(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a kickoff tee, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a kickoff tee, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1, but showing one removable tuft in an exploded state;

FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view thereof, showing the tuft element in an alternate, stored position;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

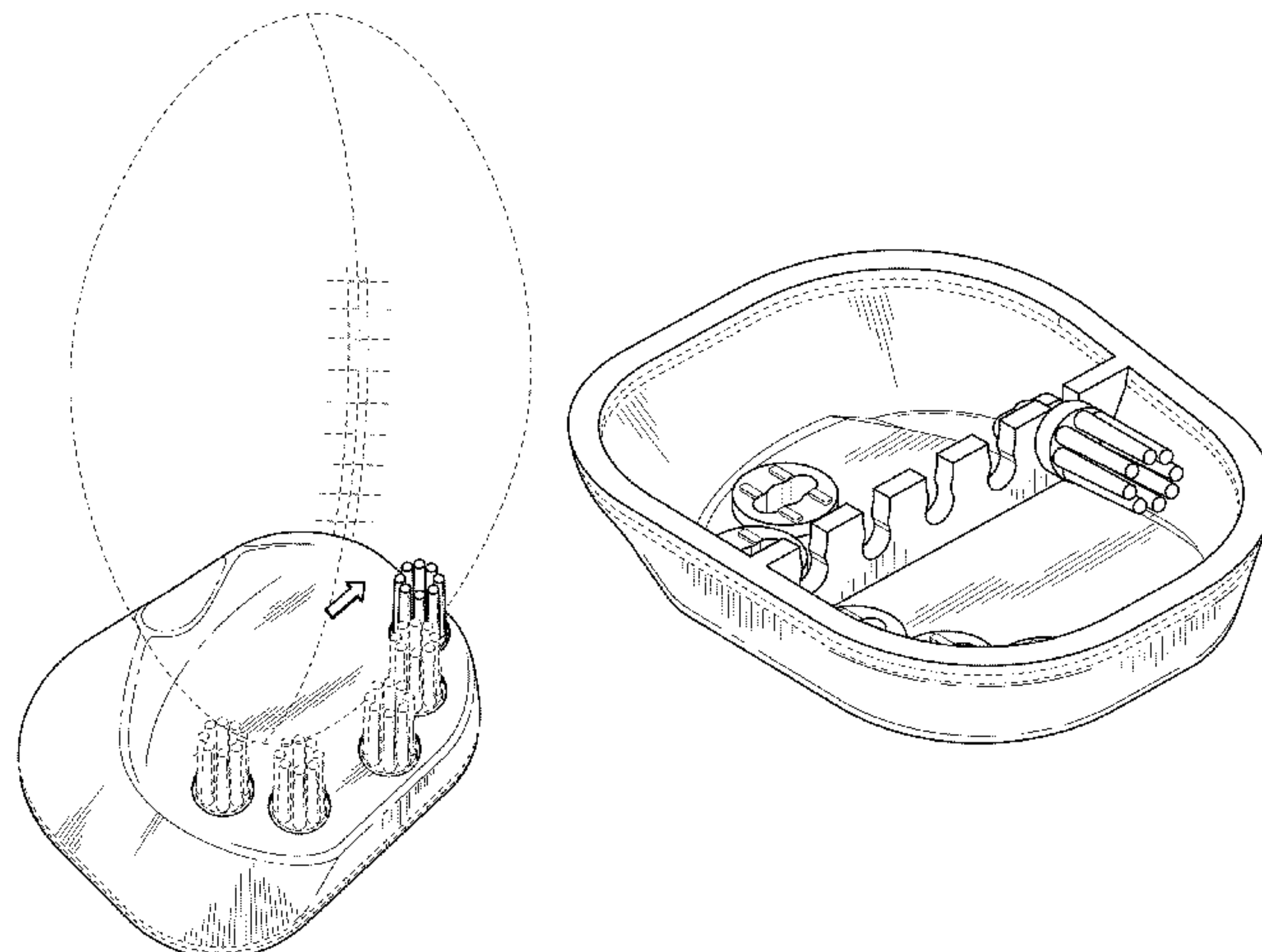
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is an exploded top plan view of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 9 is an exploded bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

The broken lines showing a football and additional tuft elements in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design. The portions of the kickoff tee between the parallel, horizontal broken lines form no part of the claim design.

