DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an endoscope system set according to the present
invention, illustrating an eyepiece in a bottom perspective
view and an operating sheath in a bottom perspective view.

FIG. 2 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1, illustrating the
eyepiece in a front plan view and the operating sheath in a rear
plan view.

FIG. 3 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1 illustrating the
eyepiece in a top perspective view and the operating sheath in
a top perspective view.

FIG. 4 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1 illustrating the
eyepiece in a rear perspective view and the operating sheath in
a front perspective view.

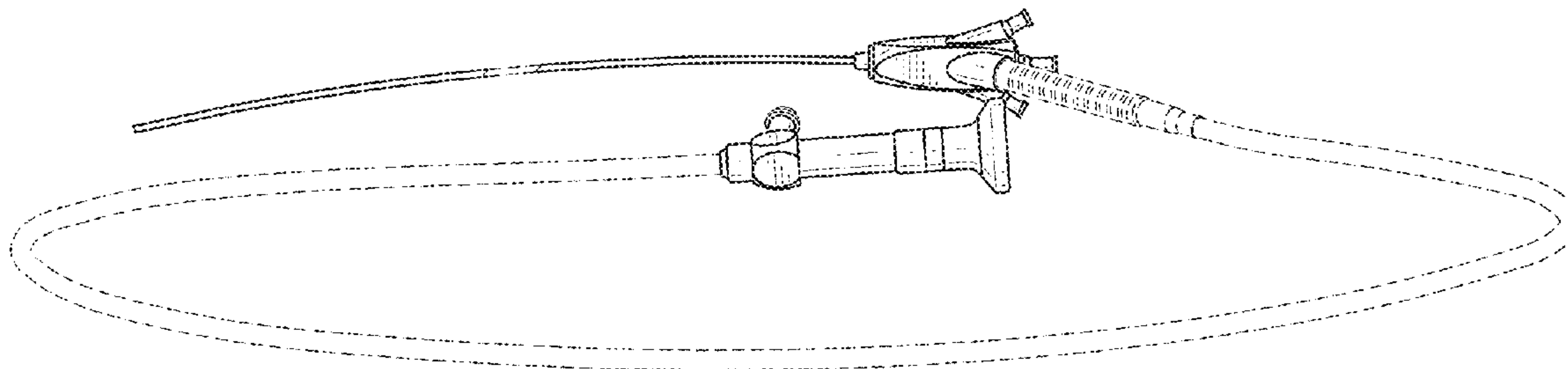
FIG. 5 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1 illustrating the
eyepiece in a left side perspective view and the operating
sheath in a right side perspective view.

FIG. 6 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1 illustrating the
eyepiece in a left side view and the operating sheath in a right
side view; and,

FIG. 7 is the endoscope system set of FIG. 1 illustrating the
eyepiece in a right side view and the operating sheath in a left
side view.

The dashed lines shown in FIGS. 1-7 illustrate portions of the
endoscope system set that form no part of the claimed design.
The dashed lines shown in FIGS. 1-7 immediately adjacent to
the claimed portion of the tube of the endoscope system set
represent boundaries of the design and form no part of the
claimed design.

