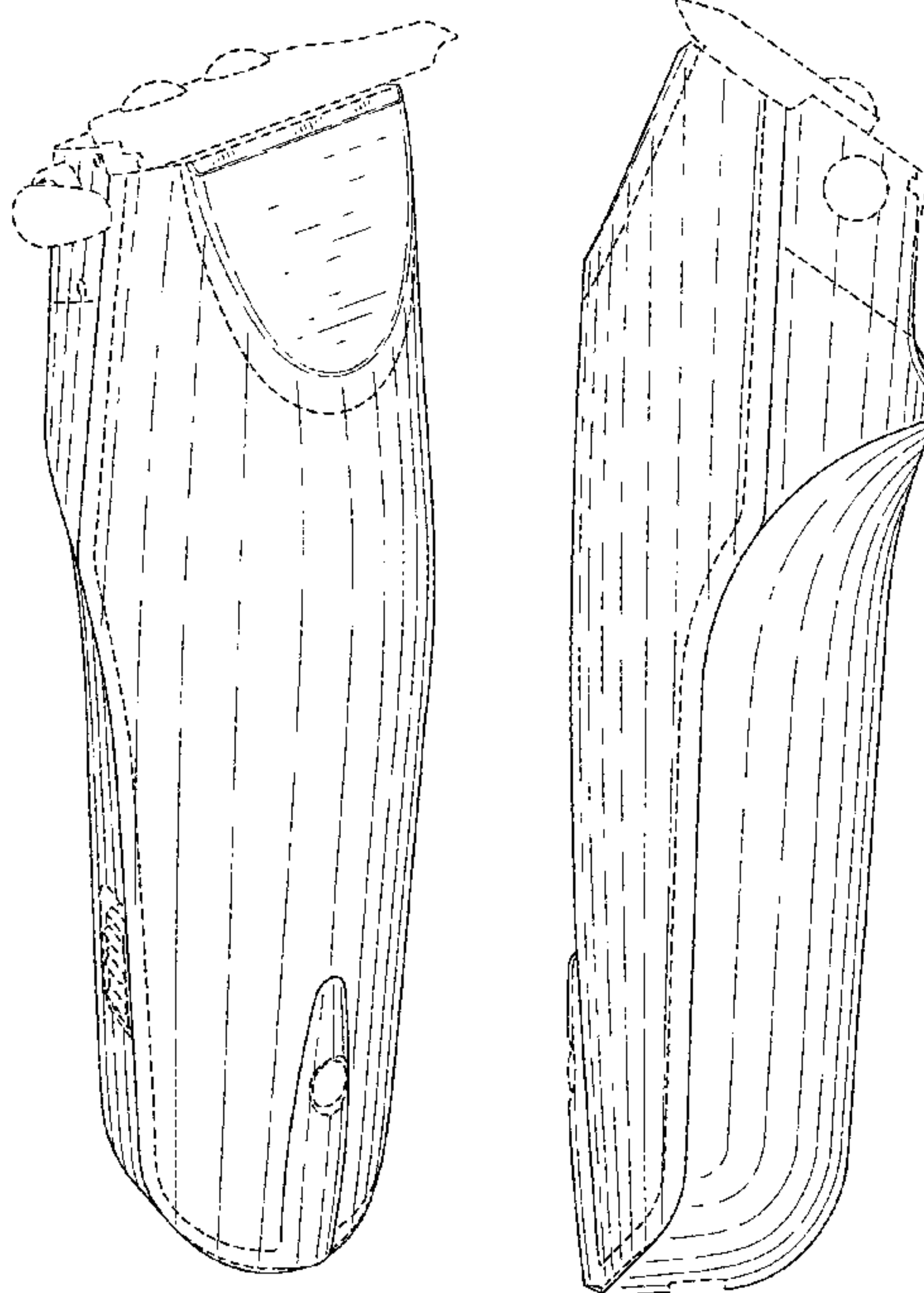
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the hair cutting device housing, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the present hair cutting device housing;  
FIG. 2 is a top view of same;  
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the hair cutting device housing of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of same;  
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the hair cutting device housing of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is a front view of same; and,  
FIG. 7 is a rear view of same.  