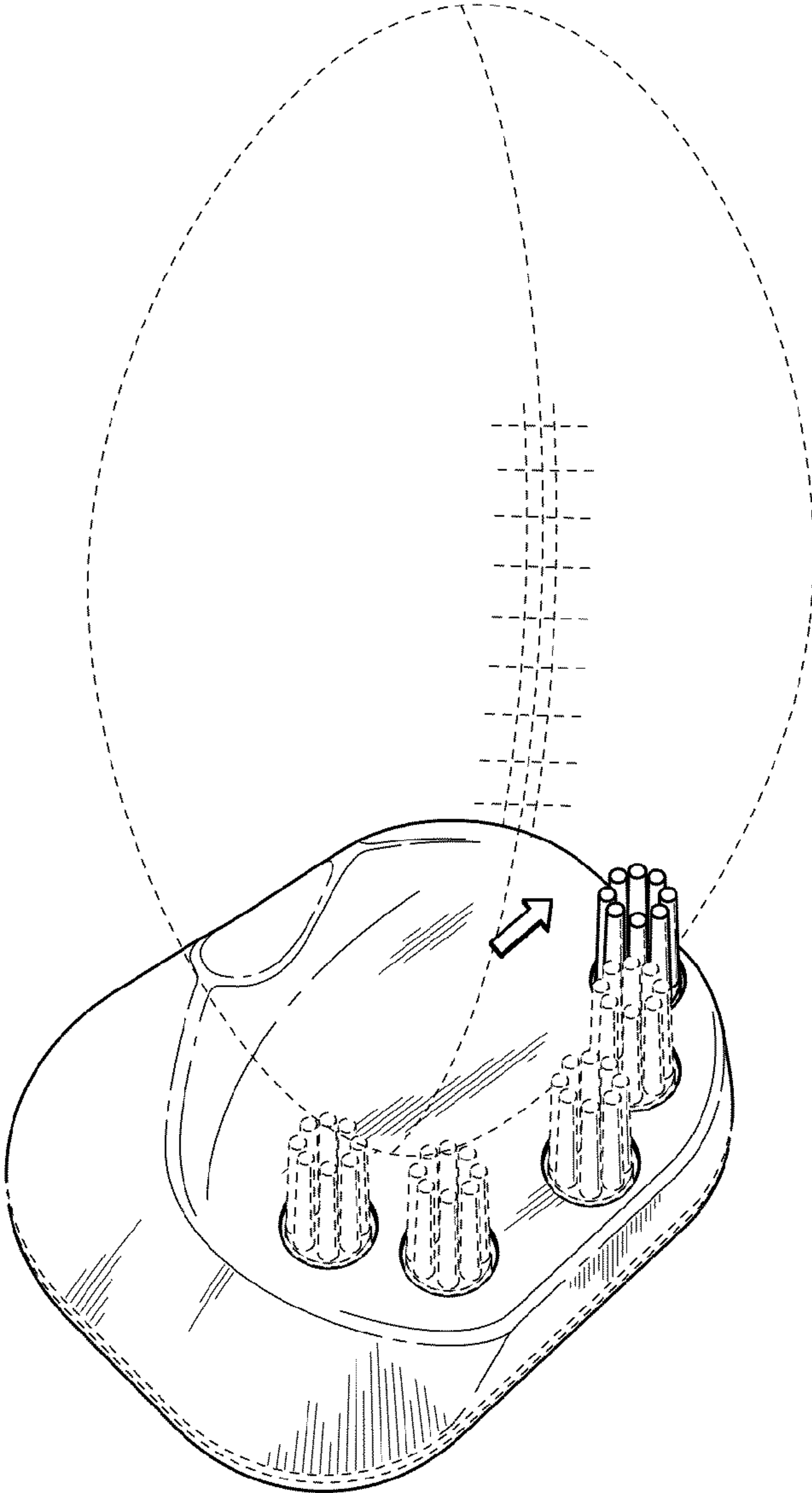

