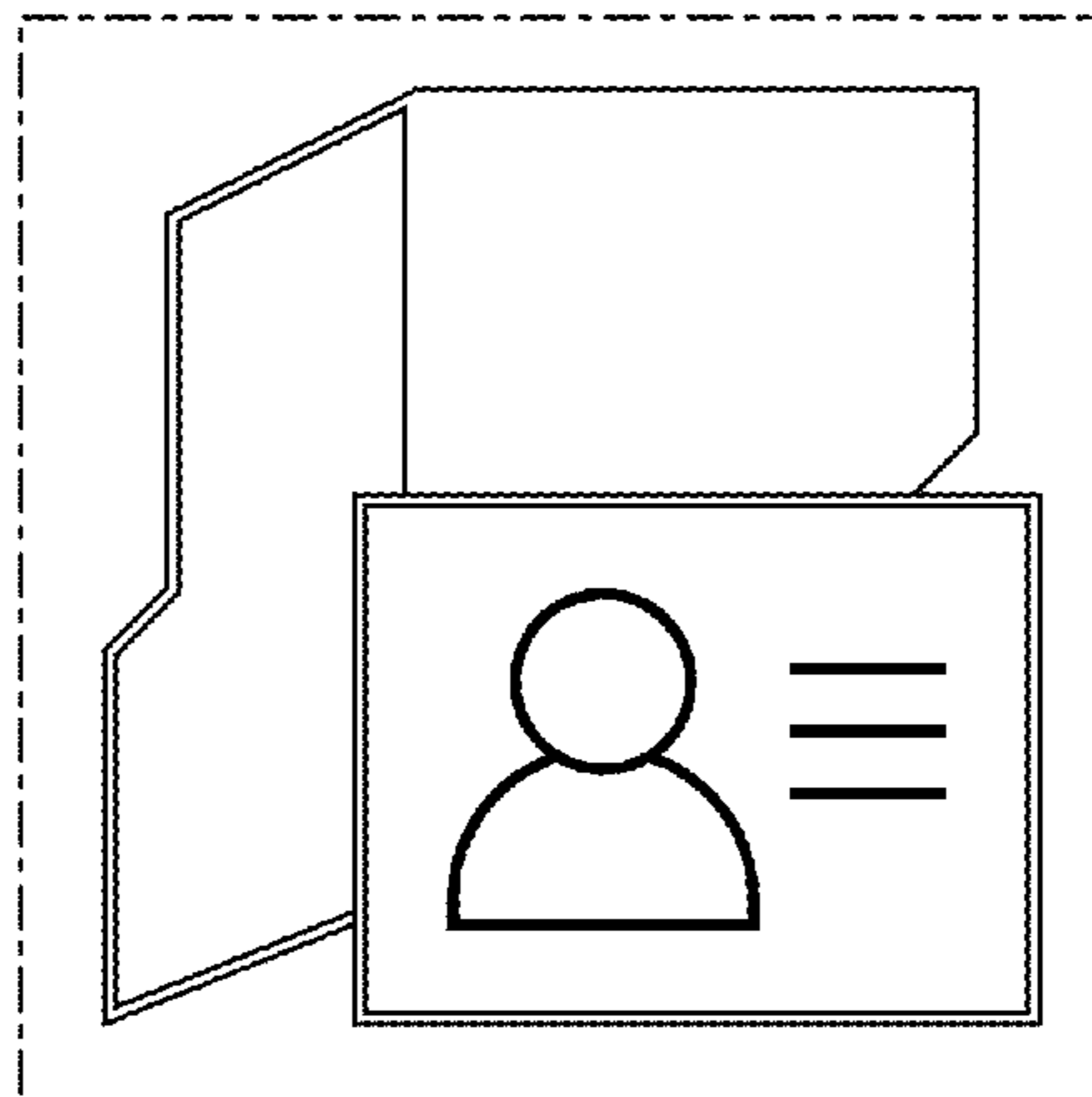

FIG. 1 is a front view of a display screen with icon showing the icon enlarged and separate for clarity; and, FIG. 2 is a front view of a display screen with icon showing the new design.

