DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, right perspective view of an RV sewer tee, according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view according to the invention; and,

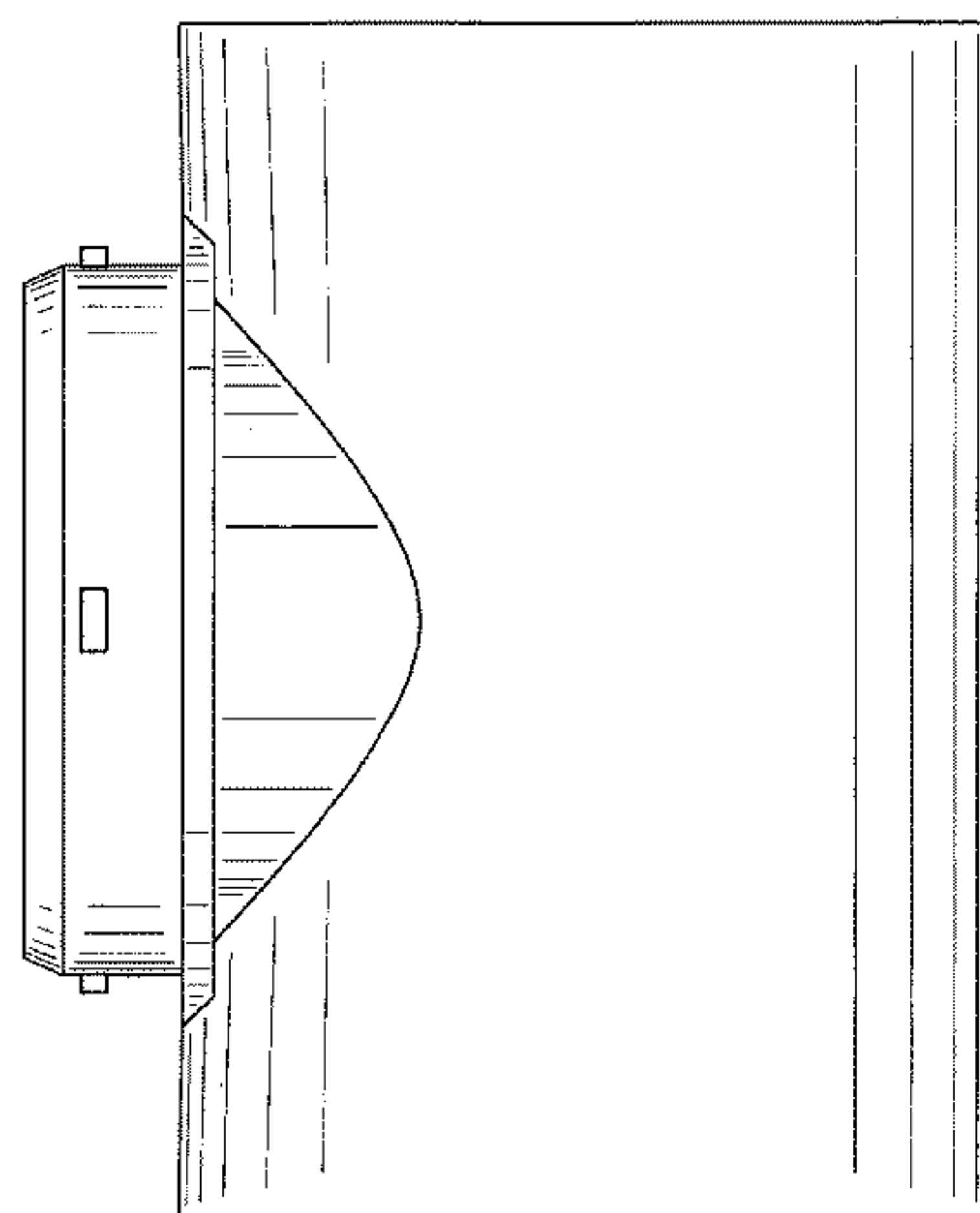