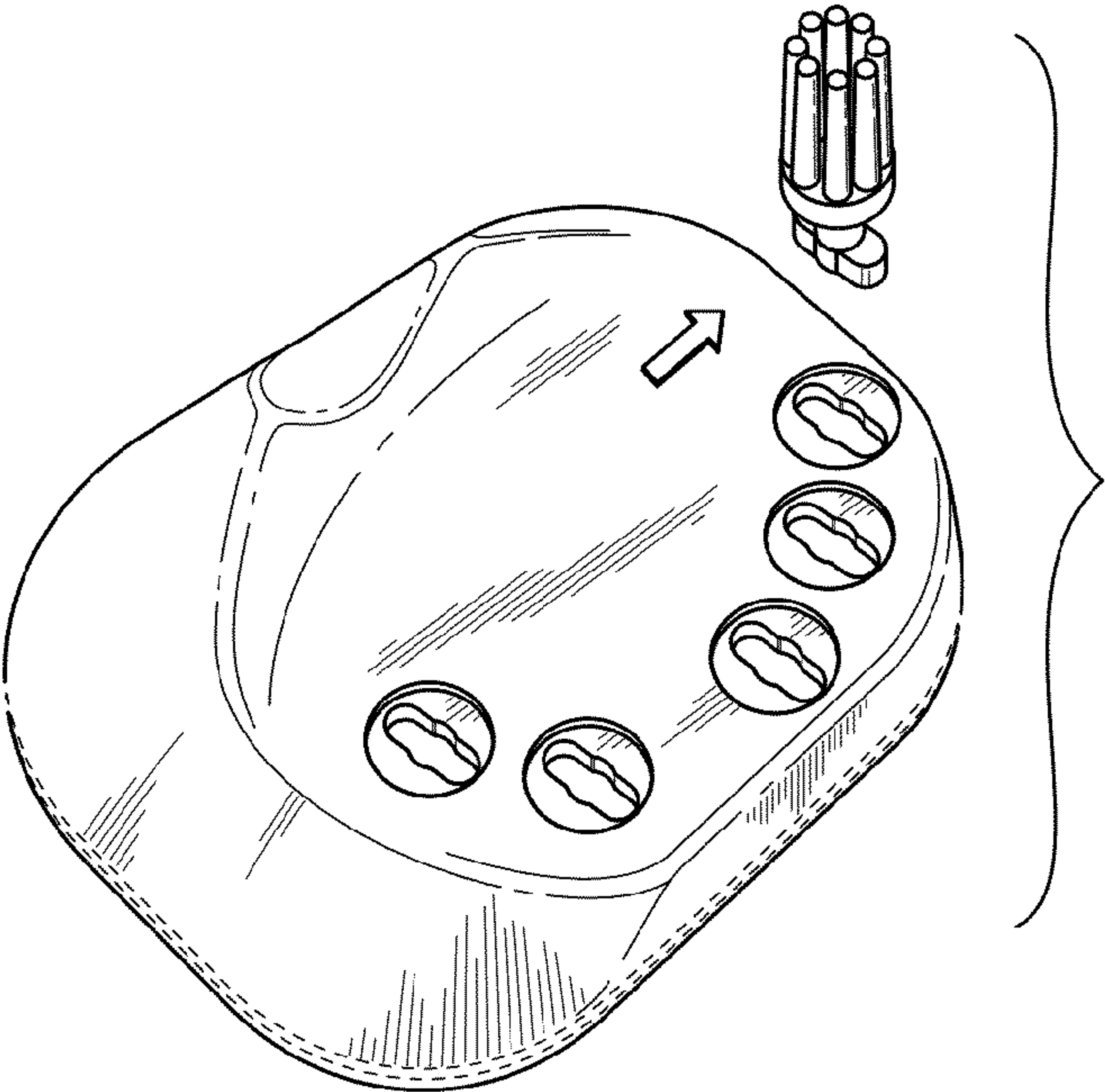

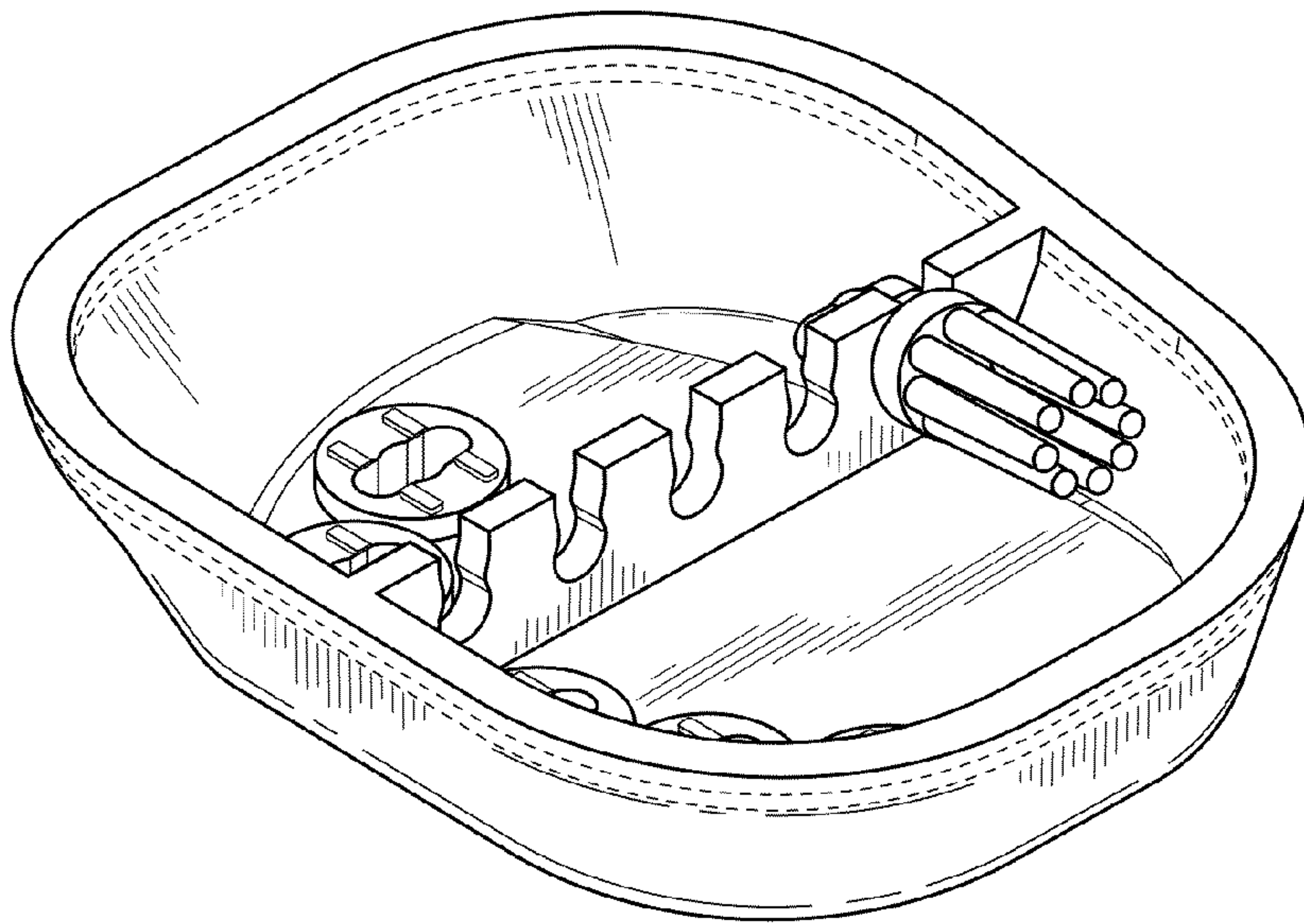