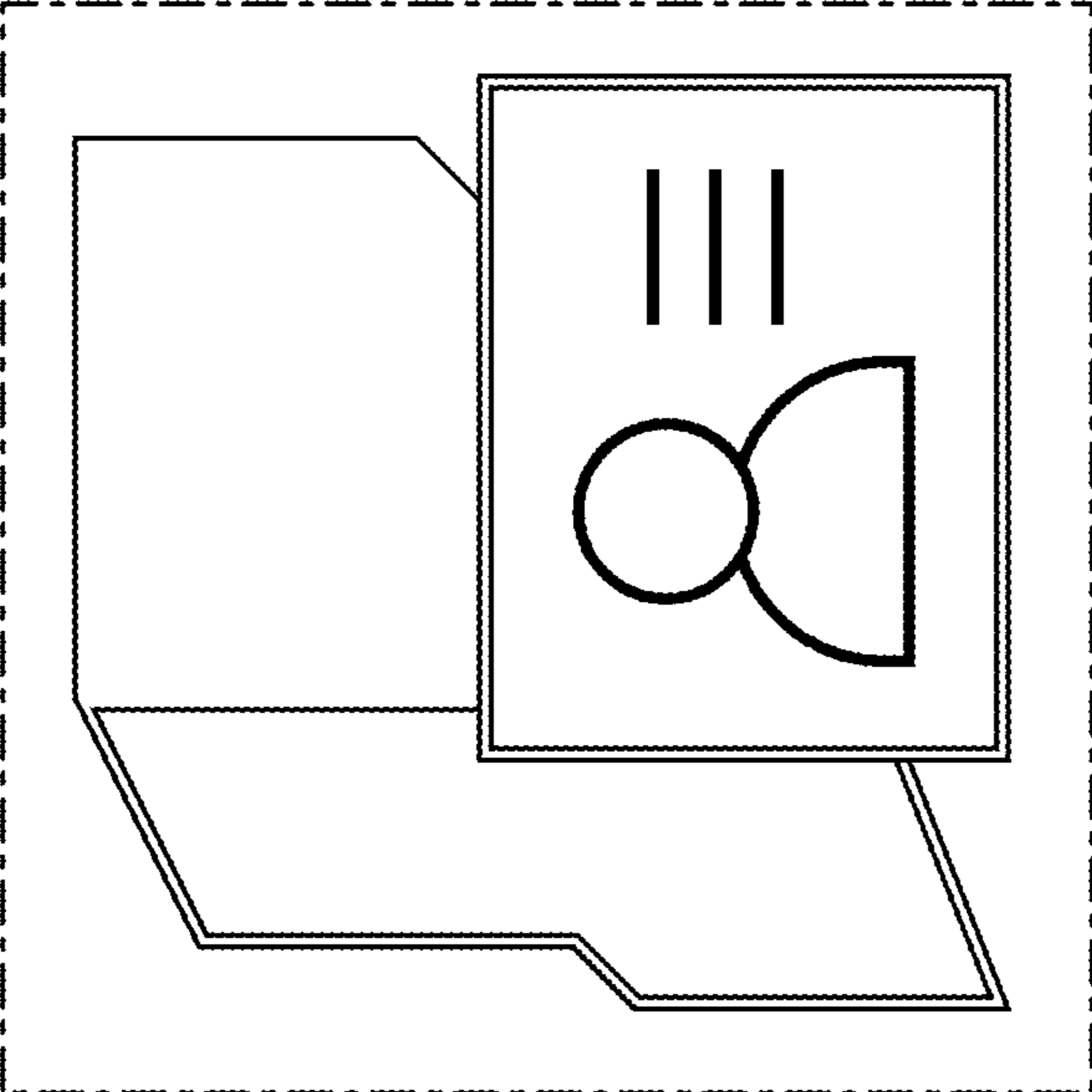

