FIG. 7 is a right front perspective view thereof;

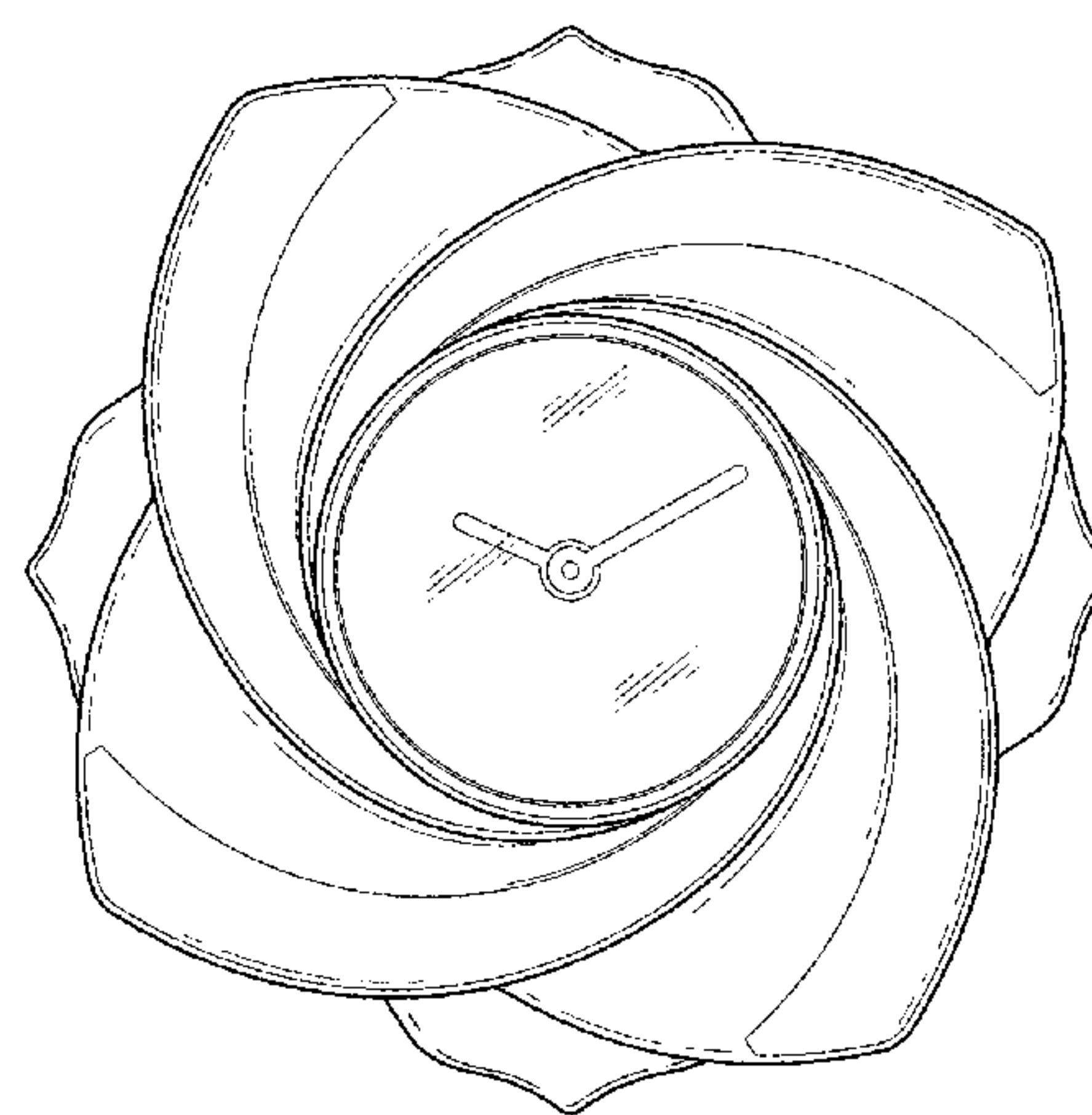
