The ornamental design for a mobile phone case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mobile phone case showing our new design;

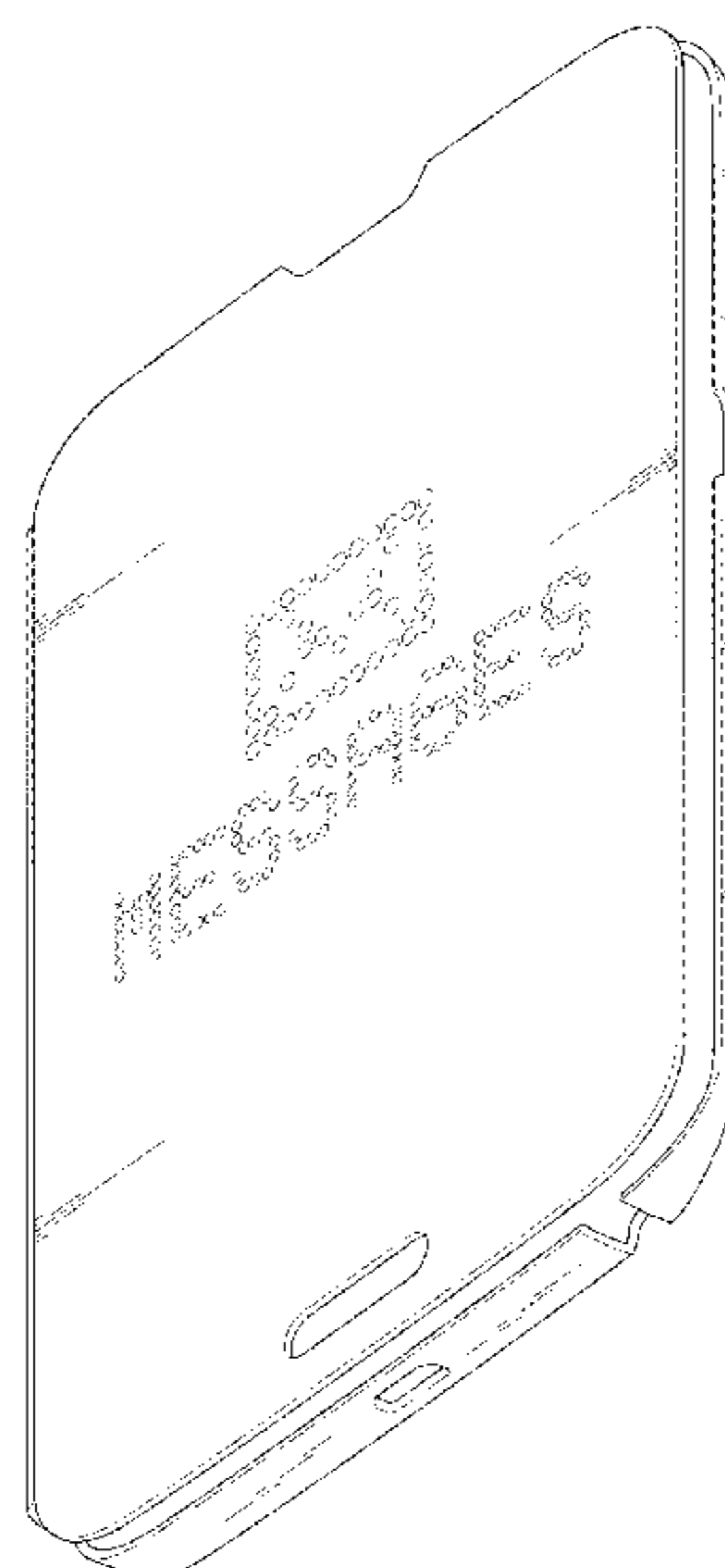
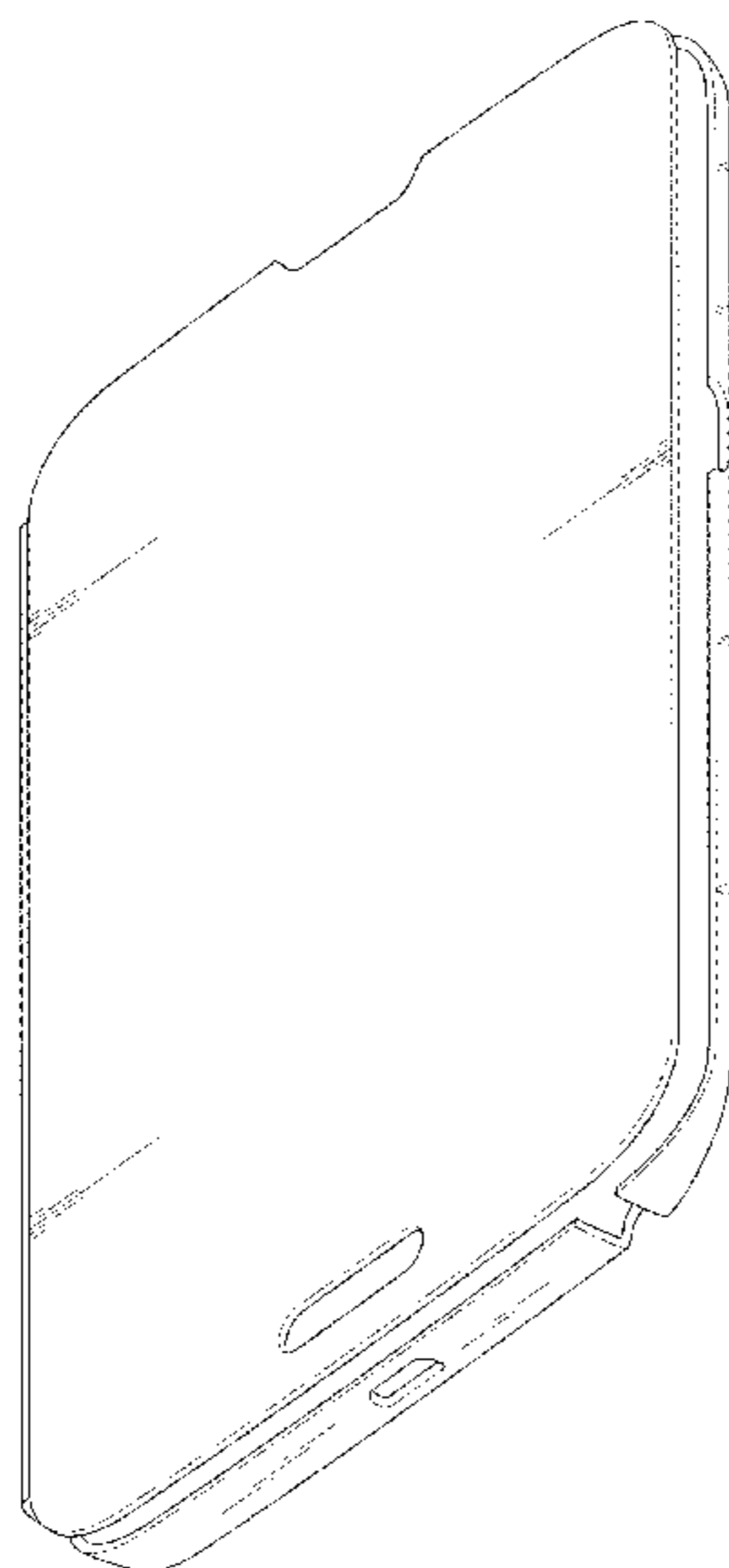

