FIG. 3 is a side view thereof;

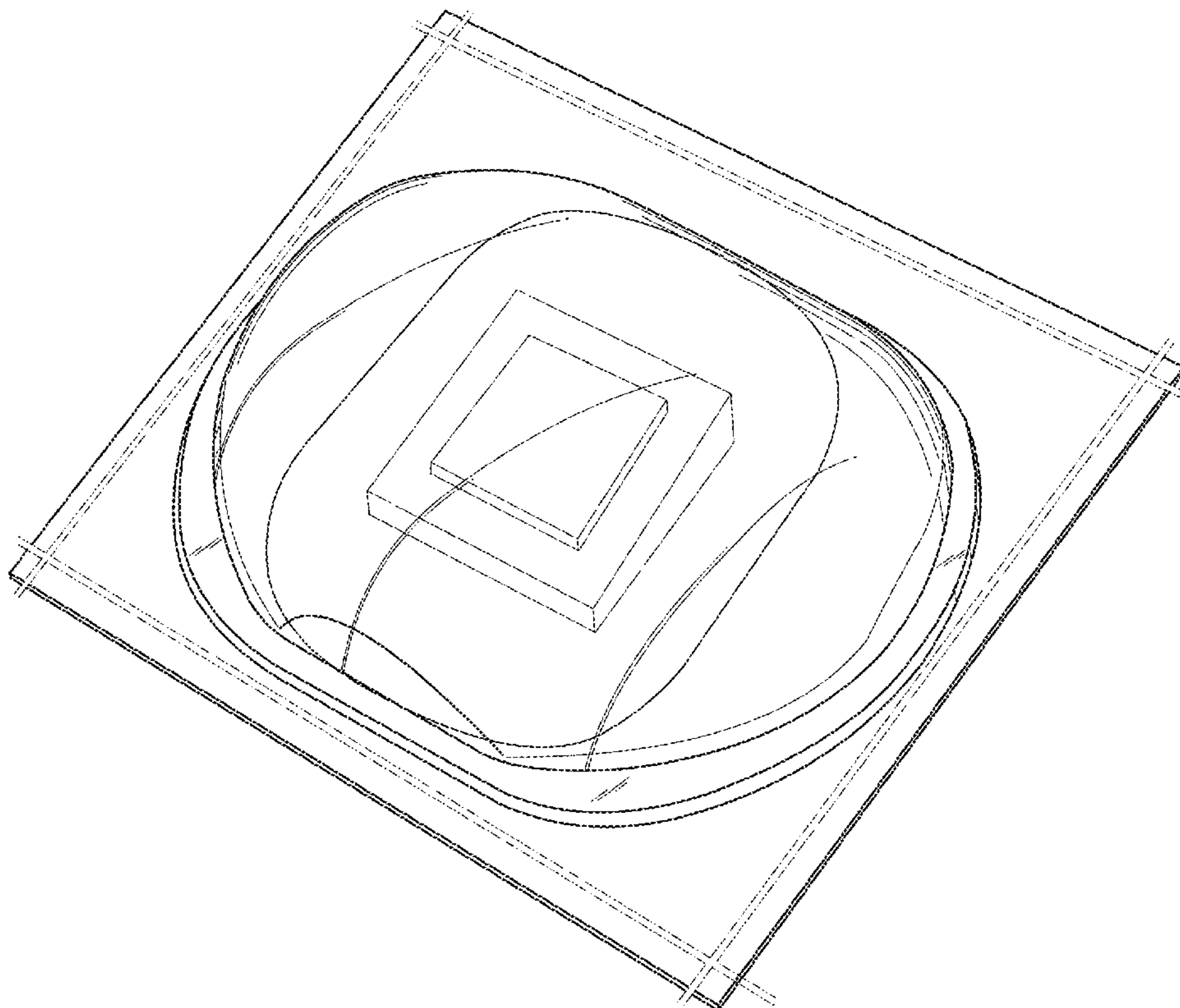