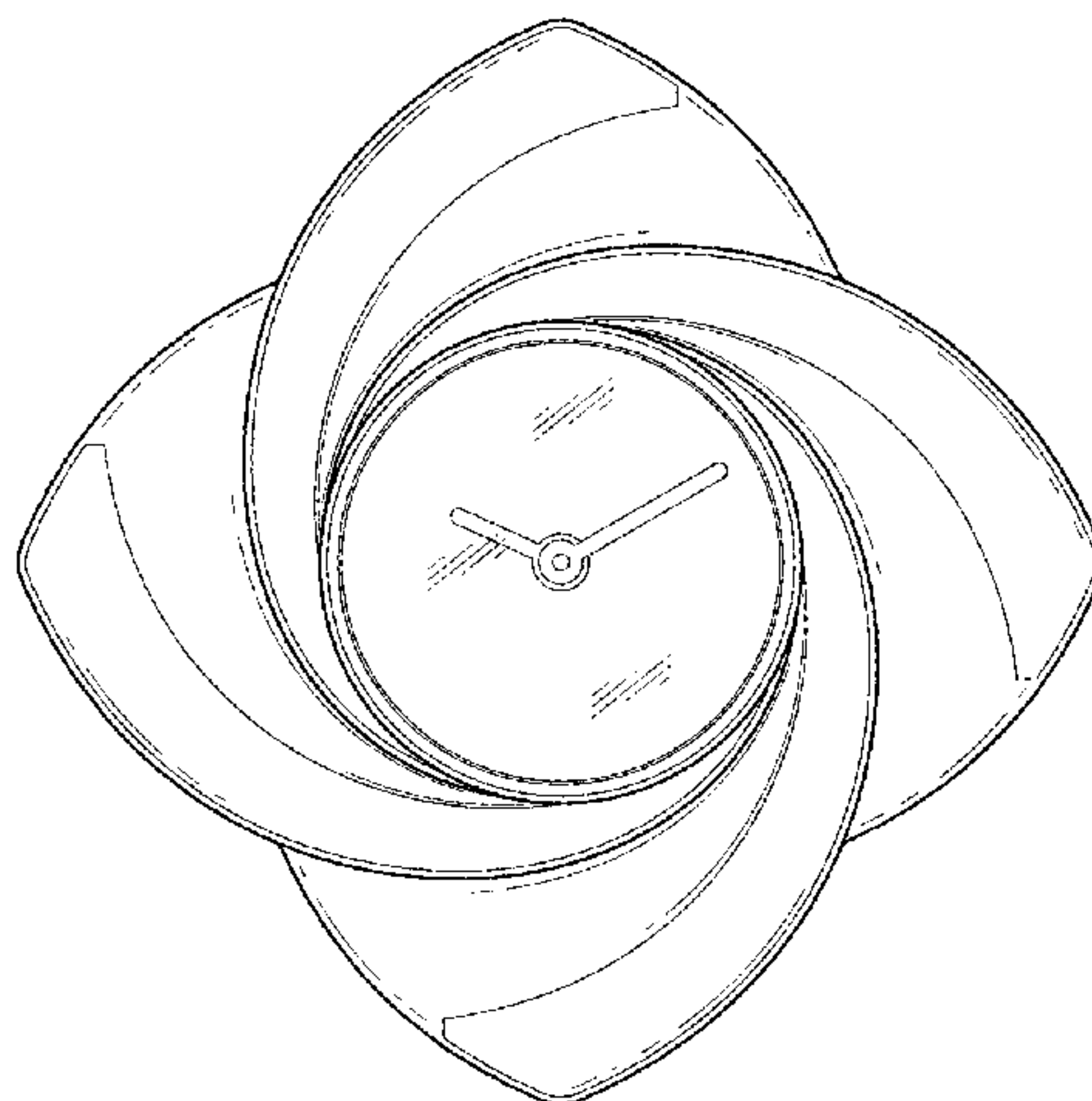
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