The broken lines showing represents portions of the article not claimed and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of the bicycle represents environment and forms no part of the claimed design.

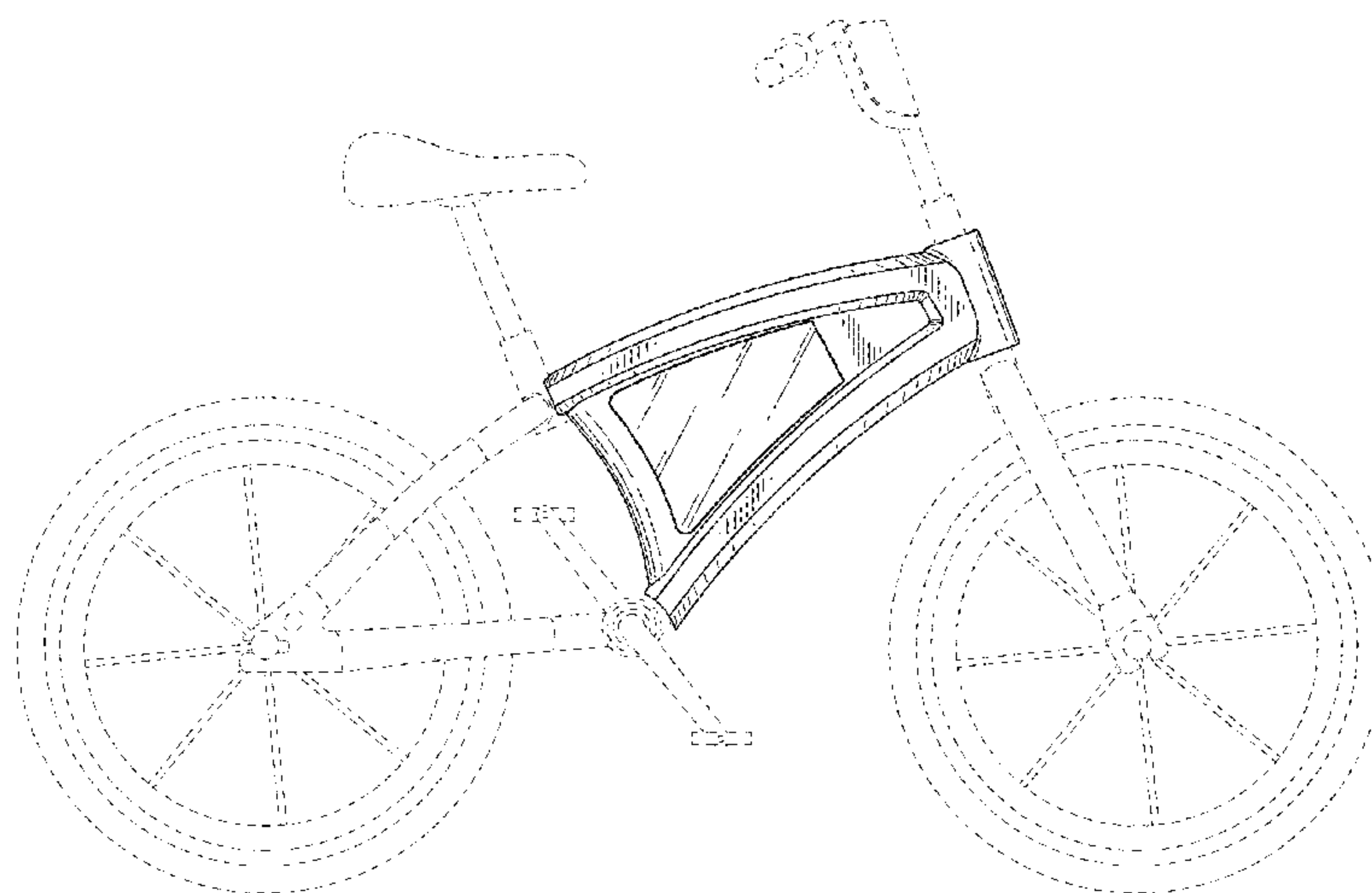

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