(57) **CLAIM**

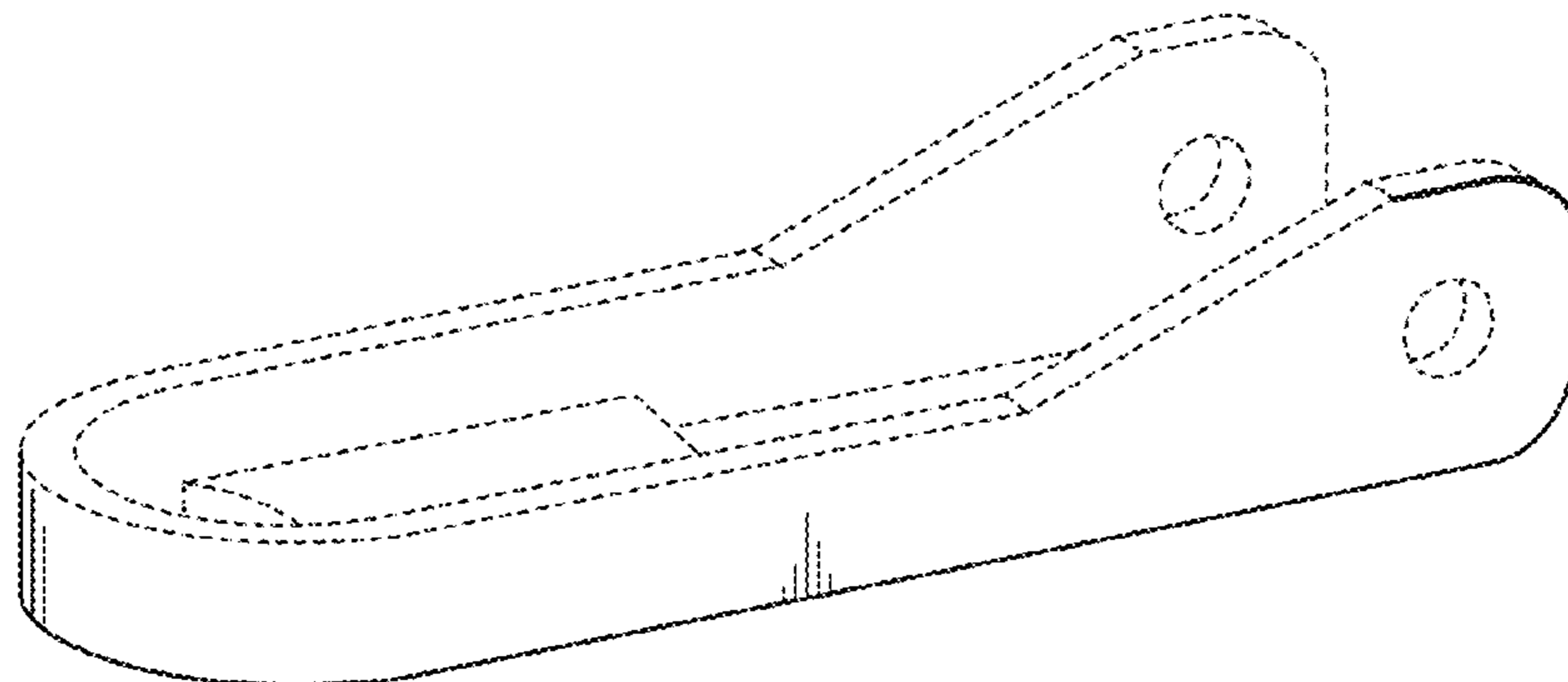
I claim the ornamental design for a pocket key organizer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the pocket key organizer; FIG. 2 is a front view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a left side view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a right side view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top view of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a bottom view of FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the pocket key organizer; FIG. 9 is a front view of FIG. 8; FIG. 10 is a rear view of FIG. 8; FIG. 11 is a left side view of FIG. 8; FIG. 12 is a right side view of FIG. 8; FIG. 13 is a top view of FIG. 8; FIG. 14 is a bottom view of FIG. 8; FIG. 15 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of the pocket key organizer; FIG. 16 is a front view of FIG. 15; FIG. 17 is a rear view of FIG. 15; FIG. 18 is a left side view of FIG. 15; FIG. 19 is a right side view of FIG. 15; FIG. 20 is a top view of FIG. 15; FIG. 21 is a bottom view of FIG. 15; FIG. 22 is a left side view of any of the embodiments shown in a position of use with a key; and, FIG. 23 is a left side view of any of the embodiments shown in a position of use with a key rotated ninety degrees clockwise.

