The novel ornamental design for a rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle in accordance with the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

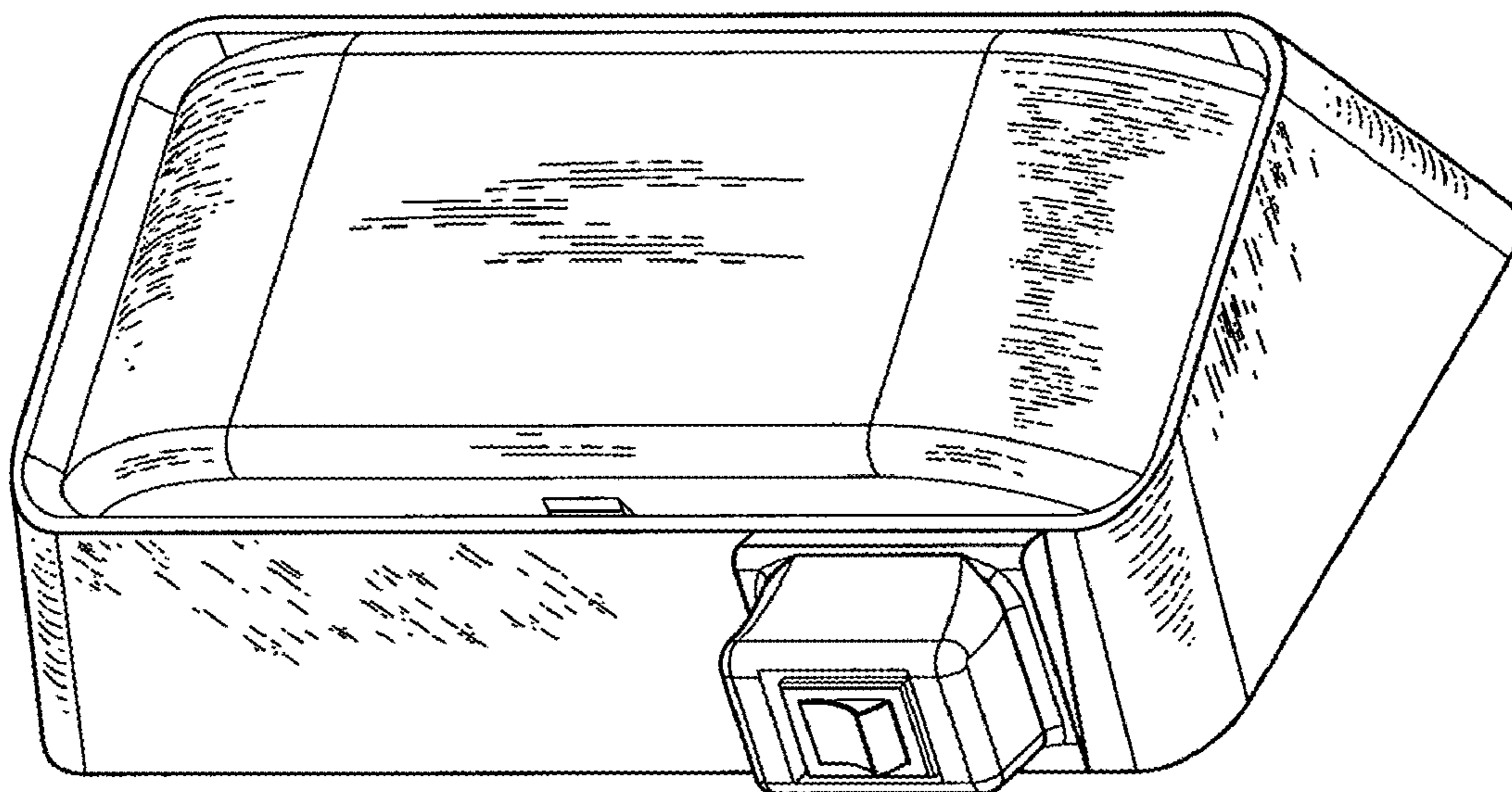
FIG. 7 is a back view of the rectangular light