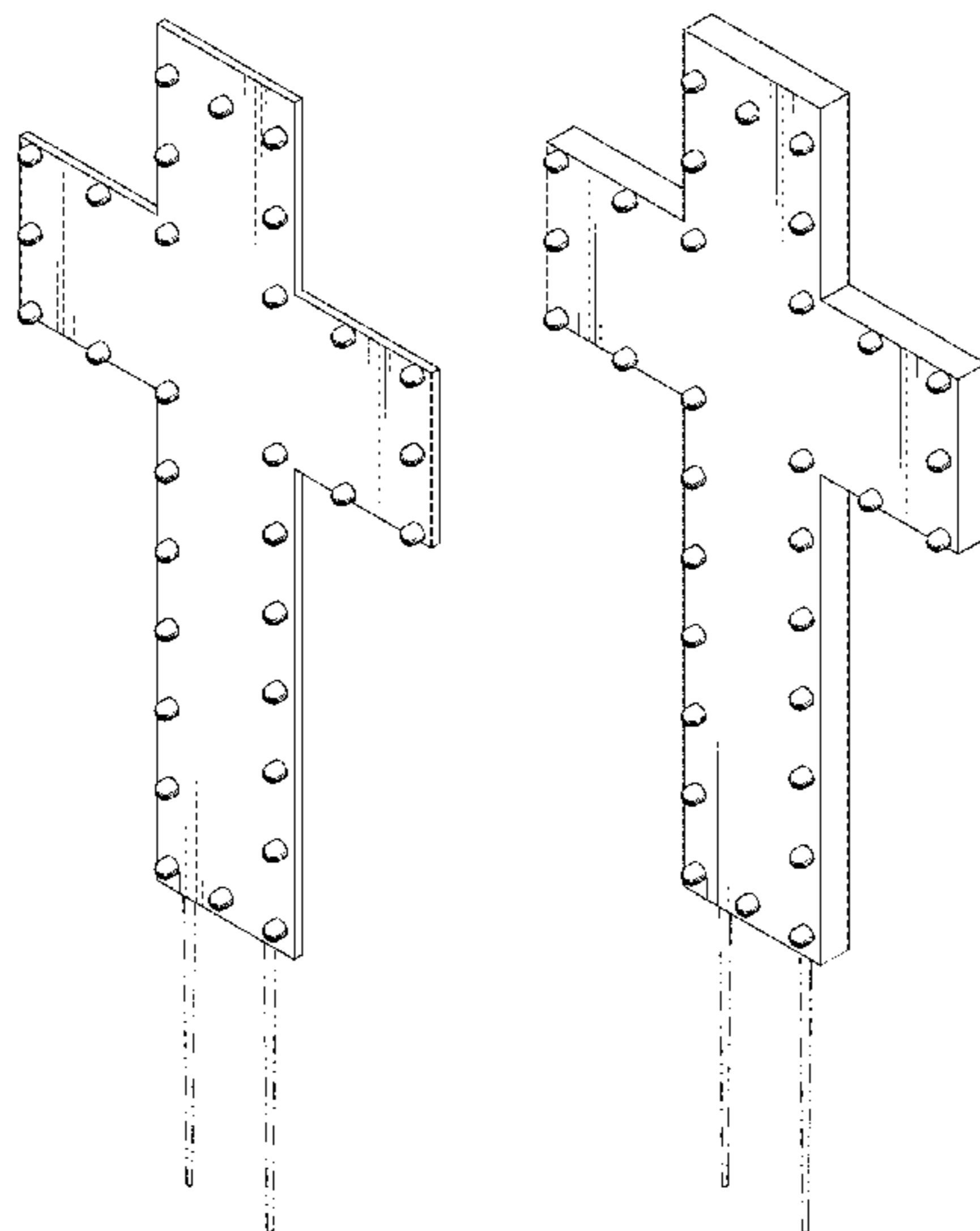
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lighted cross, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of a lighted cross showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a back elevation view thereof. FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a lighted cross showing my new design; FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 13 is a left side elevation view thereof; and FIG. 14 is a back elevation view thereof. Structure shown in broken lines in the drawings is background not forming a part of the invention.