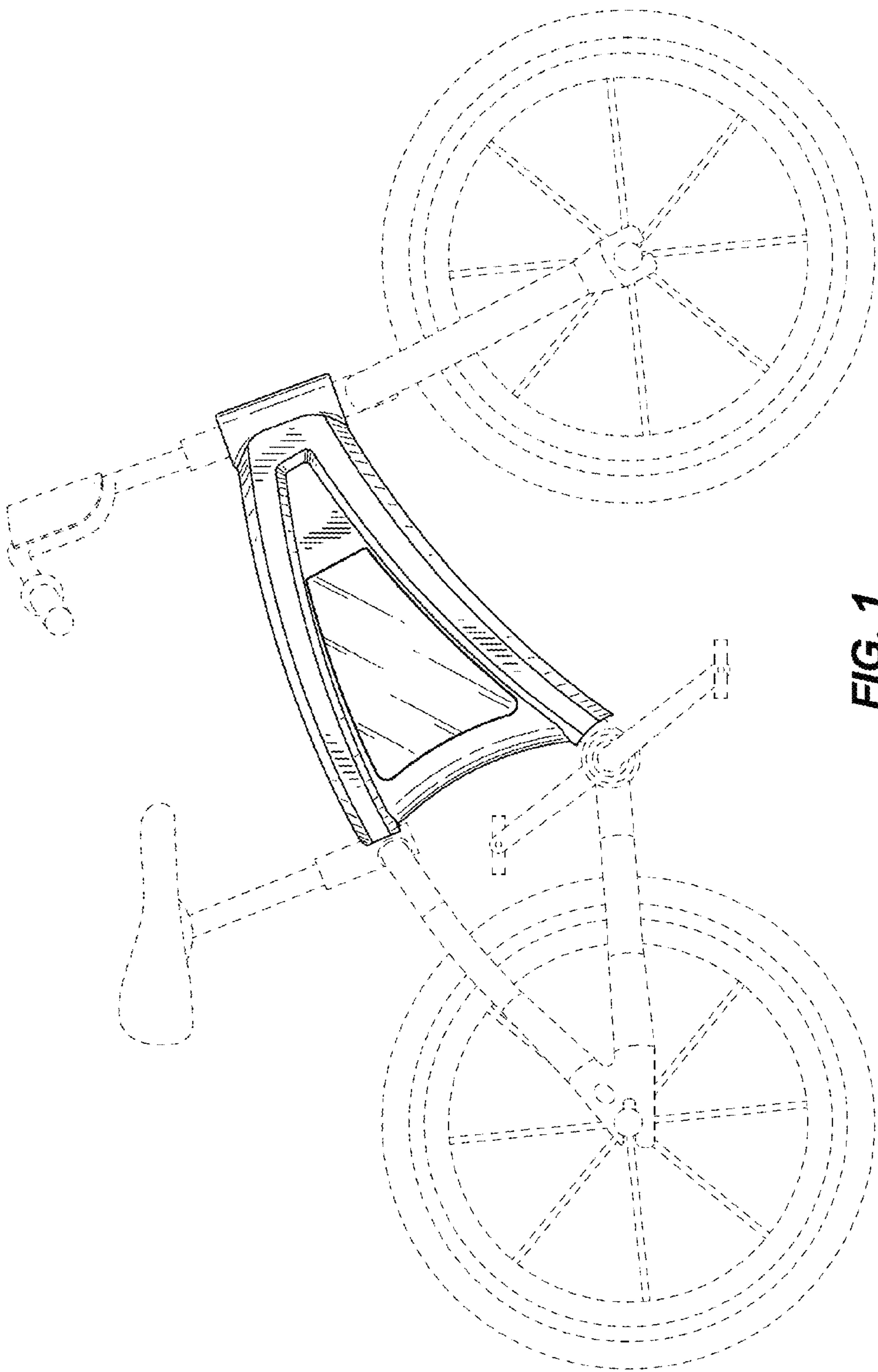

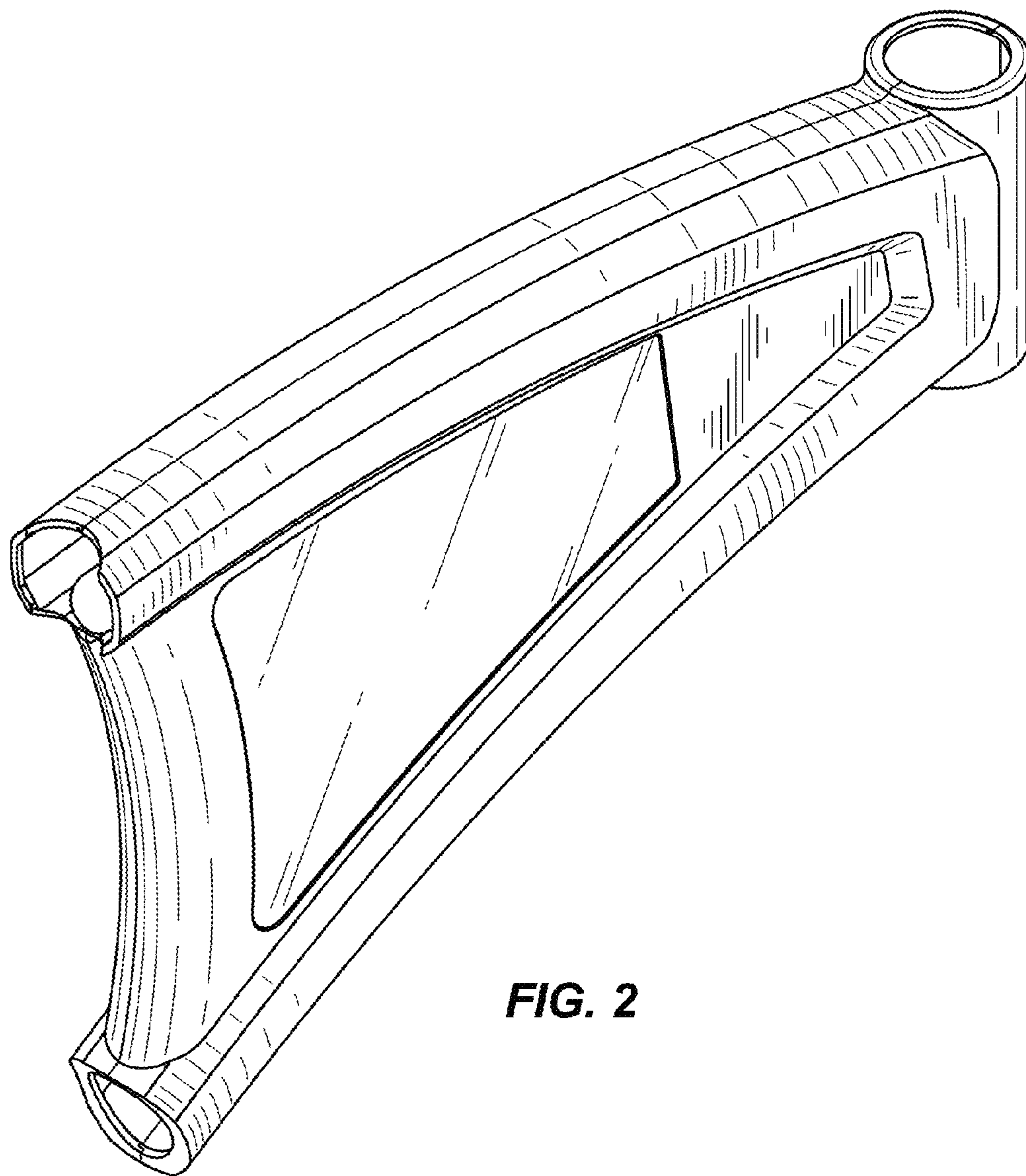

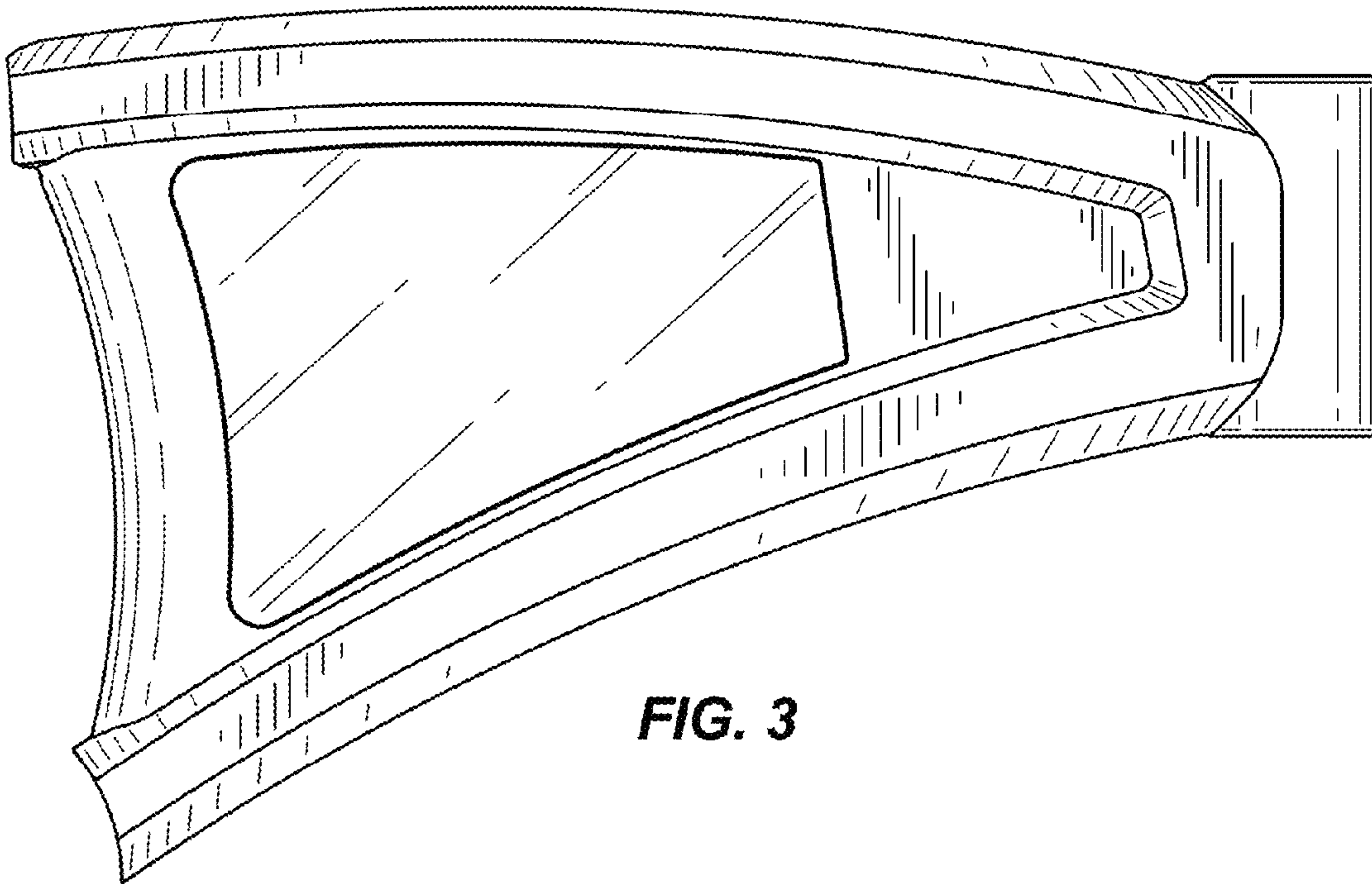

