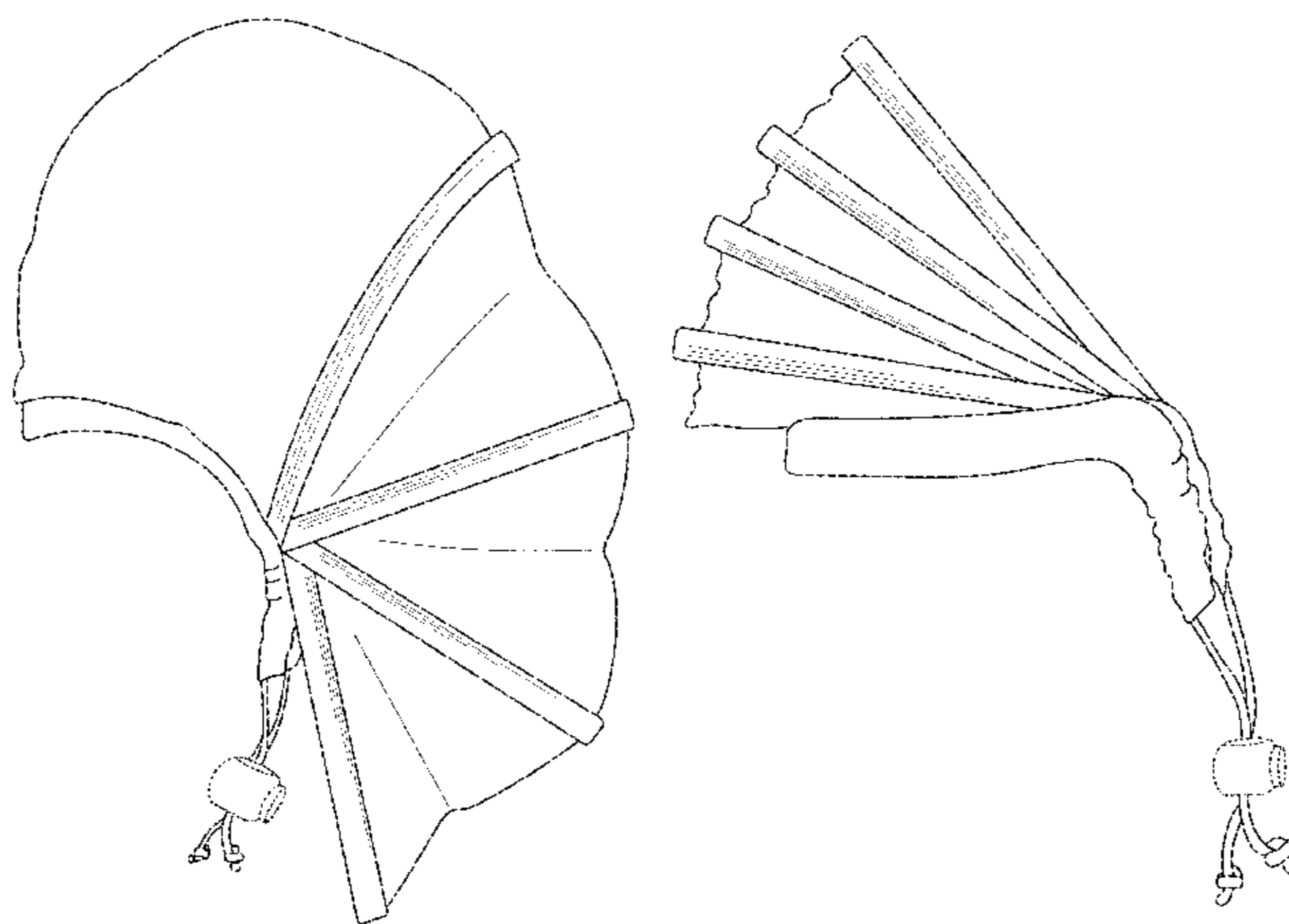
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hood for personal privacy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevation view of a hood for personal privacy showing it fully opened.