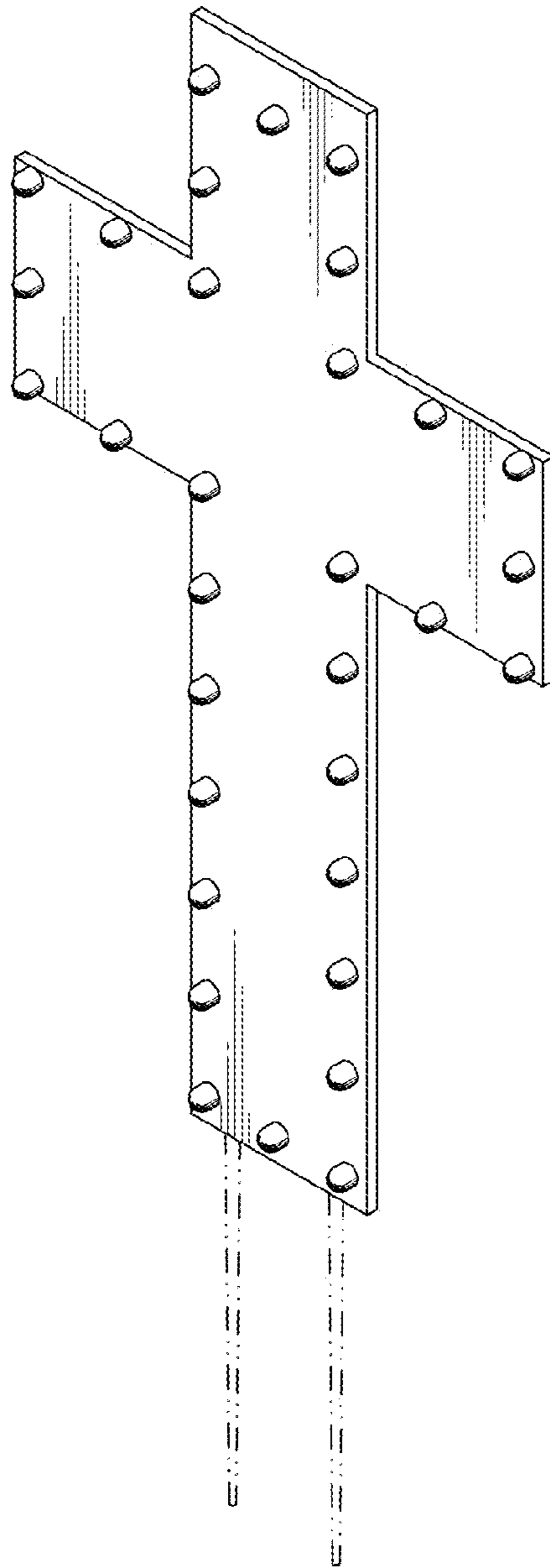

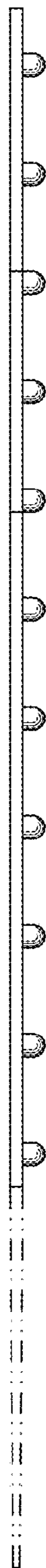

