FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

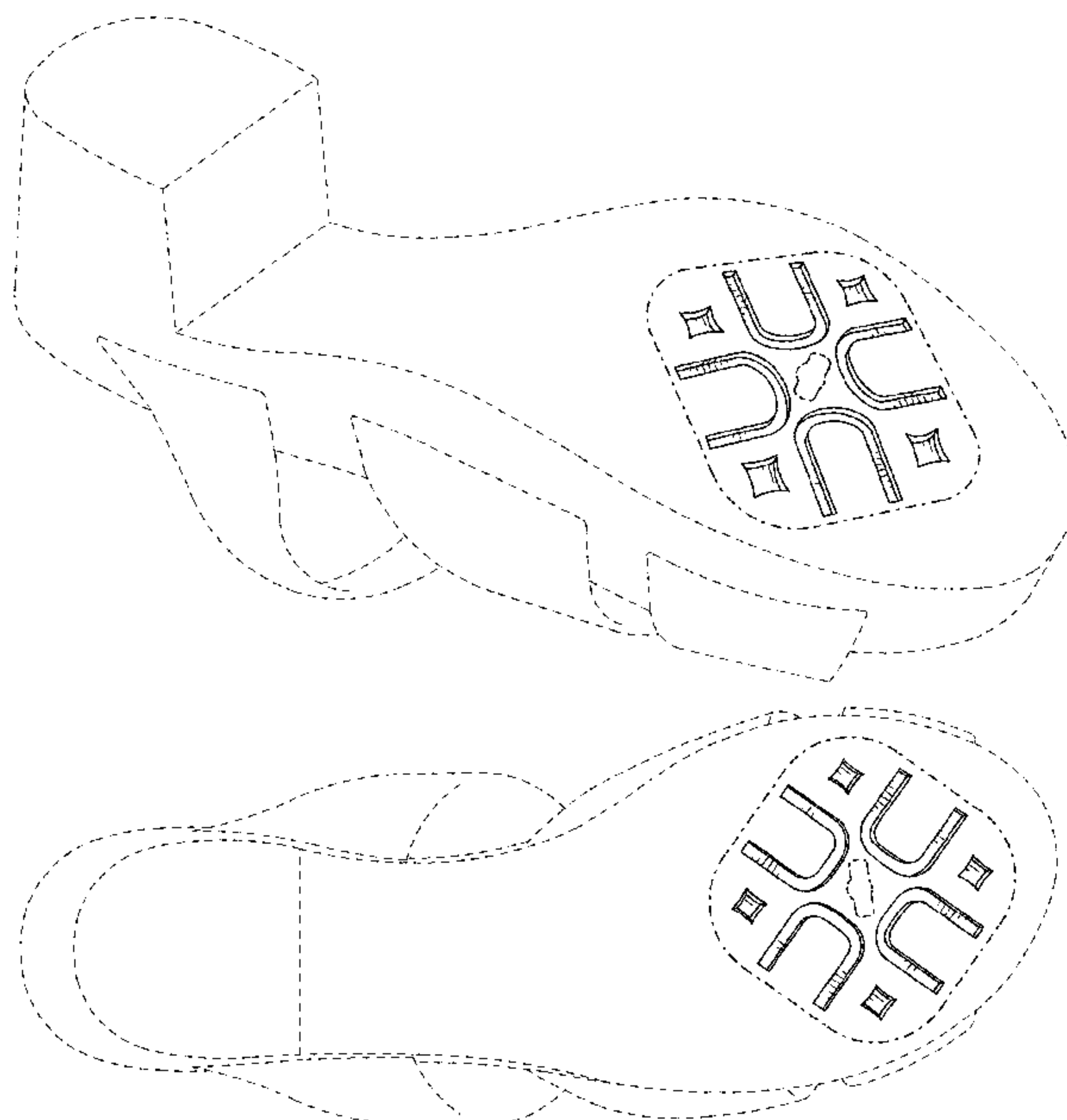
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