with switch assembly for a recreational vehicle;

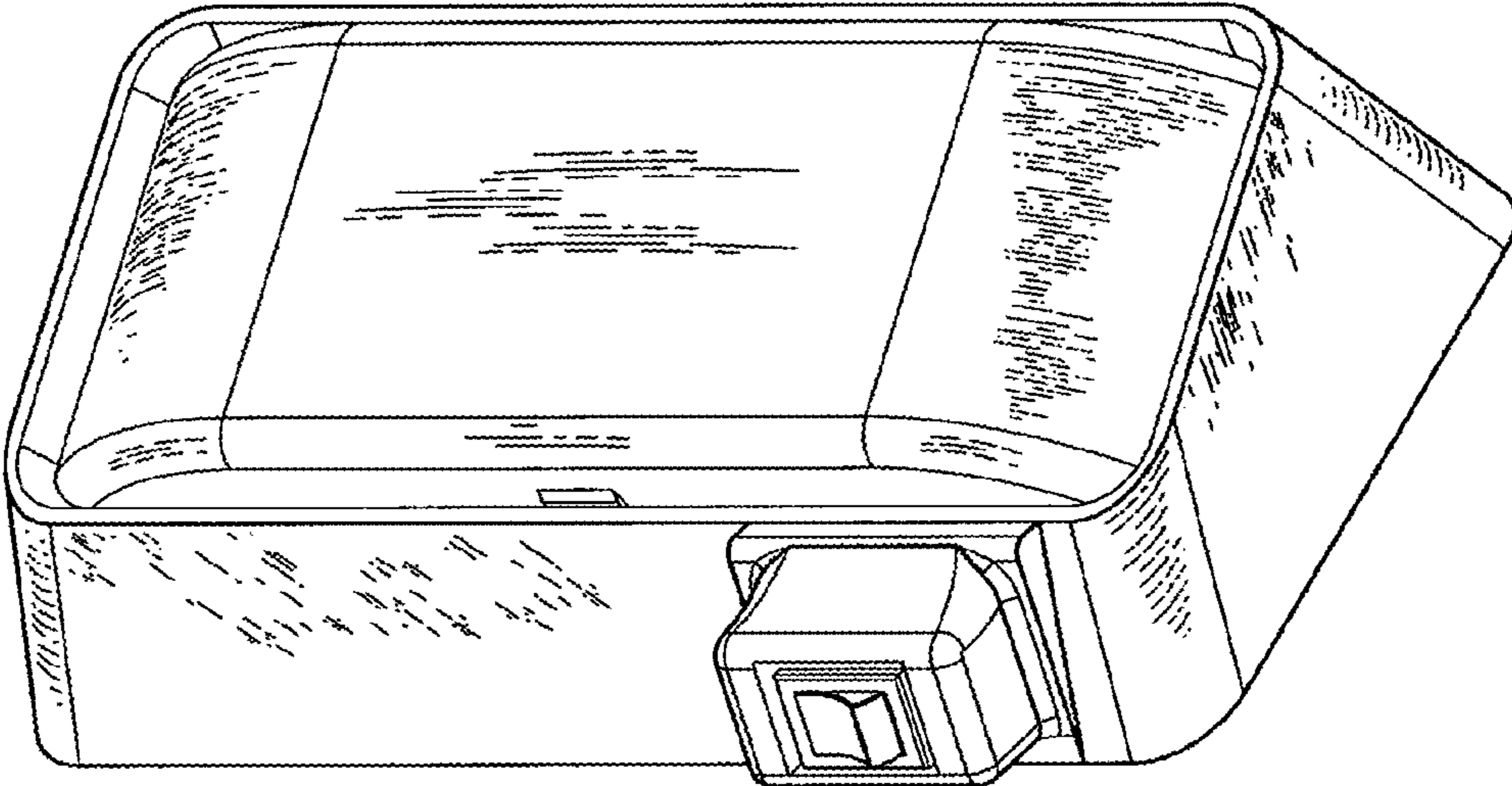

