(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a upper body garment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear left perspective view of a upper body garment showing my new design in an in-use configuration;

FIG. 2 is a rear right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

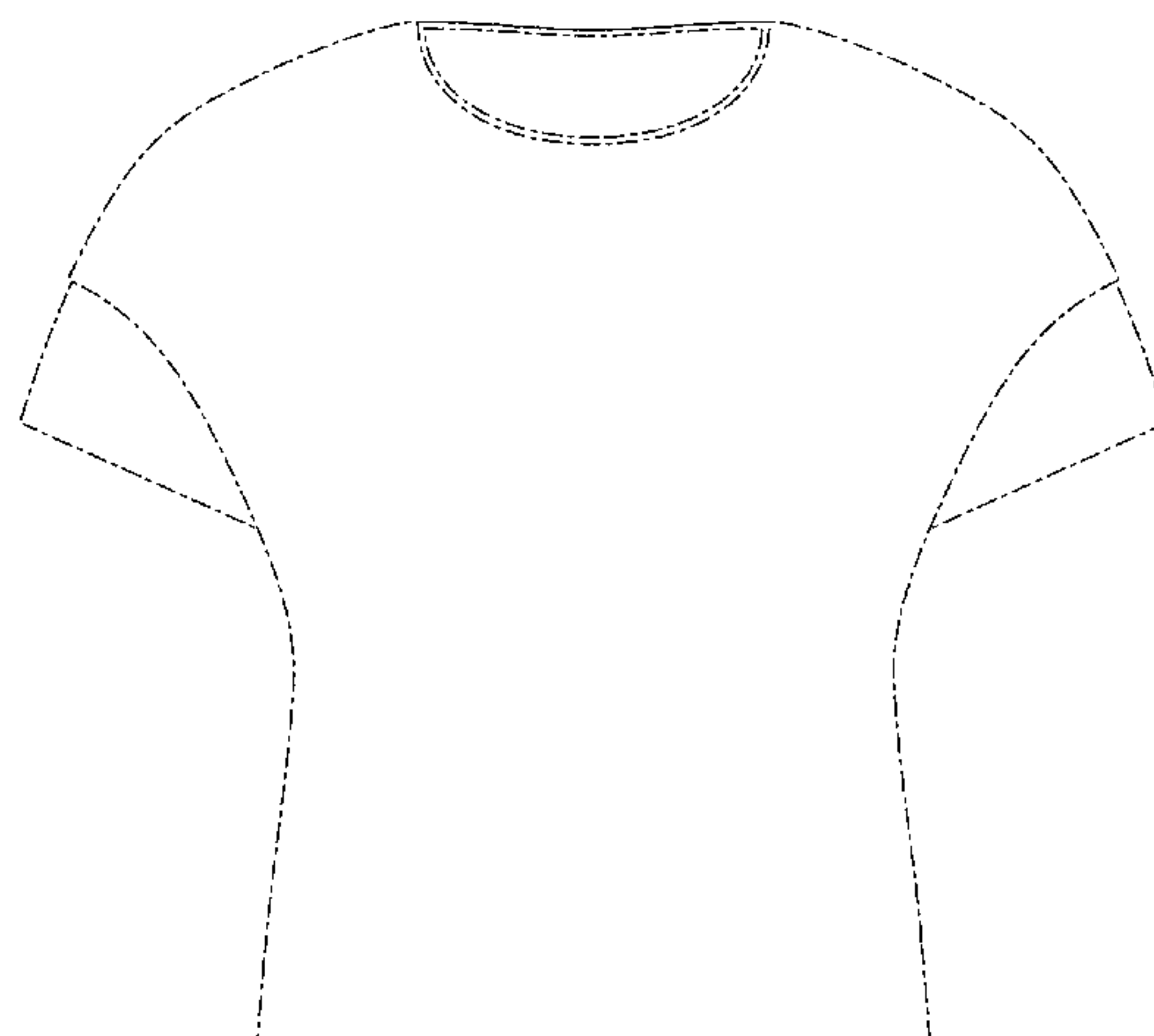
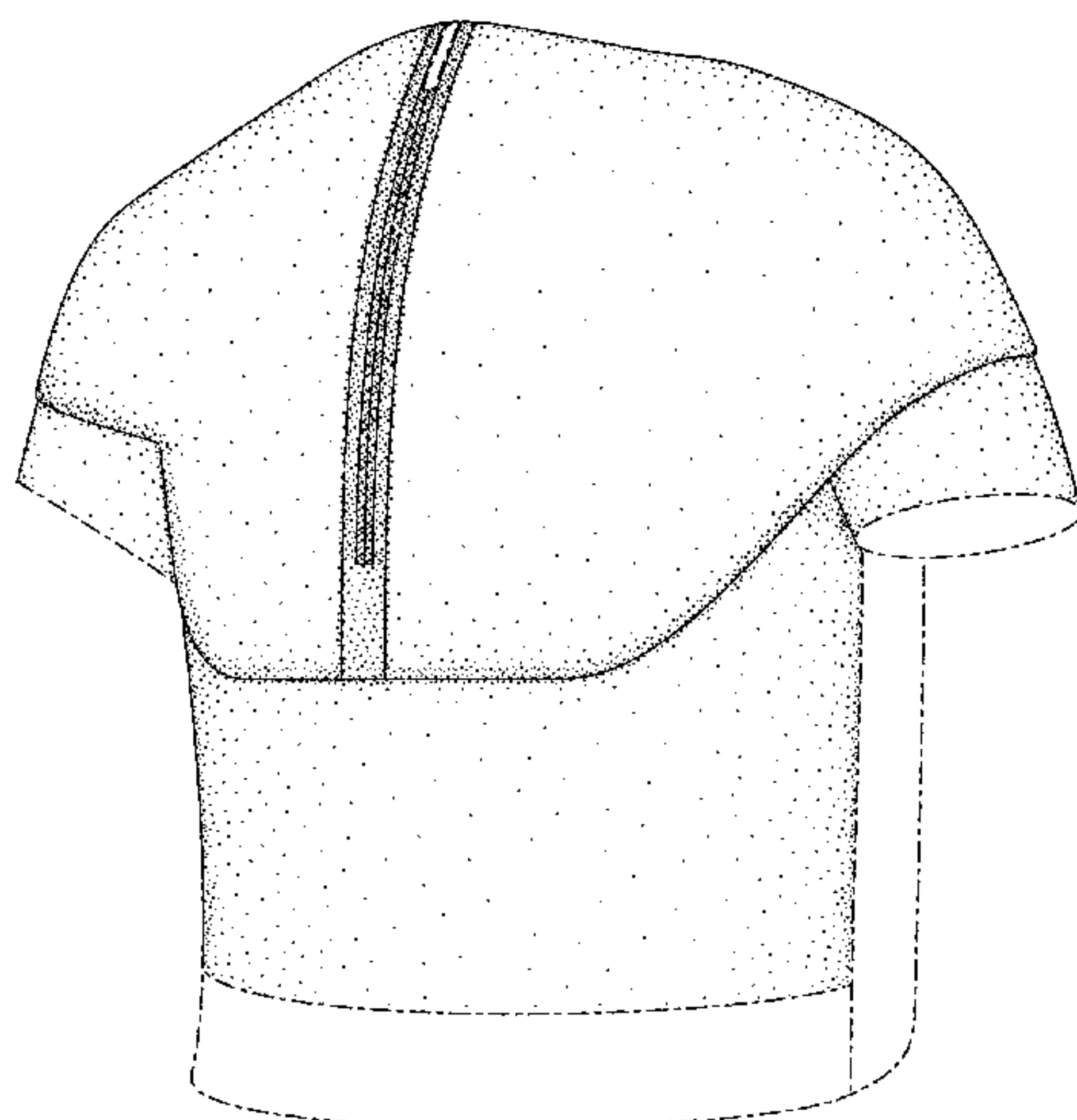
