DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, right front perspective view of a watch showing the new design.

FIG. 2 is a right front perspective view of the watch.

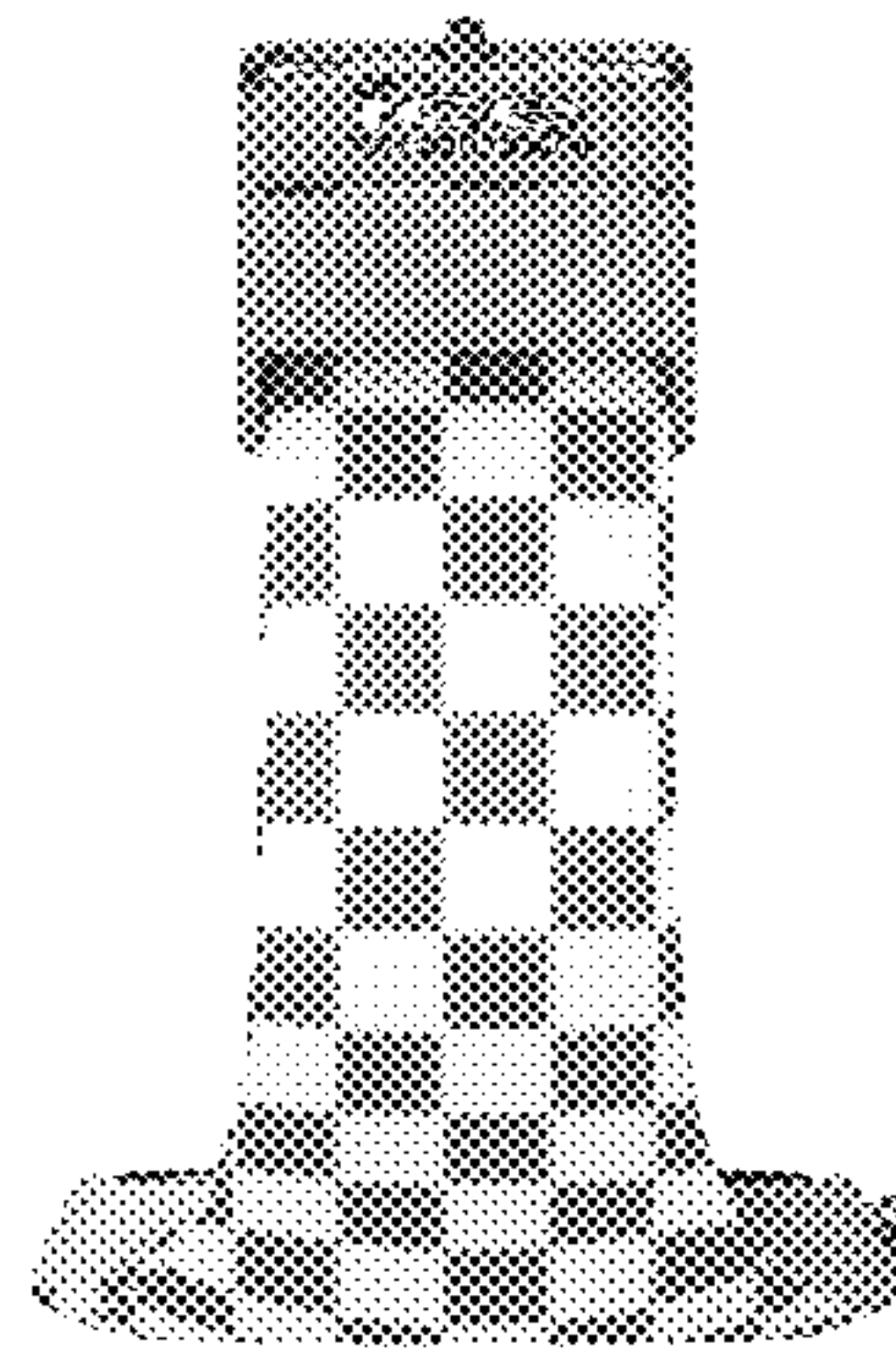

