FIG. 1 is a perspective view of our new design for hearing aid charger housing;

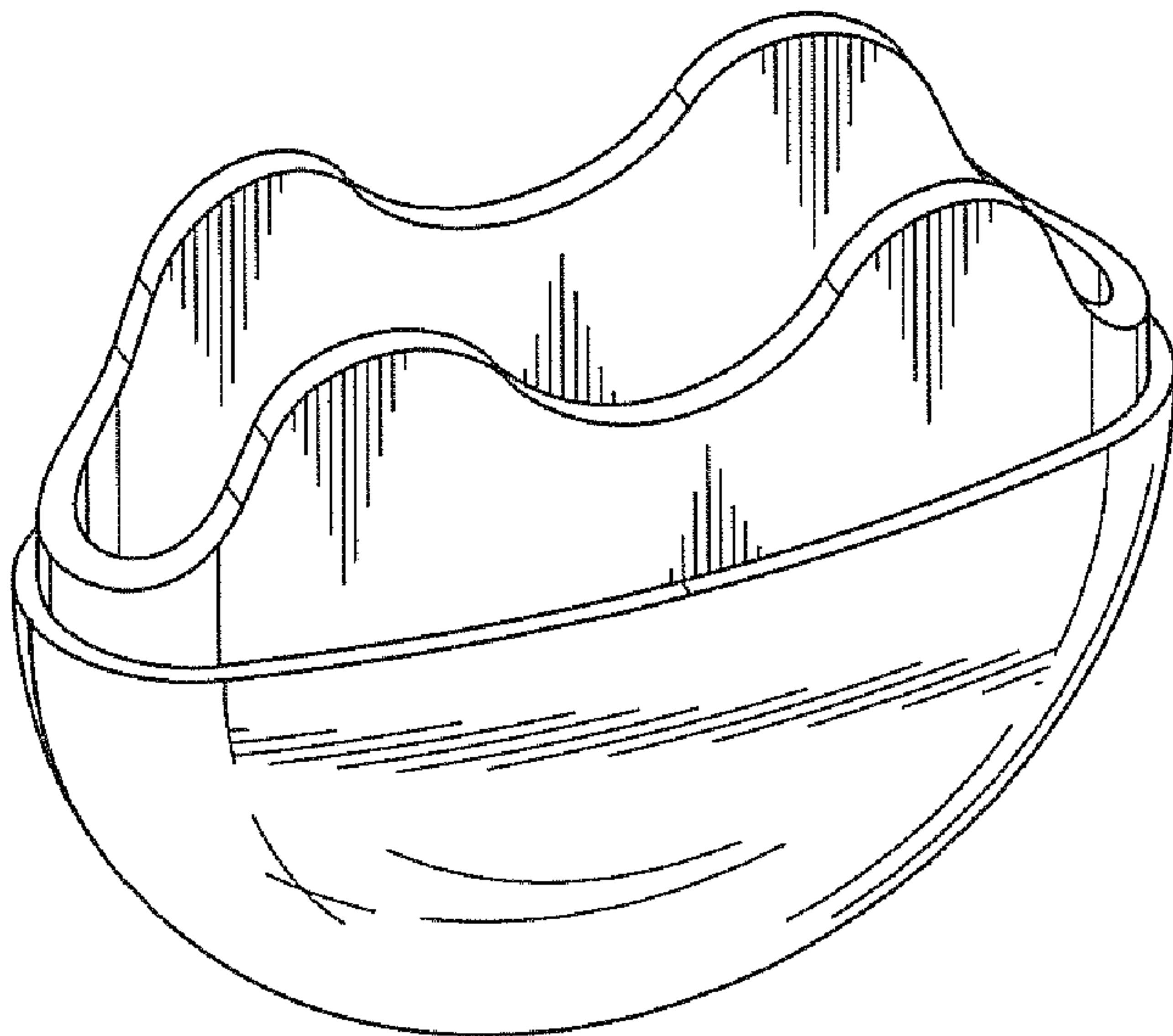
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; the rear