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;

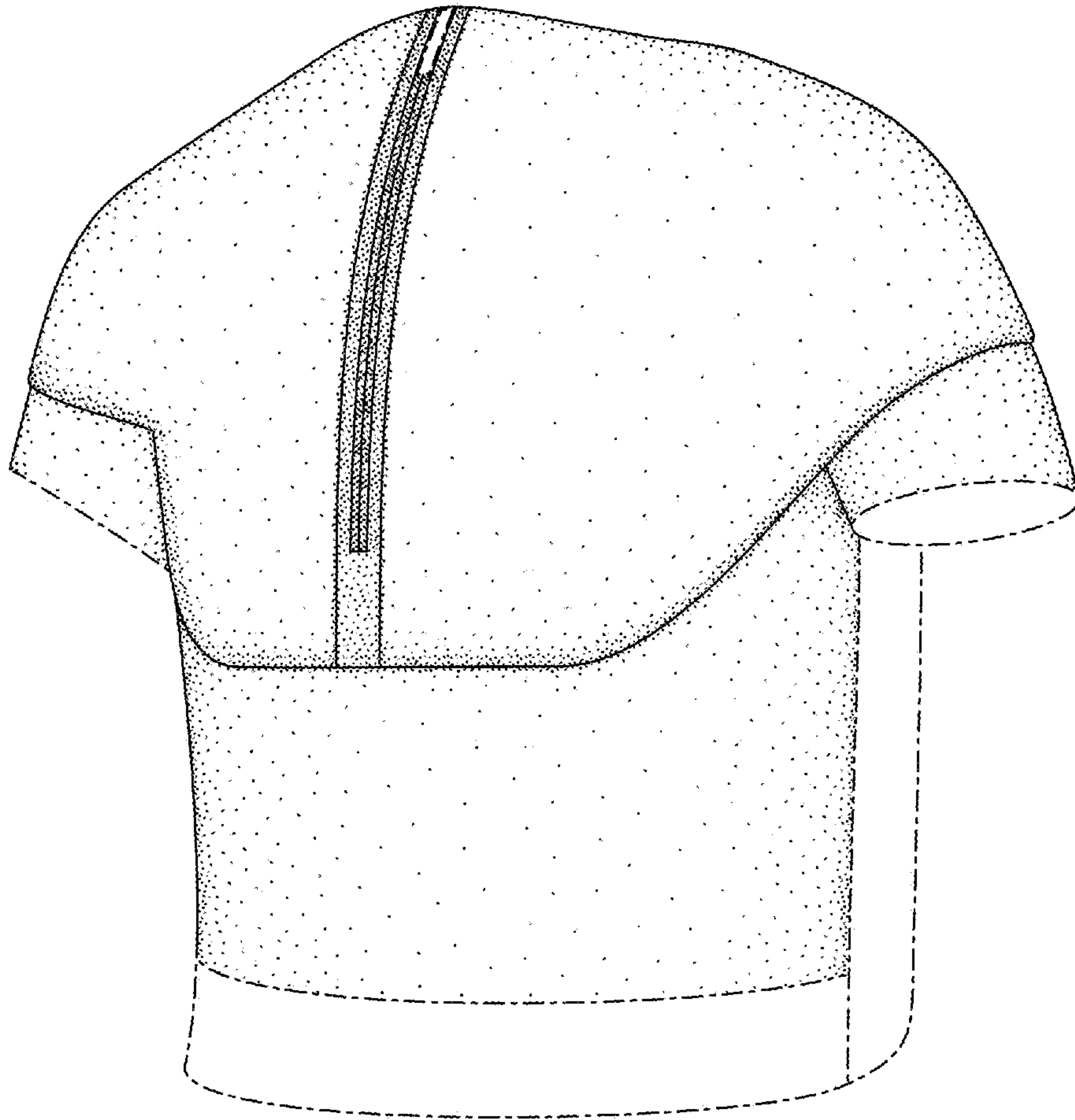

