The ornamental design for a dual flush handle sleeve, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

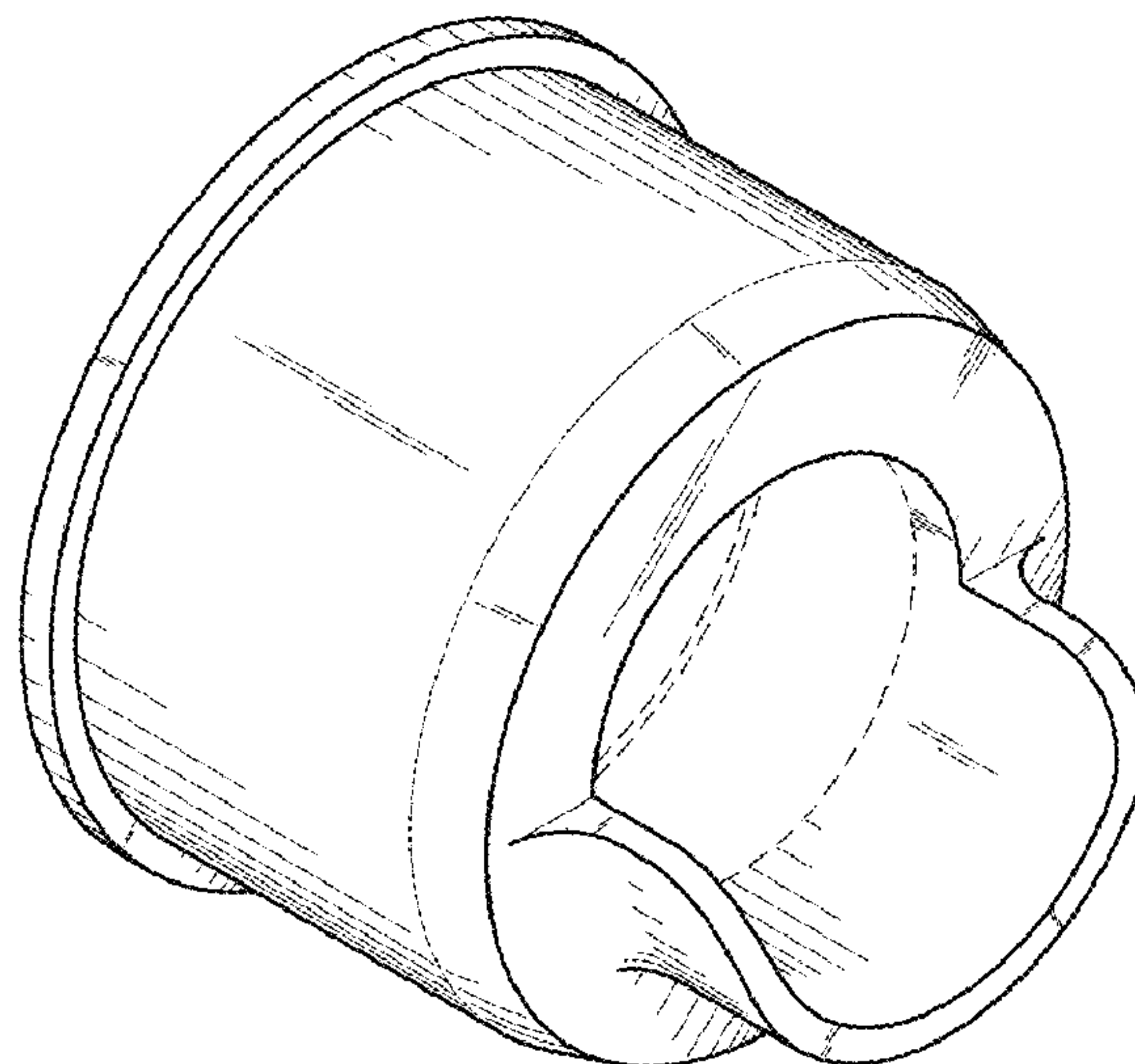
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dual flush handle sleeve showing my new design in accordance with a first embodiment of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along lines 6-6 shown in FIG. 4;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof in a condition of use;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a dual flush handle sleeve showing my new design in accordance with a second embodiment of the present invention;
FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 13 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along lines 13-13 shown in FIG. 11.
A right side elevational view of the dual flush handle sleeve for each embodiment is omitted as it is symmetric in appearance to the respective left side elevational view of FIG. 2 and FIG. 9.

Rear elevational views are omitted because they are plain and unornamental, and form no part of the subject matter of the claimed design.

The broken lines in the drawings are included for the purpose of illustrating environment only and form no part of the claimed design.

The dashed-dotted line showings of FIGS. 8 and 13 illustrate boundaries between the claimed design and environmental features.