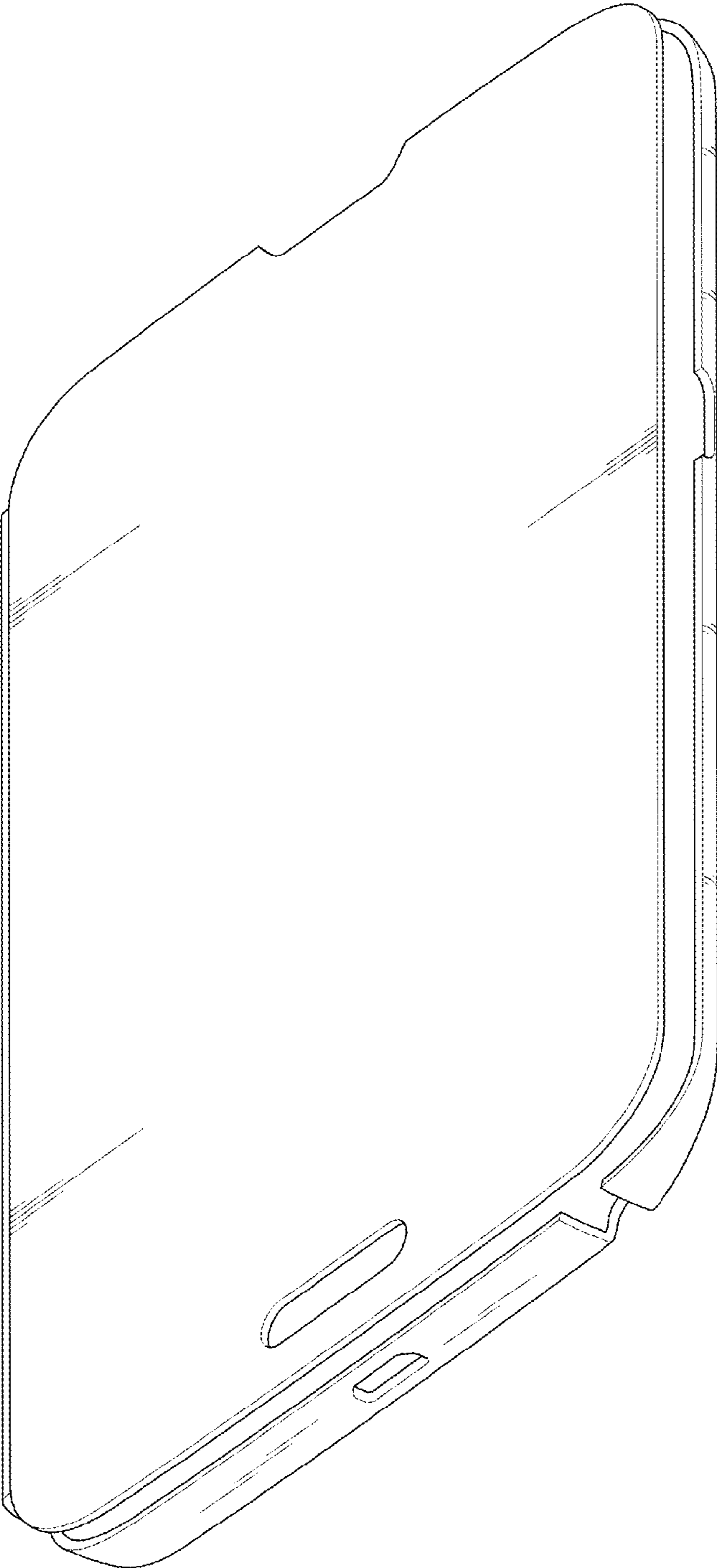

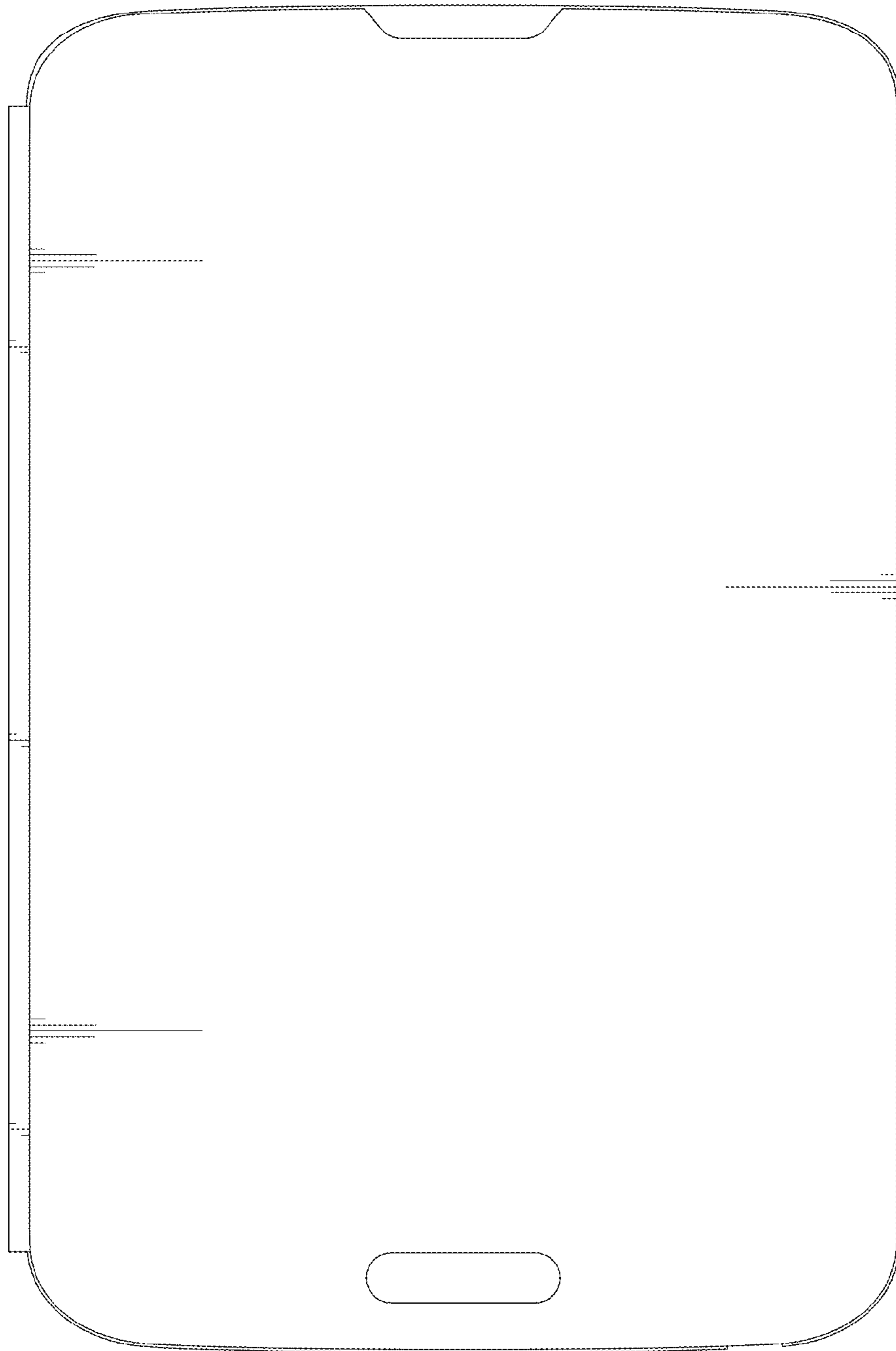