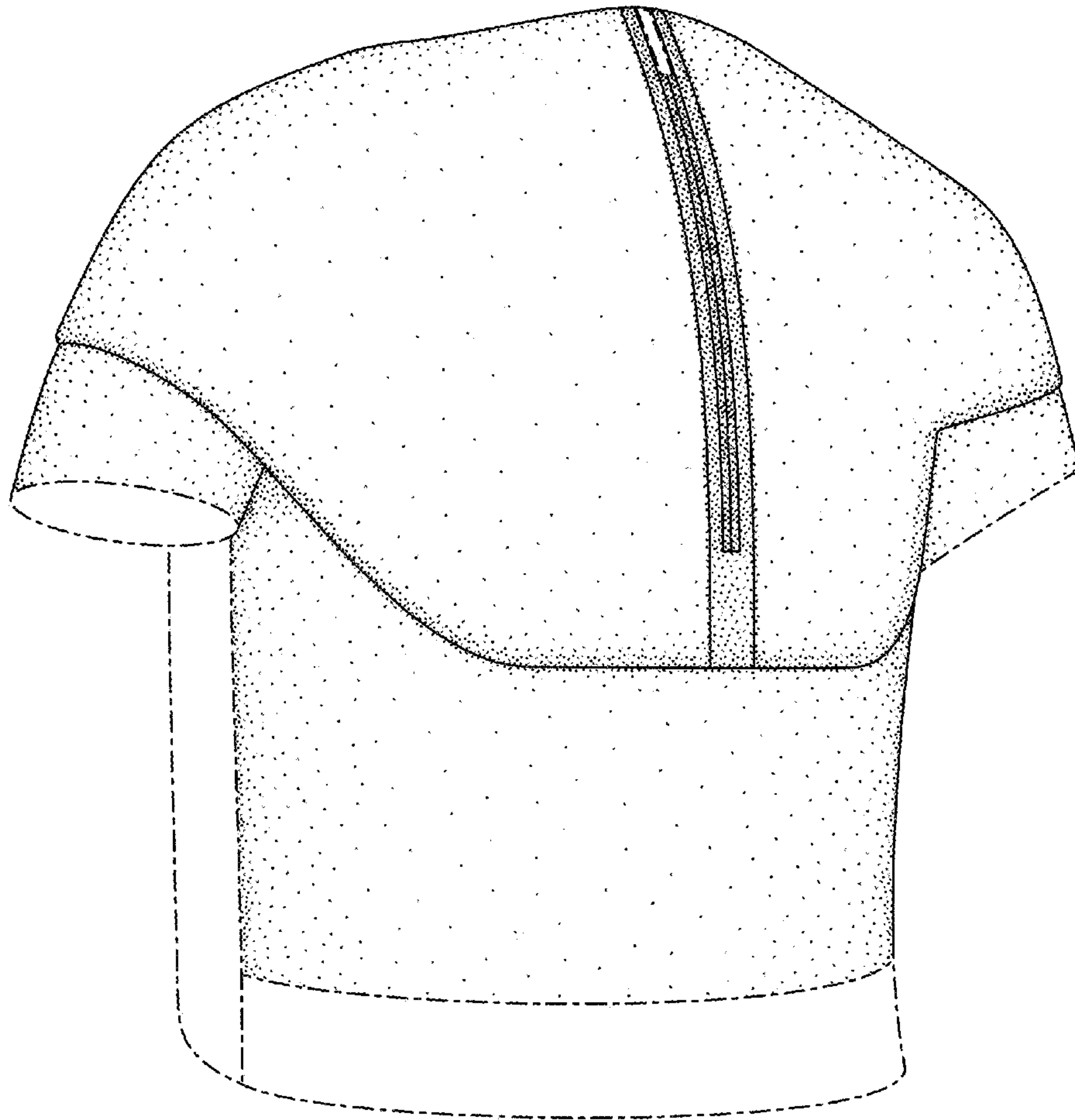

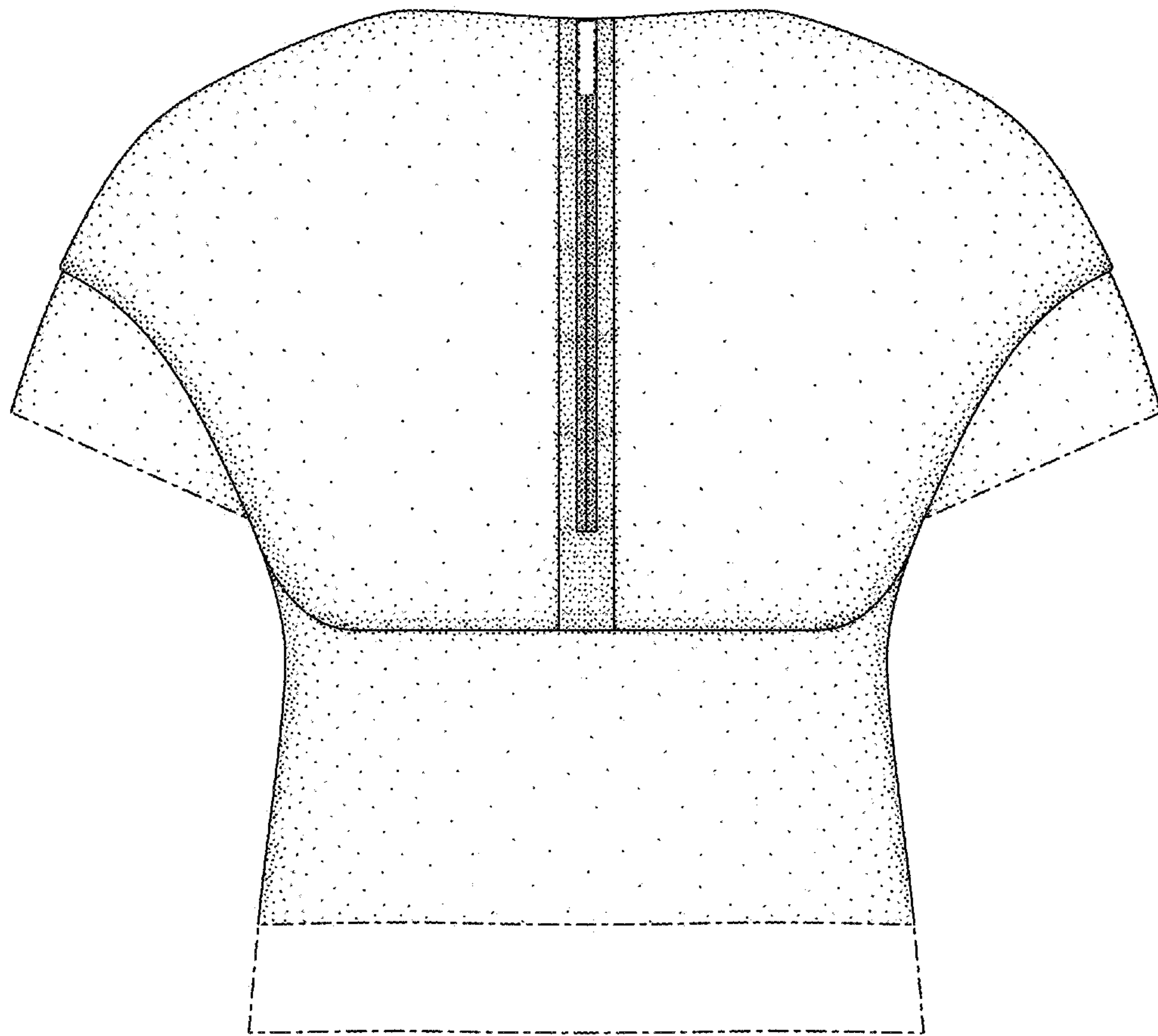