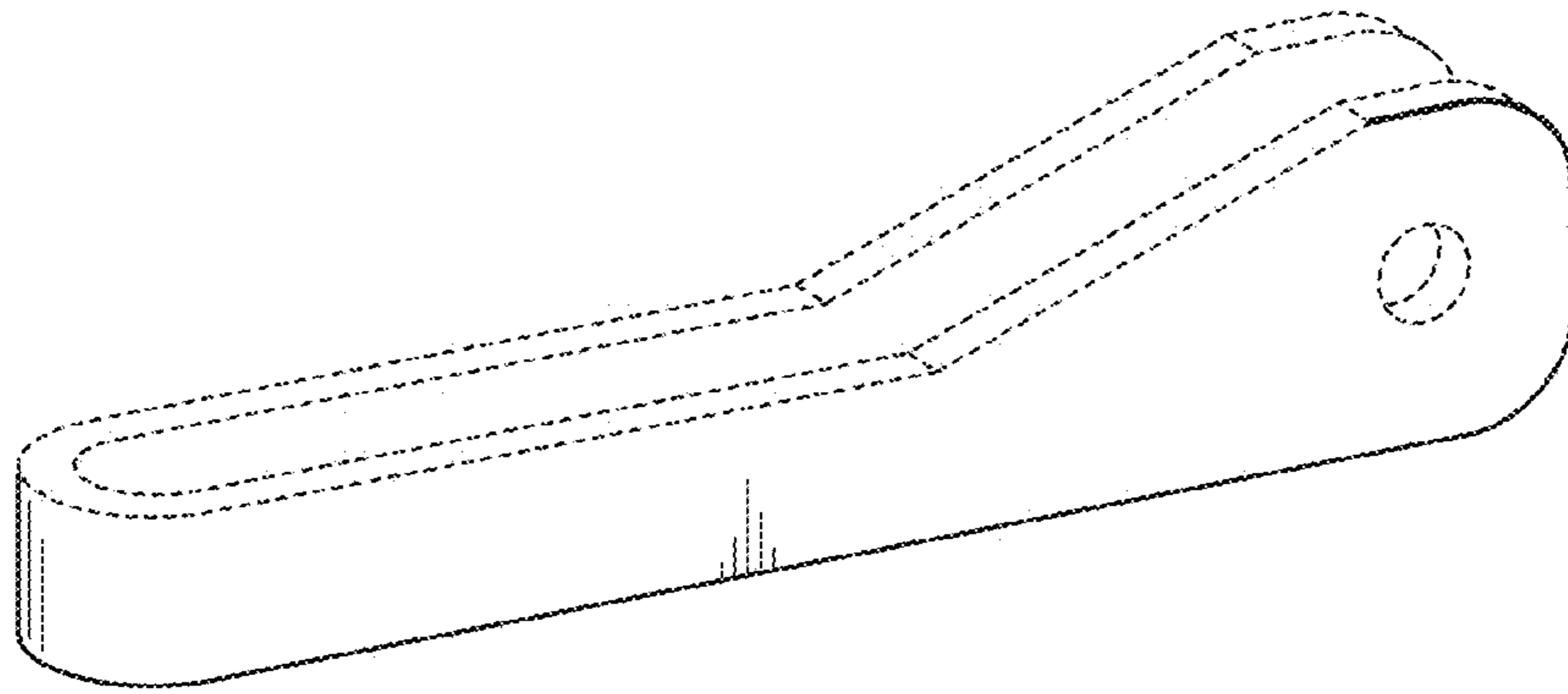

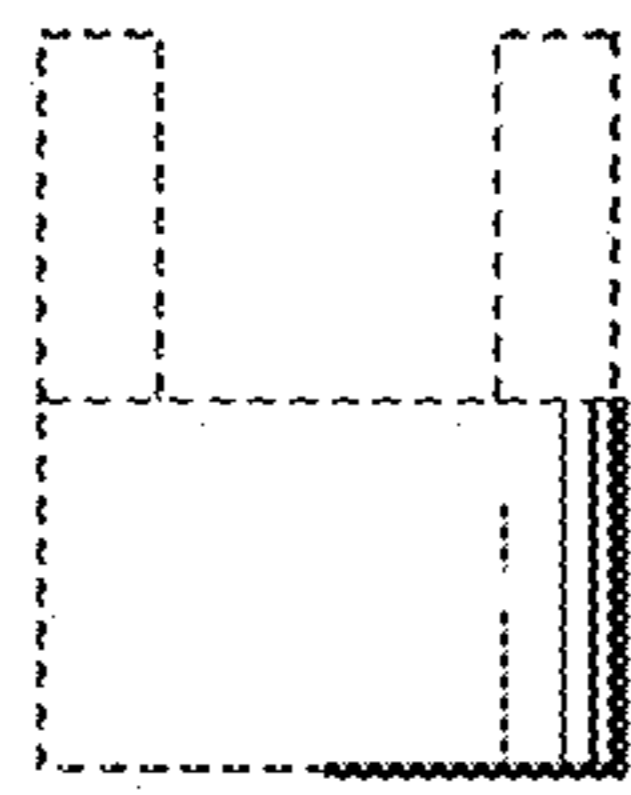

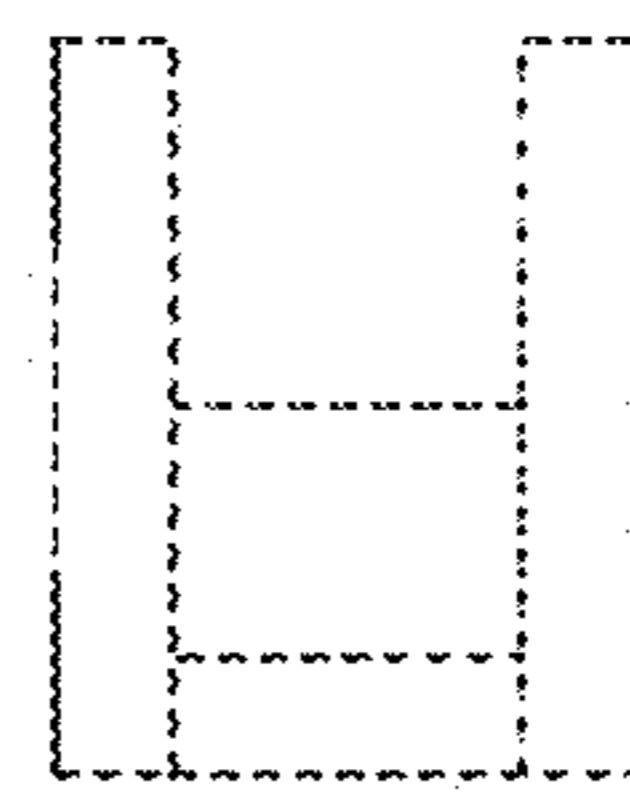