view with the petals in a first partially rotated position;

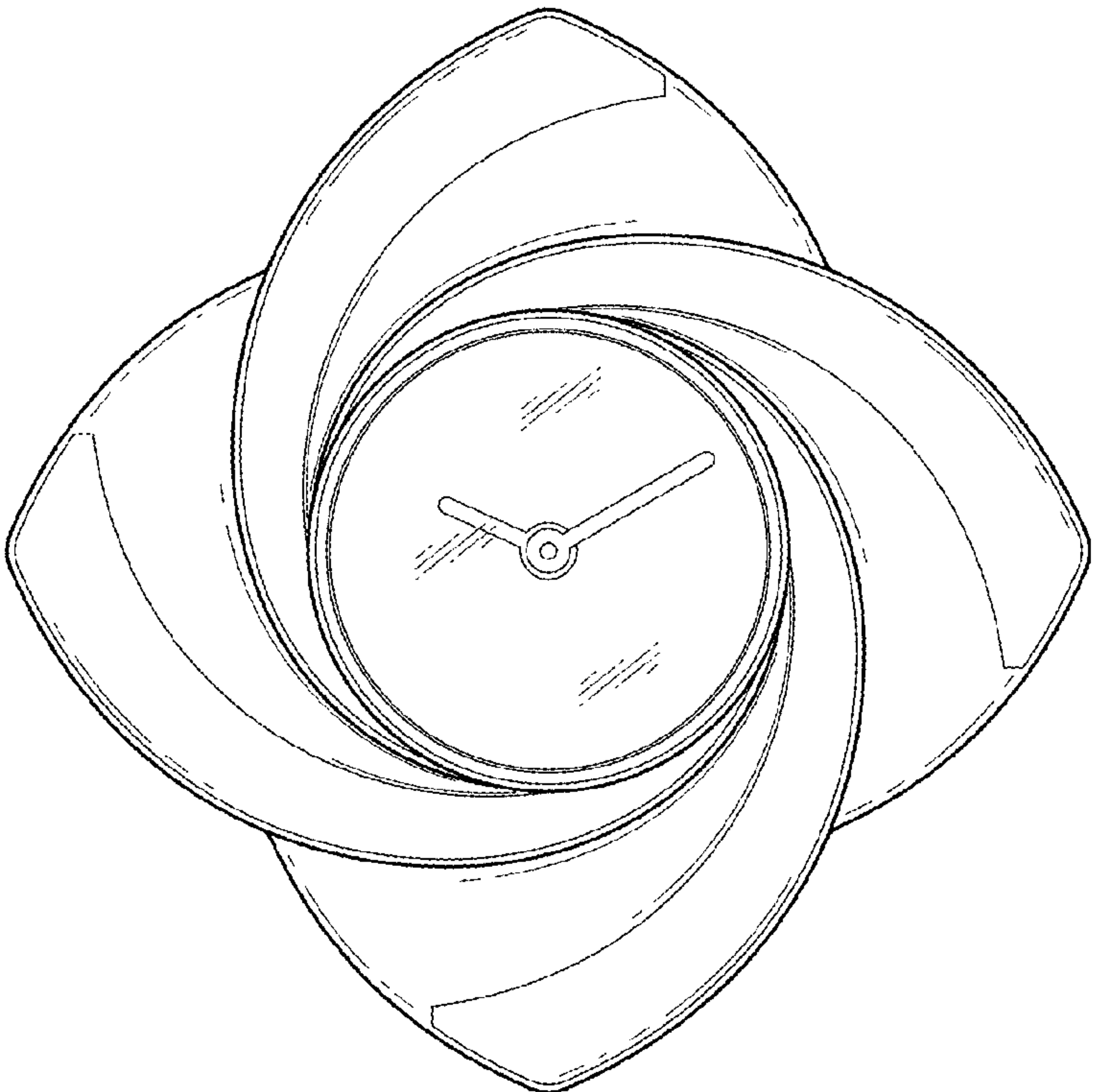

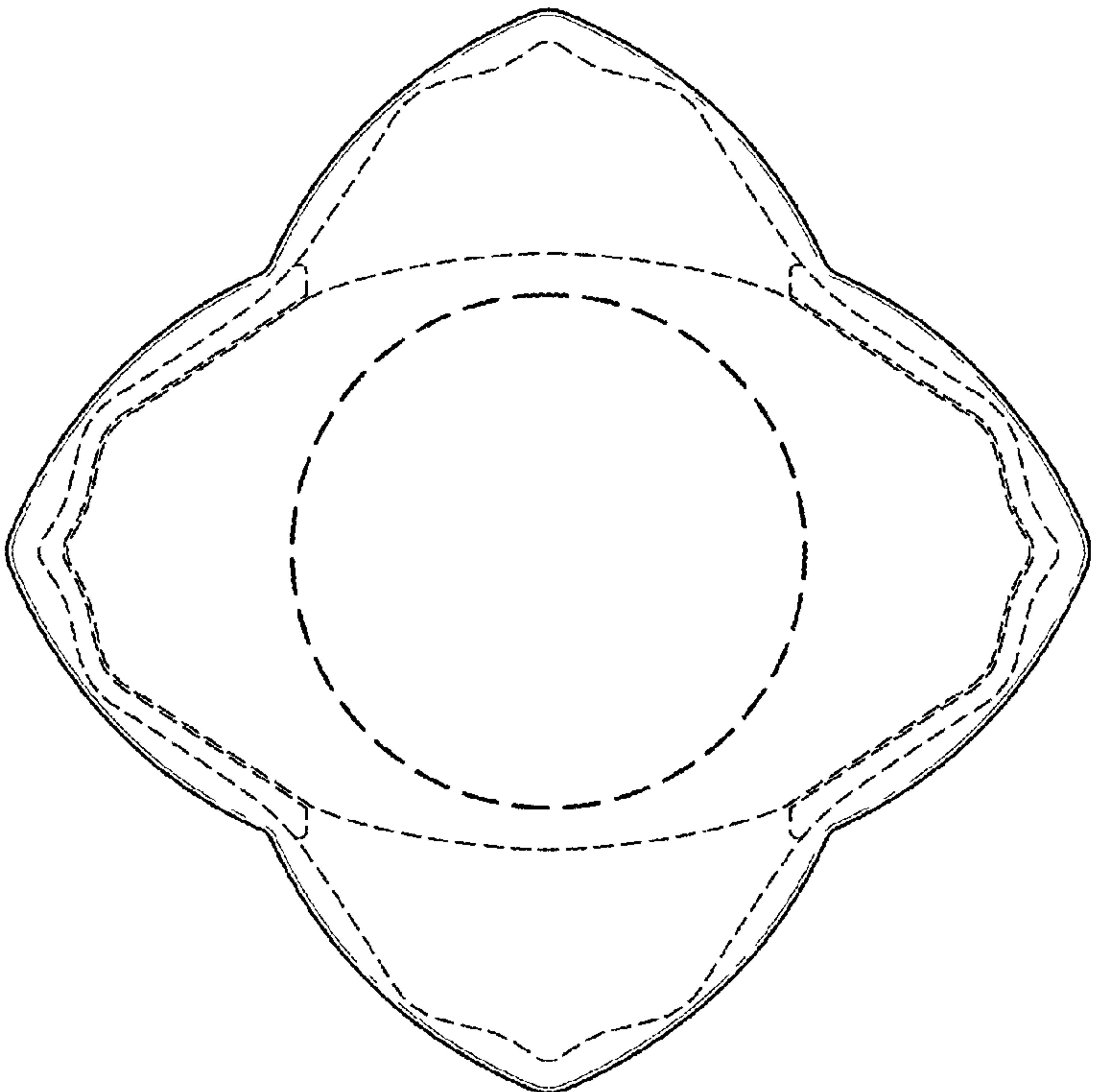

