FIG. 2 is a left elevational view thereof, with the right elevational view thereof a mirror image of the left elevational view;

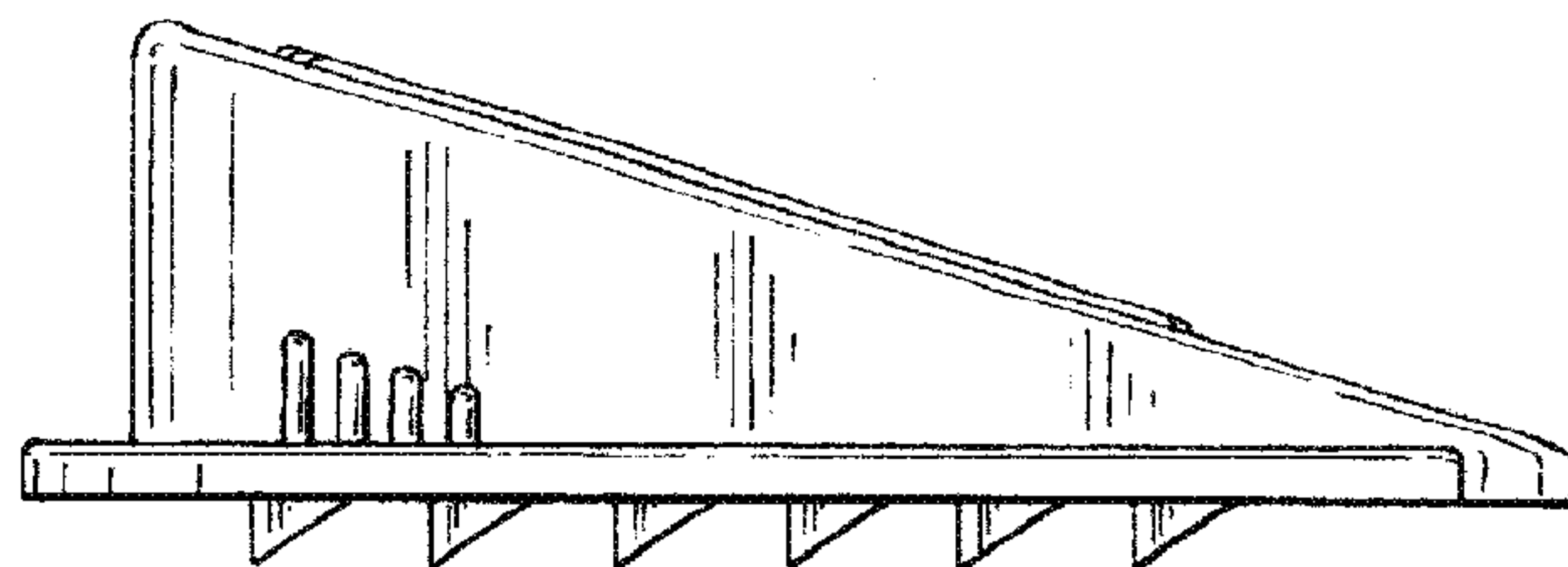
