(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a multimedia terminal with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a multimedia terminal with graphical user interface showing our new design. The broken lines shown in the drawing are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design. The one-dot chain line indicates a boundary between a part to be protected for a partial design and the other part excluded from the scope of protection of the design.
