image of this view;

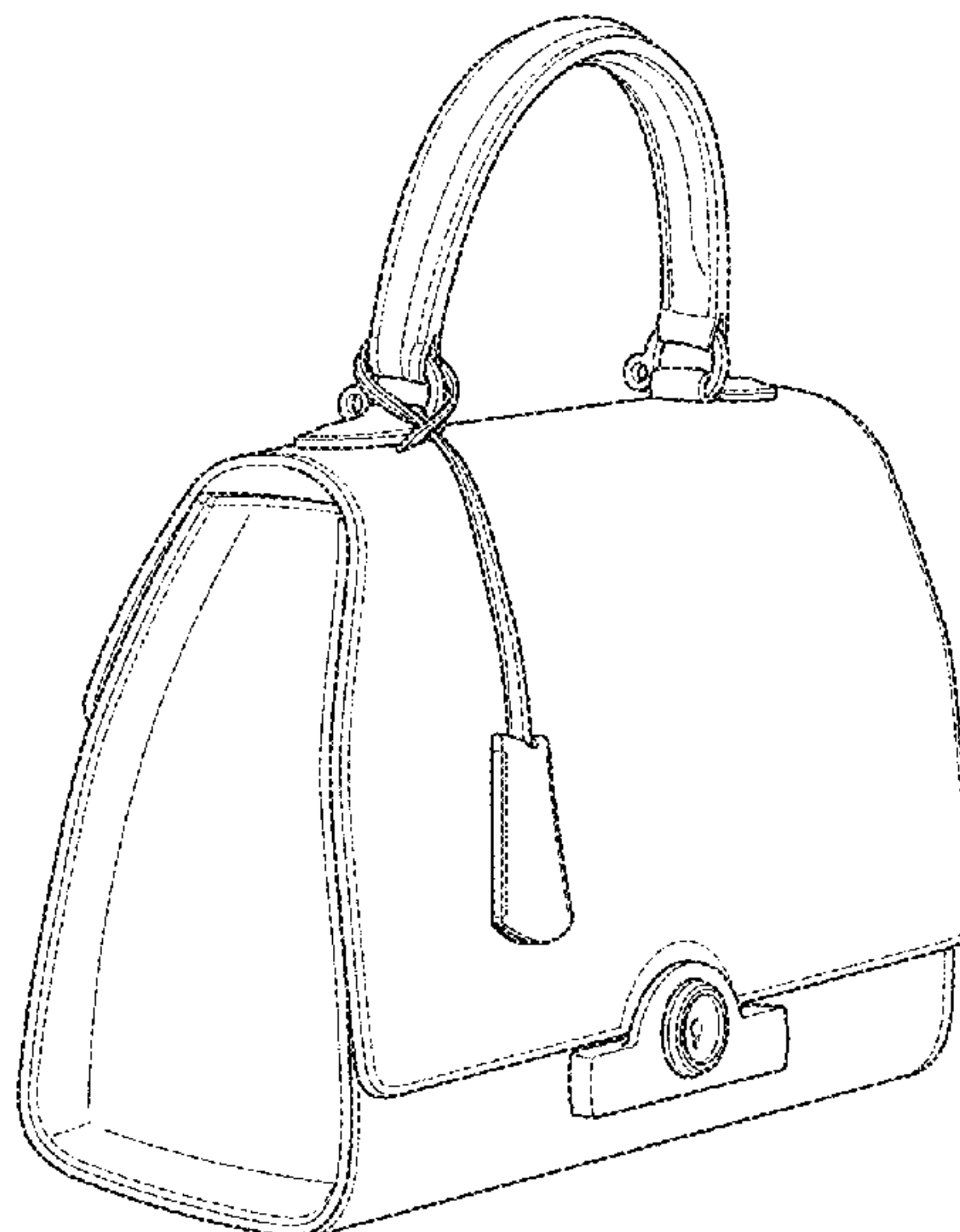