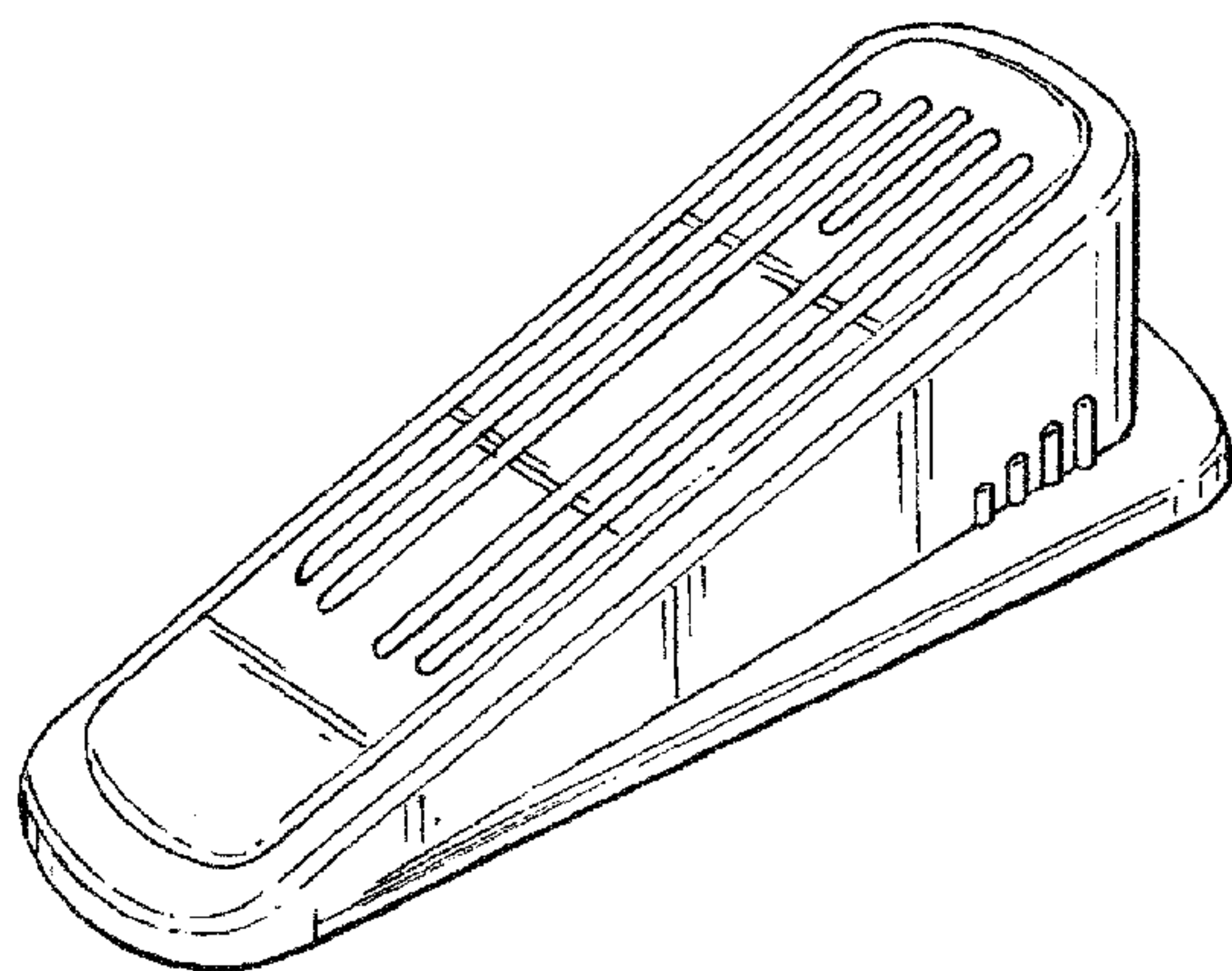
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

