DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right perspective view of a lock latch system showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front and right perspective view thereof, shown without a latch;
FIG. 3 is a top, front and right perspective view of a latch, shown separately for clarity of illustration;
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of FIG. 3;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2; and,
FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of FIG. 2.

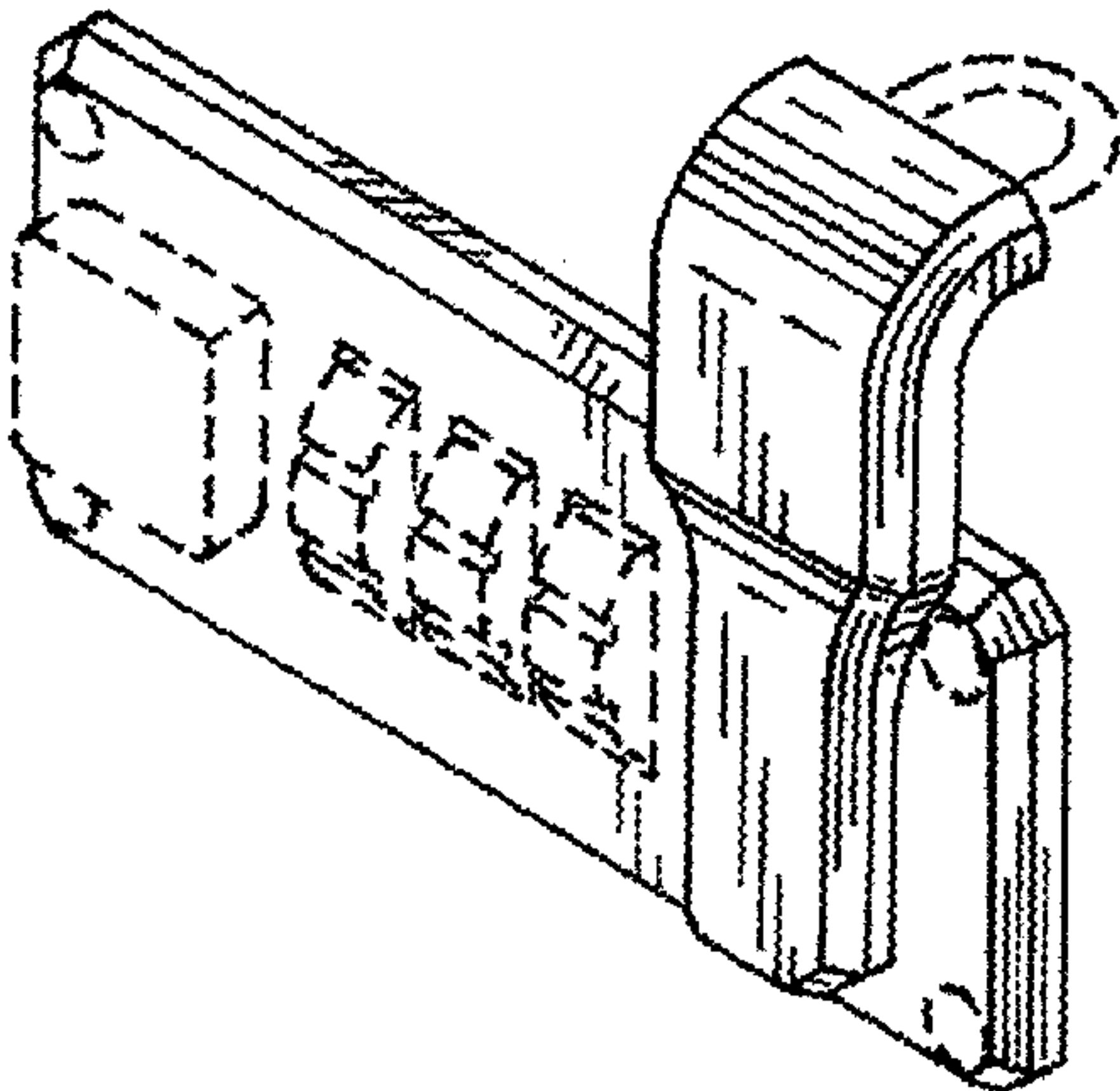

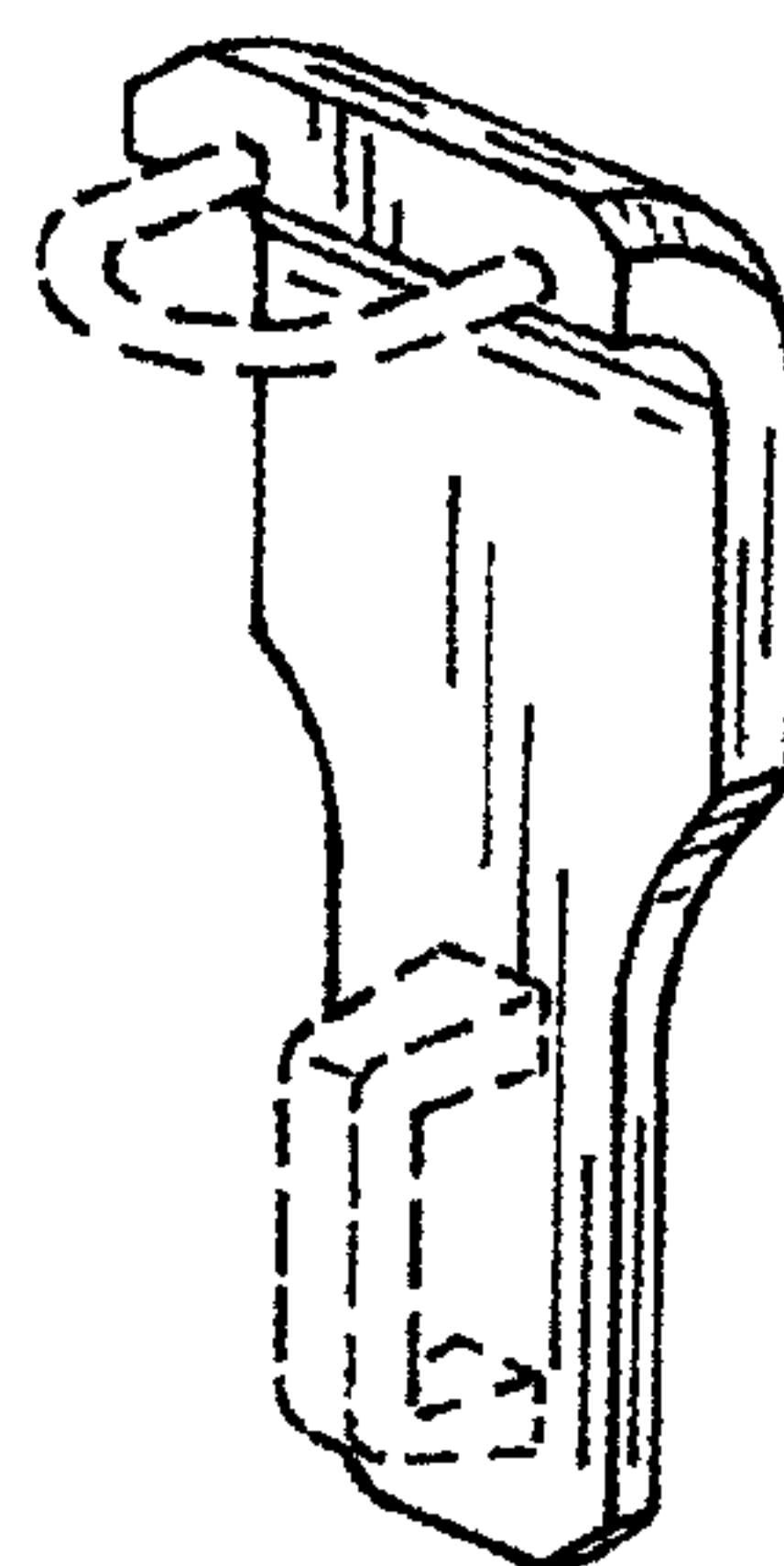
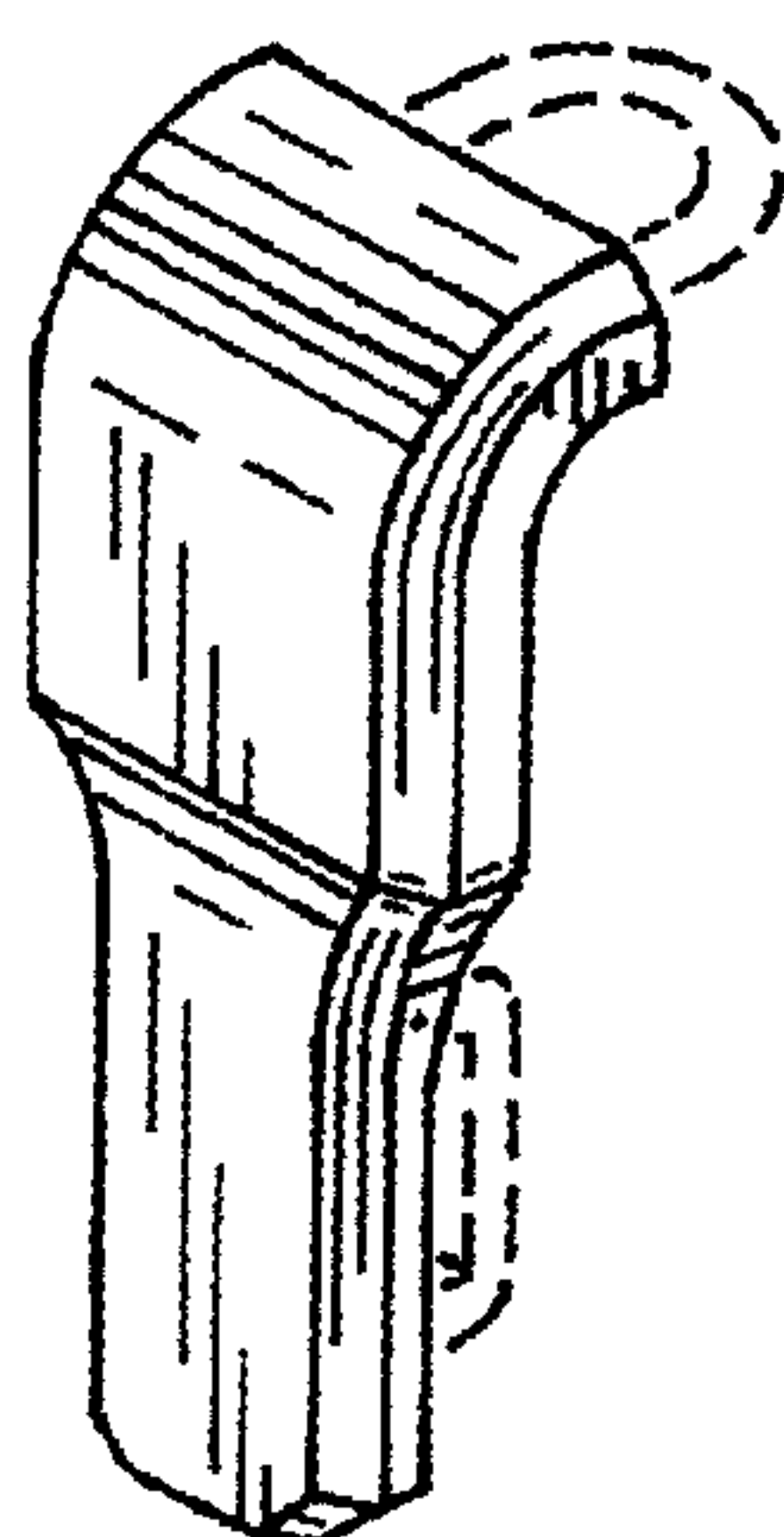