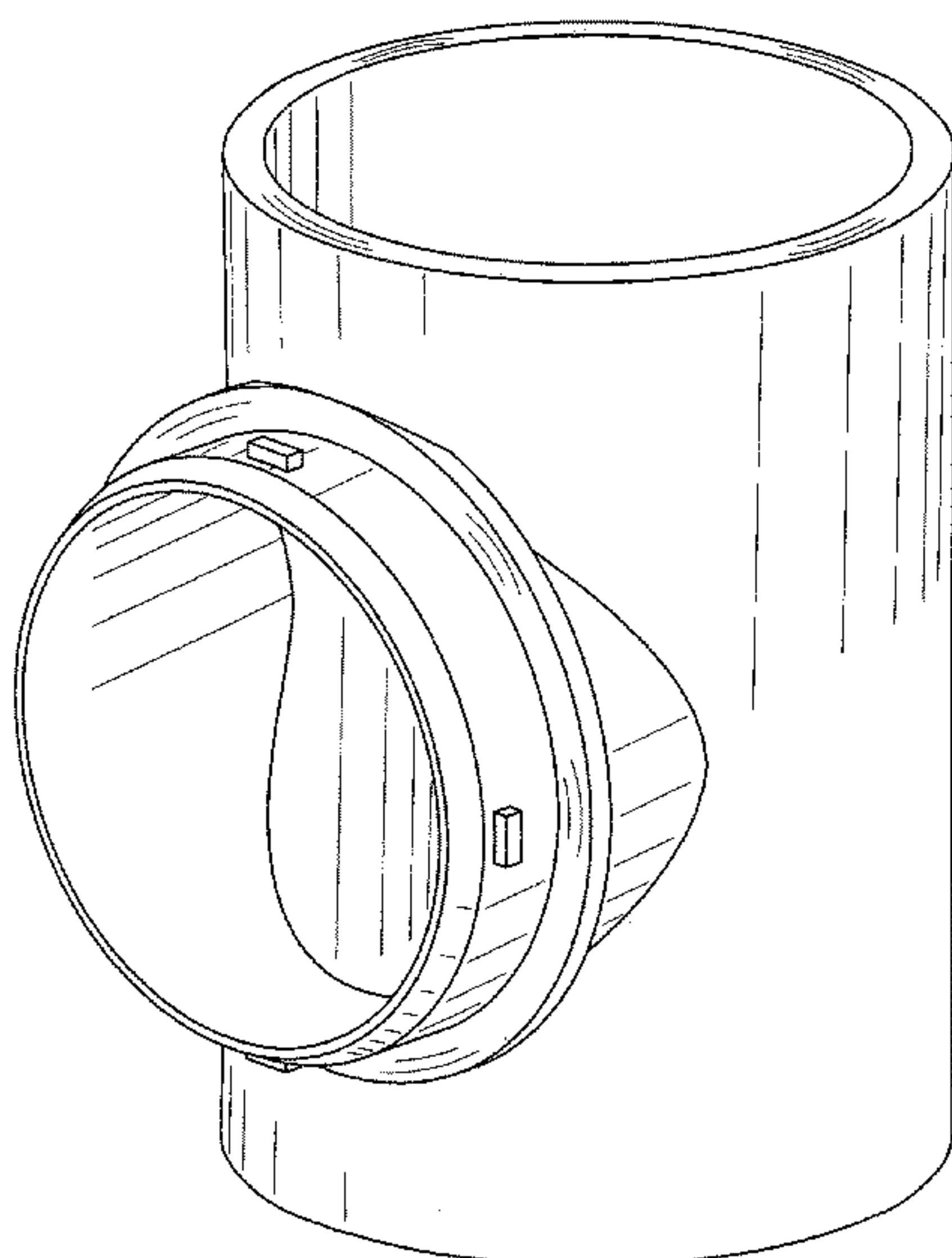
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