(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a scissors guard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the scissors guard of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1.

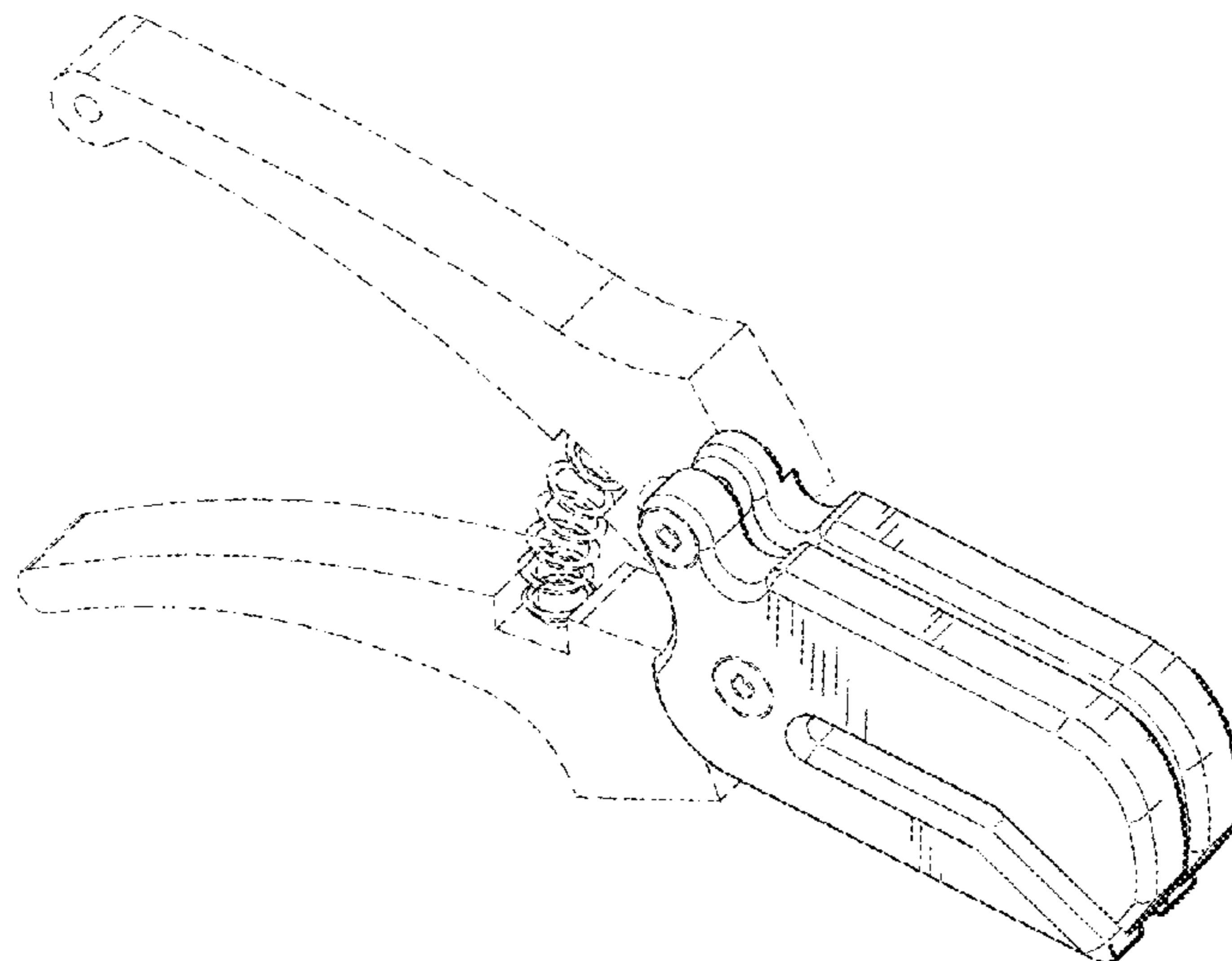
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a top elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom elevational view of the scissors guard of FIG. 1.

