(57) **CLAIM**

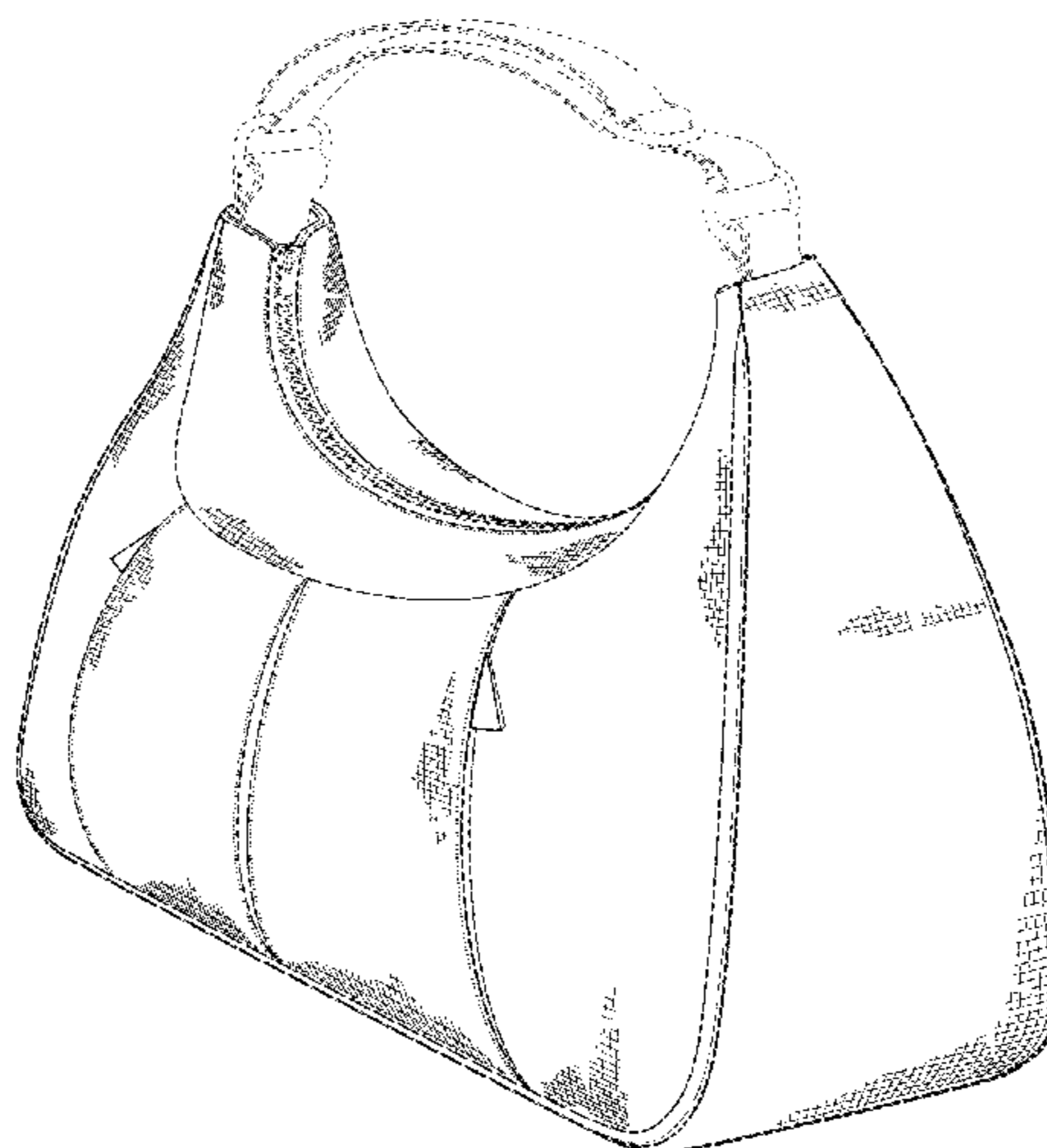
The ornamental design for a shoulder bag and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoulder bag in accordance with a first embodiment of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a front view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a left side view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a right side view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a shoulder bag in accordance with a second embodiment of the present invention; FIG. 9 is a front view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8; FIG. 10 is a left side view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8; FIG. 11 is a rear view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8; FIG. 12 is a right side view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8; FIG. 13 is a top view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8; and, FIG. 14 is a bottom view of the shoulder bag illustrated in FIG. 8.

The broken lines showing a handbag are for the purposes of illustrating environment and form no part of the claimed design. The smaller spaced broken lines represent stitching and are part of the claimed design. The cross-hatched lines represent textured material.