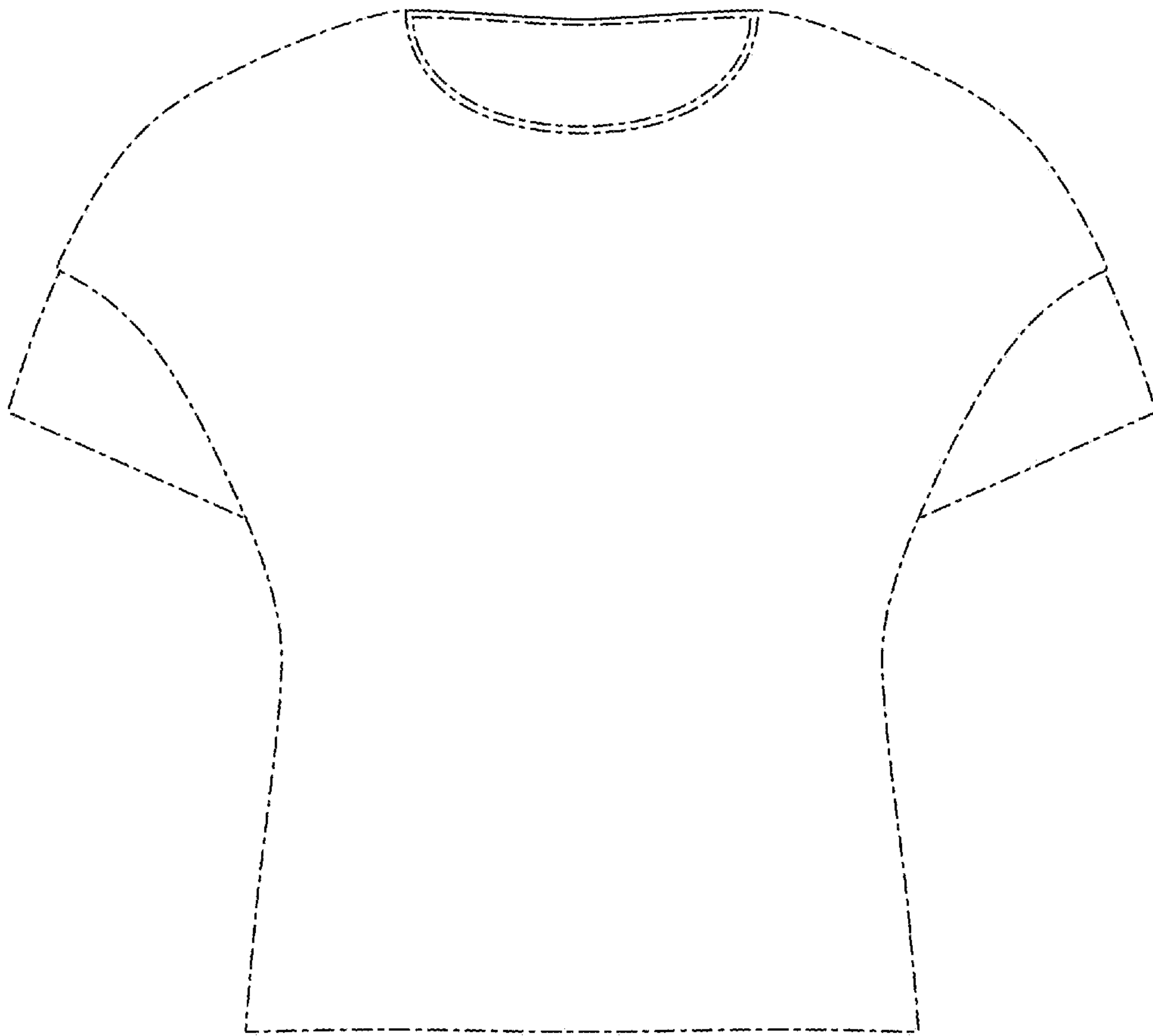

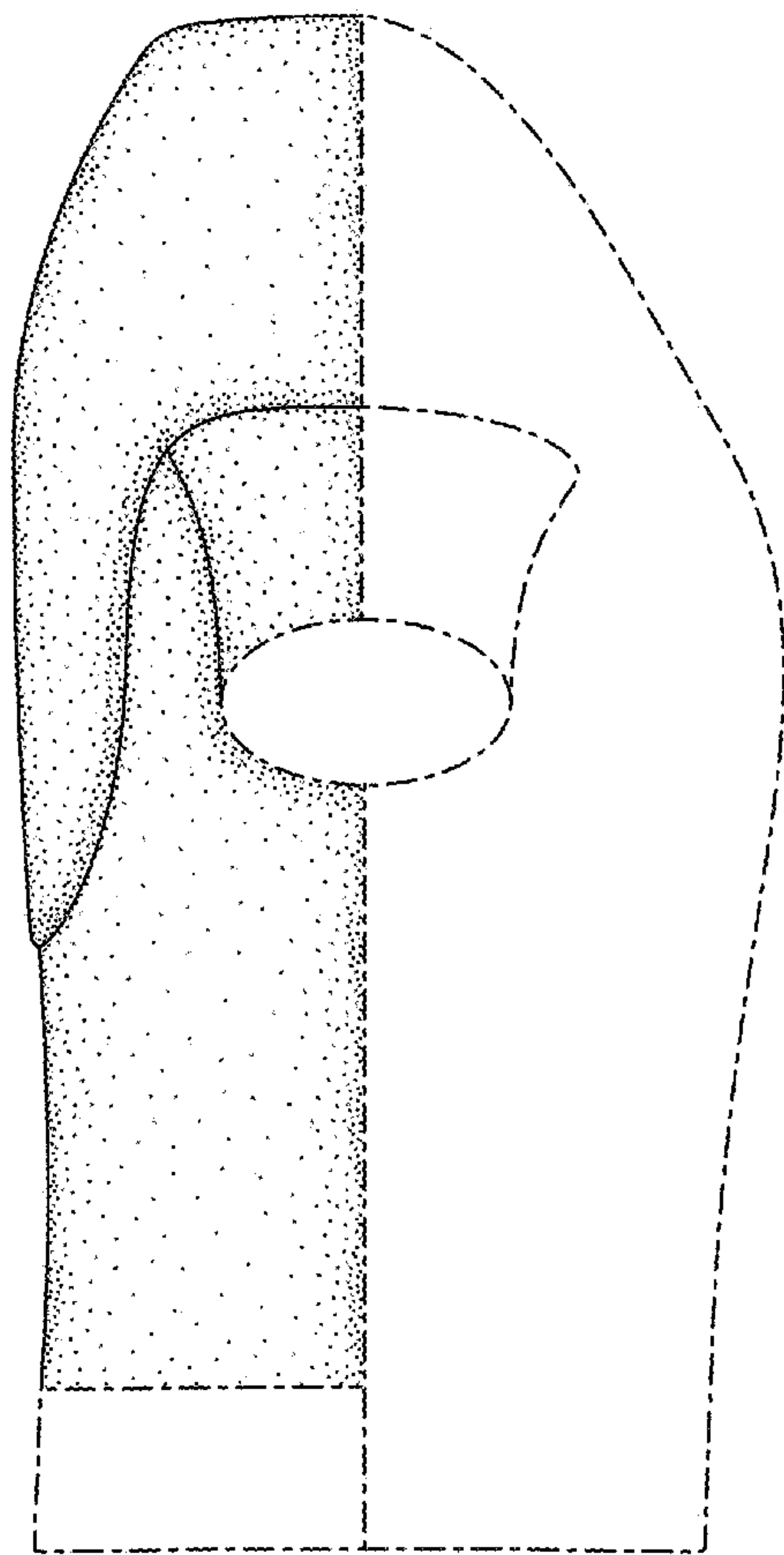

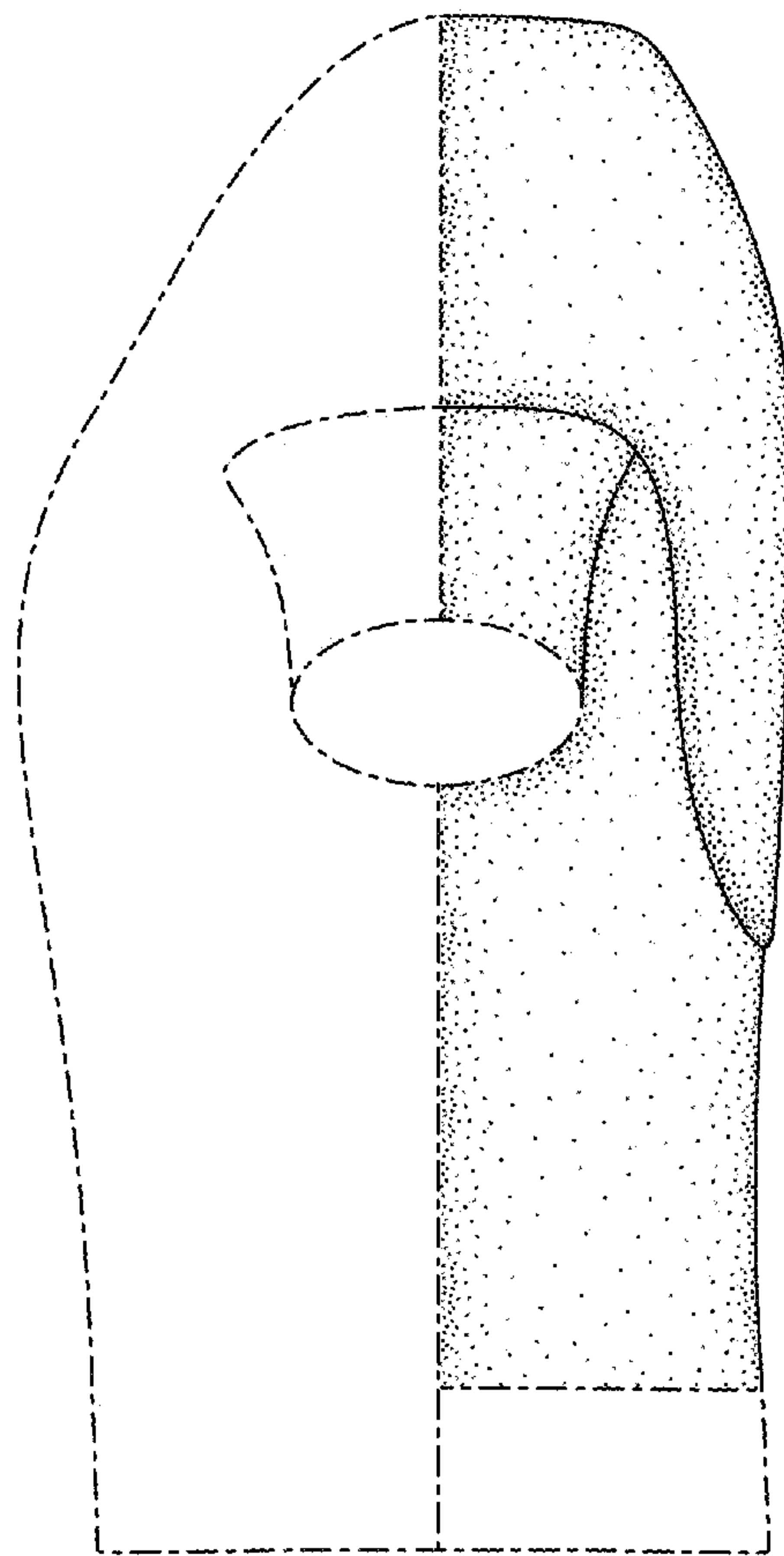

