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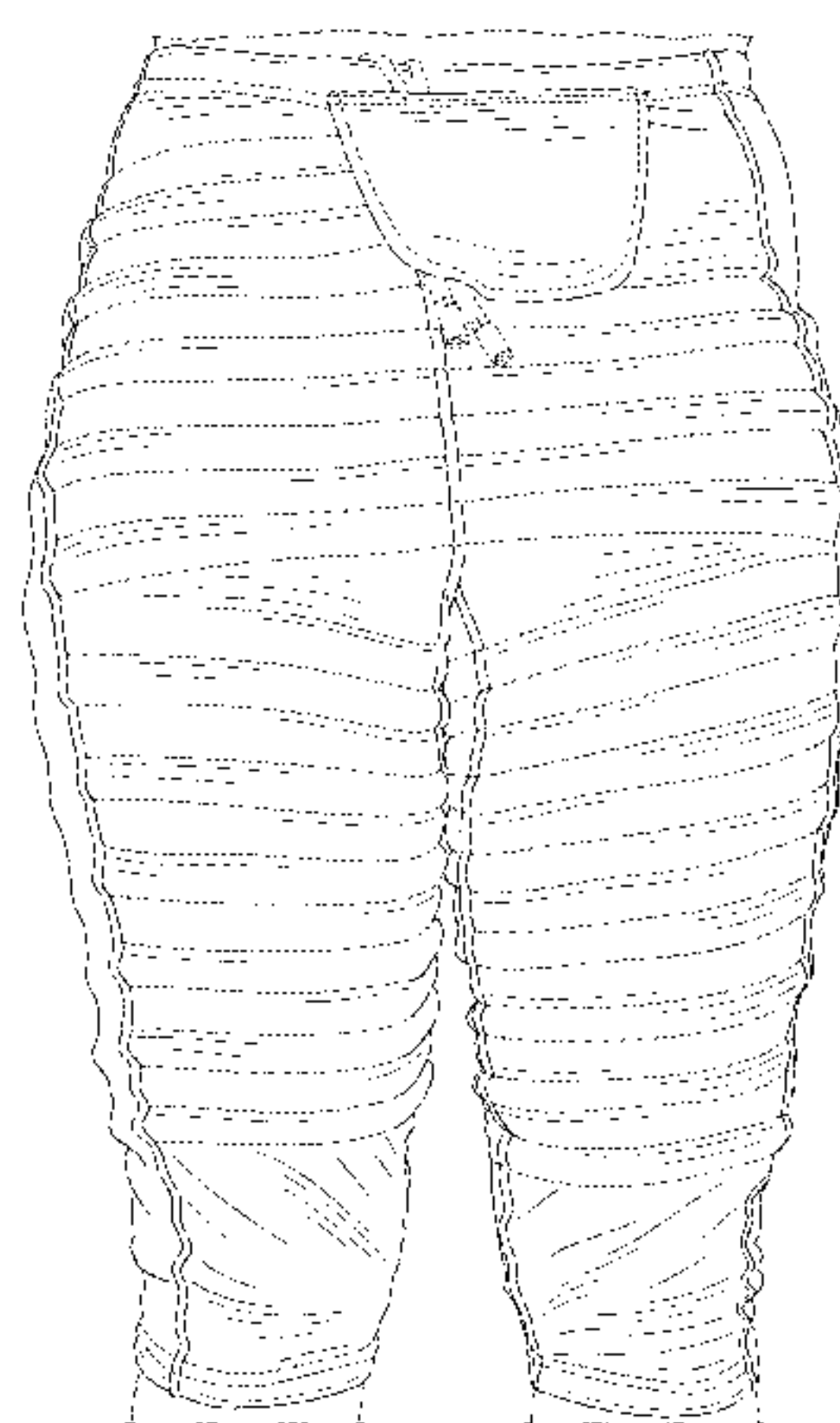

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side and rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side and front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side and front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof in an alternate configuration, showing the front flap in a raised position;
FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a left side and rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a right side and rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a left side and rear perspective view thereof, showing an alternate configuration showing an exercise belt being worn over the body-hugging pants;
FIG. 13 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a right side and front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 15 is a left side and front perspective view, from an angled perspective more towards the left side; and,
FIG. 16 is a left side and front perspective view thereof, from an angled perspective more towards the front.
The generally horizontal broken lines on the body of the body-hugging pants and the broken lines about the periphery of a front flap of the body-hugging pants depict stitching. The remaining broken lines illustrate portions of the body-hugging pants that form no part of the claimed design as well as environmental matter that forms no part of the claimed design including the exposed human body parts (i.e., the human torso extending above the body-hugging pants, the human arms and hands extending over the body-hugging pants, and the human legs extending below the body-hugging pants) as well as the clothing and belt worn around the human torso.

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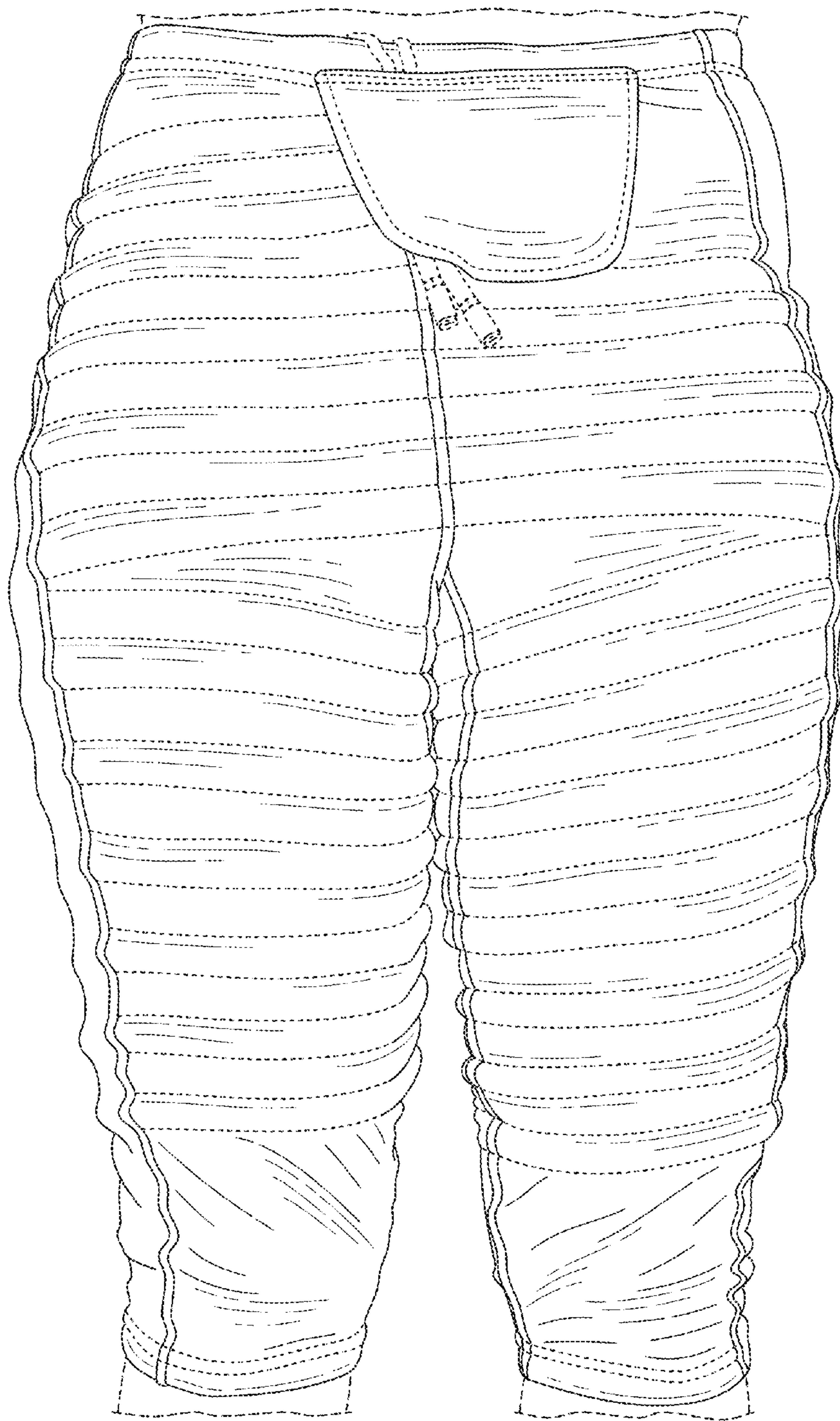