elevational view thereof being identical to said front elevational view;

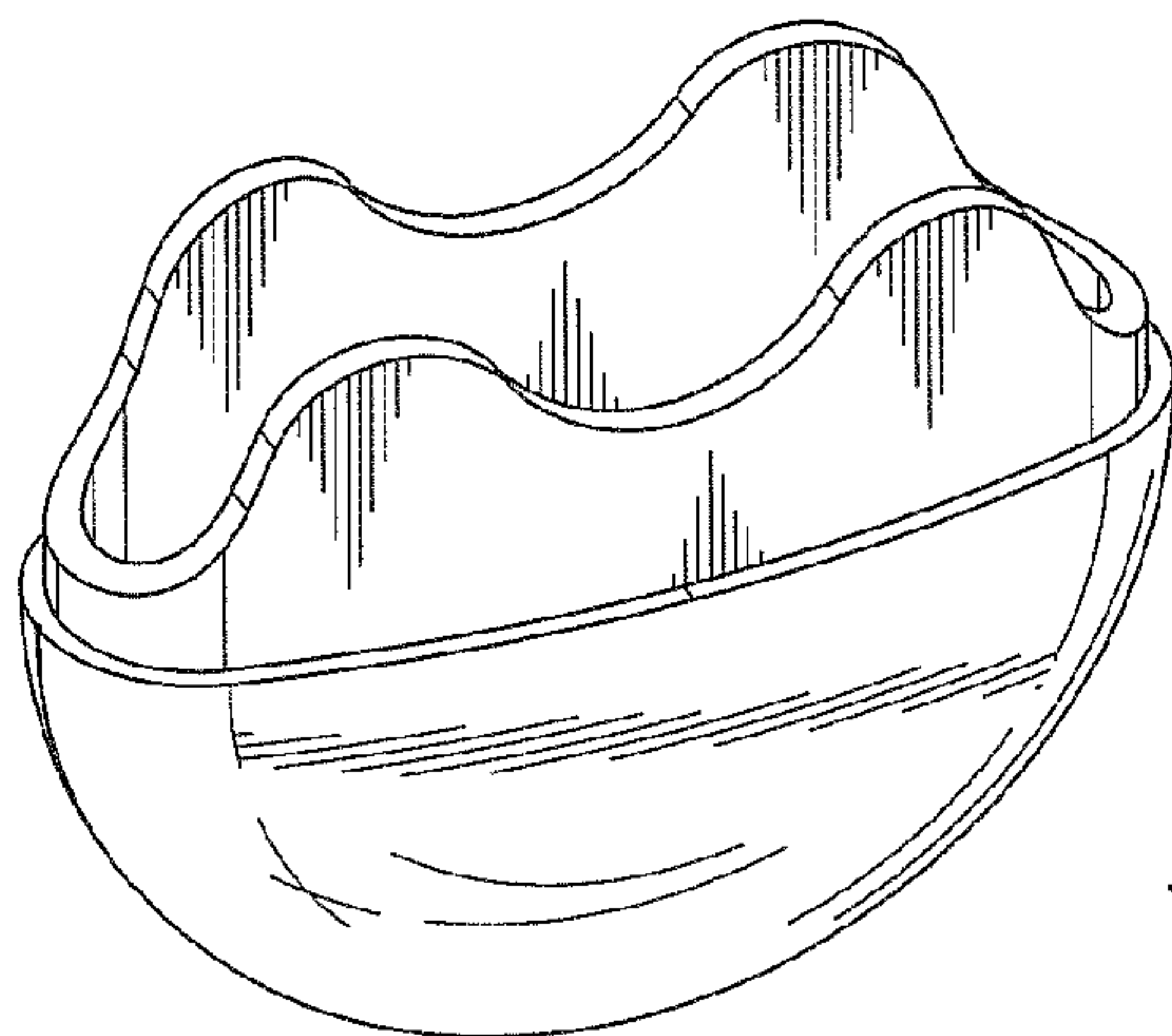

