The ornamental design for a footwear sole, as shown and described.

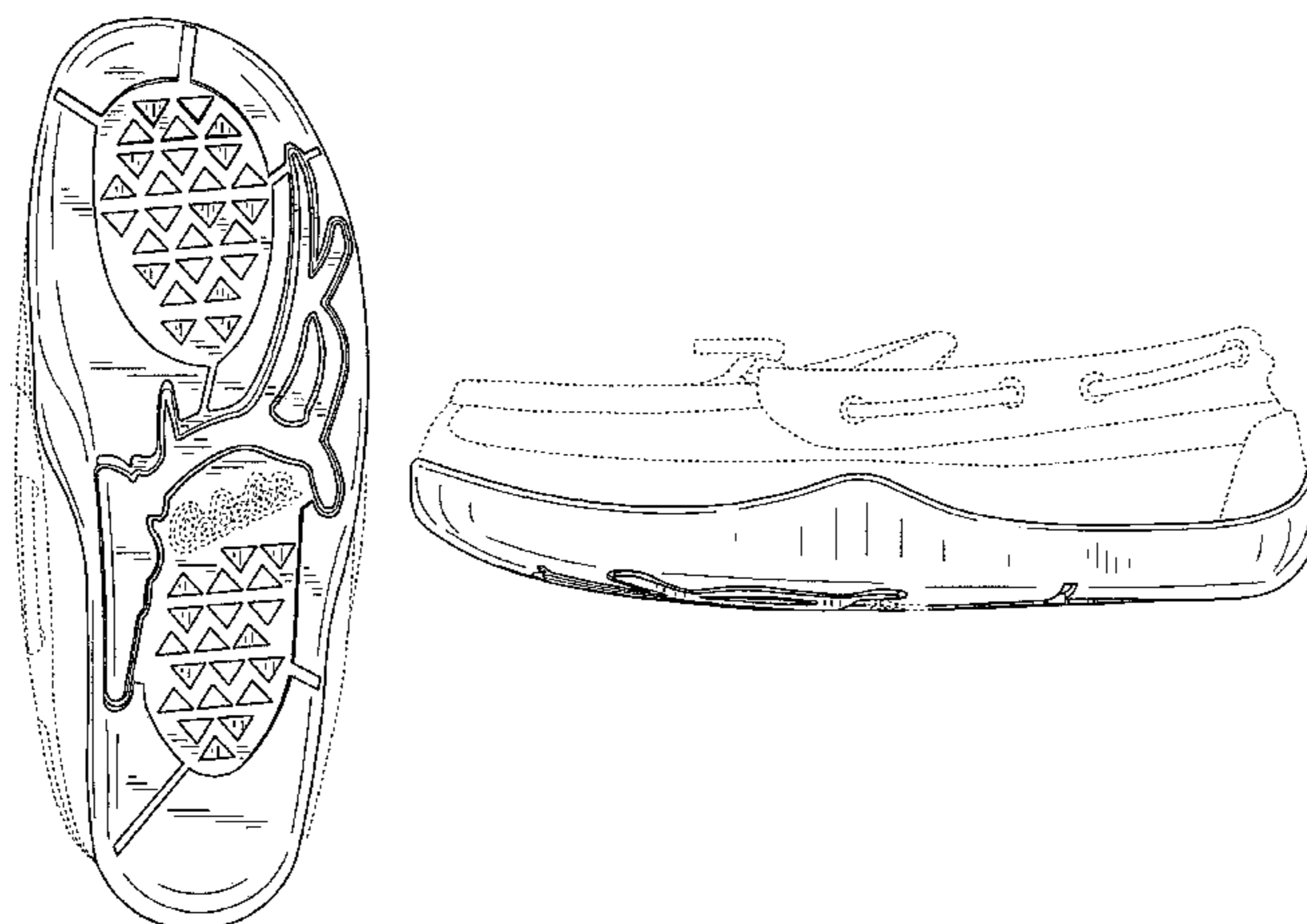
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom, right perspective view of a footwear sole according to my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of a mirror image embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, this embodiment of the design also having views that are mirror images of the views shown in FIGS. 1 and 3-7; and,  
 FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the design of FIG. 1 shown alongside mirror image environment.  
 The broken line representations in the figures show unclaimed environment or boundaries, and thus form no part of the claimed design.