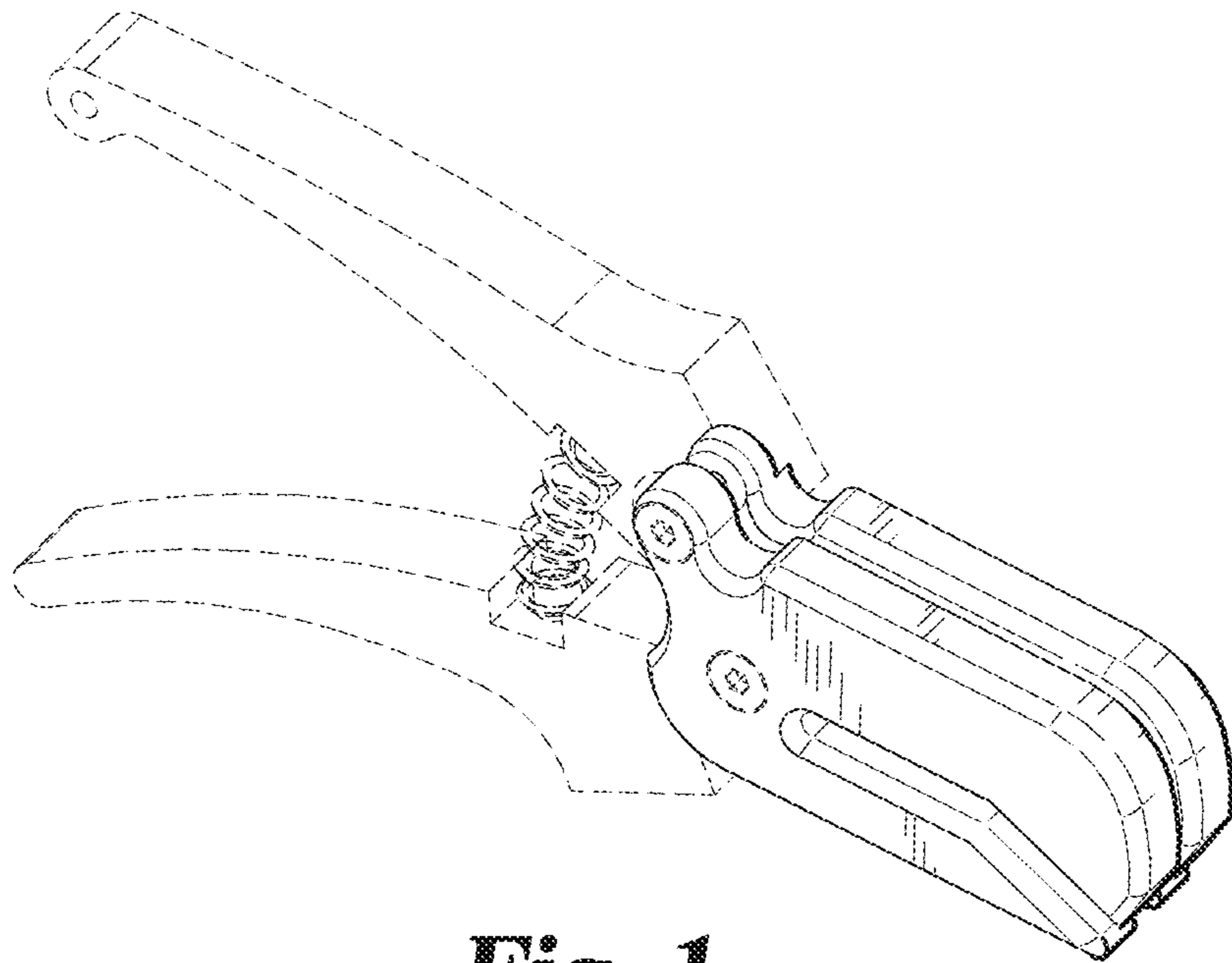

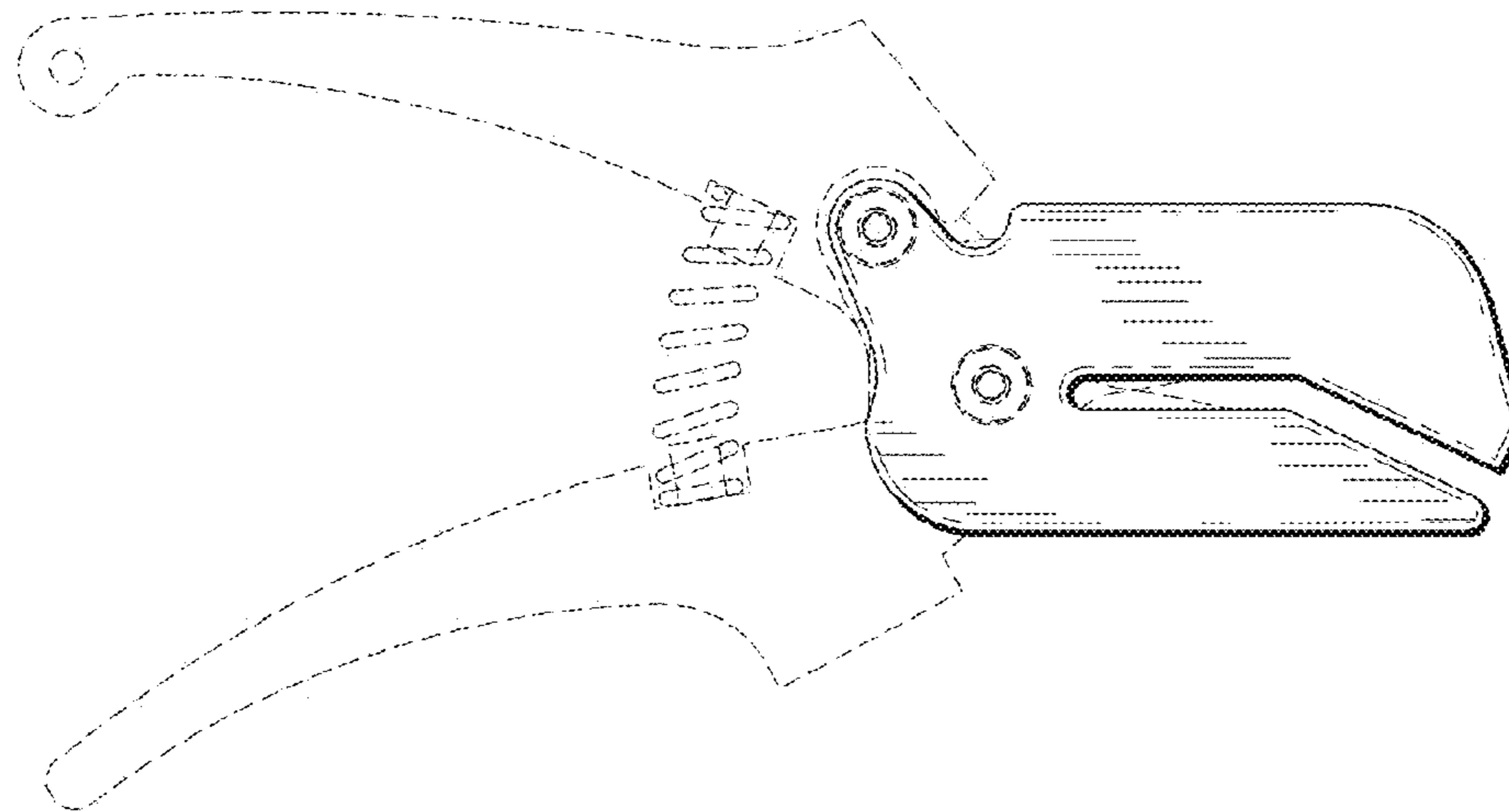