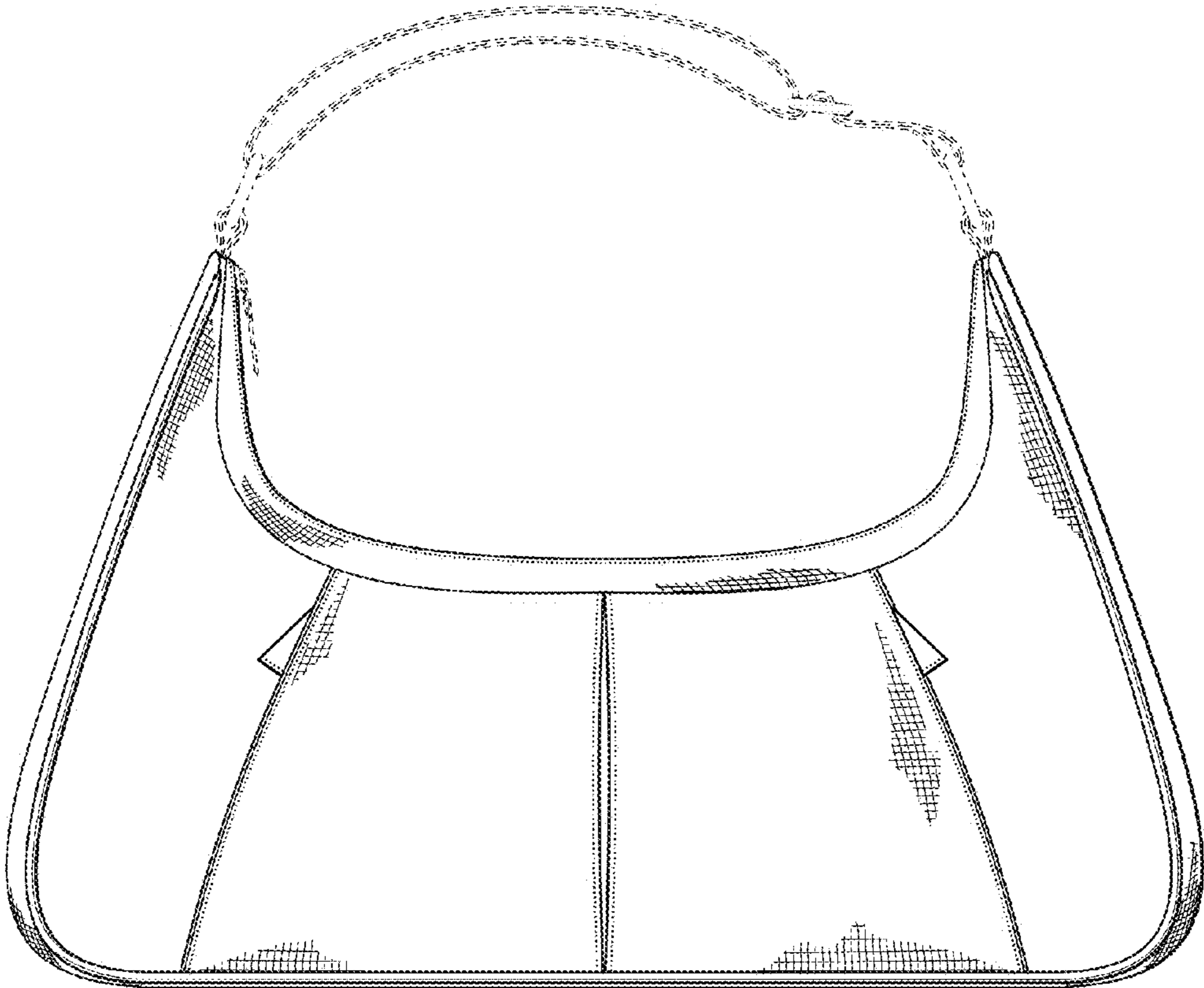

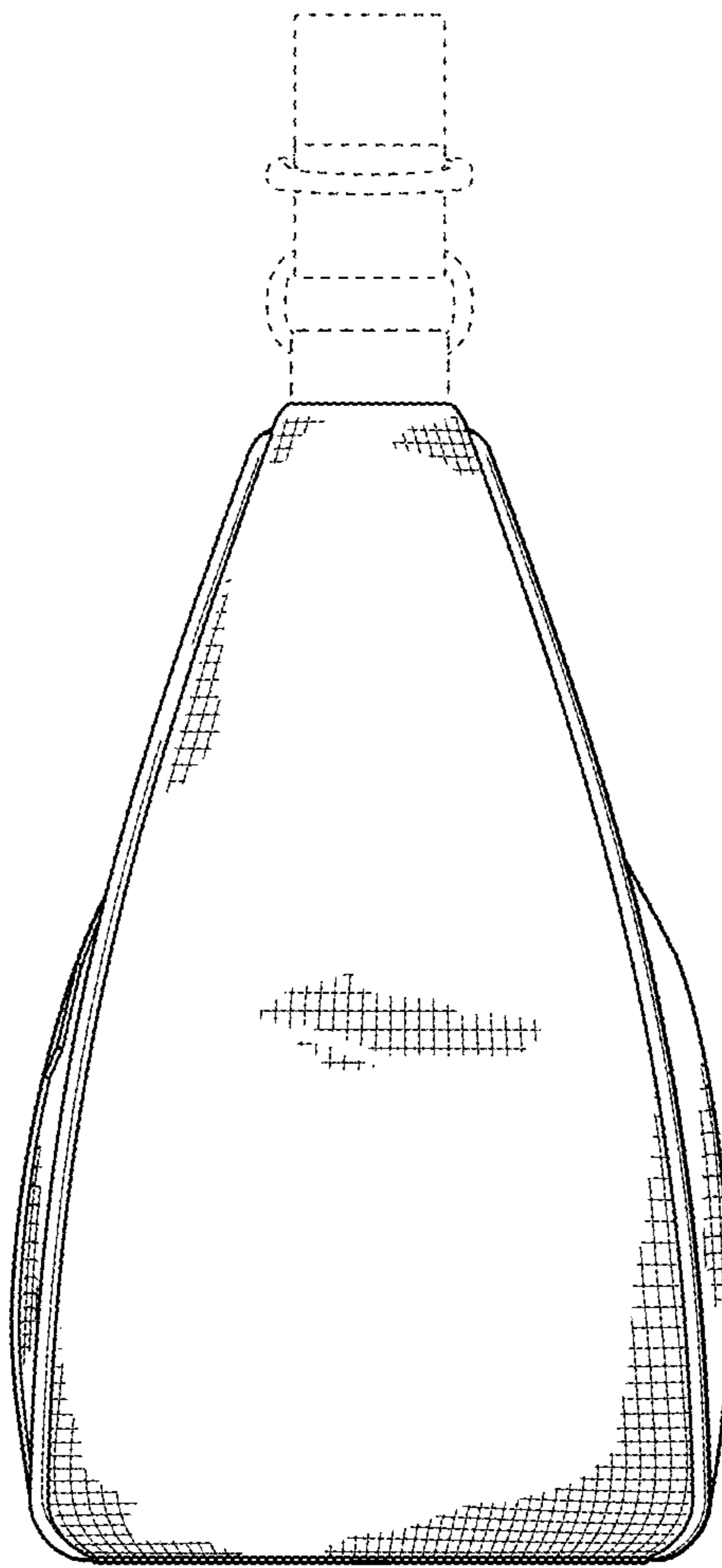