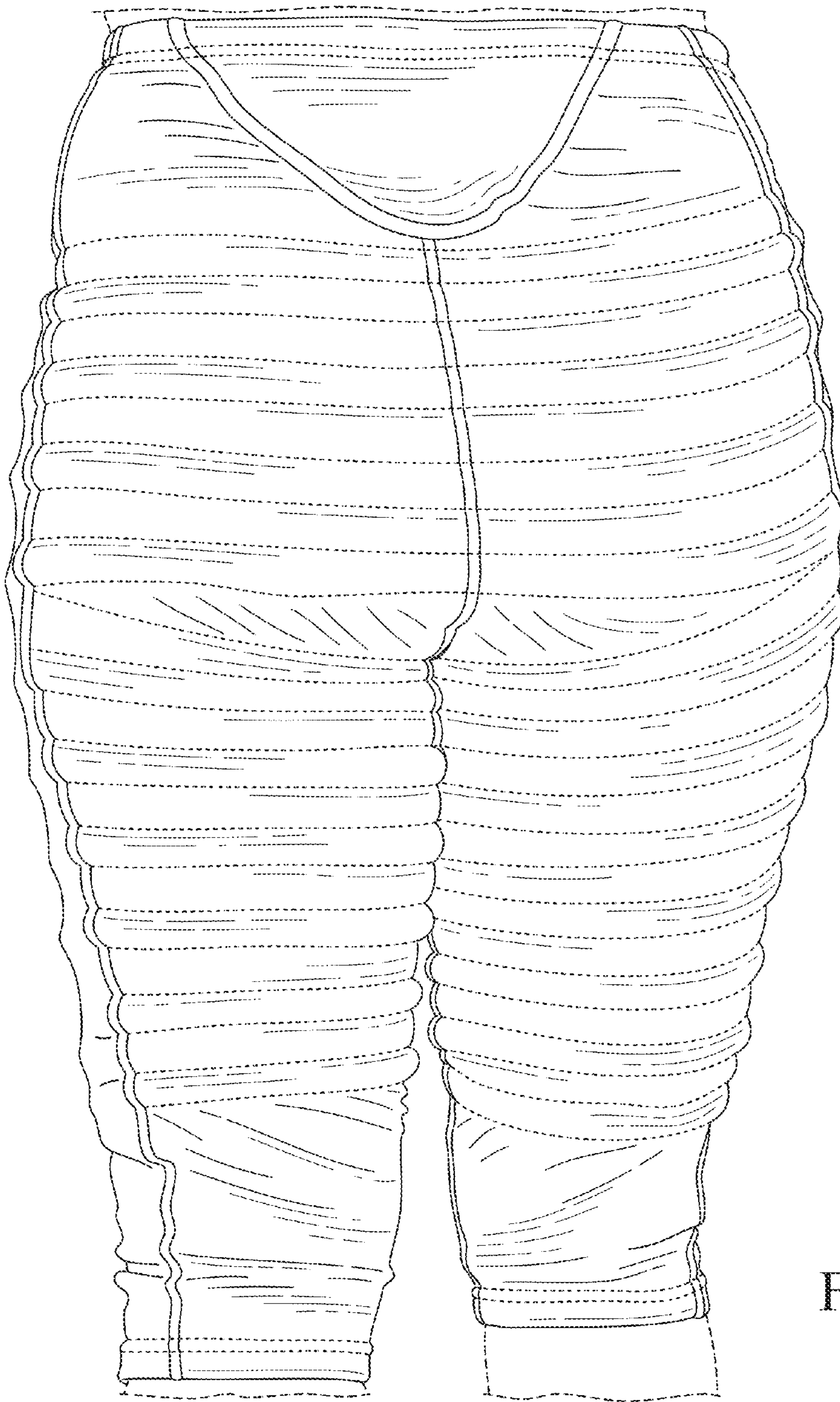

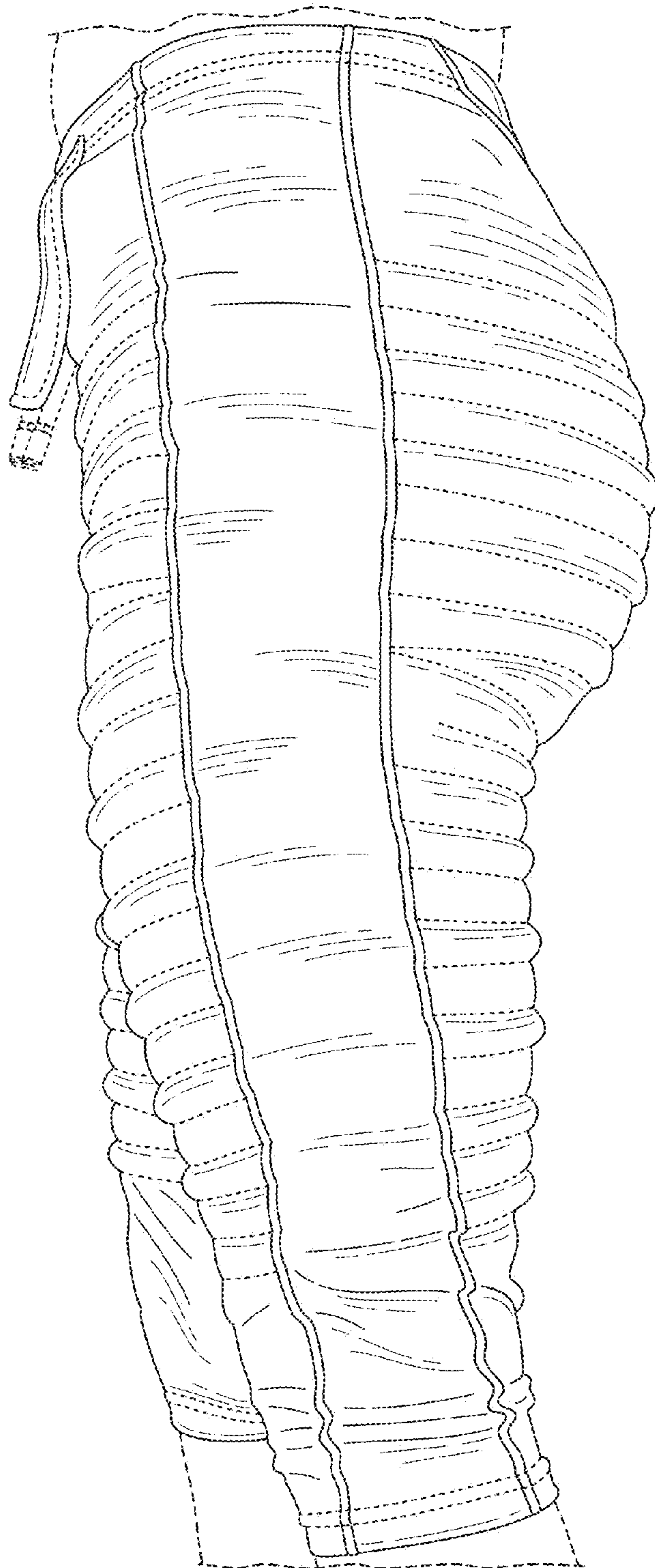