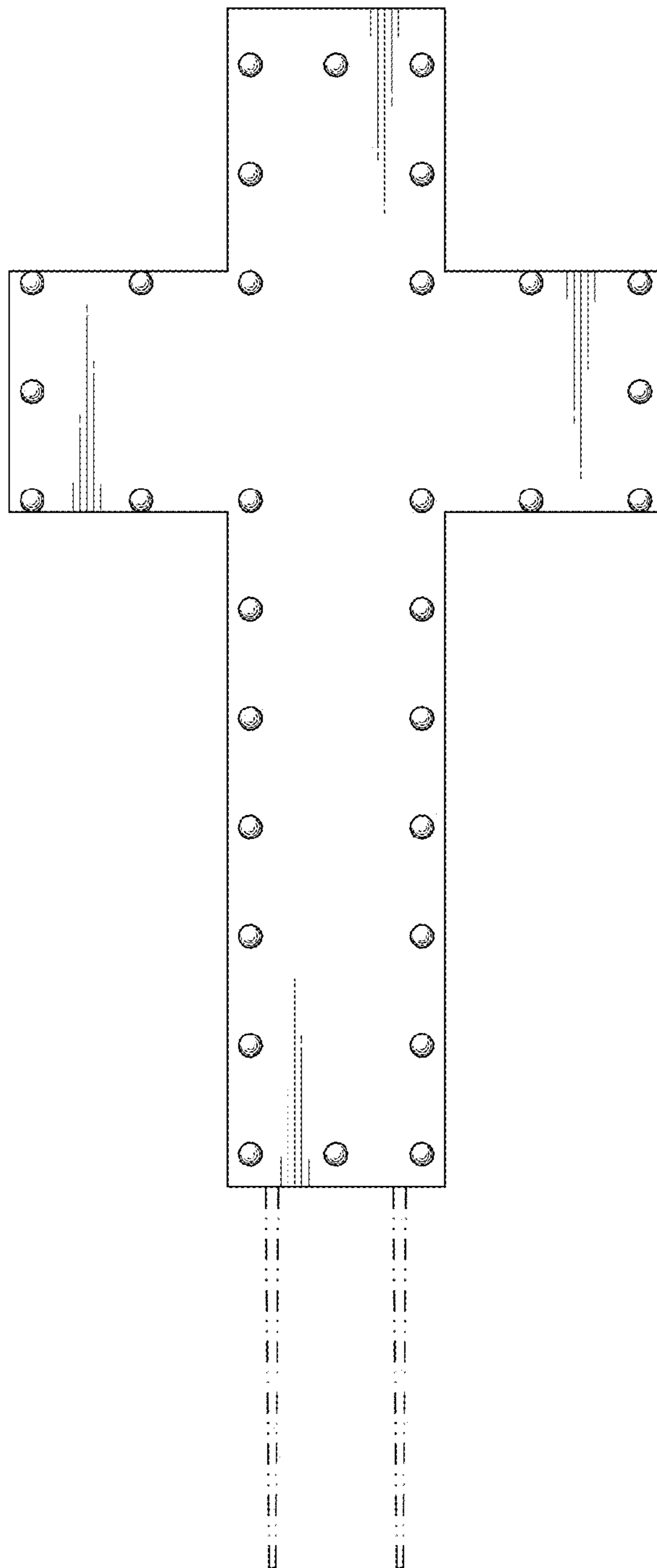

