 I claim the ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

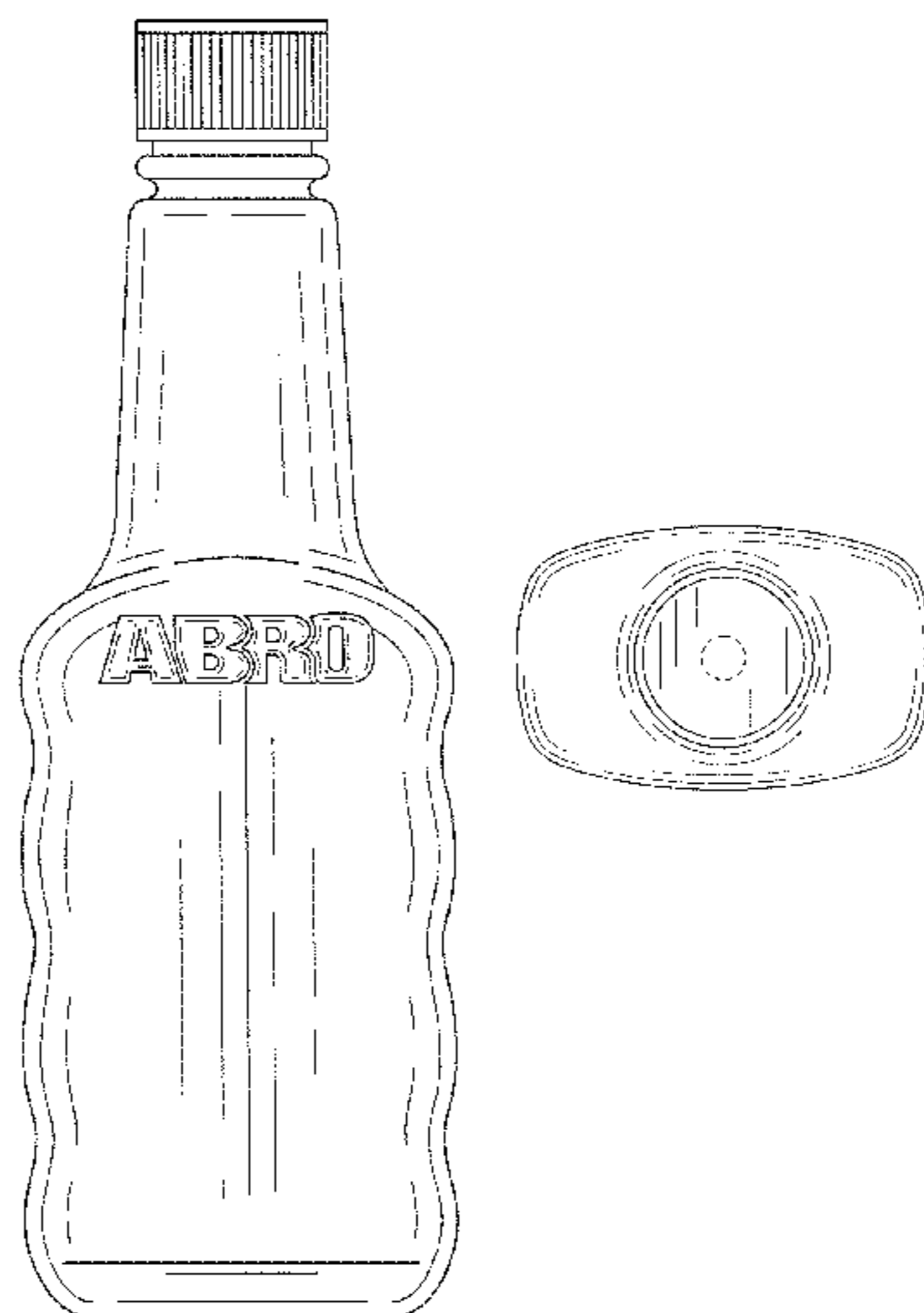
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ornamental design of a bottle according to the present invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the bottle depicted in FIG. 1, with the rear being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the bottle depicted in FIG. 1, with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the bottle depicted in FIG. 1.
 The broken lines in the drawings illustrate the portions of the bottle that form no part of the claim.
 The claimed design includes subject matter contained in U.S. trademark registration no. 4,883,288, owned by ABRO Industries, Inc.

