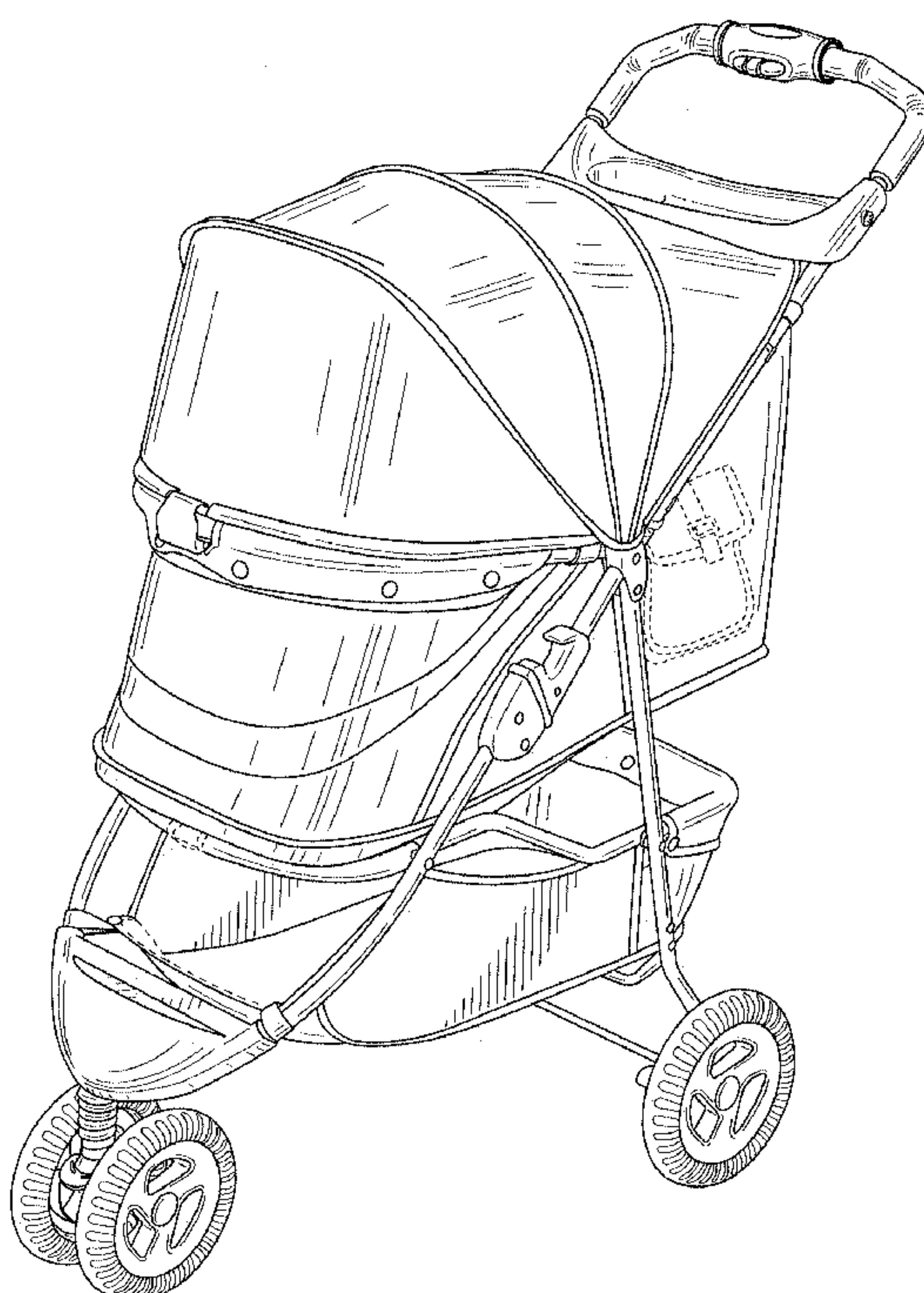
The ornamental design for a pet stroller, as shown and described.

