1.

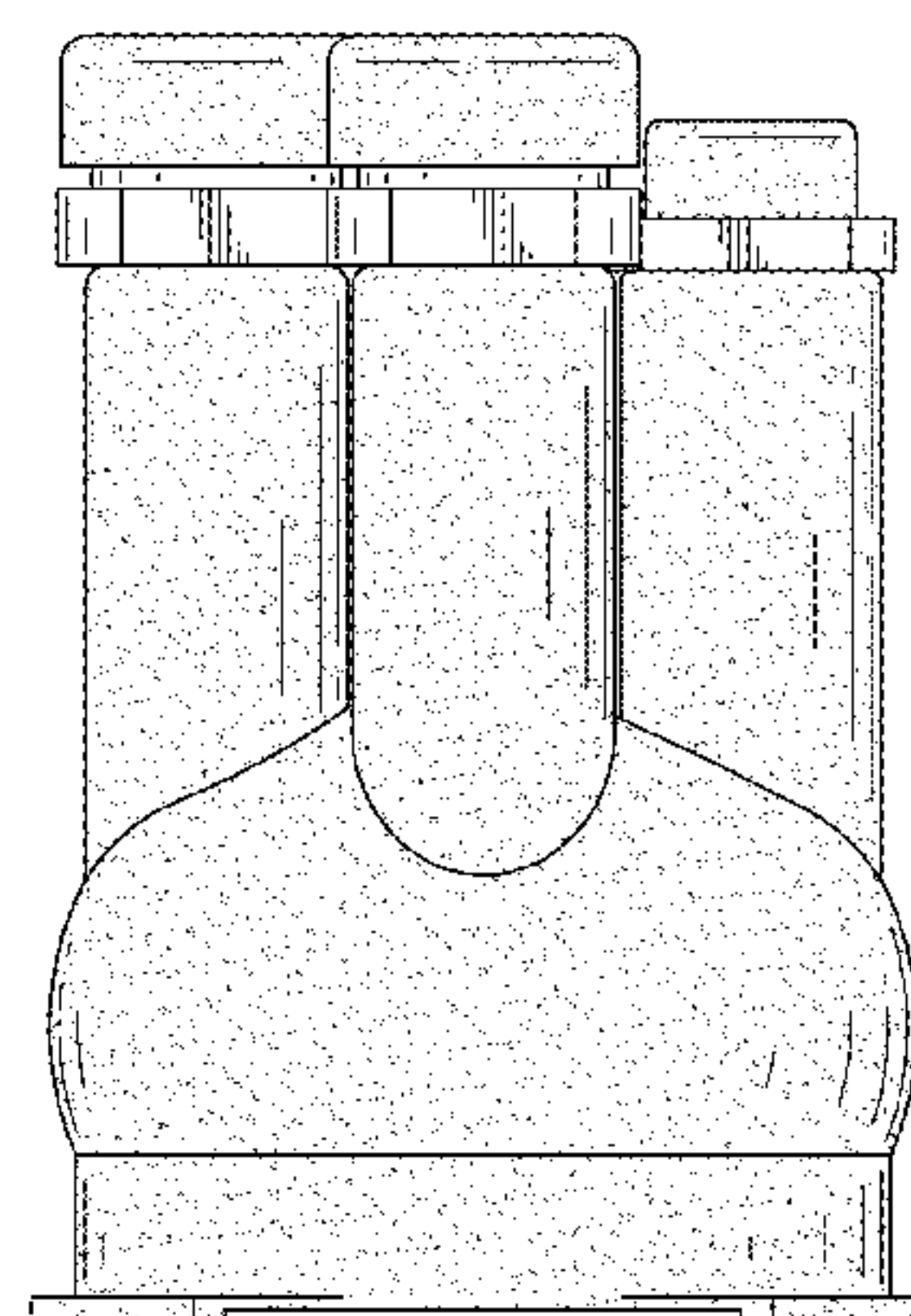
