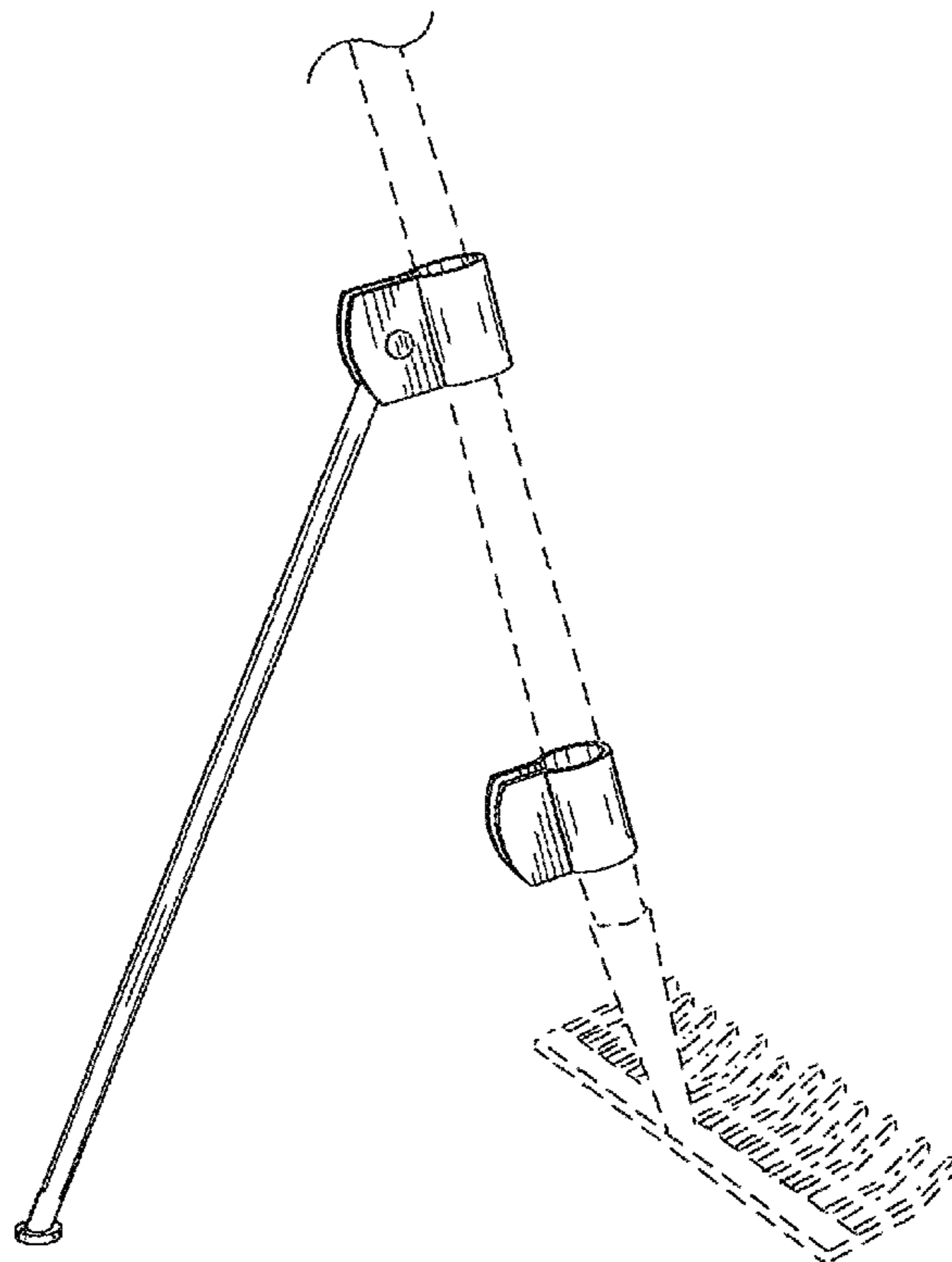
(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a tool support stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the tool support stand of my new design.