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof, where the strap is not shown

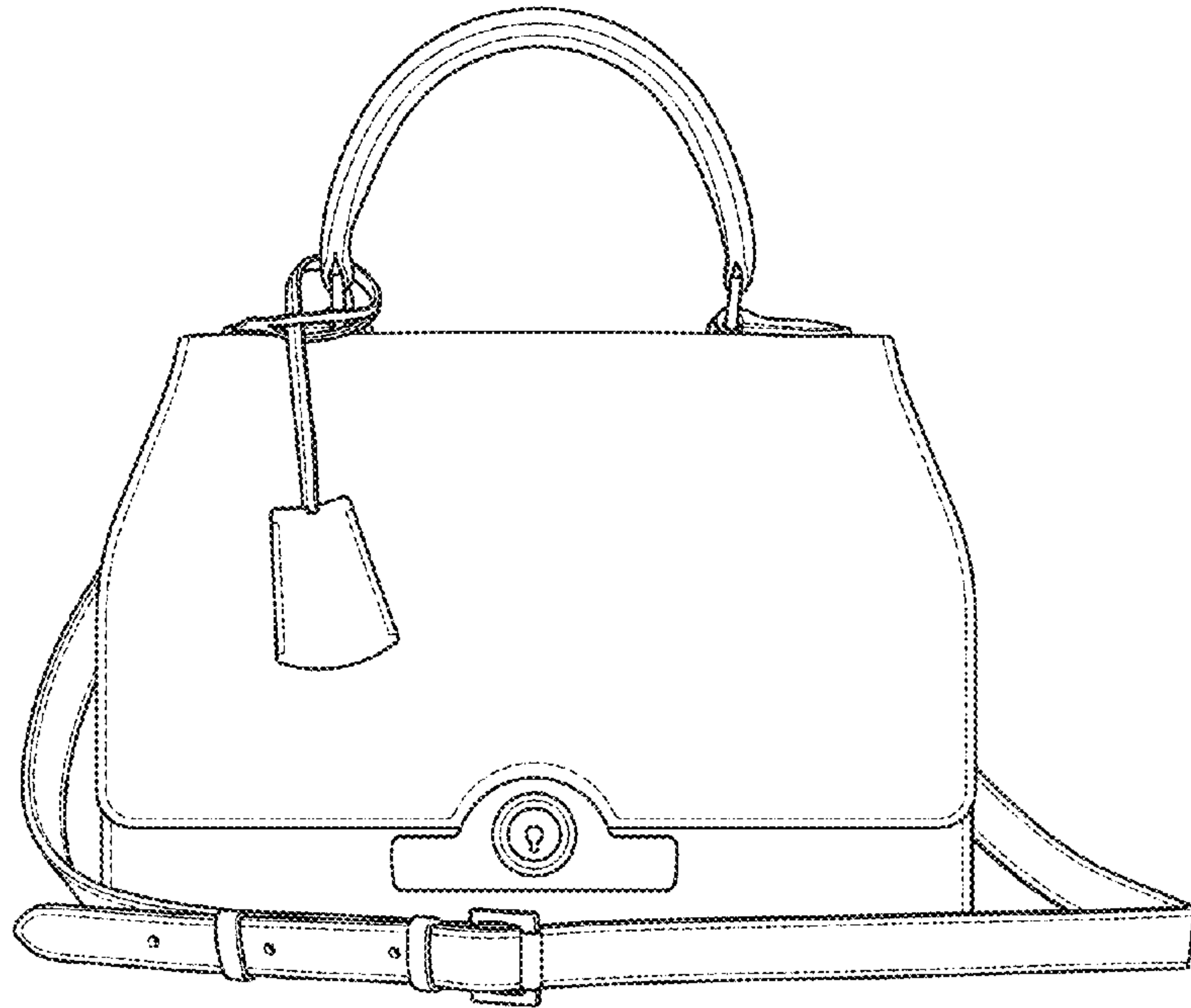

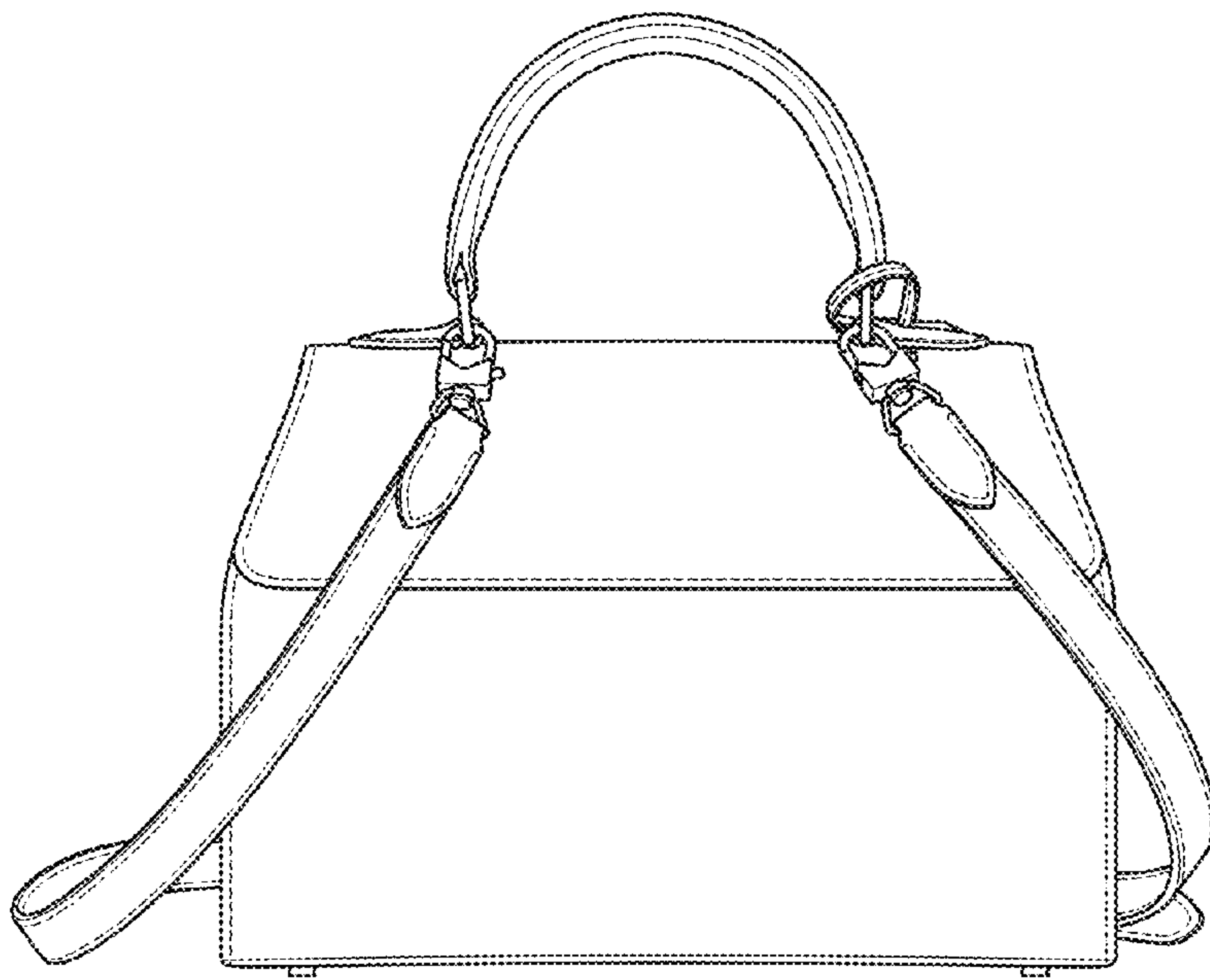