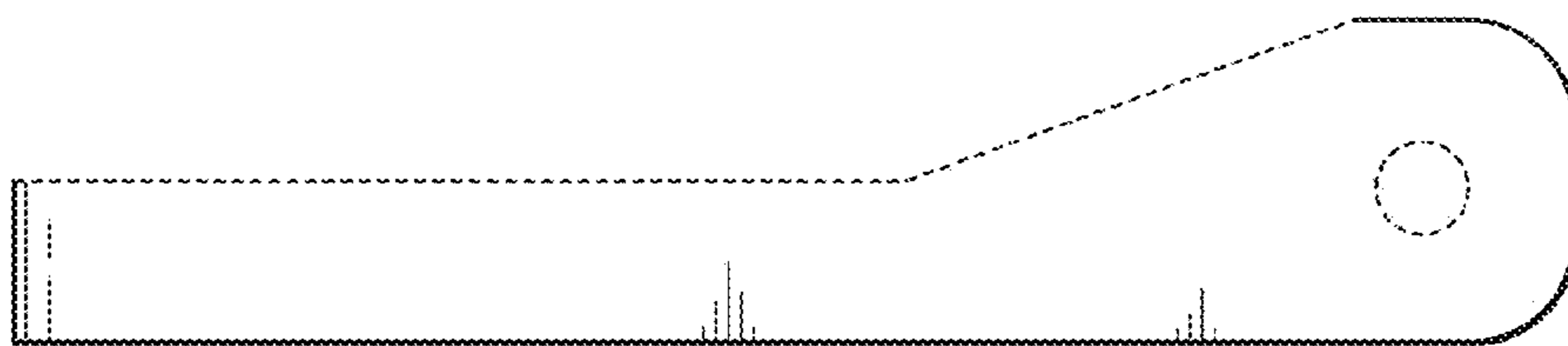

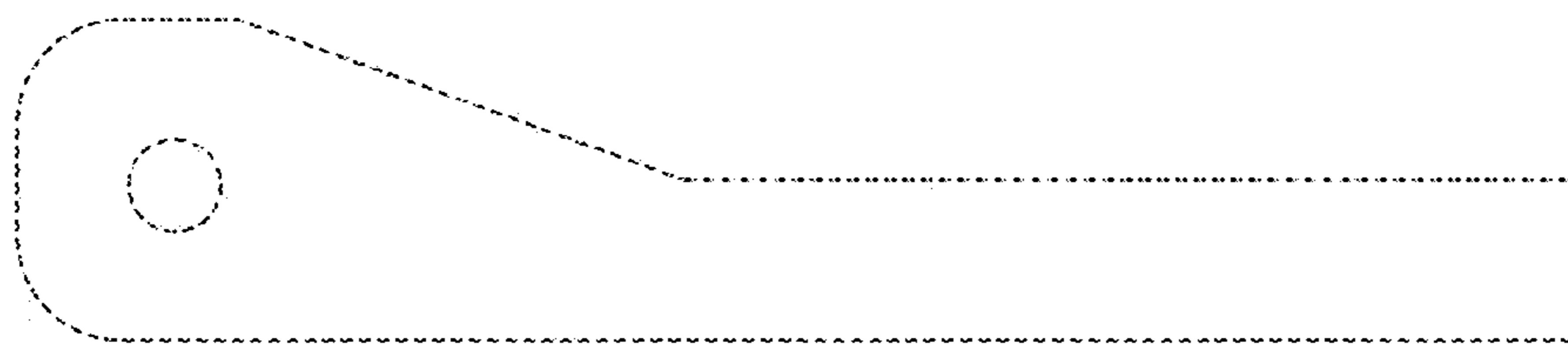

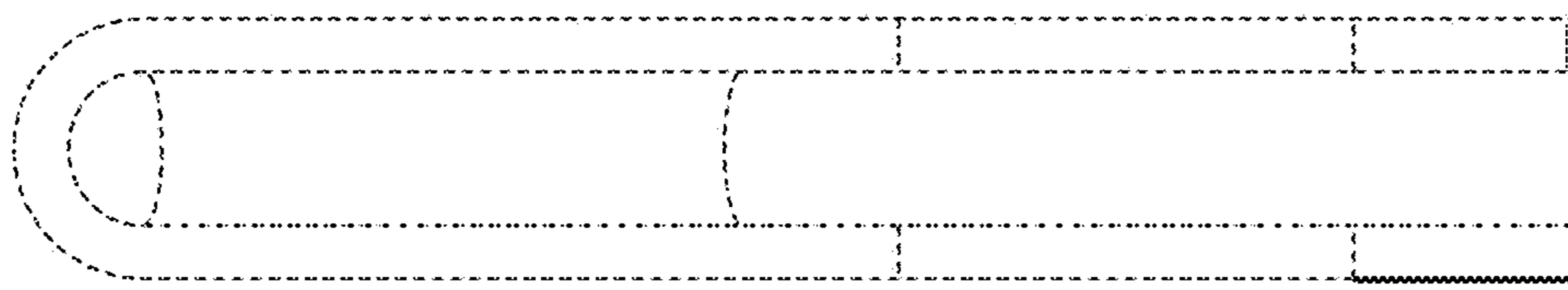

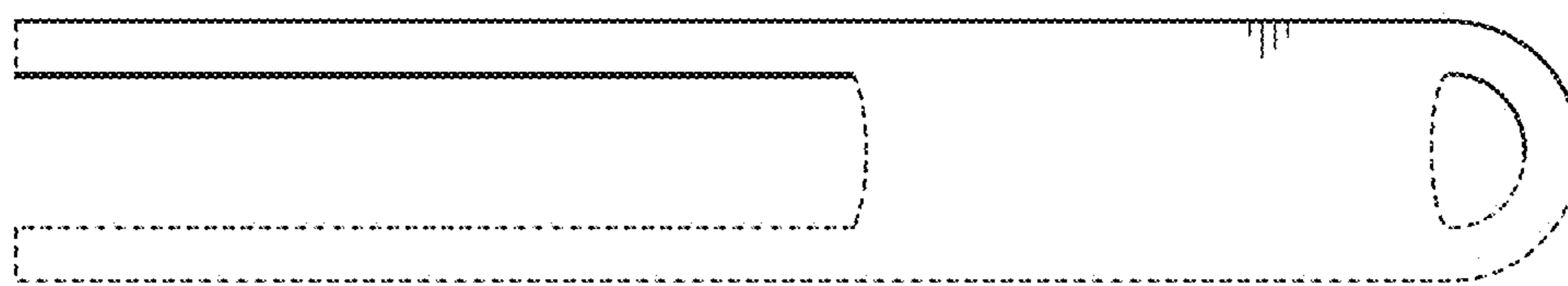