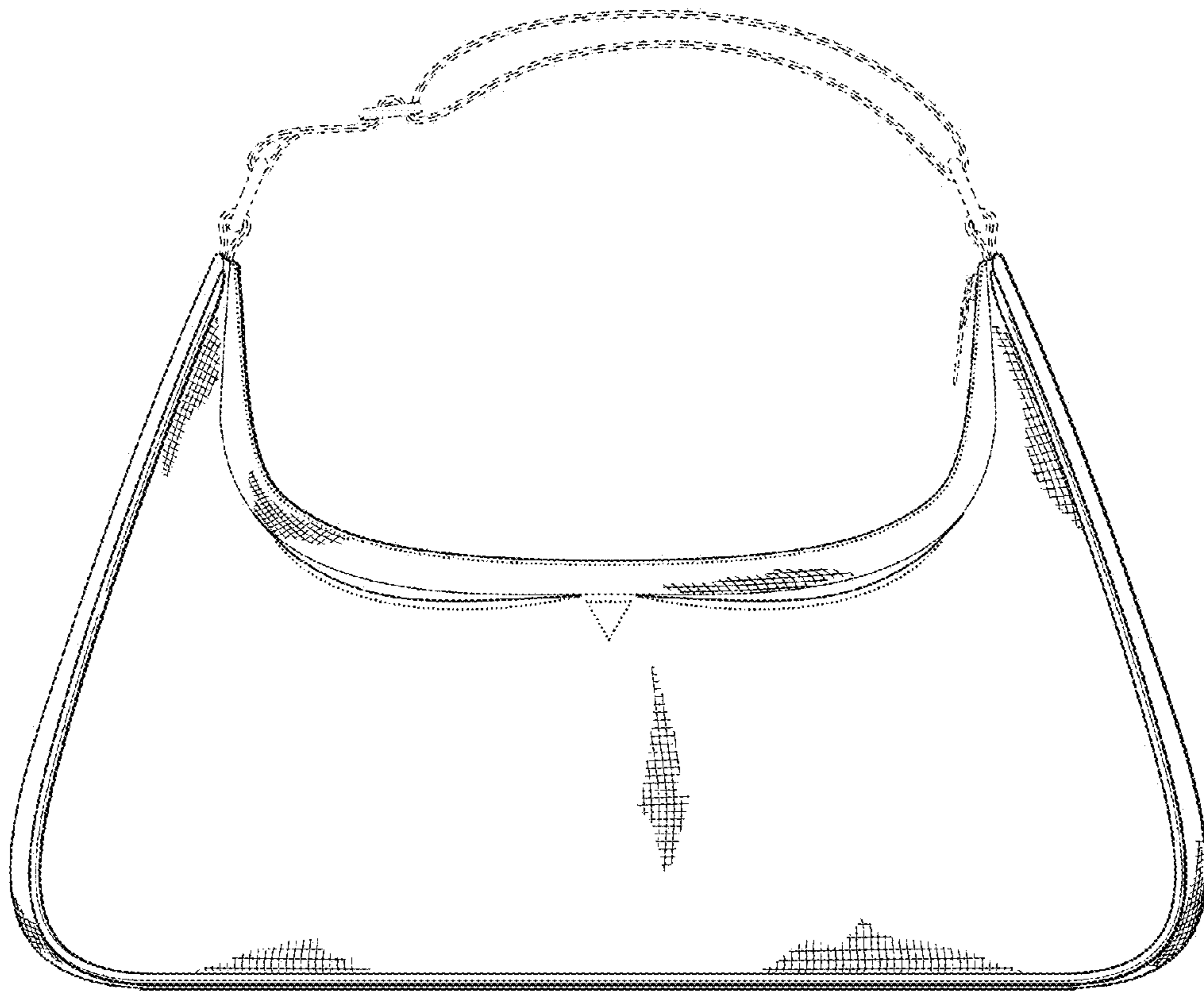