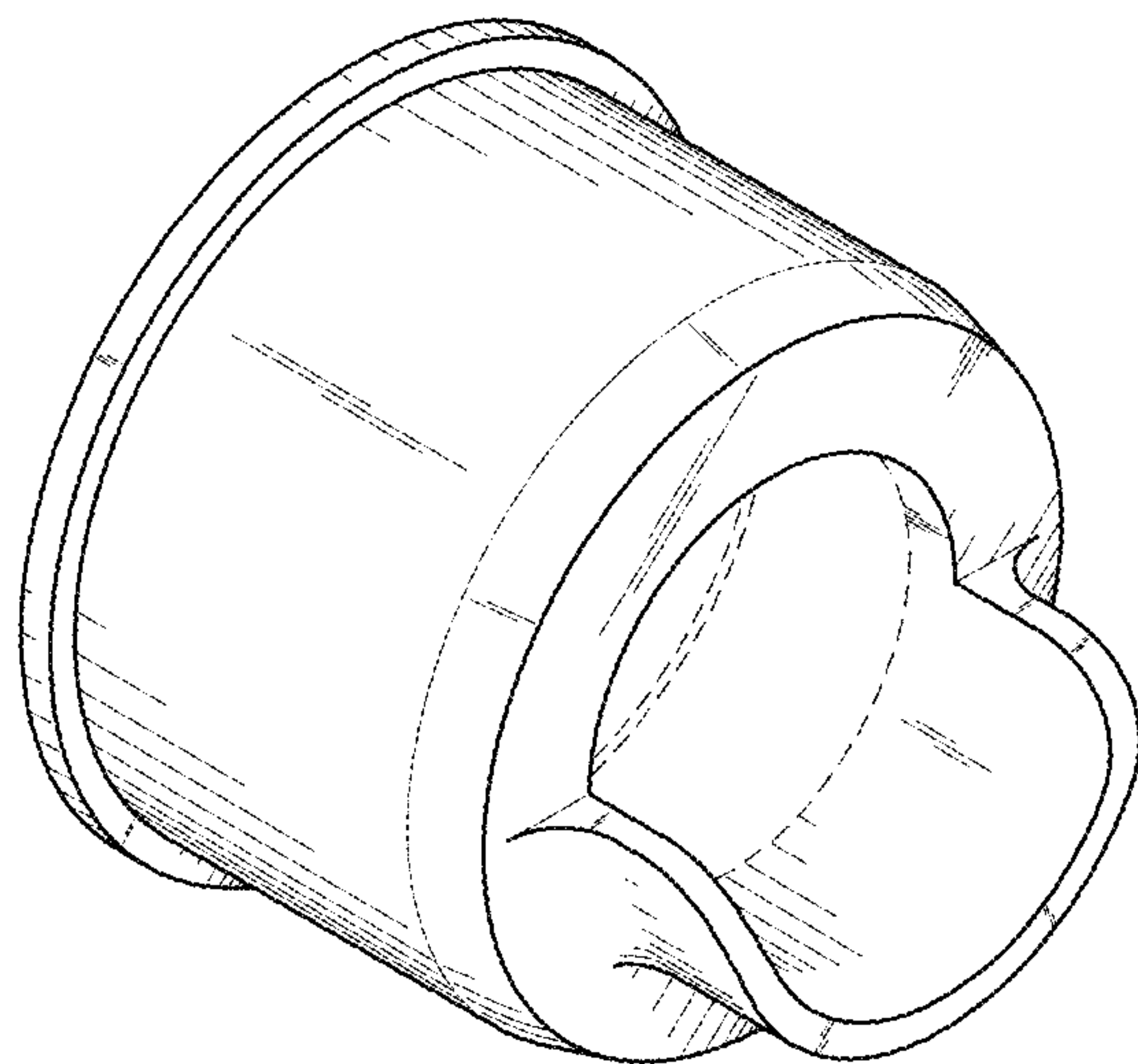

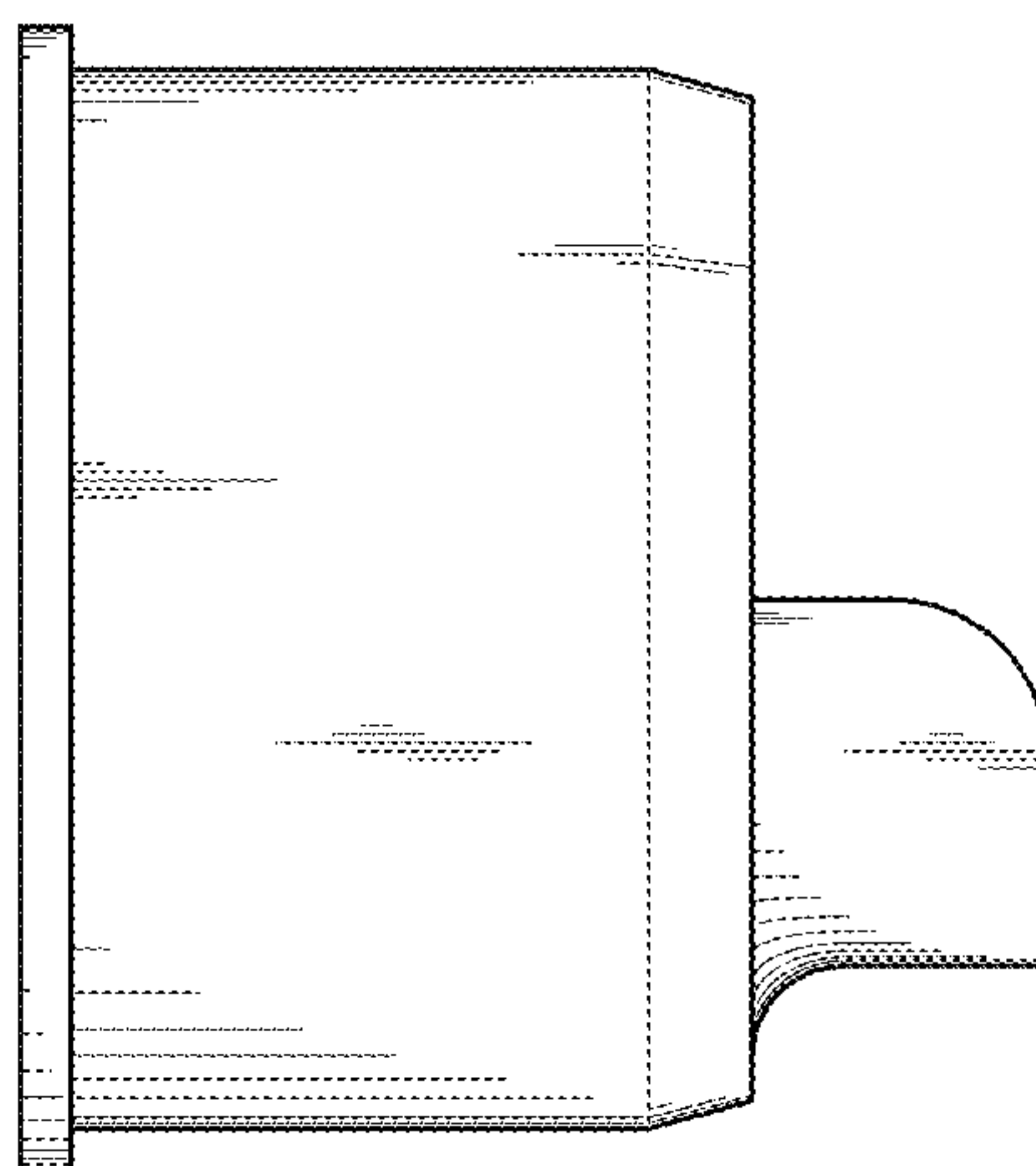