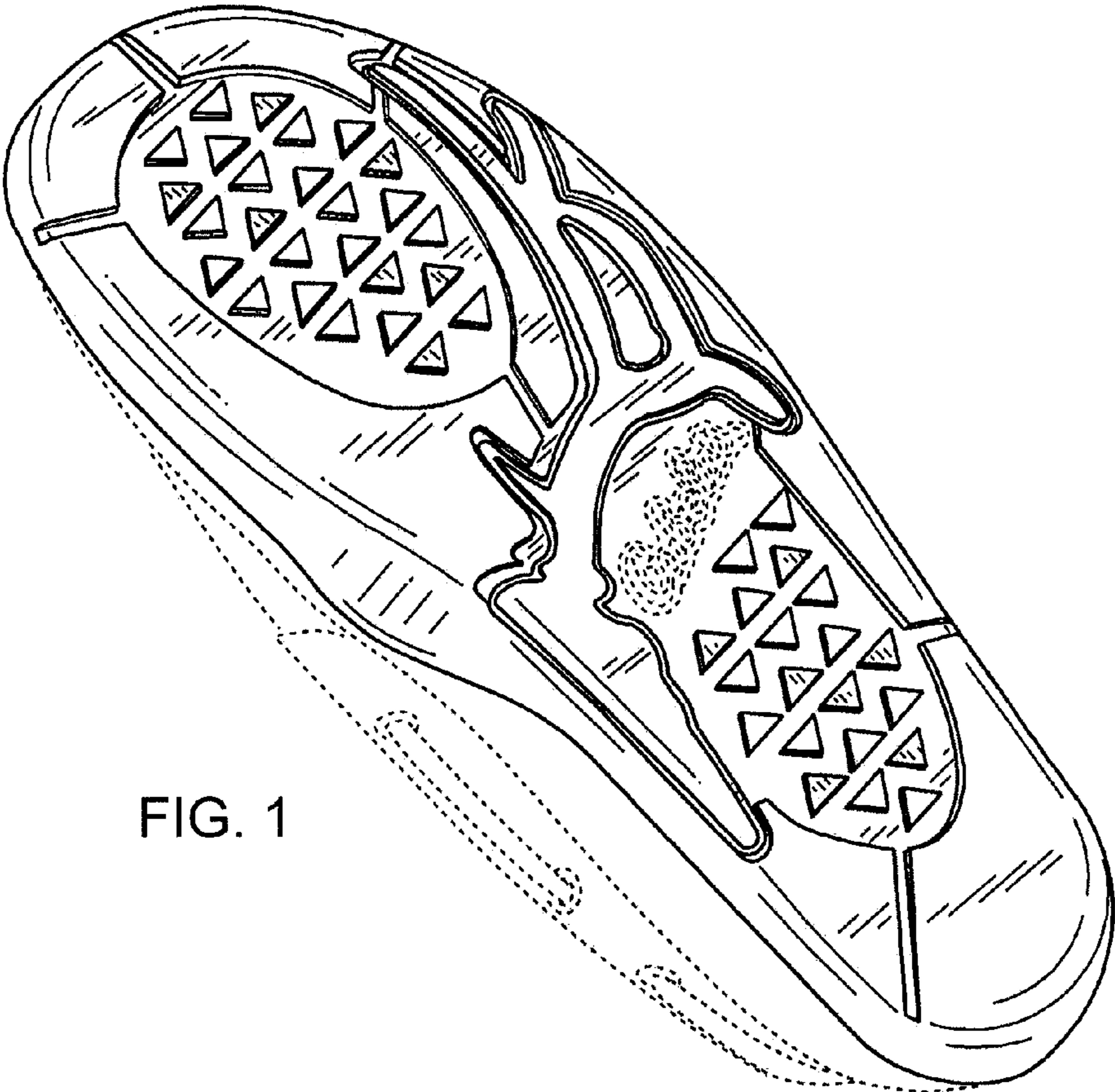