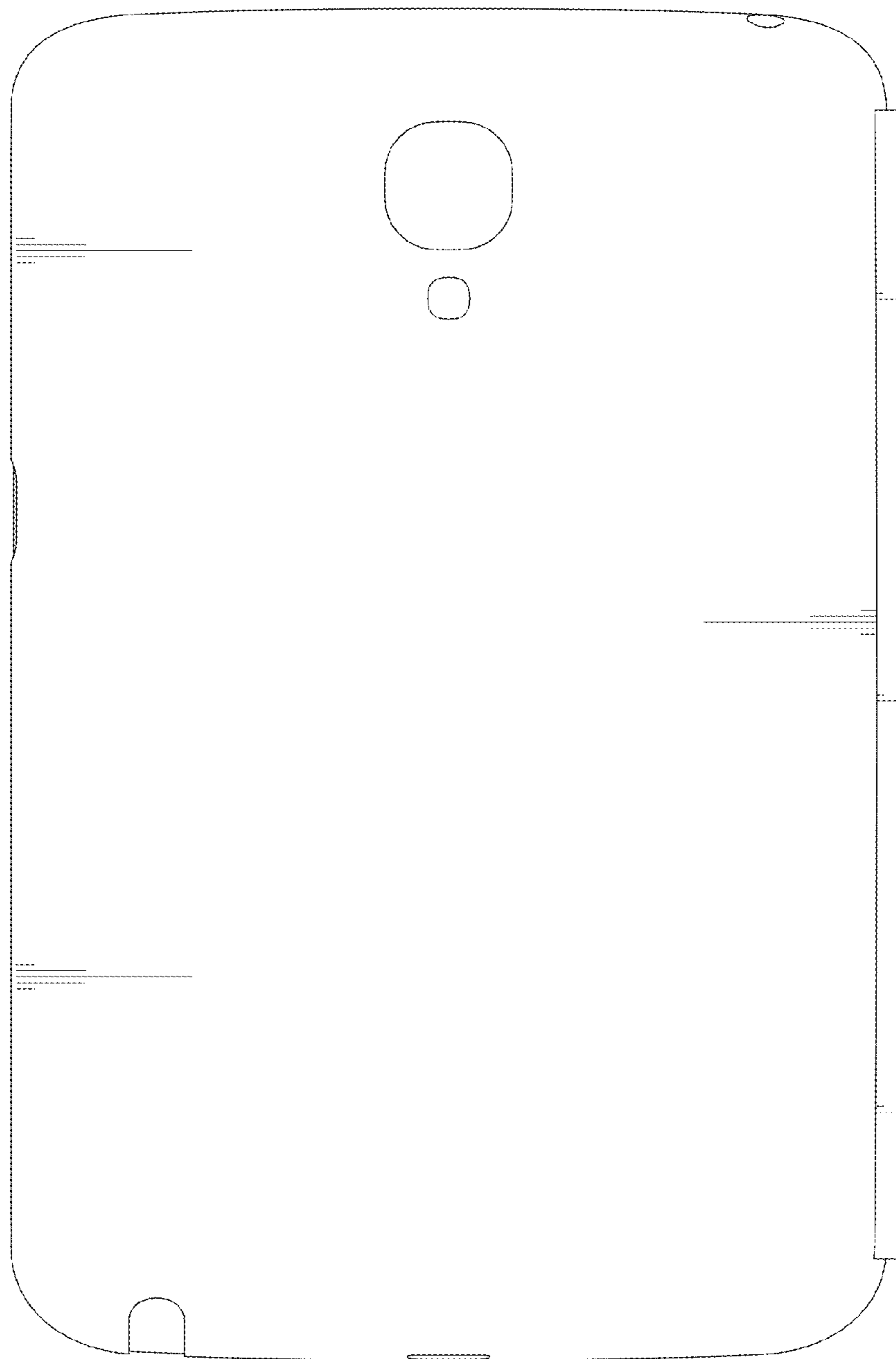

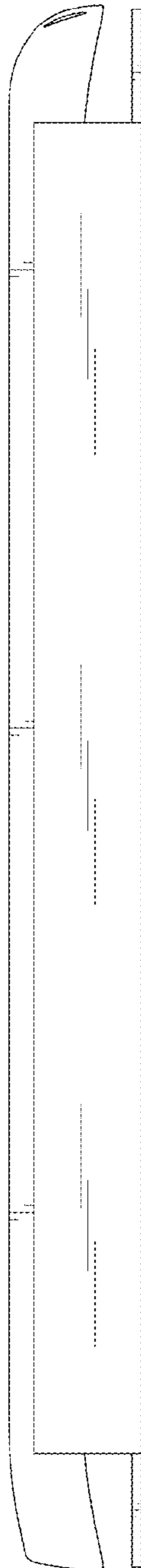