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line figure shown in FIG. 1, depicting a garden rake, is an environmental element, and forms no part of my new design.

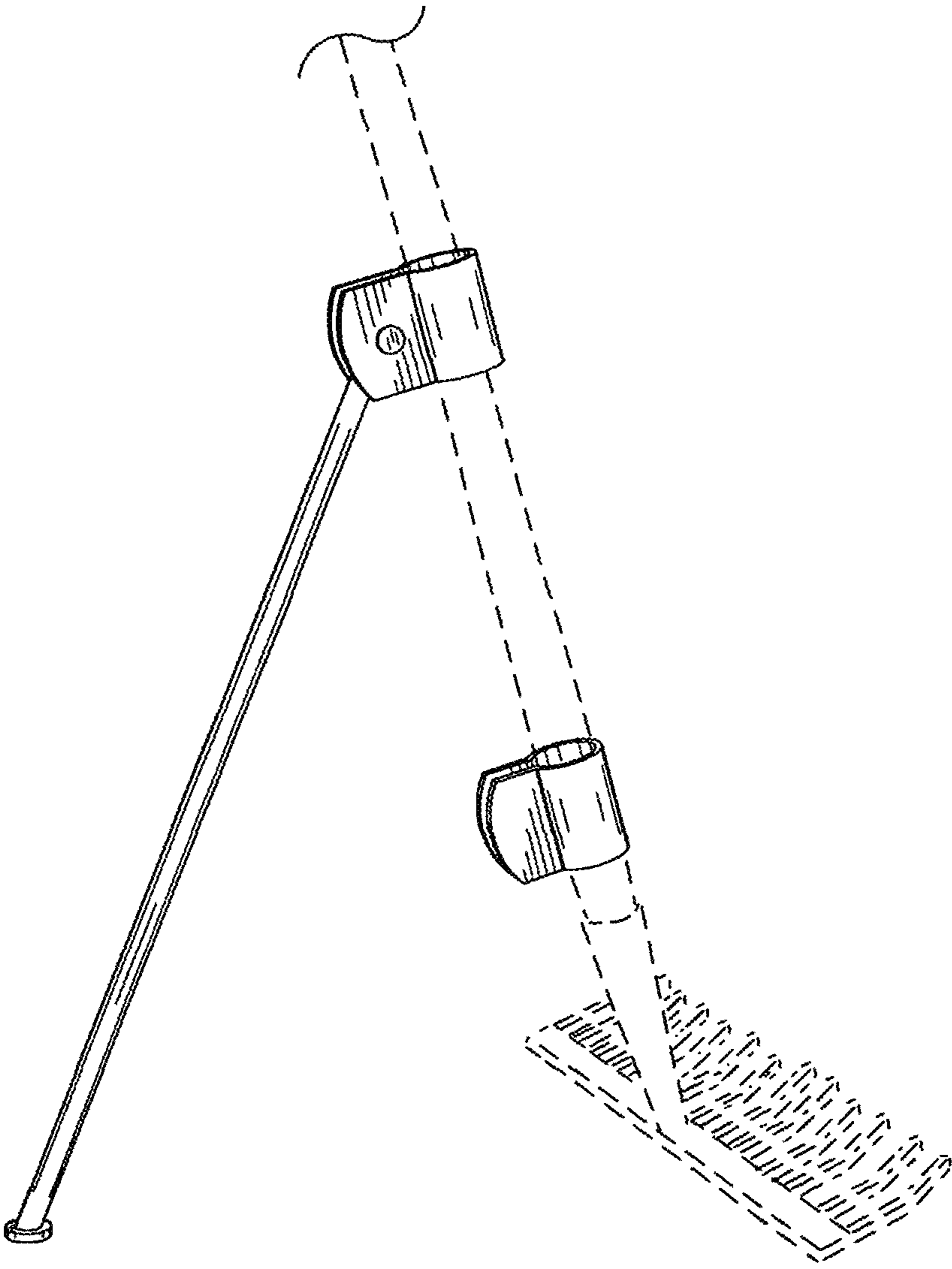

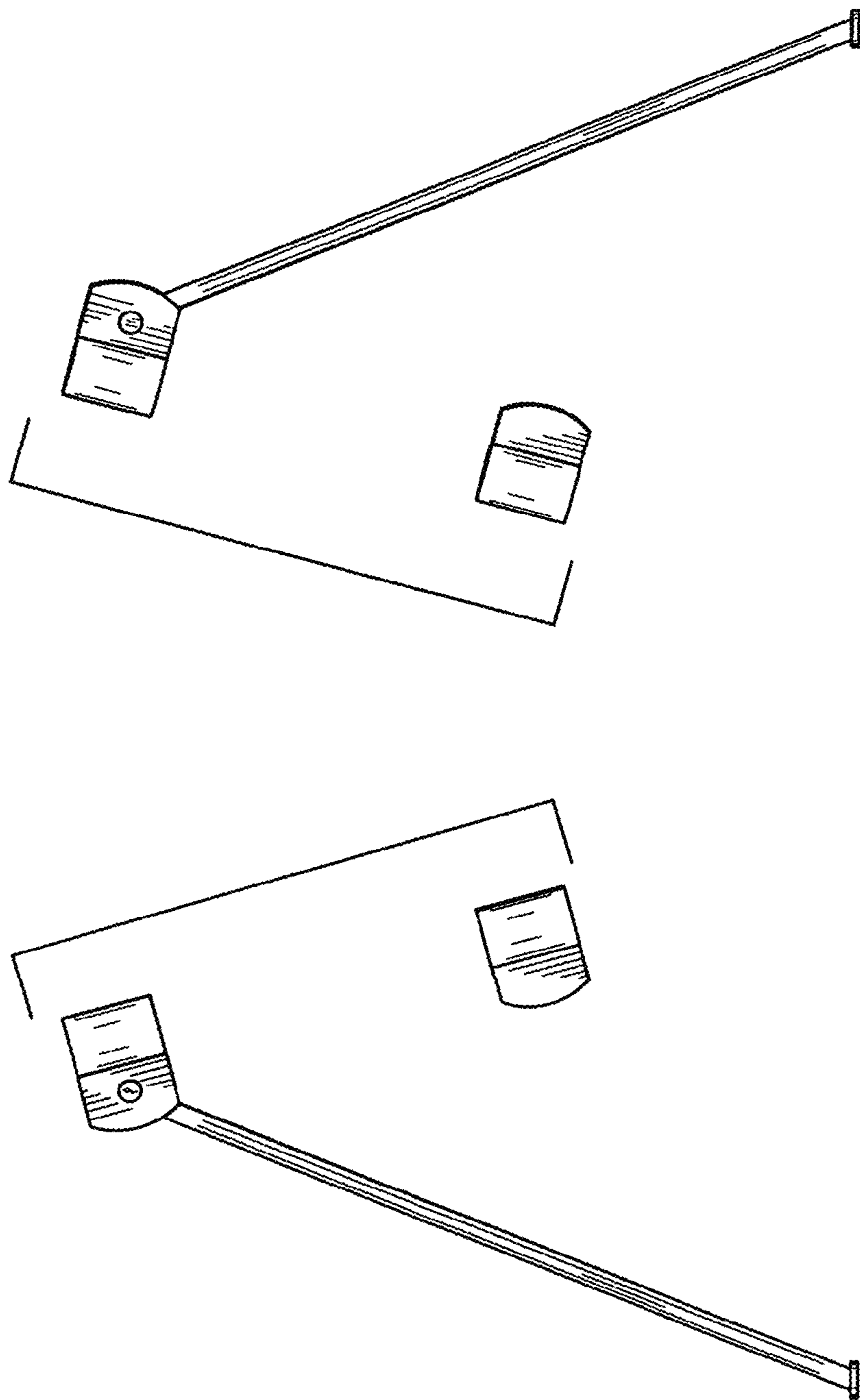

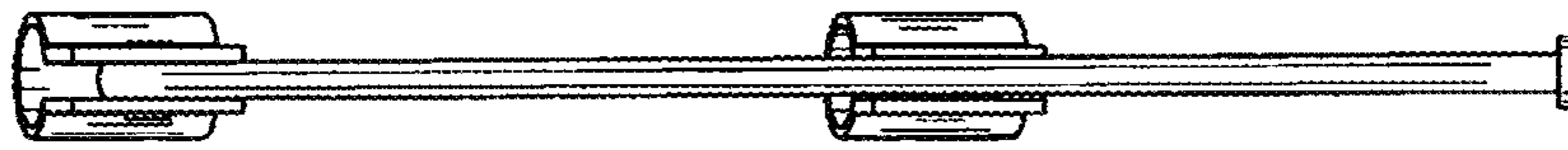