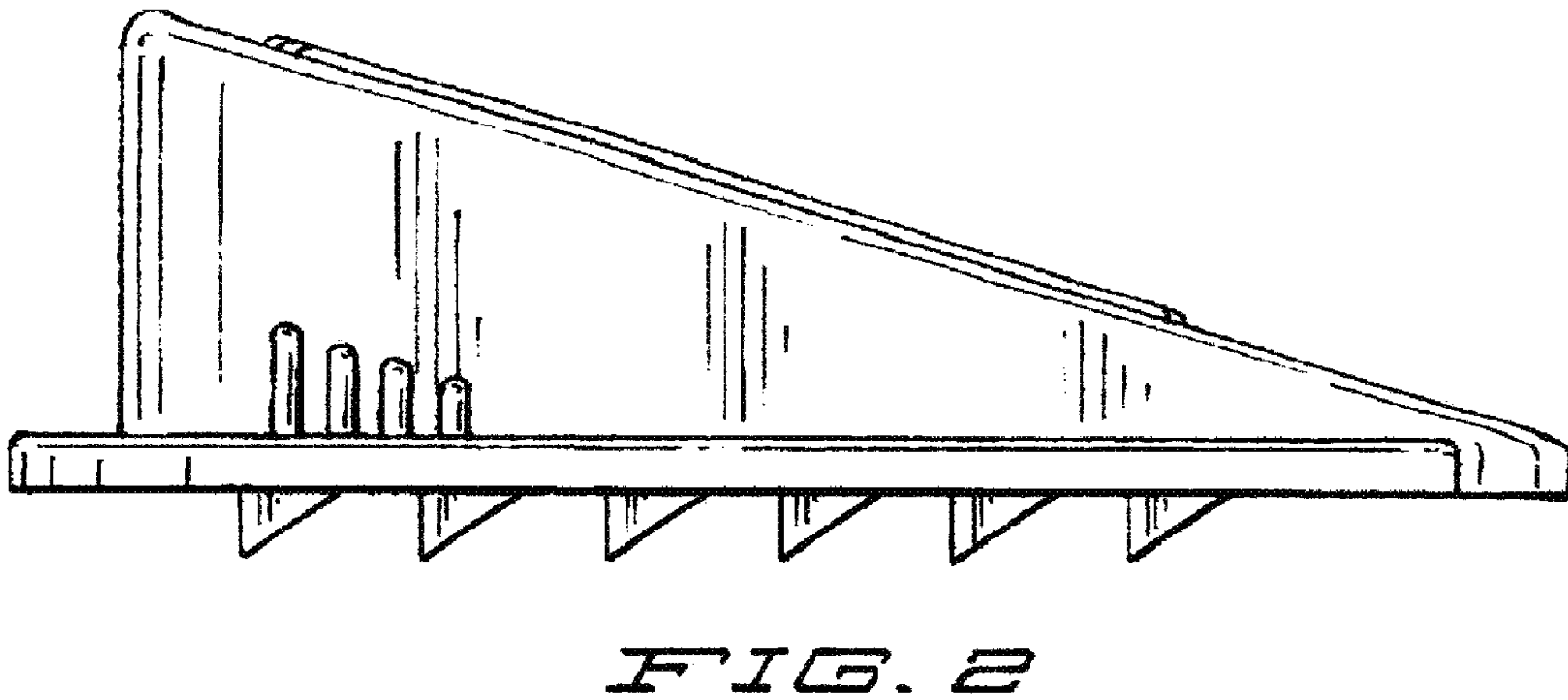