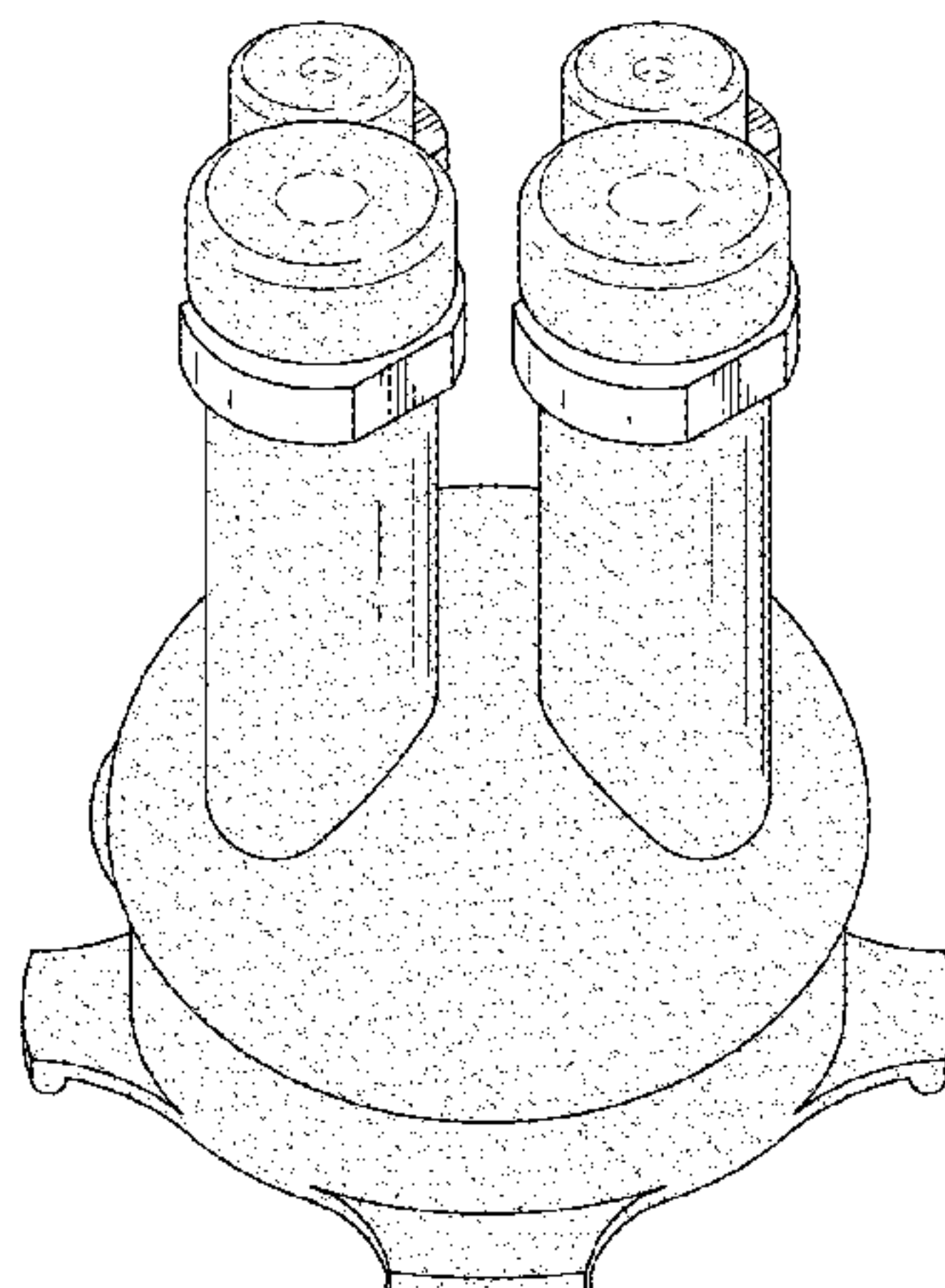
FIG. 5 is a front view of the single