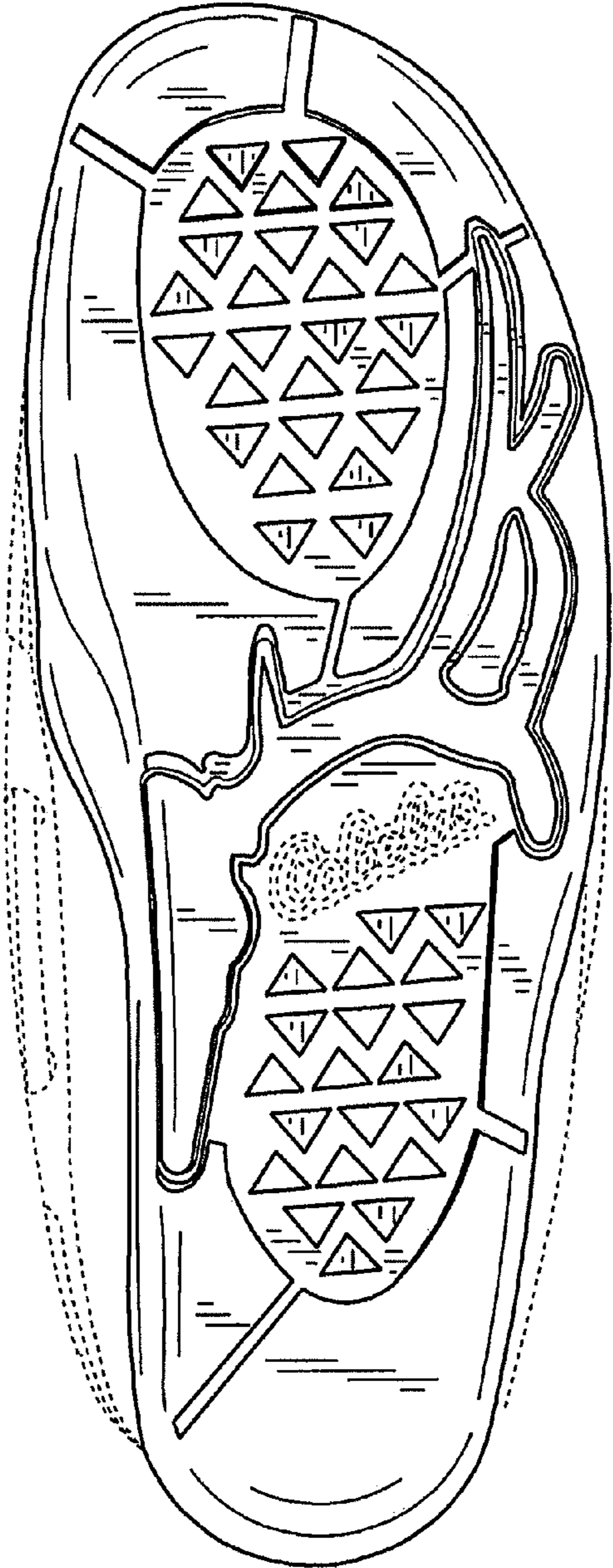

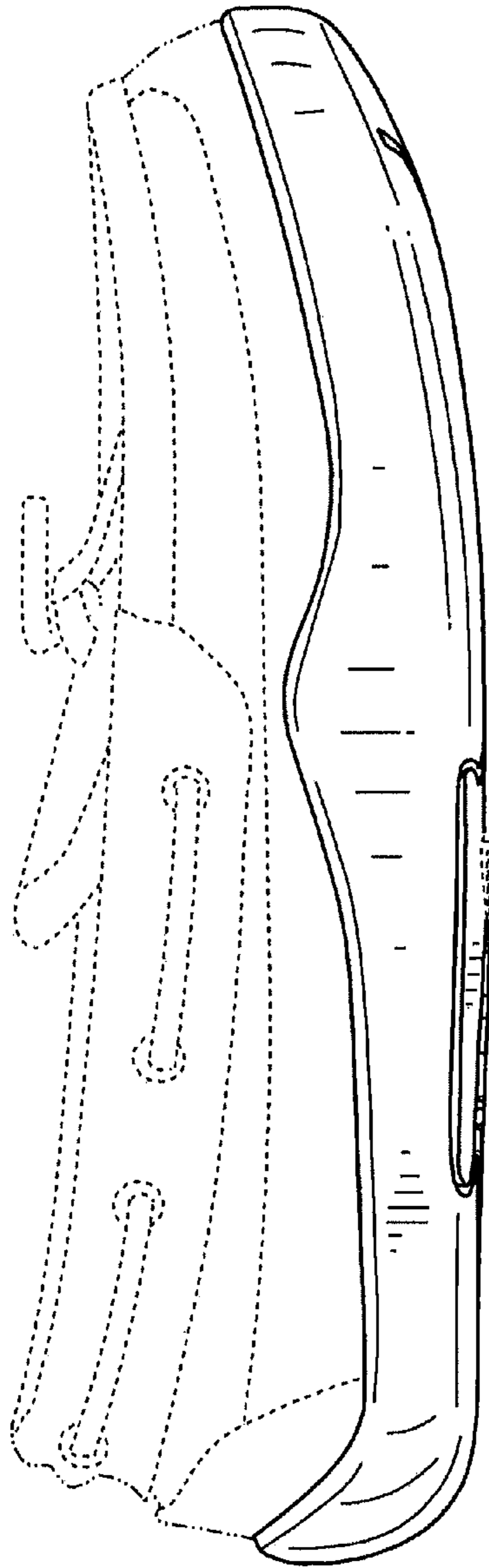