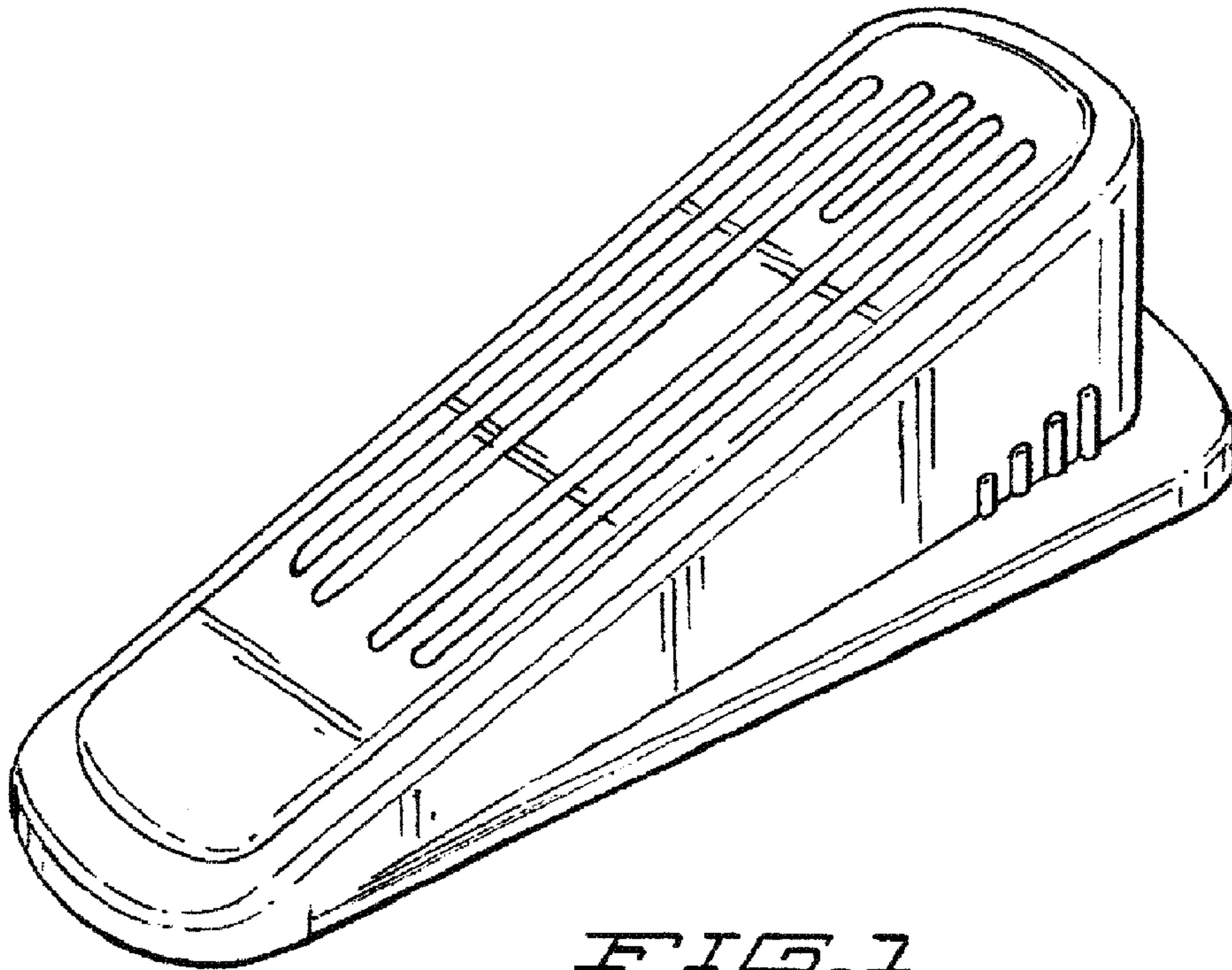
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