port access platform of

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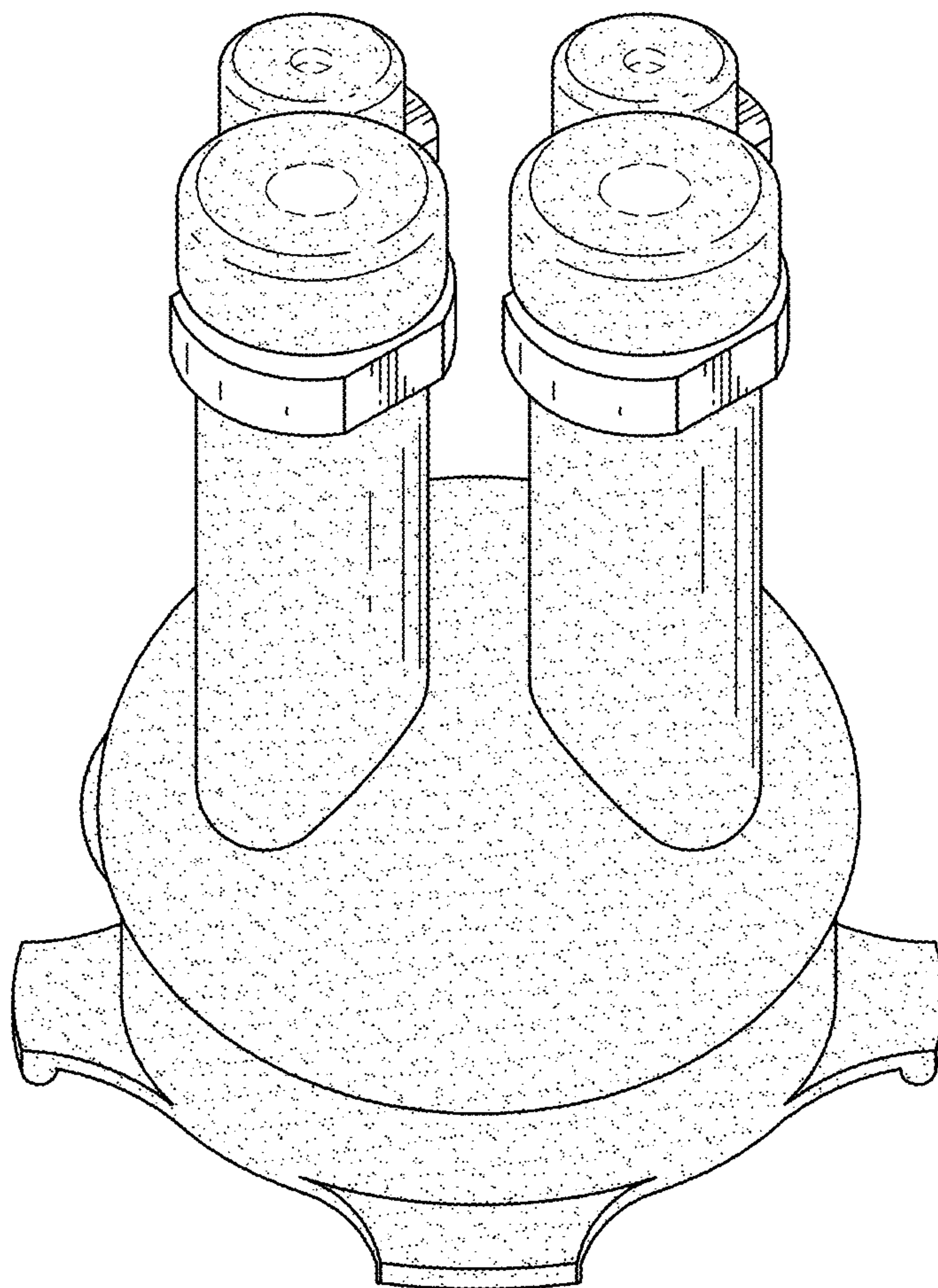