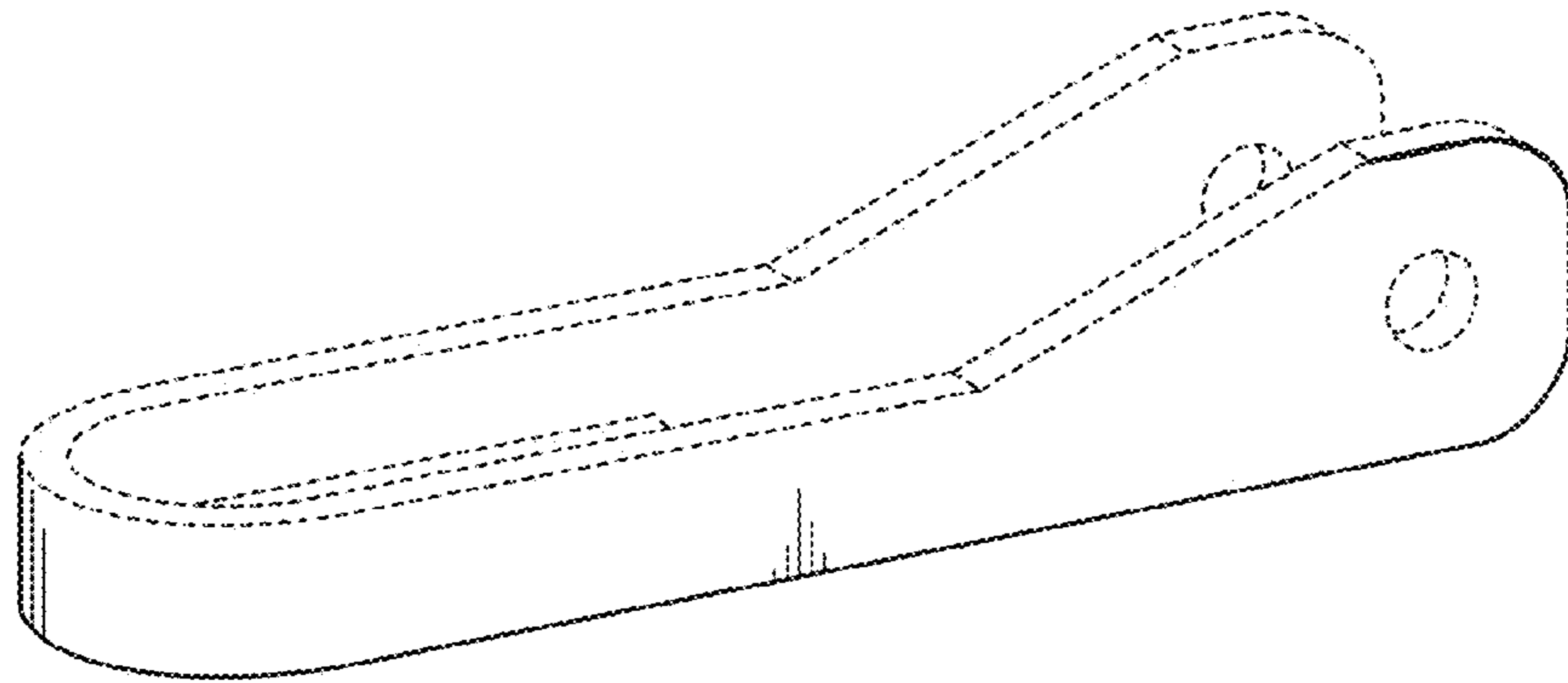

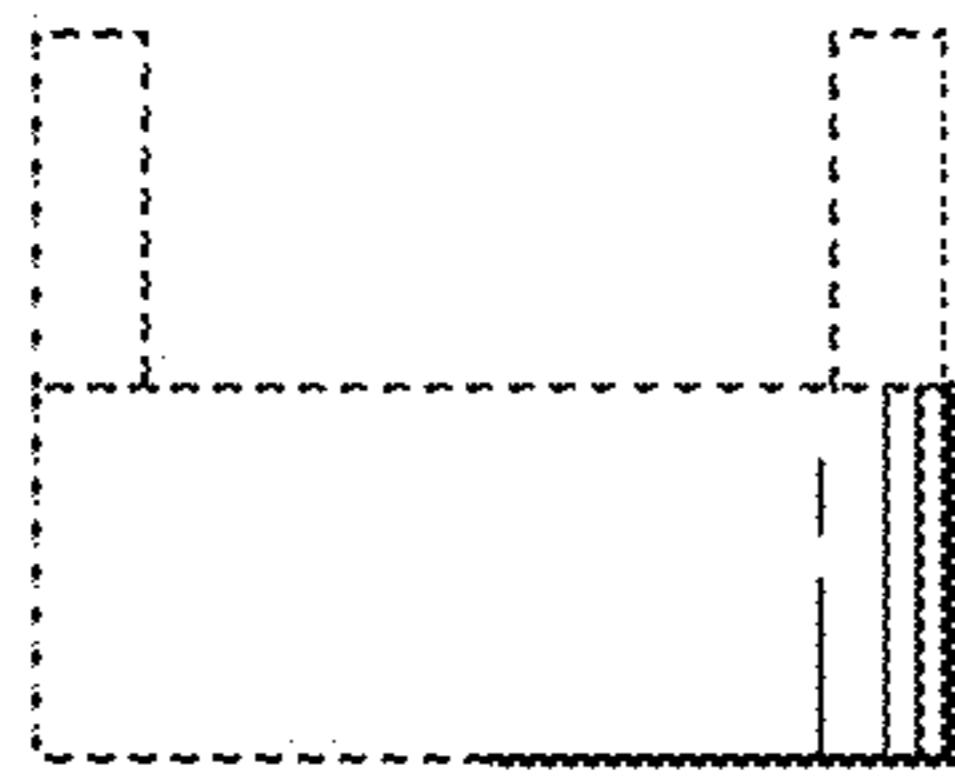

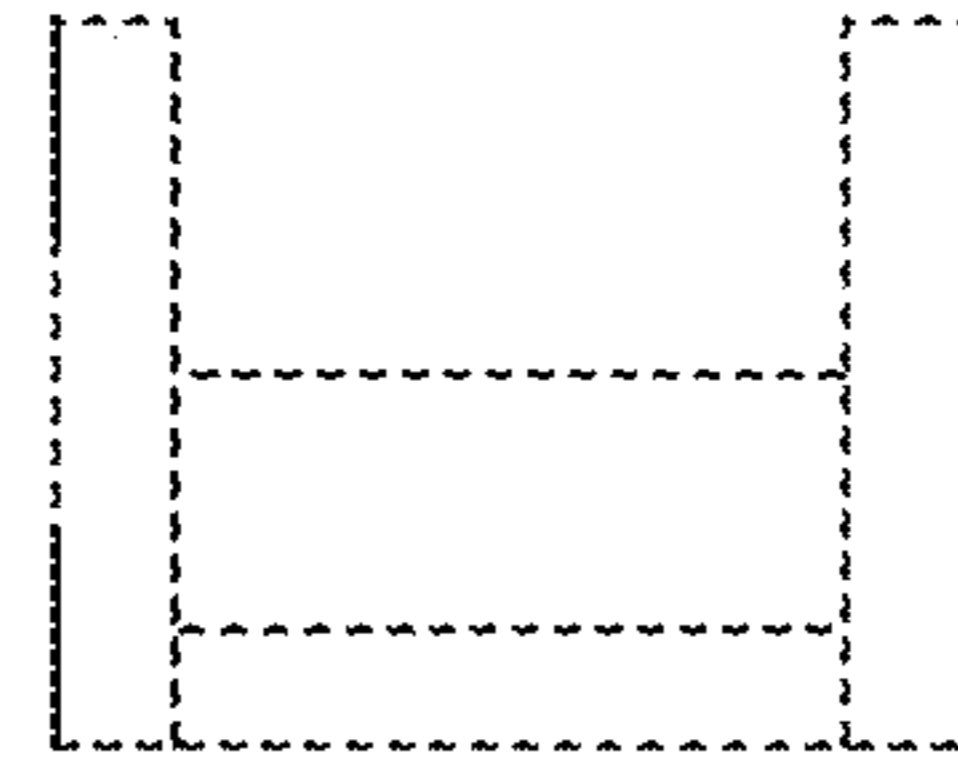