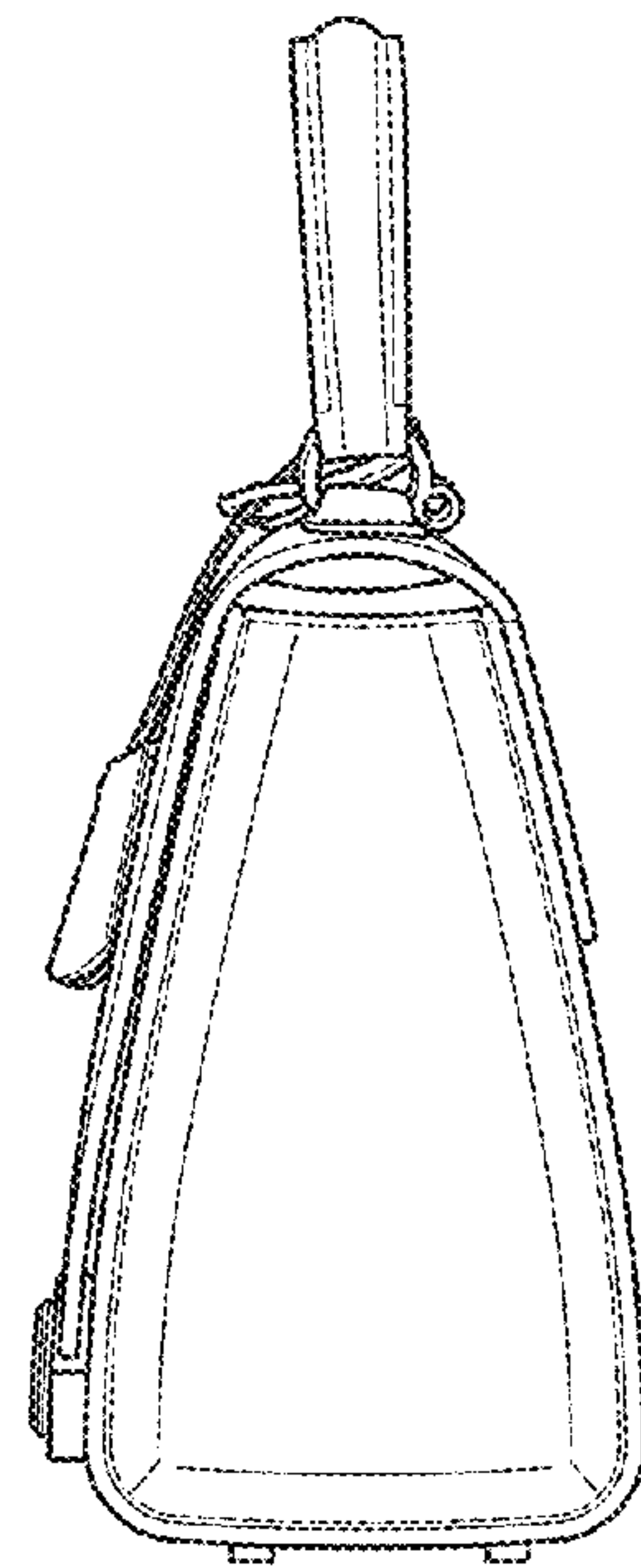