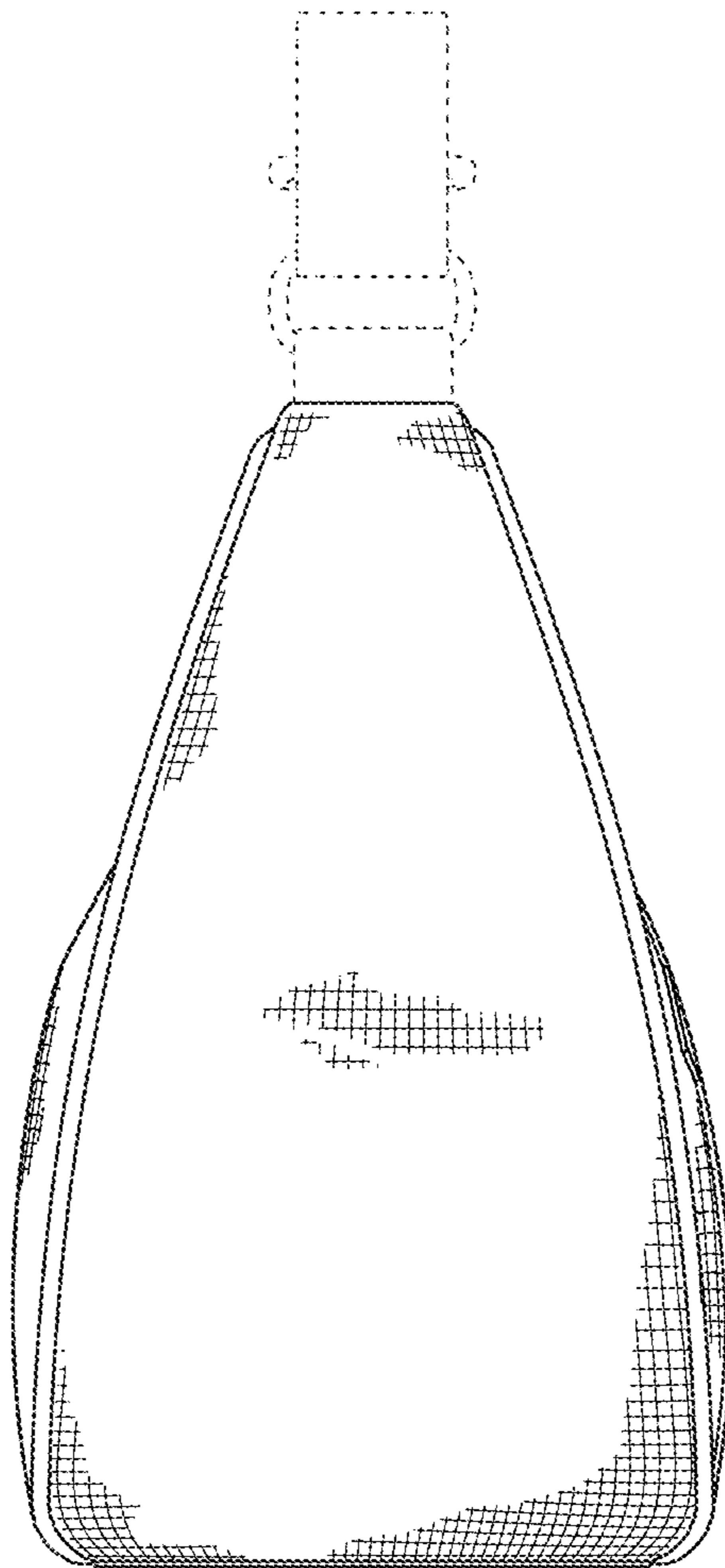

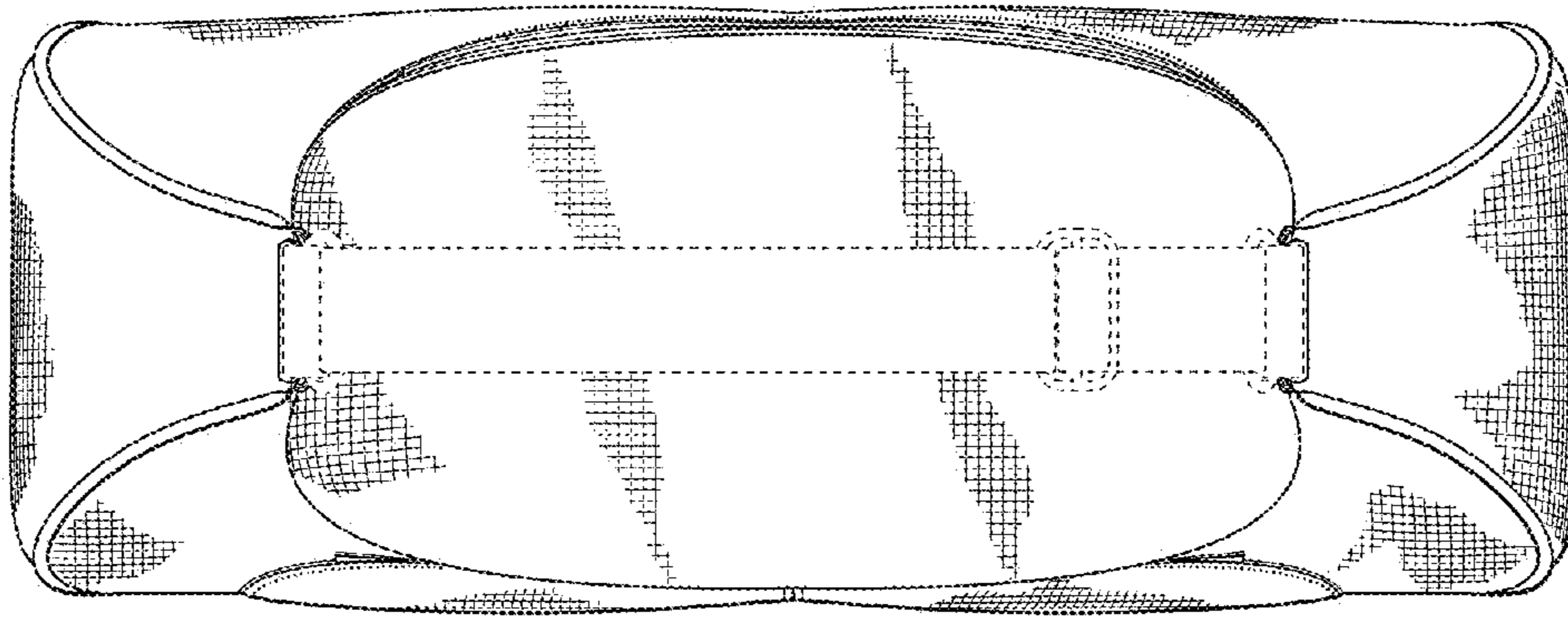