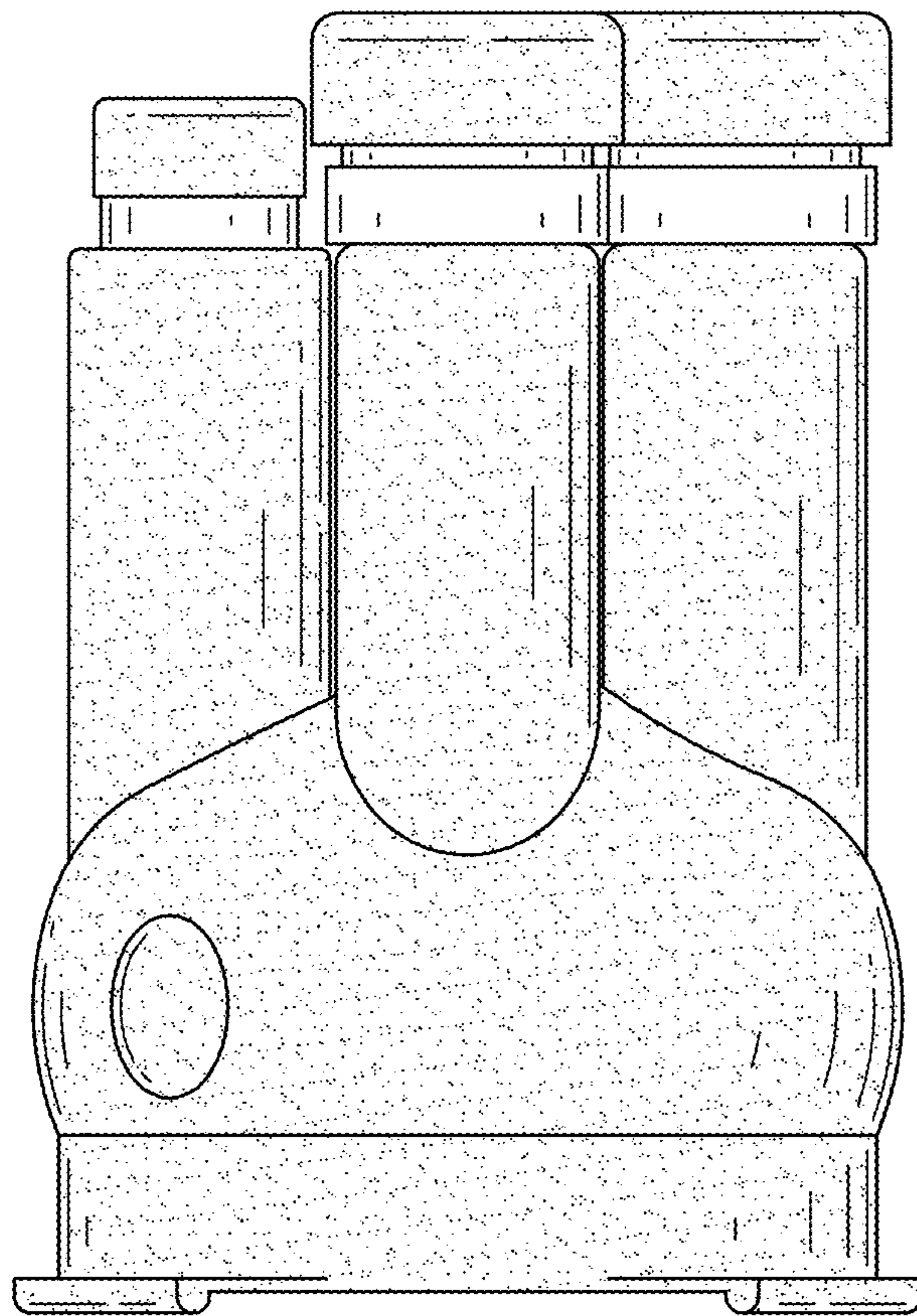

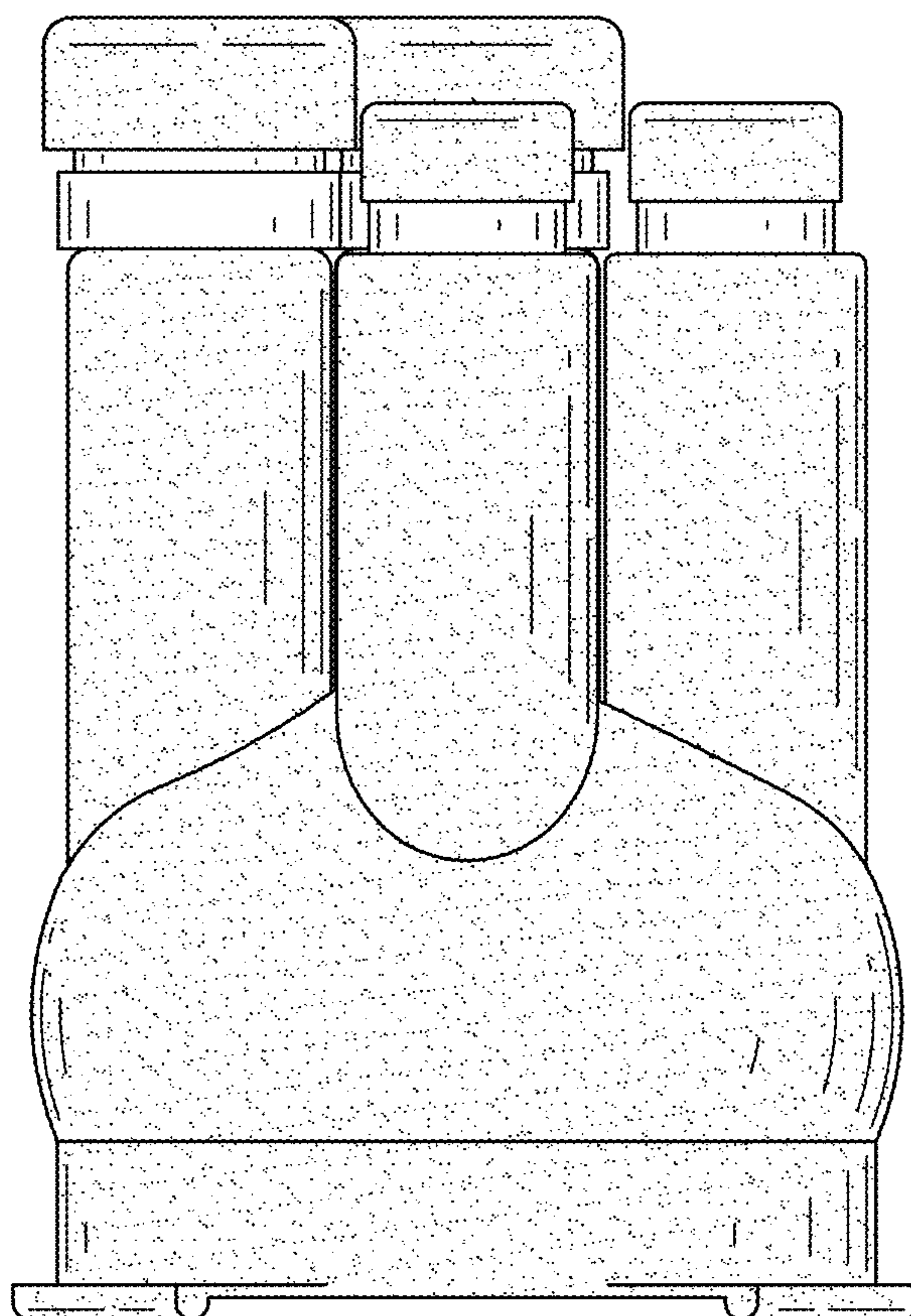