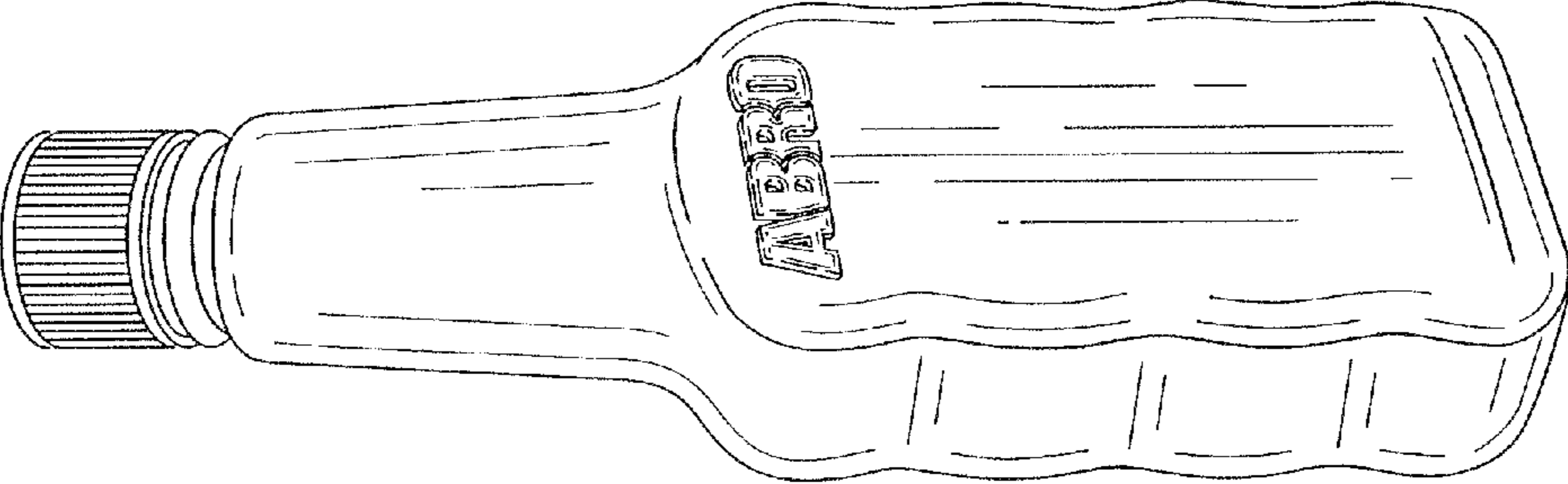

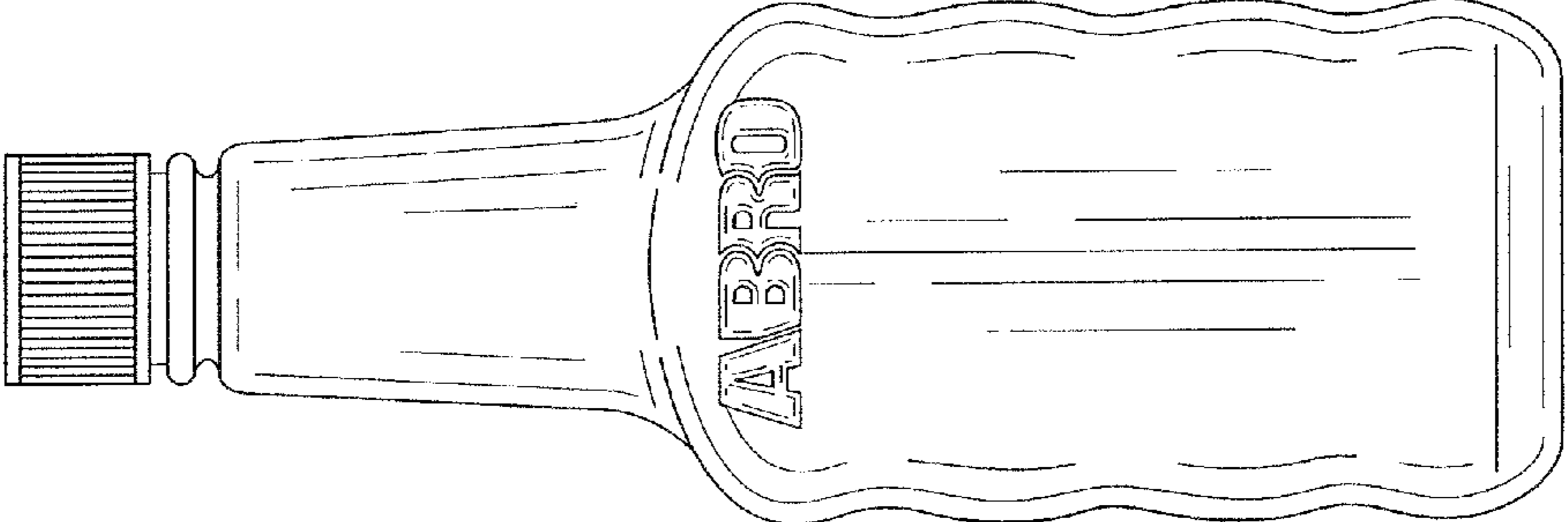