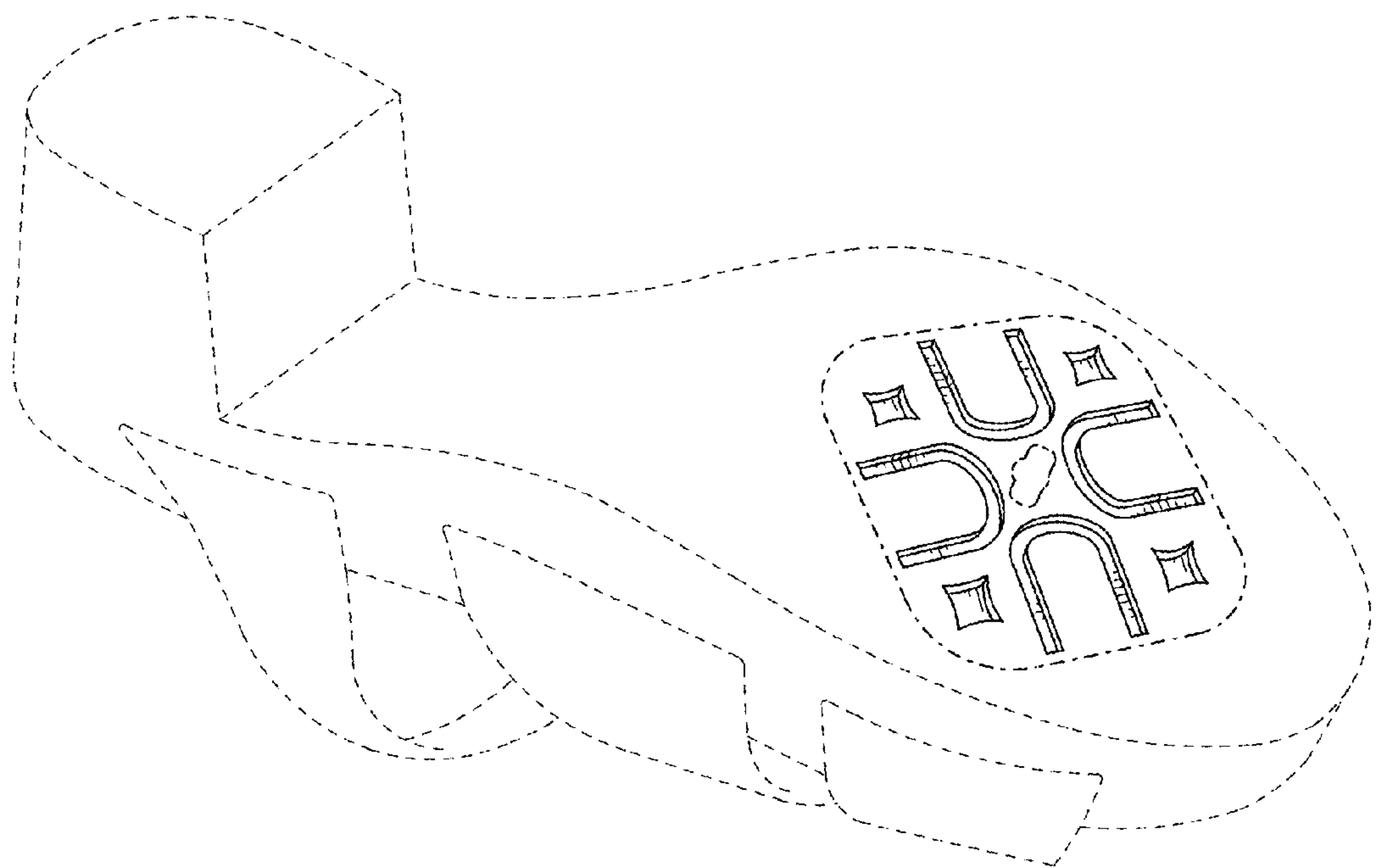