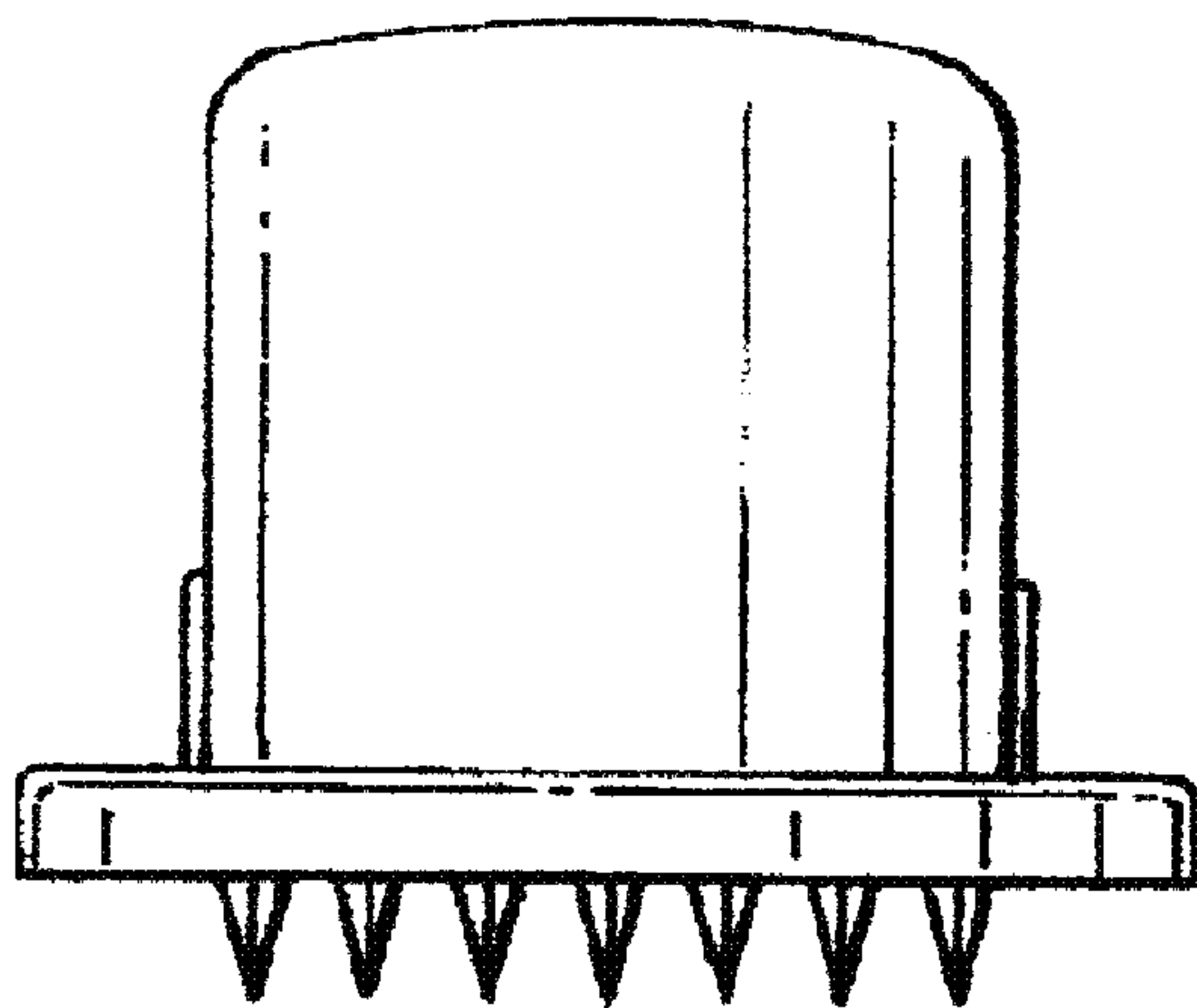

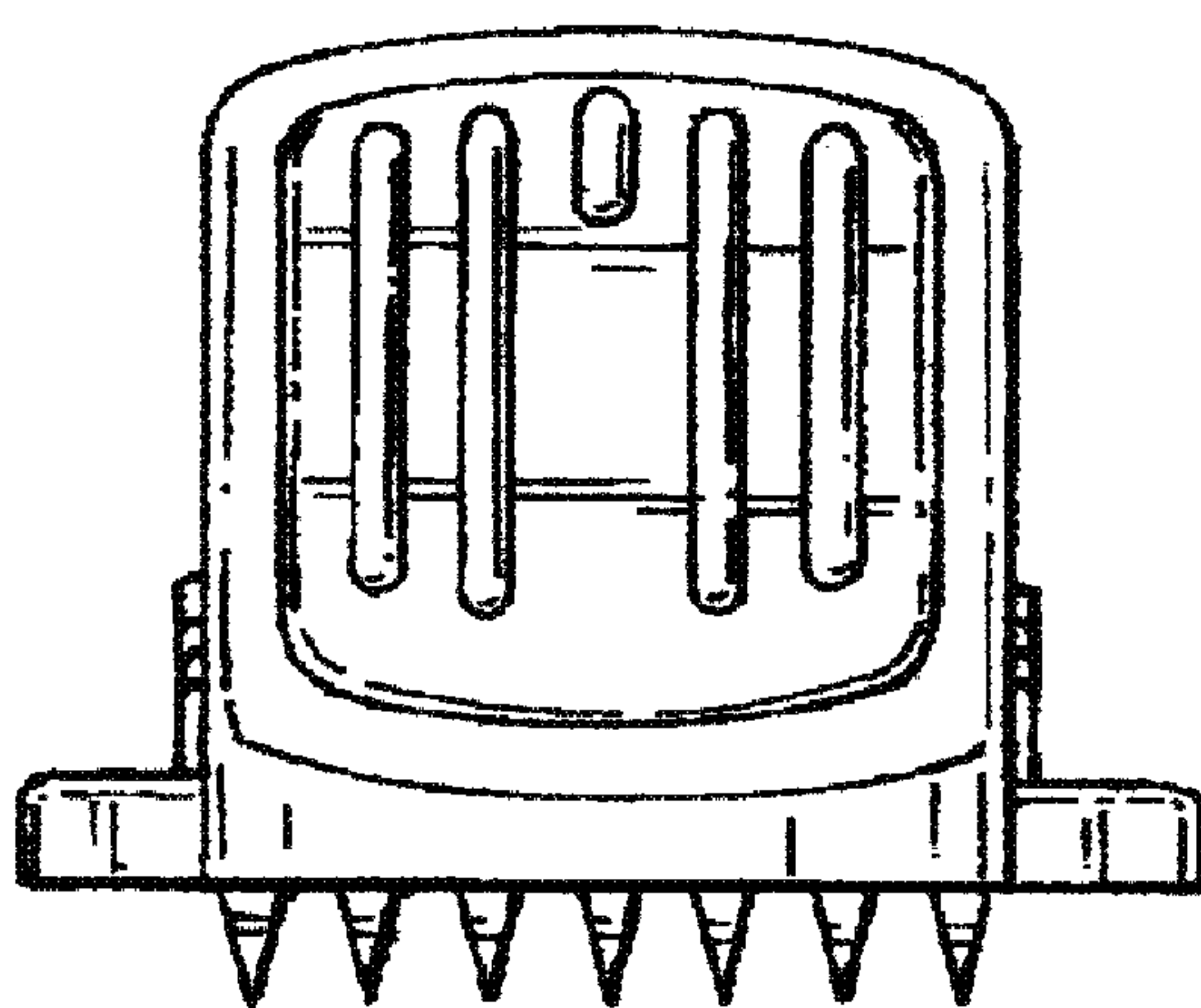