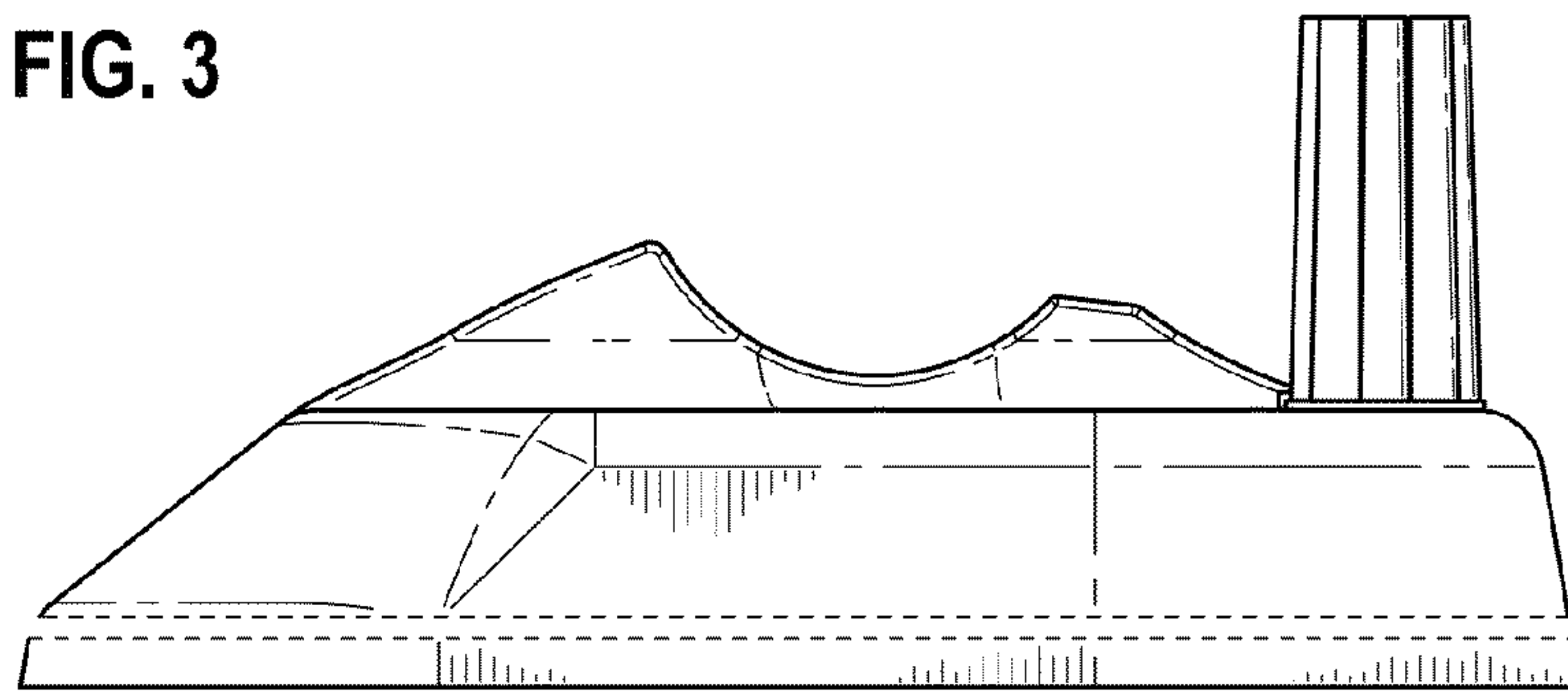