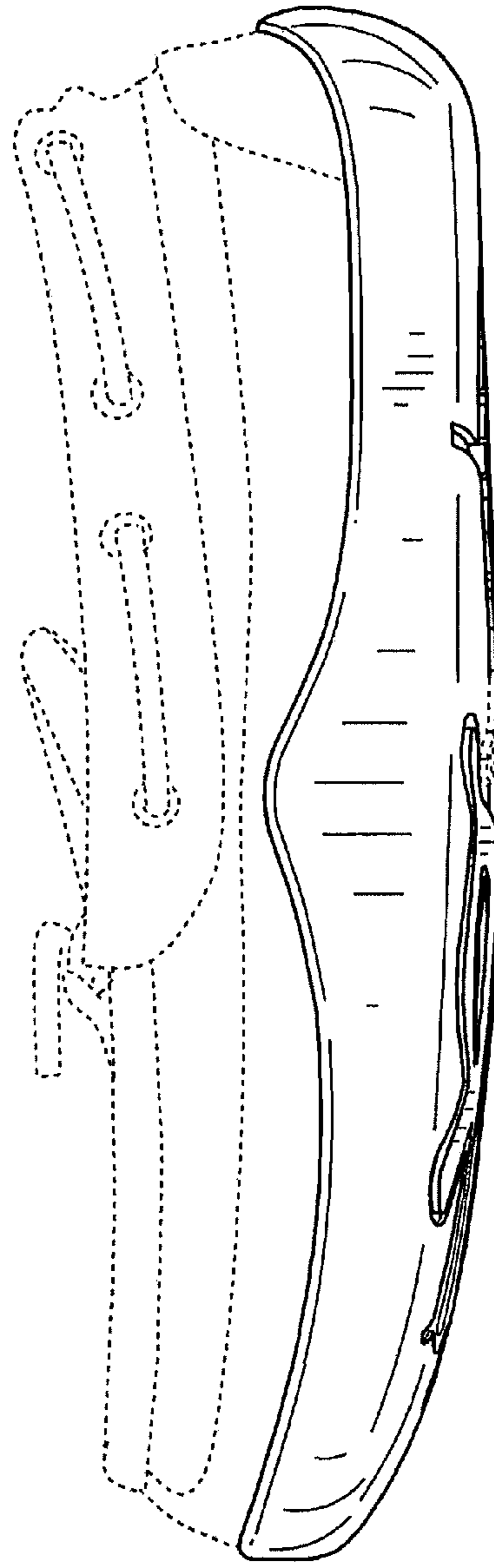