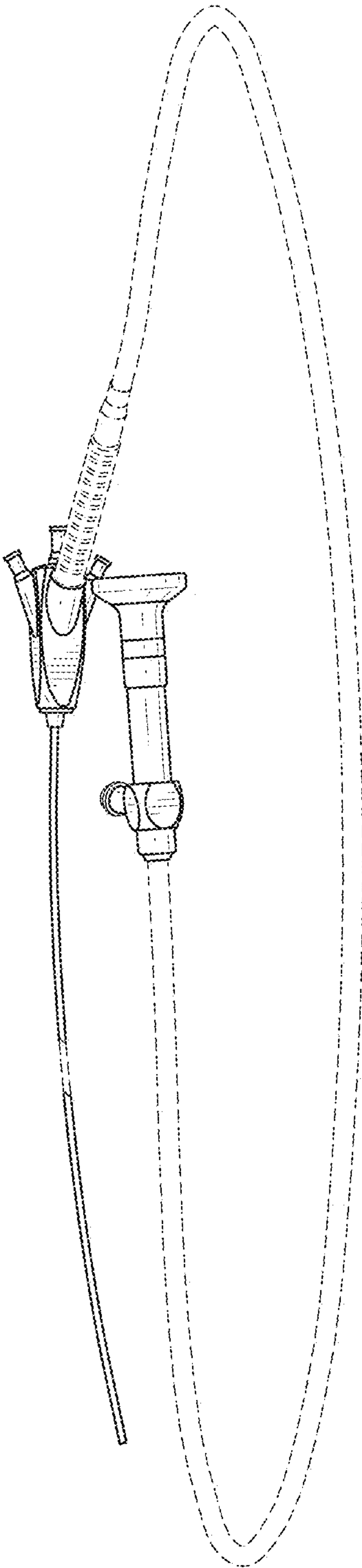

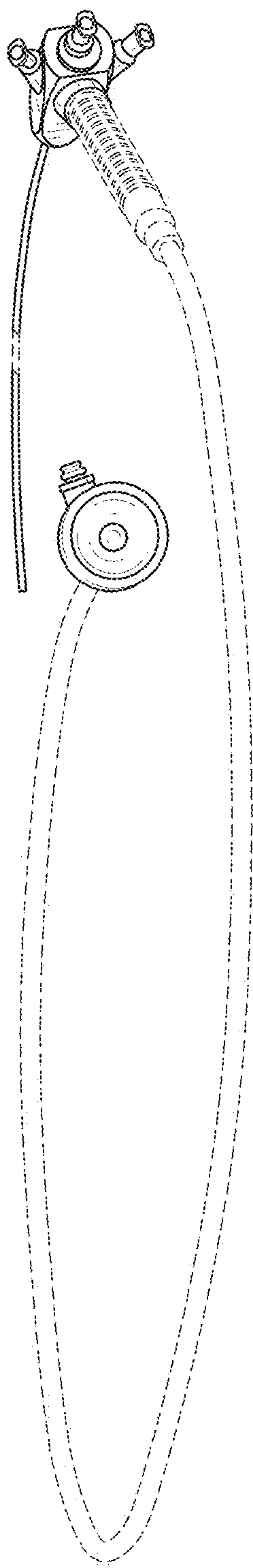