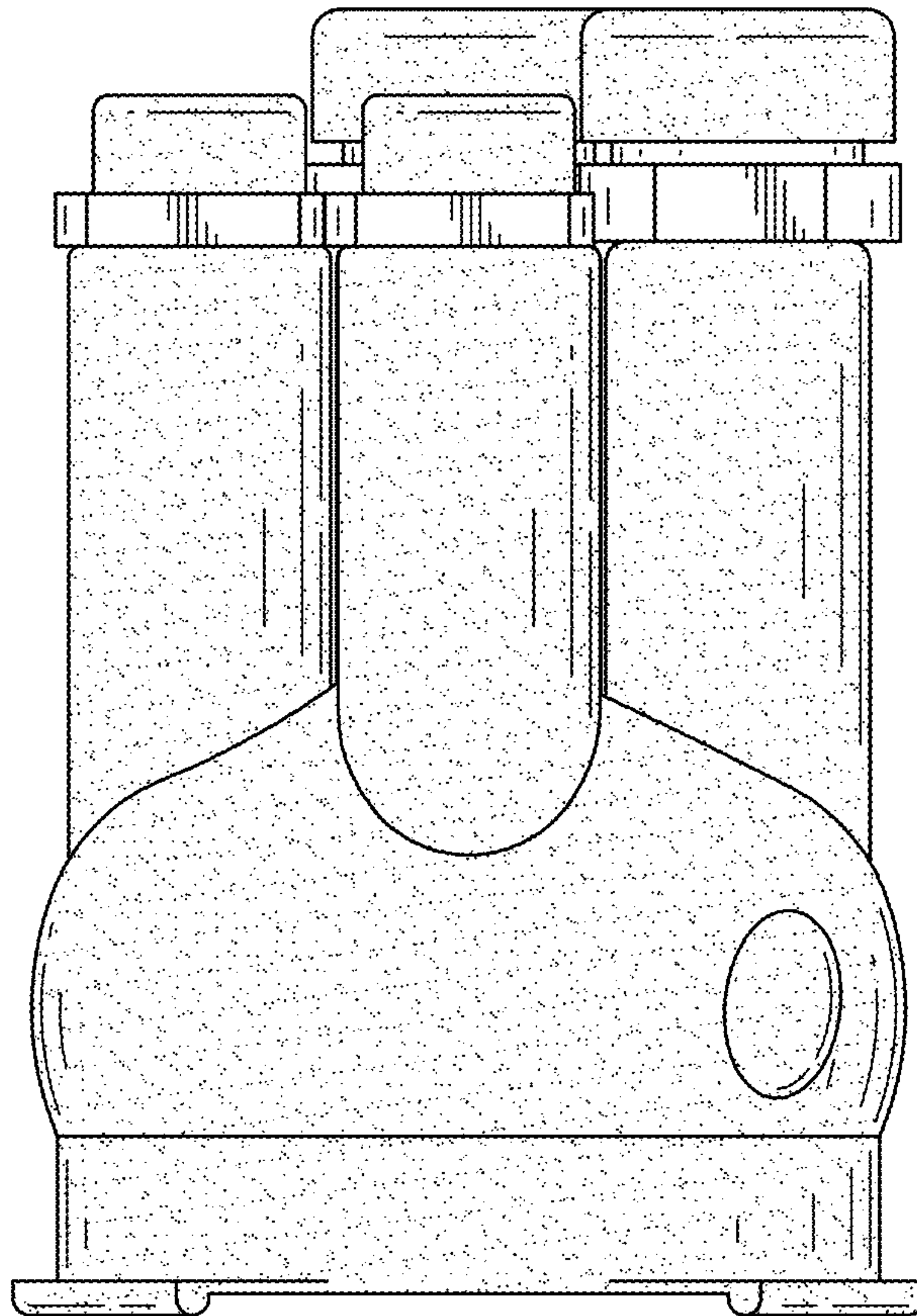