view according to the invention; and,

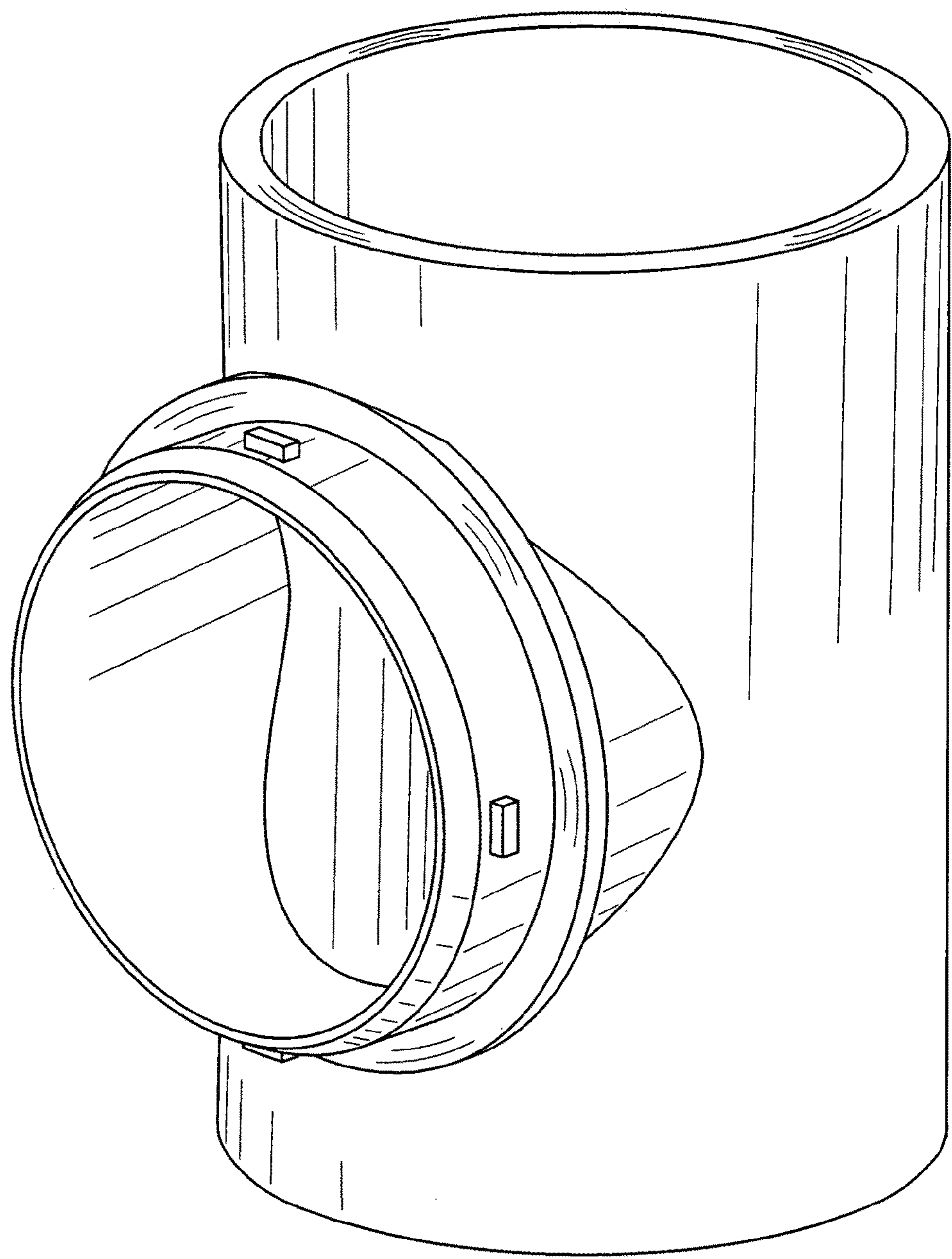

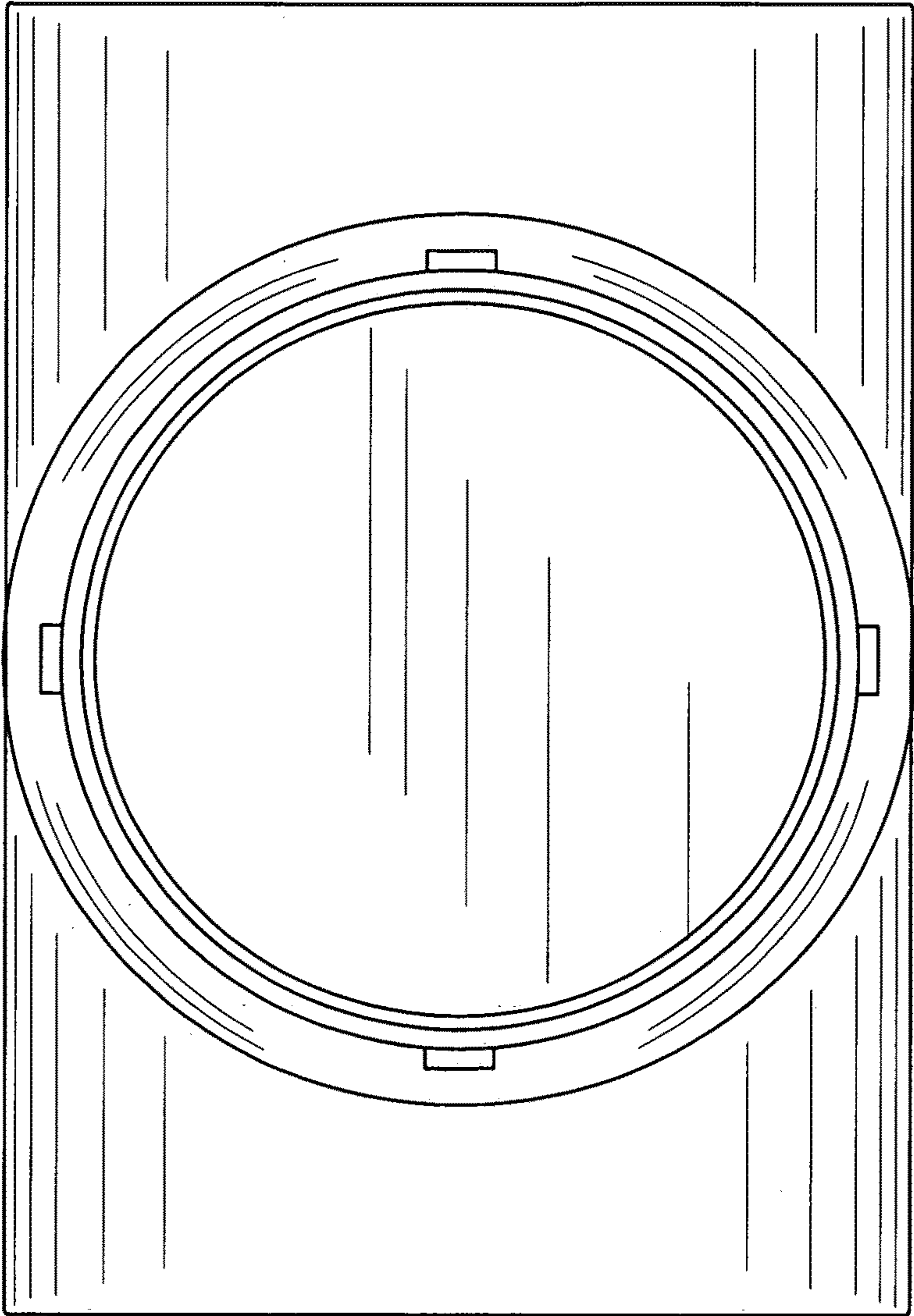