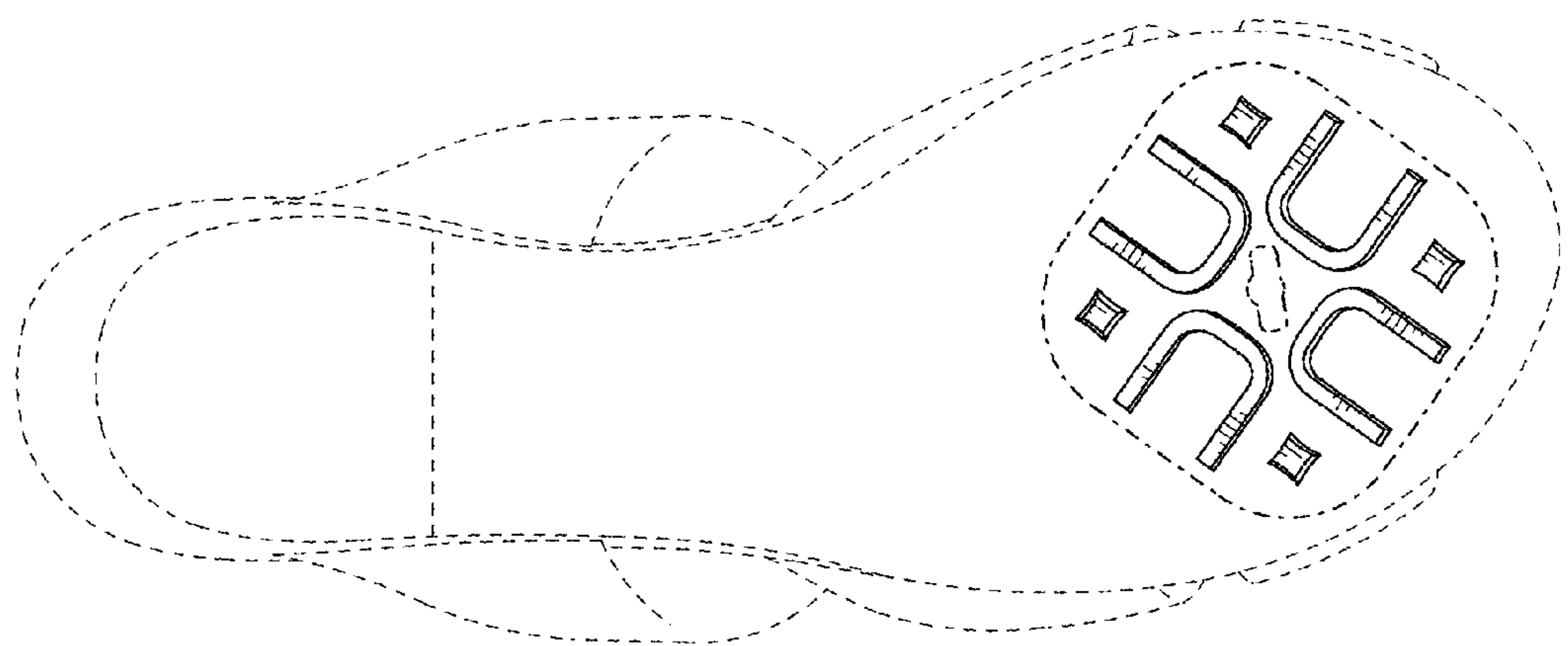