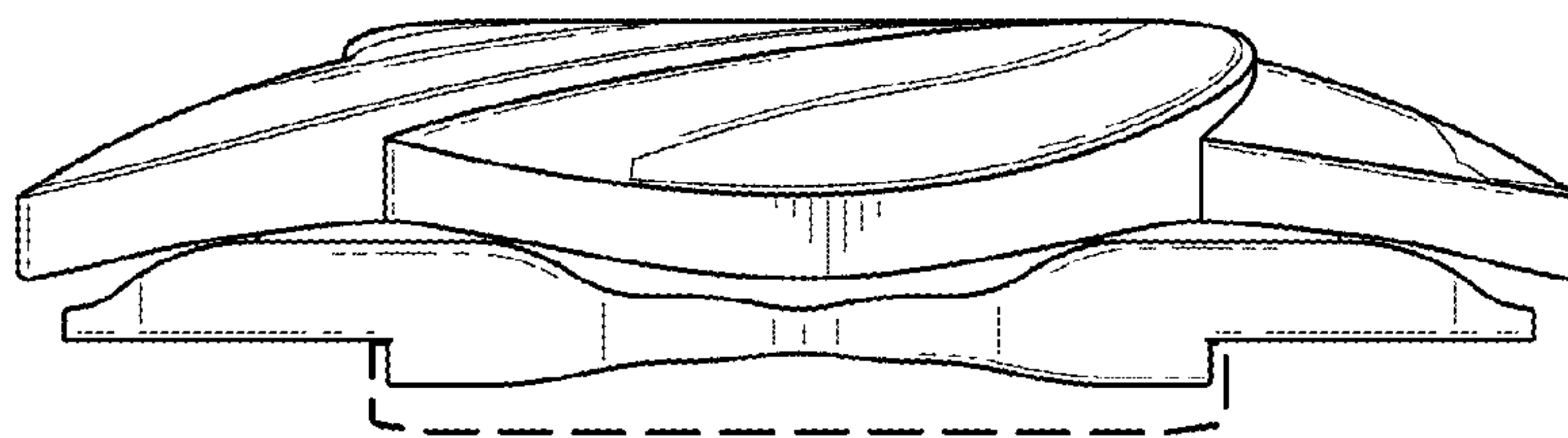

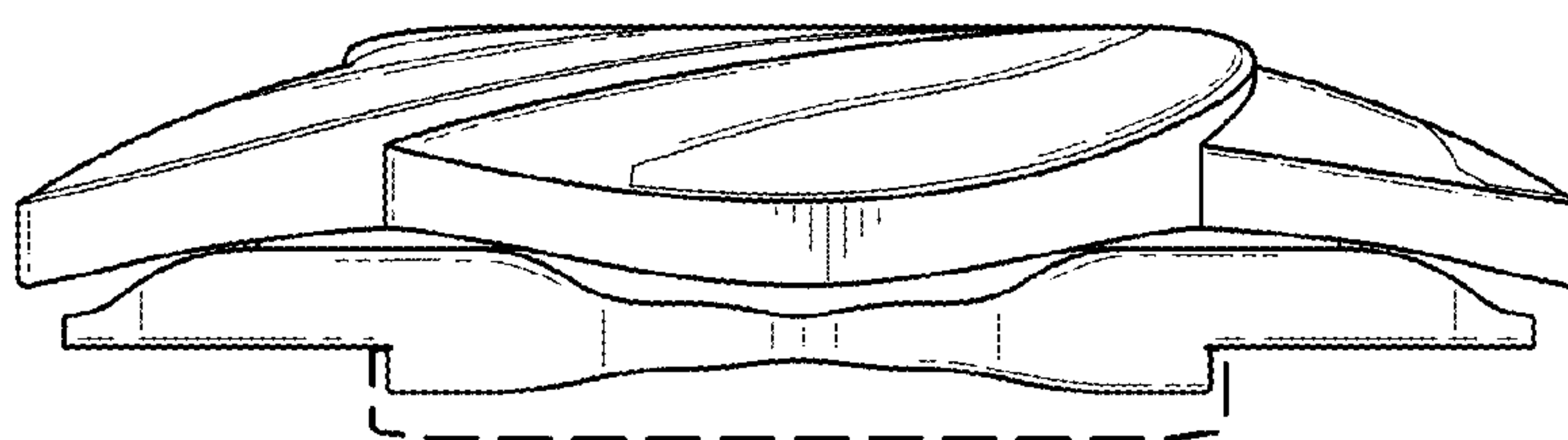