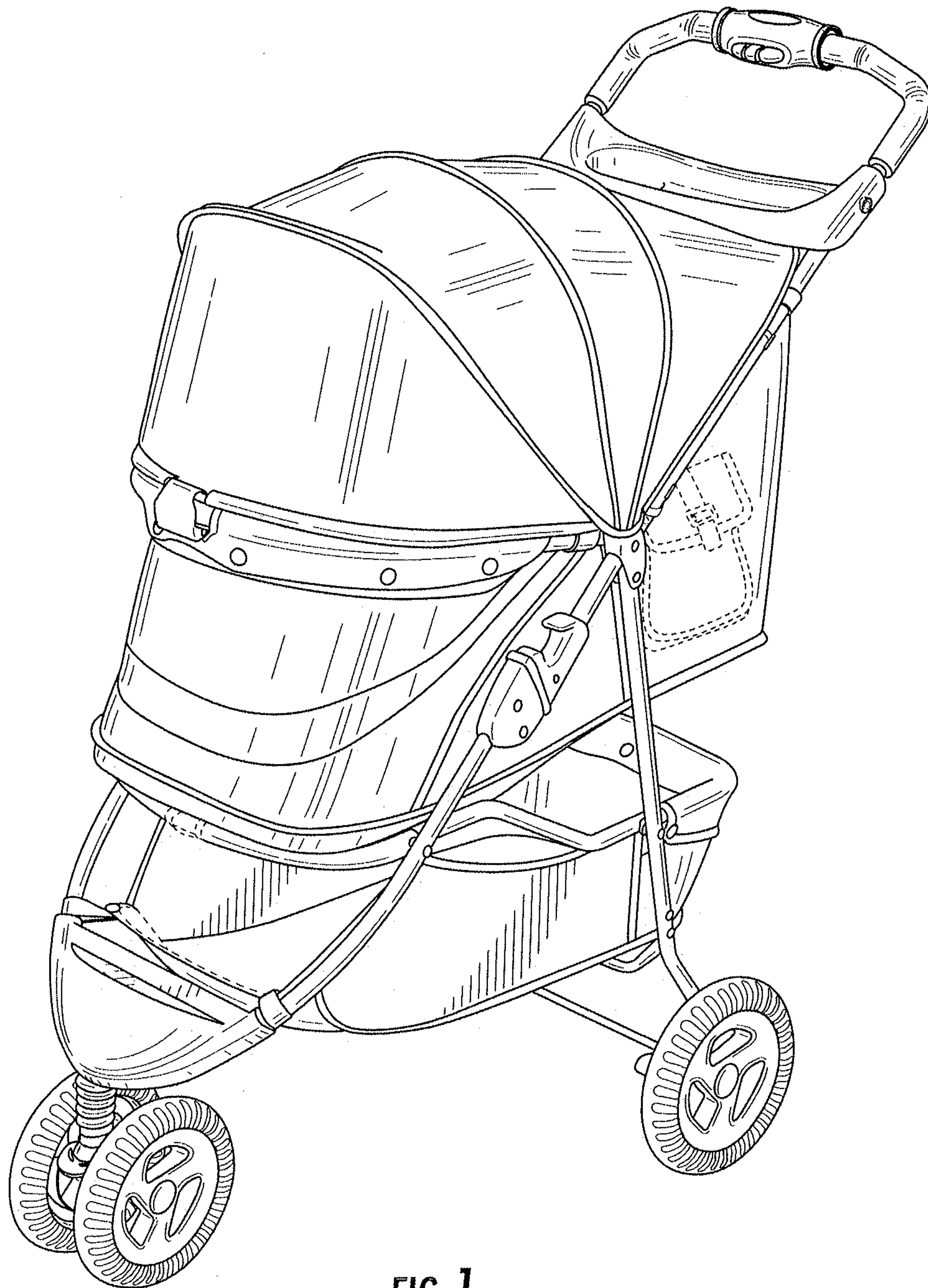