FIG. 4 is an opposite side view thereof;

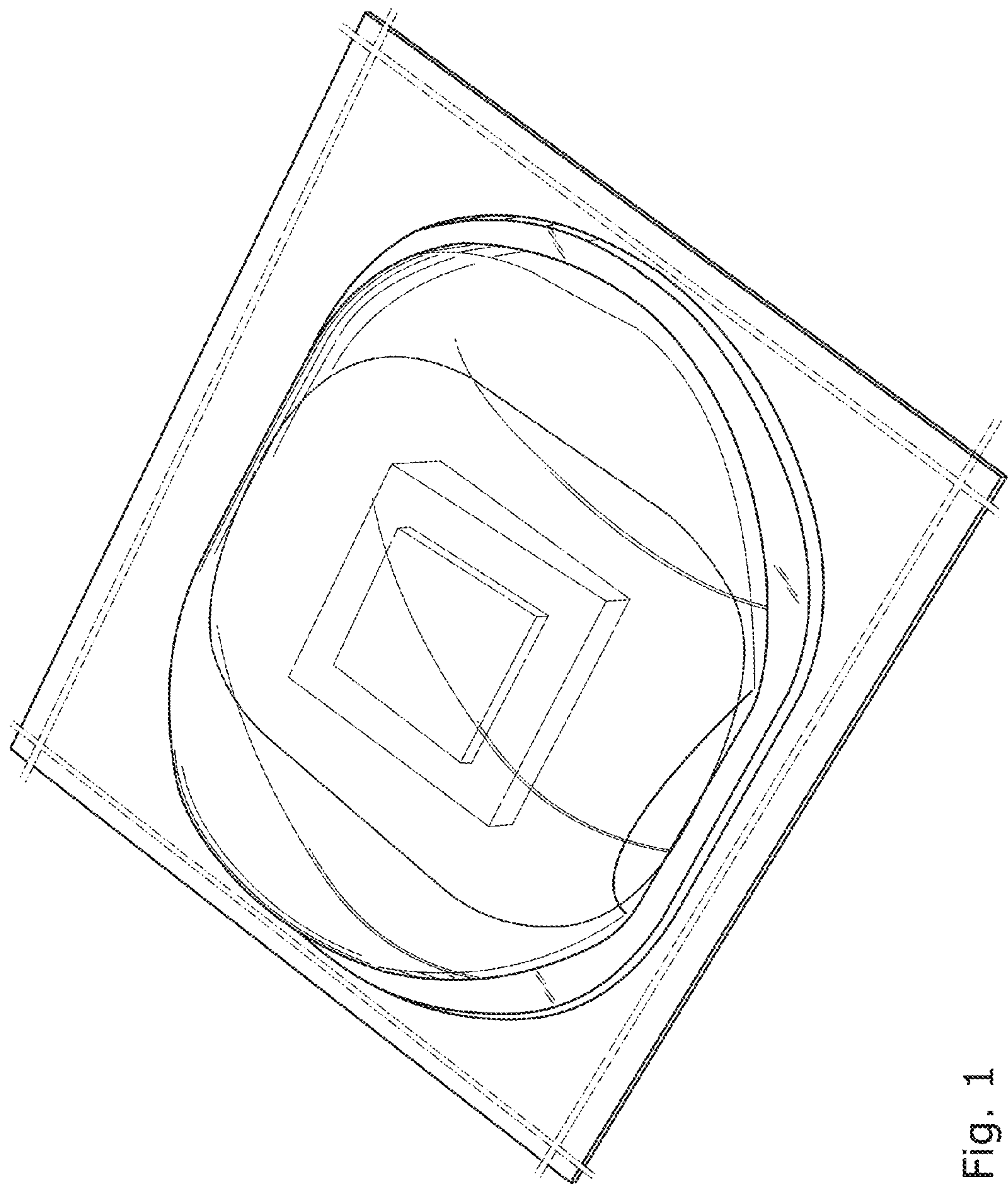

