(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tote bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tote bag design with the bag handle in the closed position;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of the back of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the open position;

FIG. 3 is a plan view of the front of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the open position;

FIG. 4 is a plan view of the left side of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the open position;

FIG. 5 is a plan view of the right side of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the open position;


FIG. 6 is a plan view of the bottom of the tote bag design;

FIG. 7 is a plan view of the top of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the closed position; and,

FIG. 8 is a plan view of the top of the tote bag design with the bag handle in the open position.