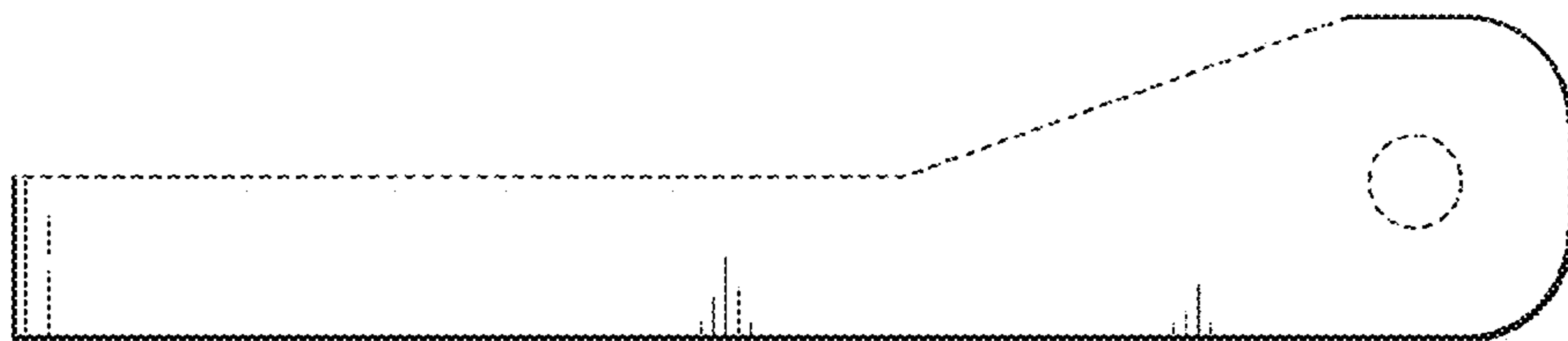

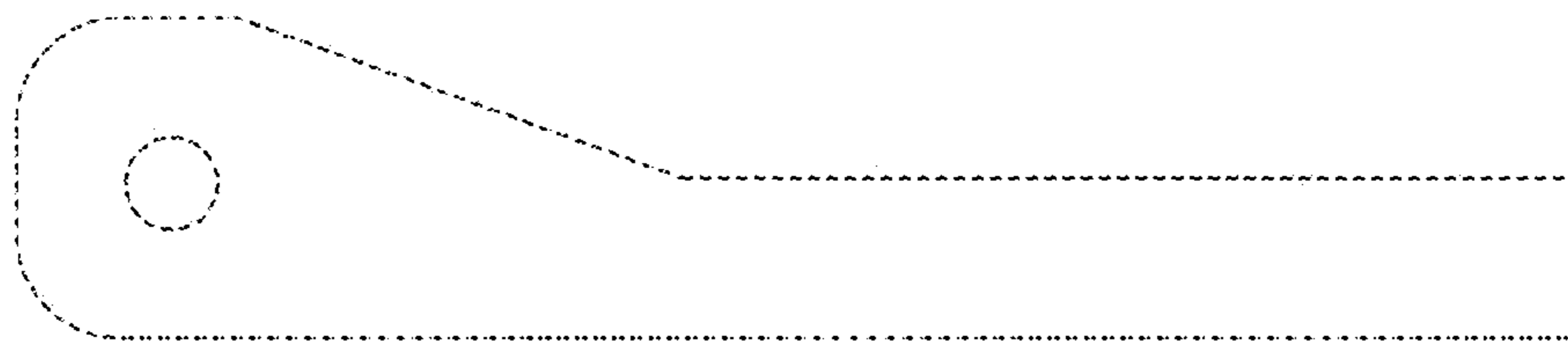

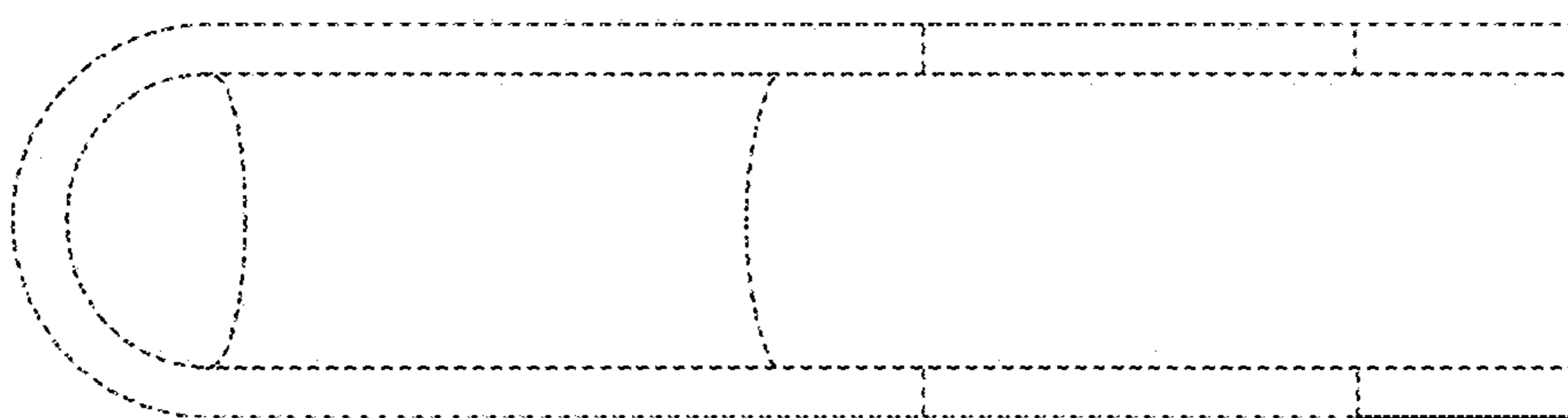