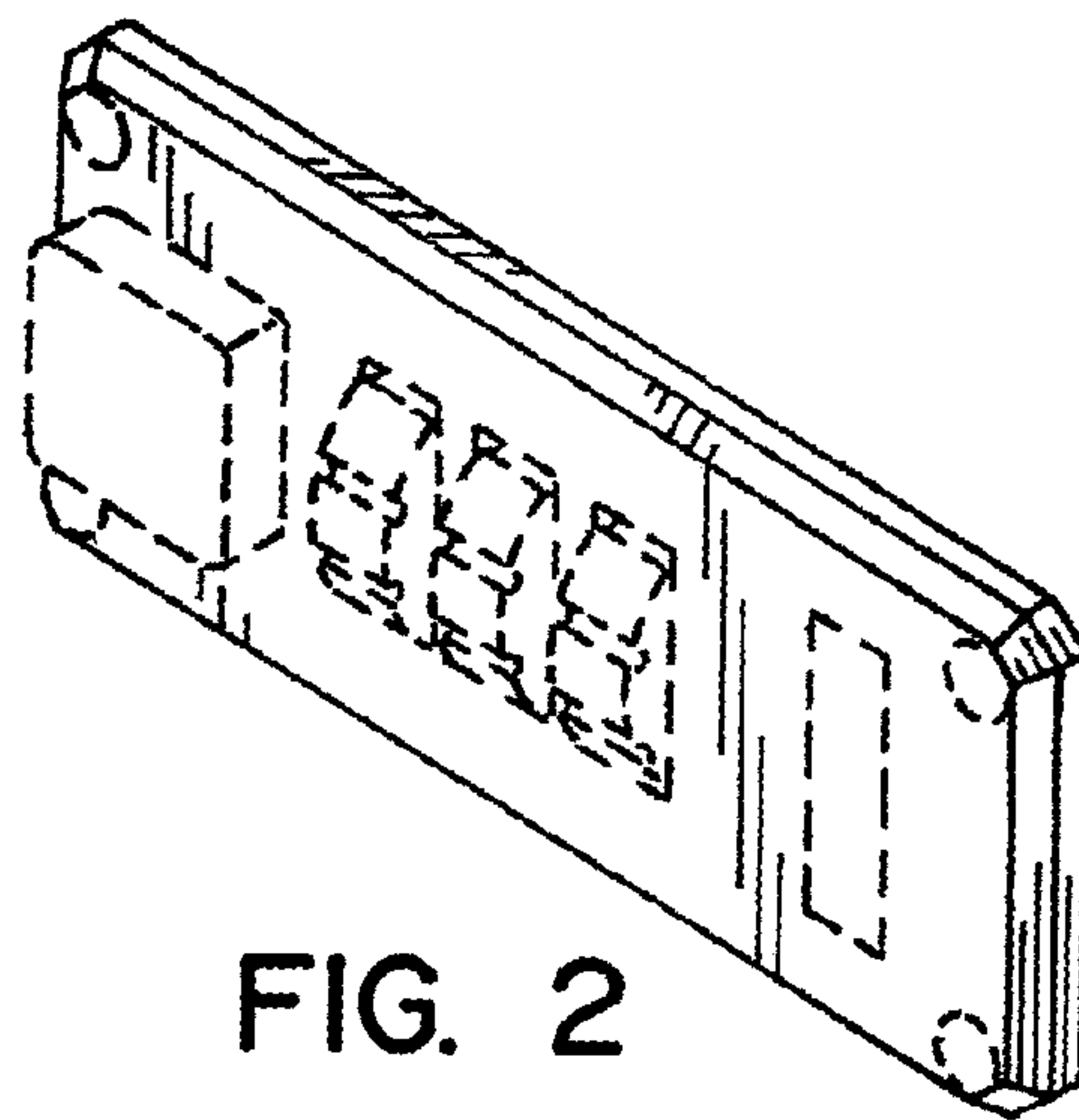
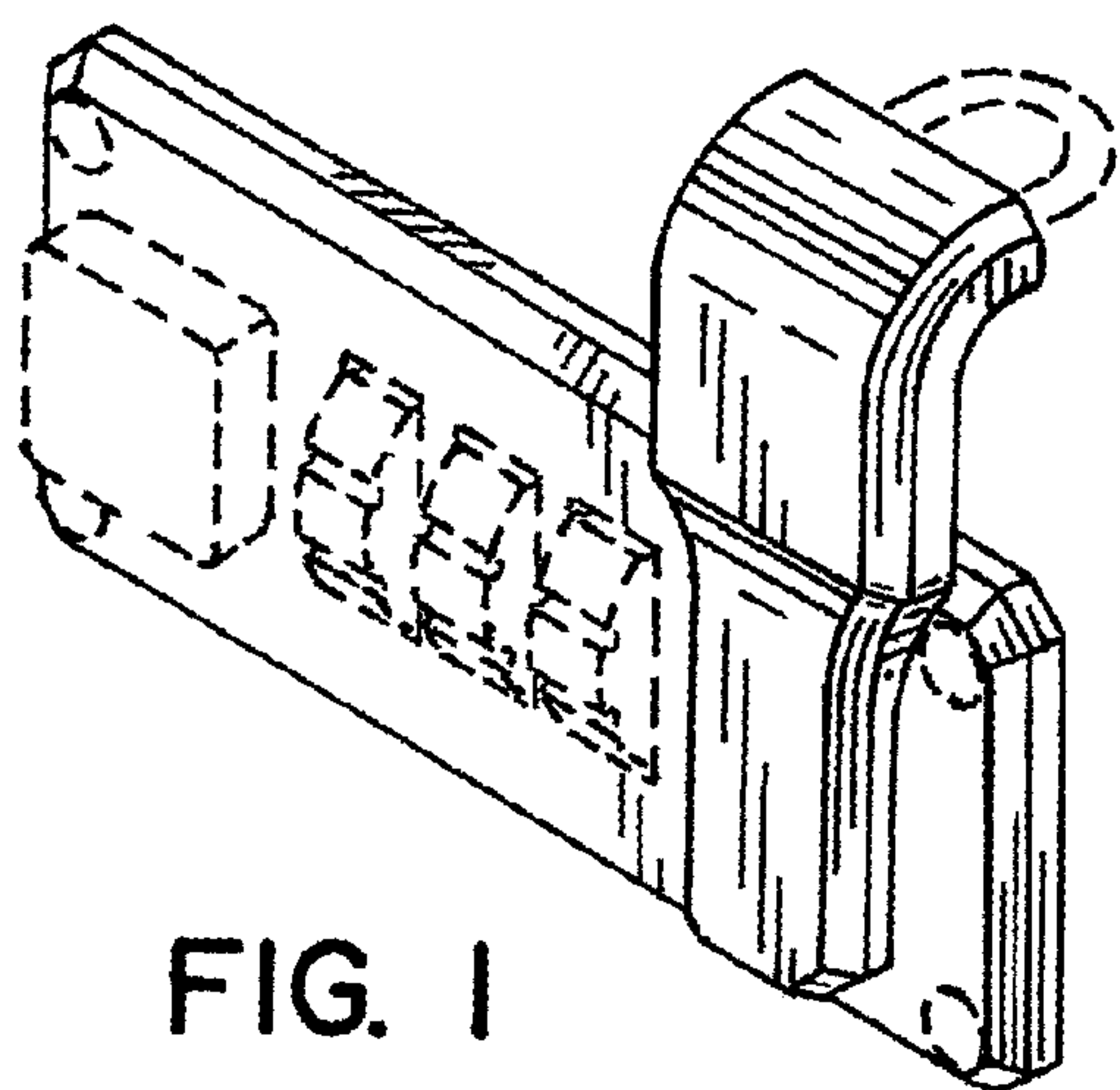
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