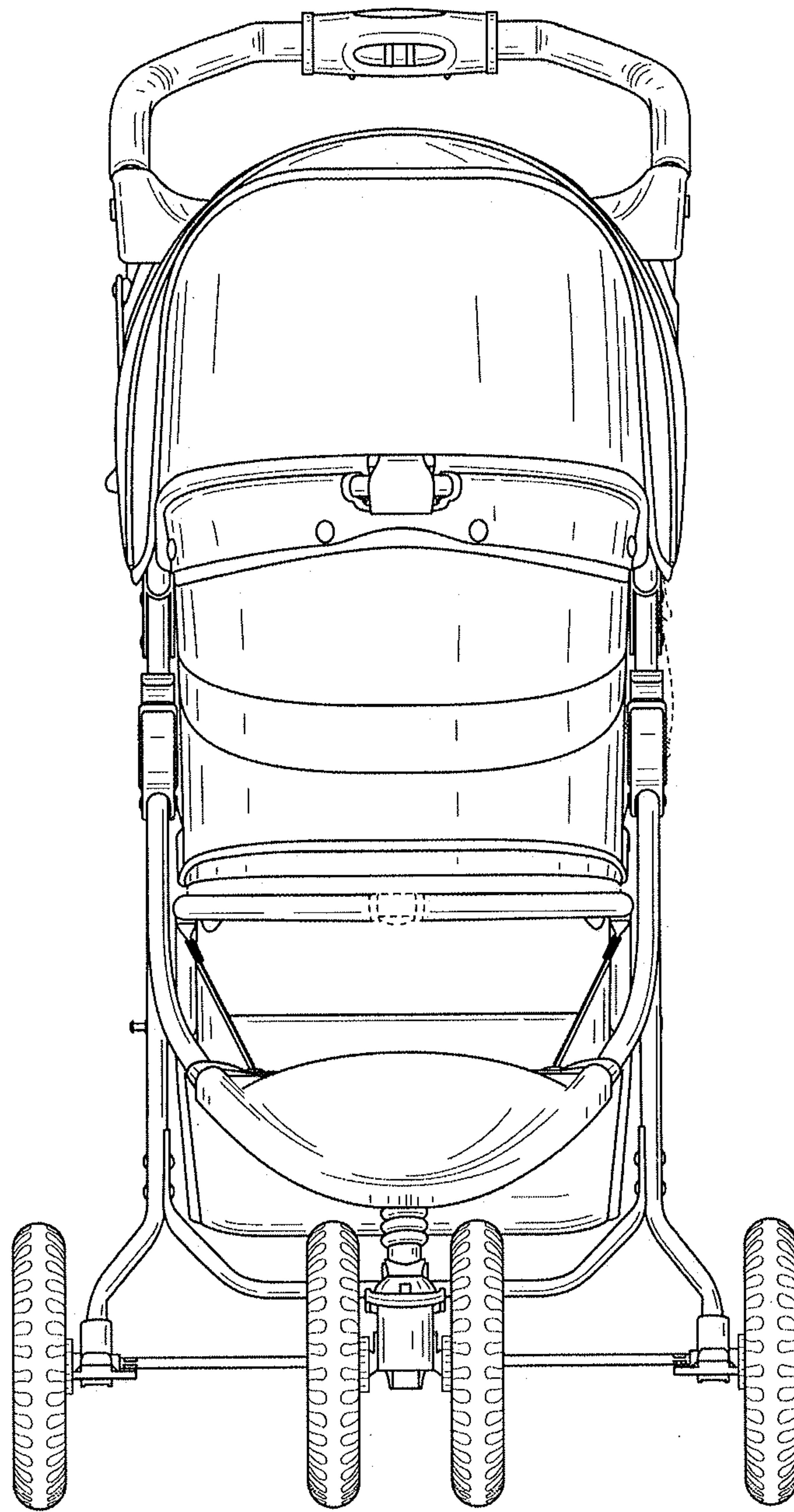