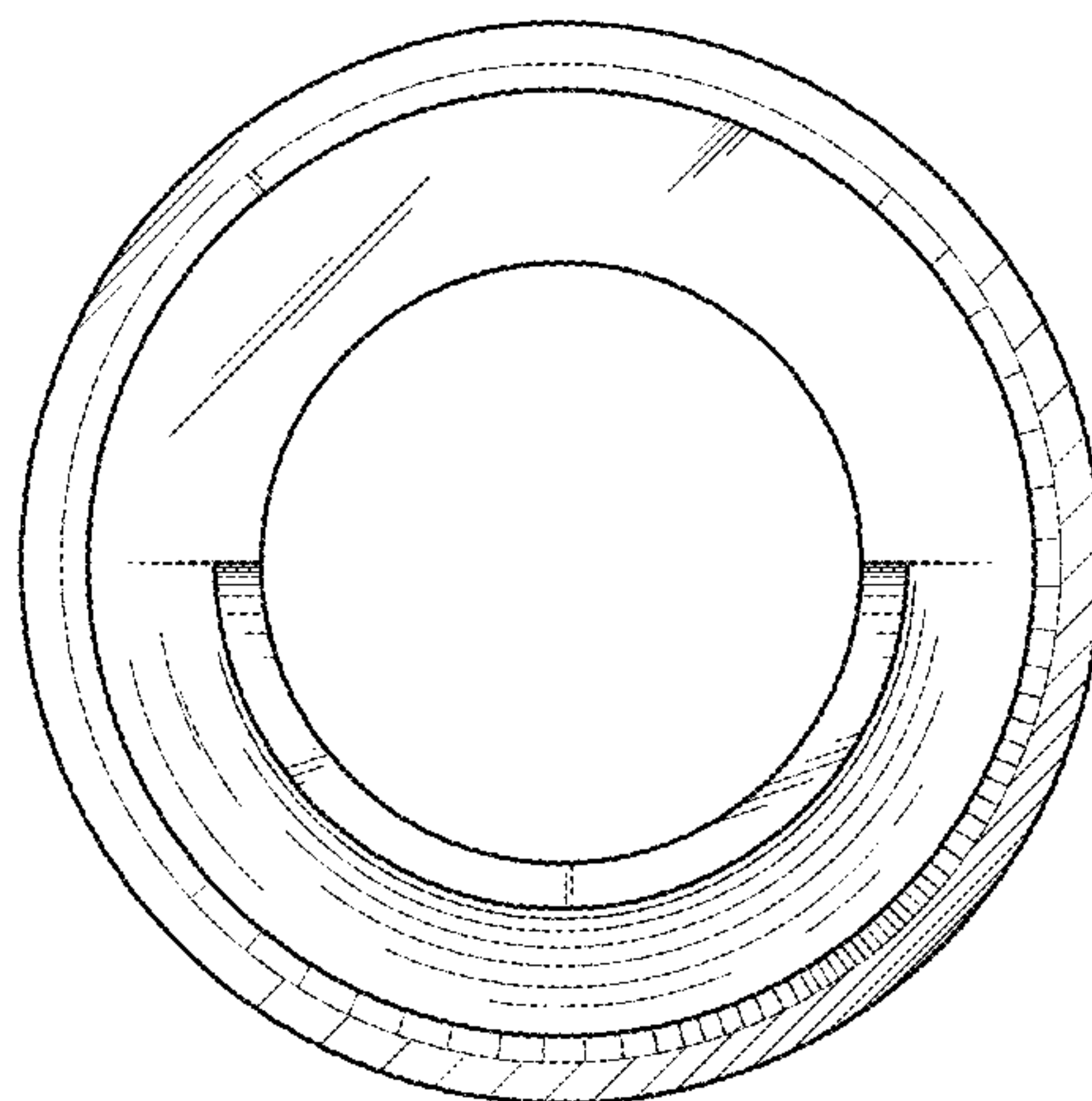

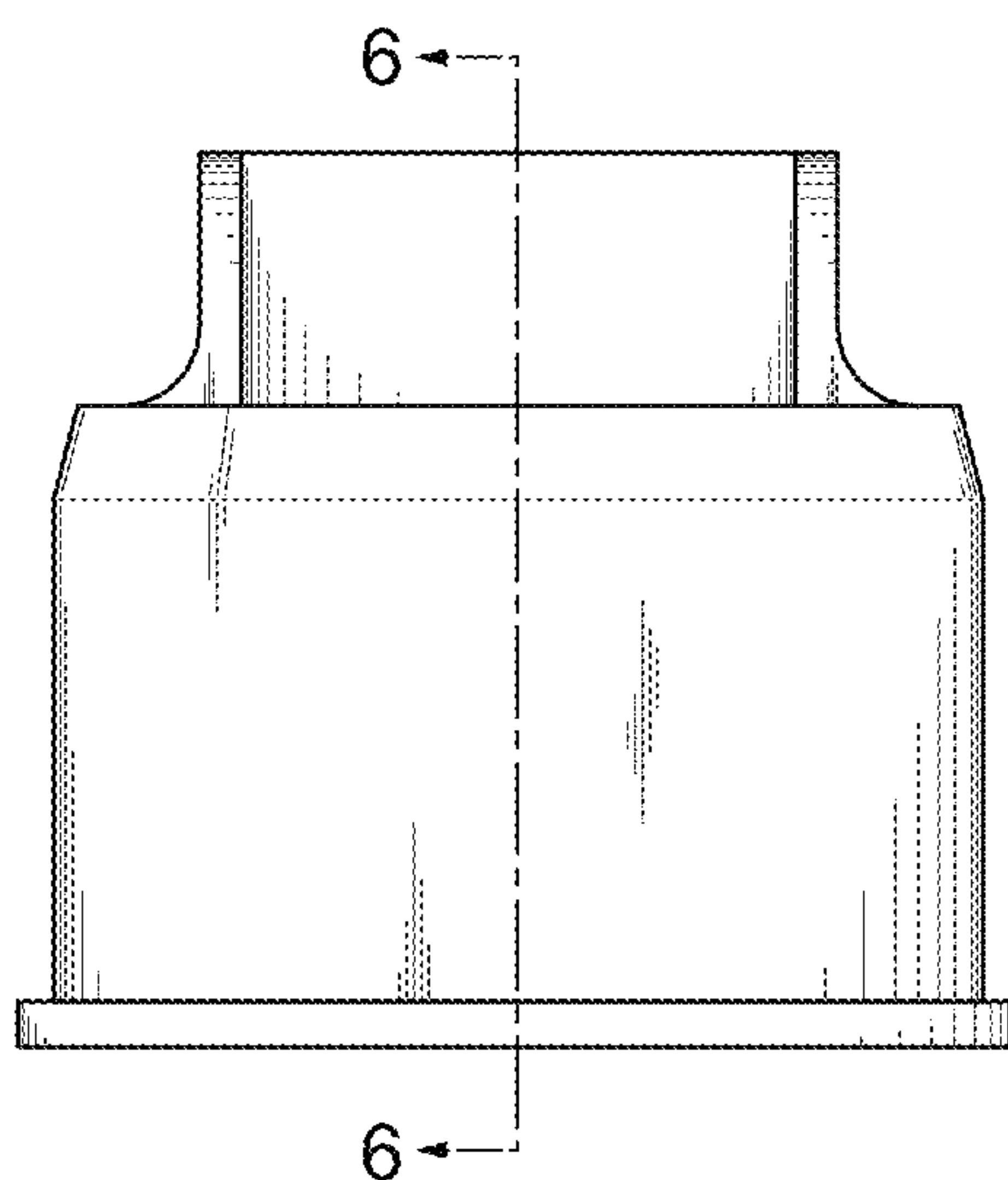