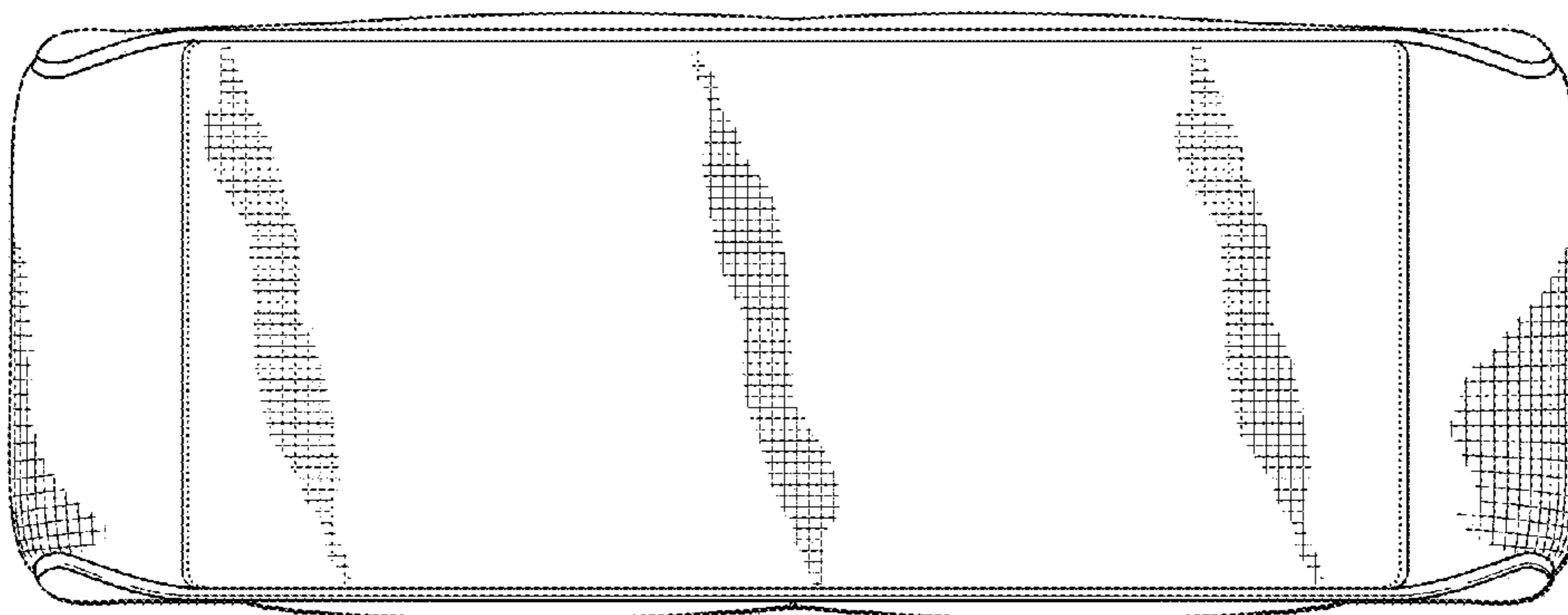