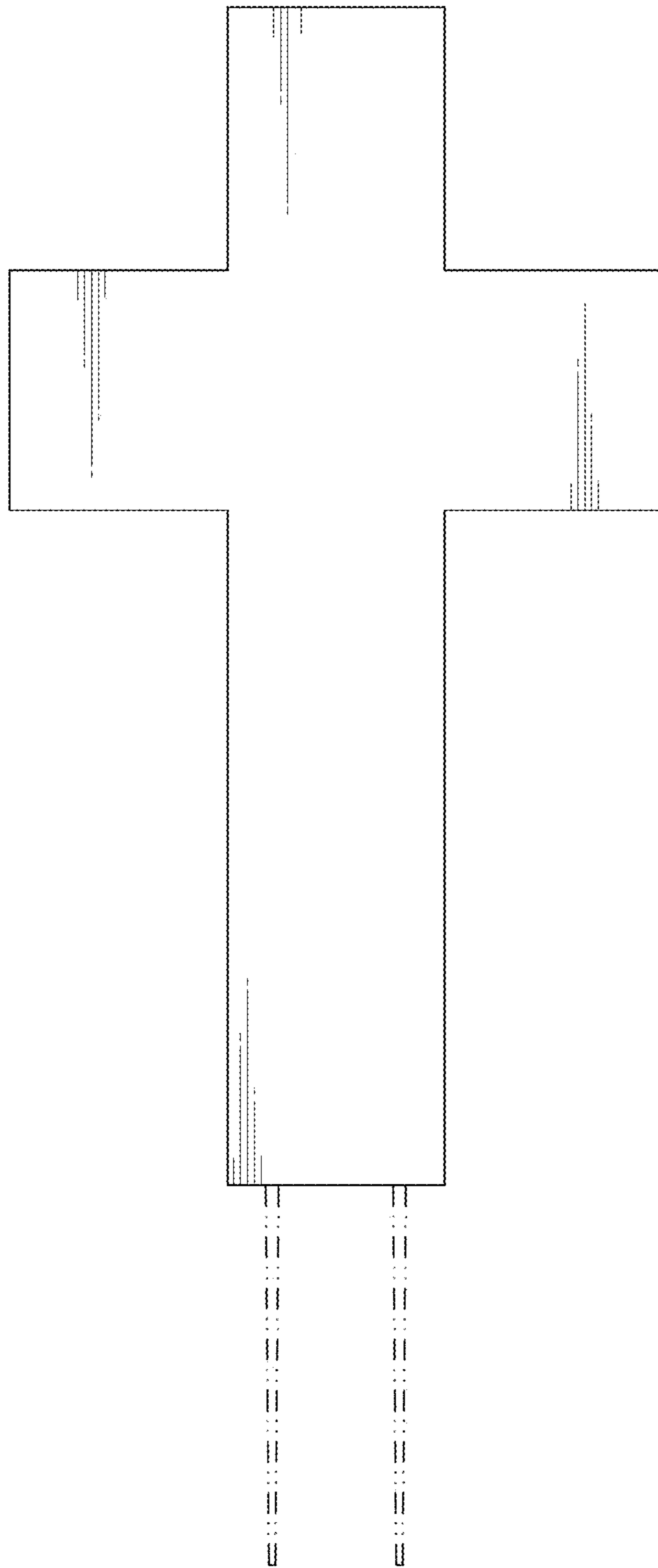

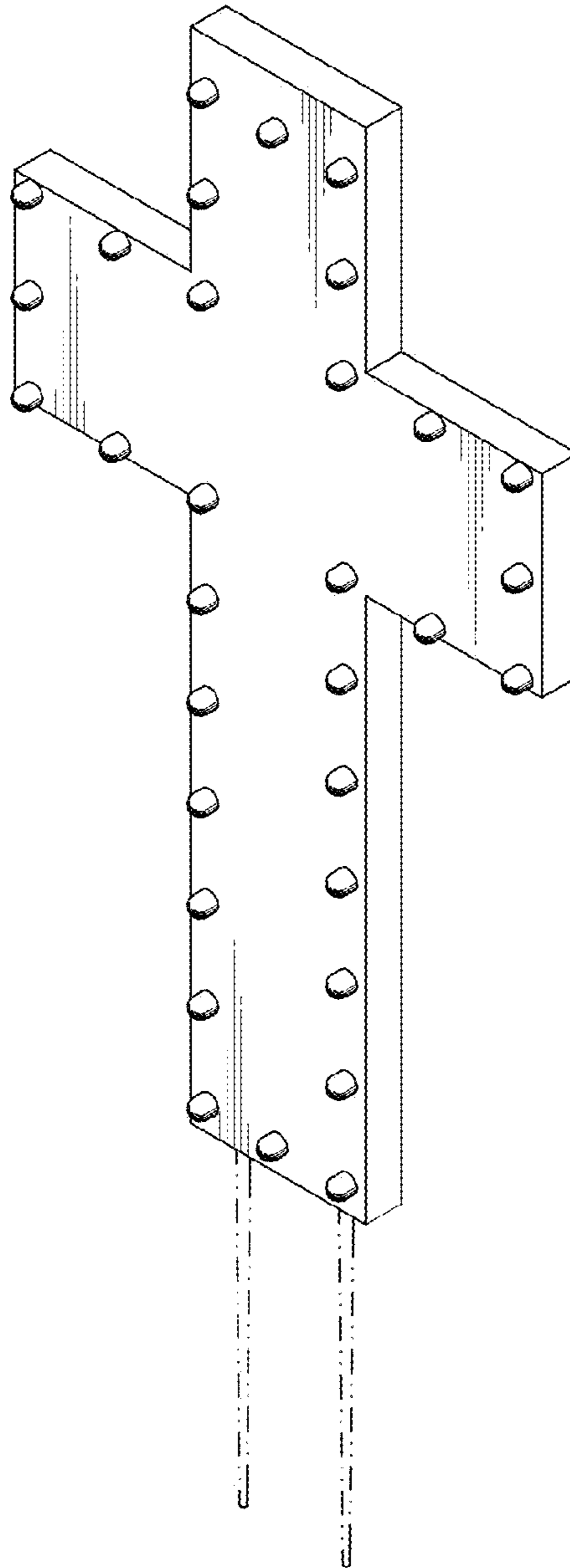