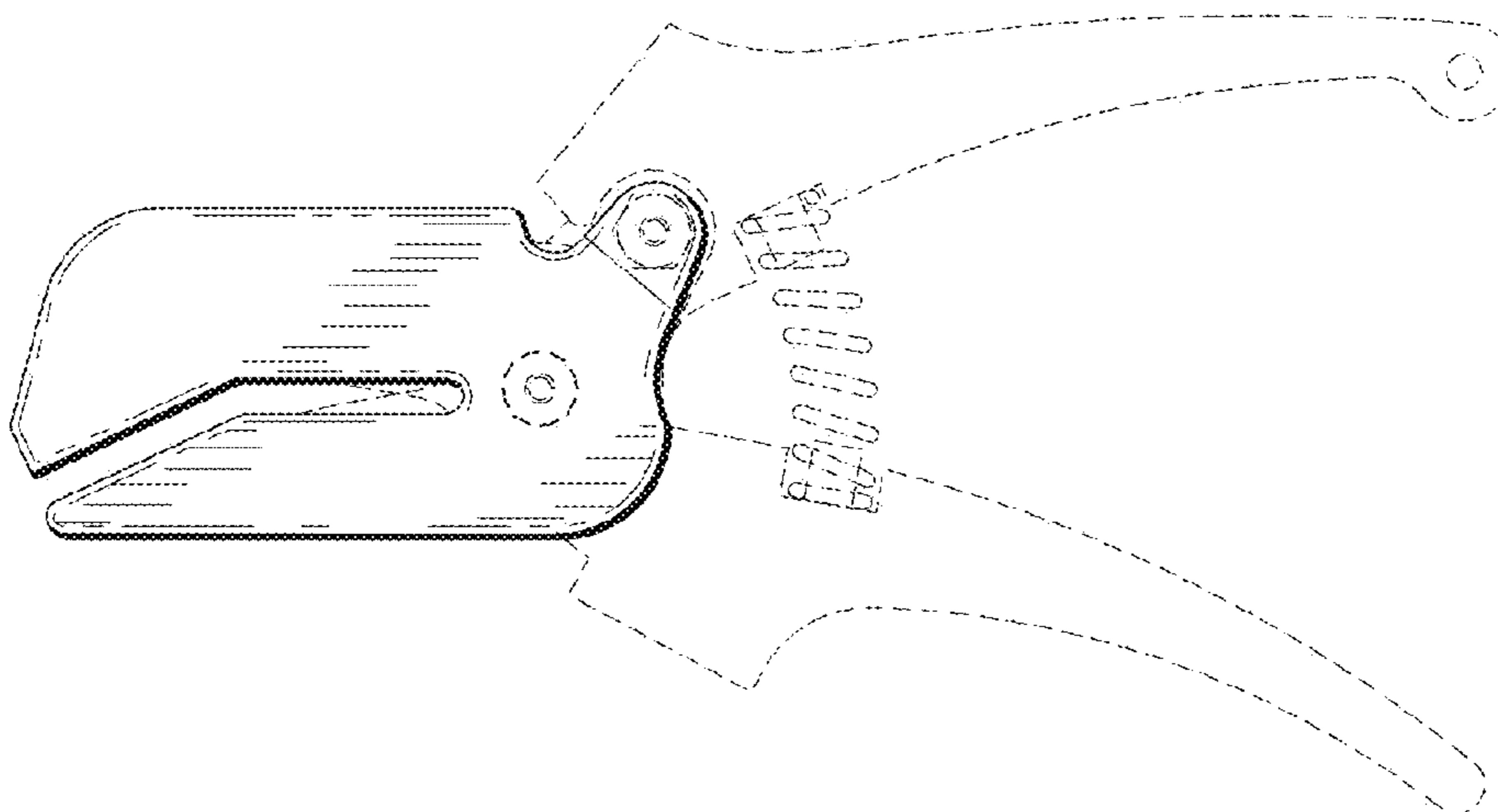