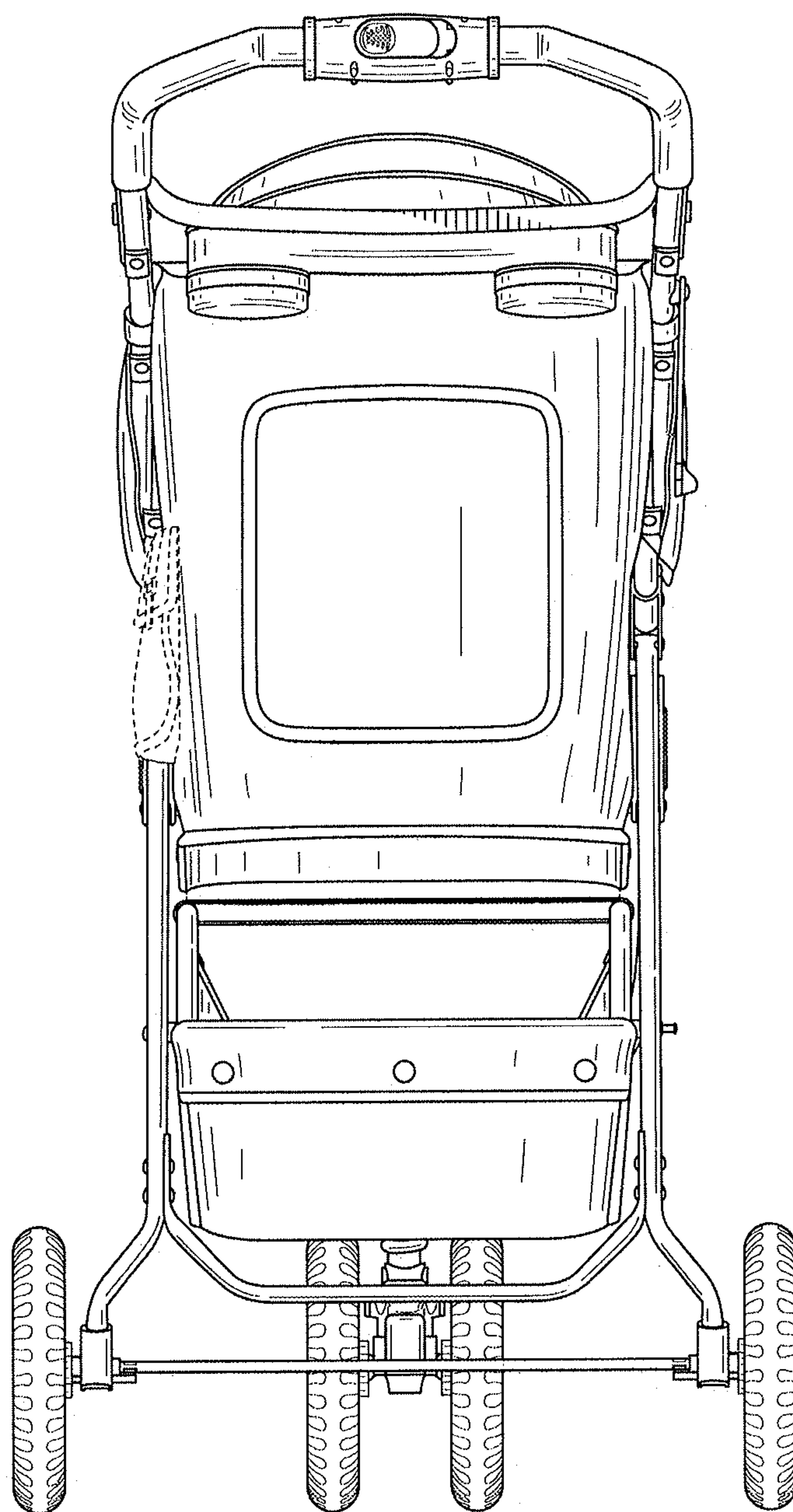