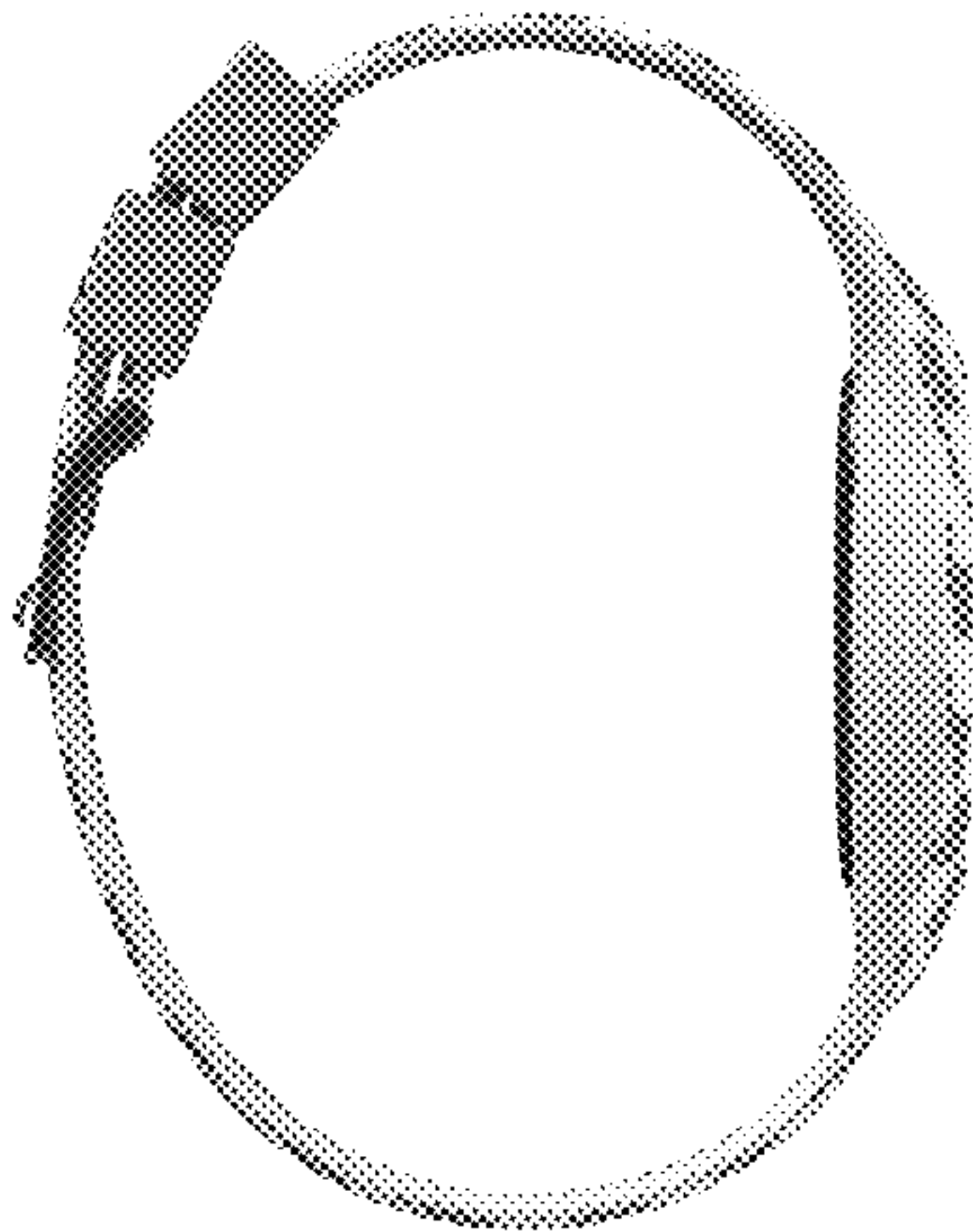

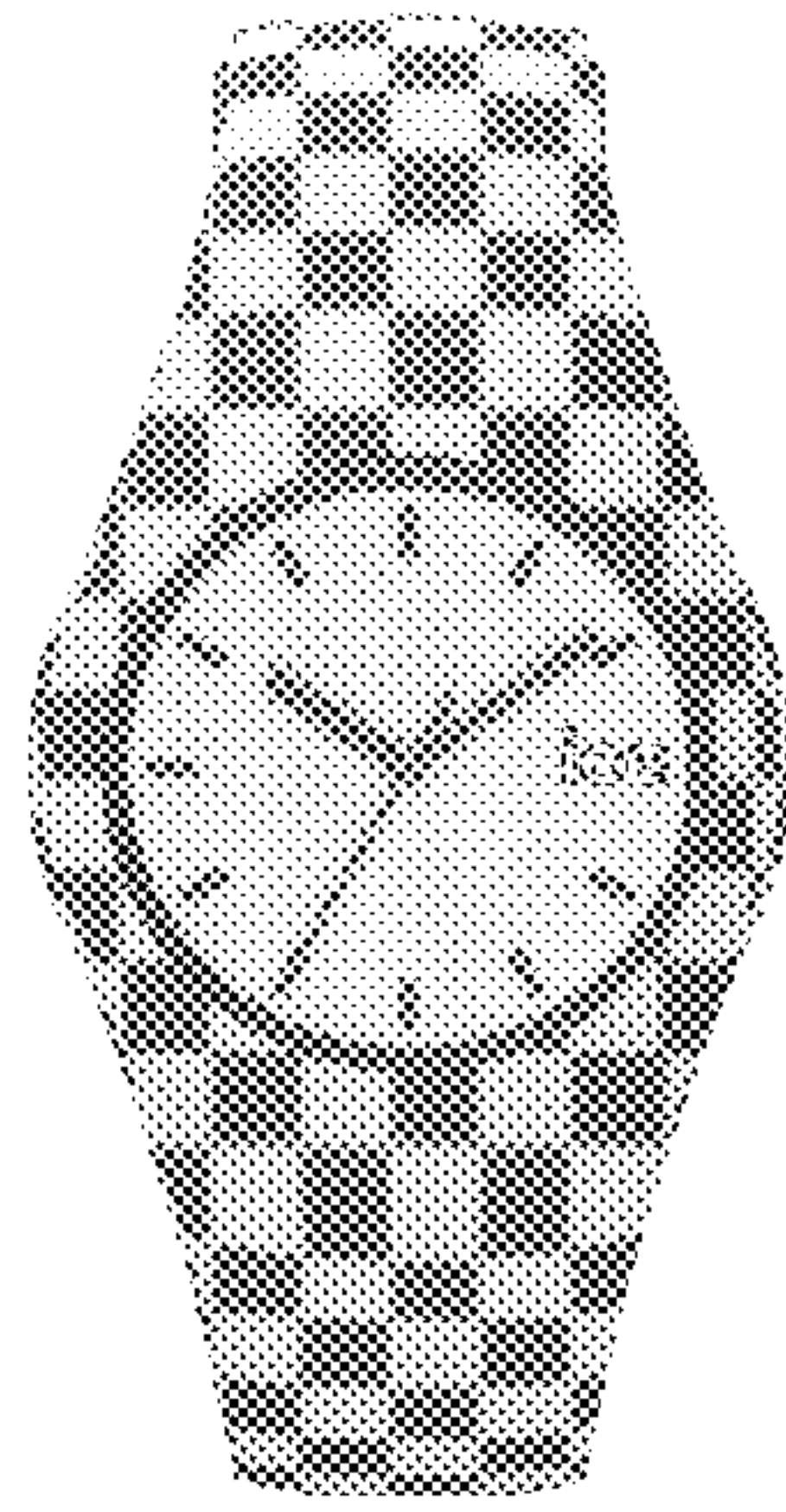