The broken lines showing the cutting blade and lever illustrate the environment. The remaining broken lines illustrate portions of the article. None of the broken lines forms part of the claimed design.

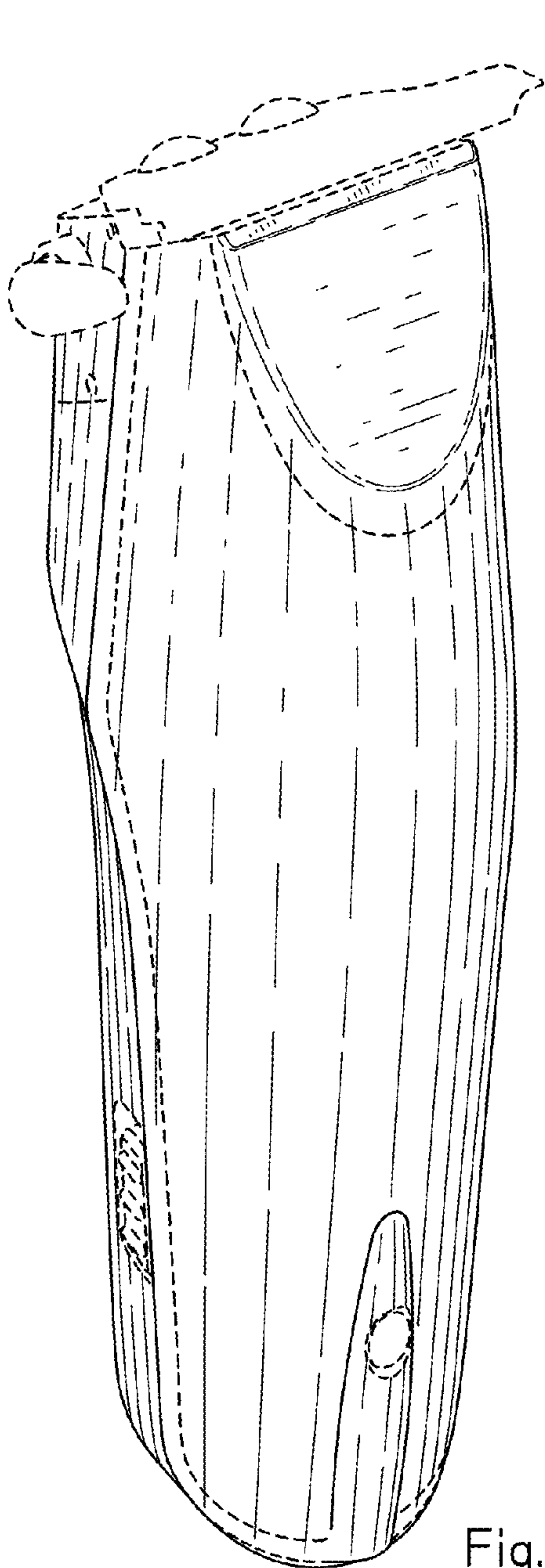

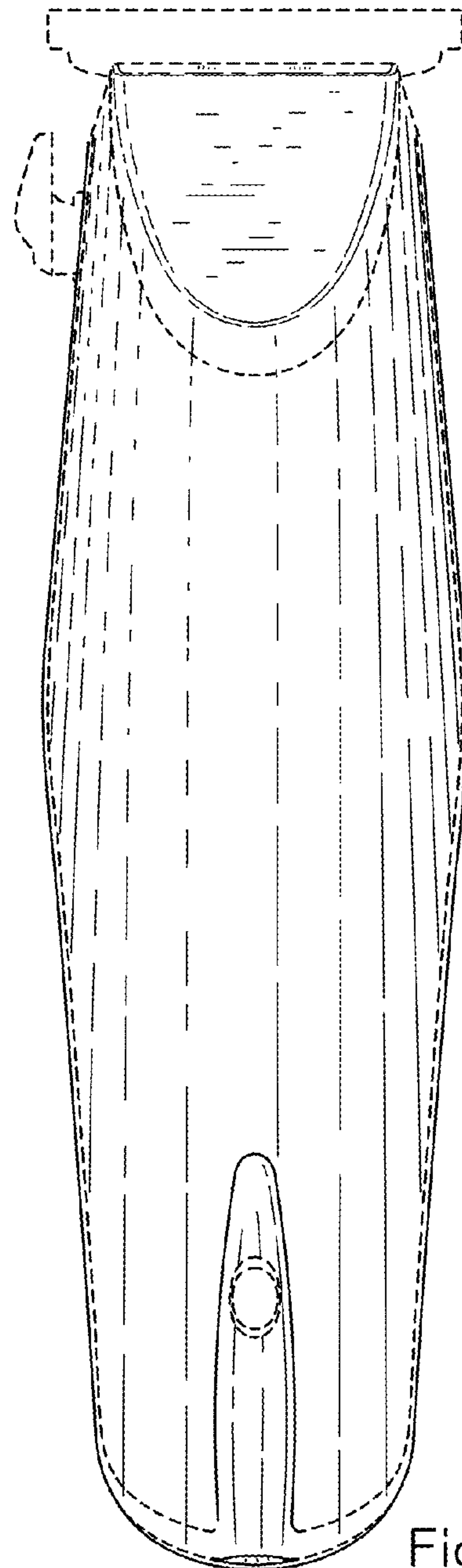