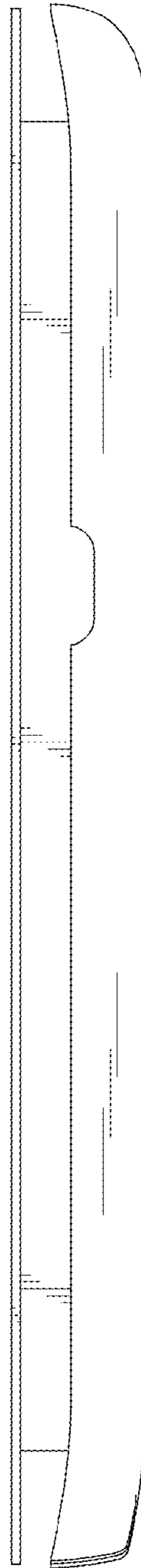

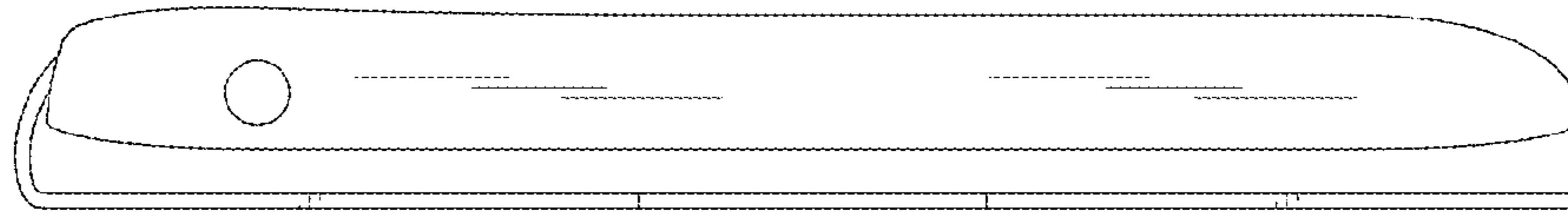