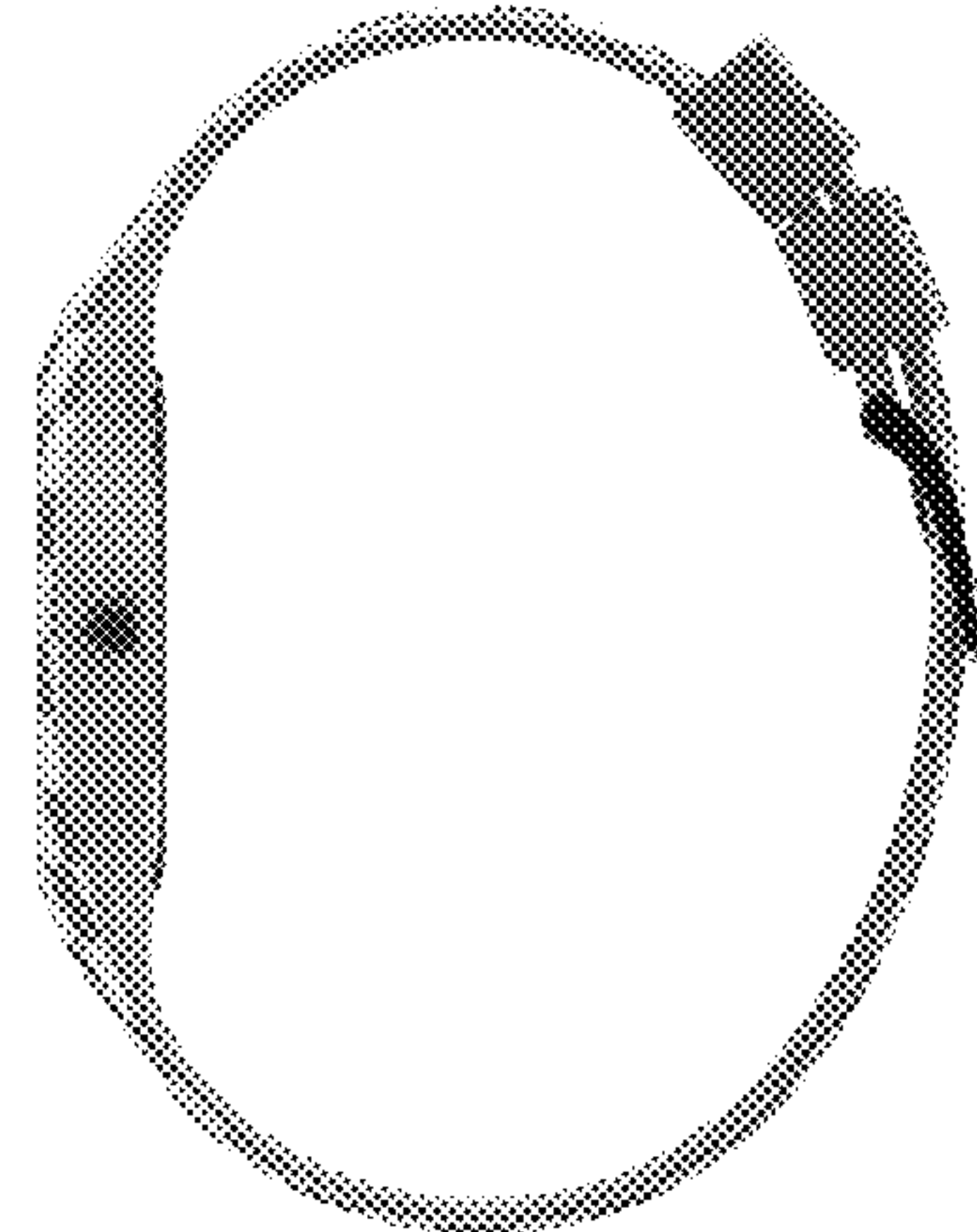