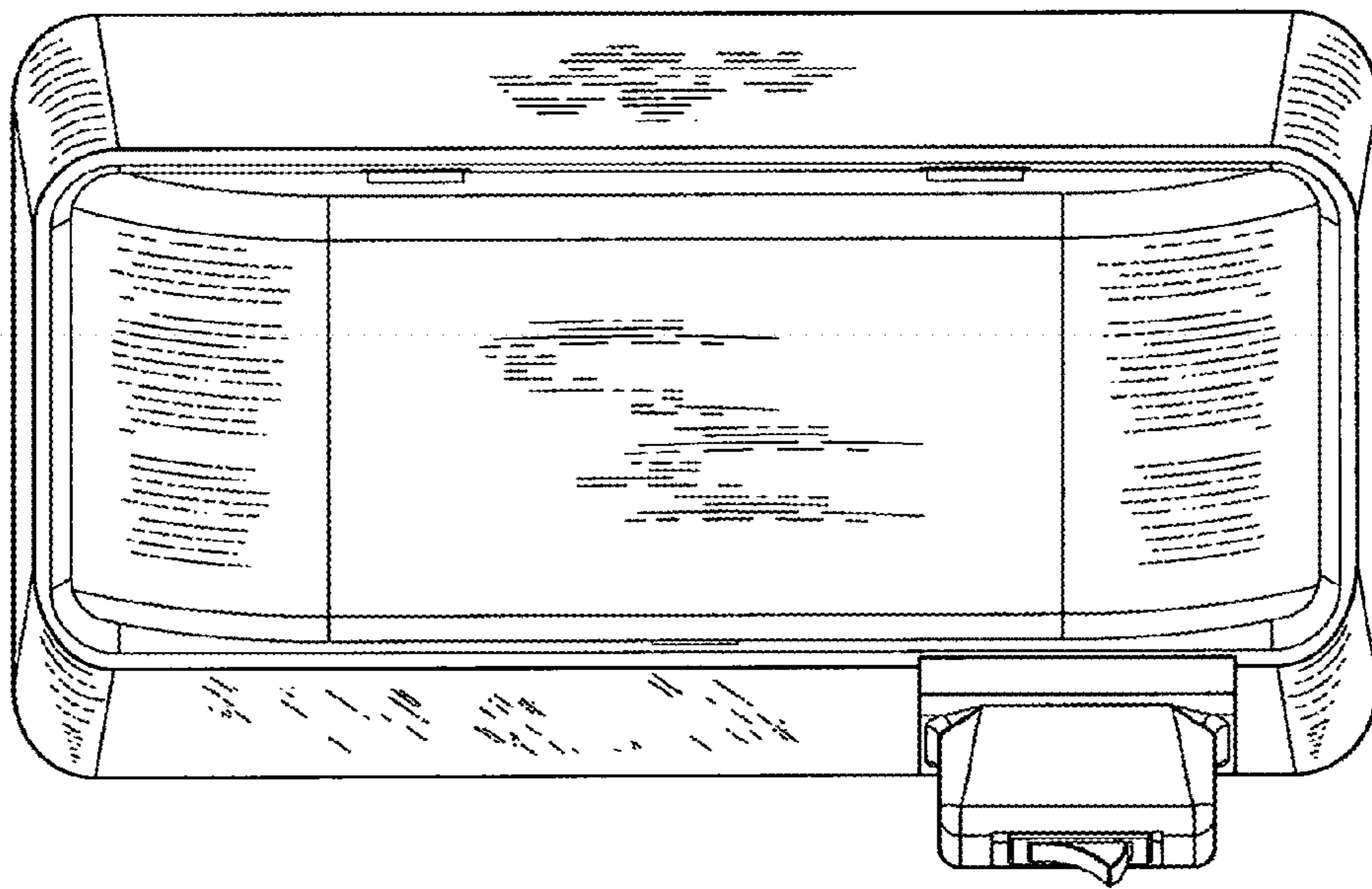

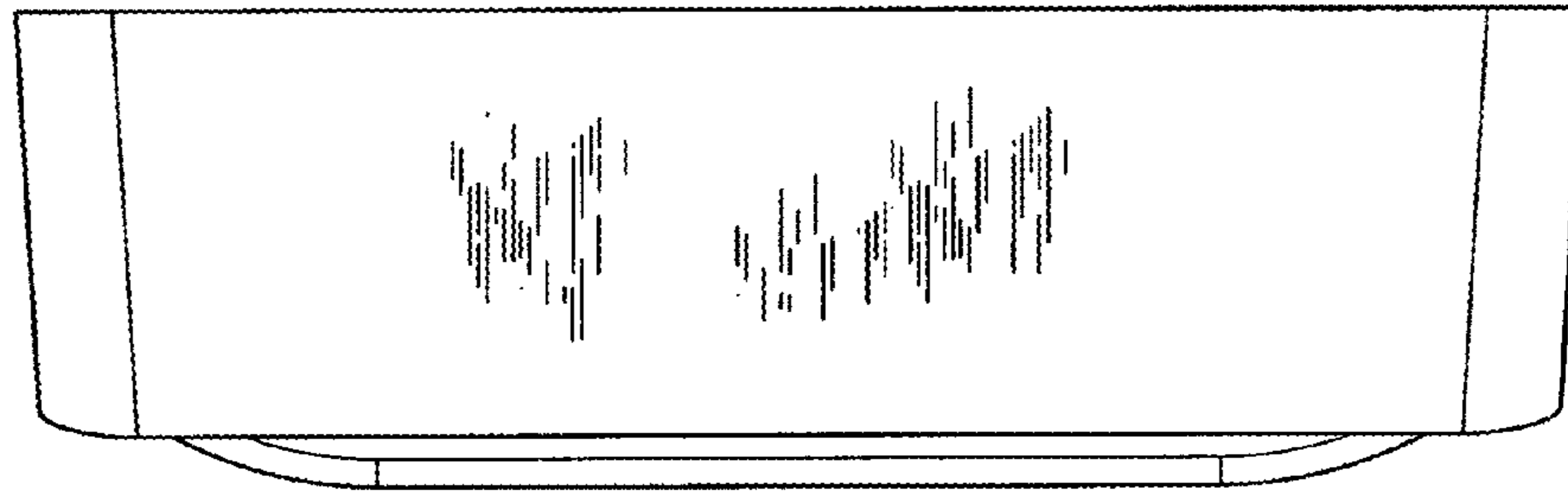