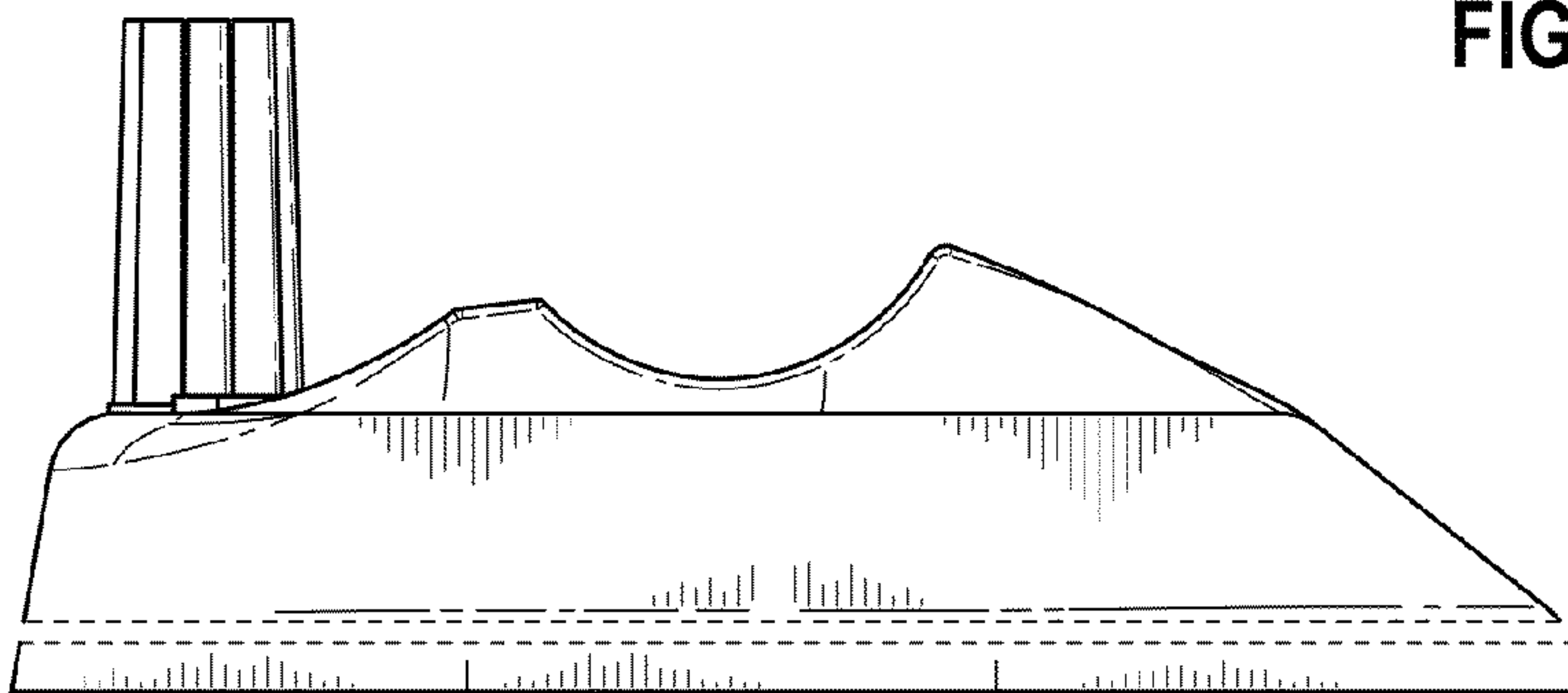