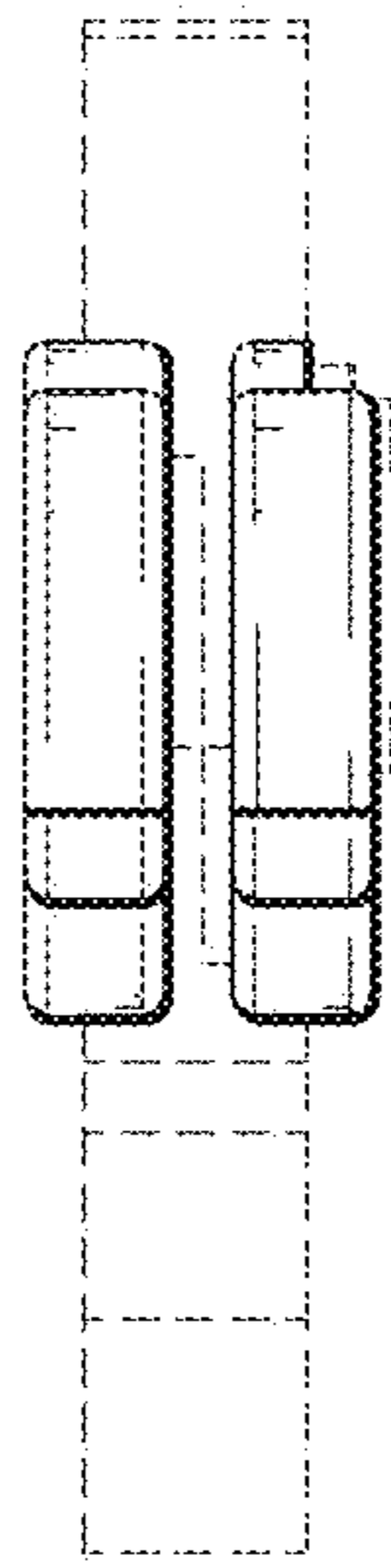

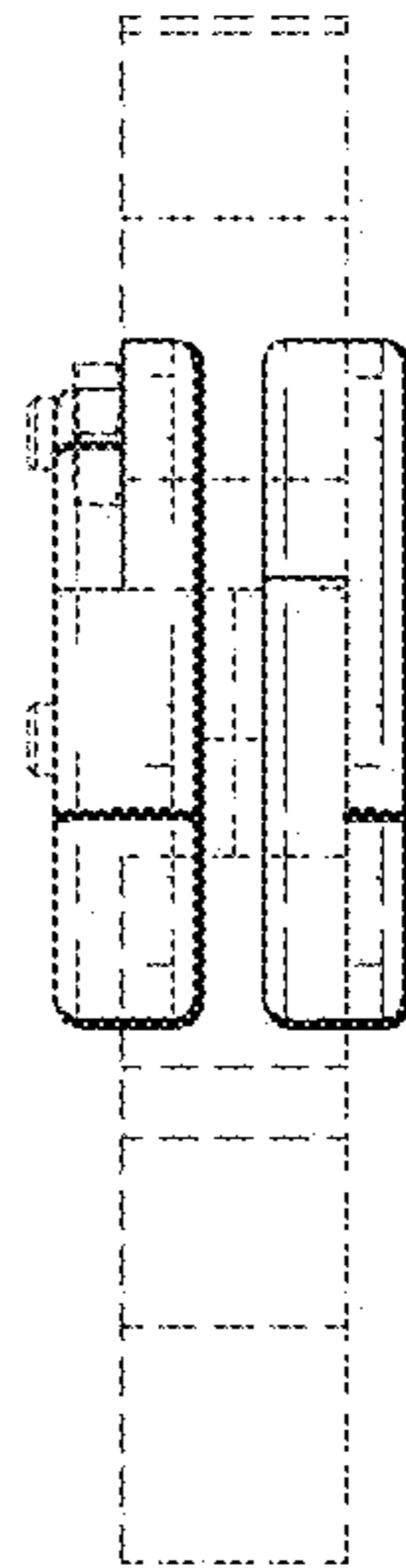