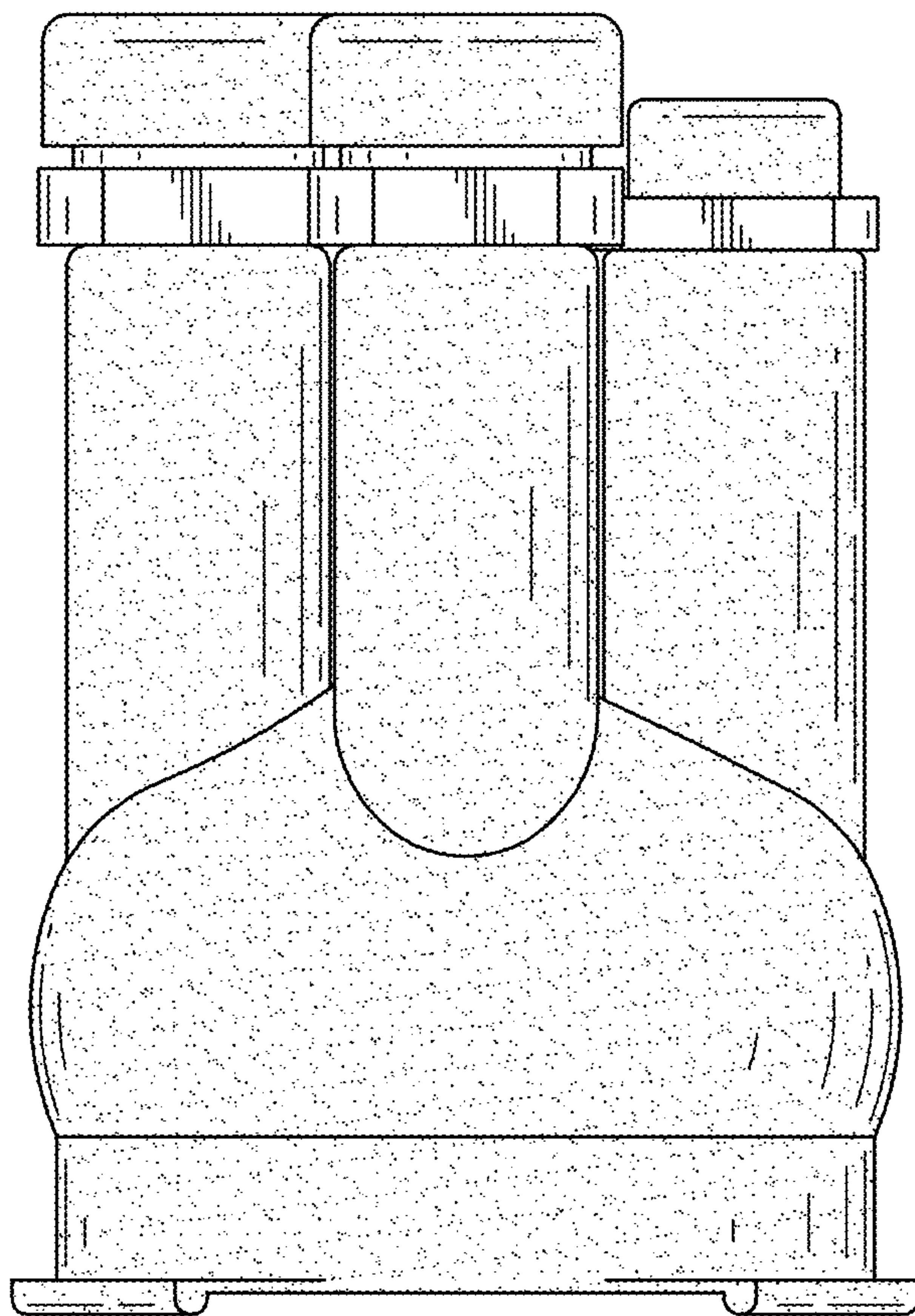

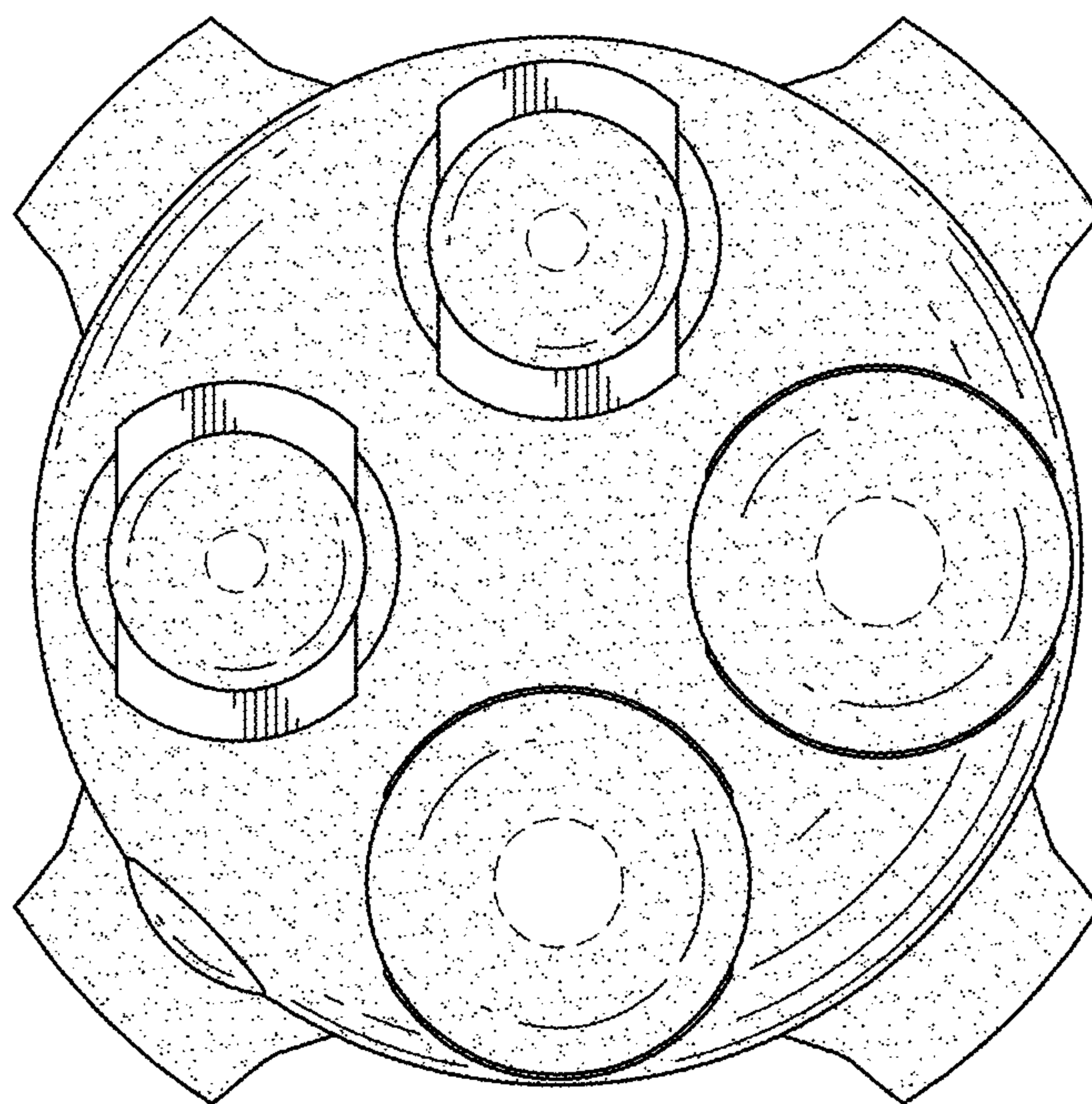