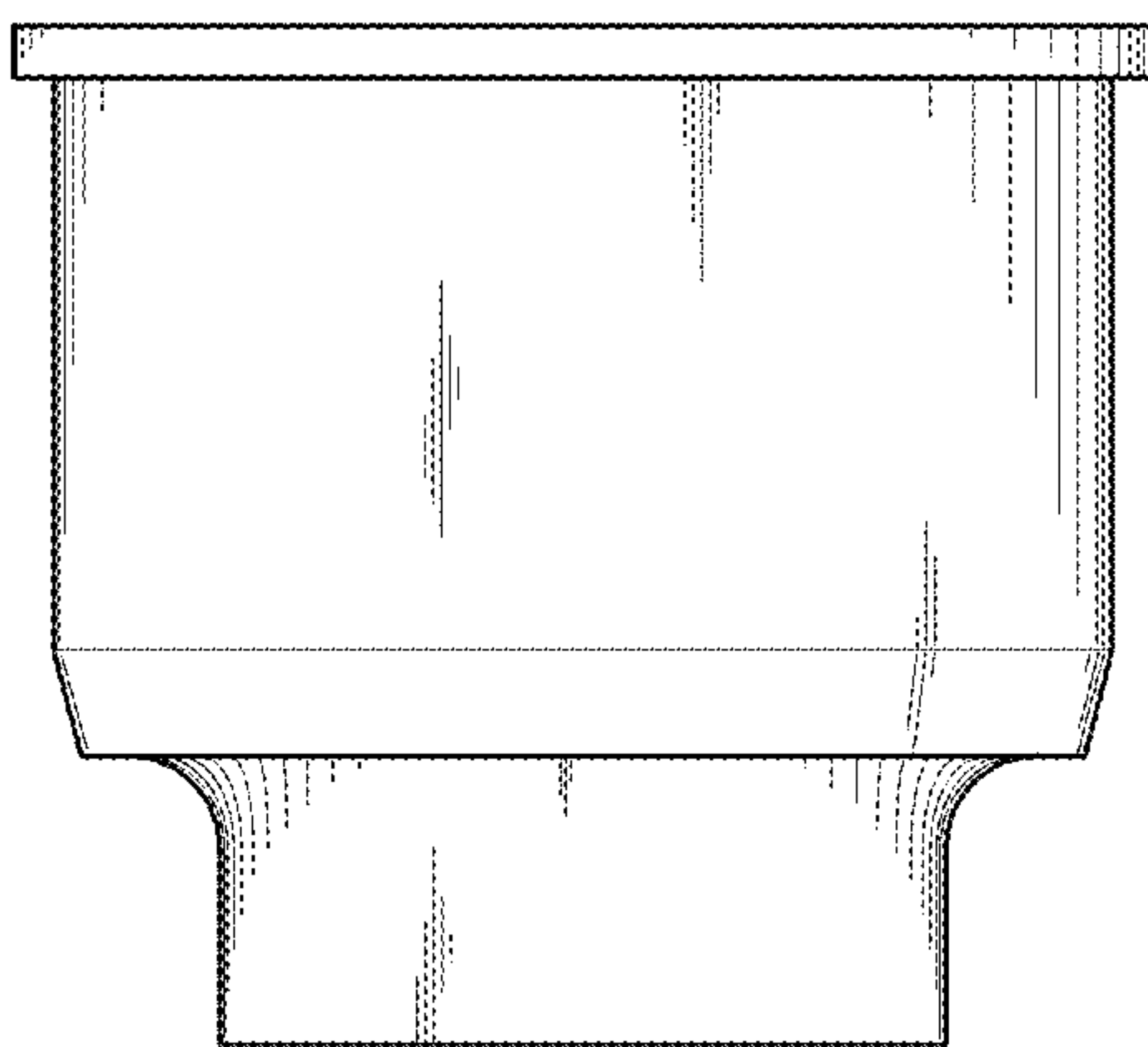

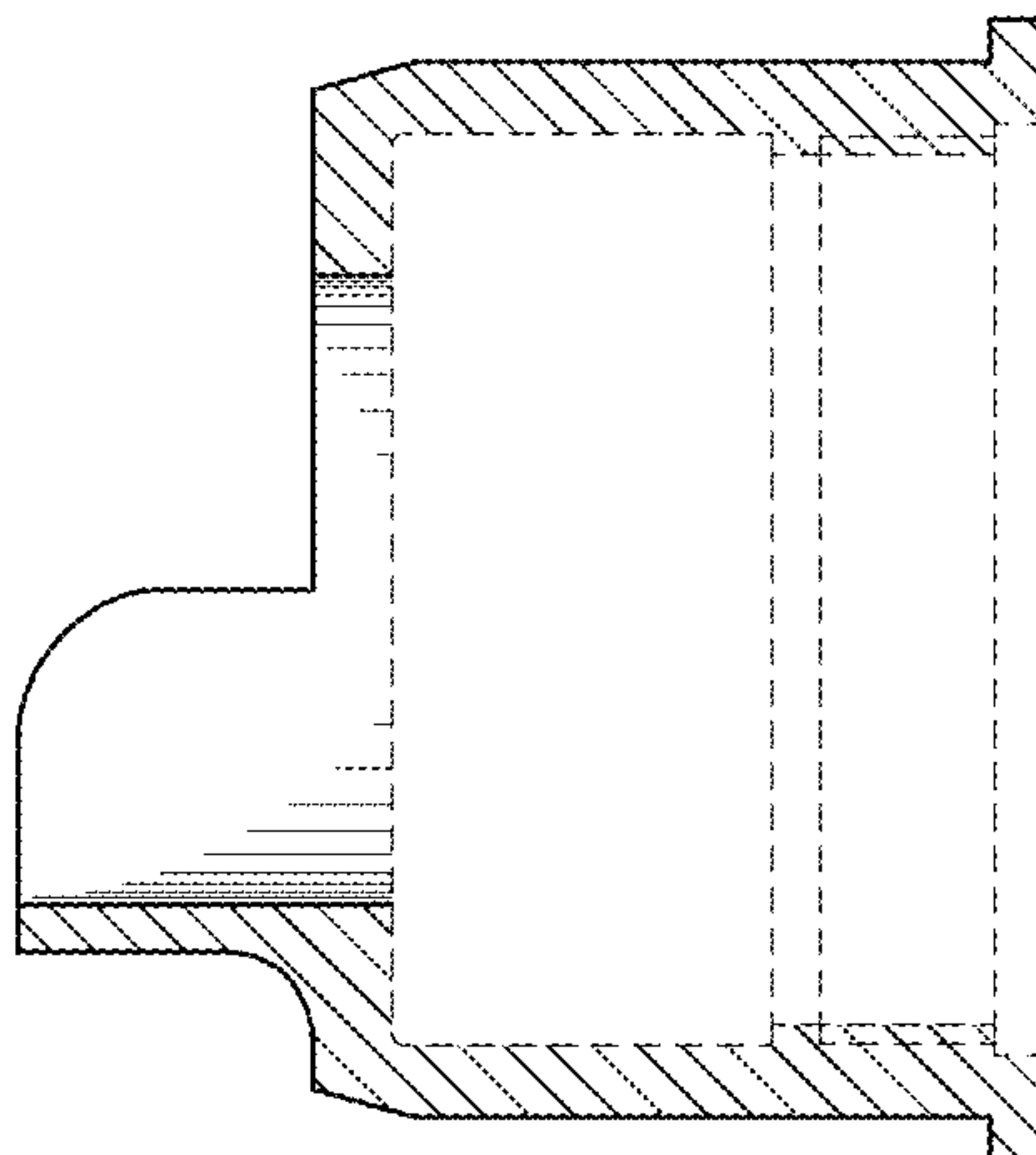