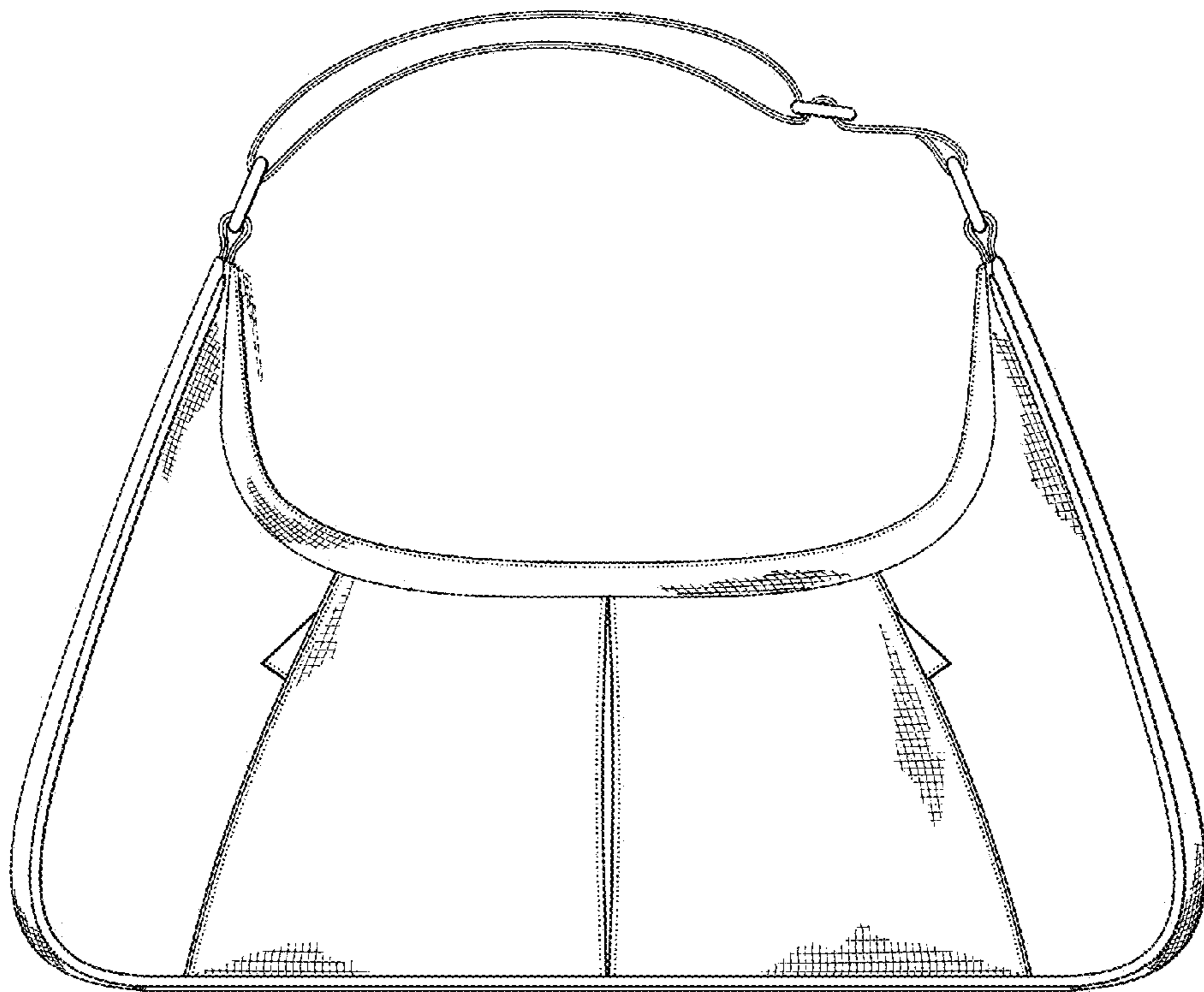

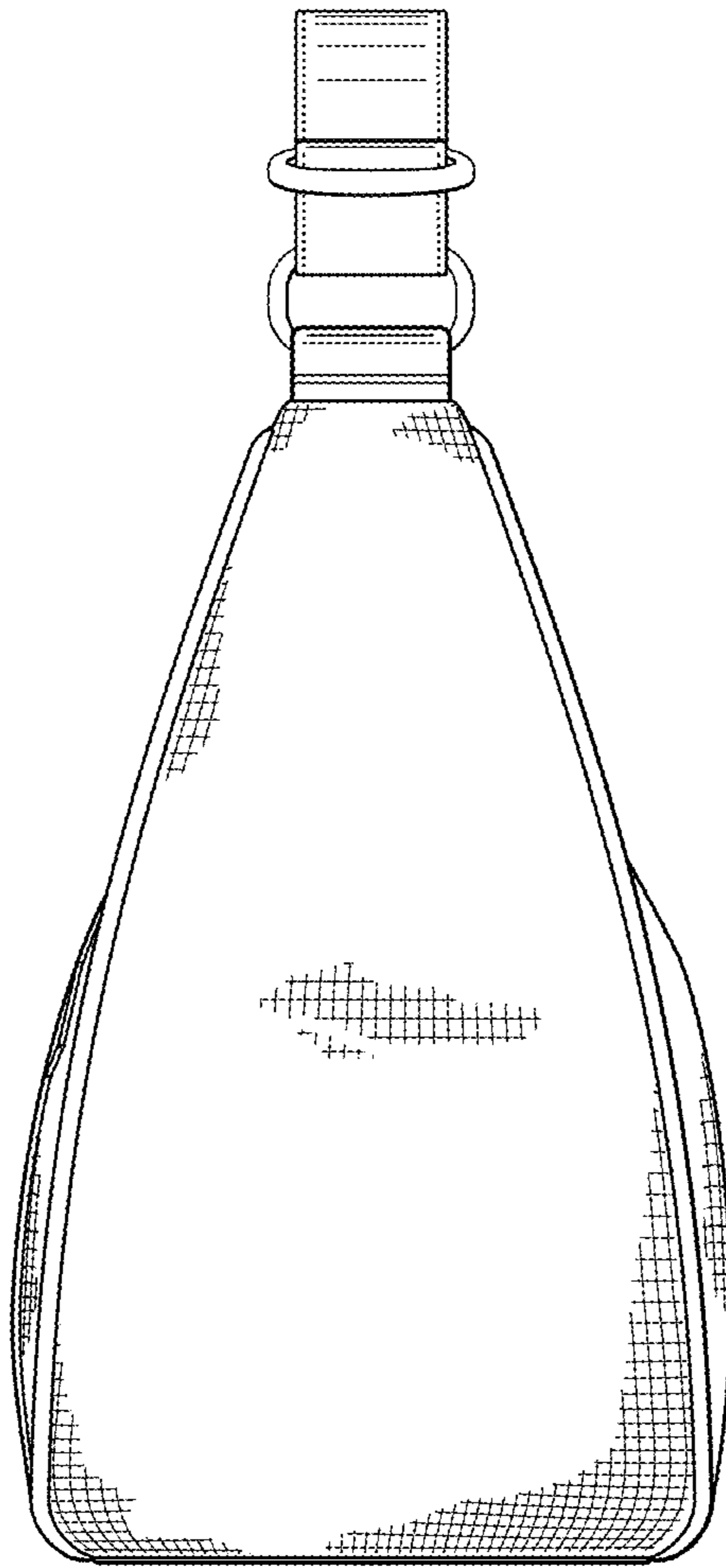