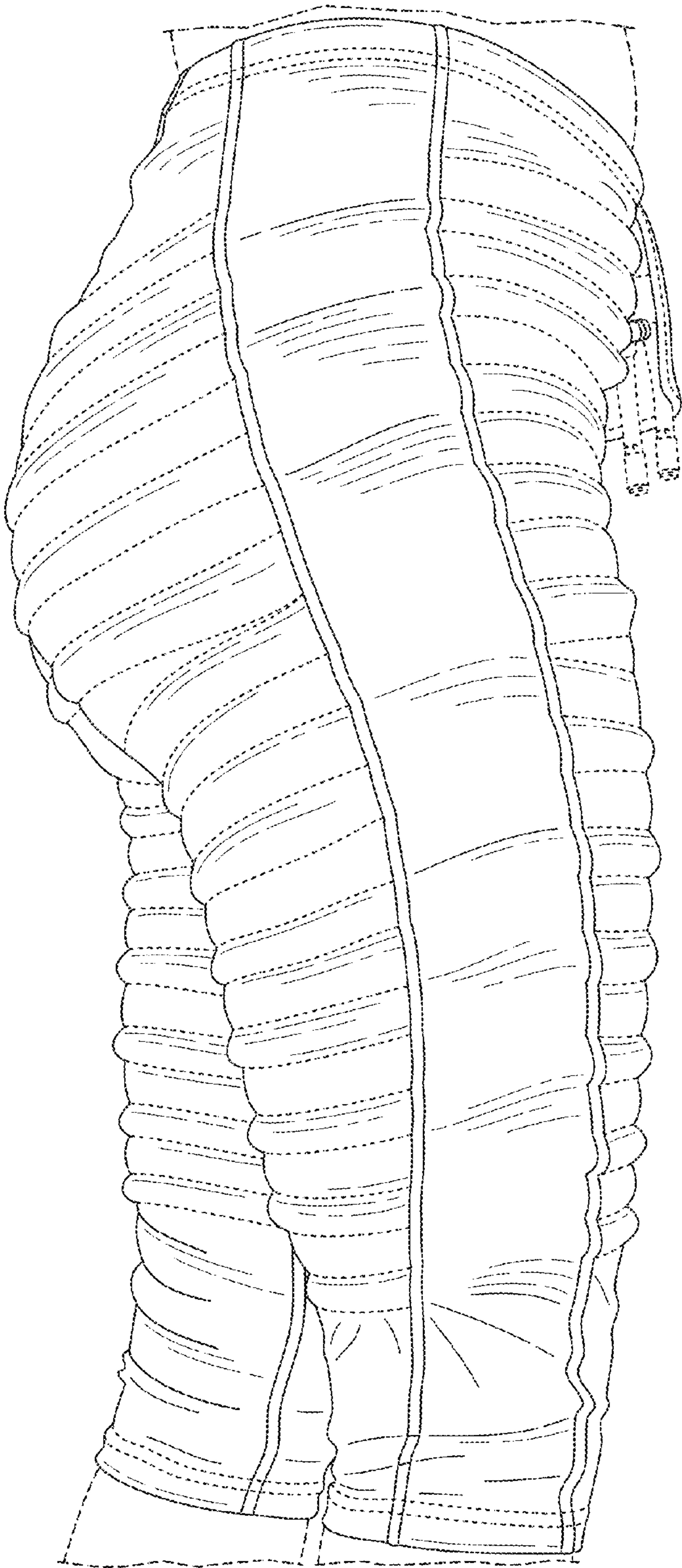

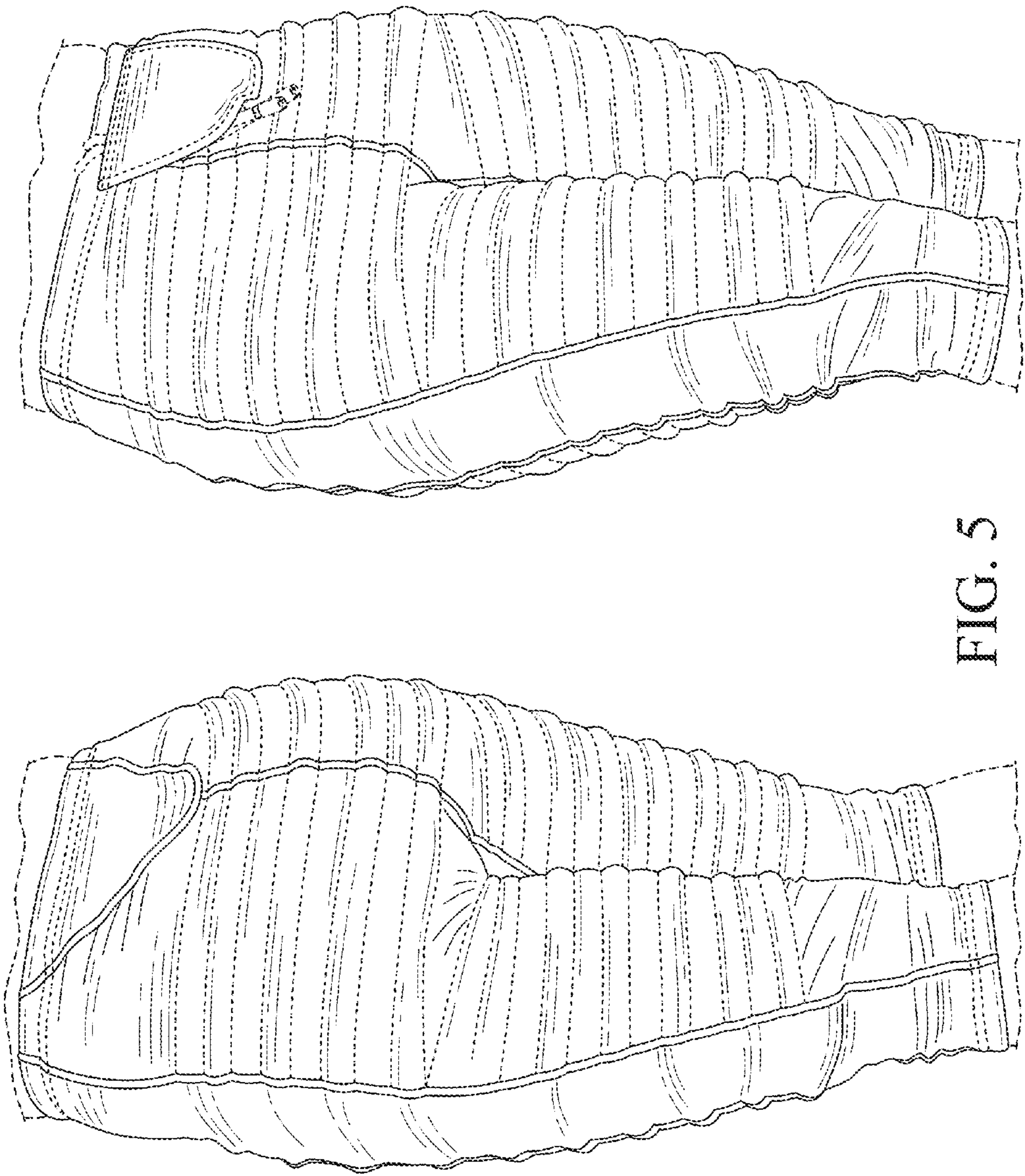