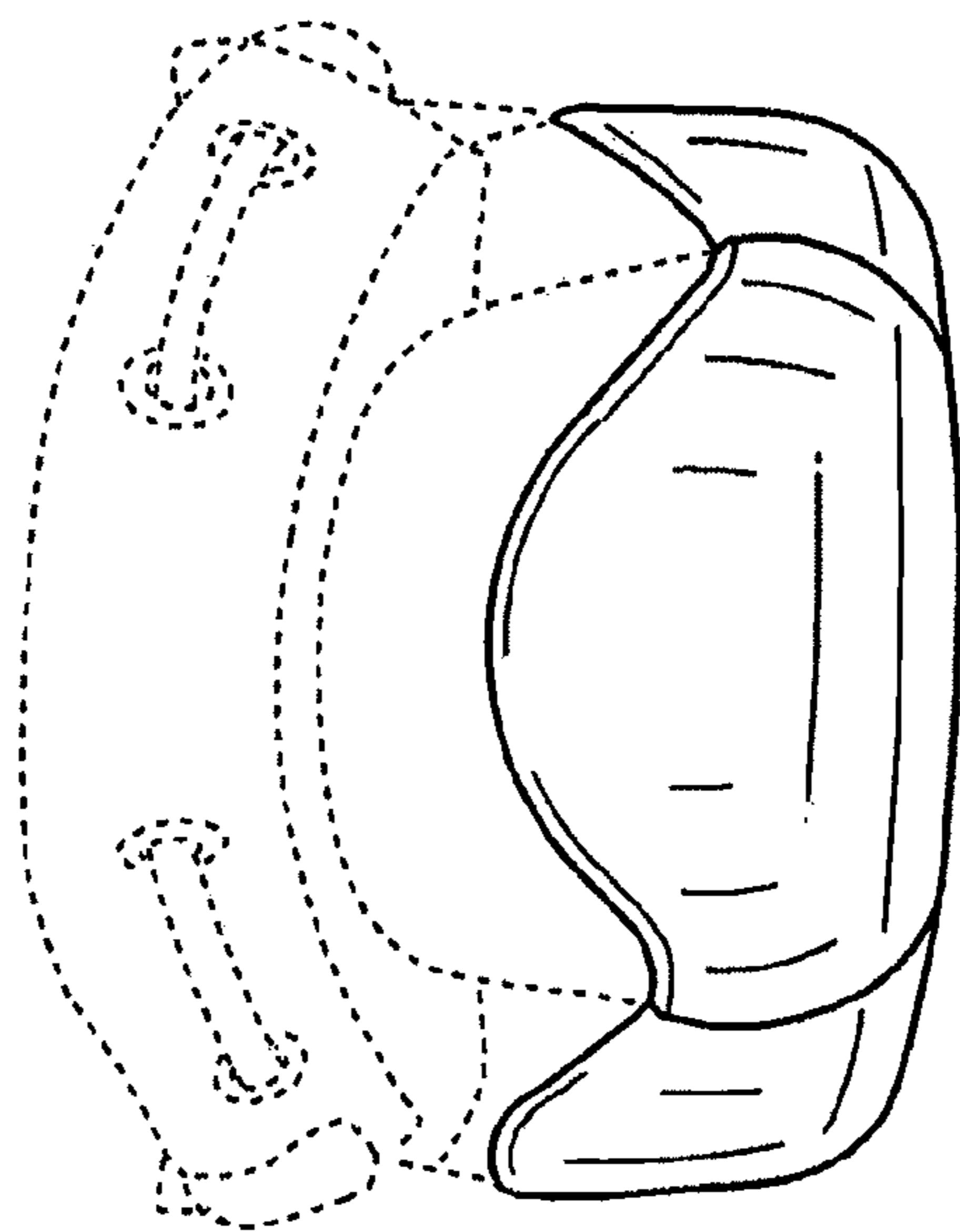

