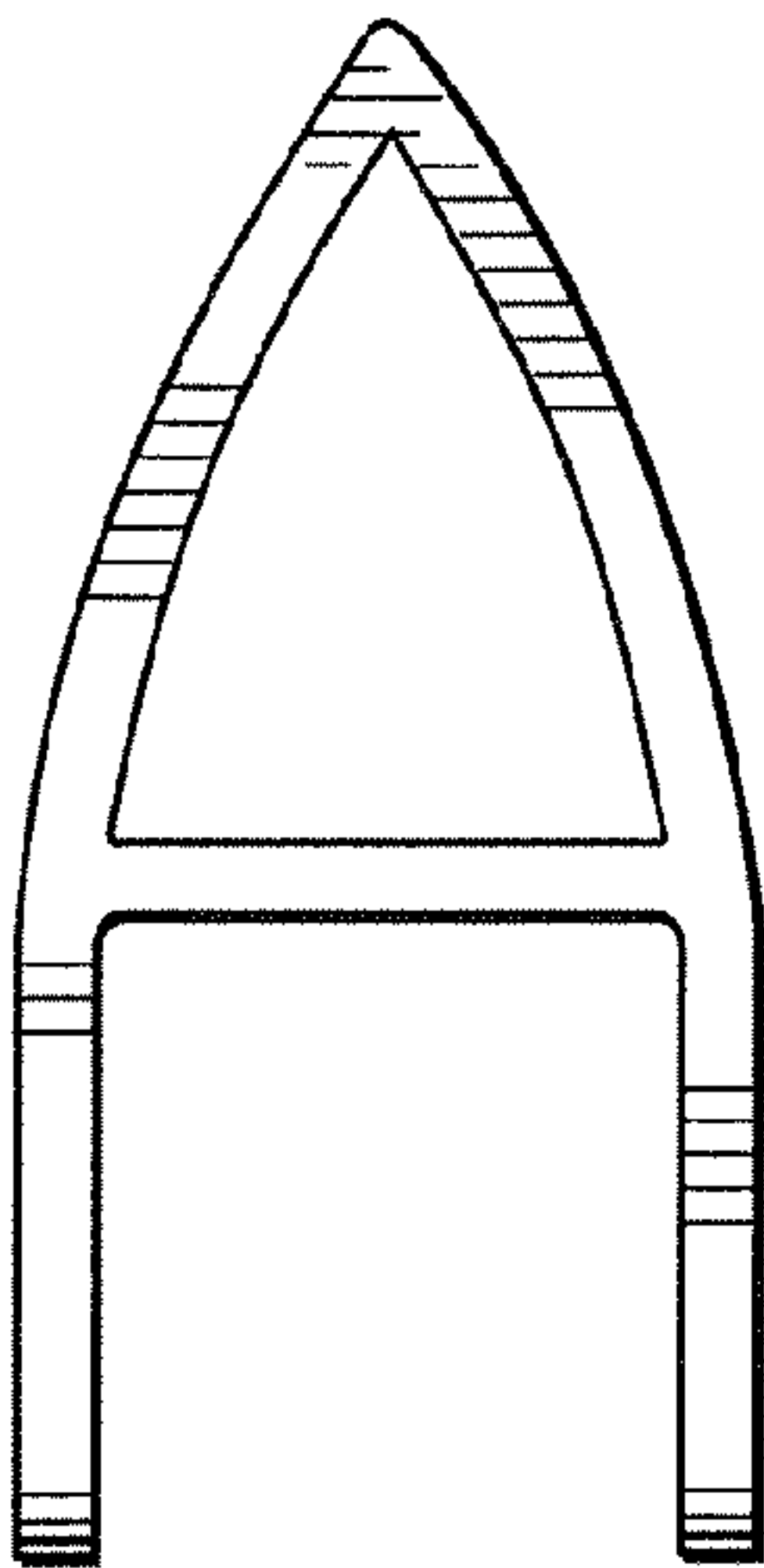