FIG. 2 is another right side elevation view of the hood for personal privacy of FIG. 1, but showing it fully collapsed.
FIG. 3 is another right side elevation view of the hood for personal privacy of FIG. 1, but showing it partially collapsed.
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the hood for personal privacy of FIG. 1, but showing it fully opened; and,
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of the hood for personal privacy of FIG. 1, but showing it fully opened.
The broken lines represent features of the article of manufacture that form no part of the claimed design.

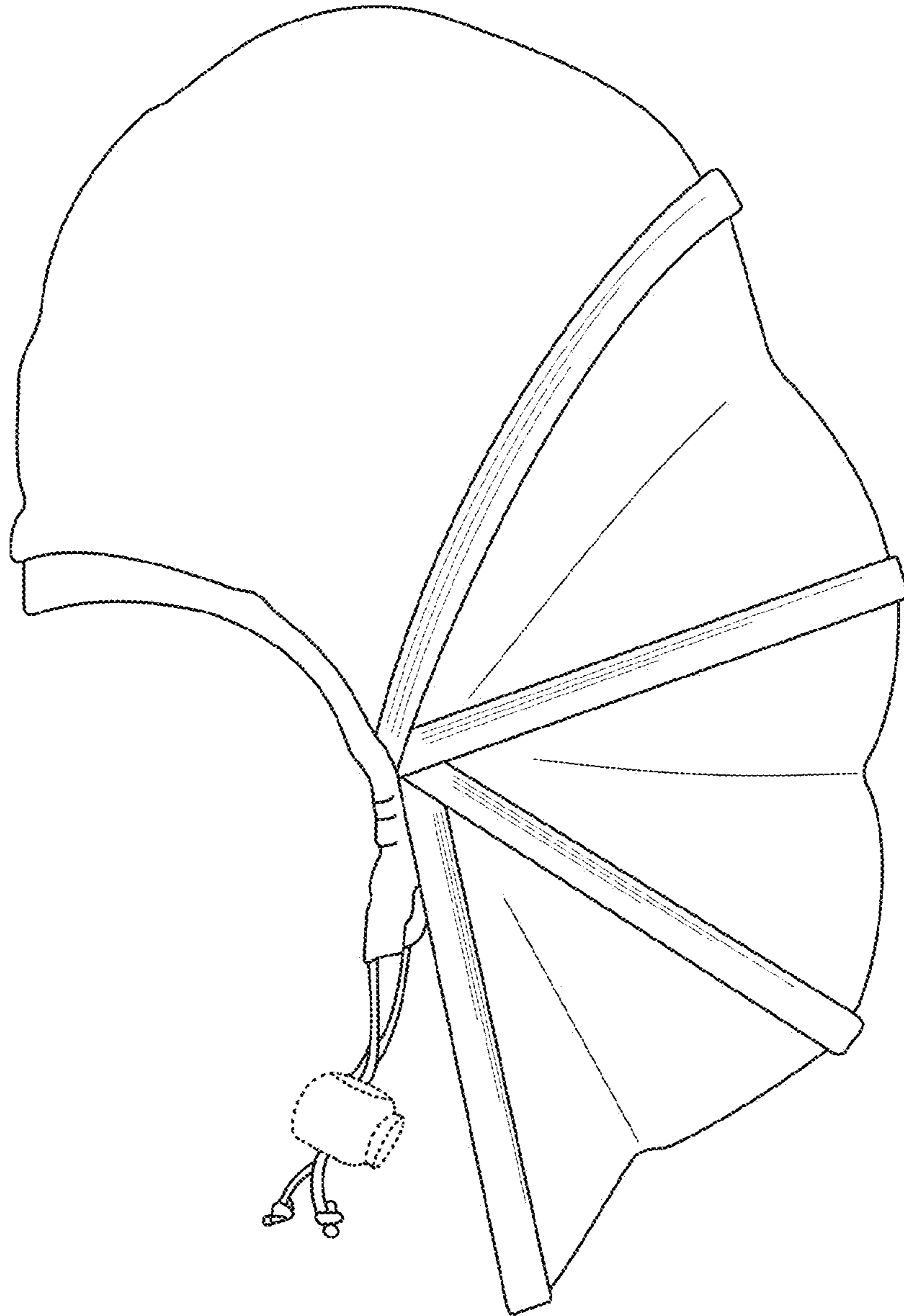