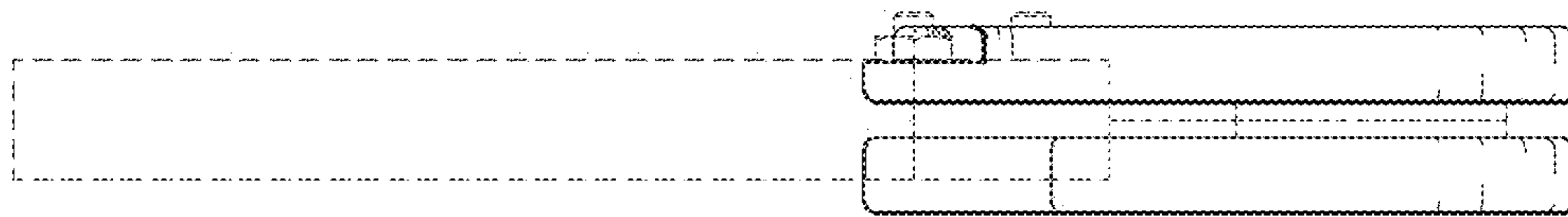

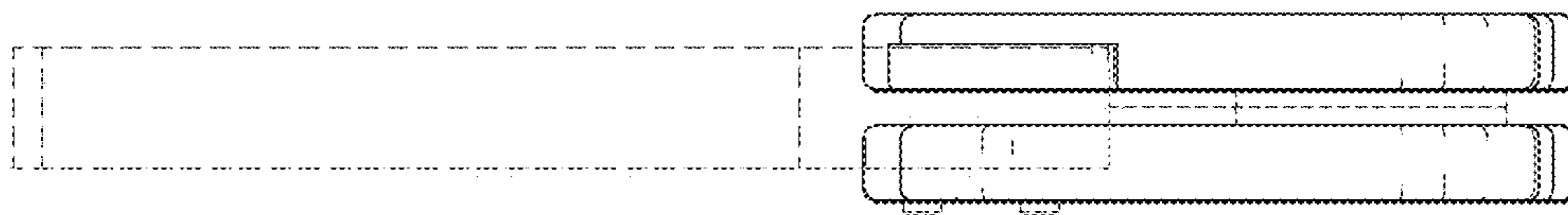