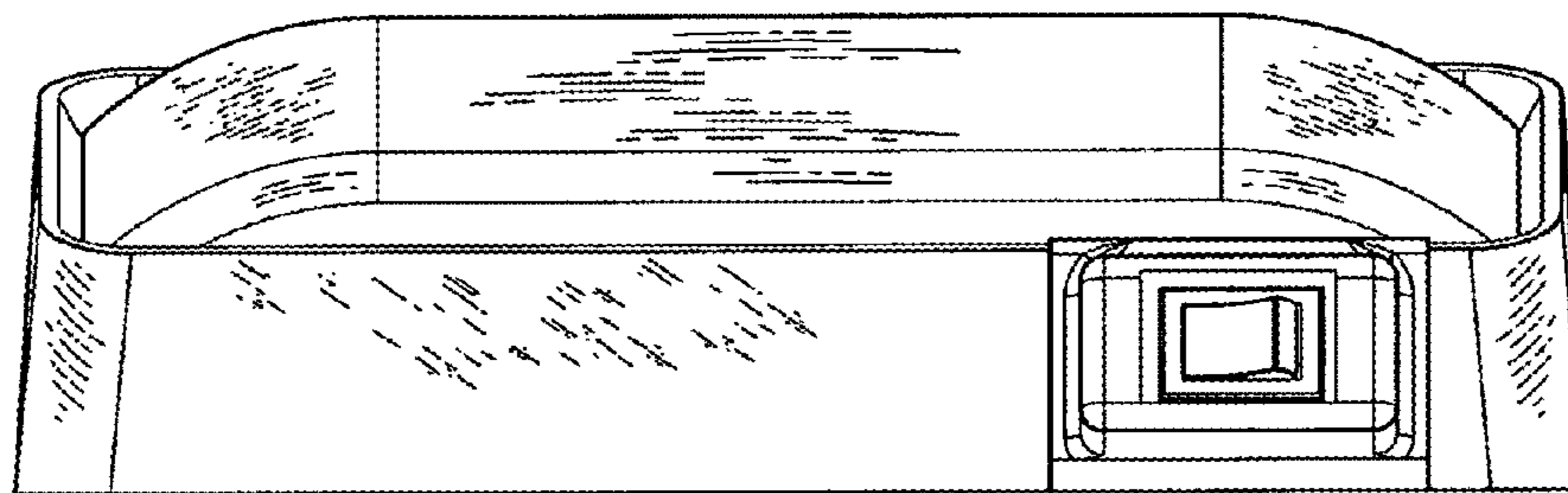

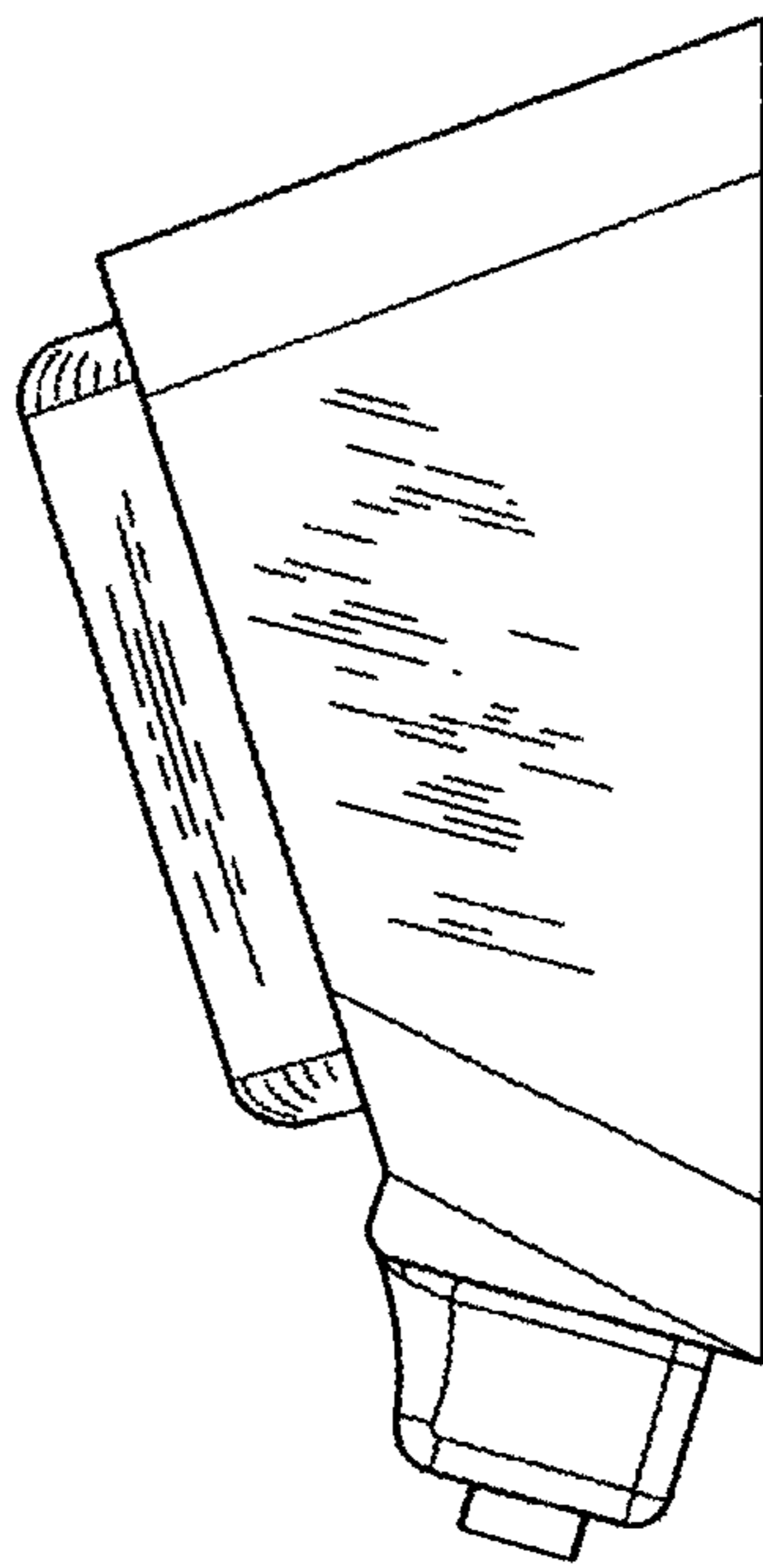