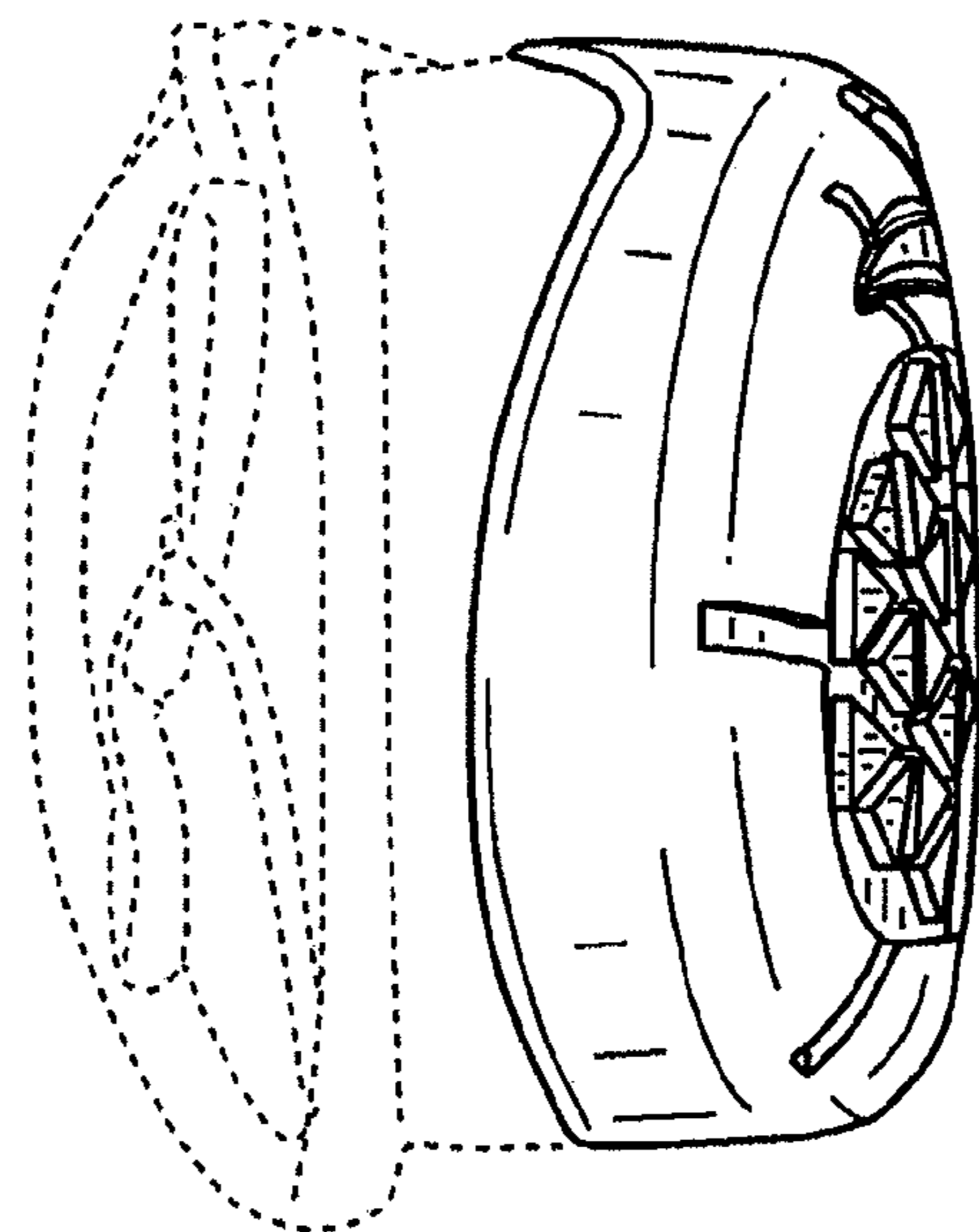