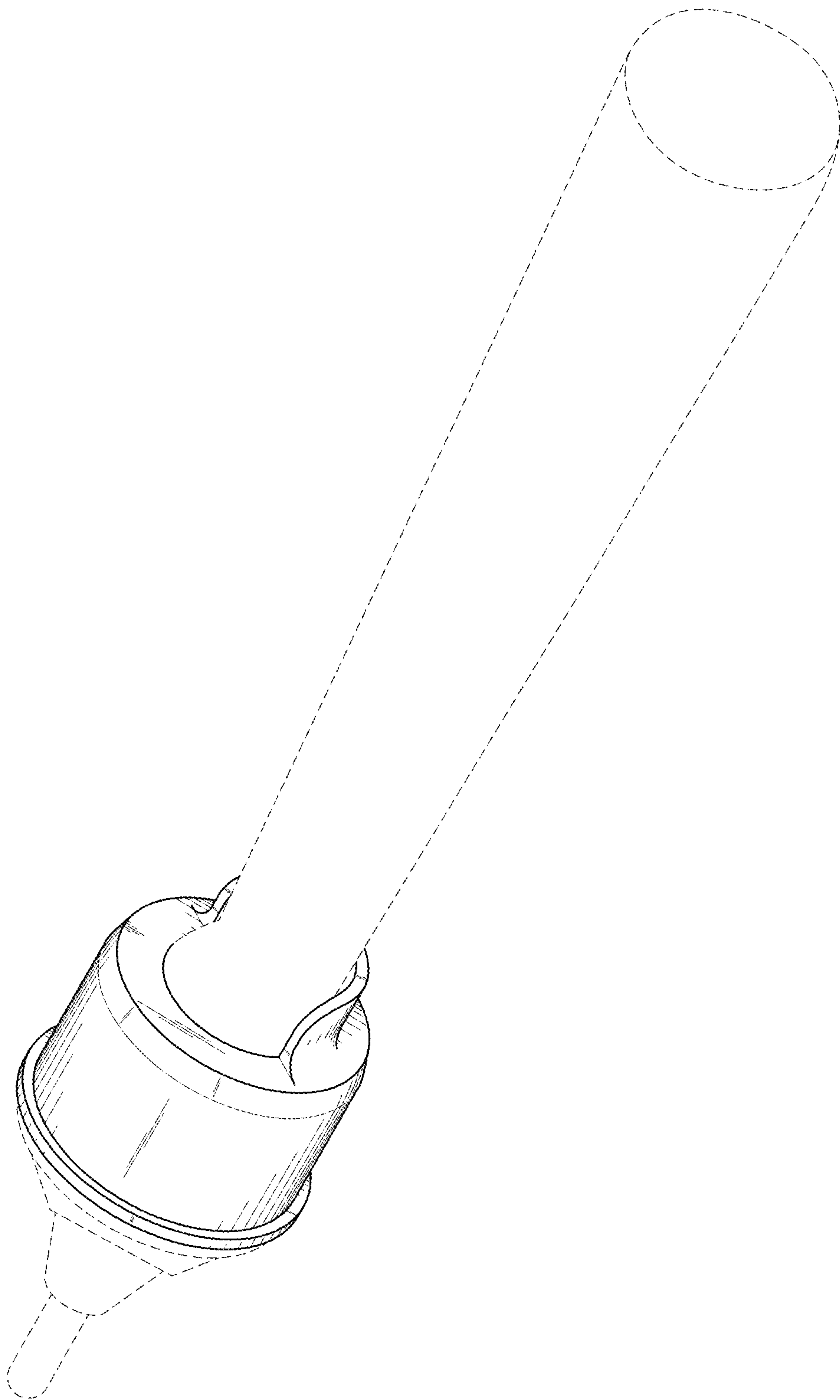