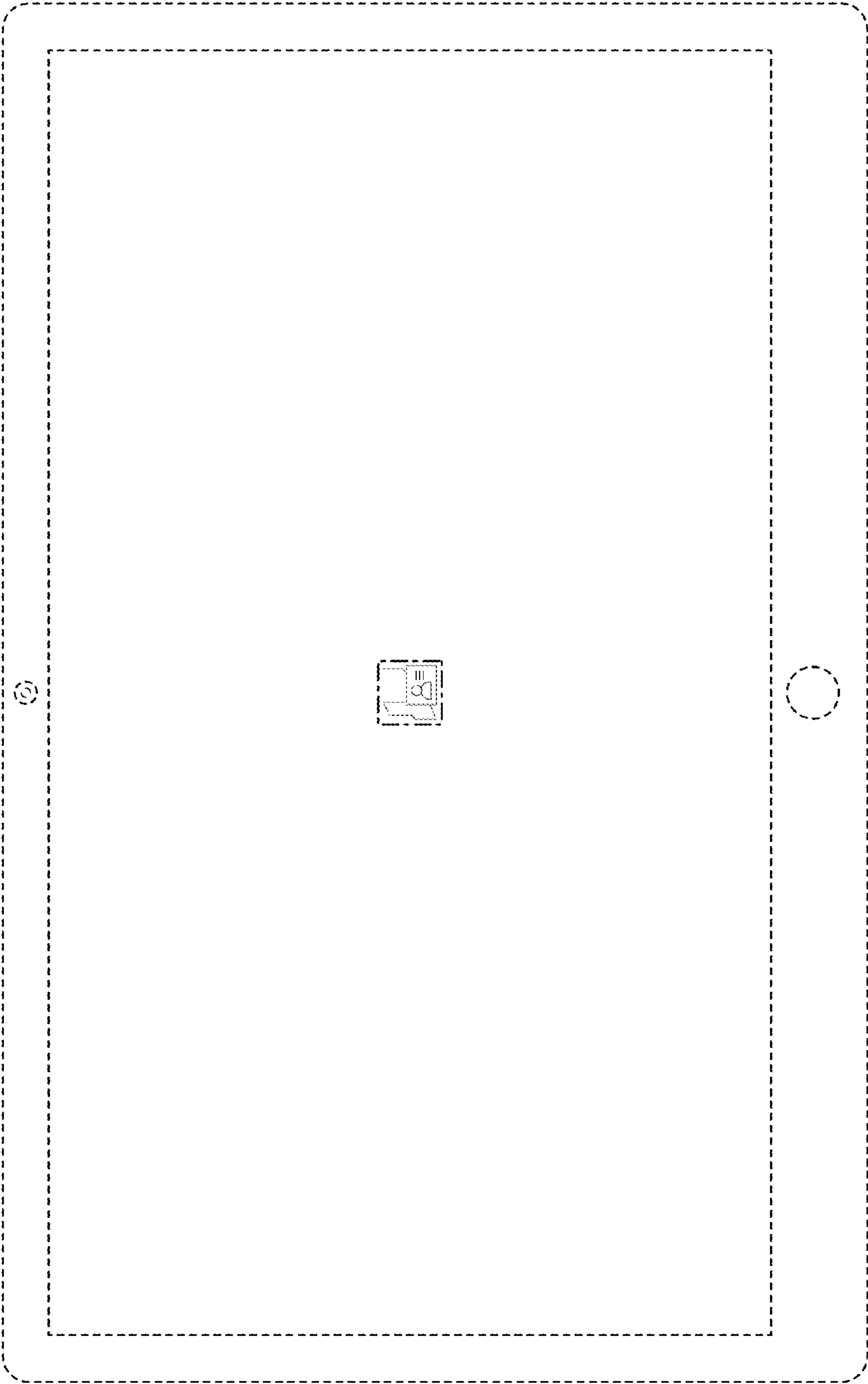