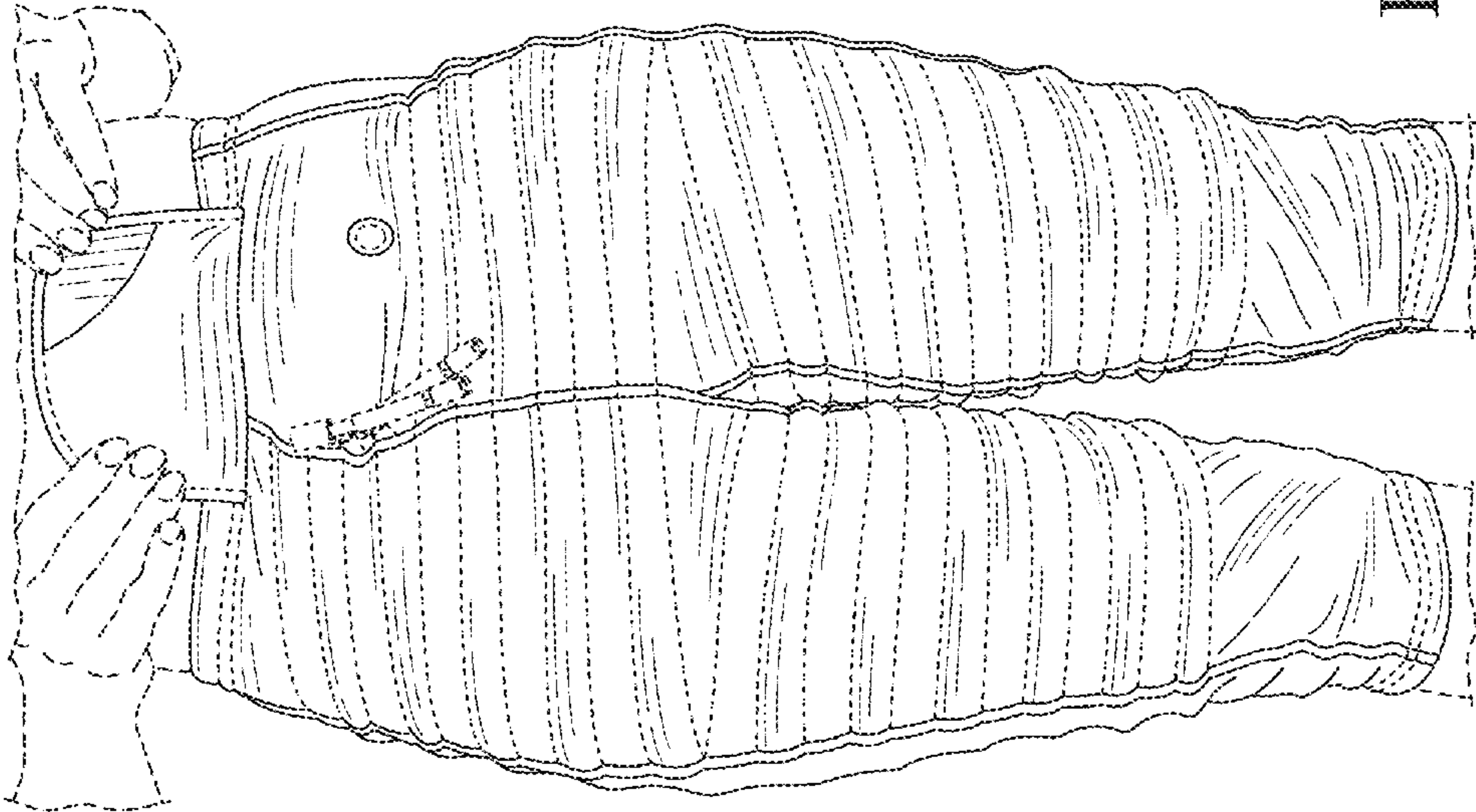

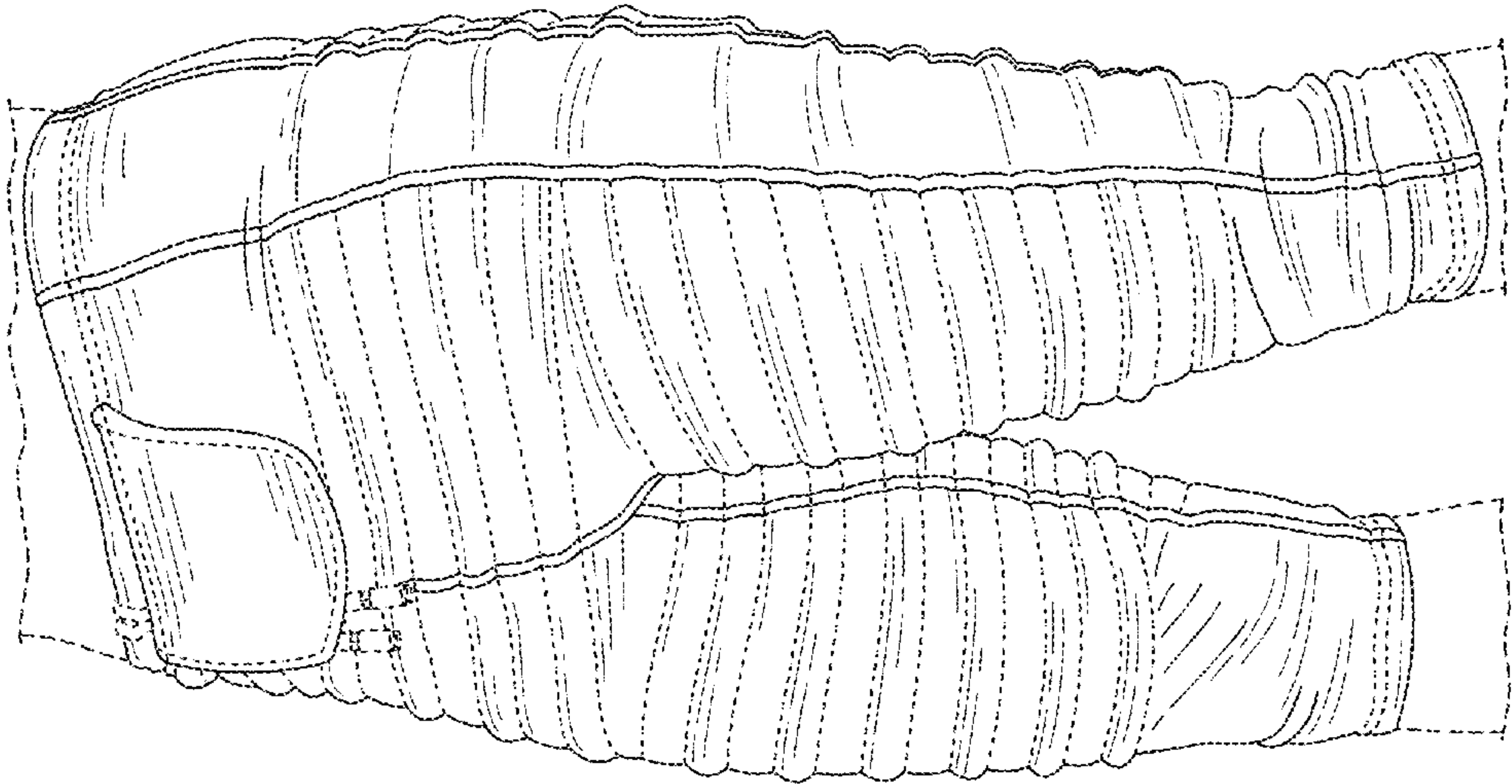