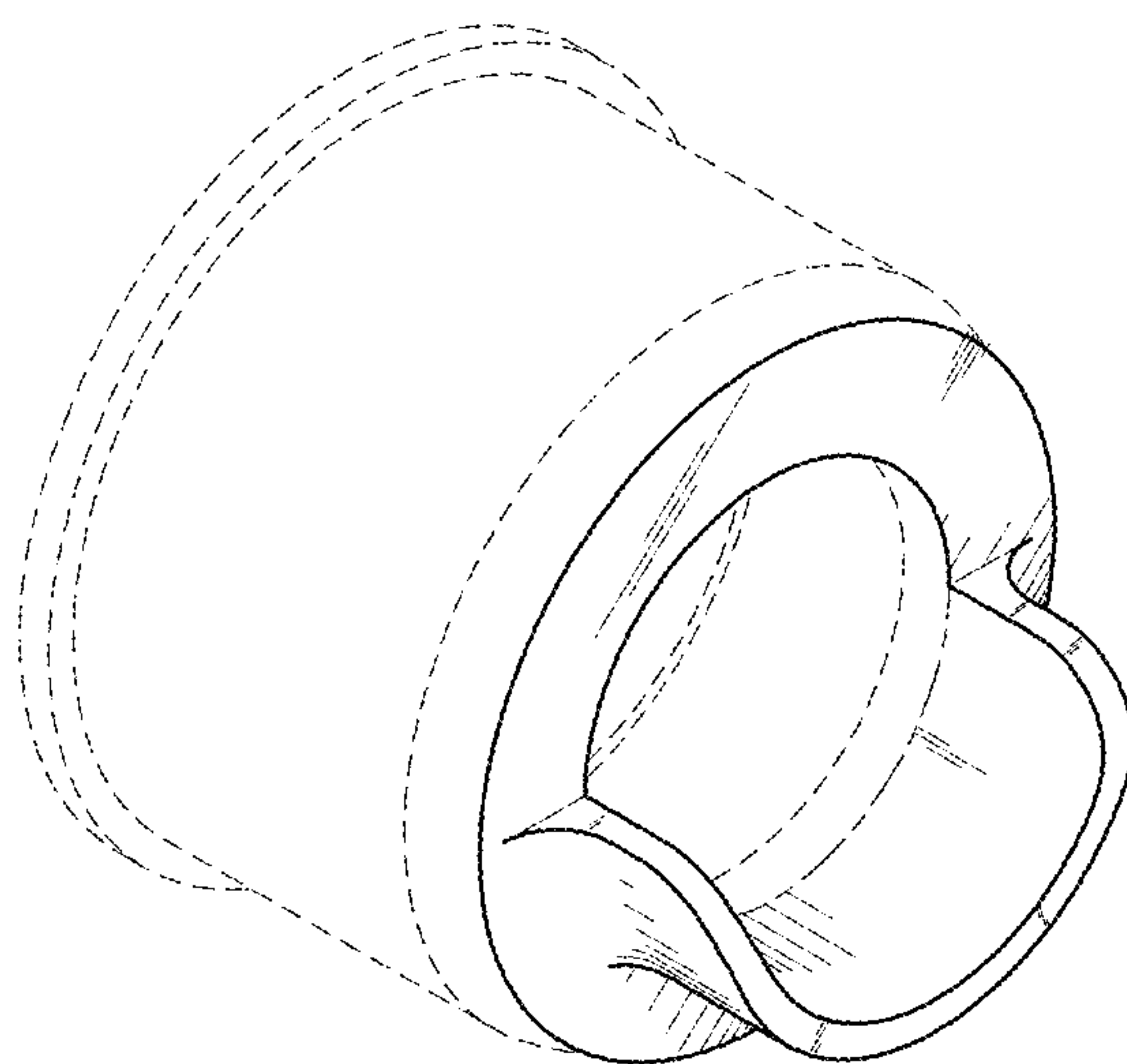

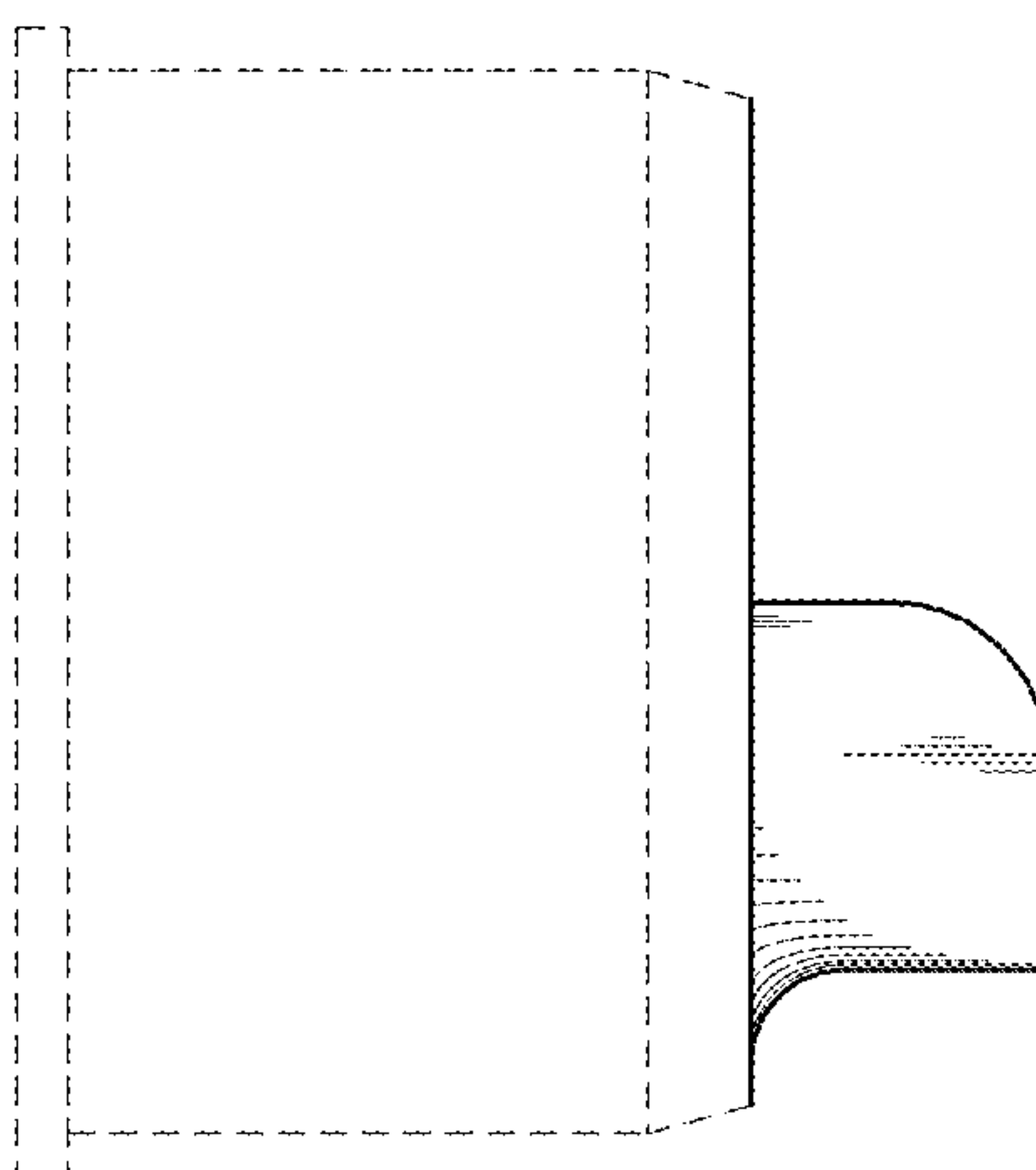