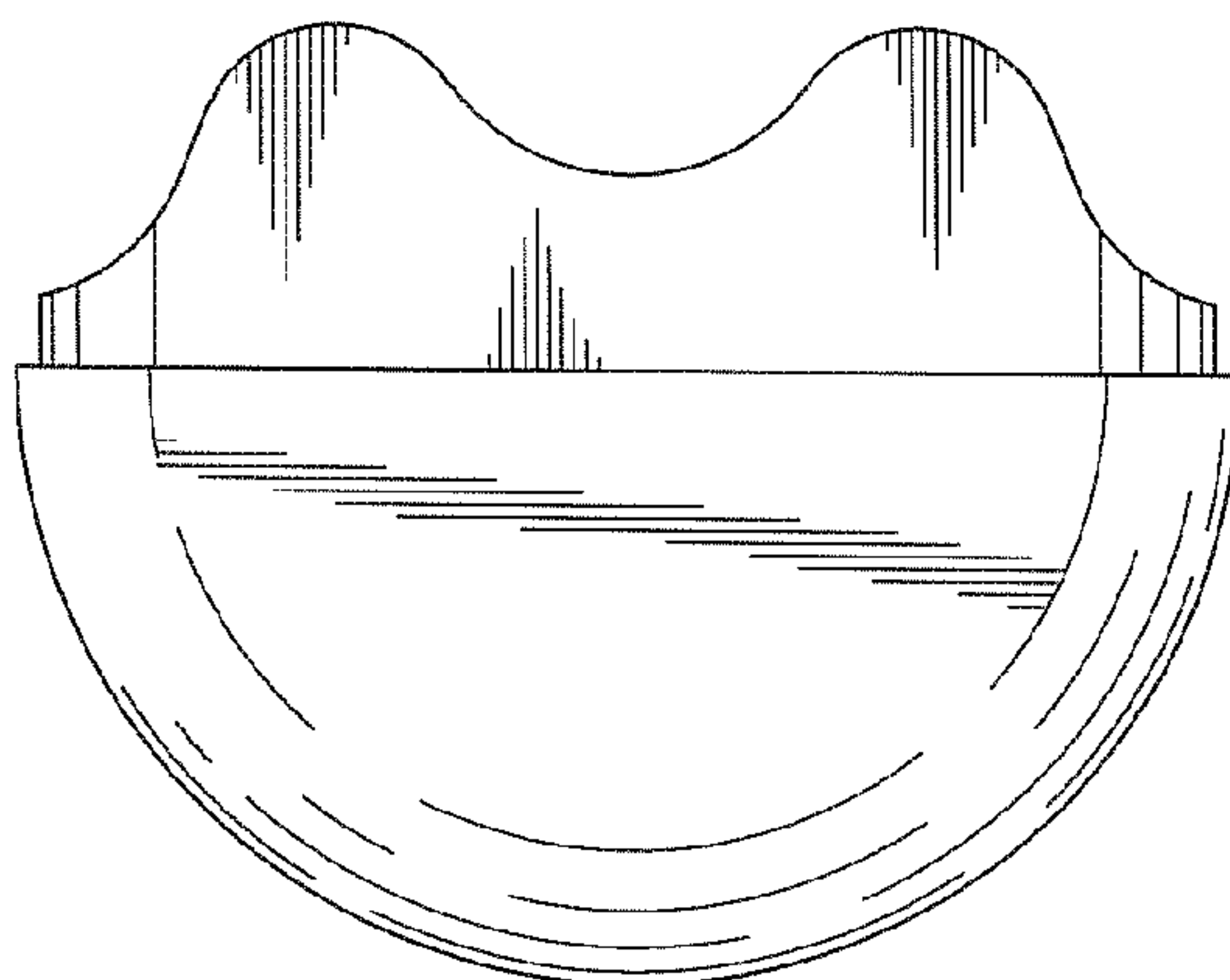

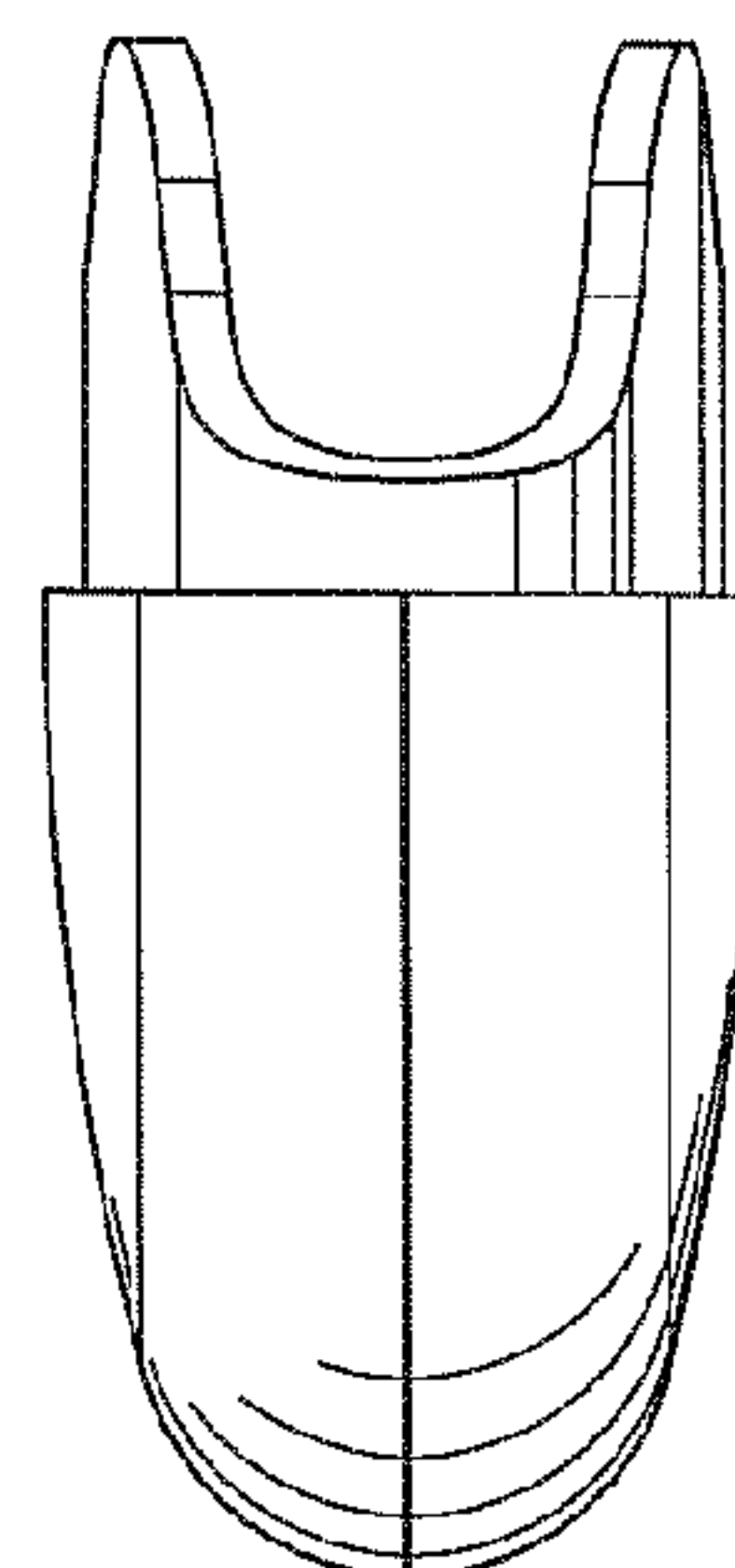