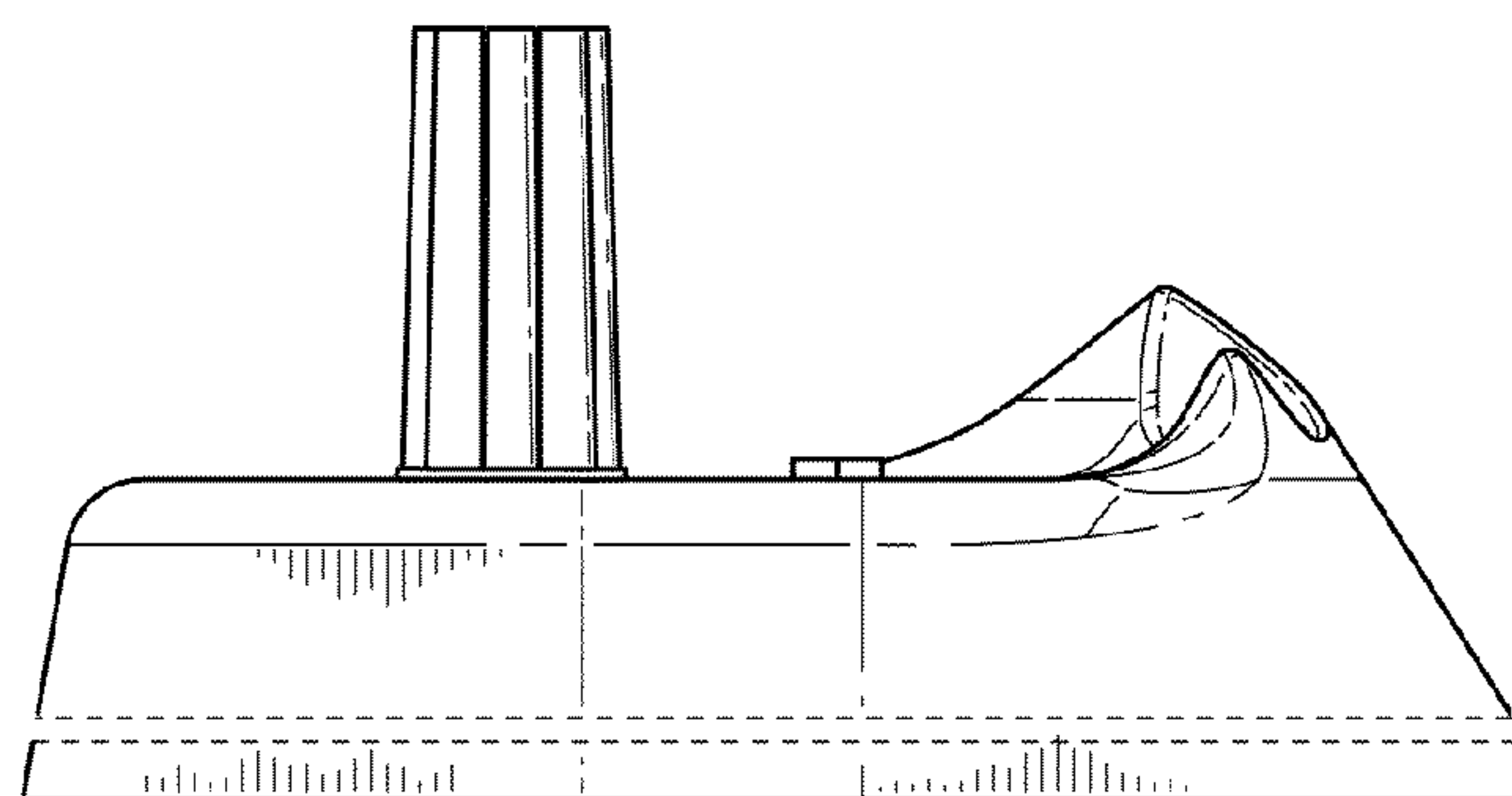