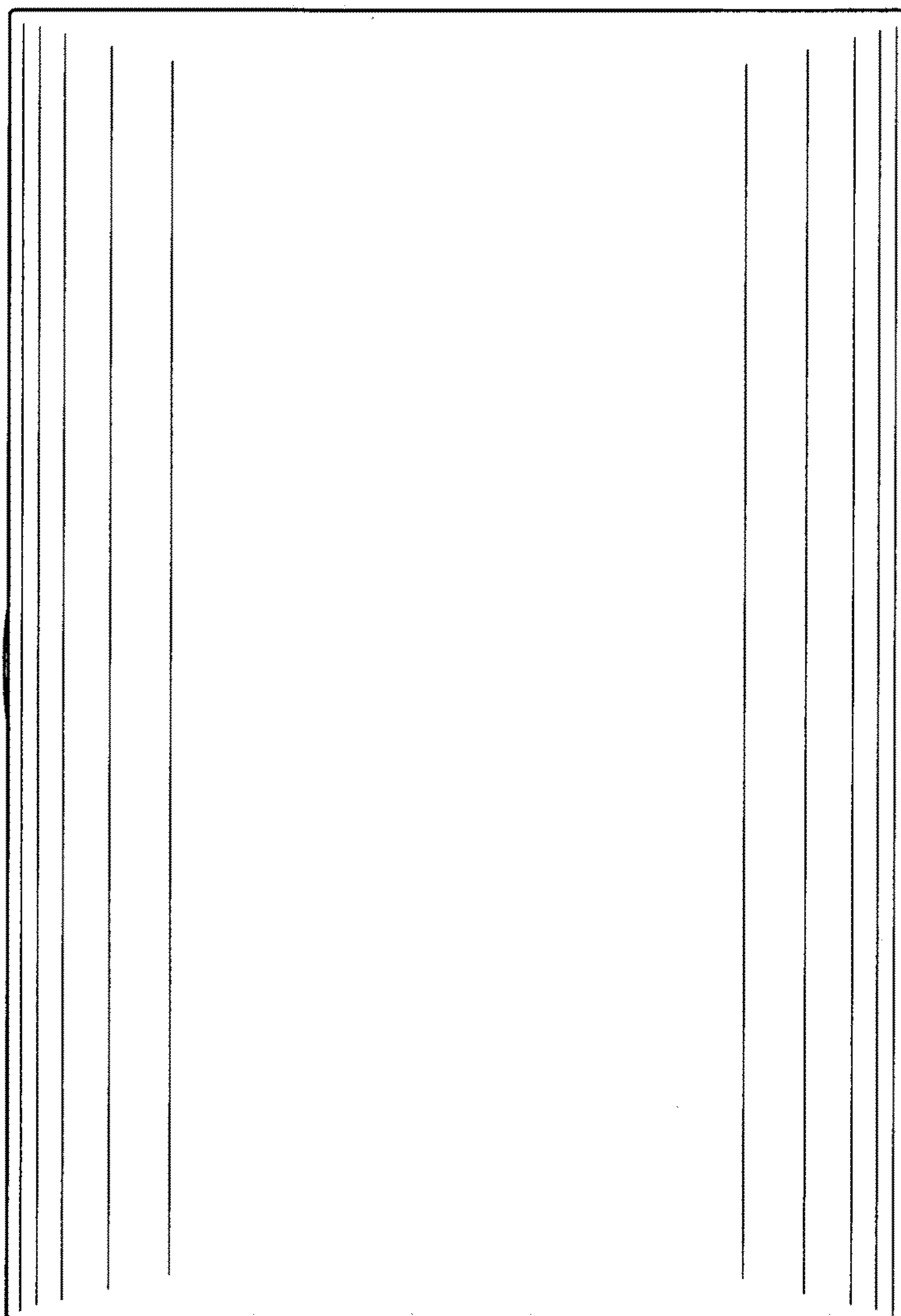

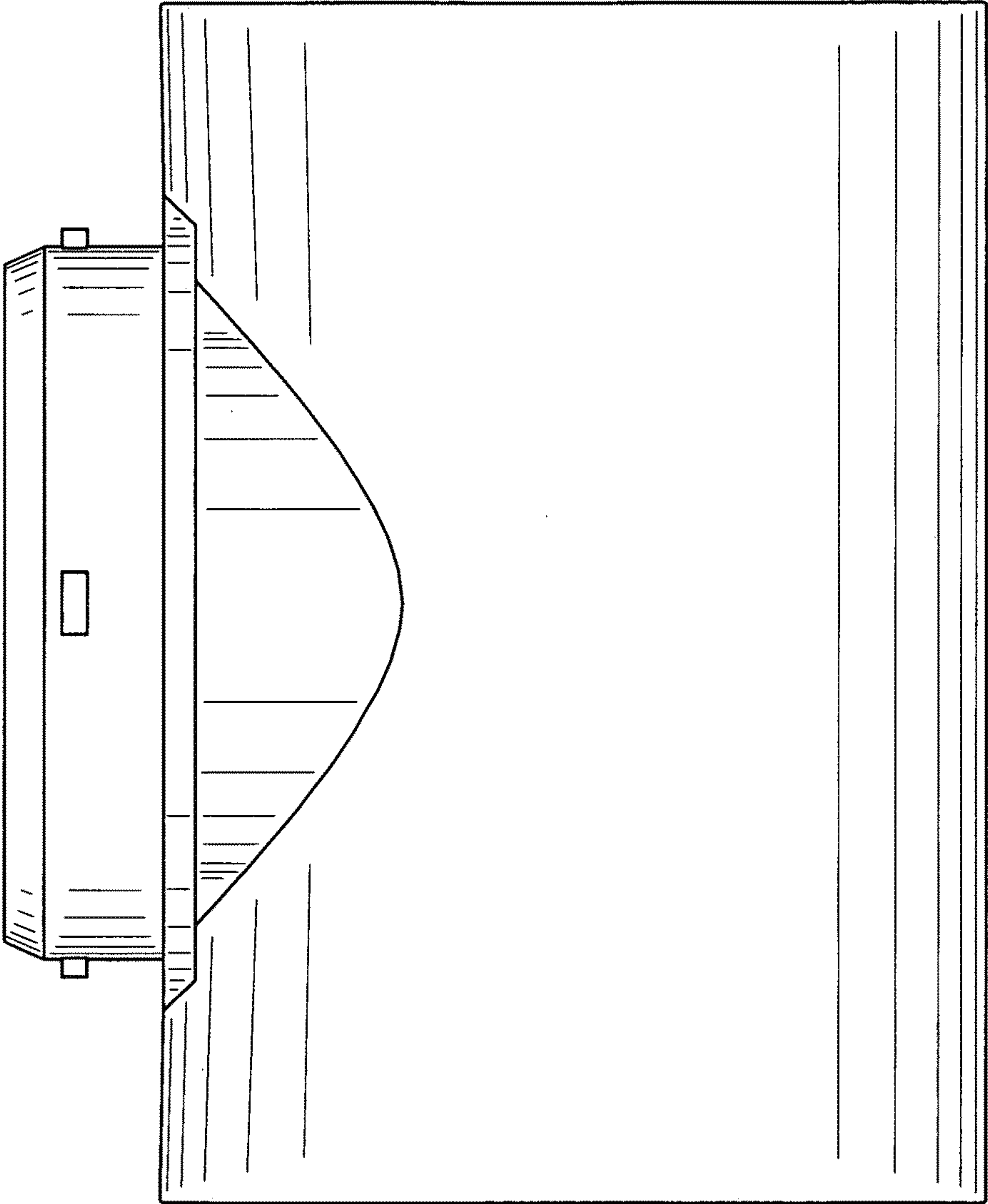