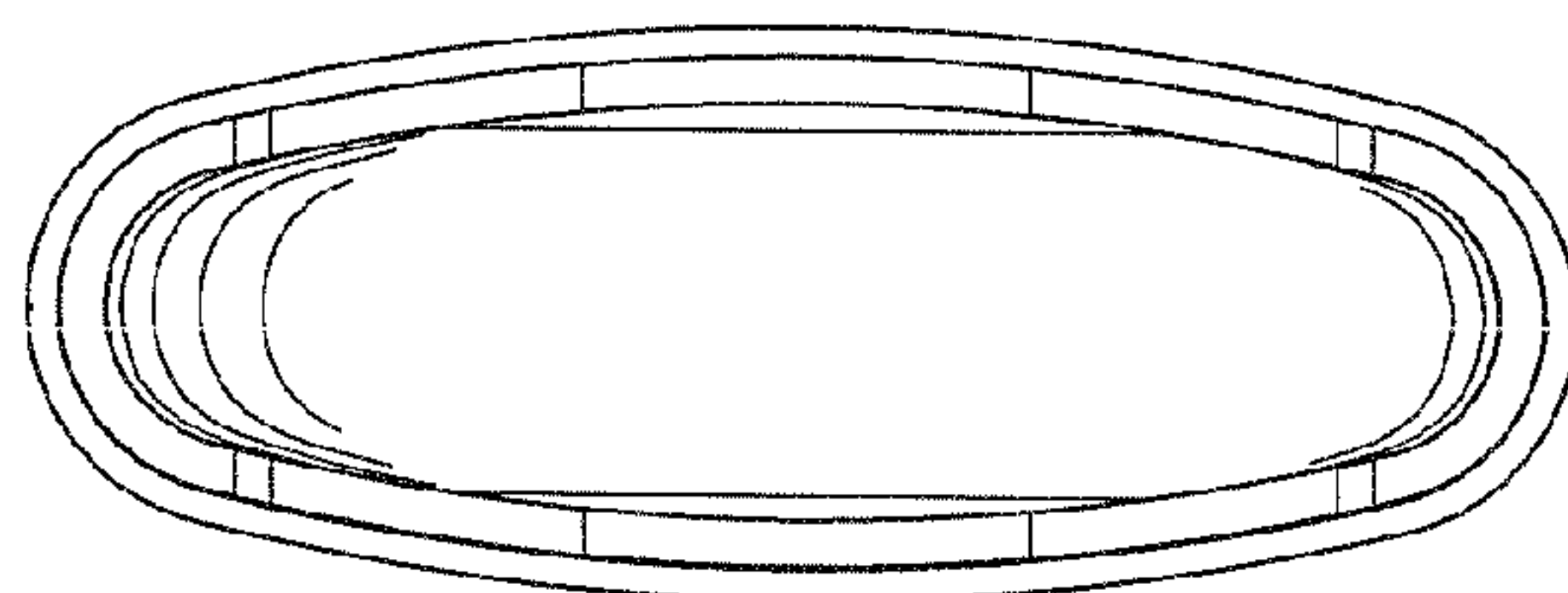

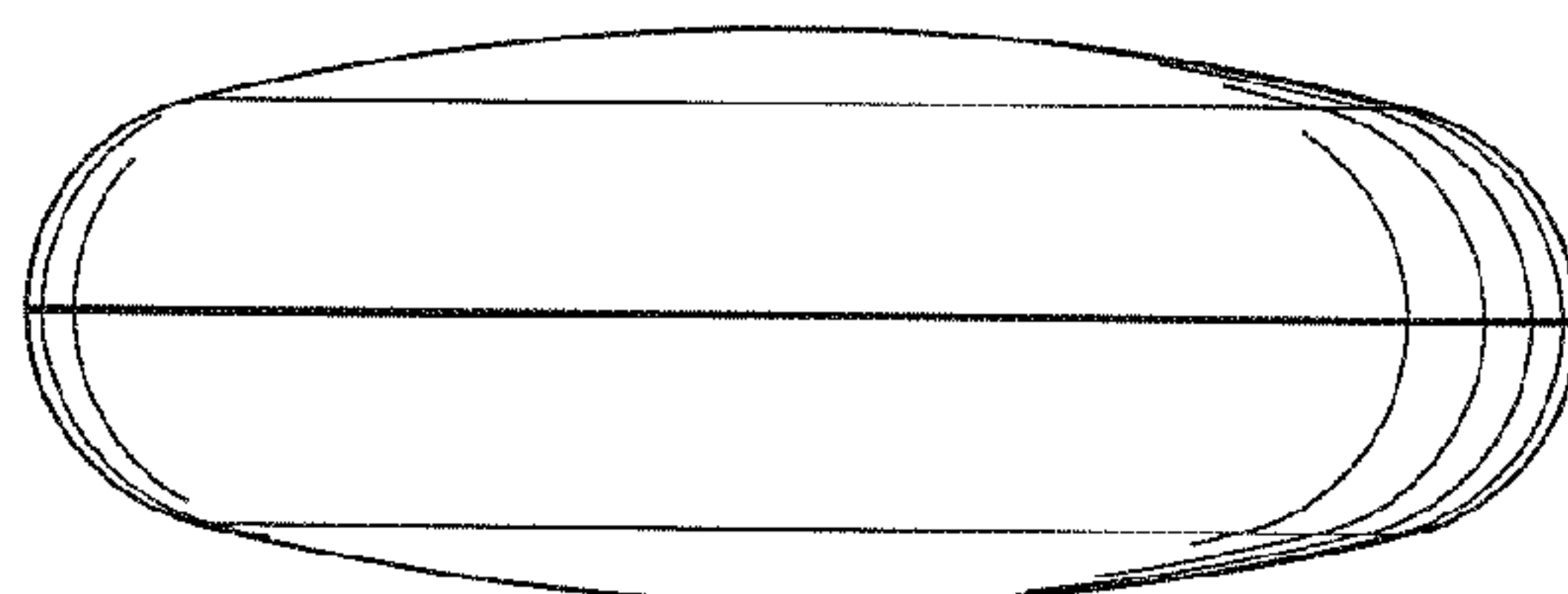