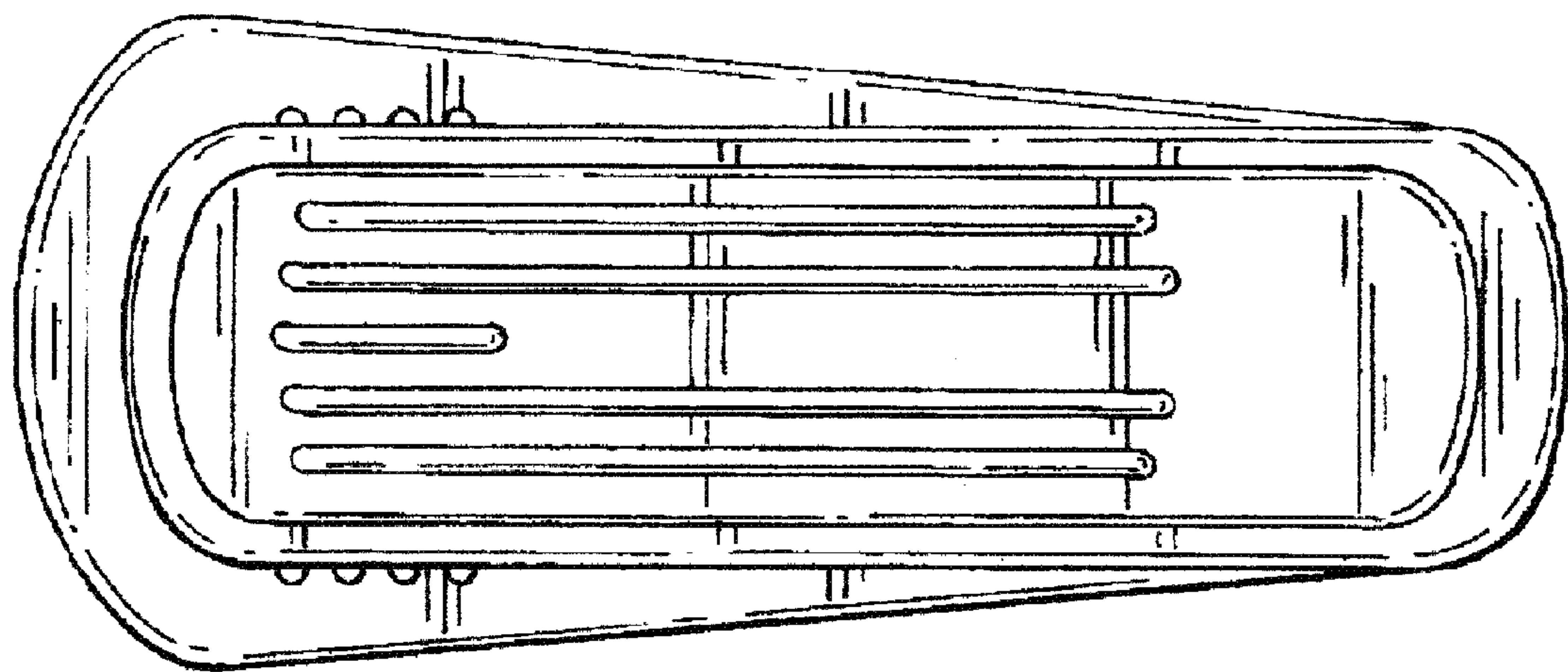

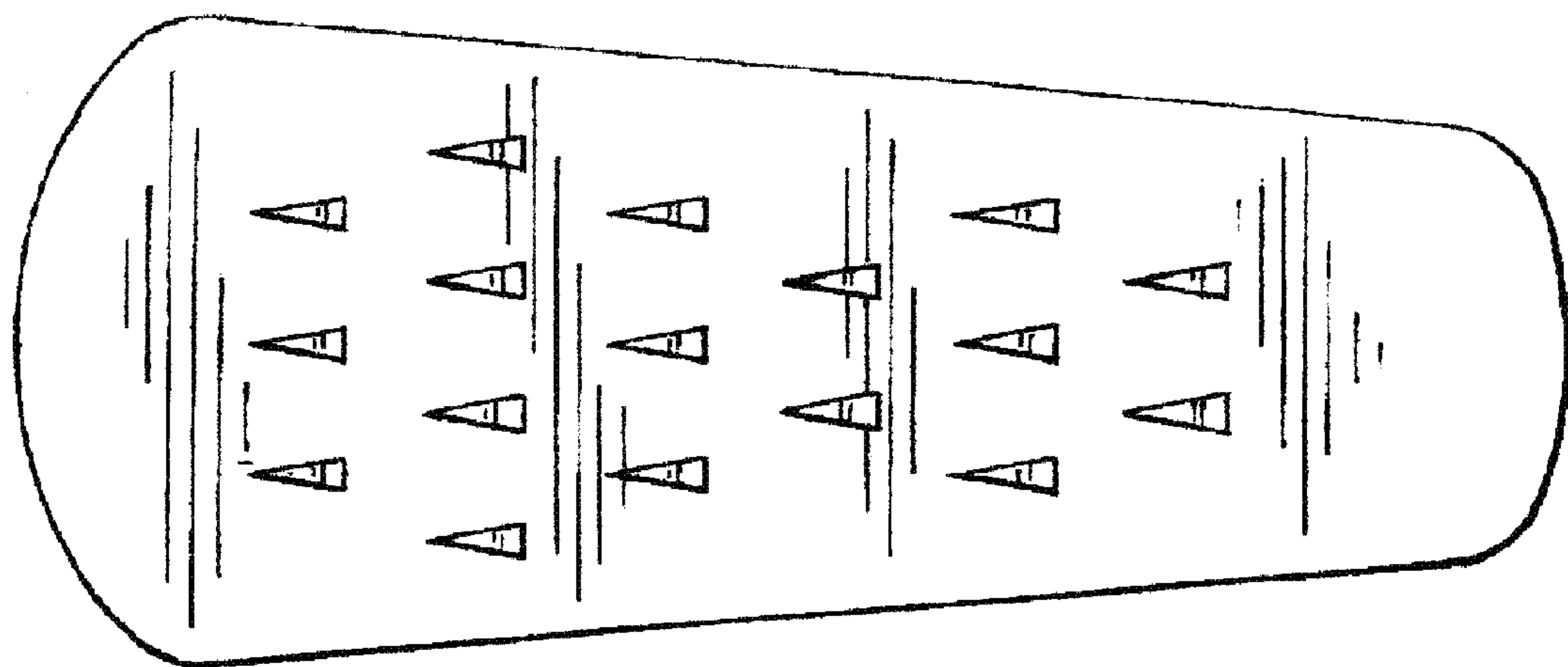