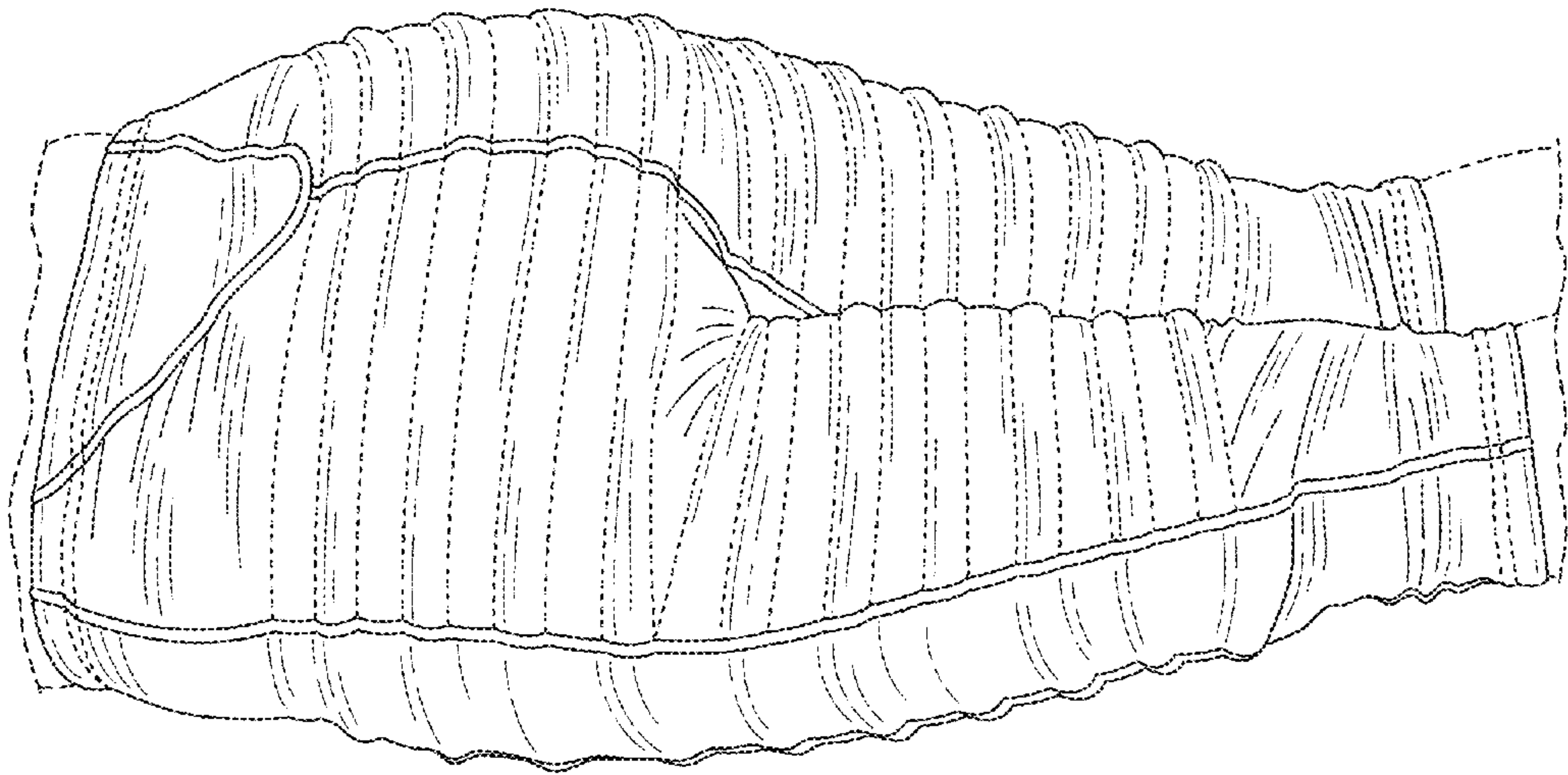

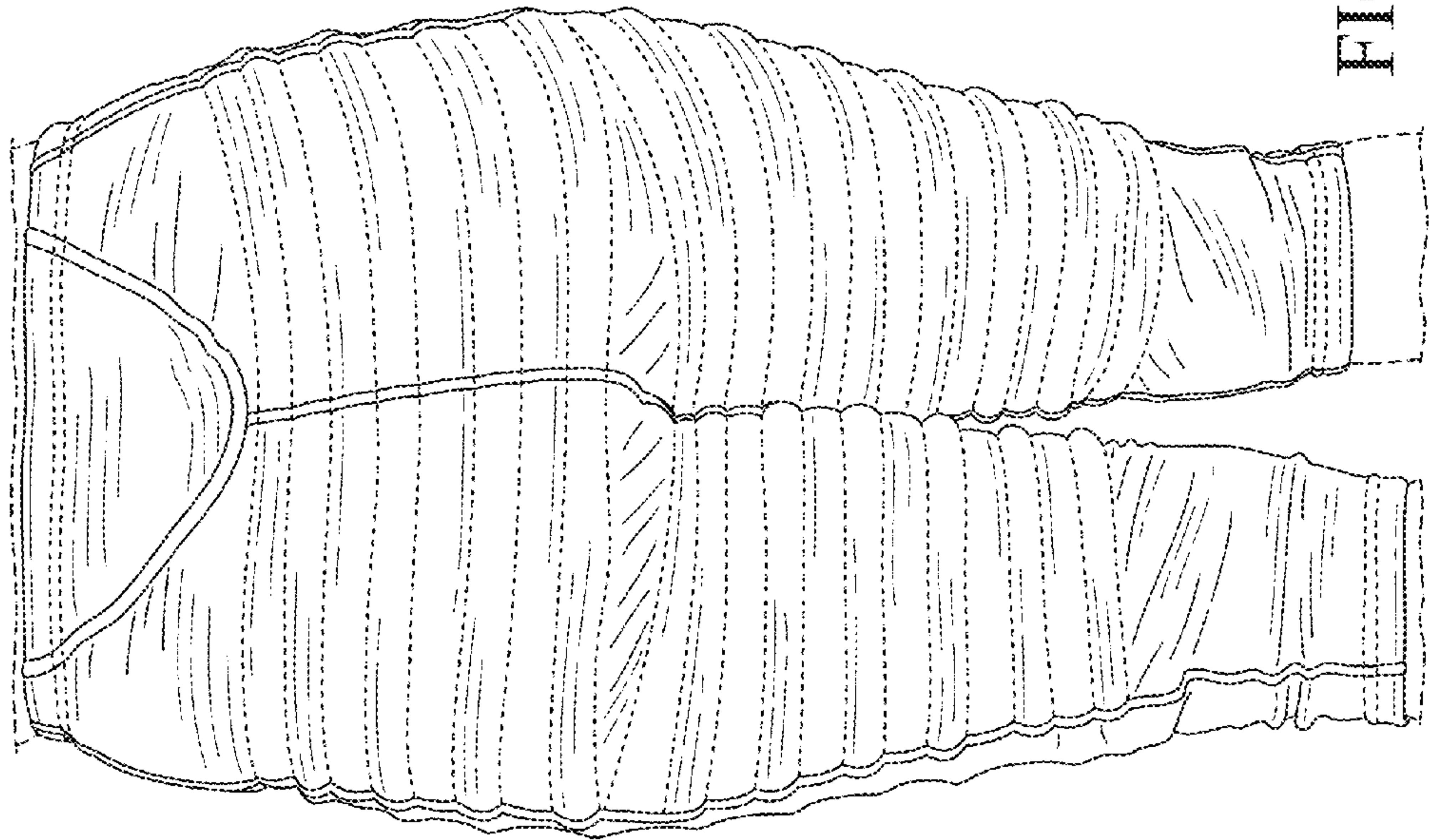