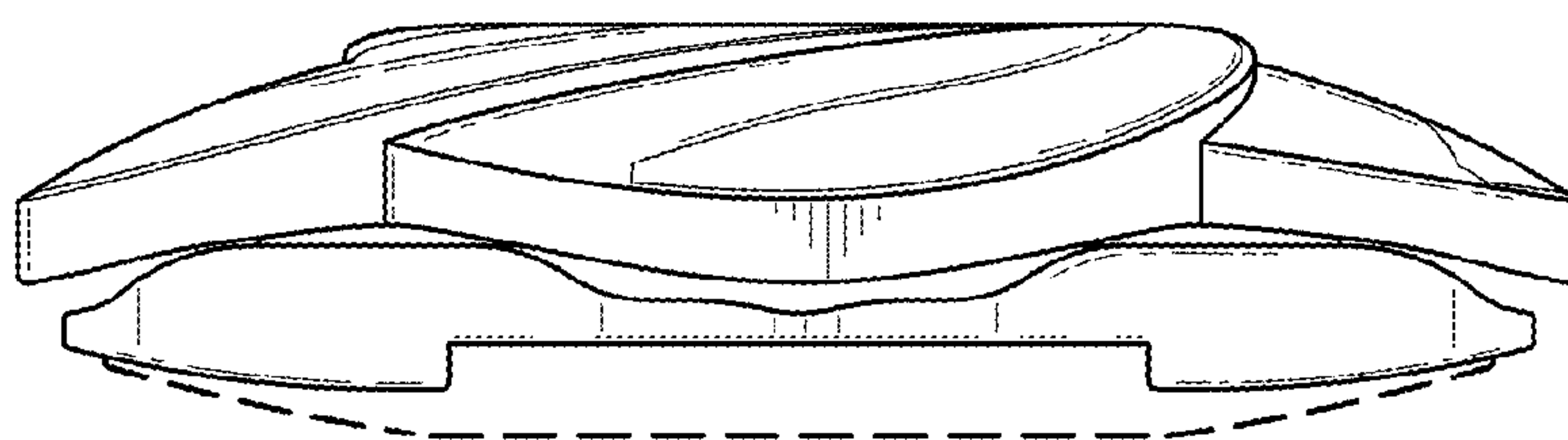

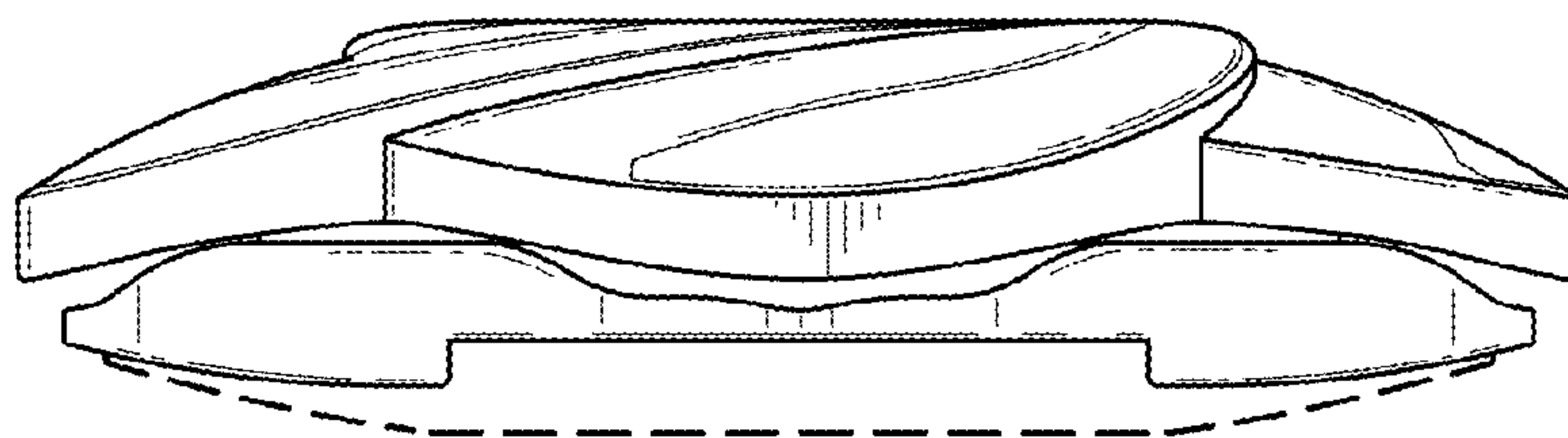

