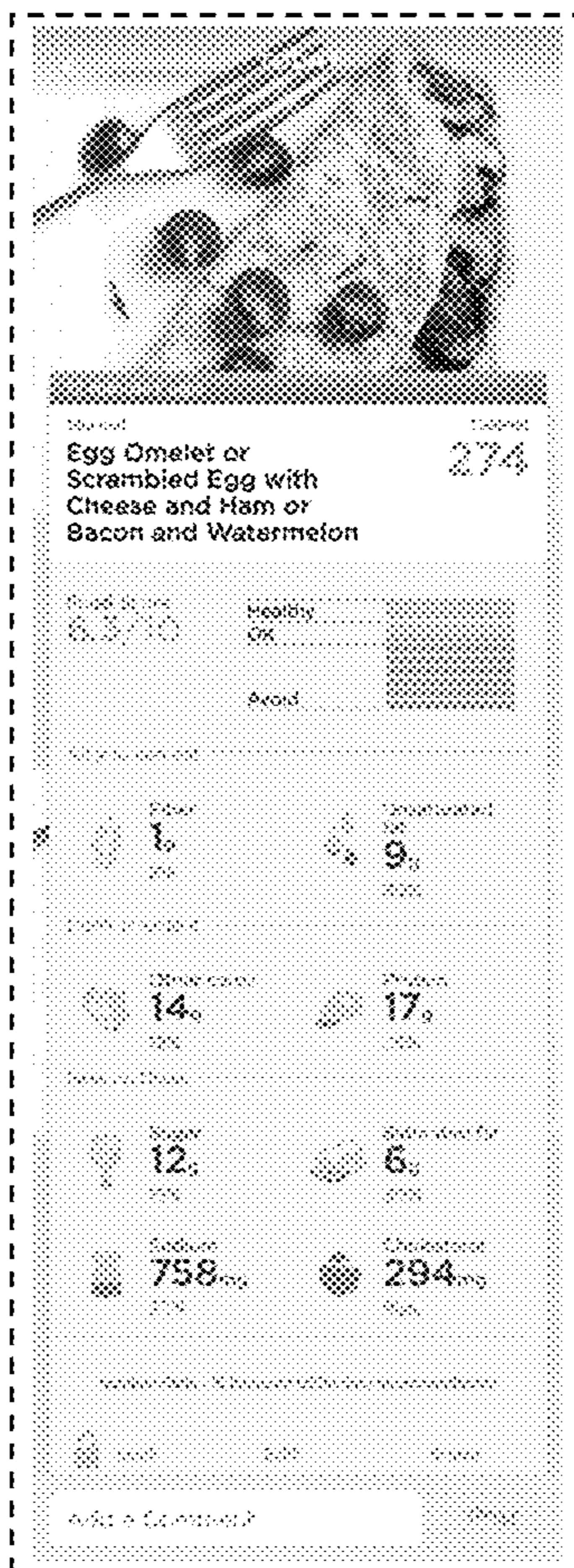
The ornamental design for the display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface, as shown and described.