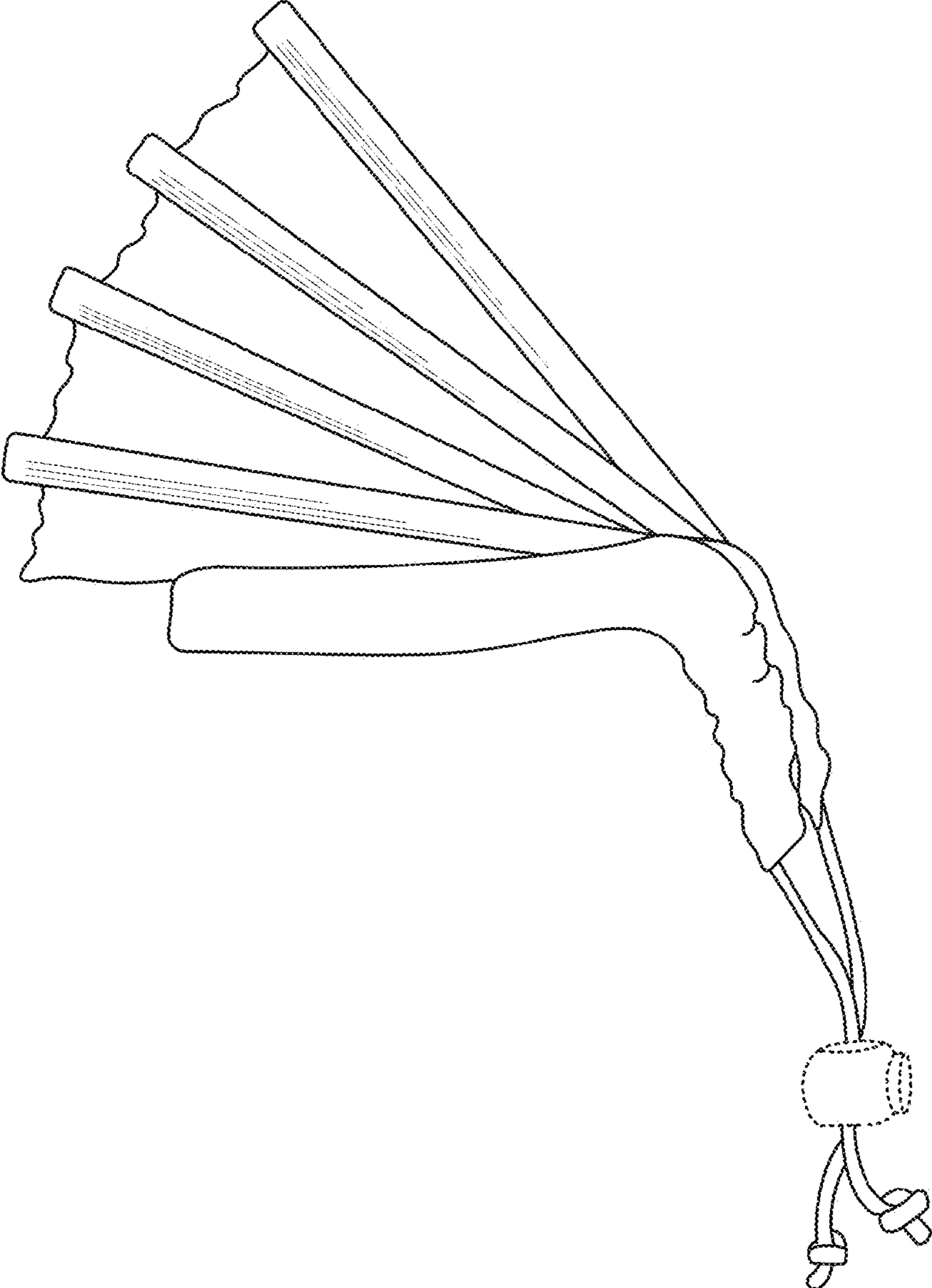

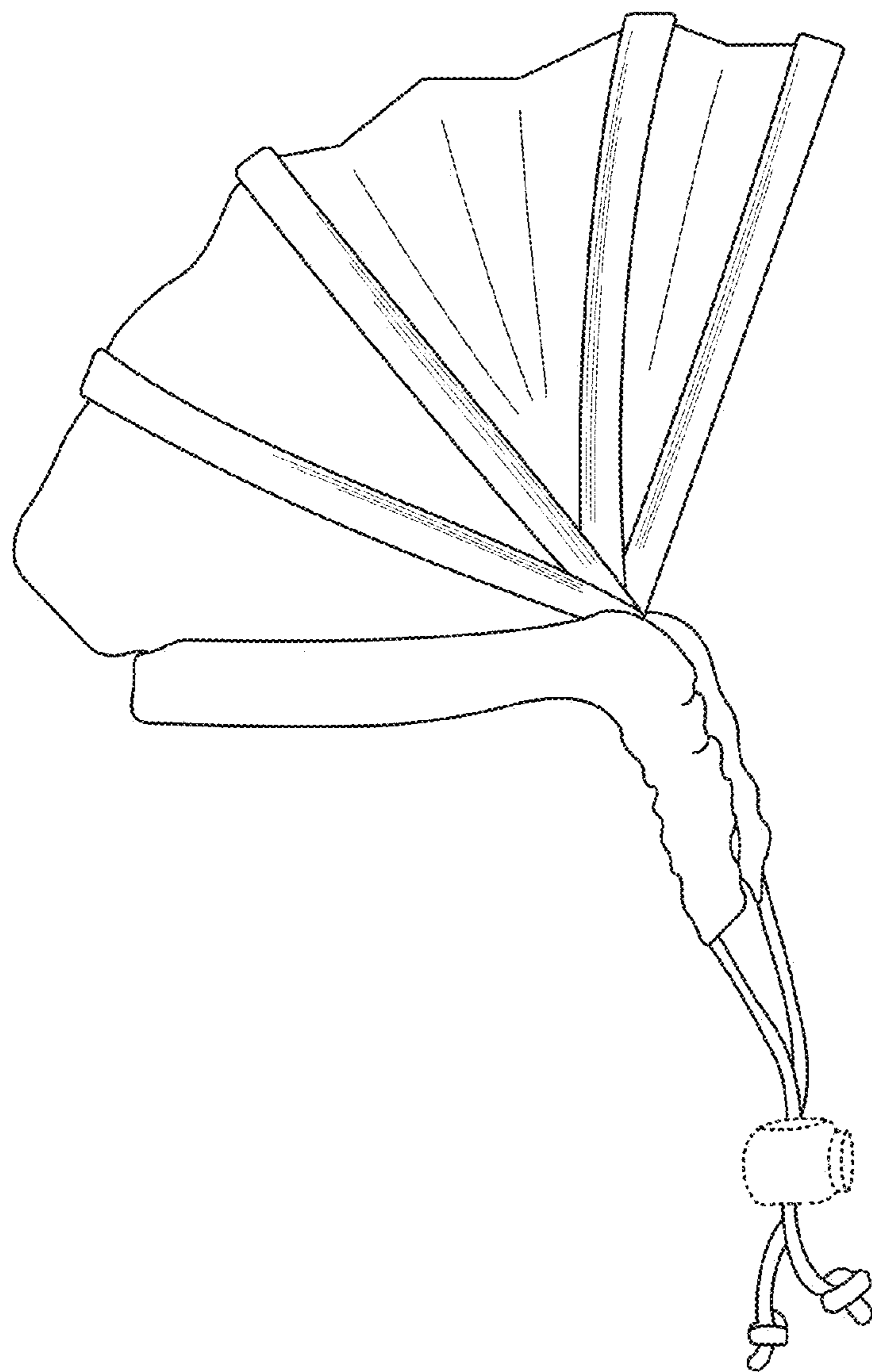

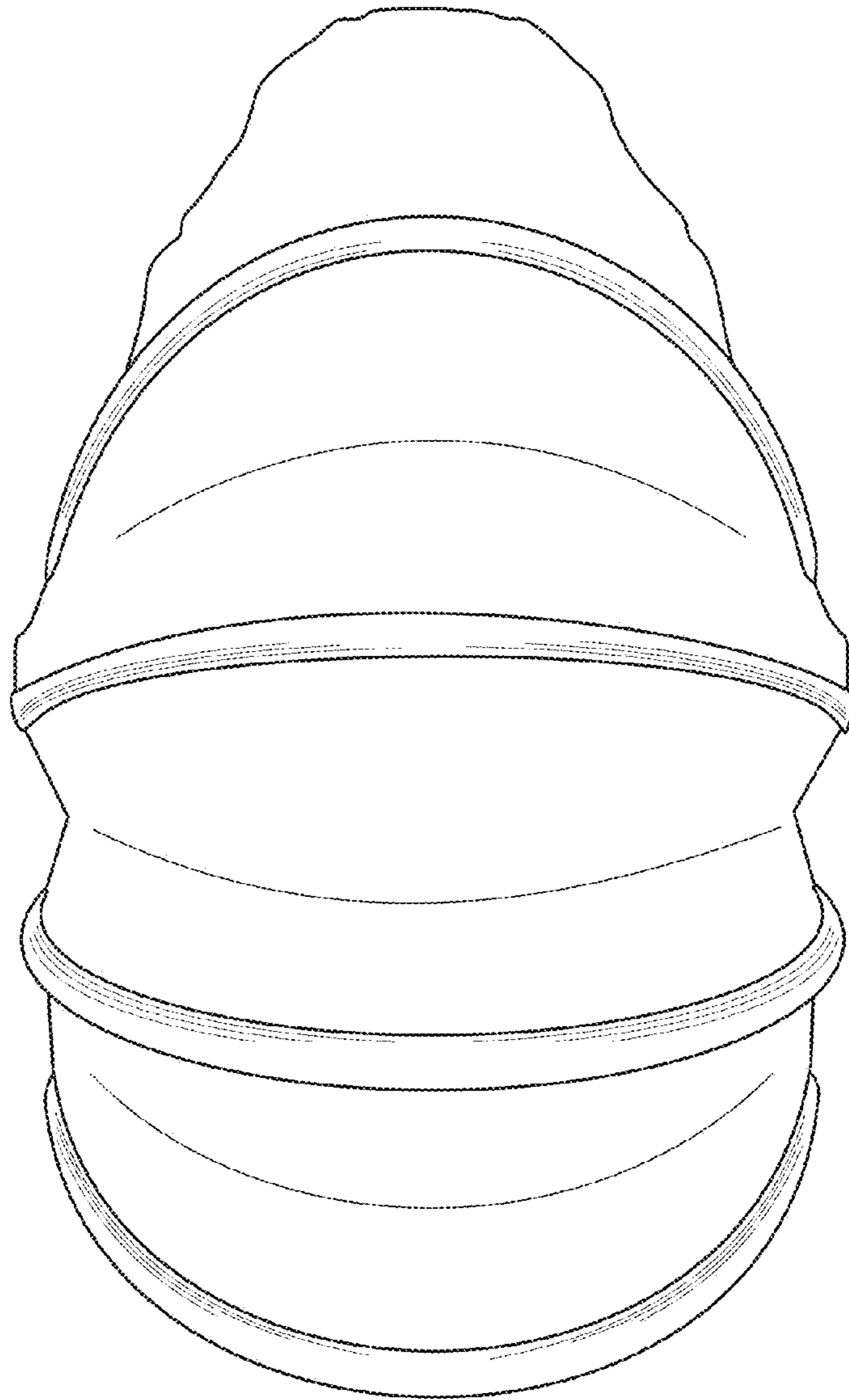

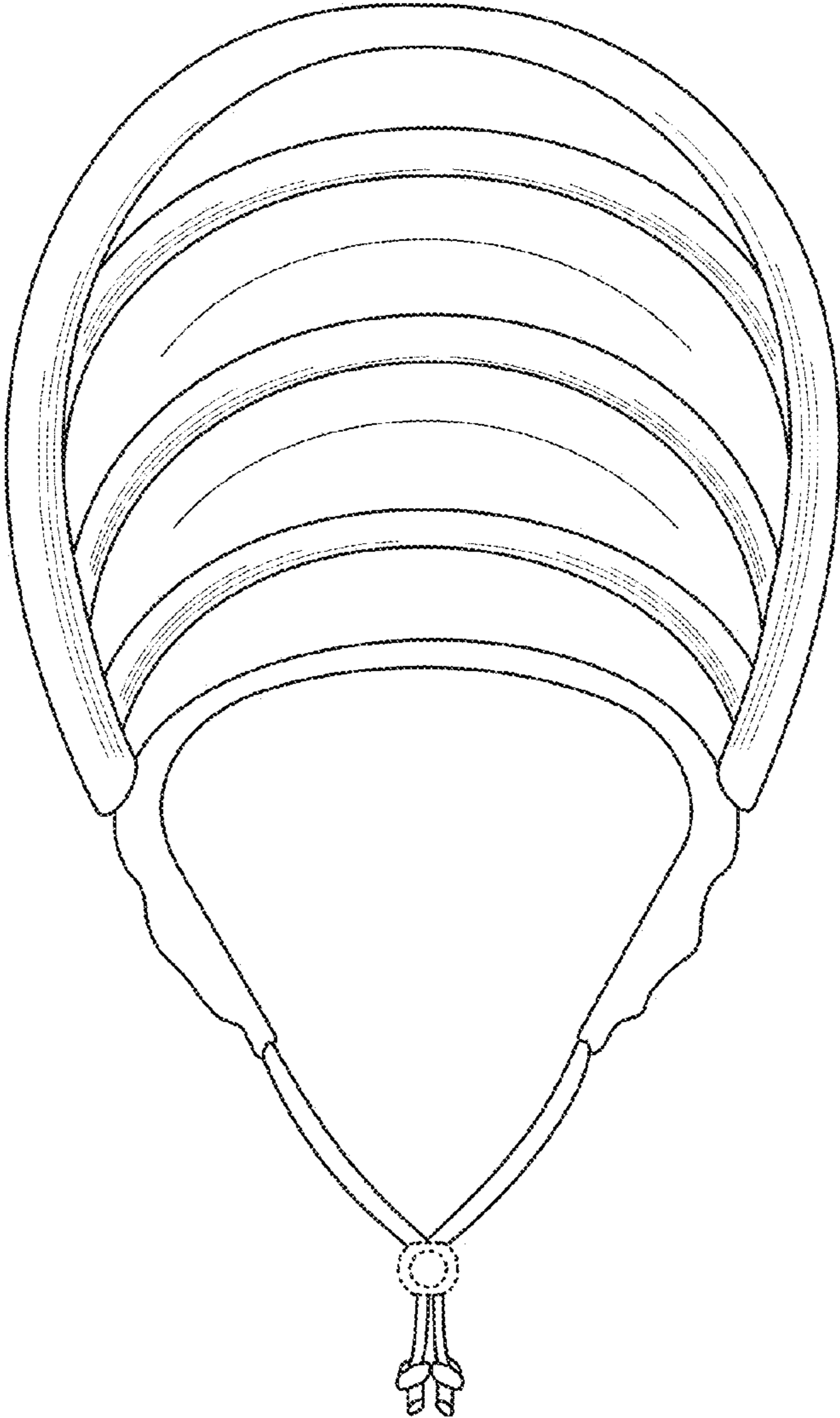