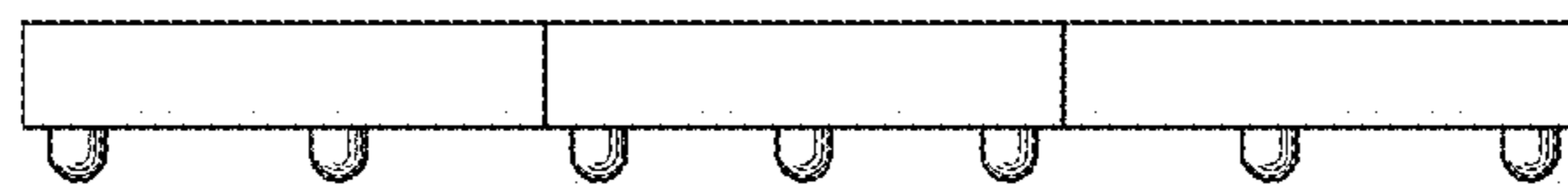

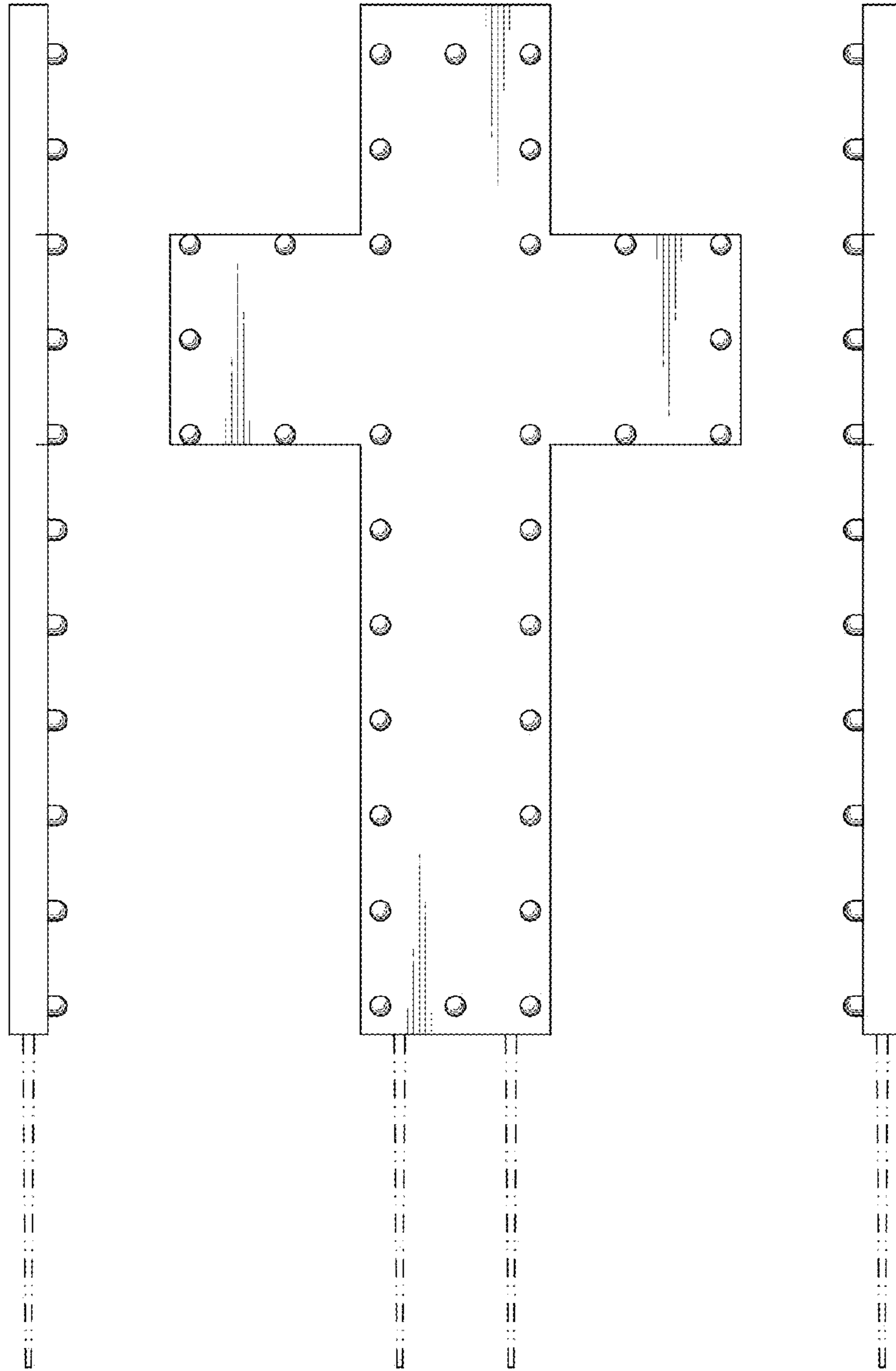

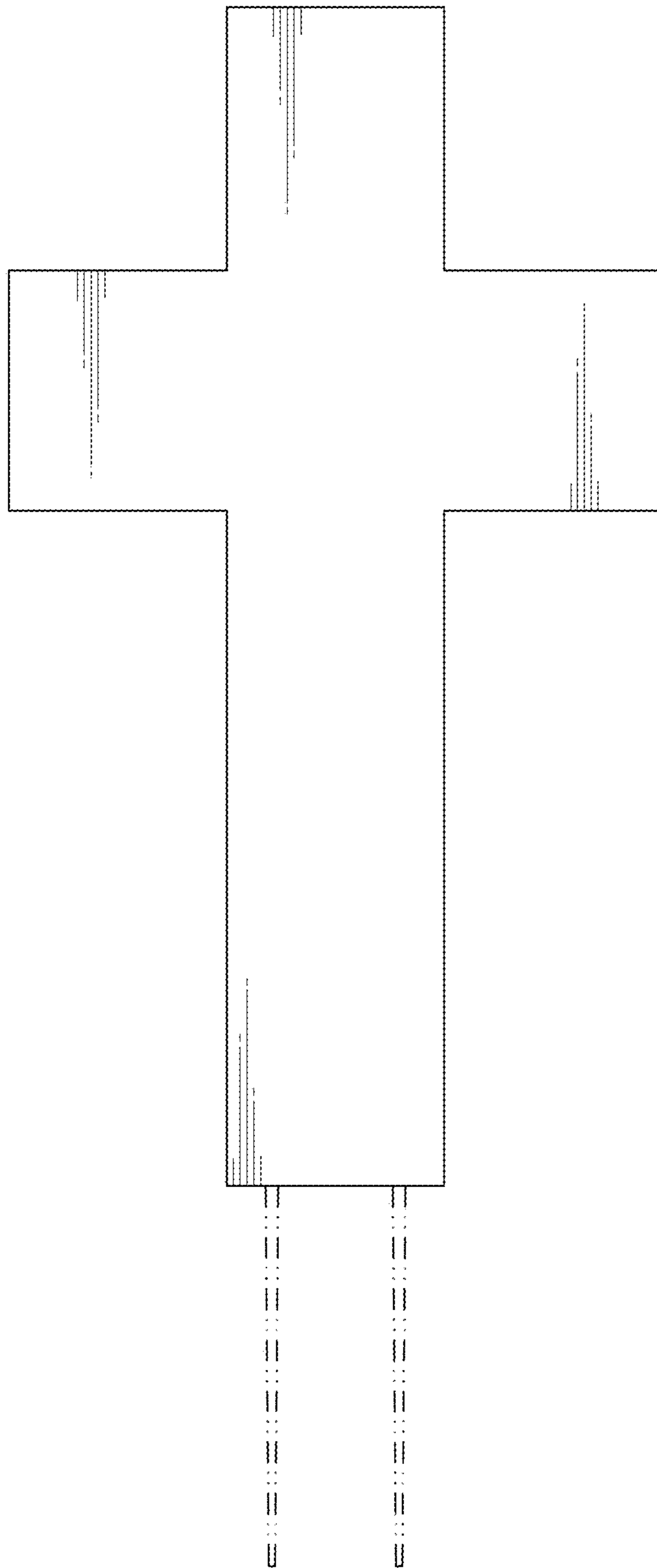