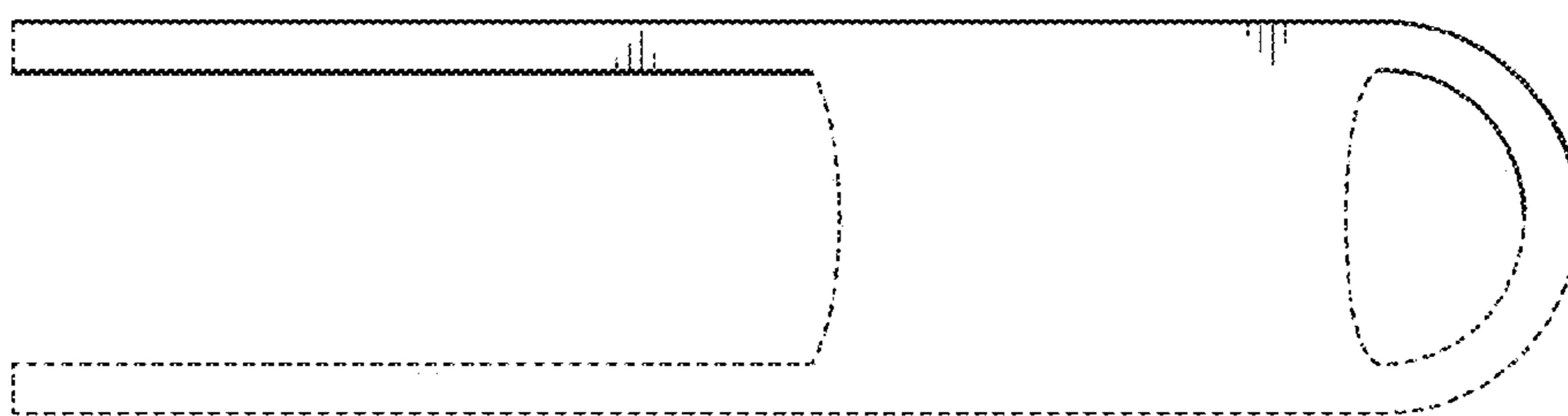

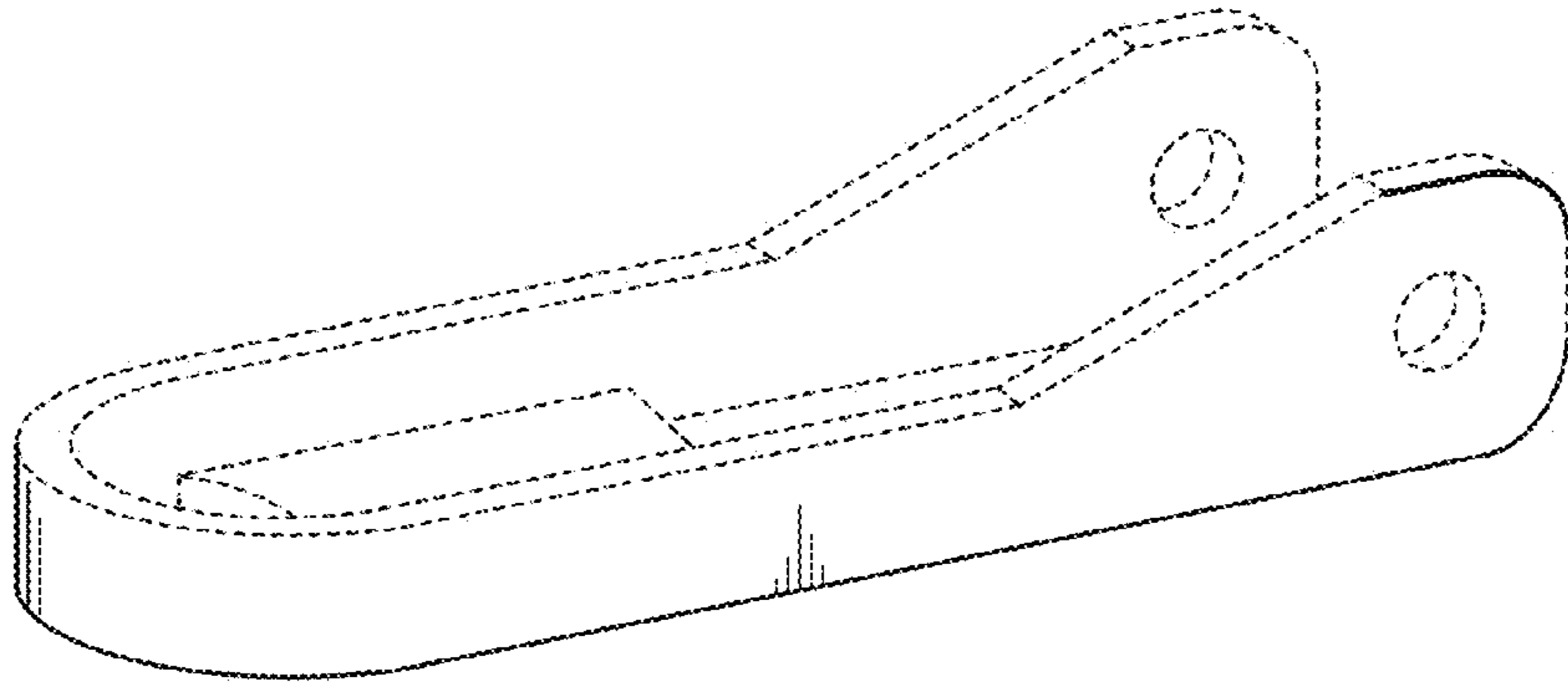

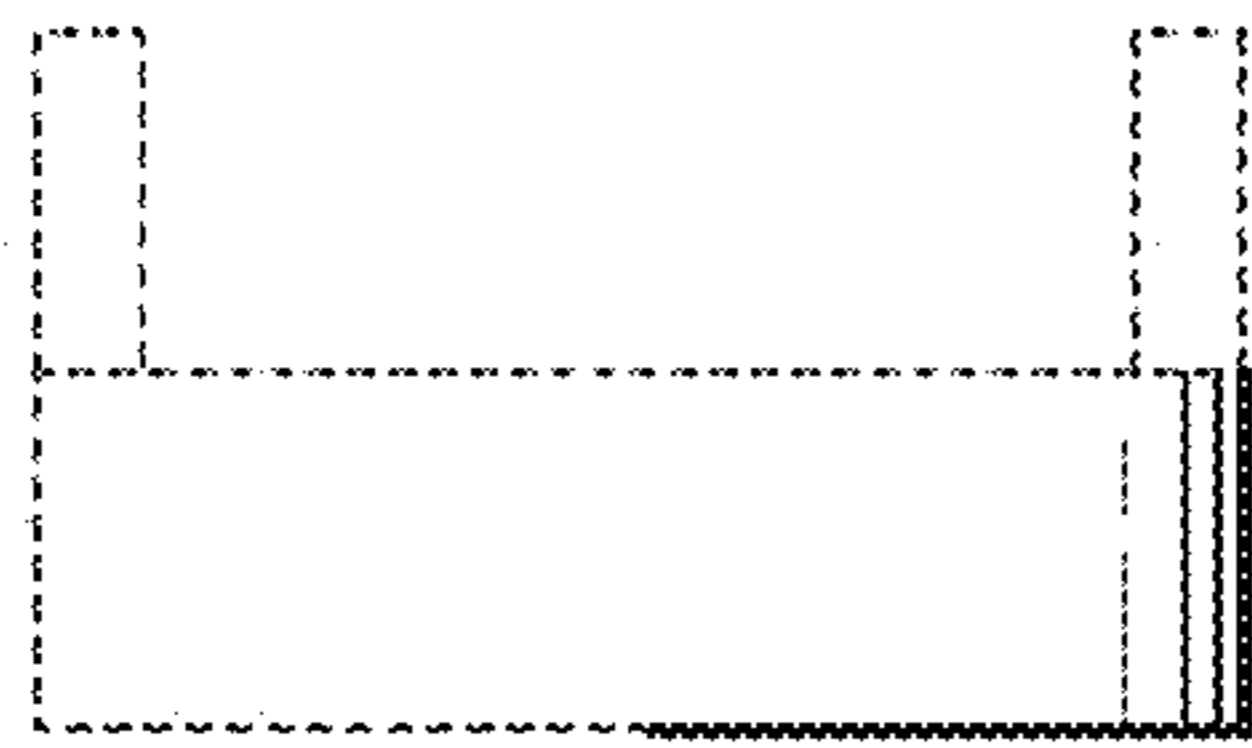