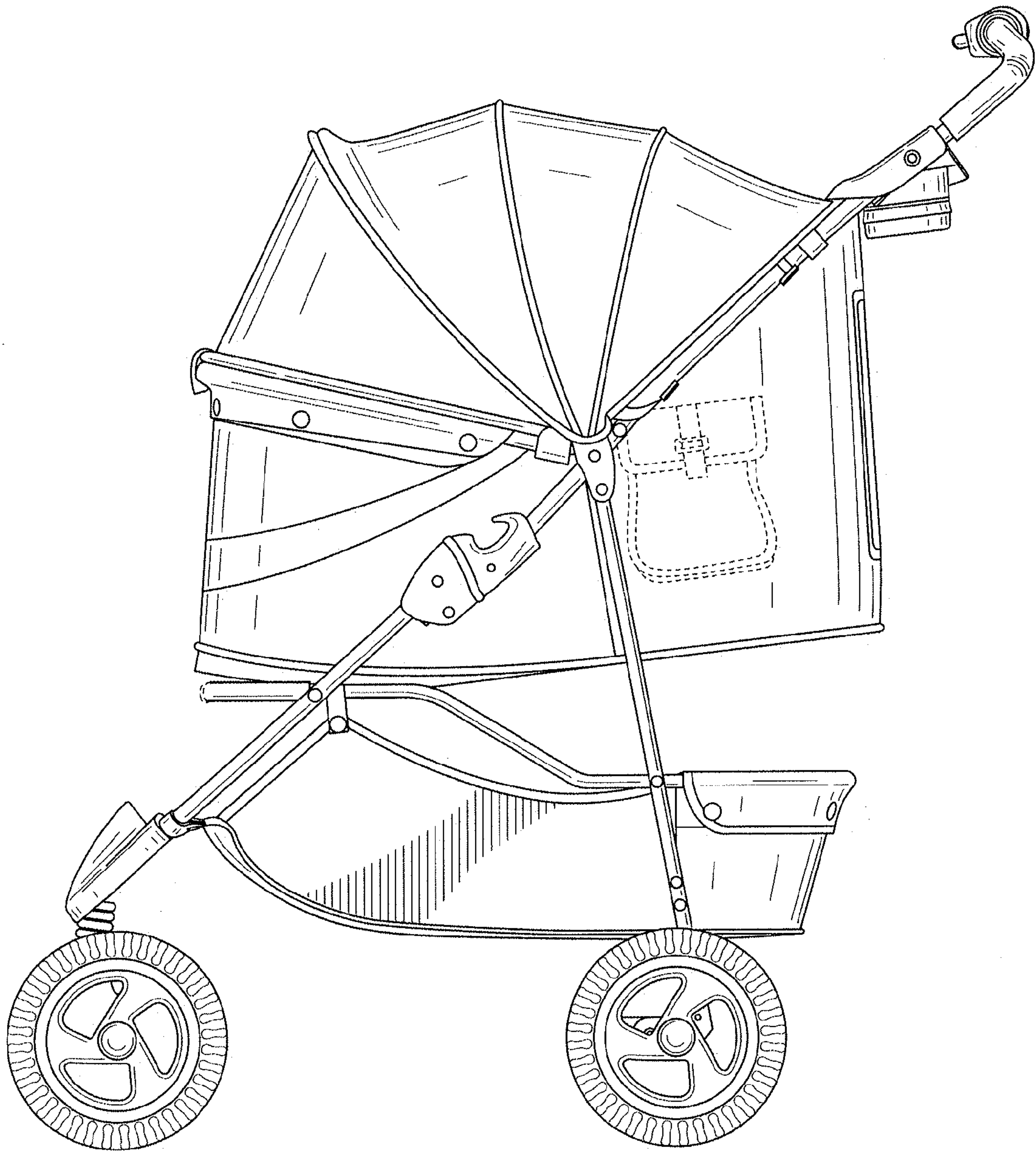