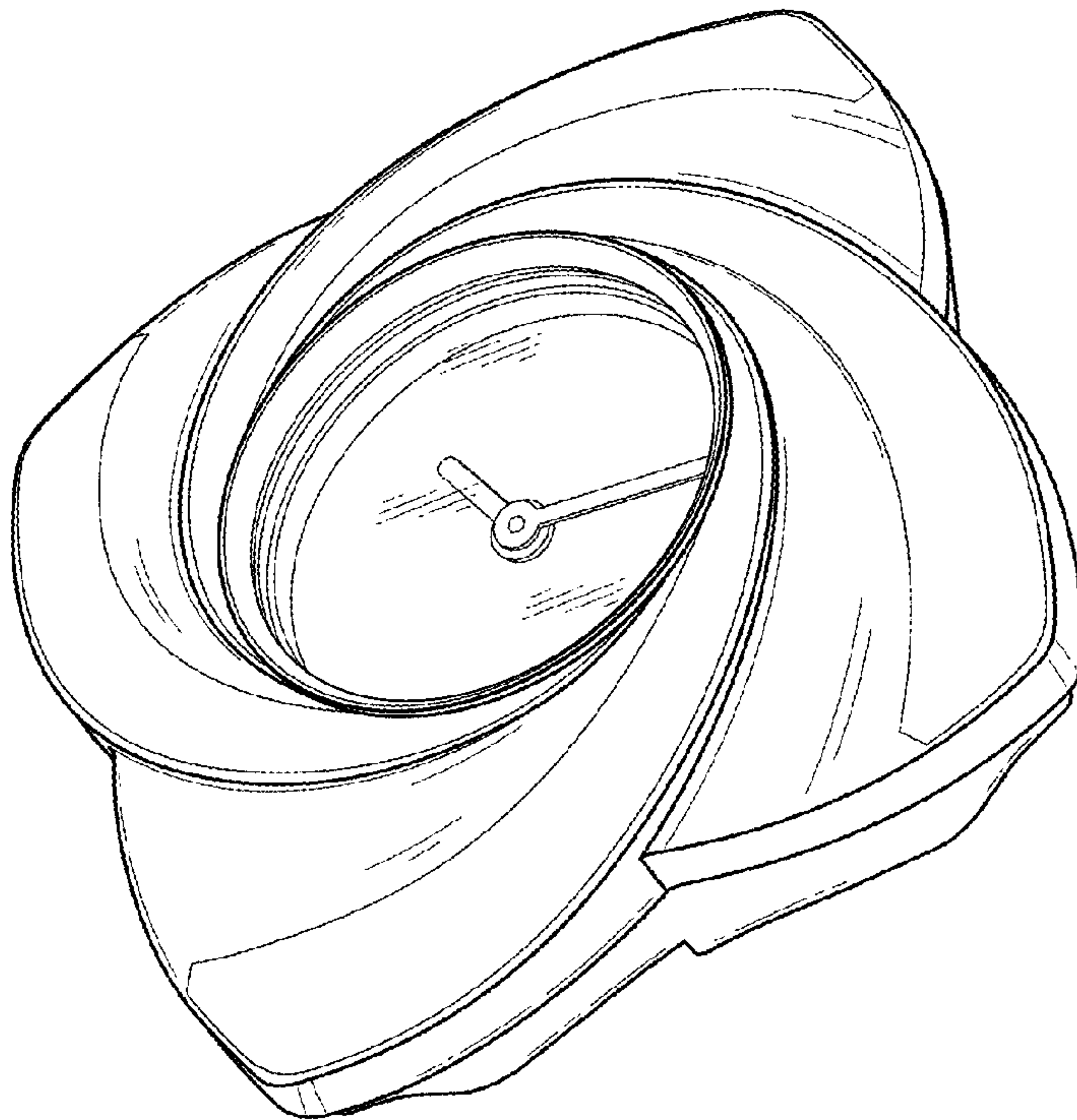

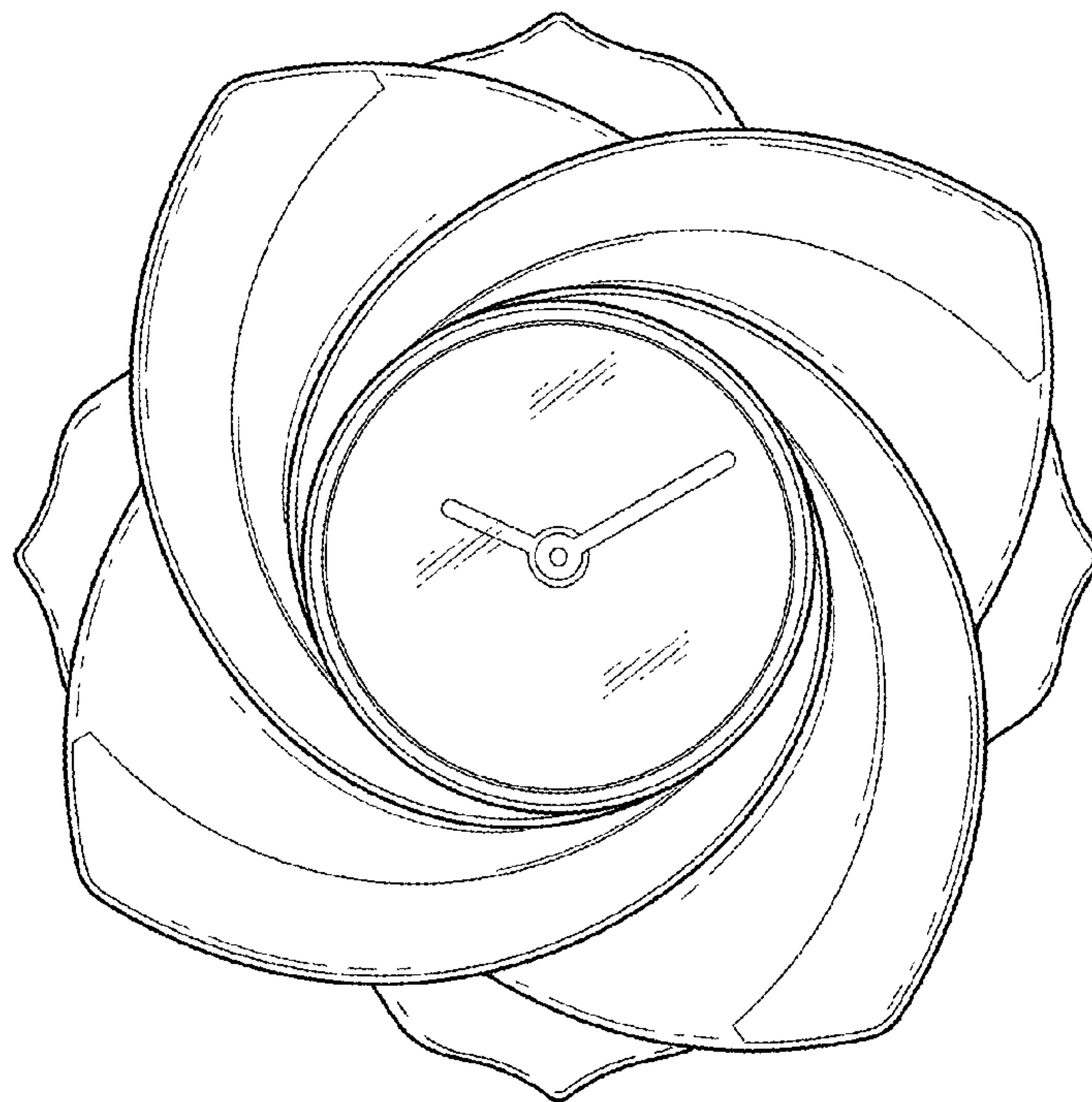