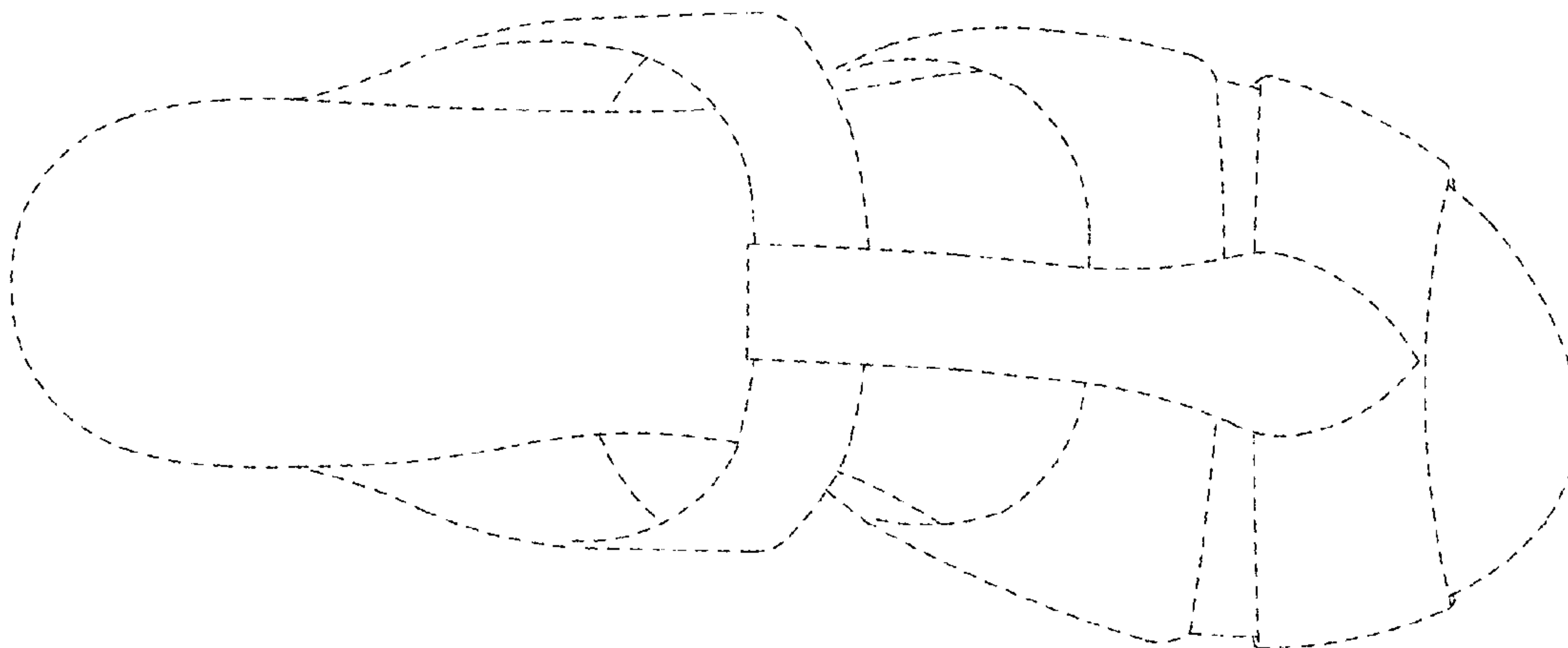

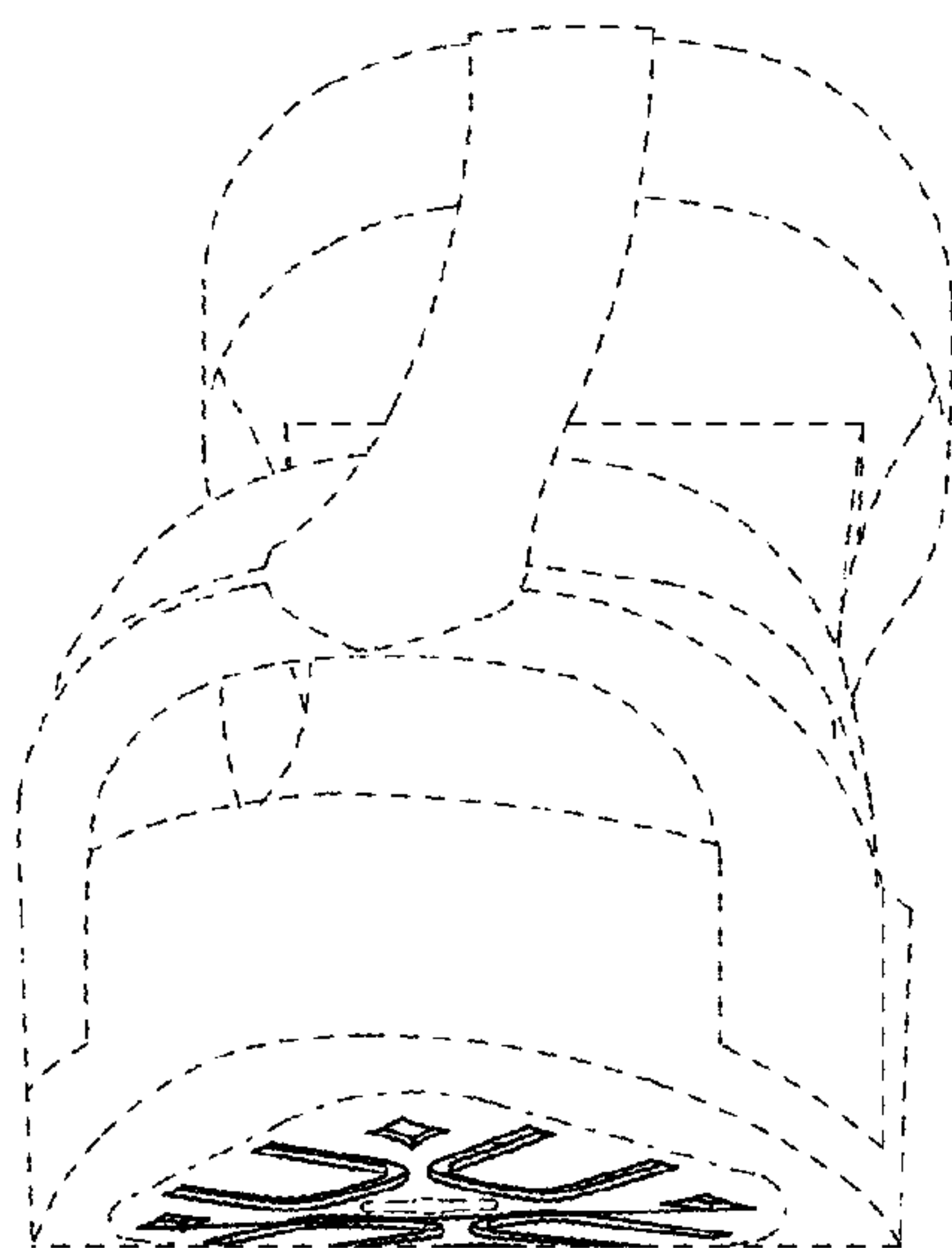