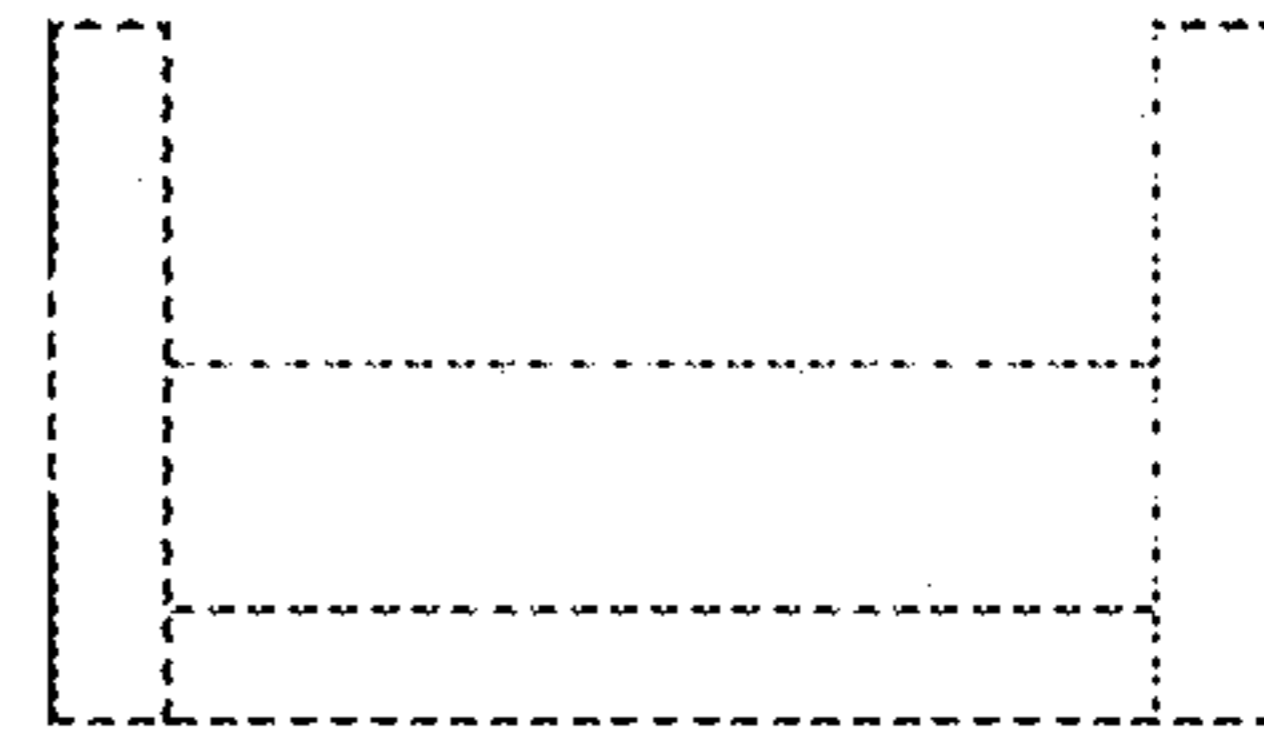

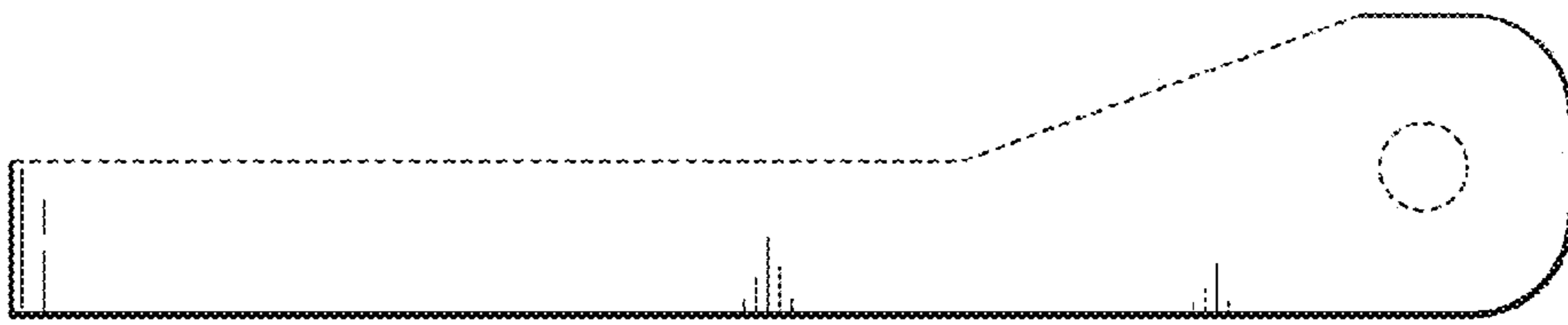

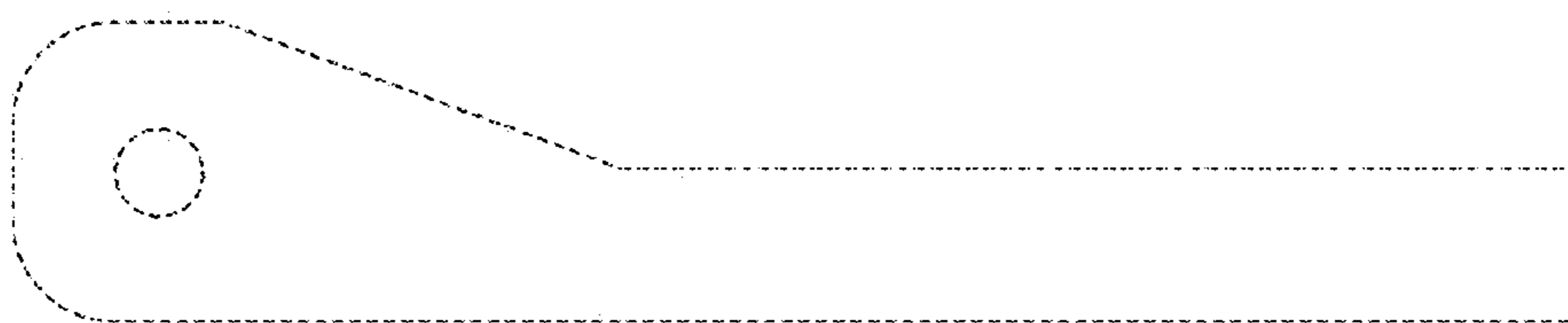

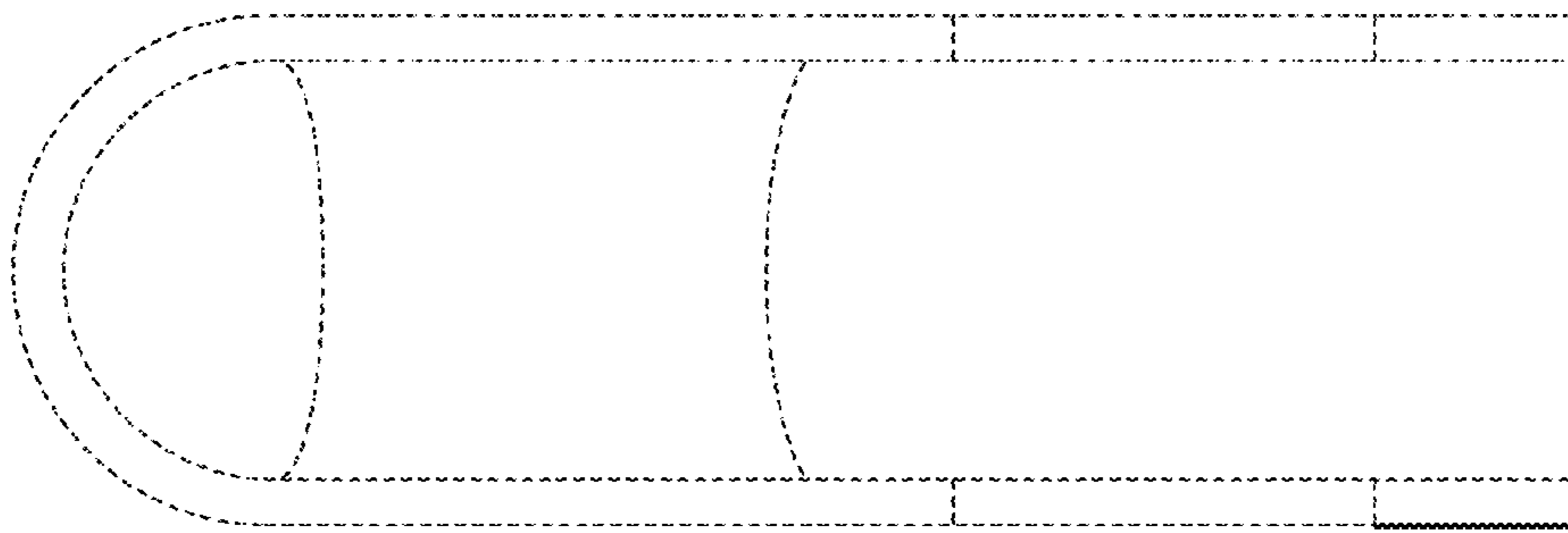