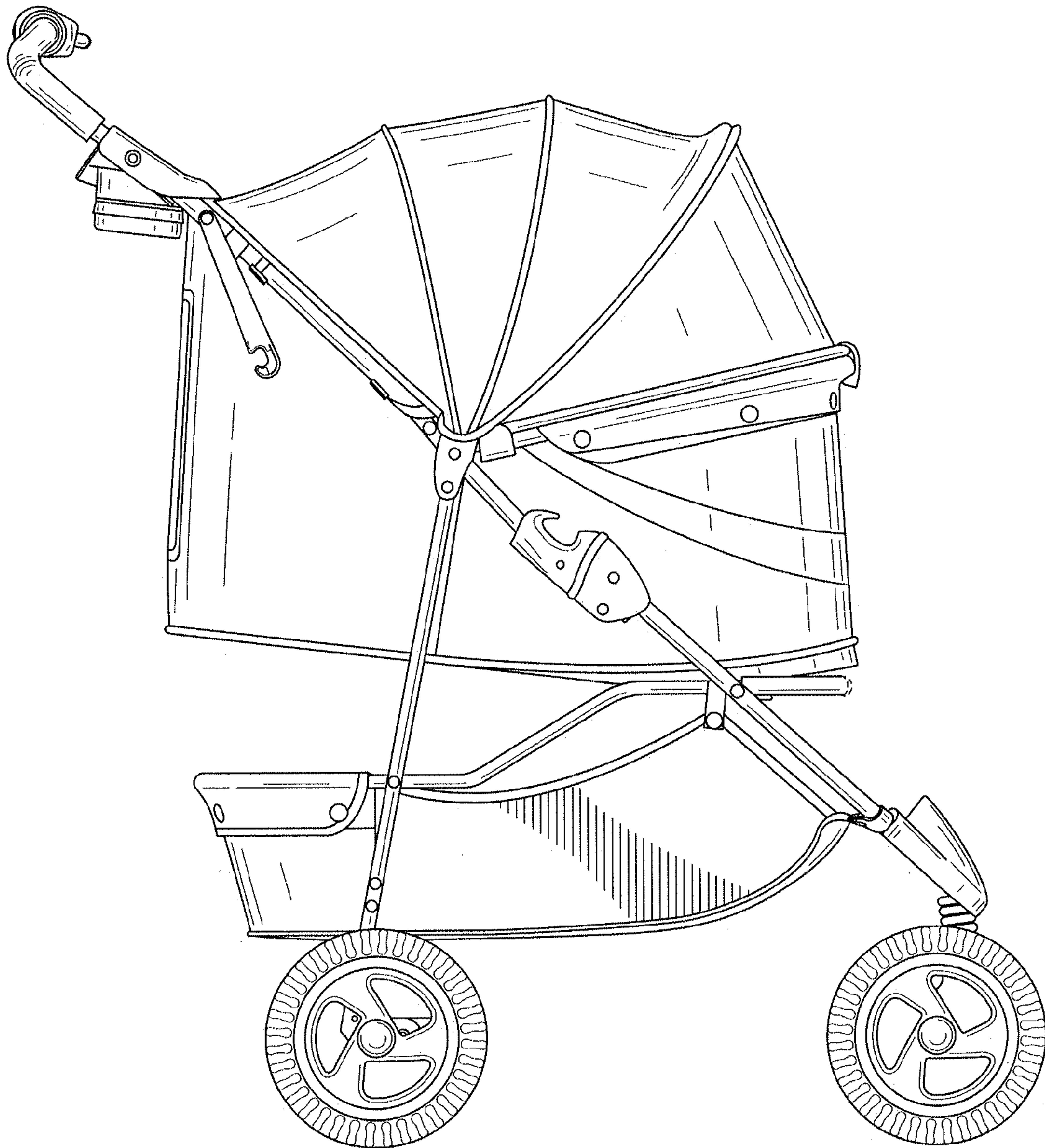