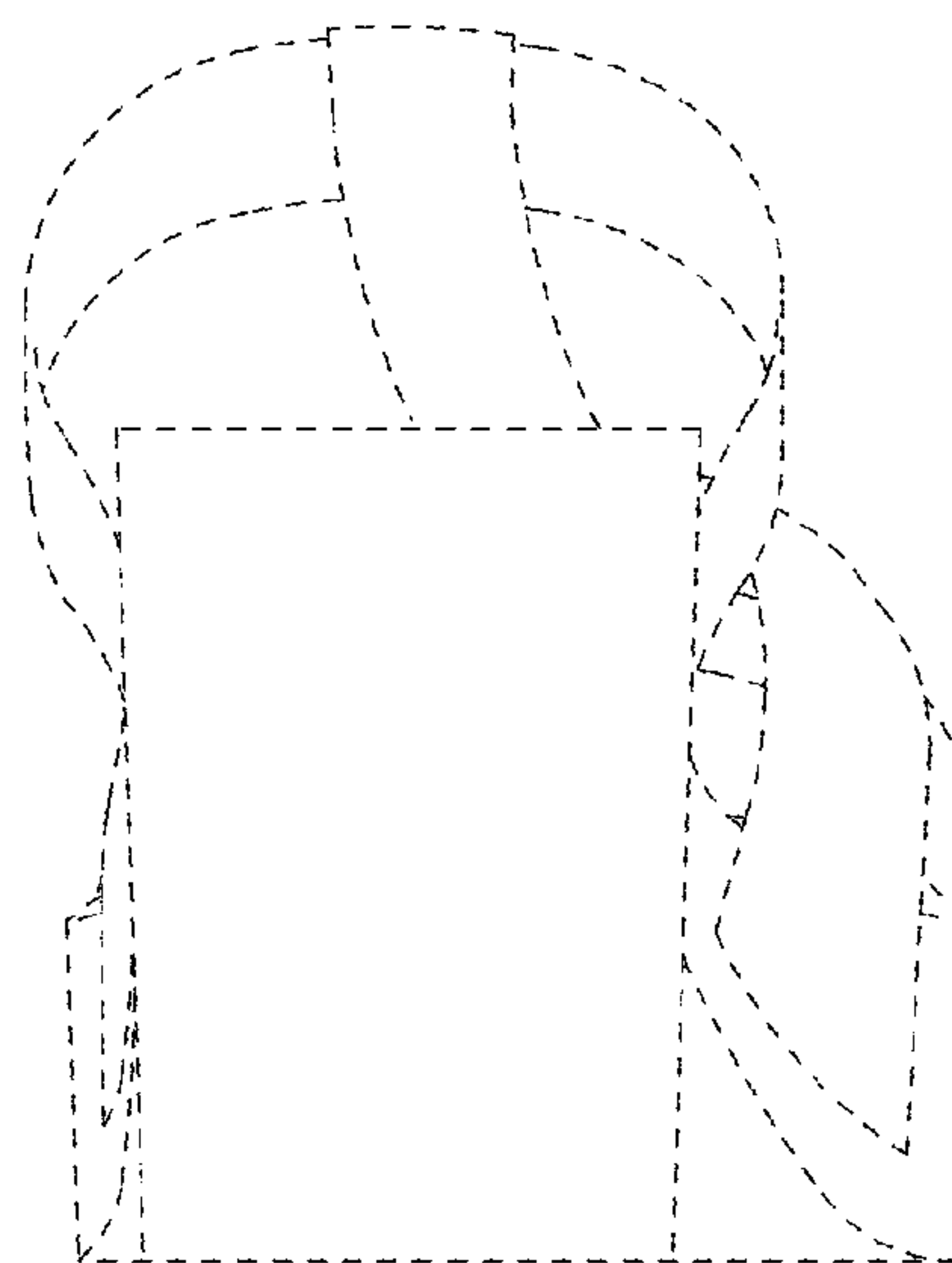