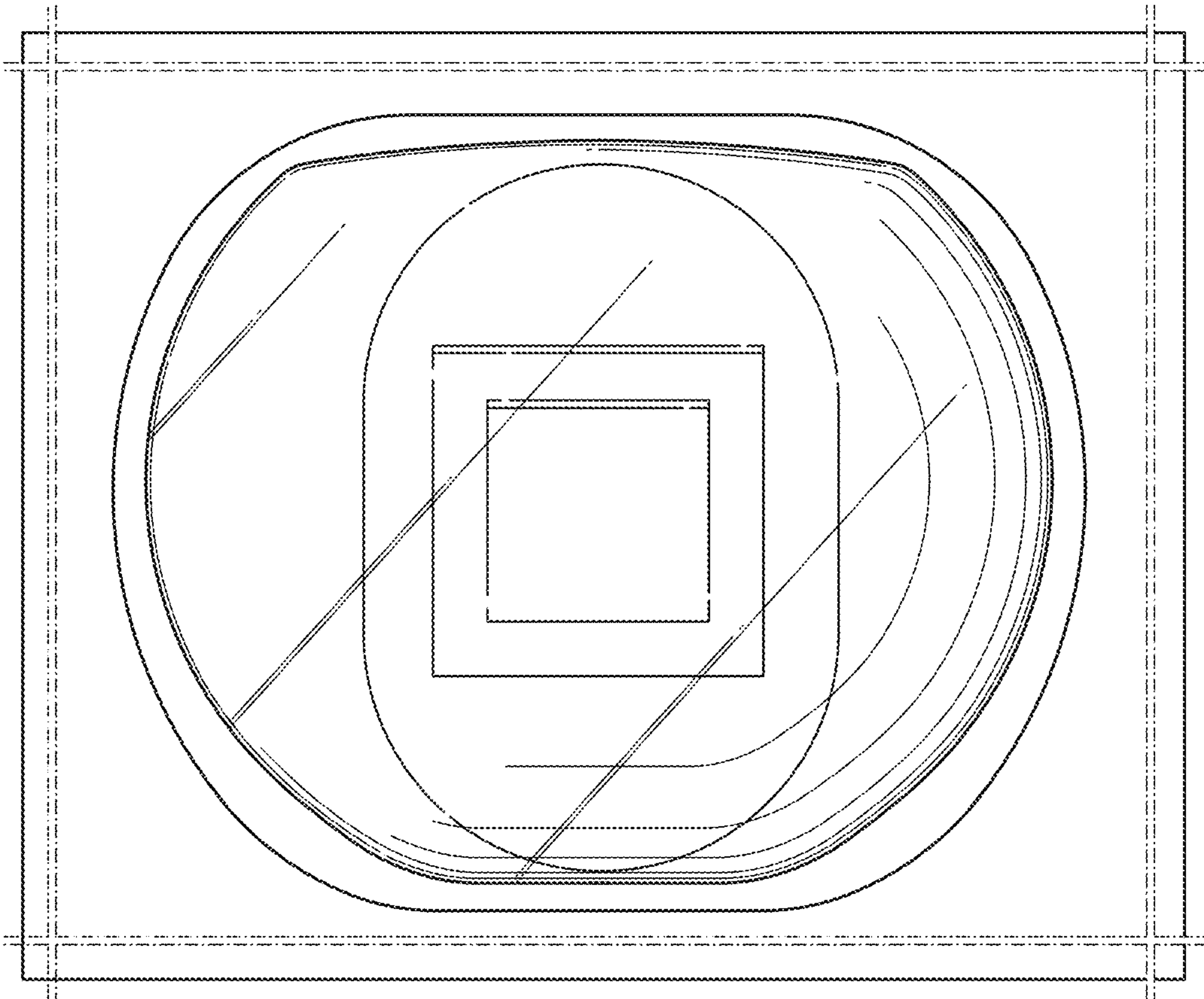

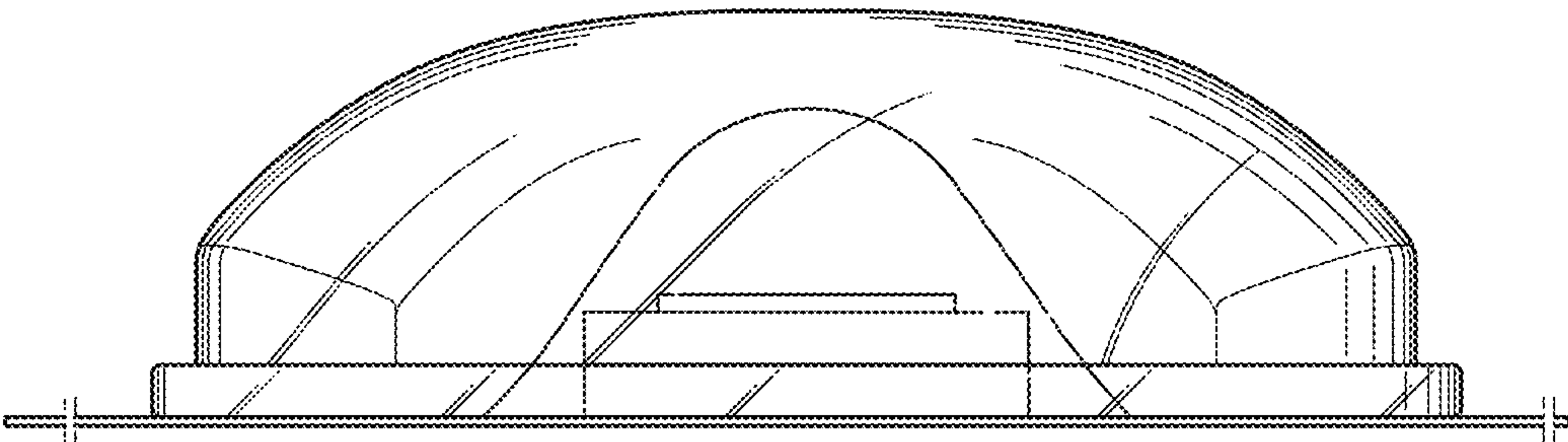