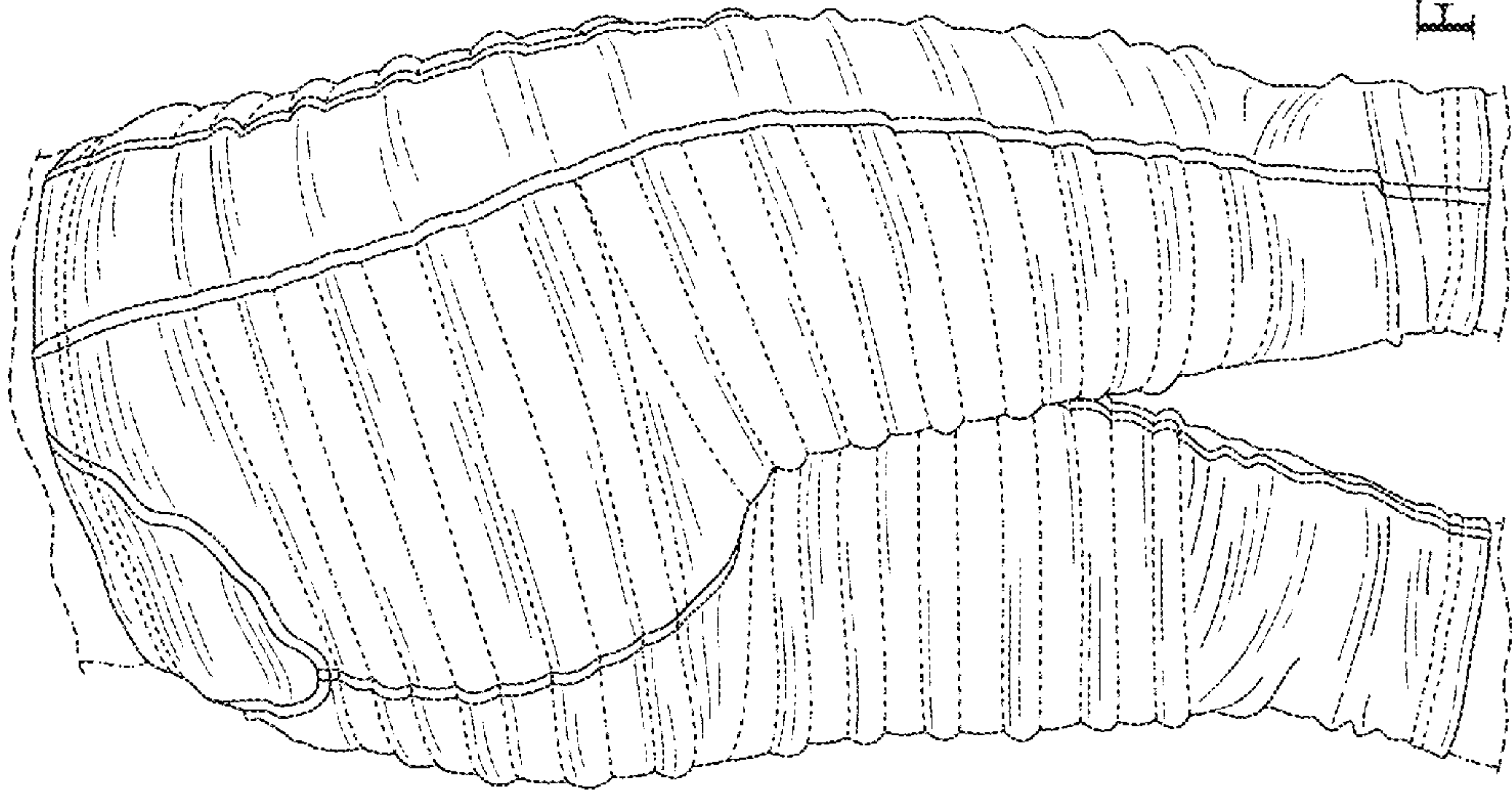

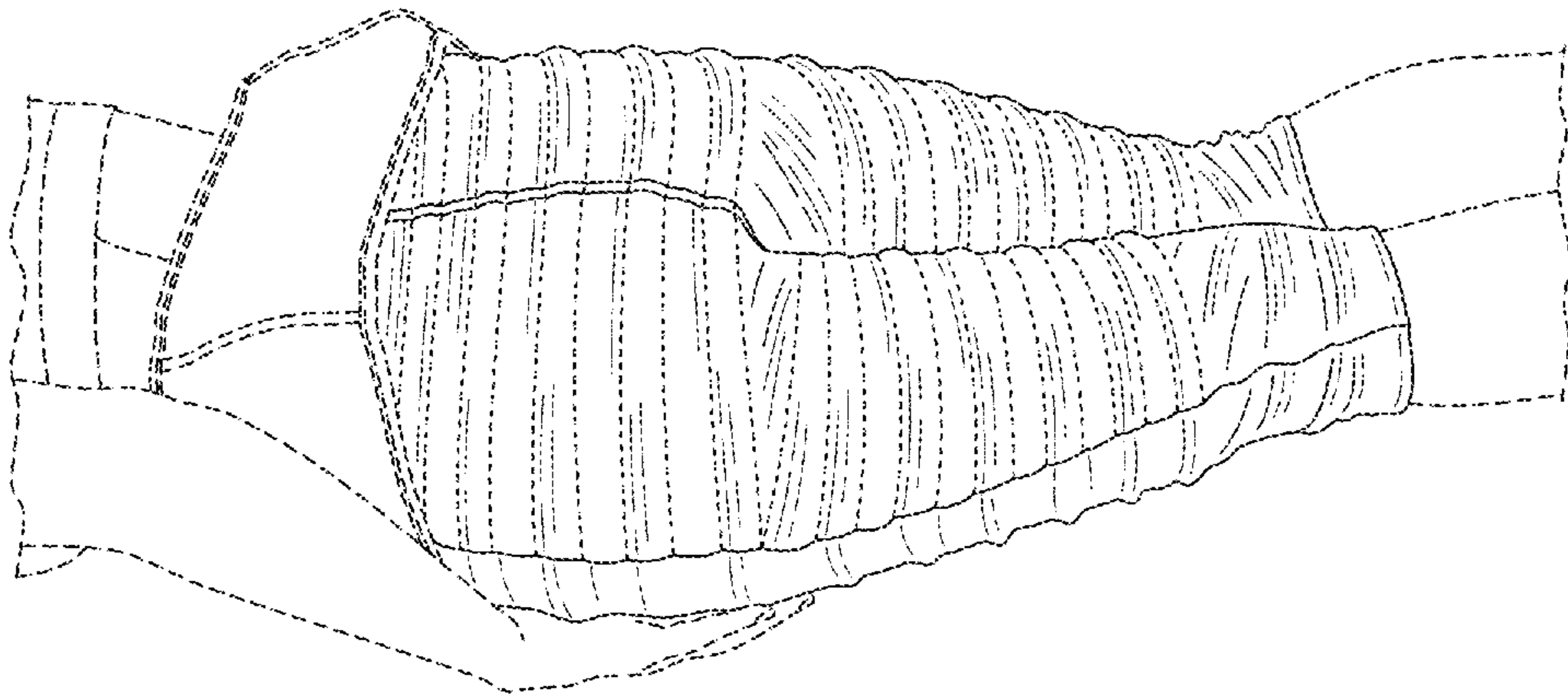