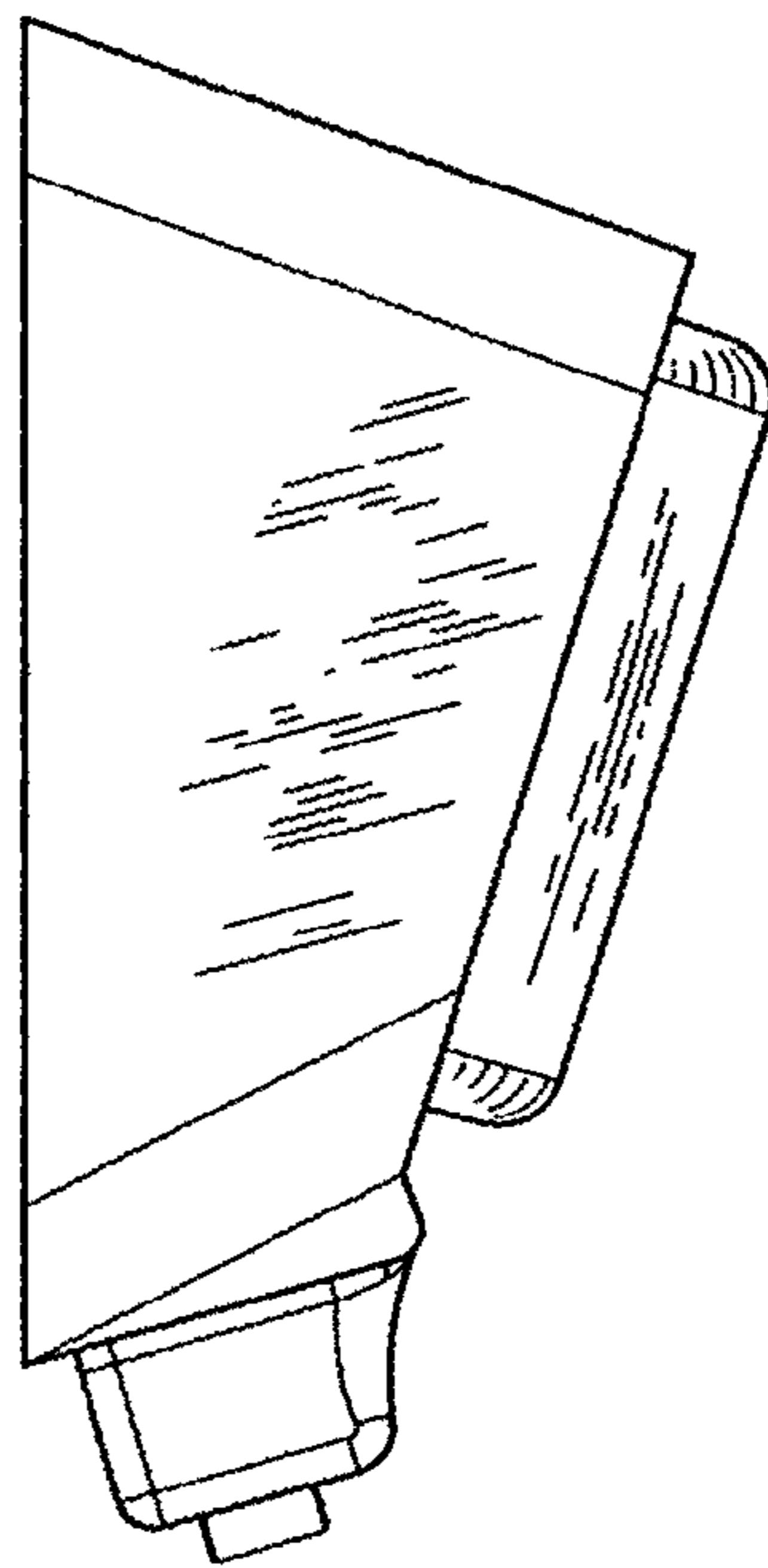

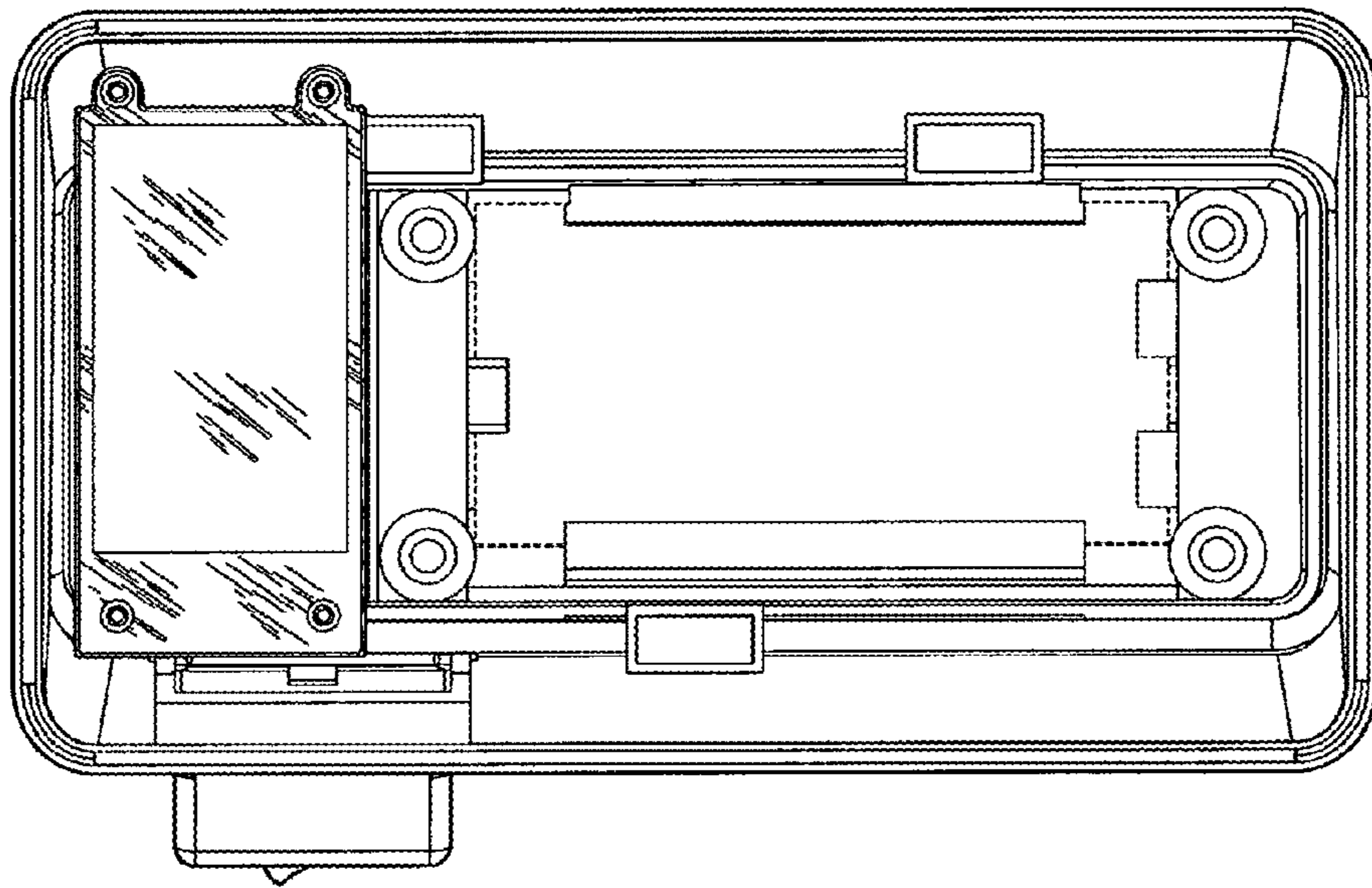