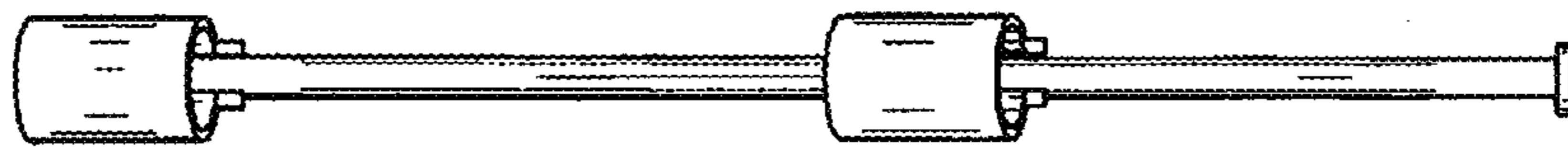

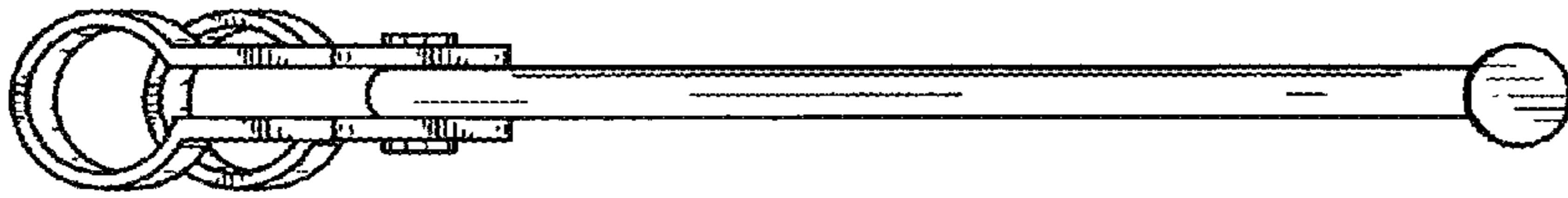

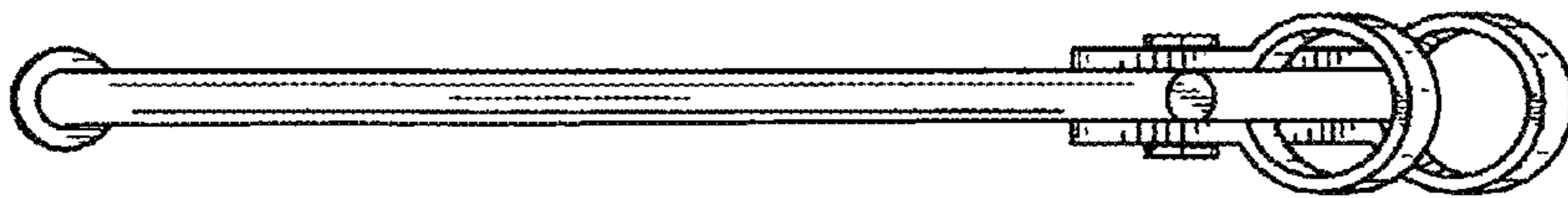