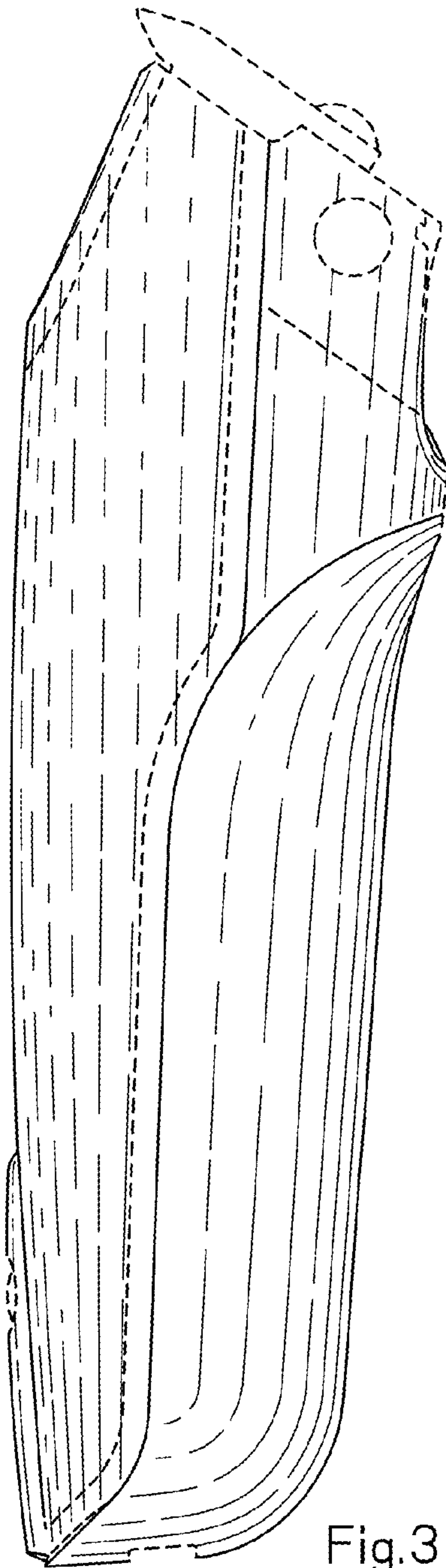

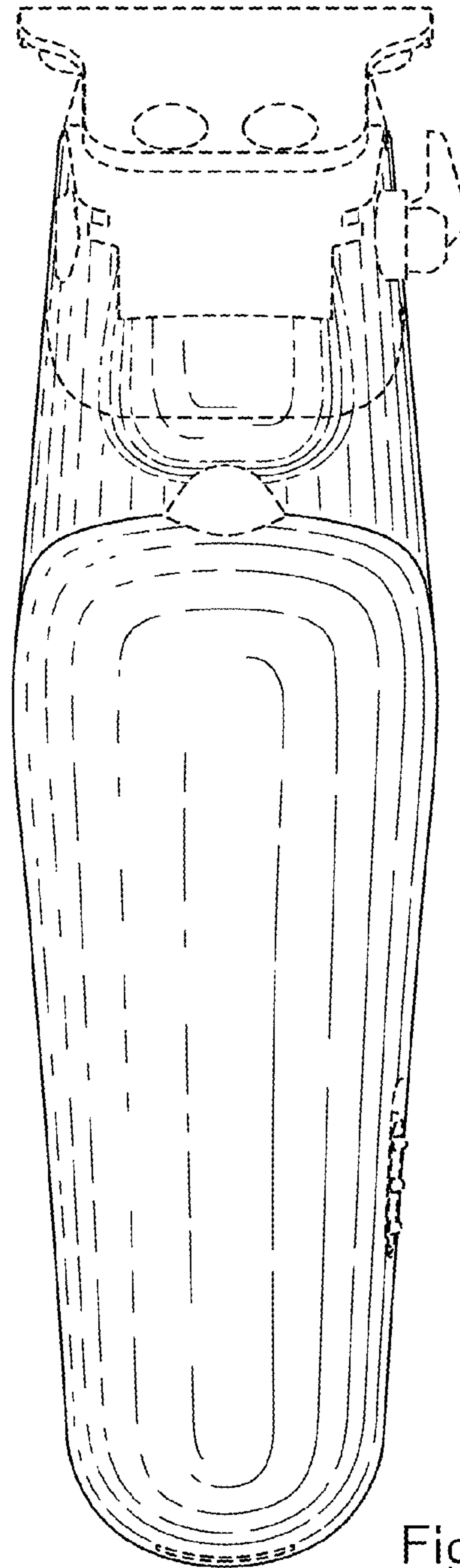

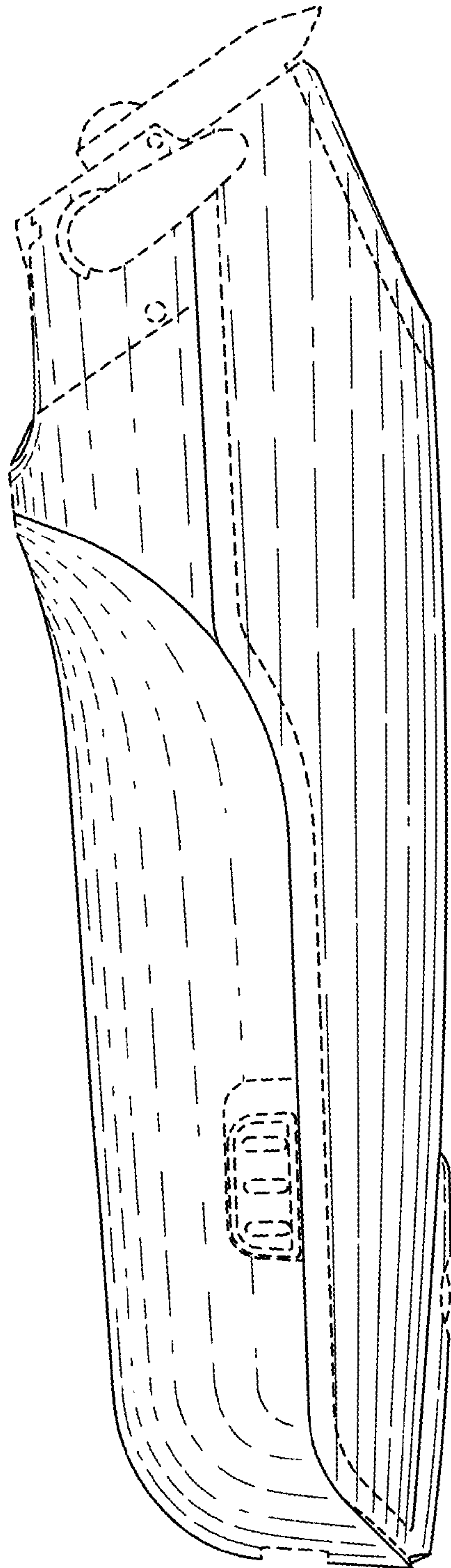