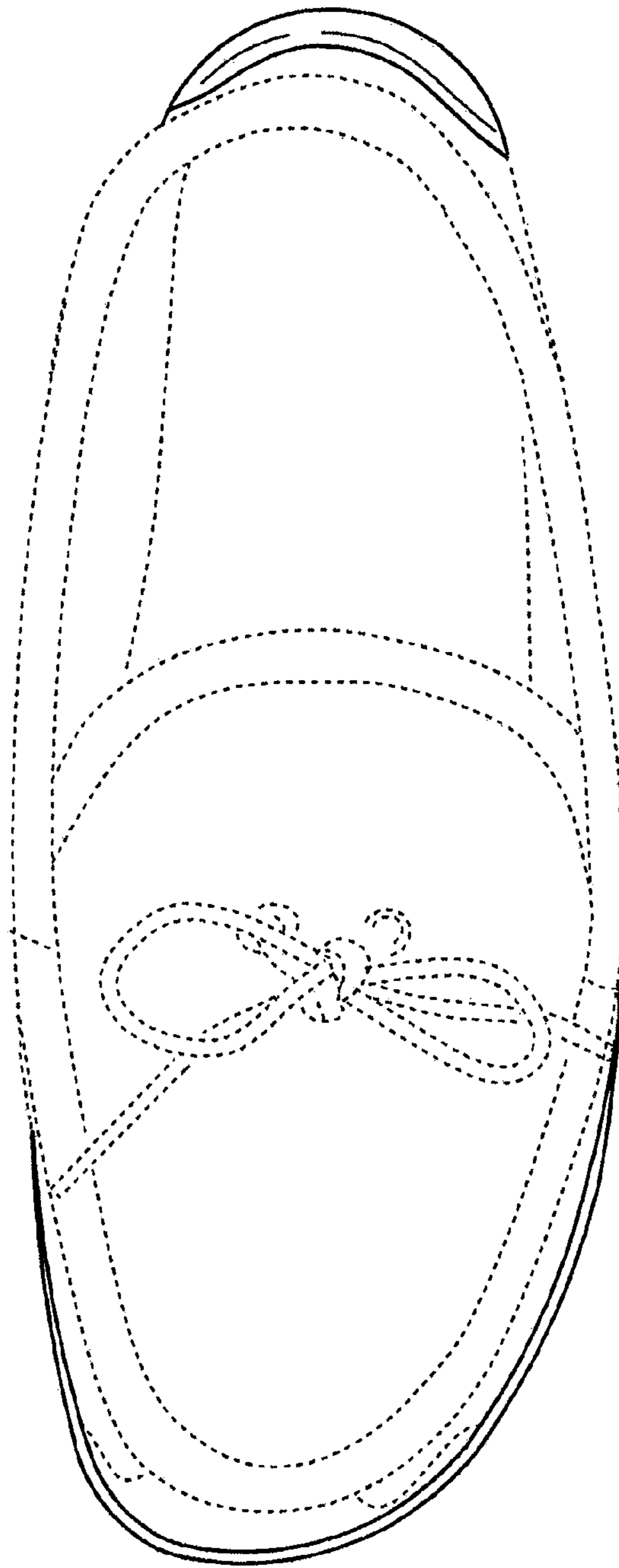

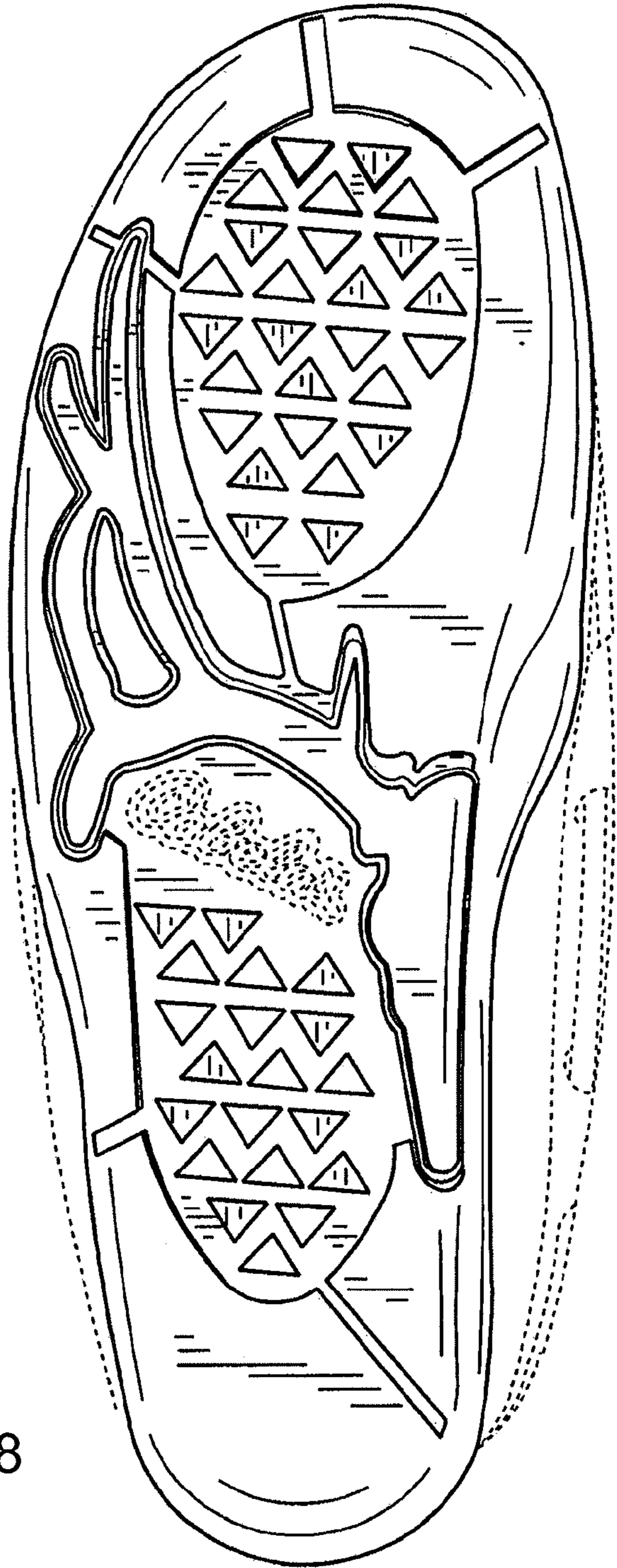