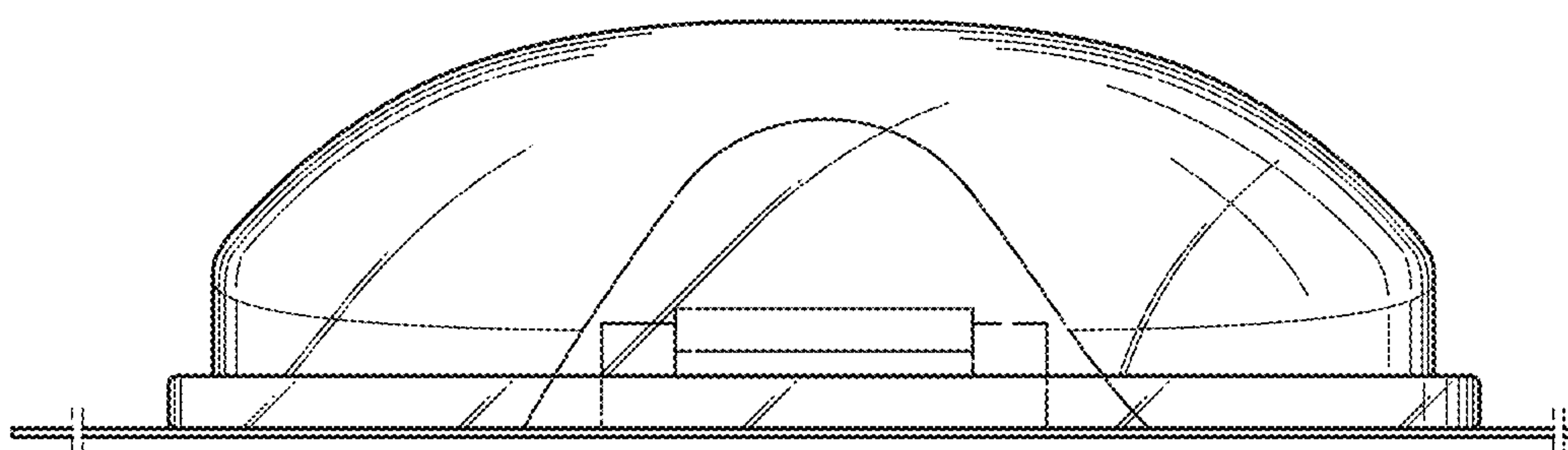