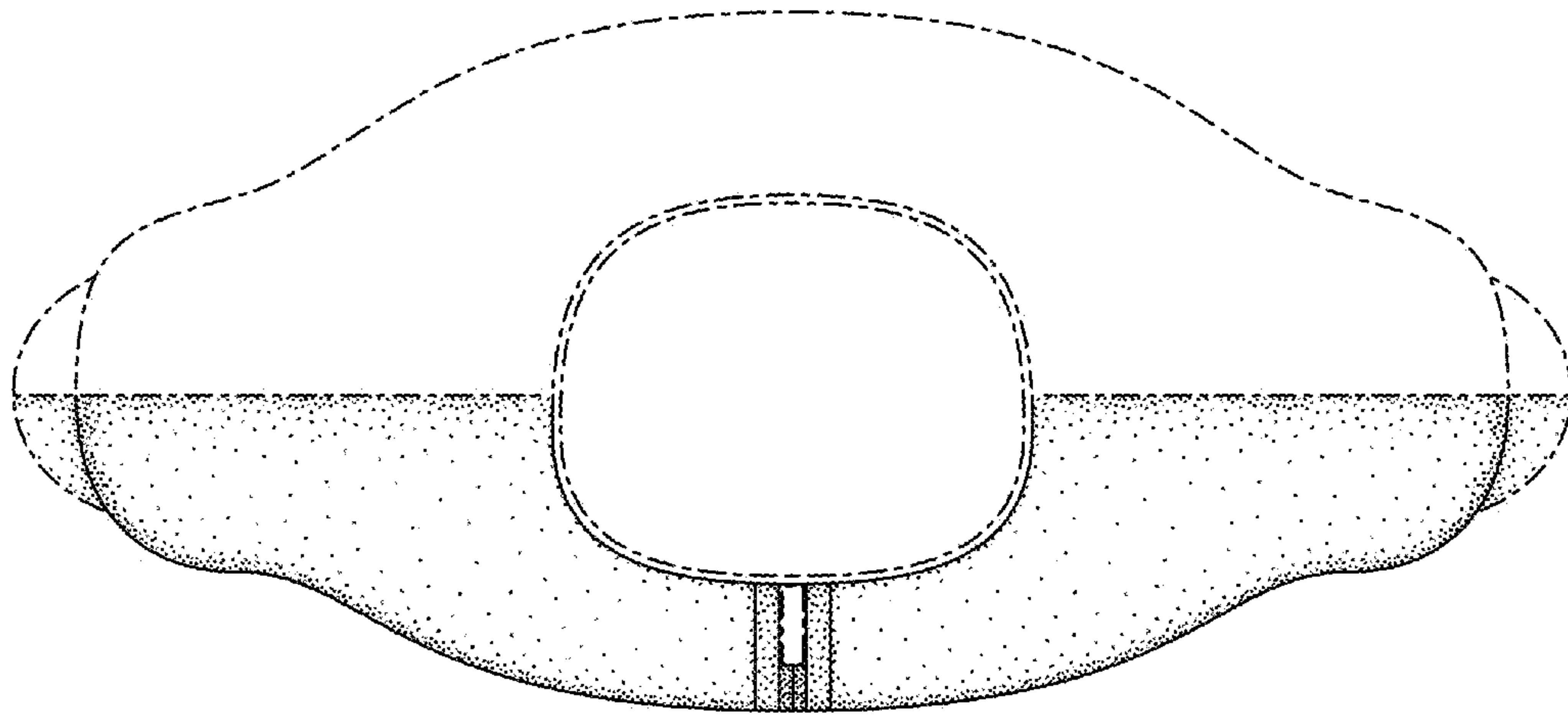

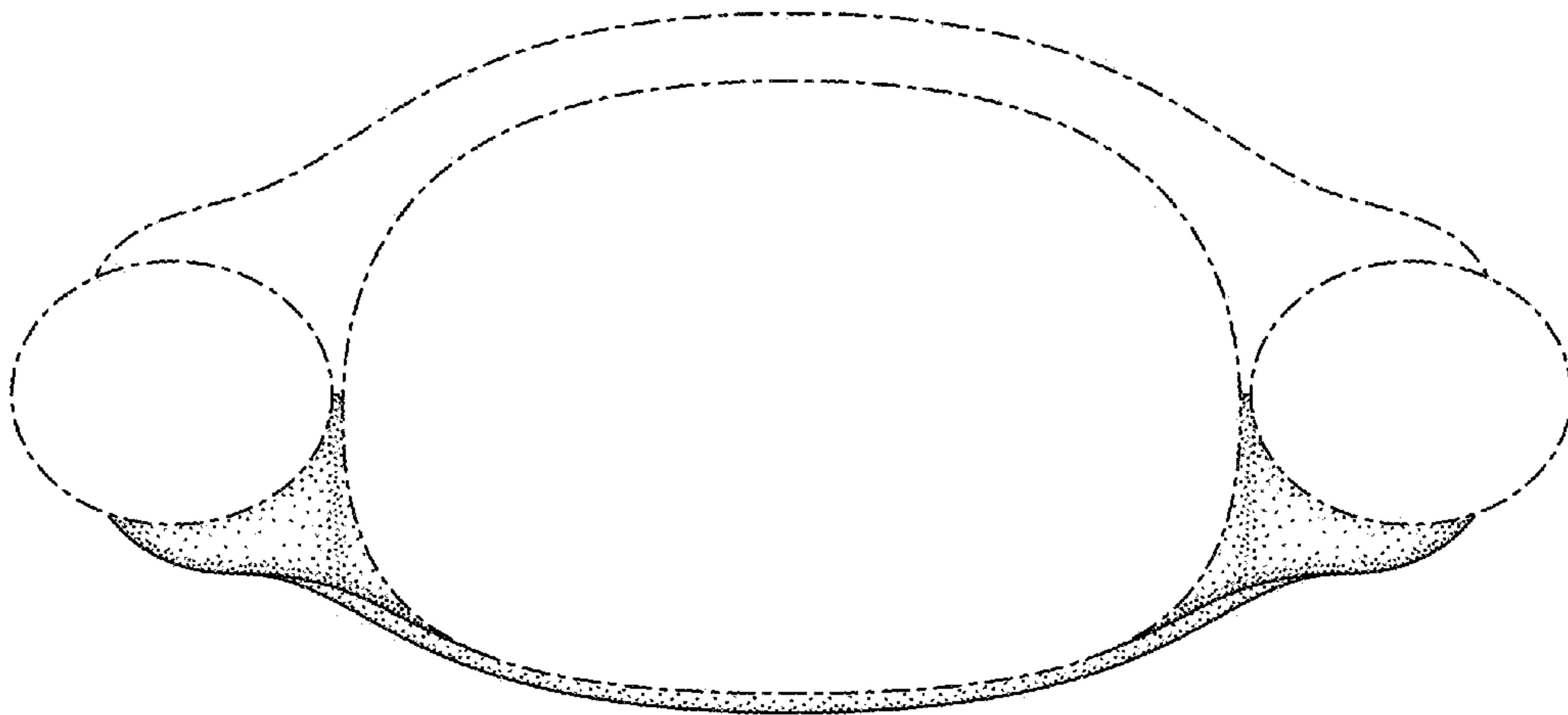