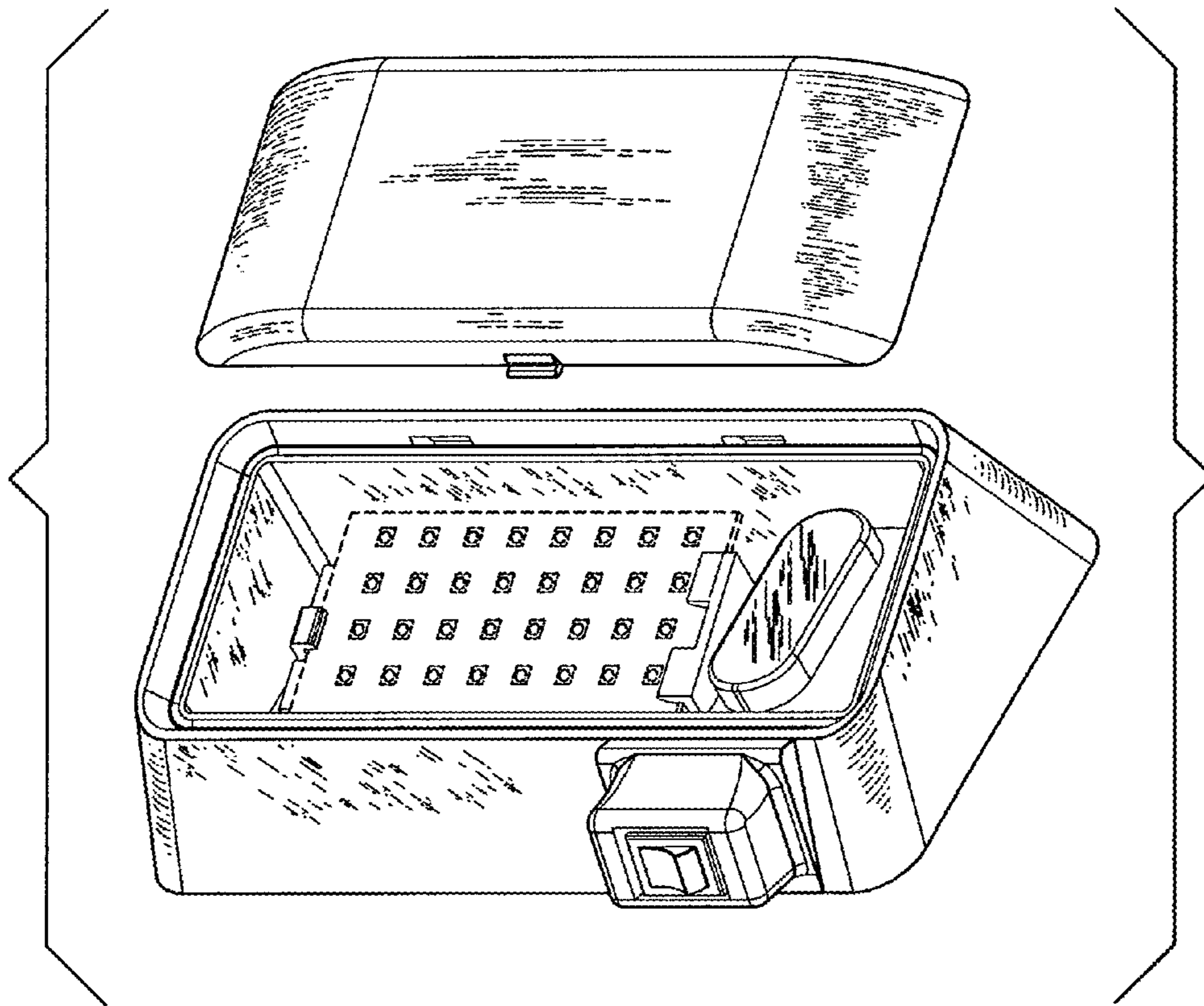

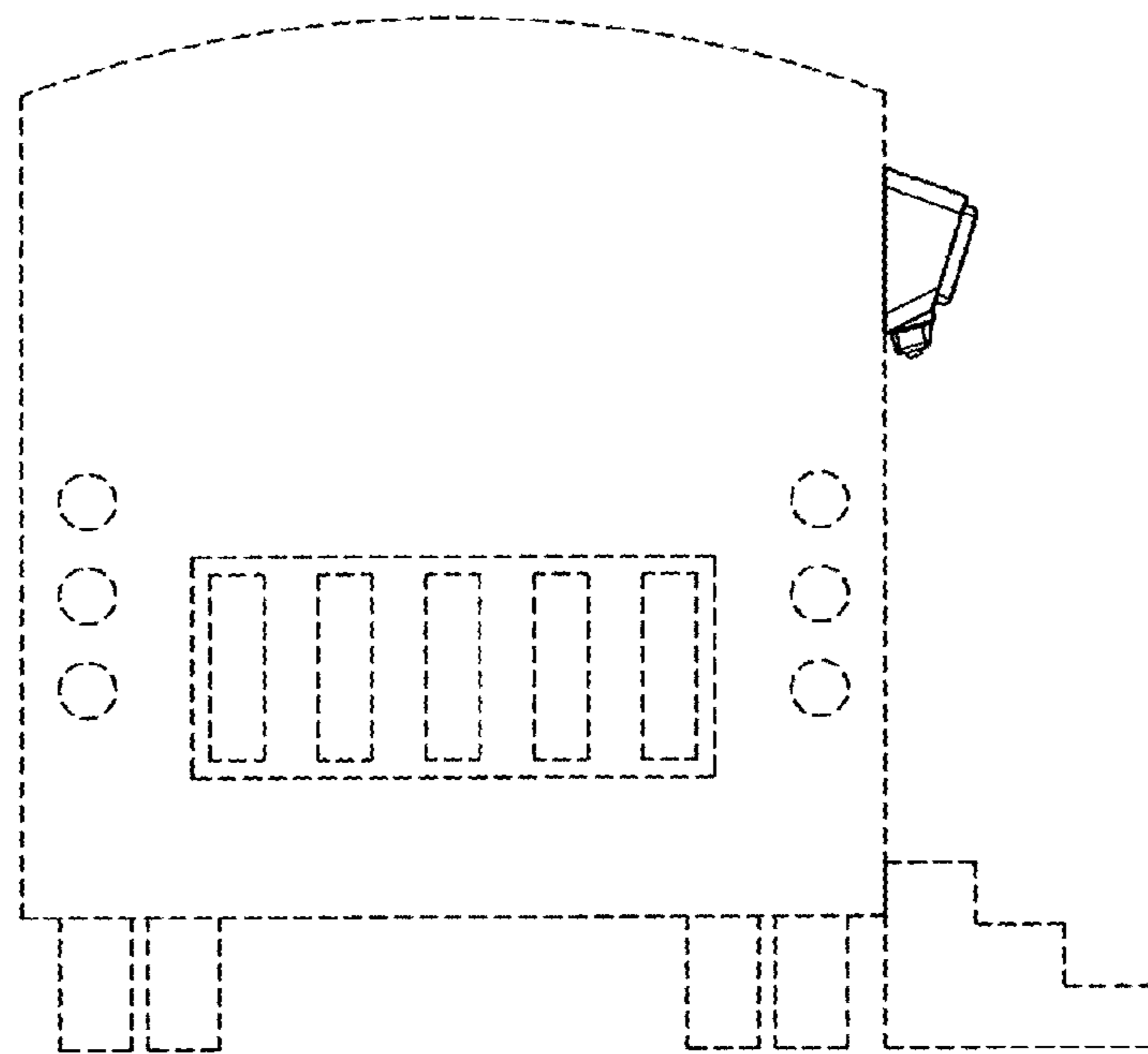