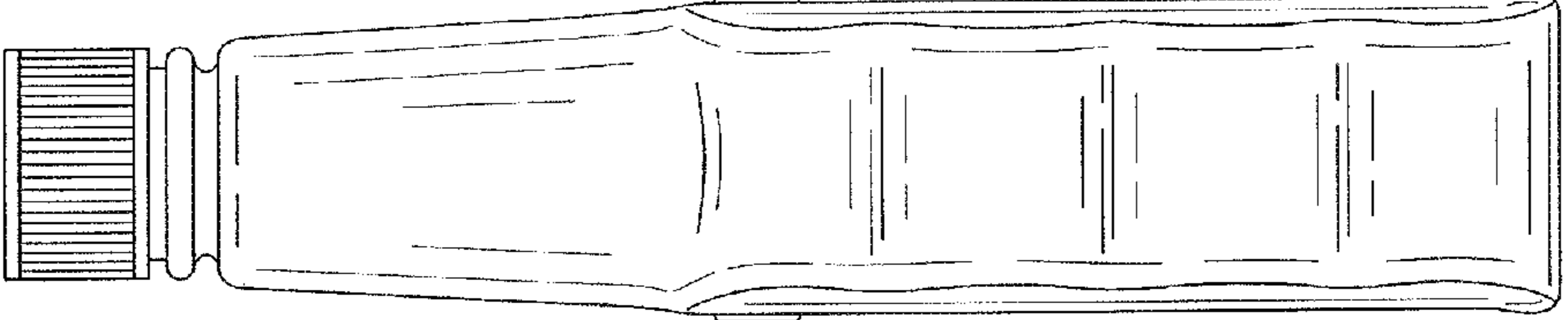

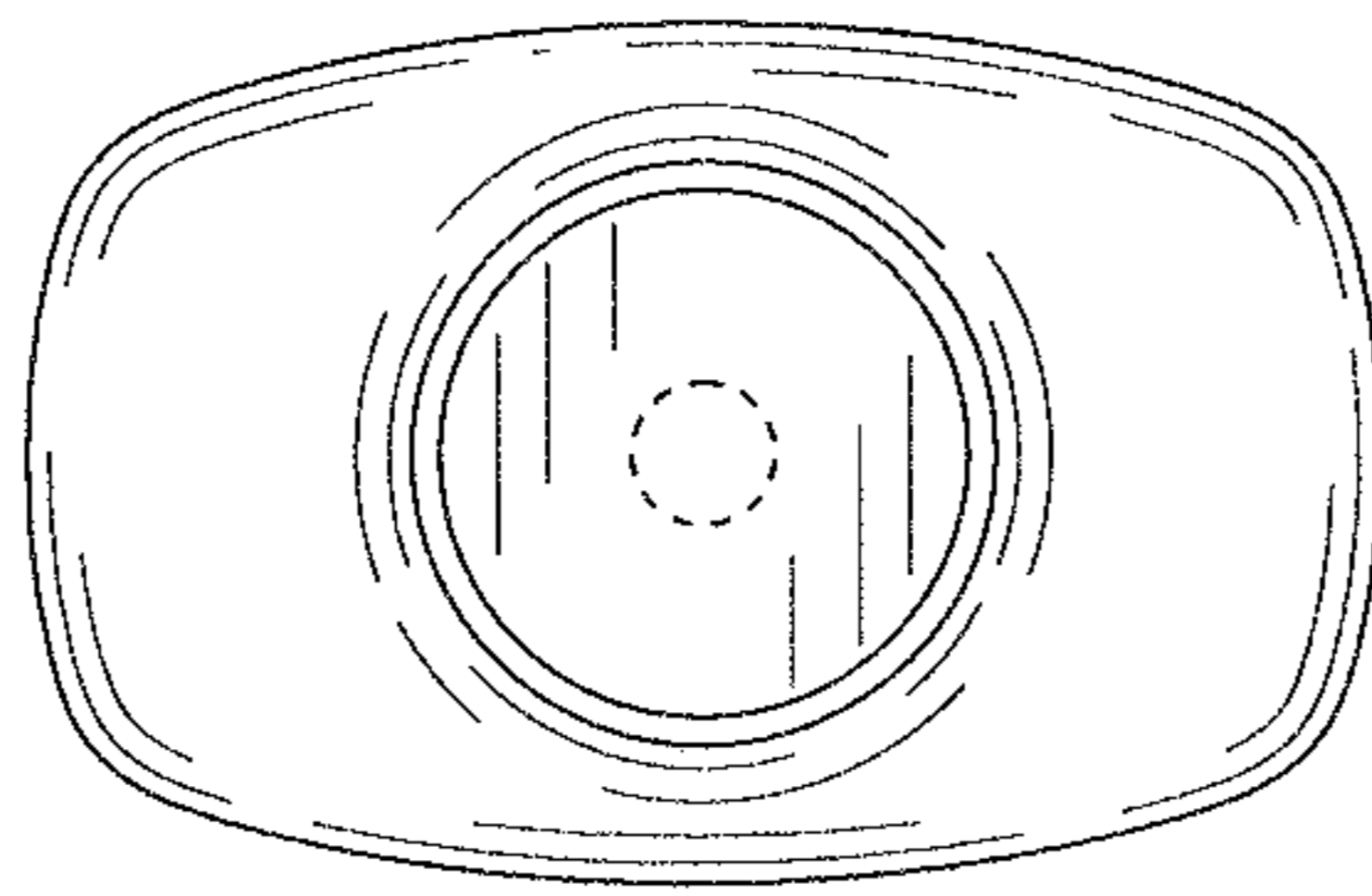