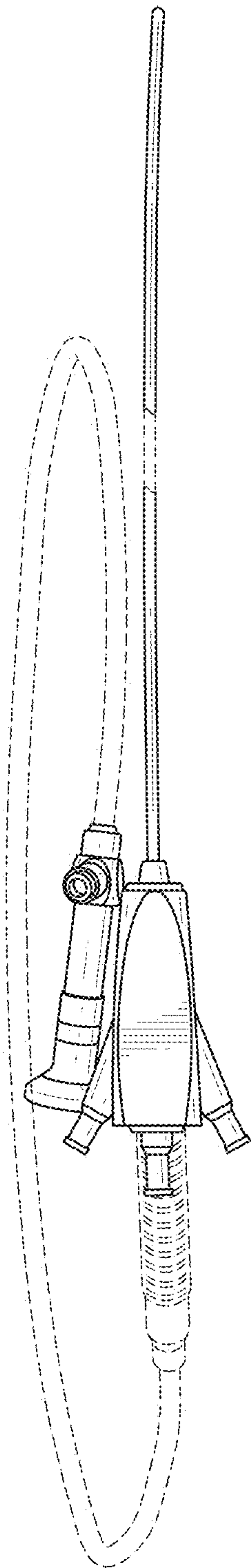

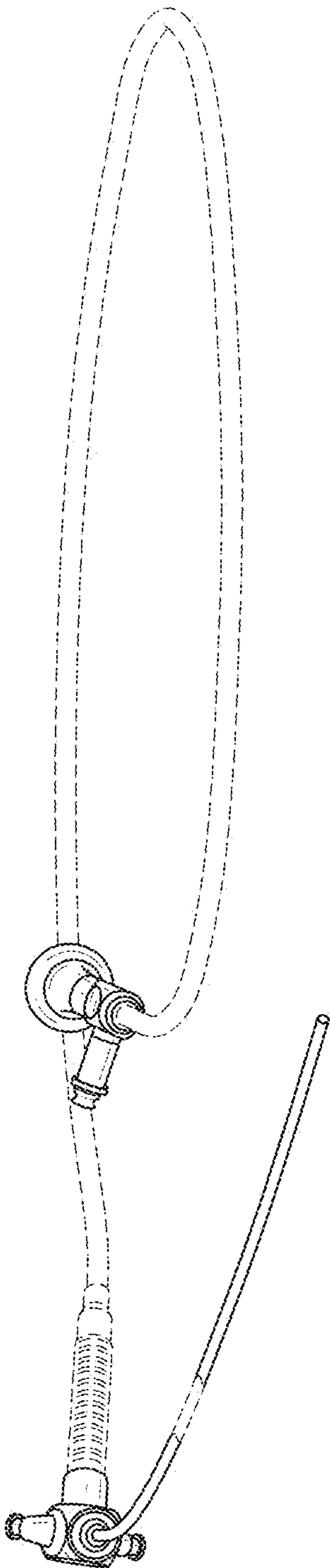