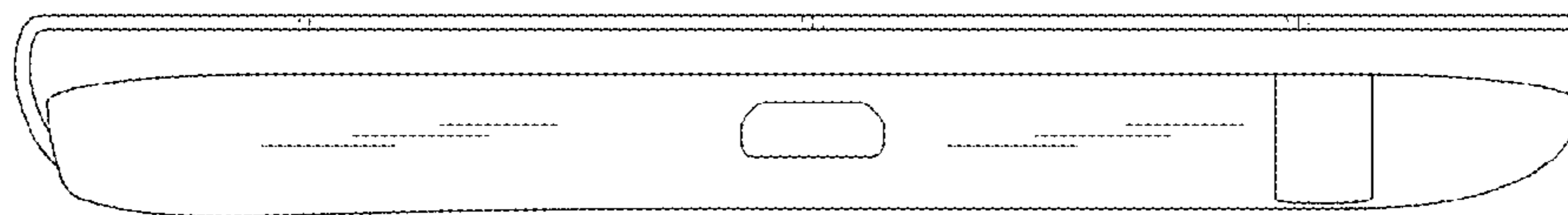

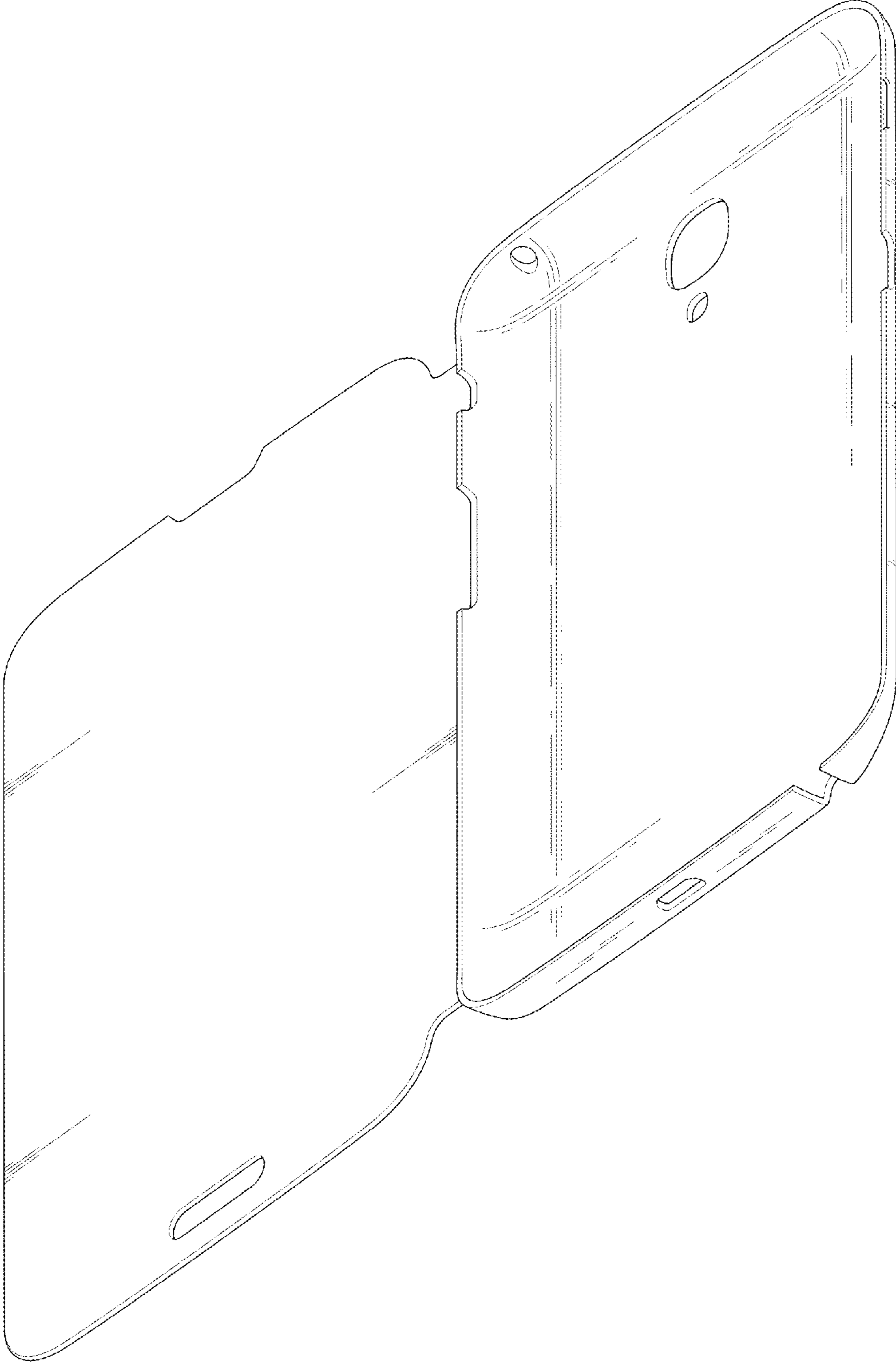