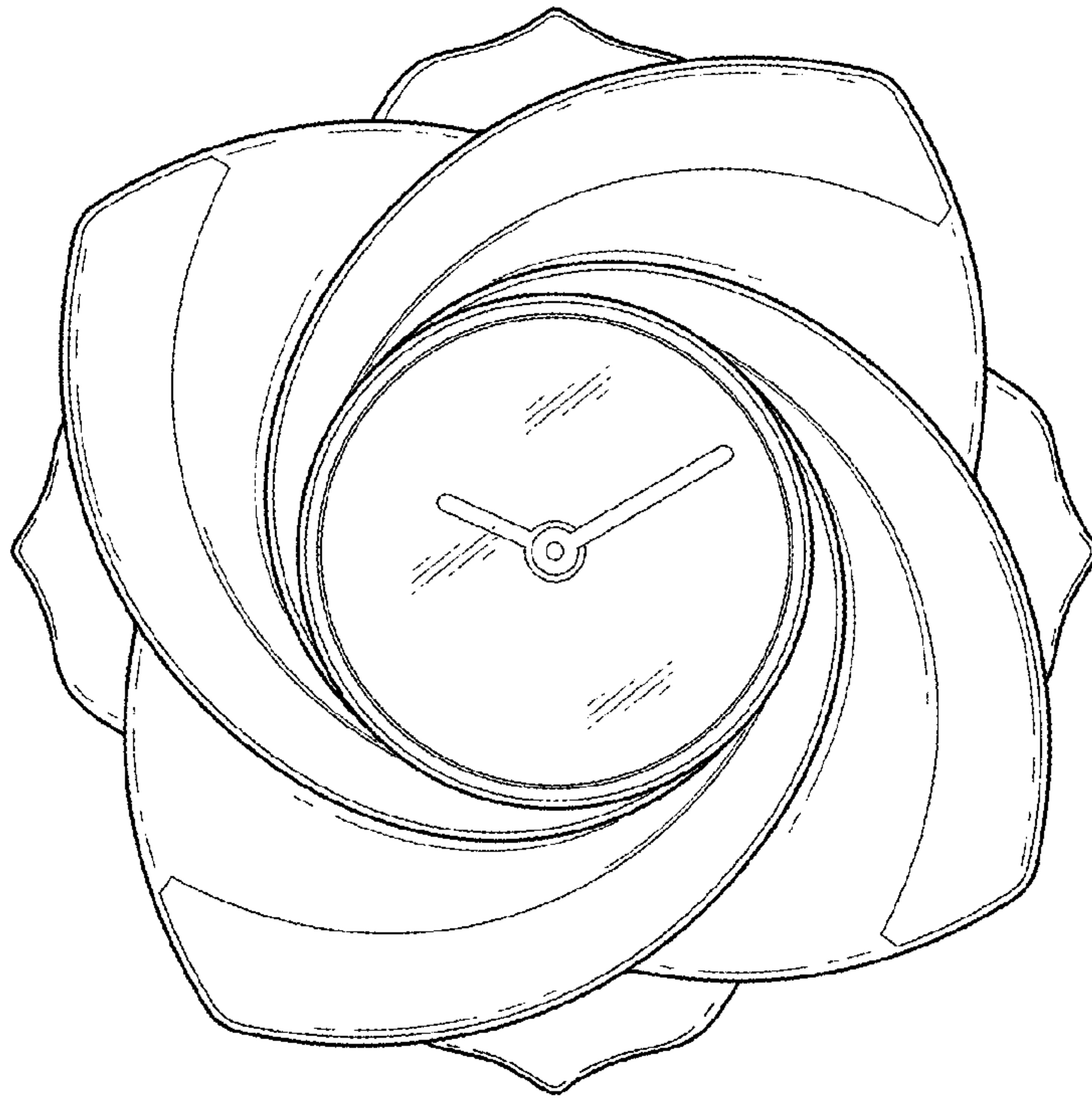

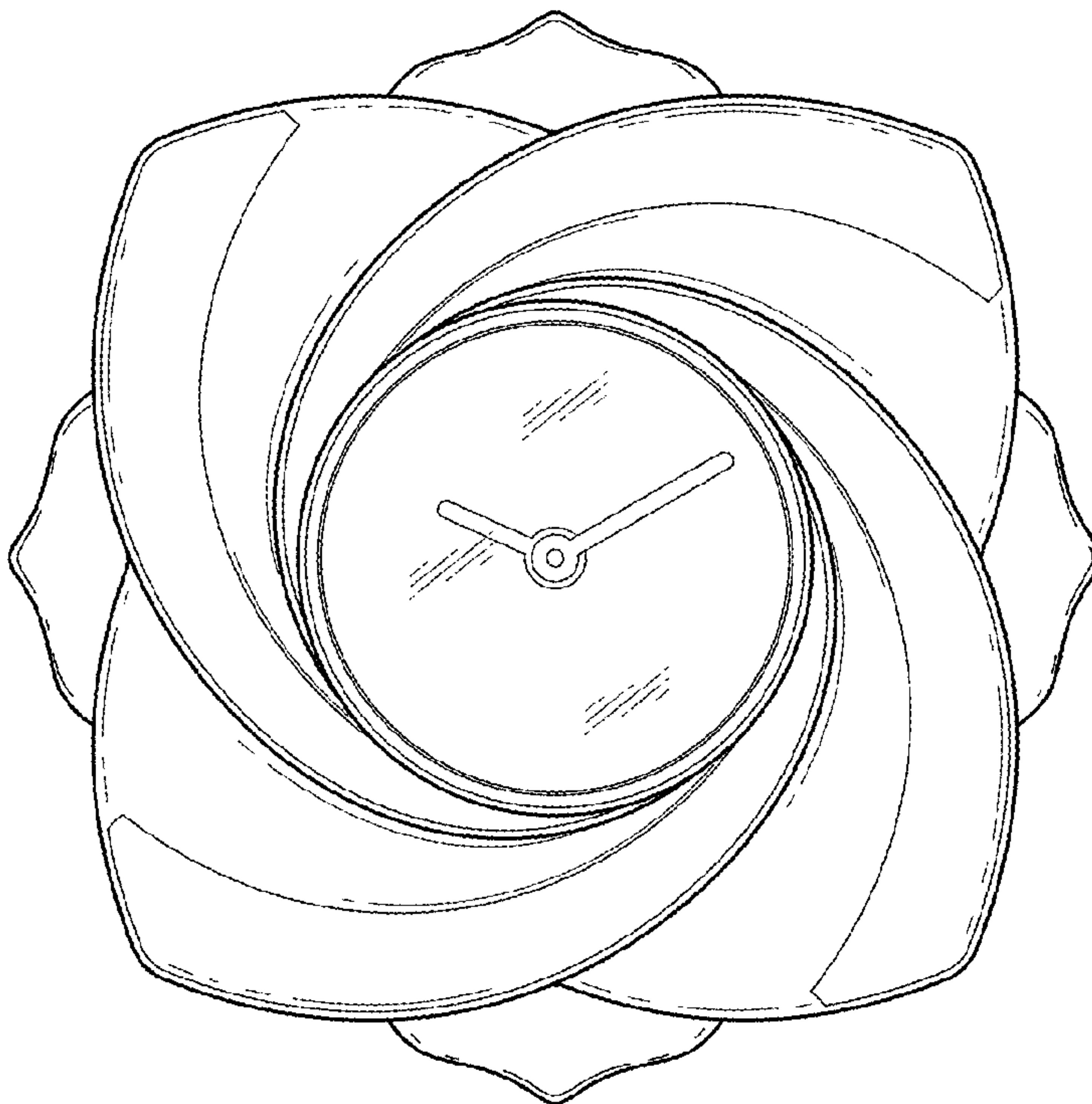