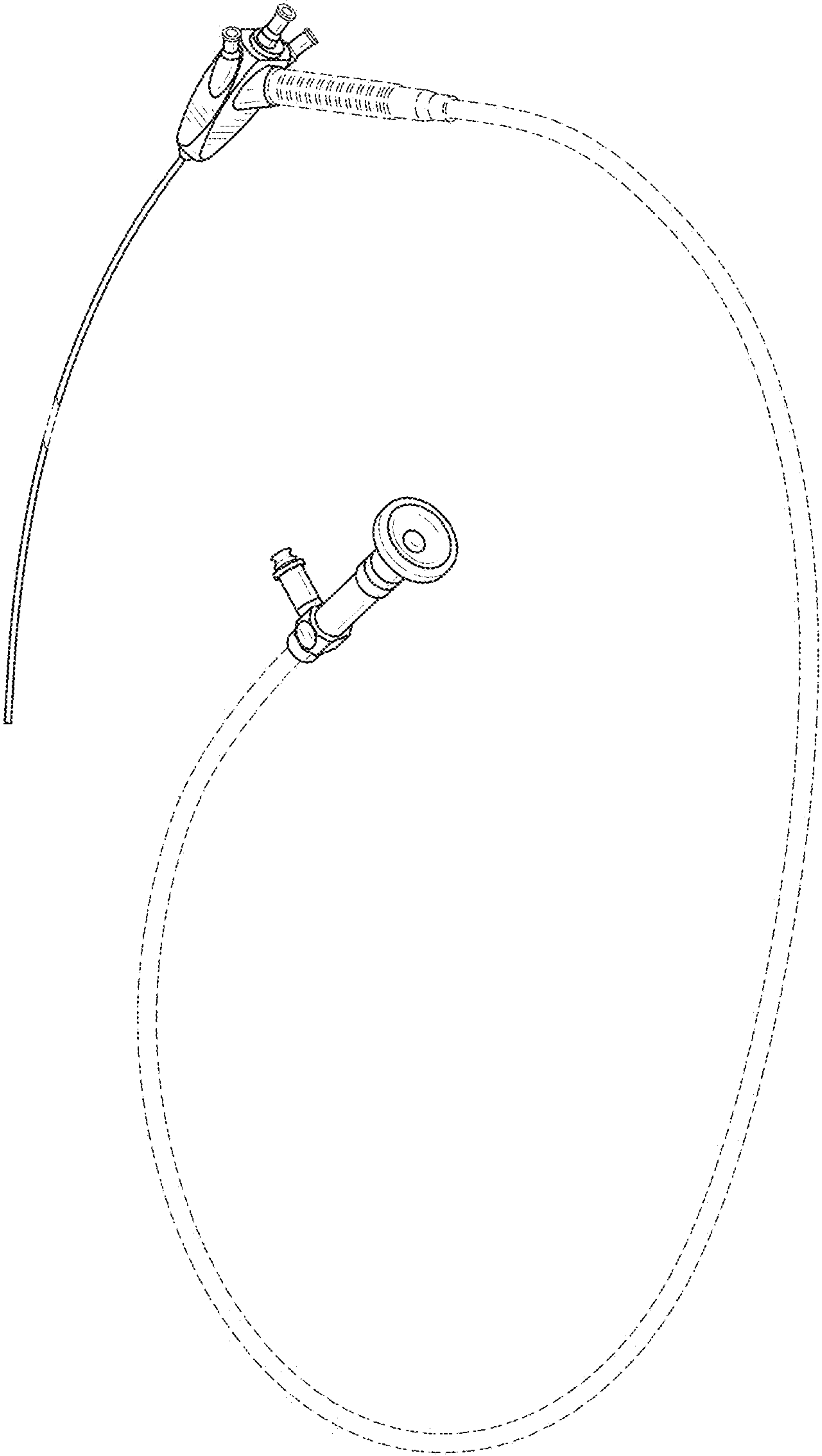

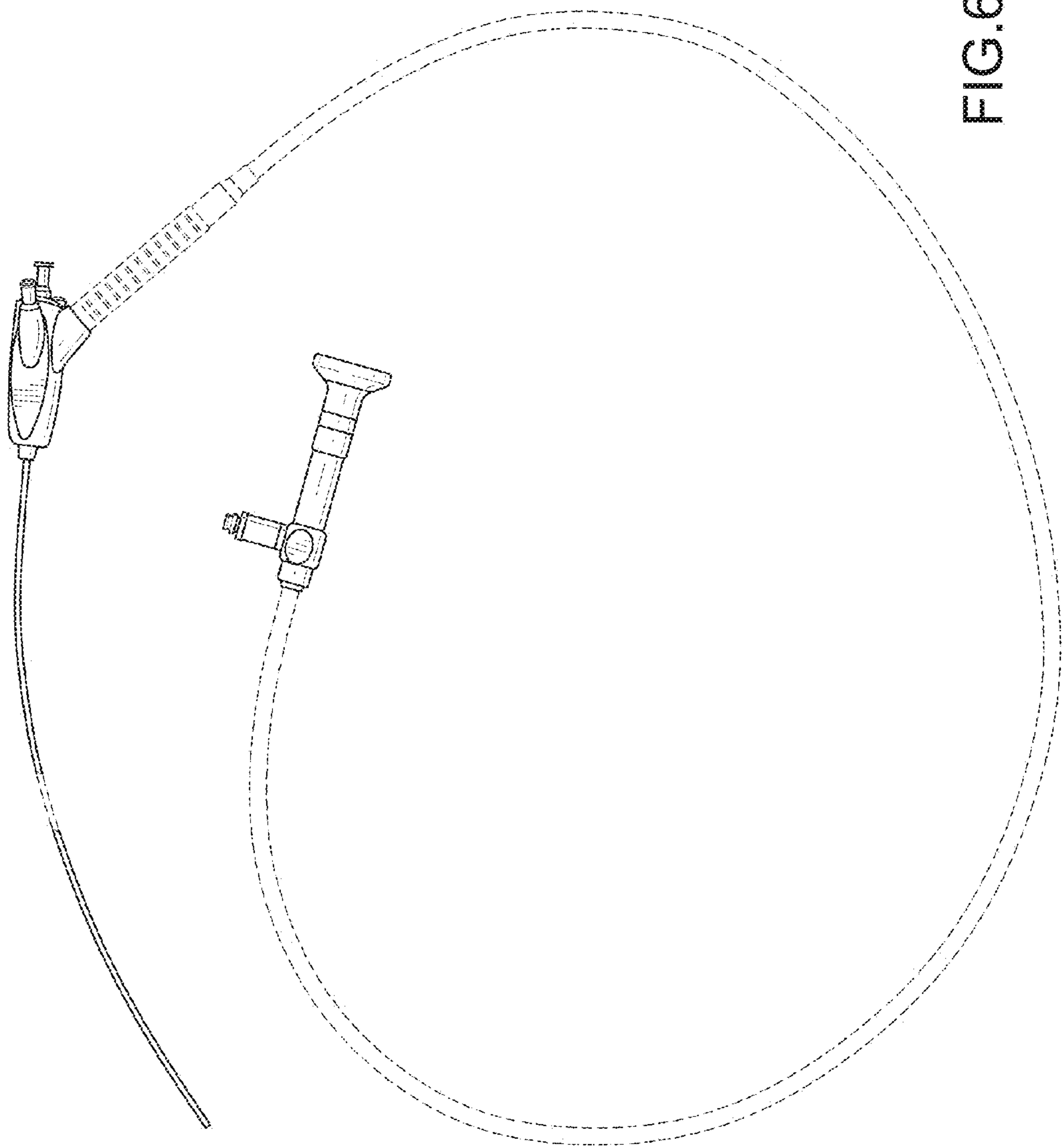