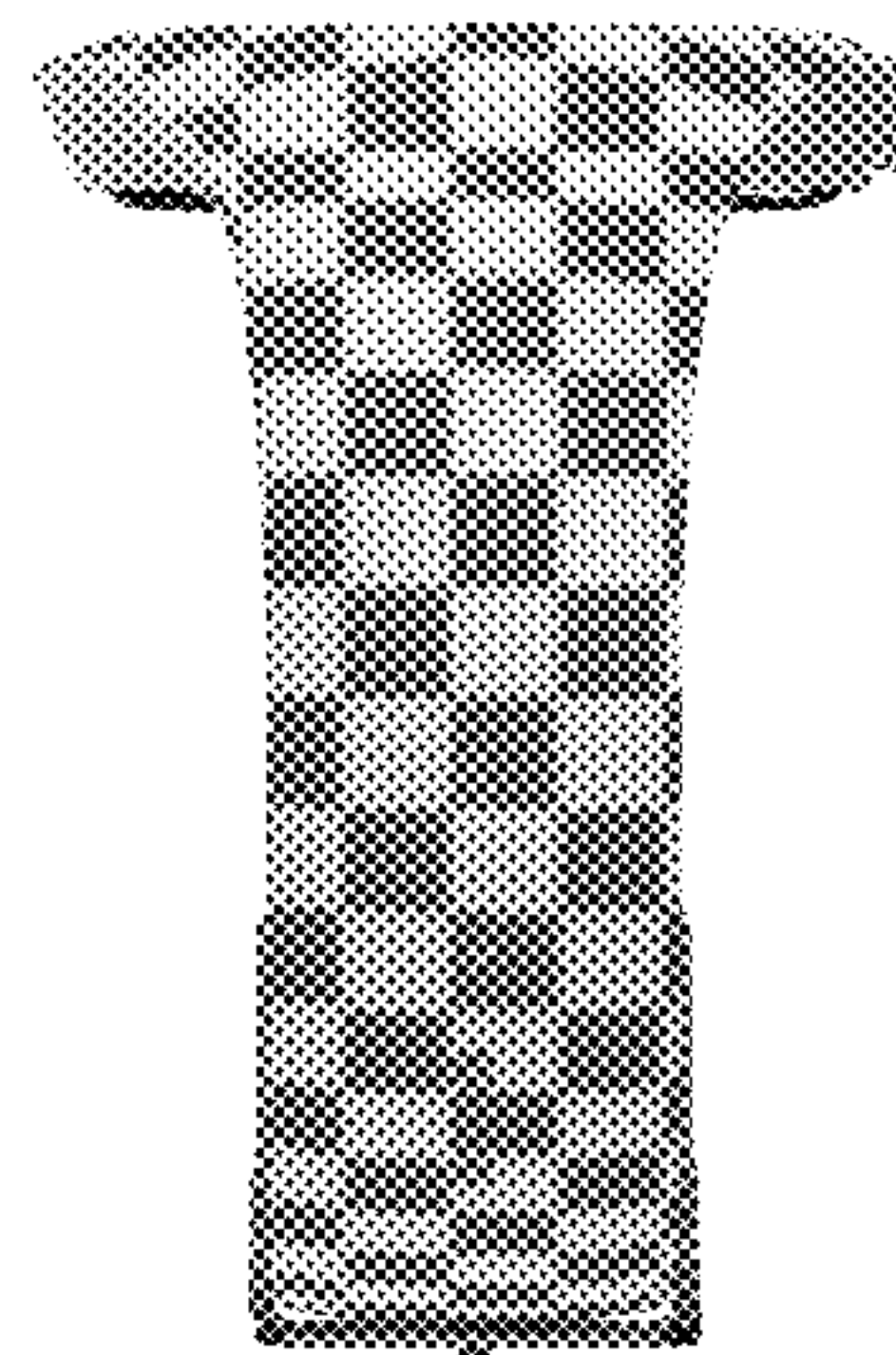

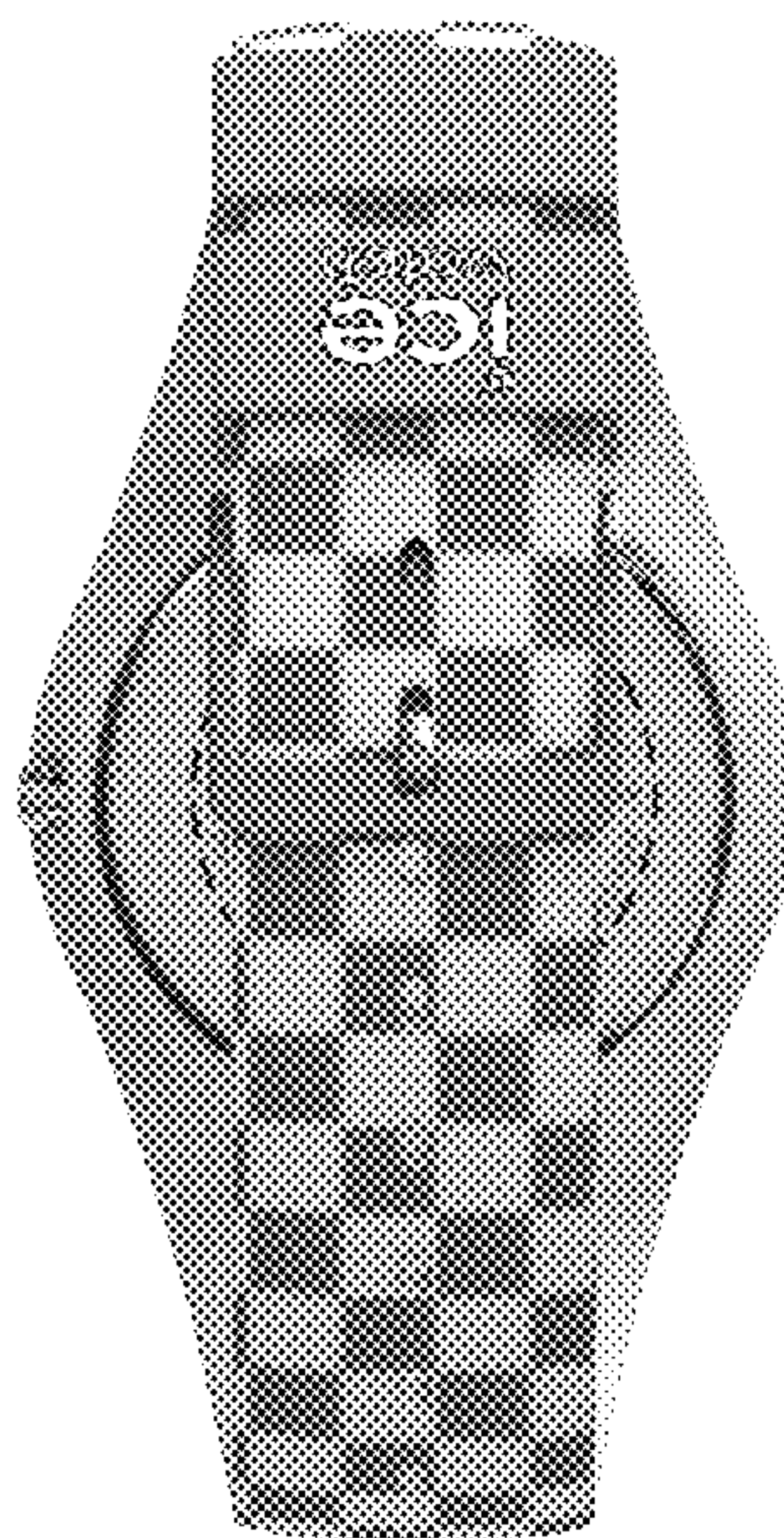