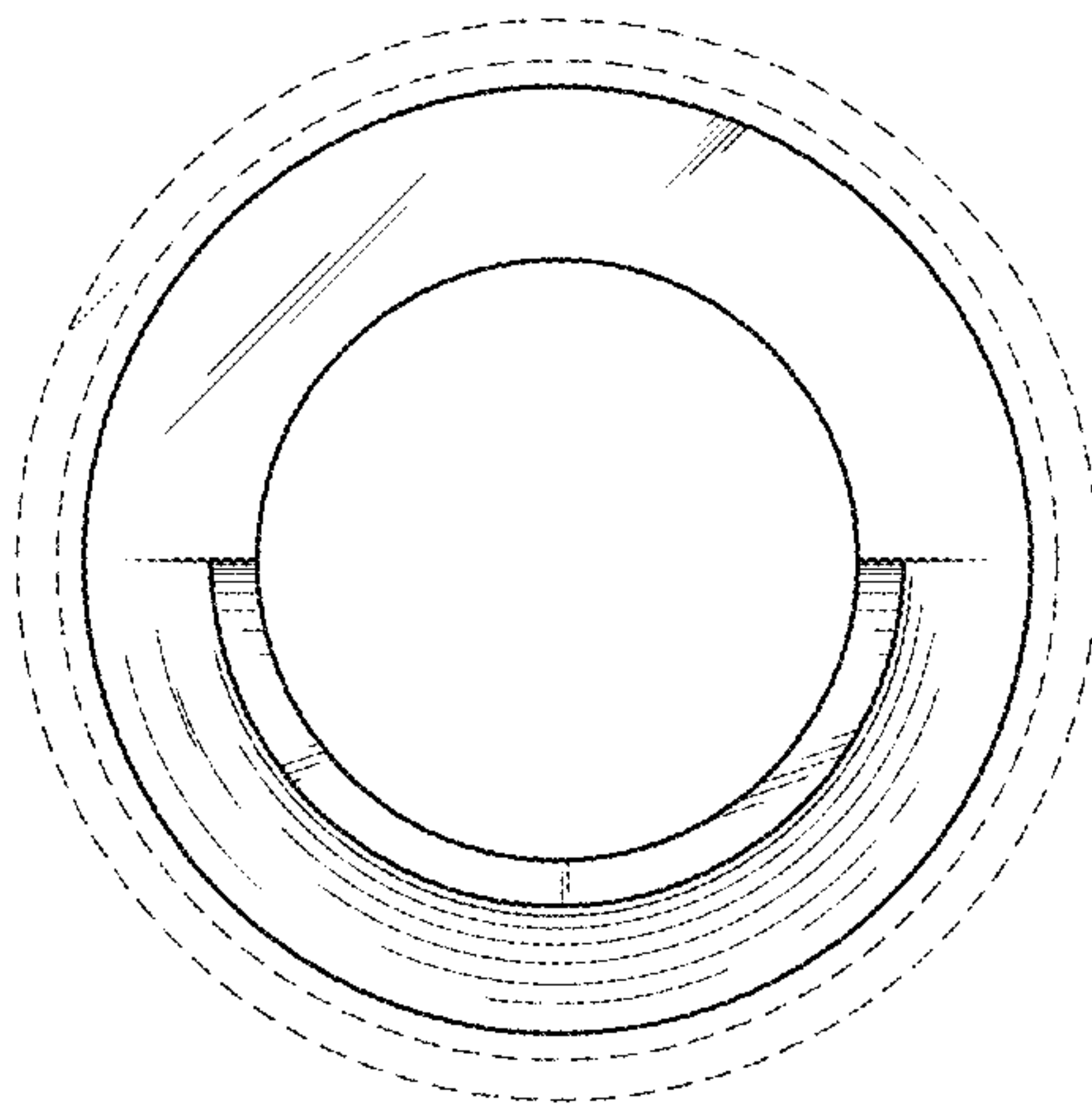

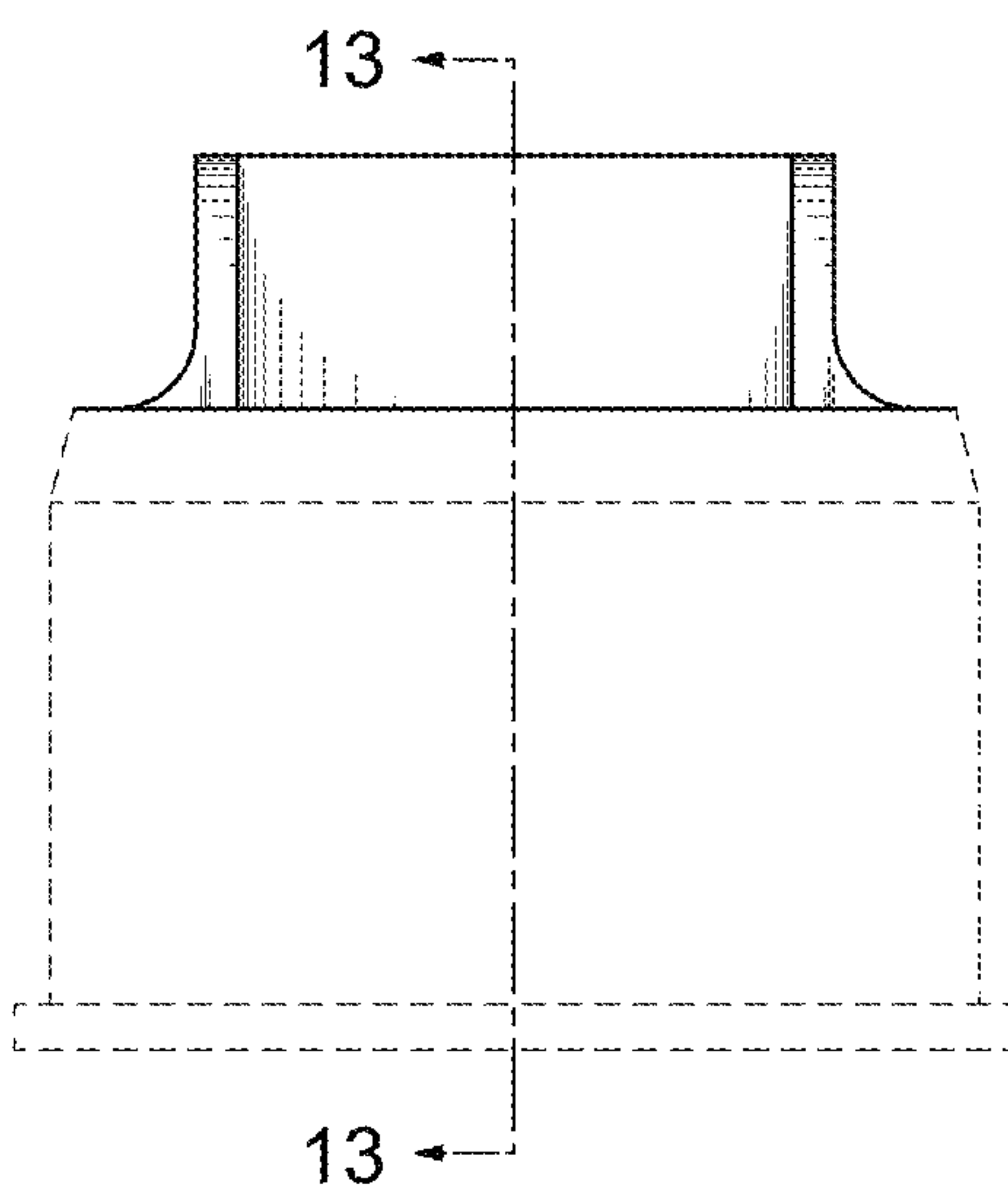