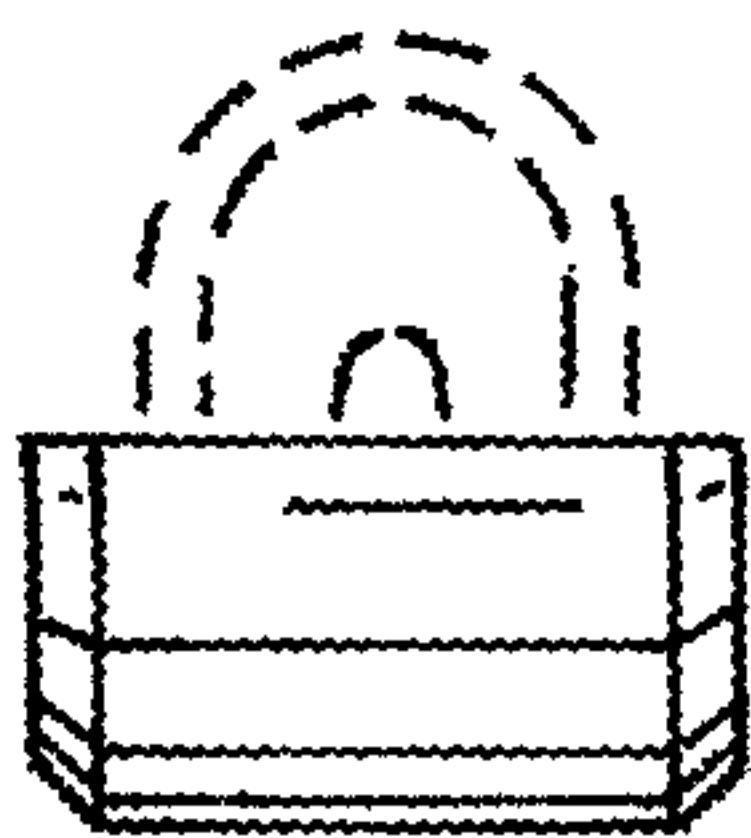

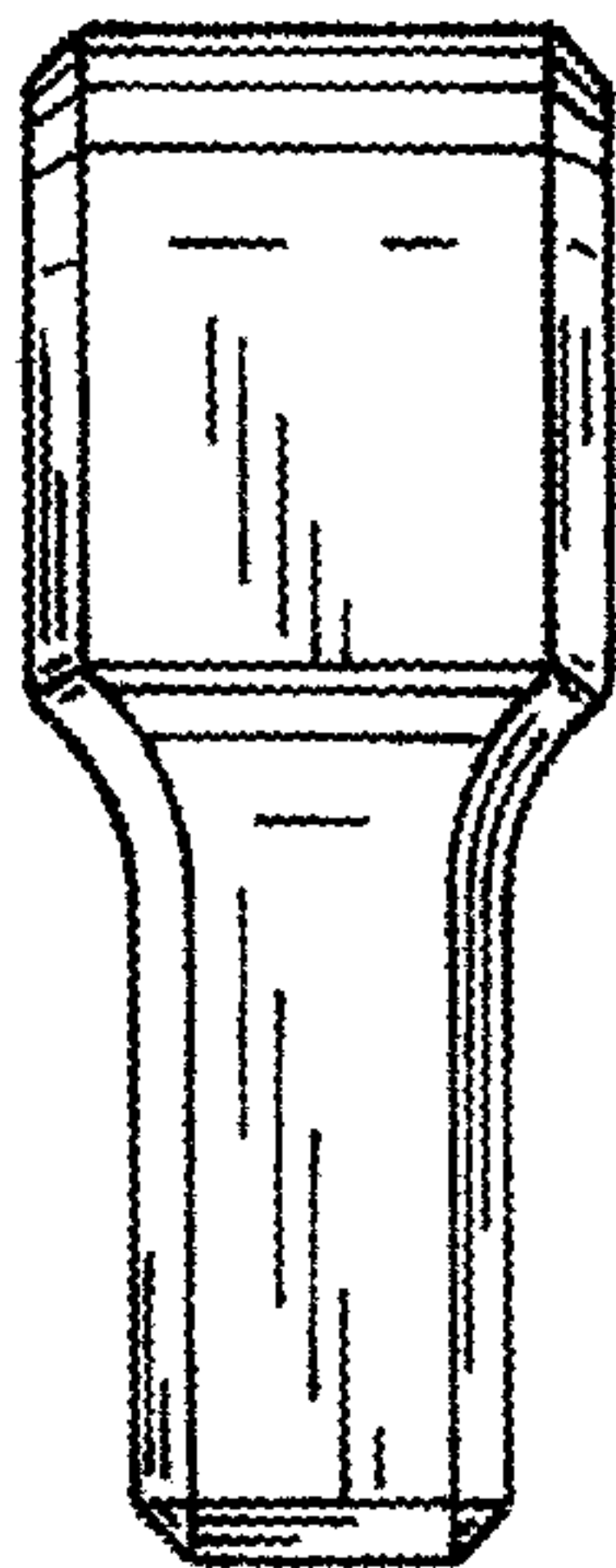

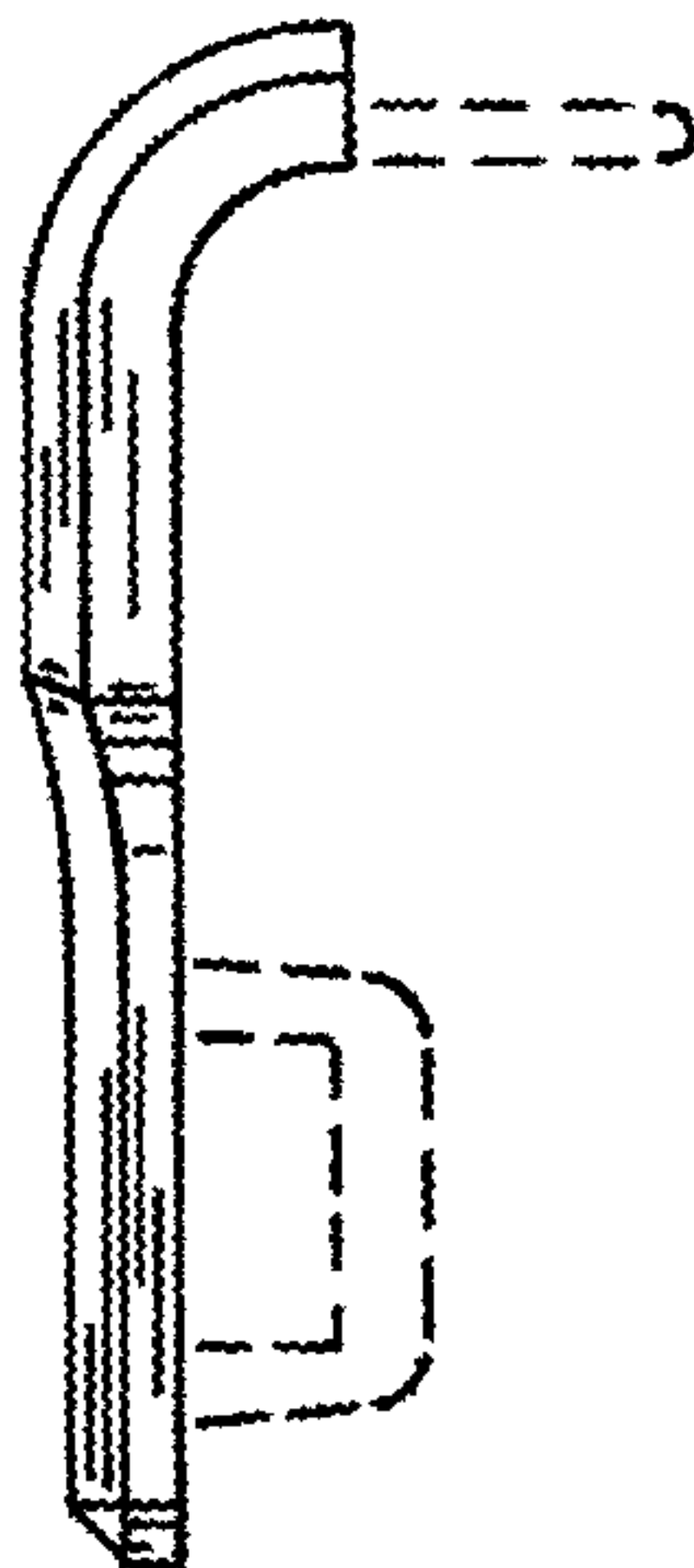