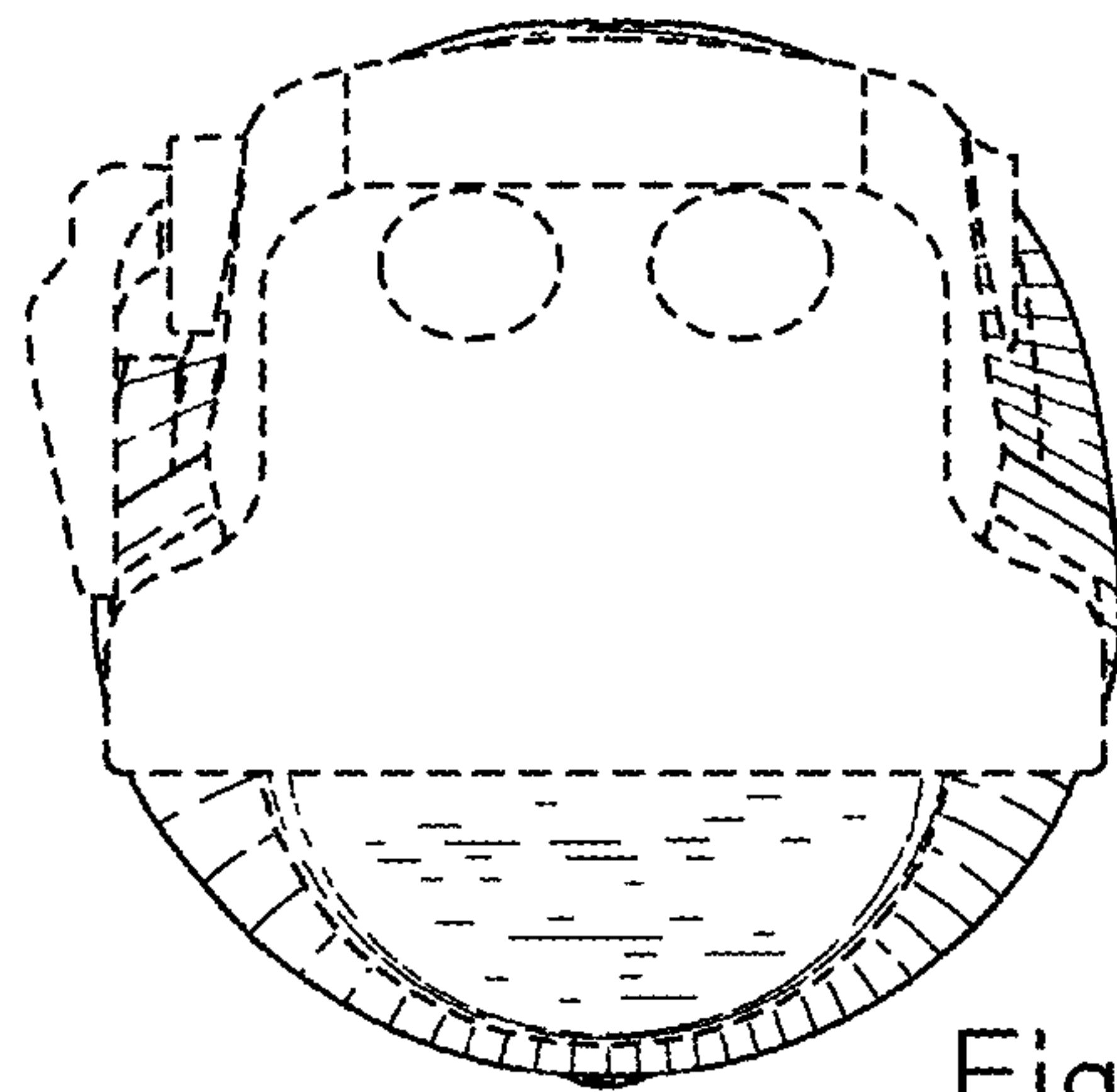

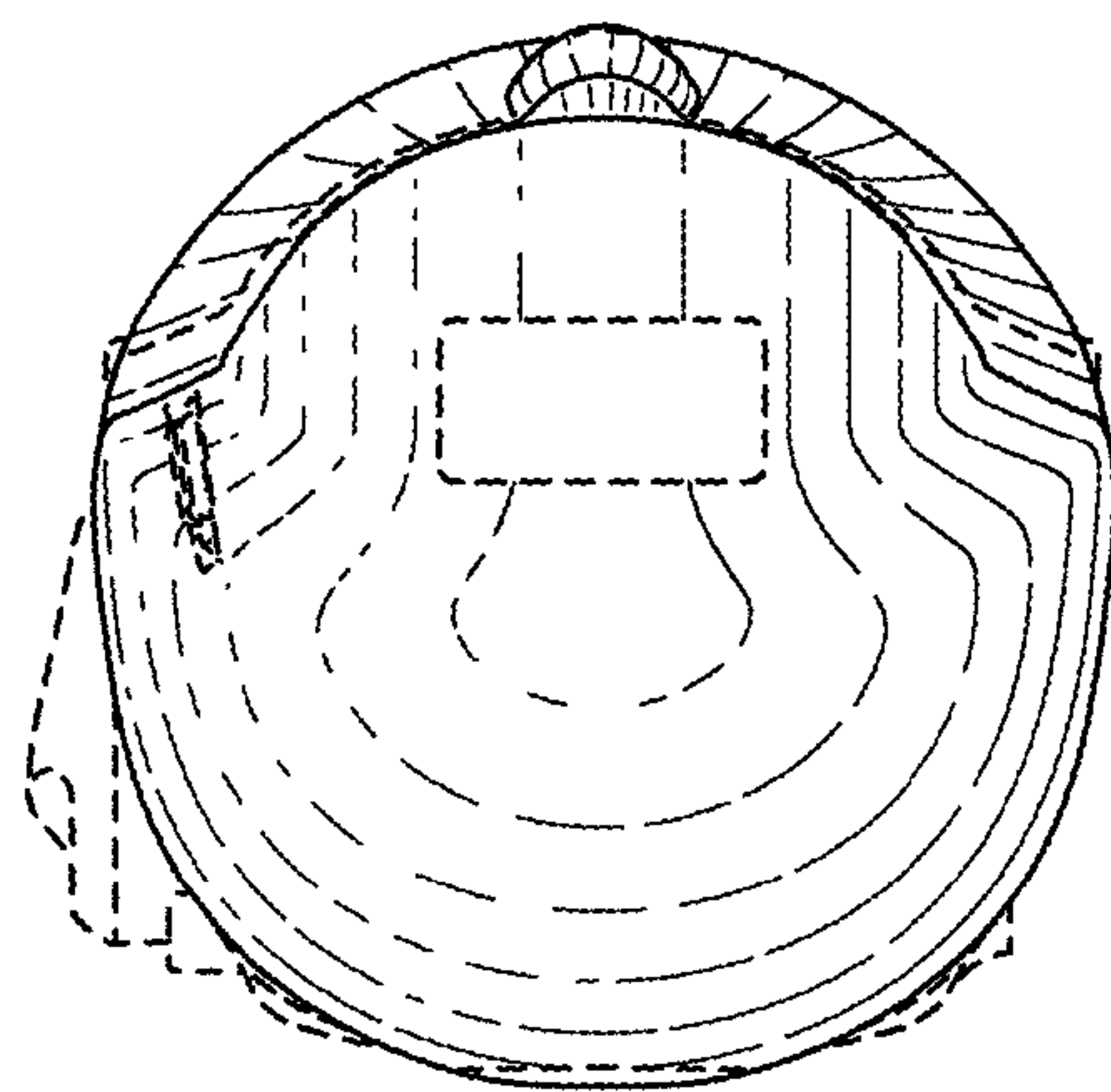