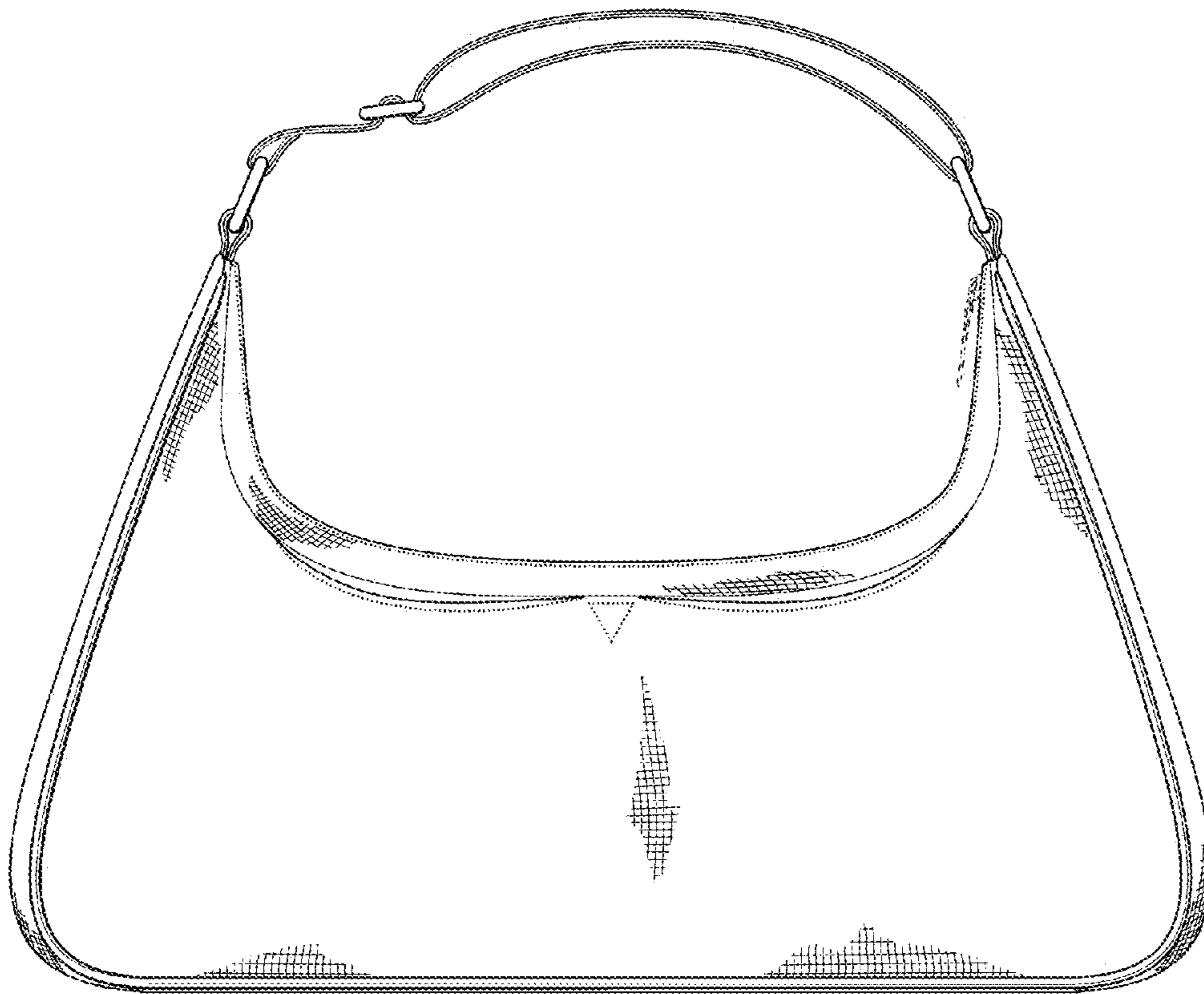