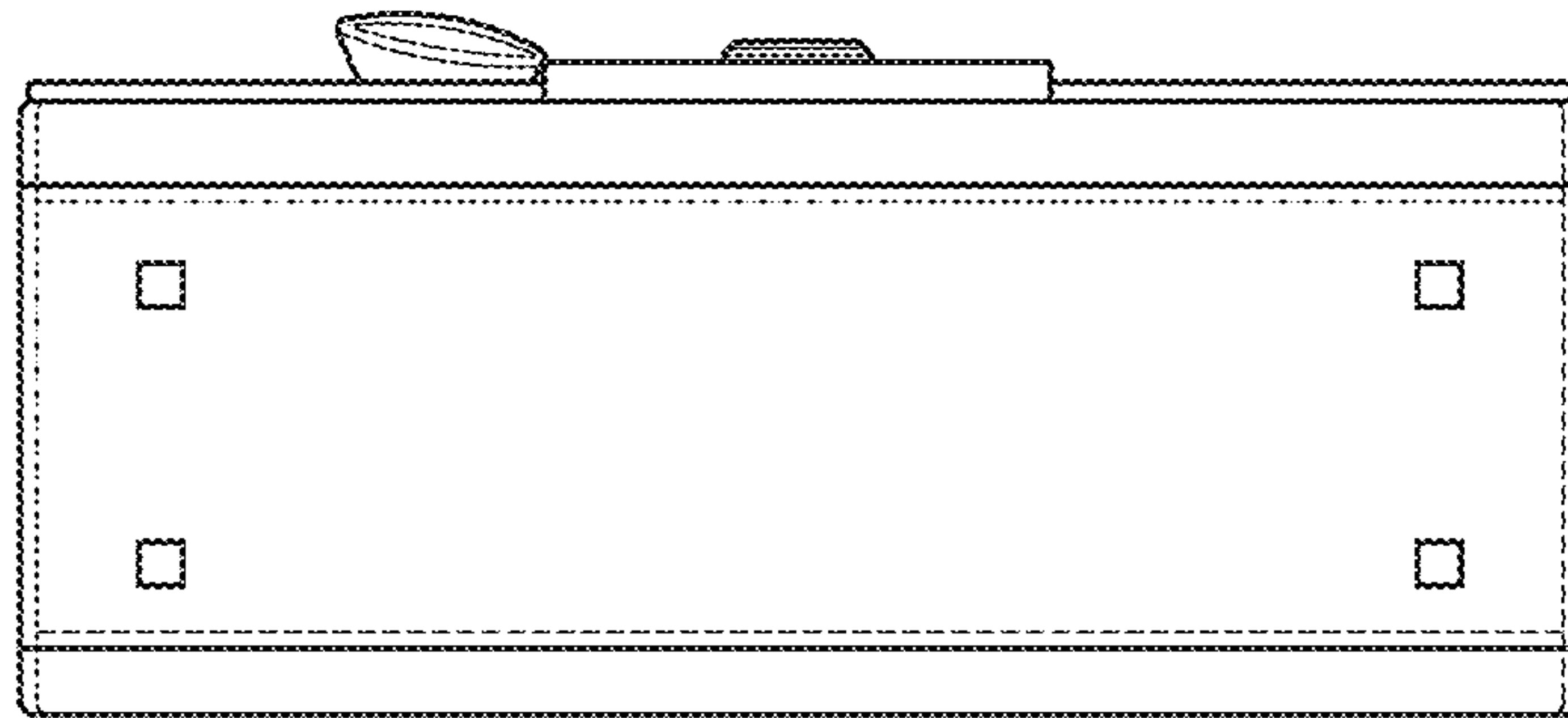

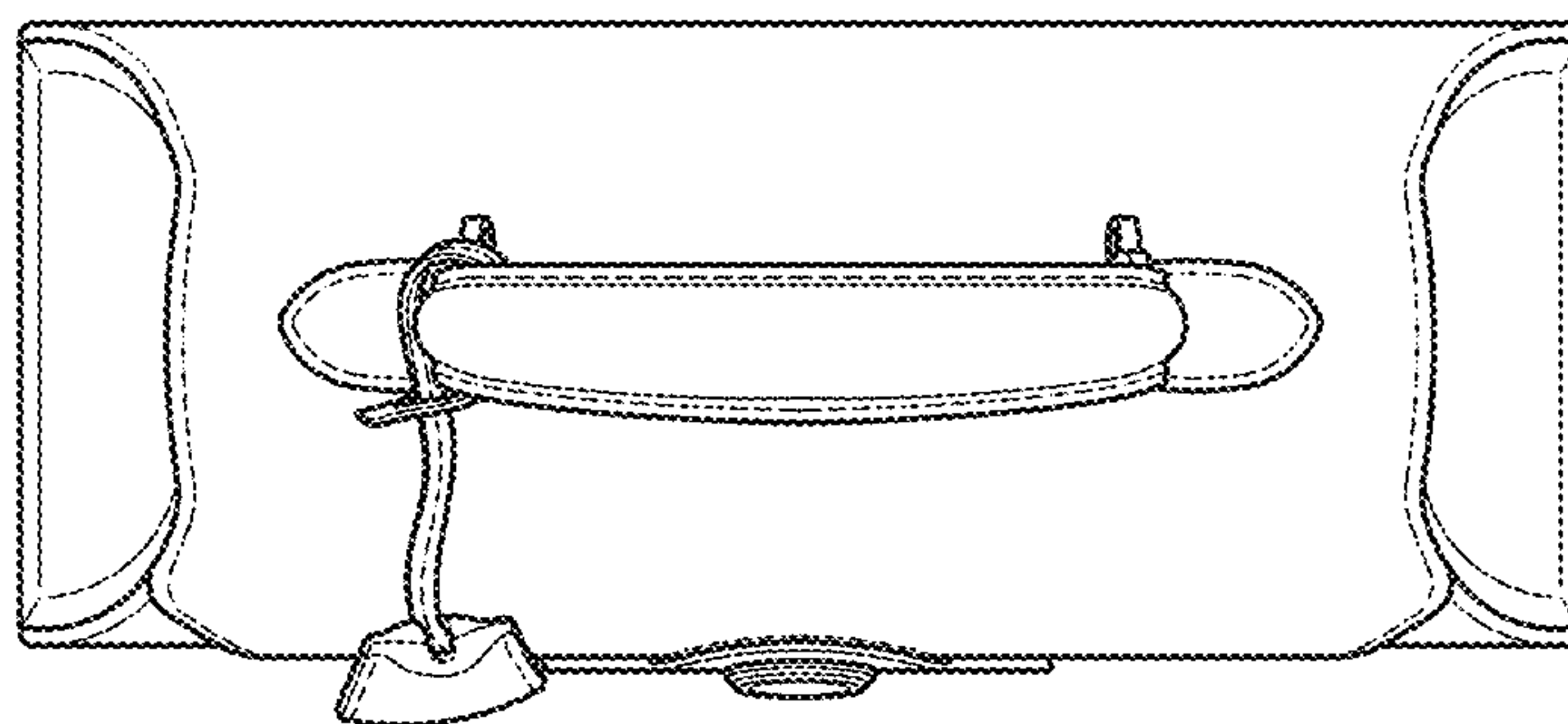