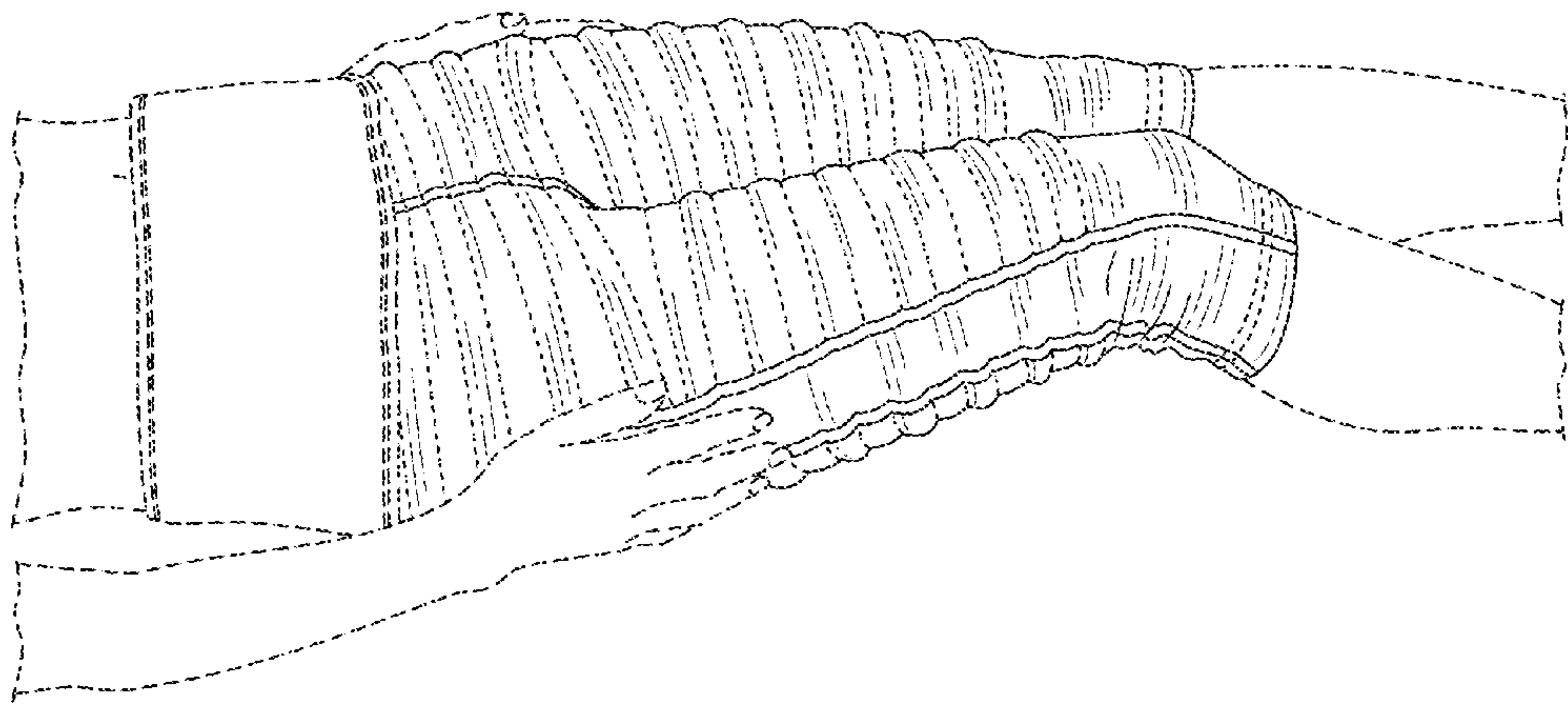

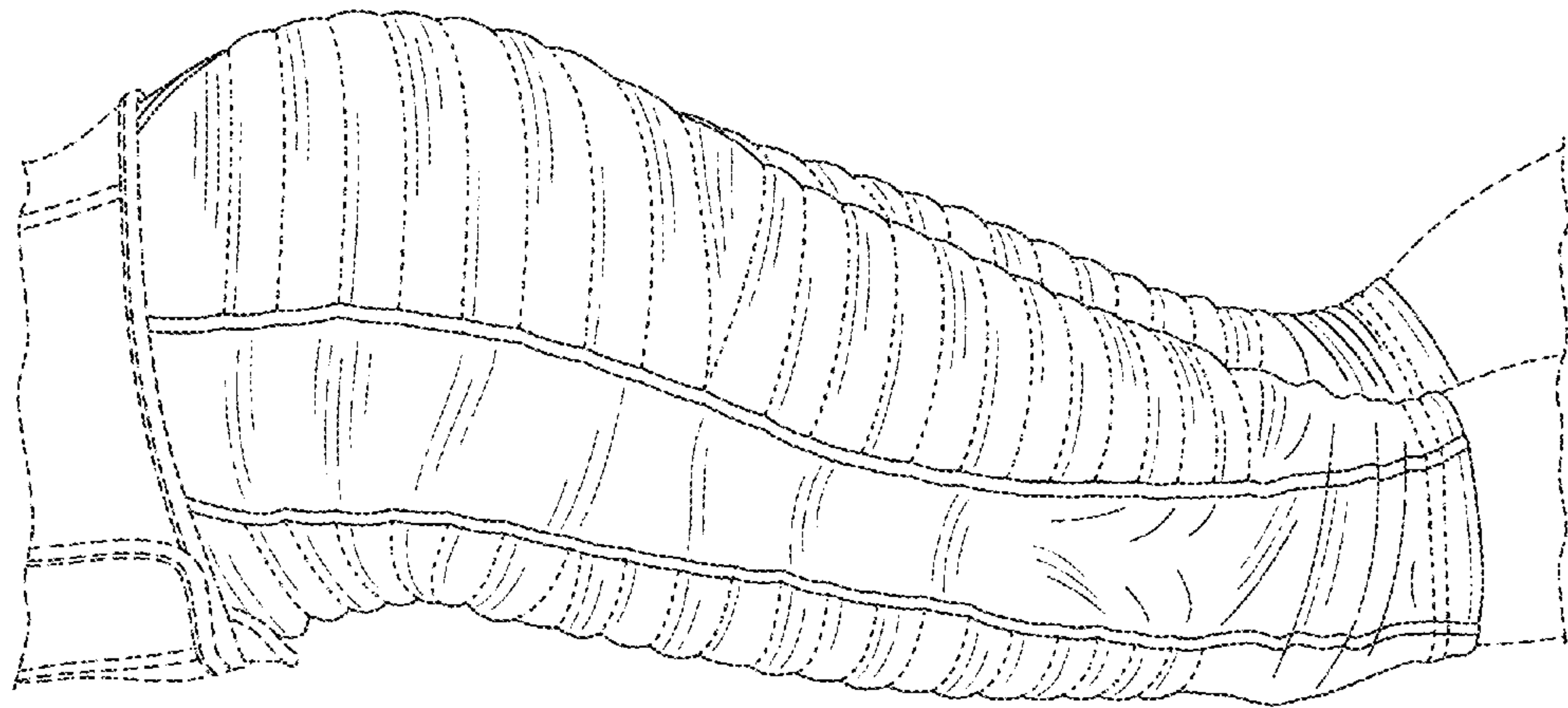