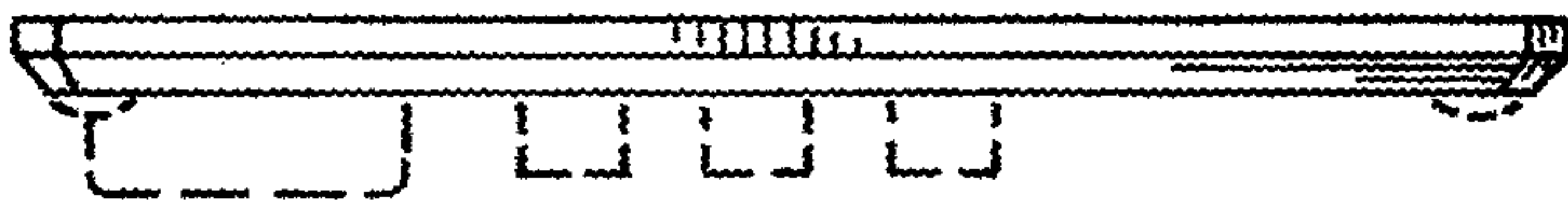

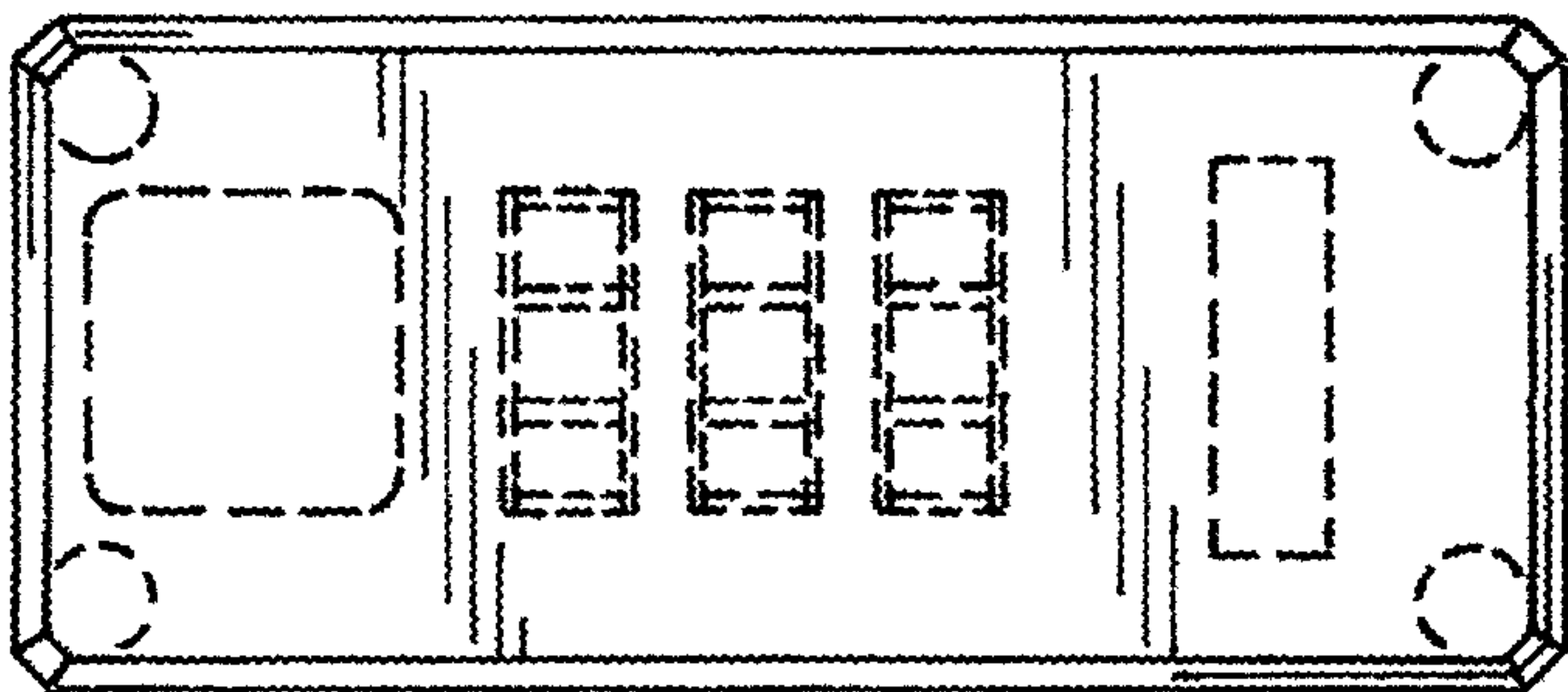

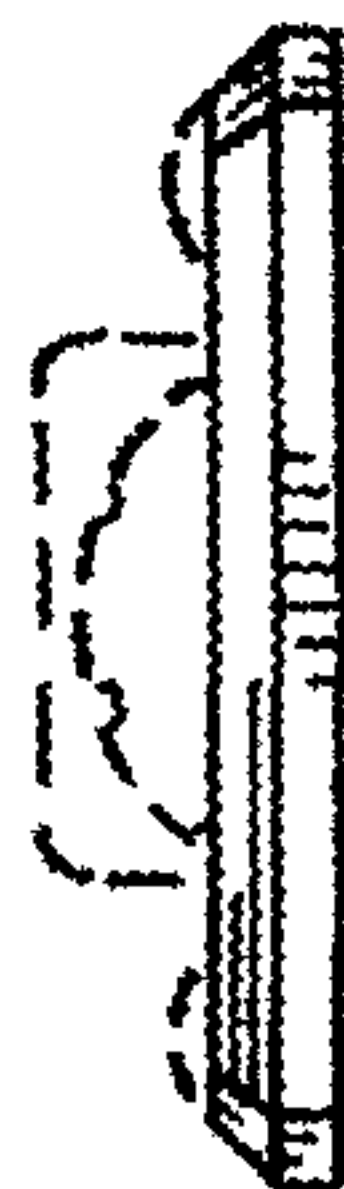