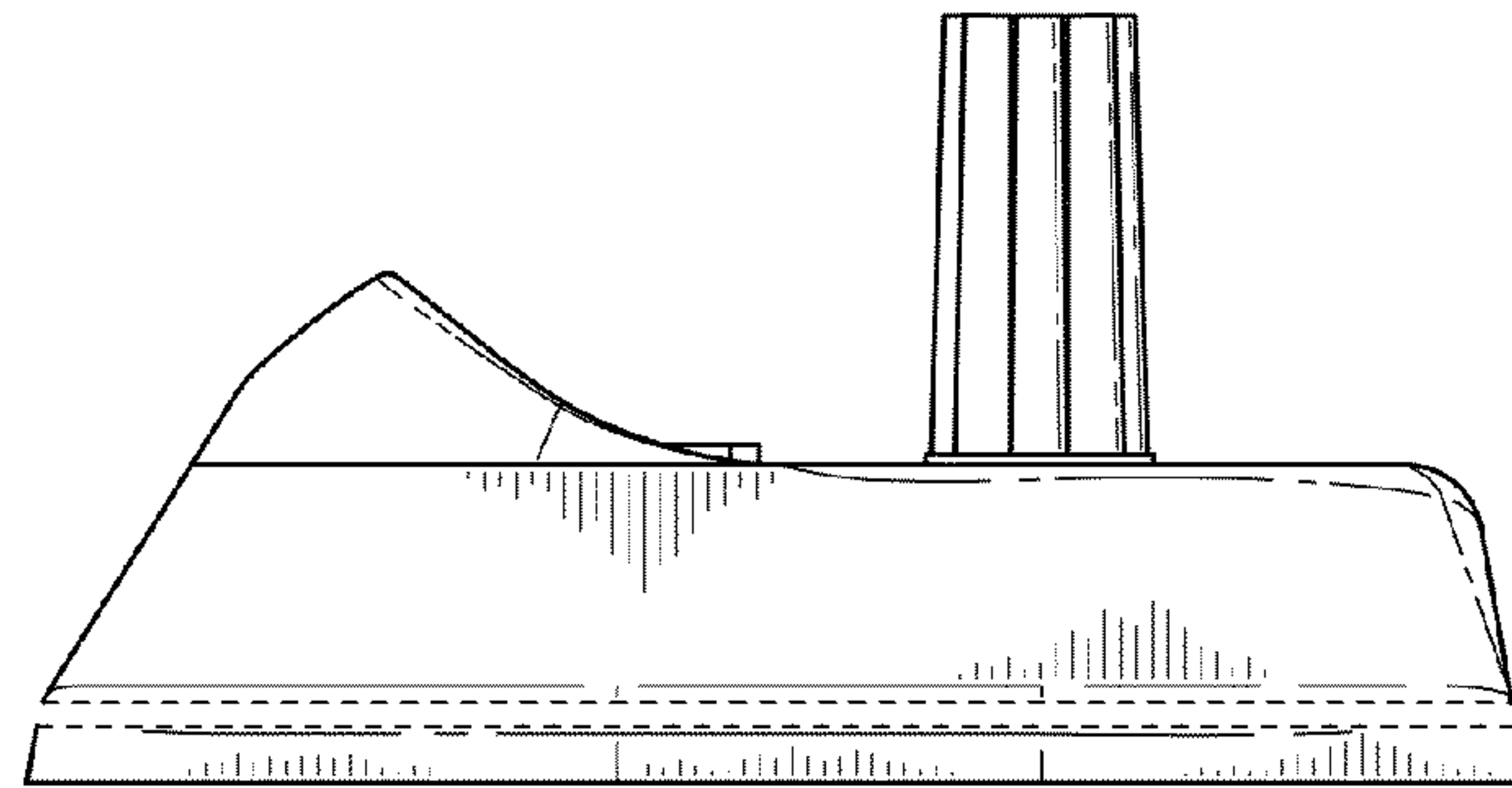

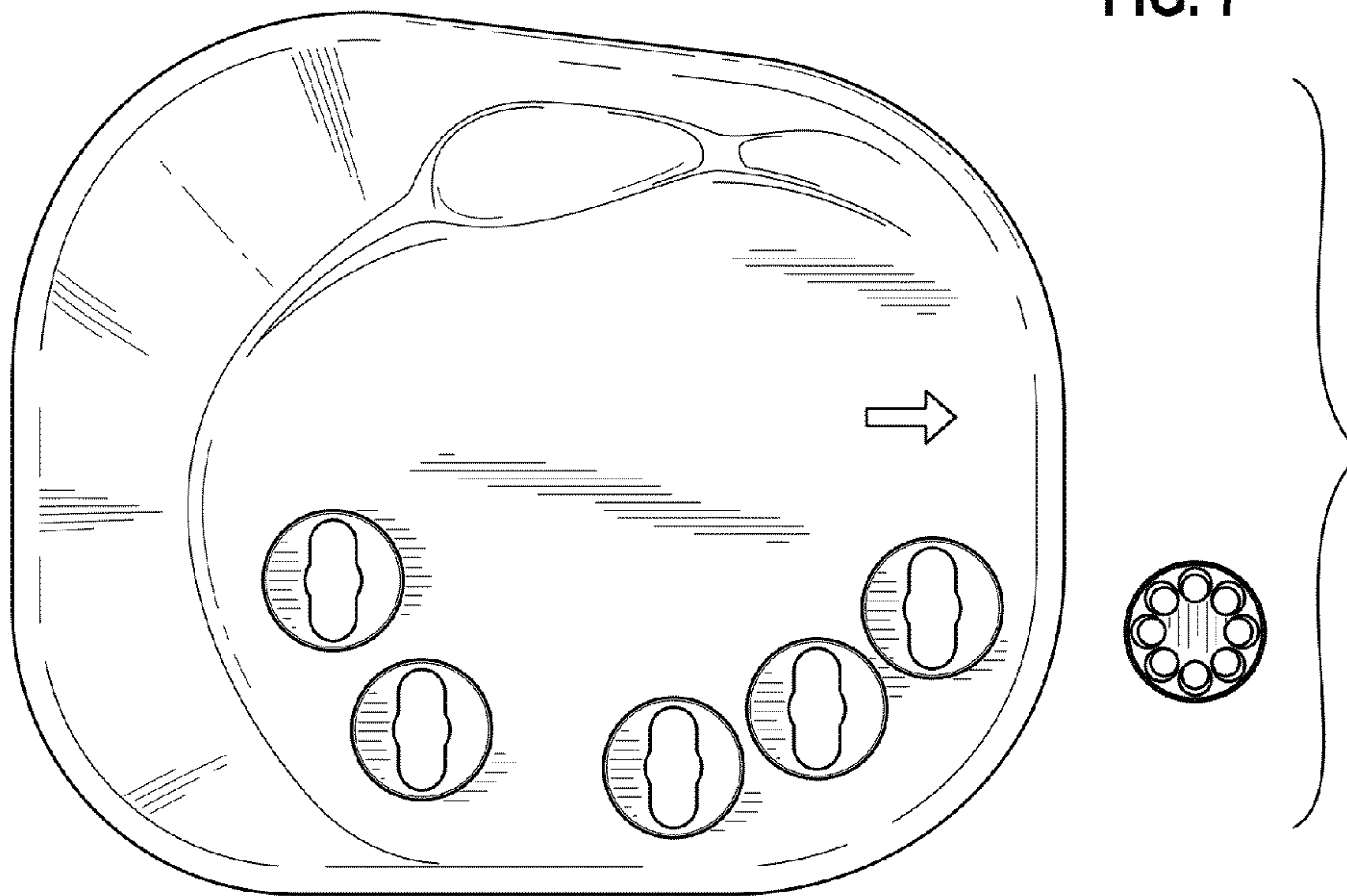