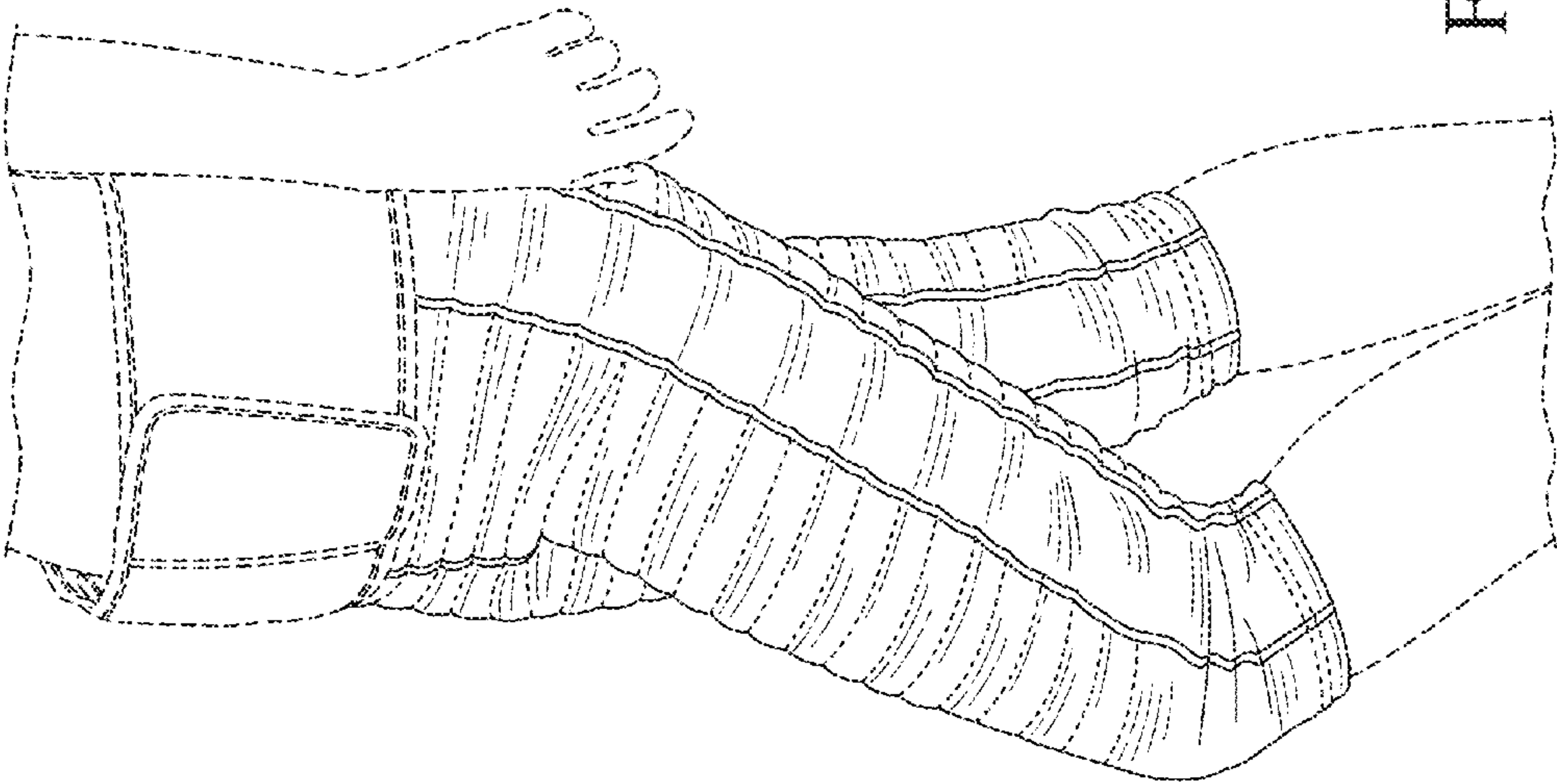

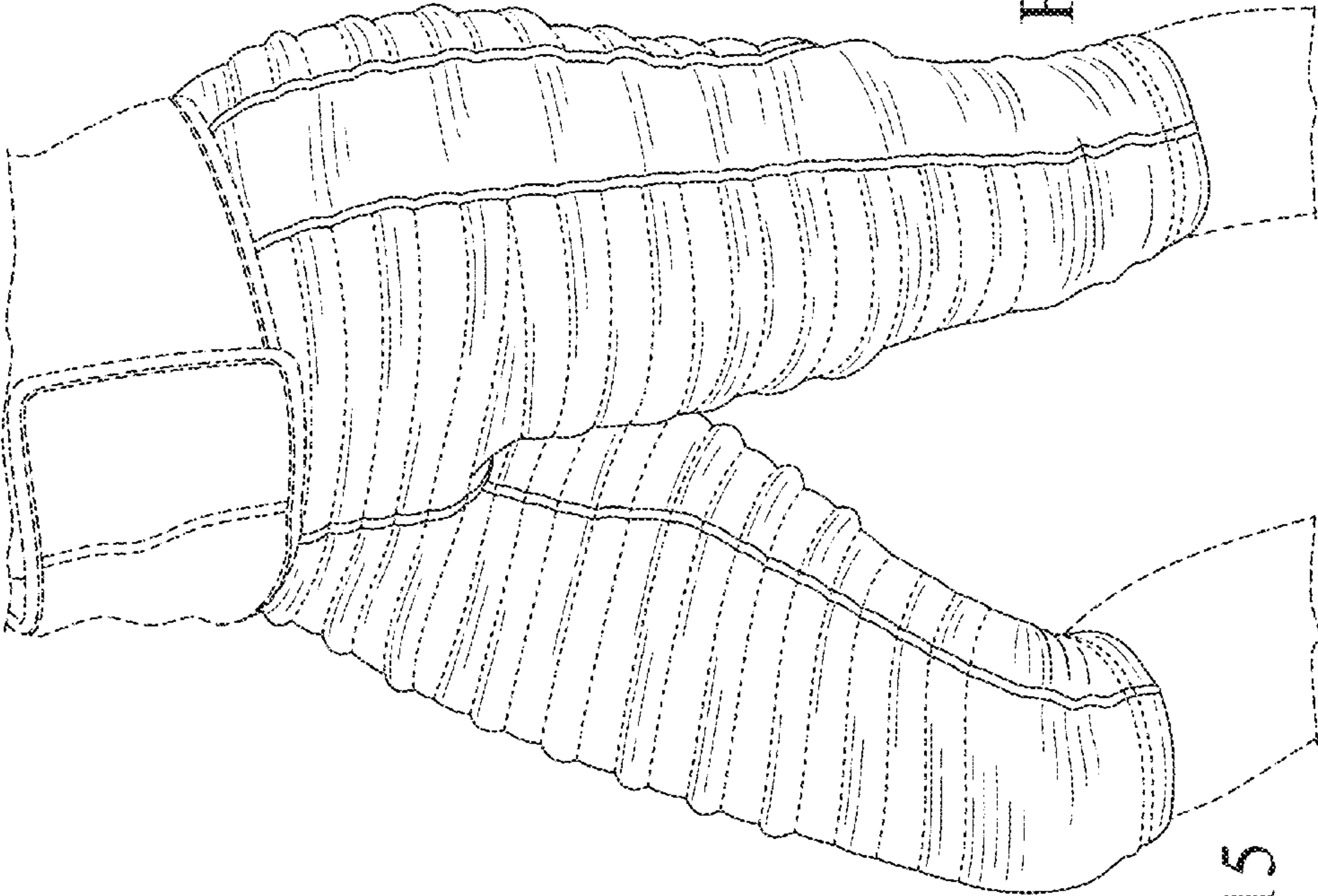