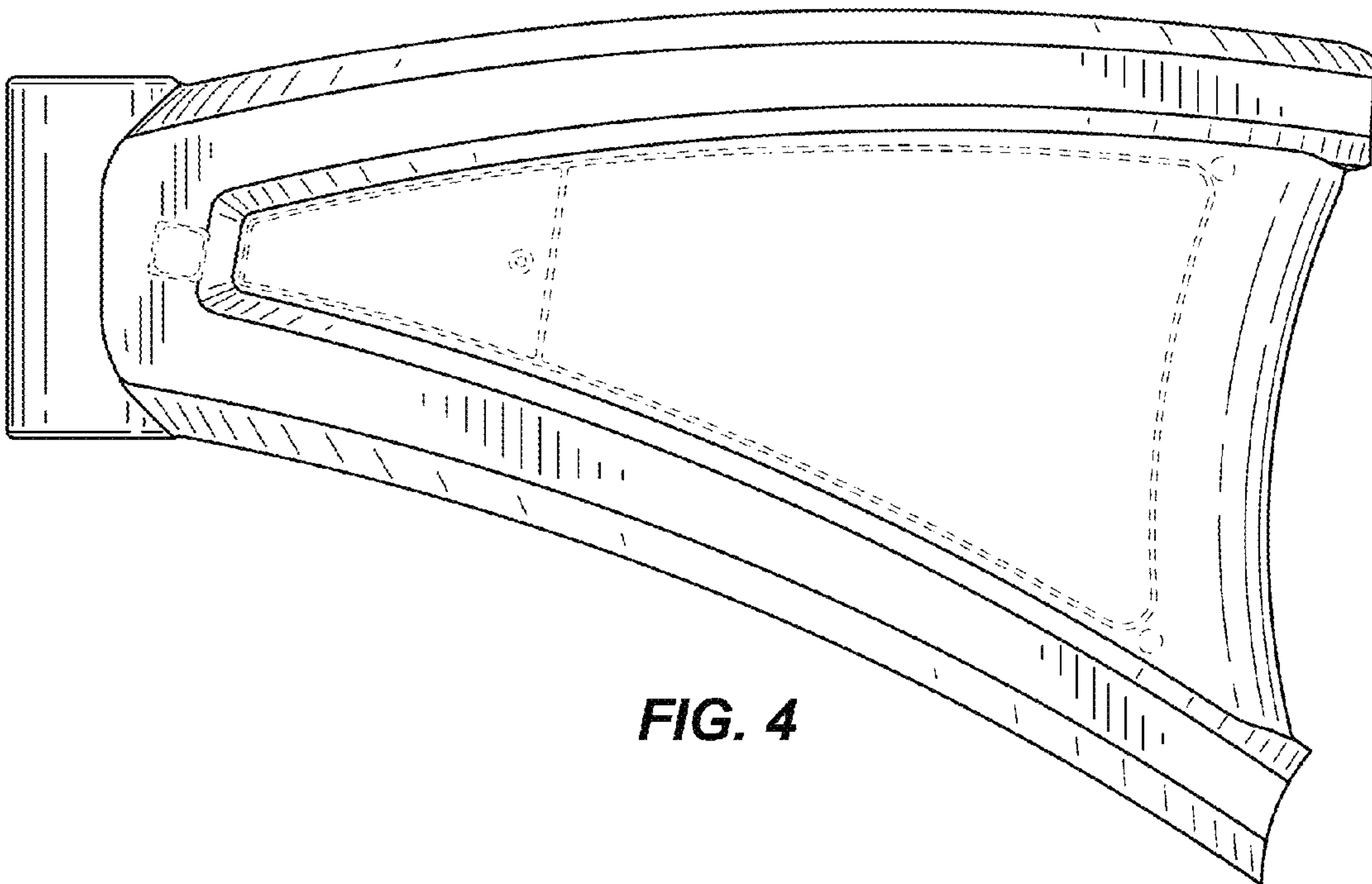

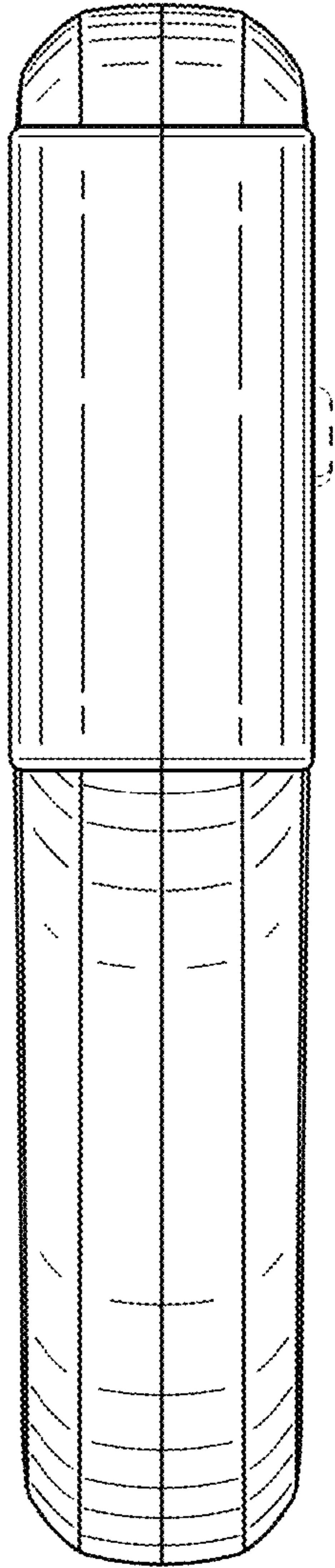