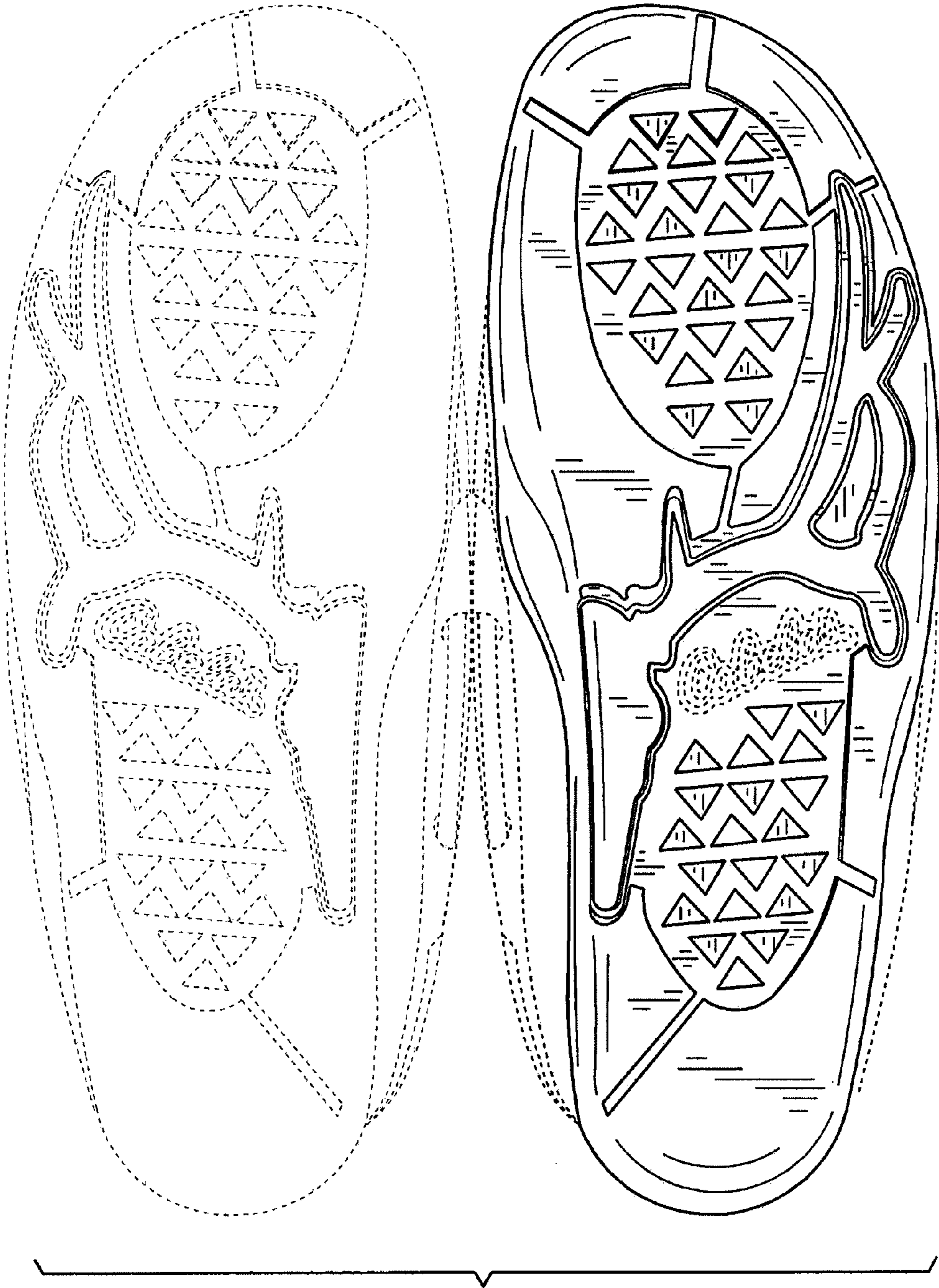