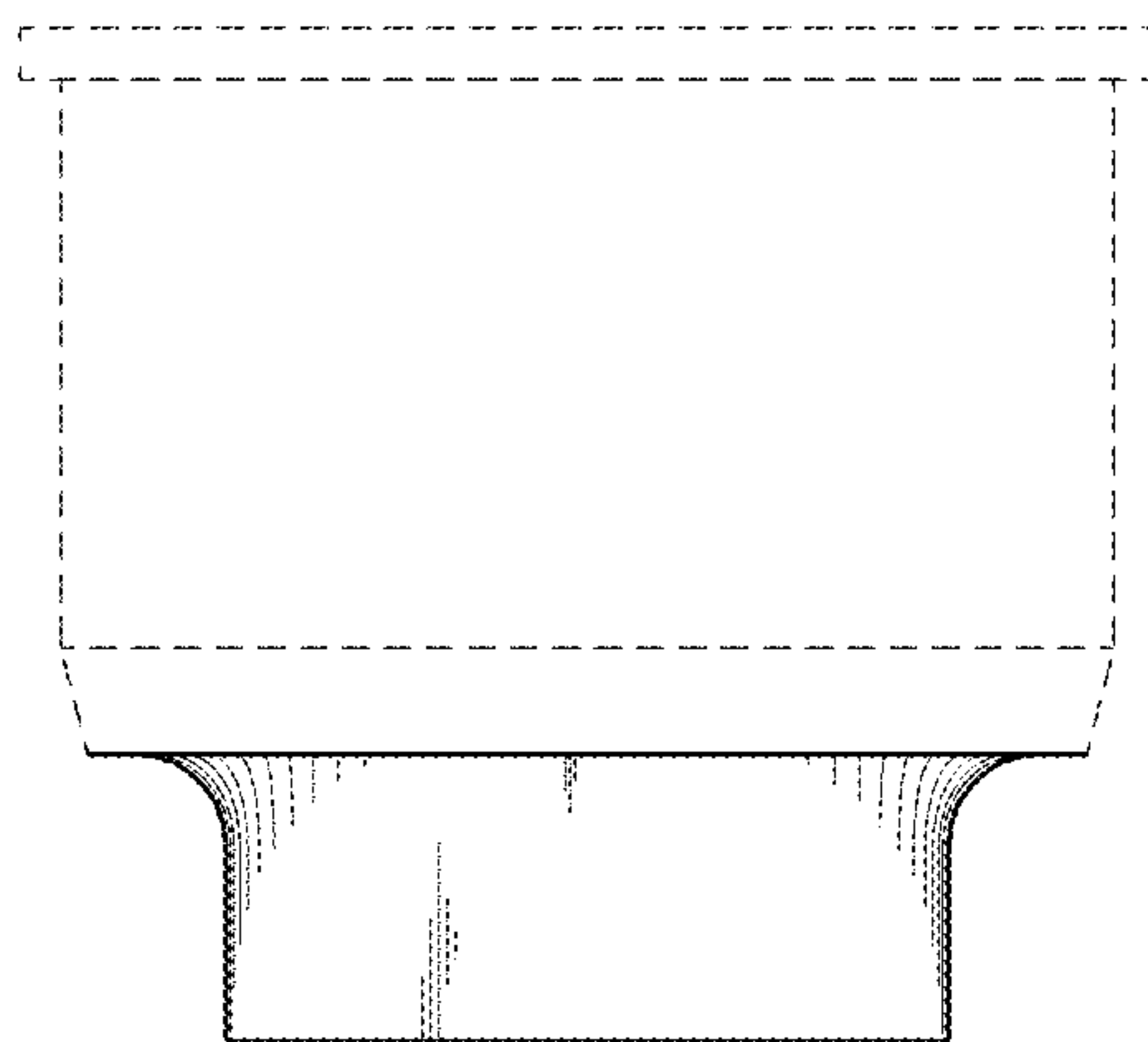

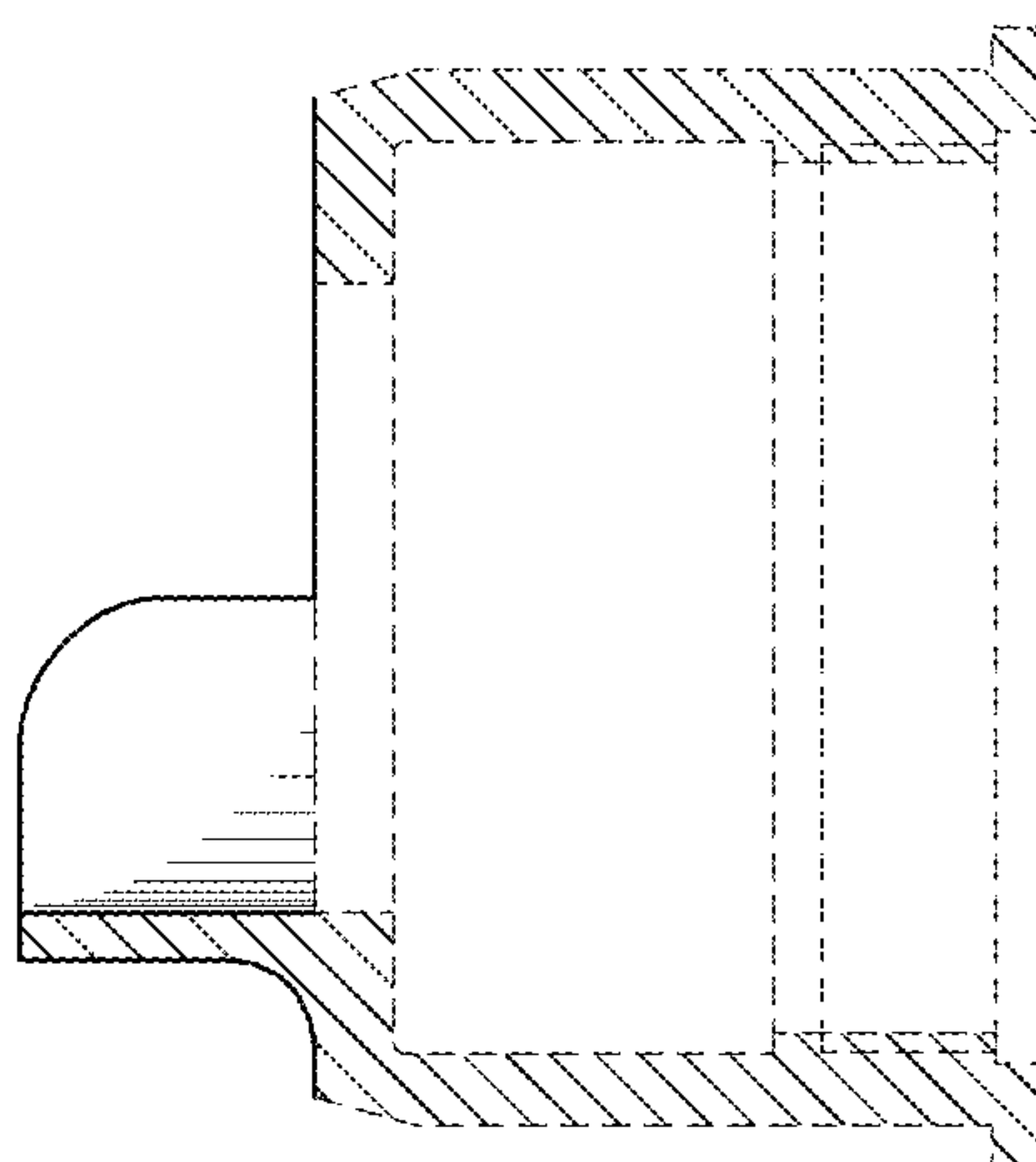