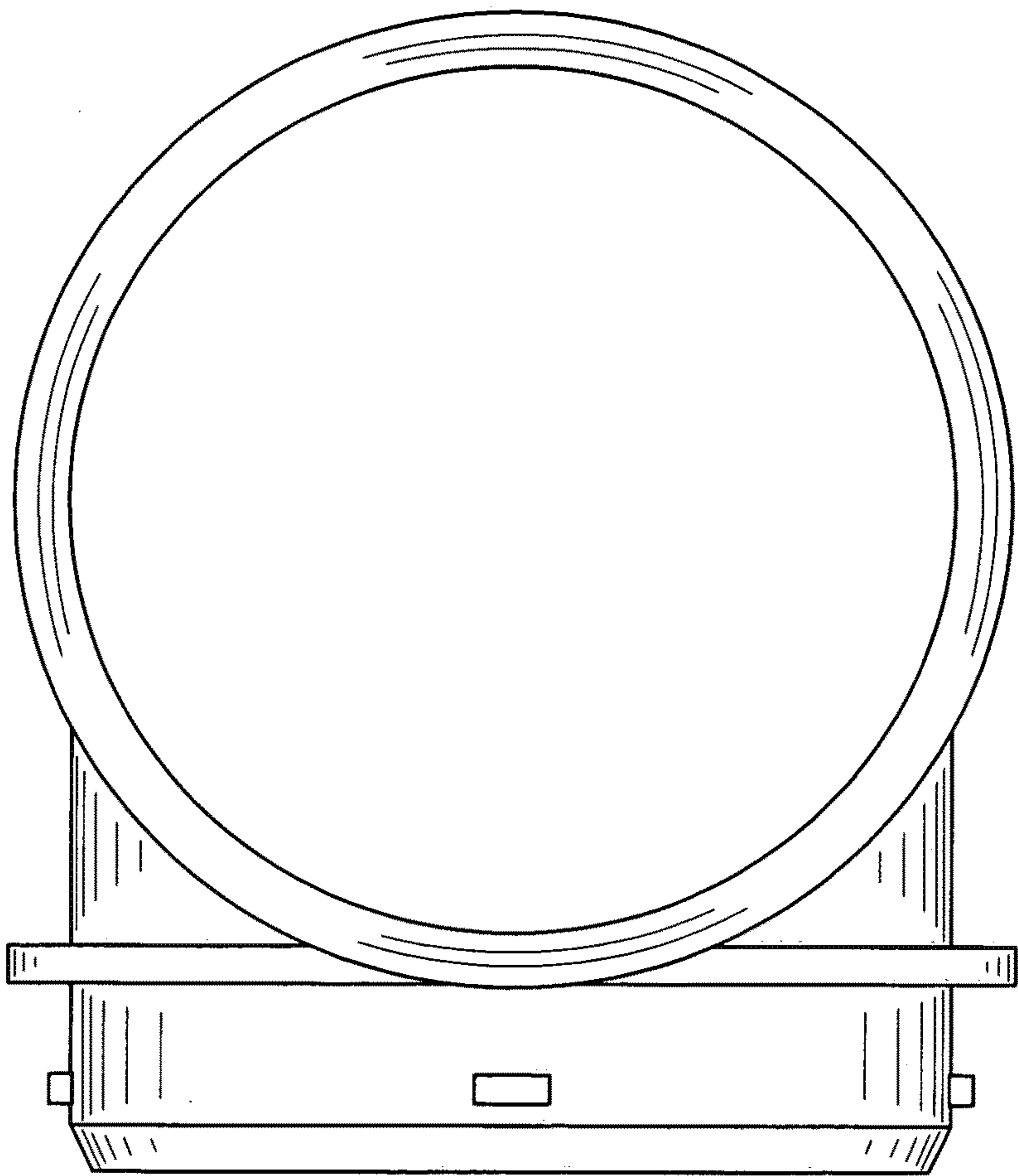

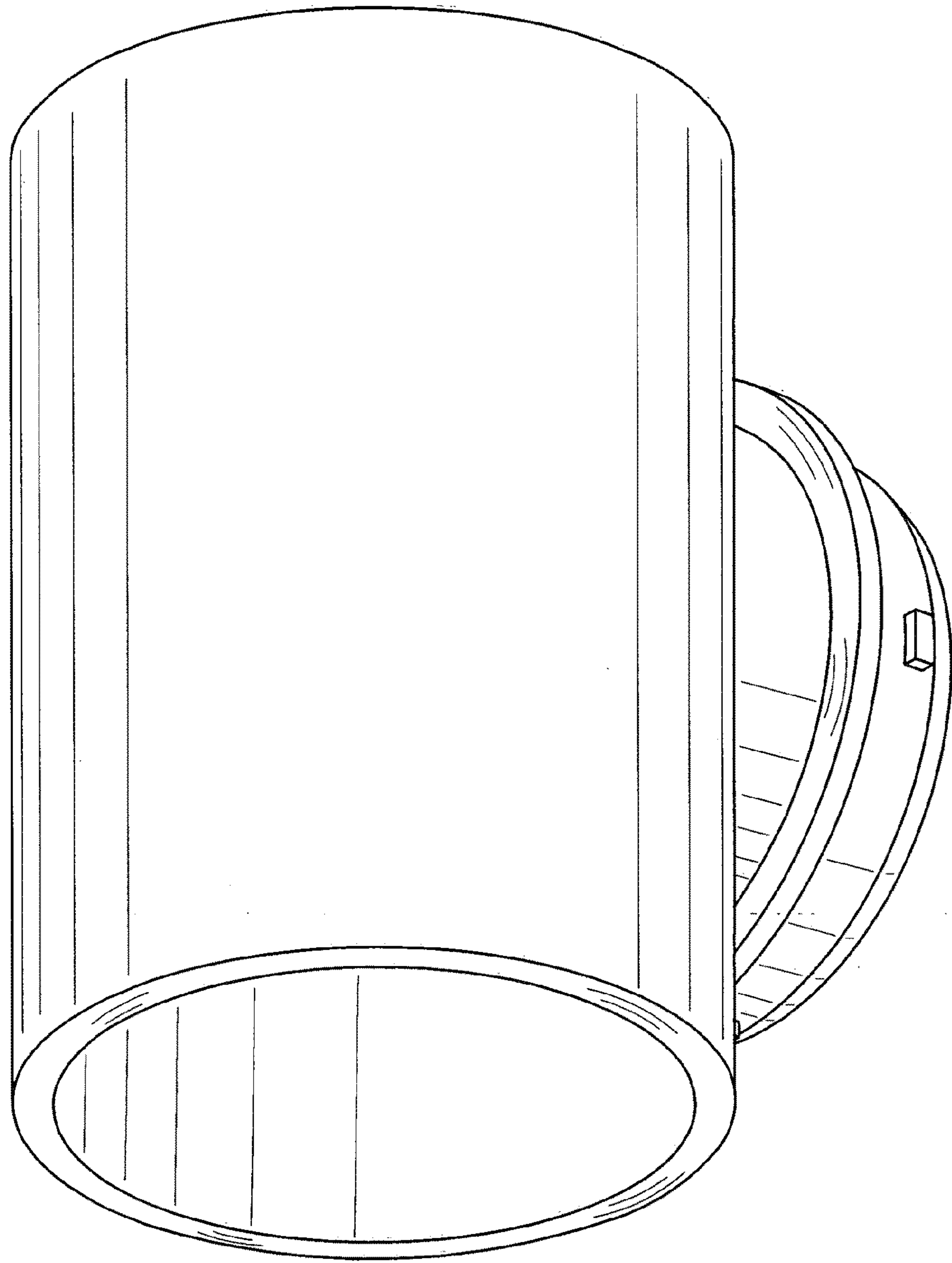