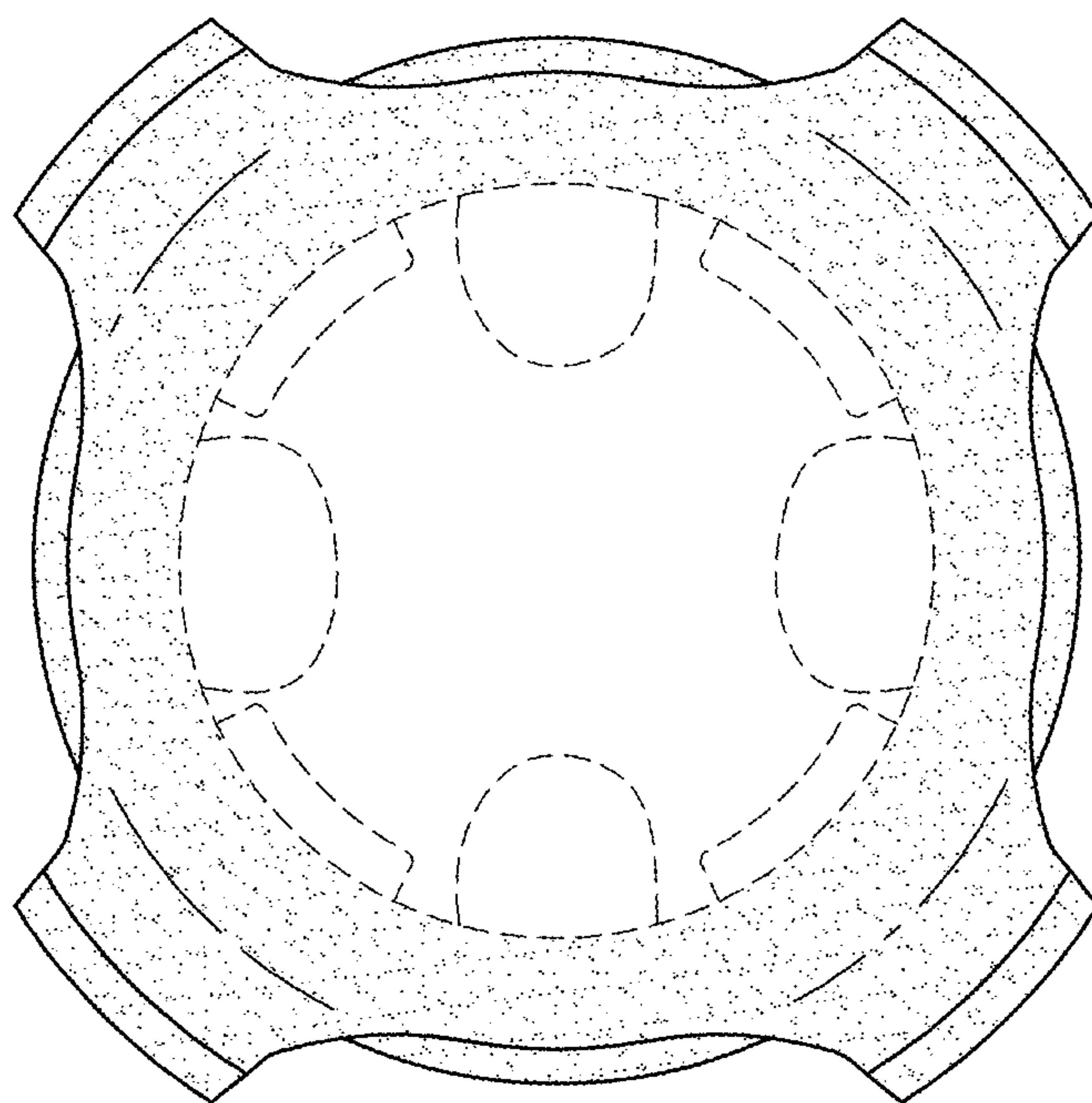