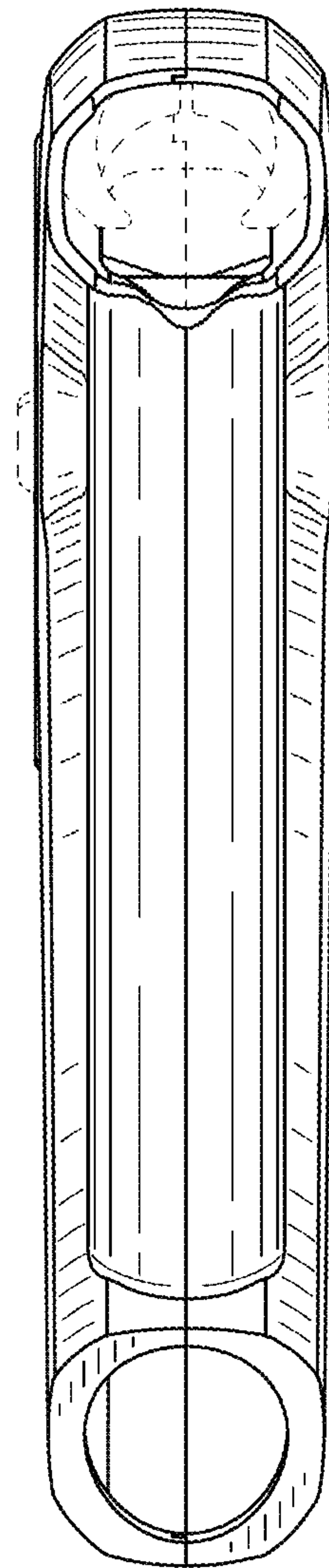

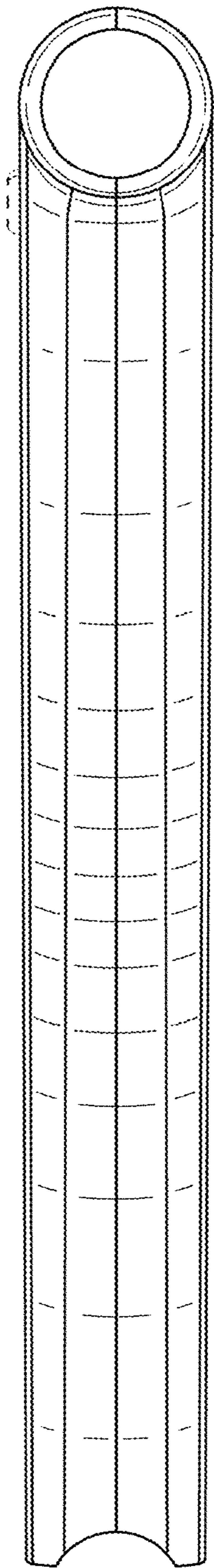

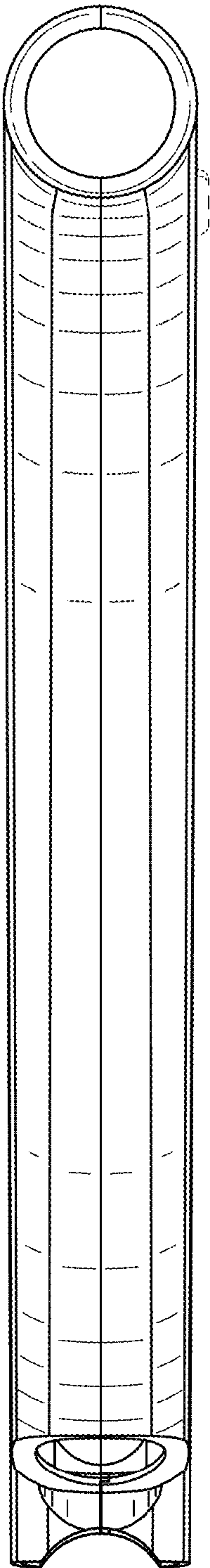