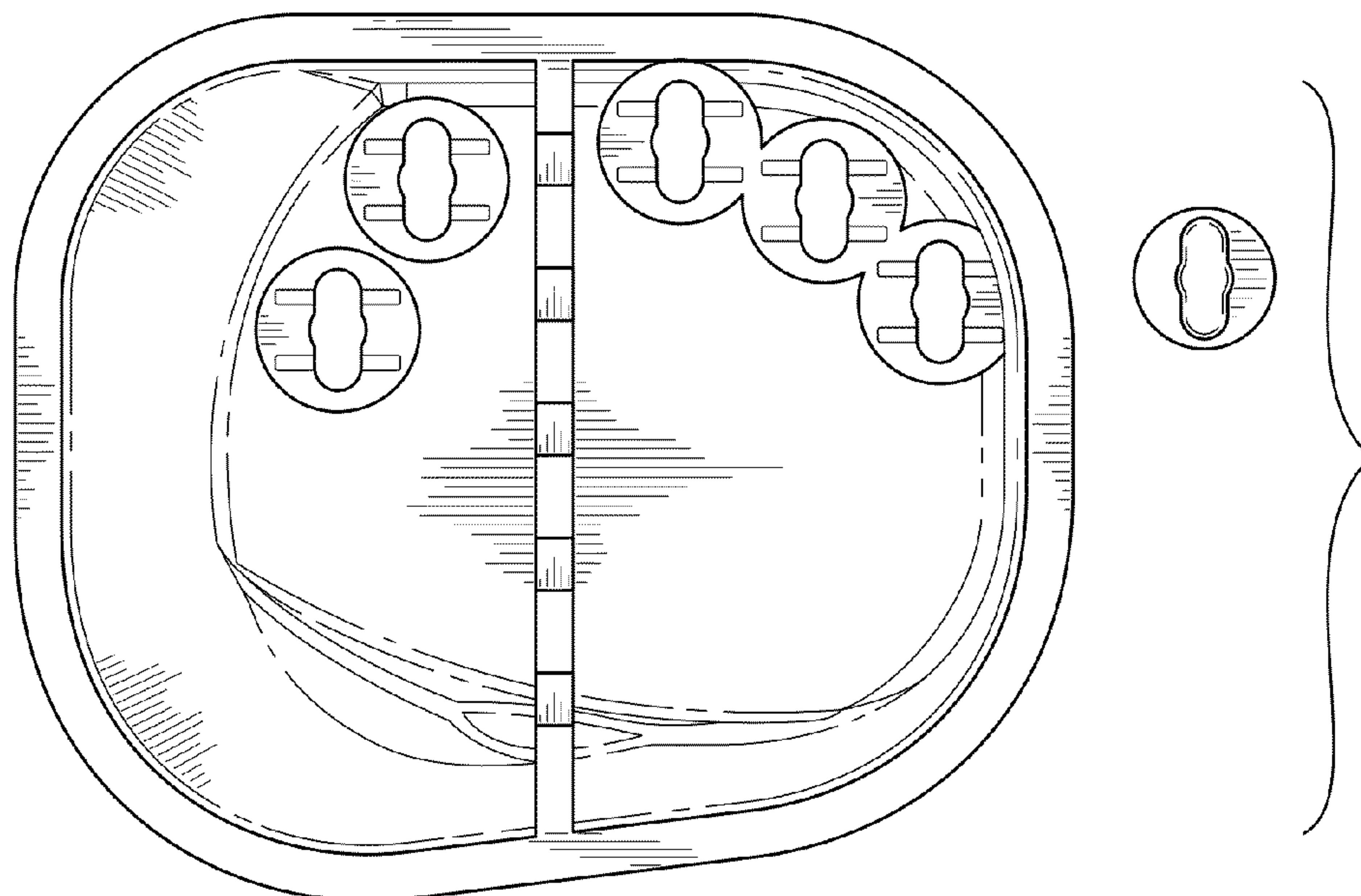