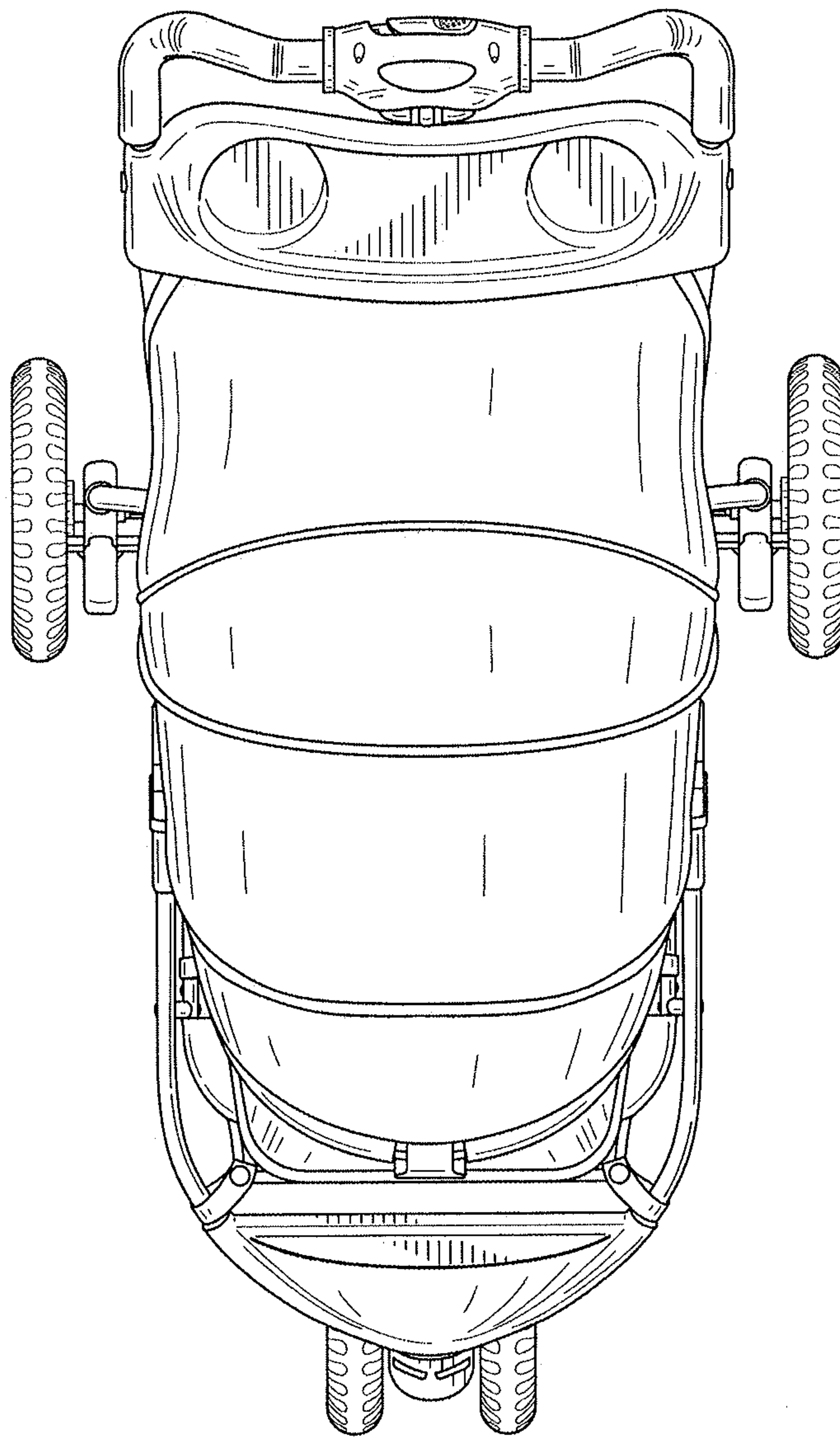