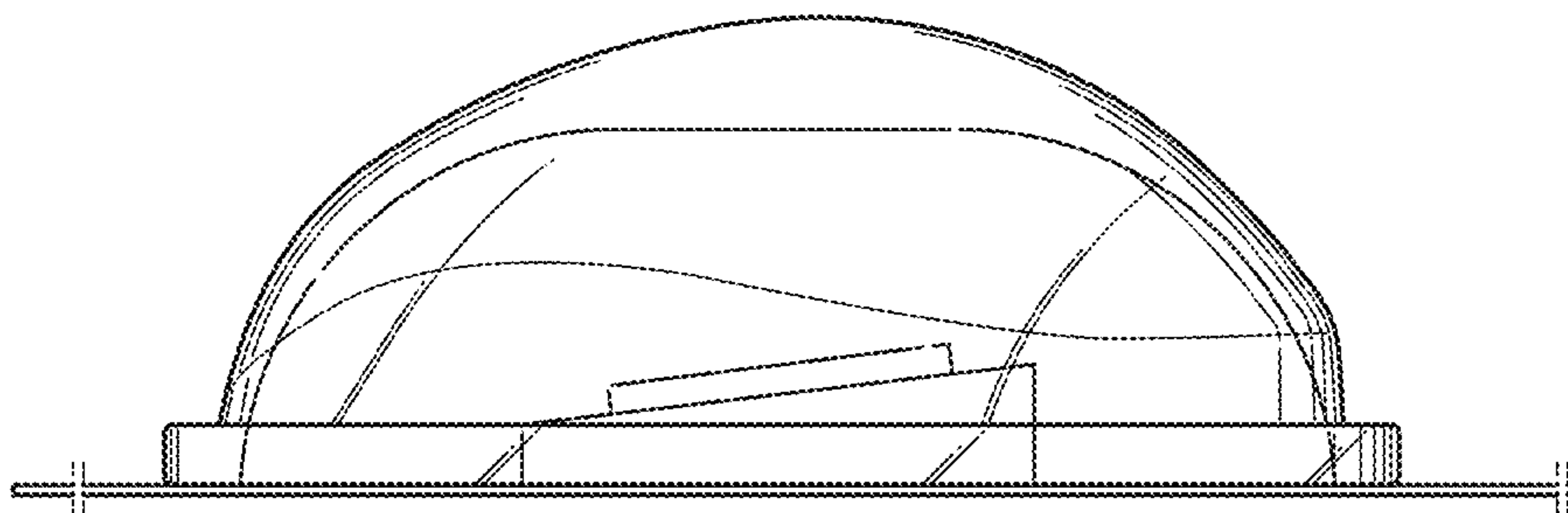

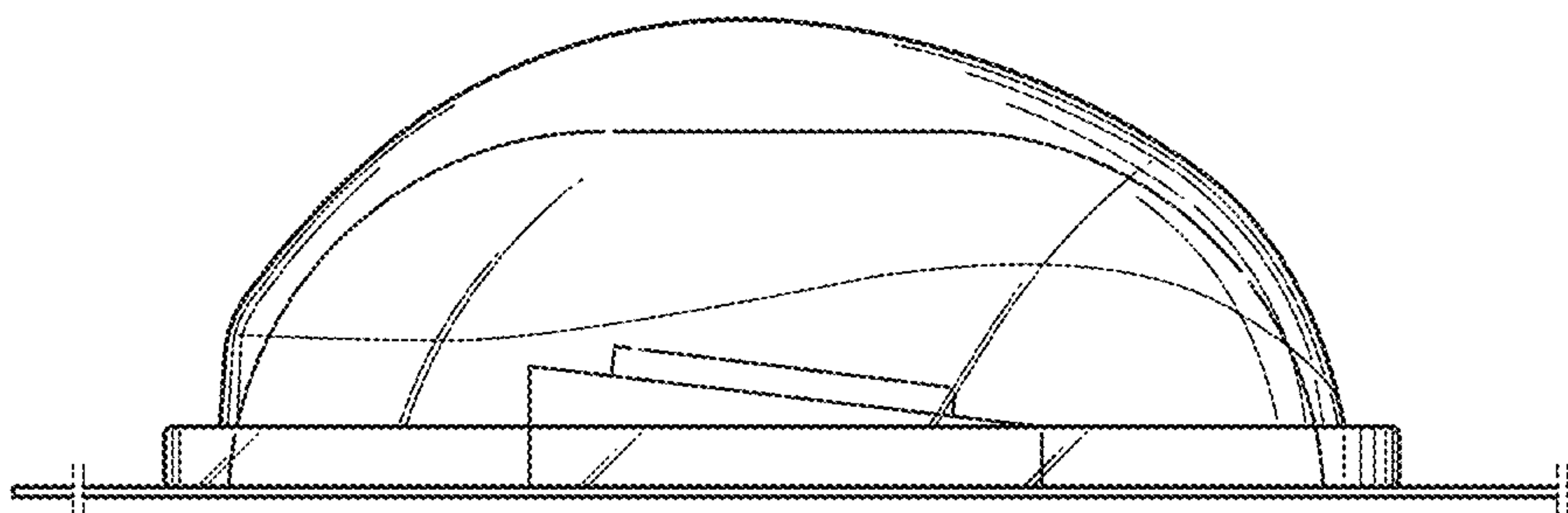