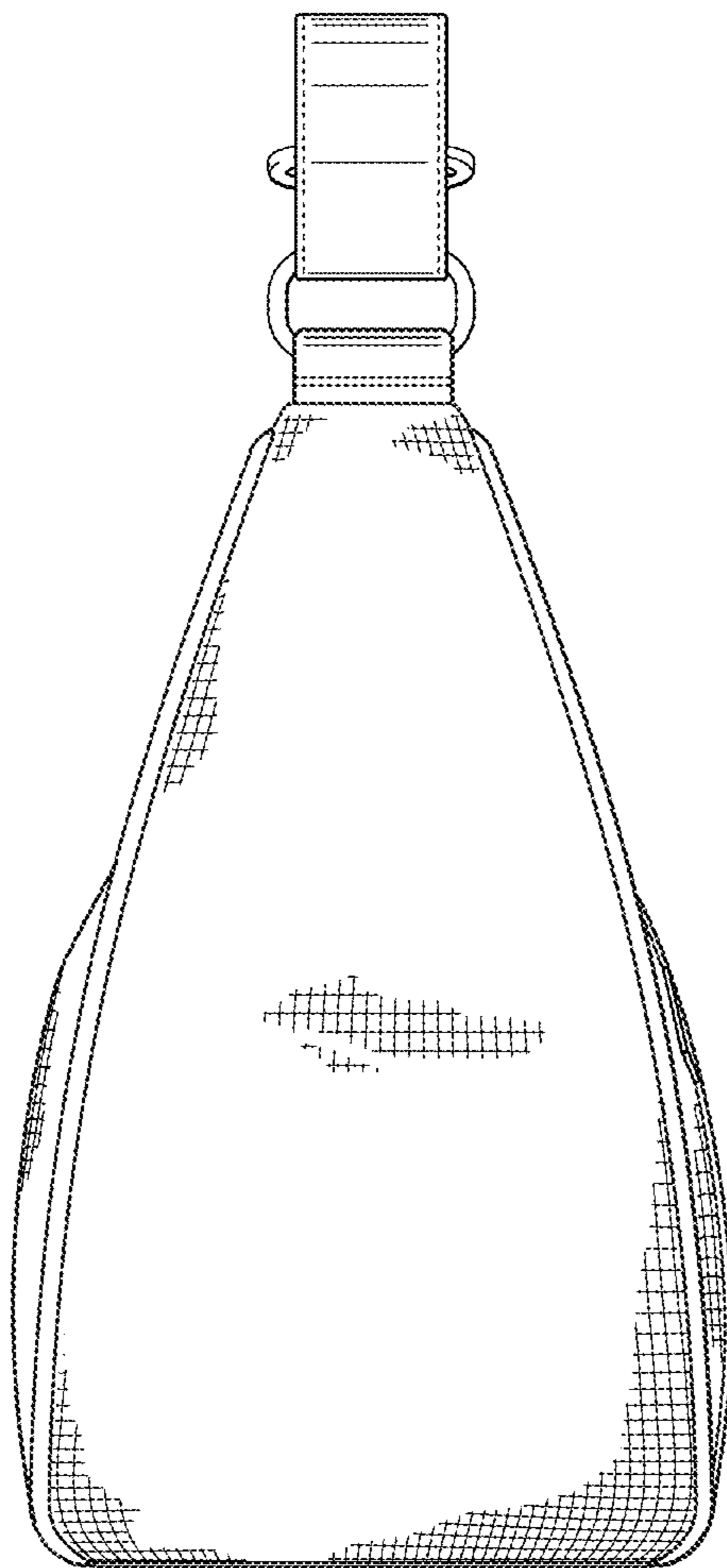

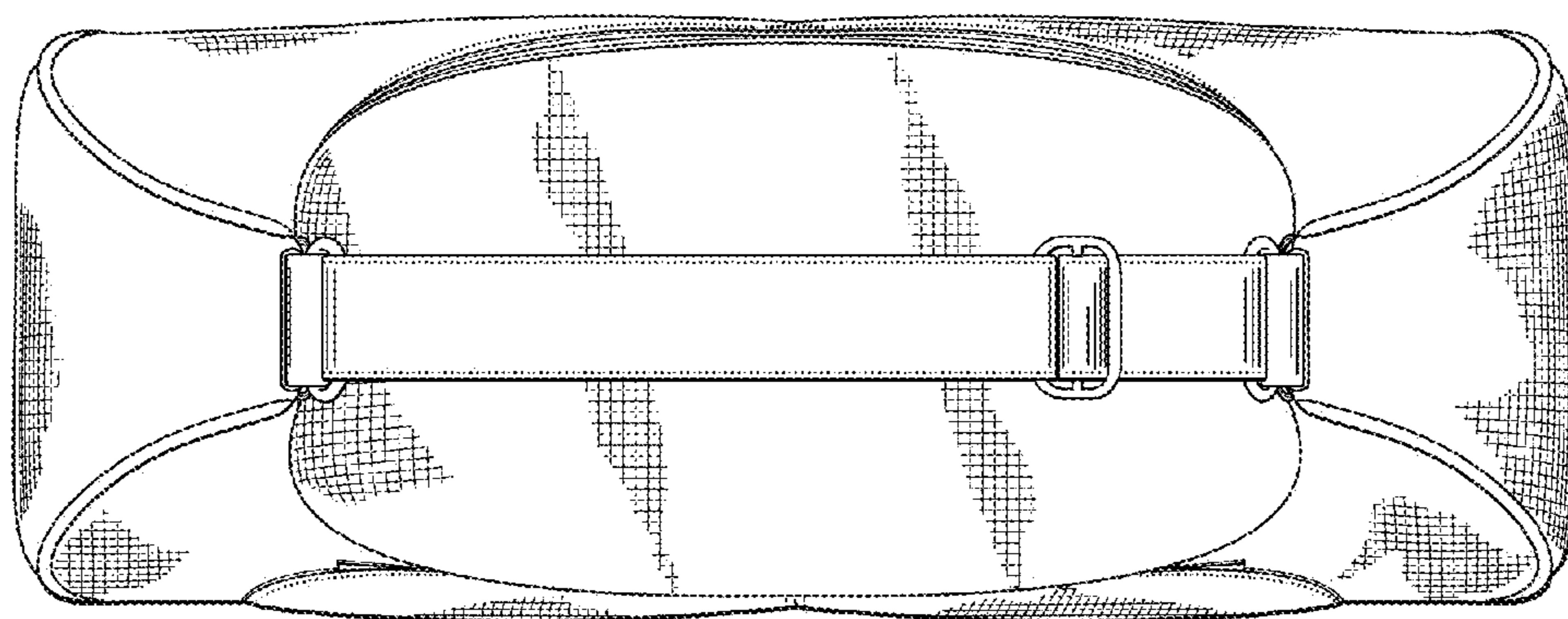