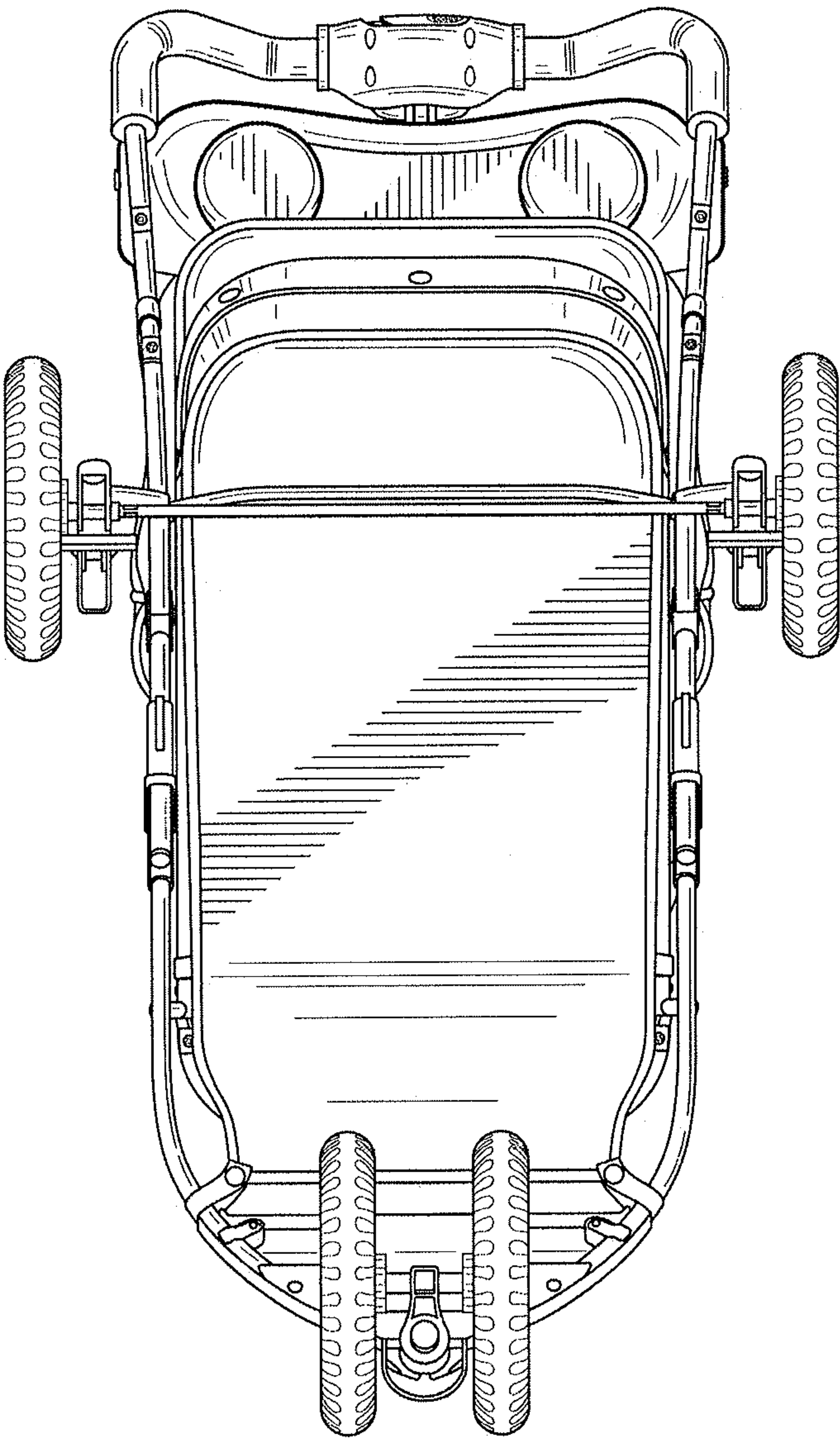