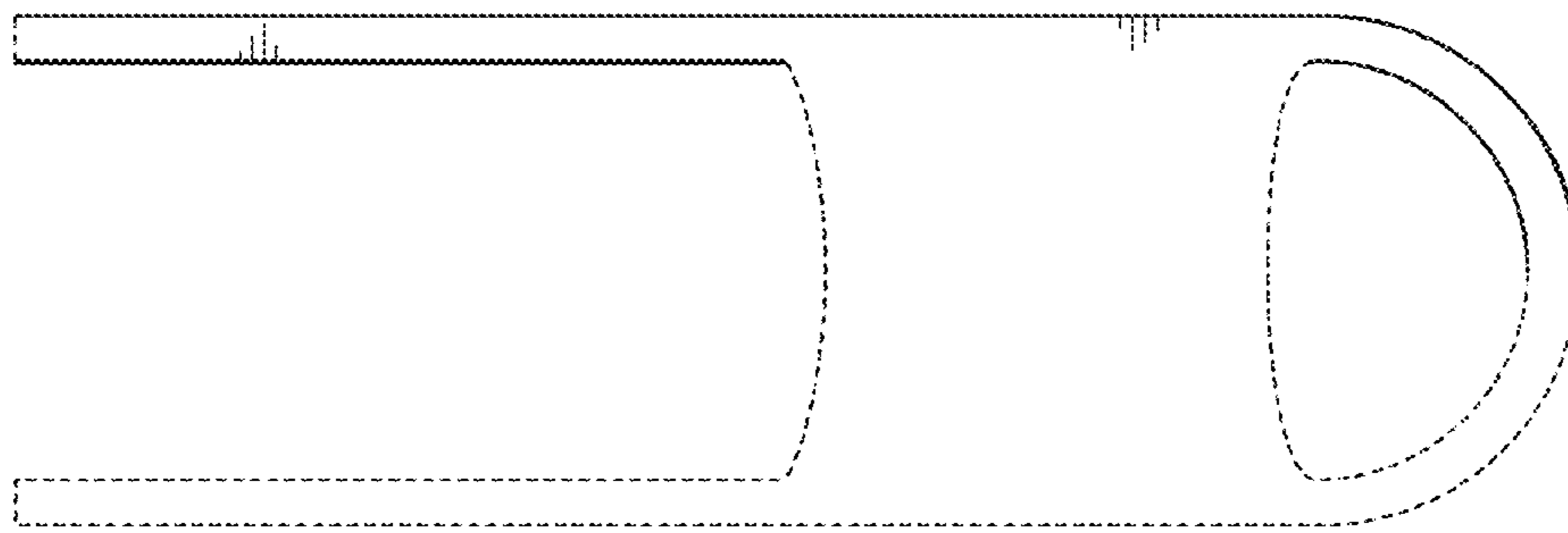

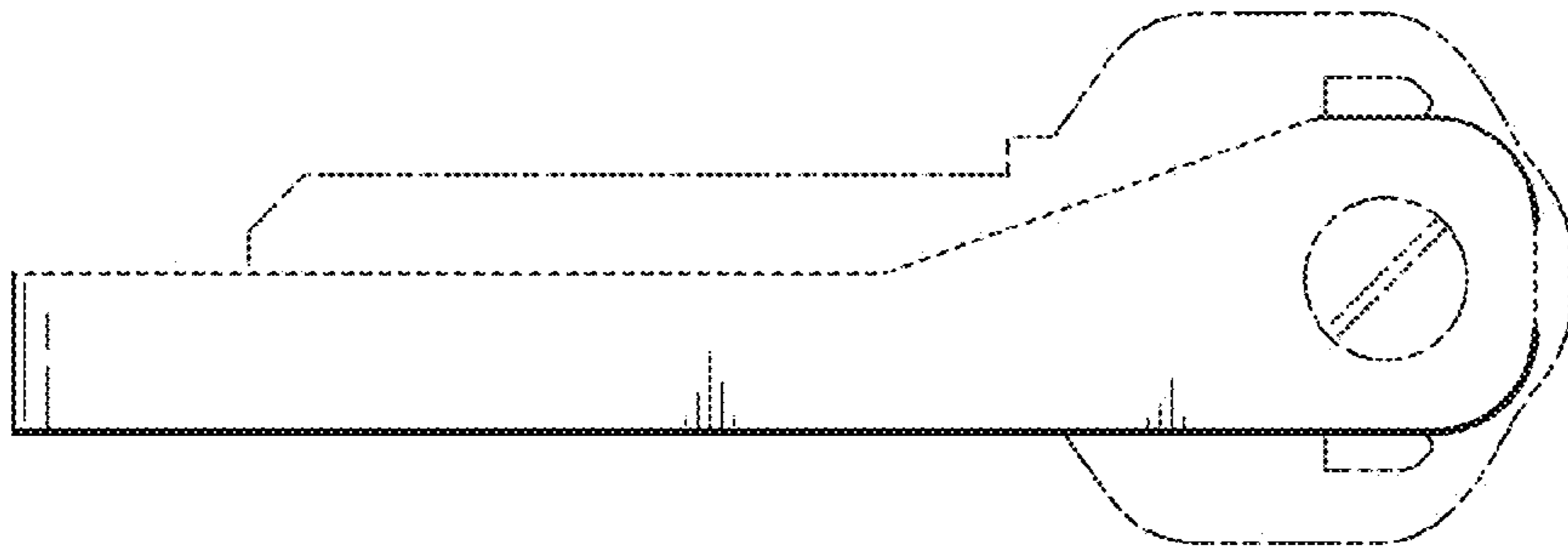

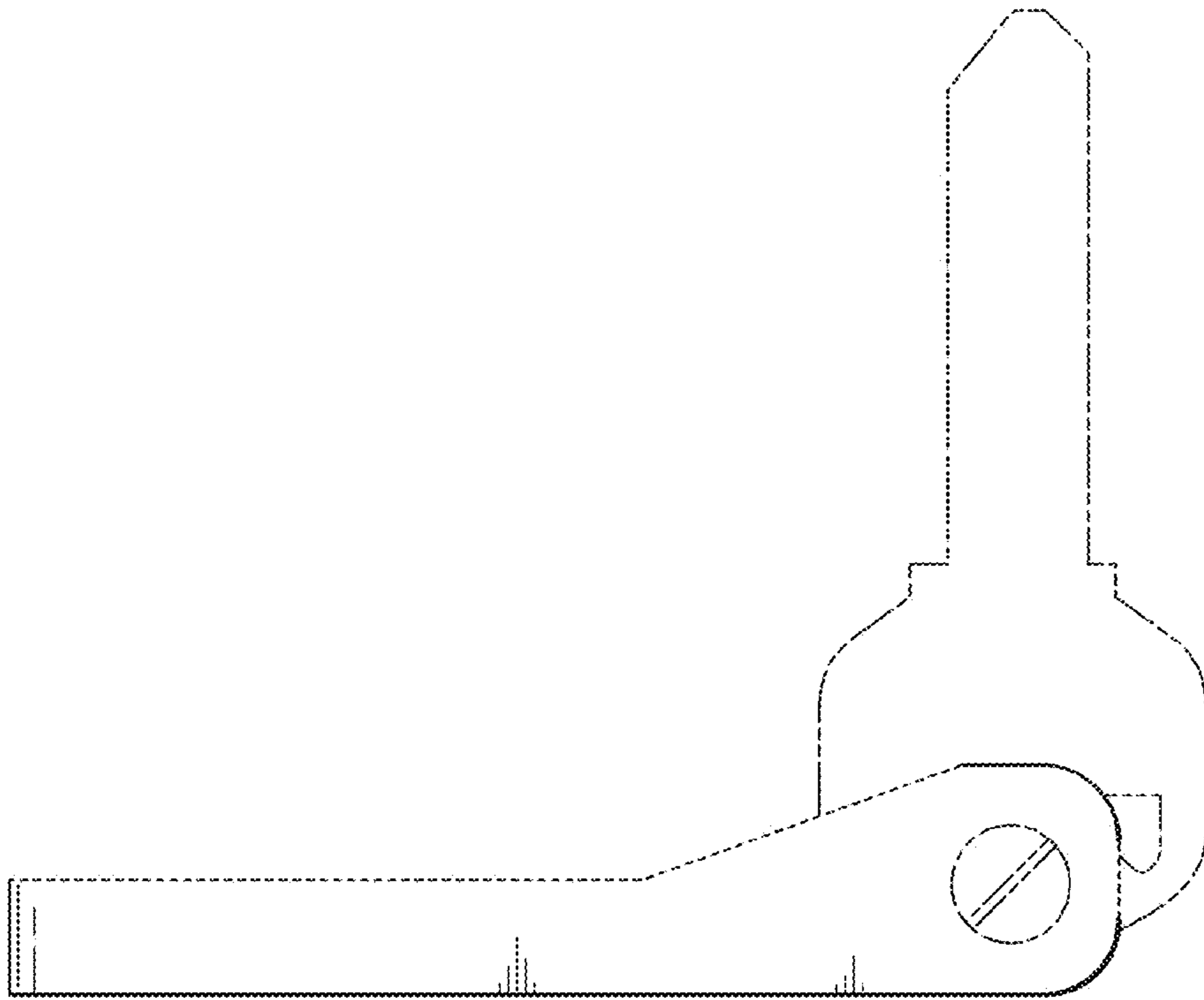