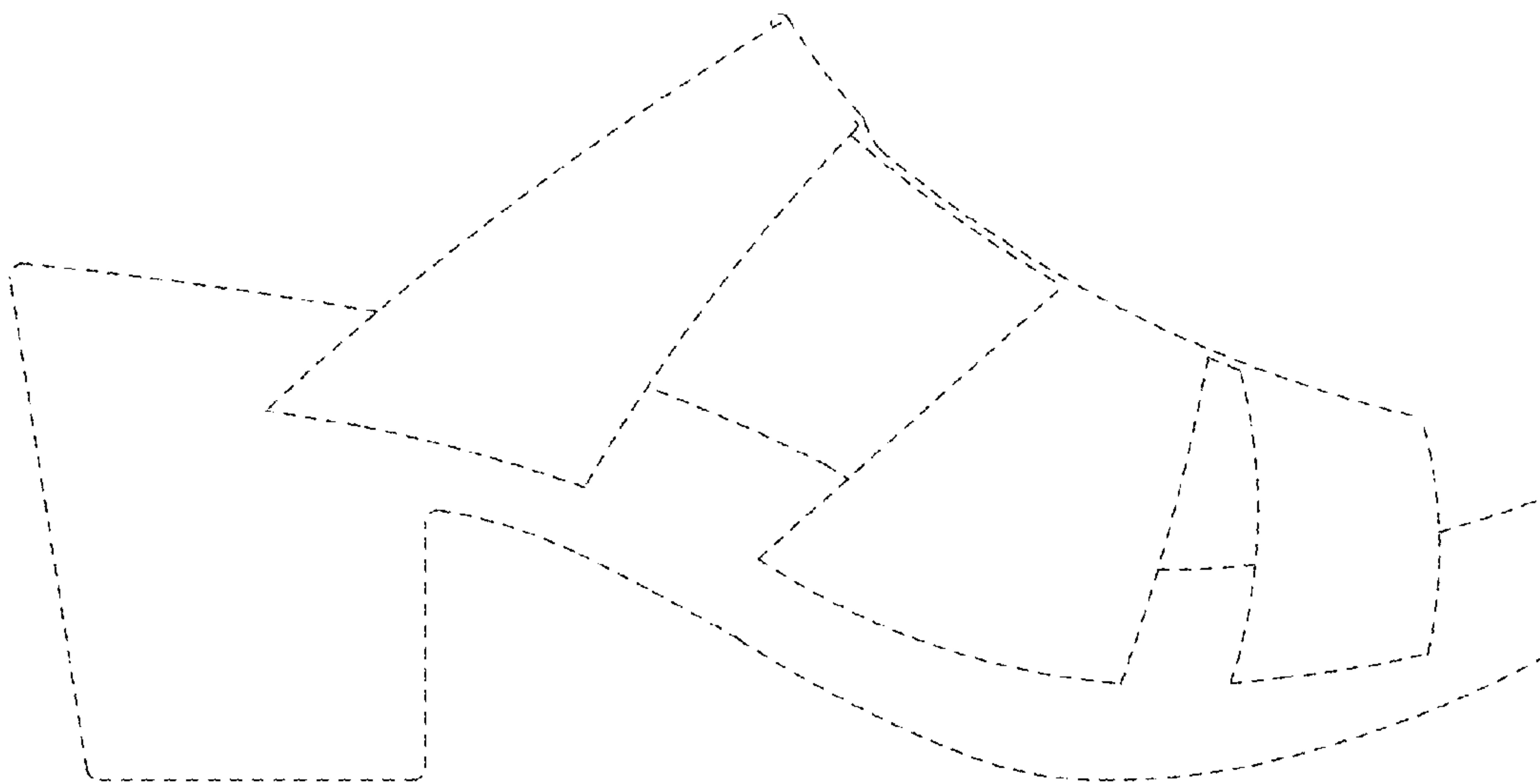

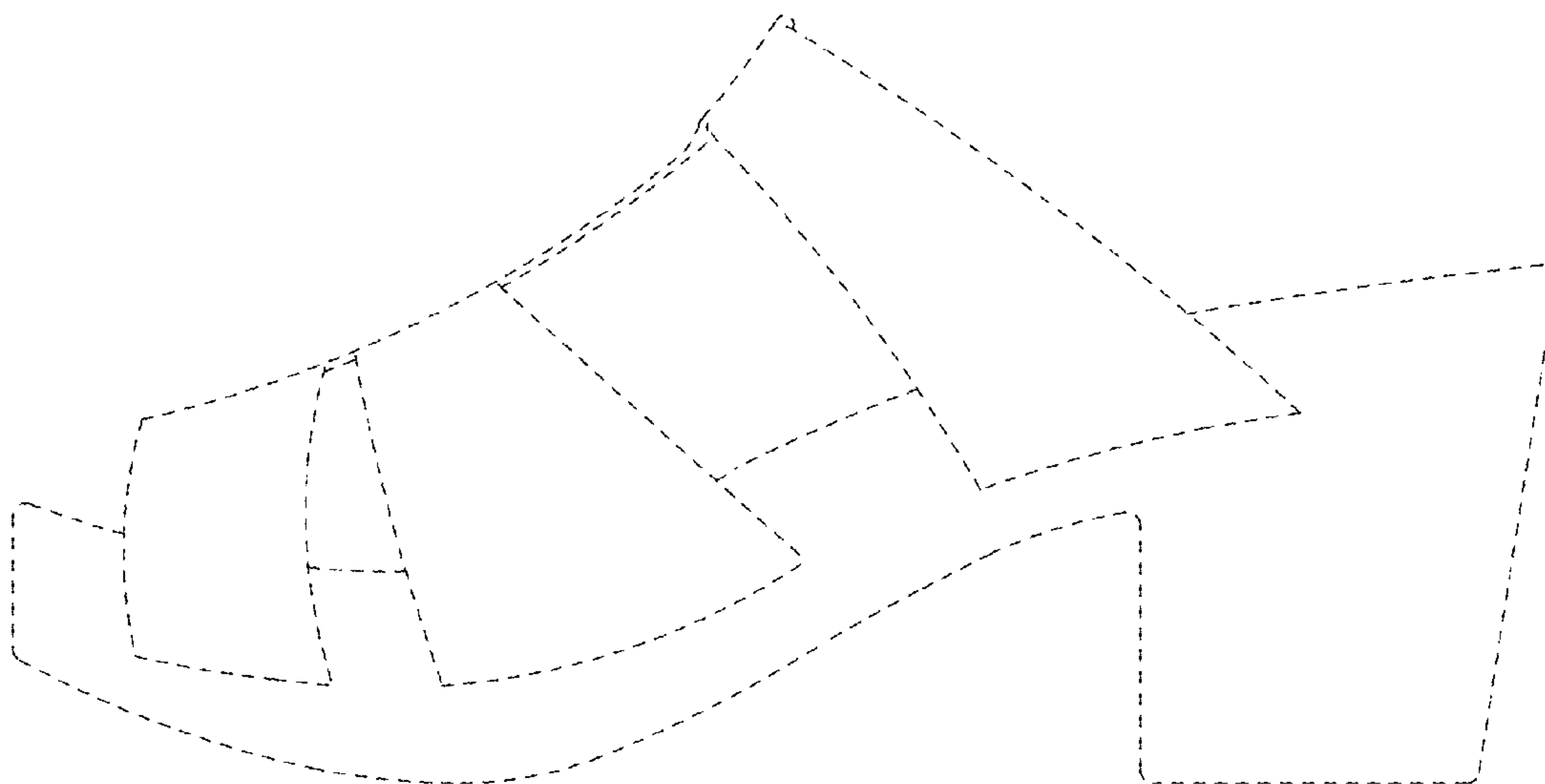
