The ornamental design for a position lamp for motorcycles, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a position lamp for motorcycles showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front left perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is an enlarged elevation view of FIG. 1;

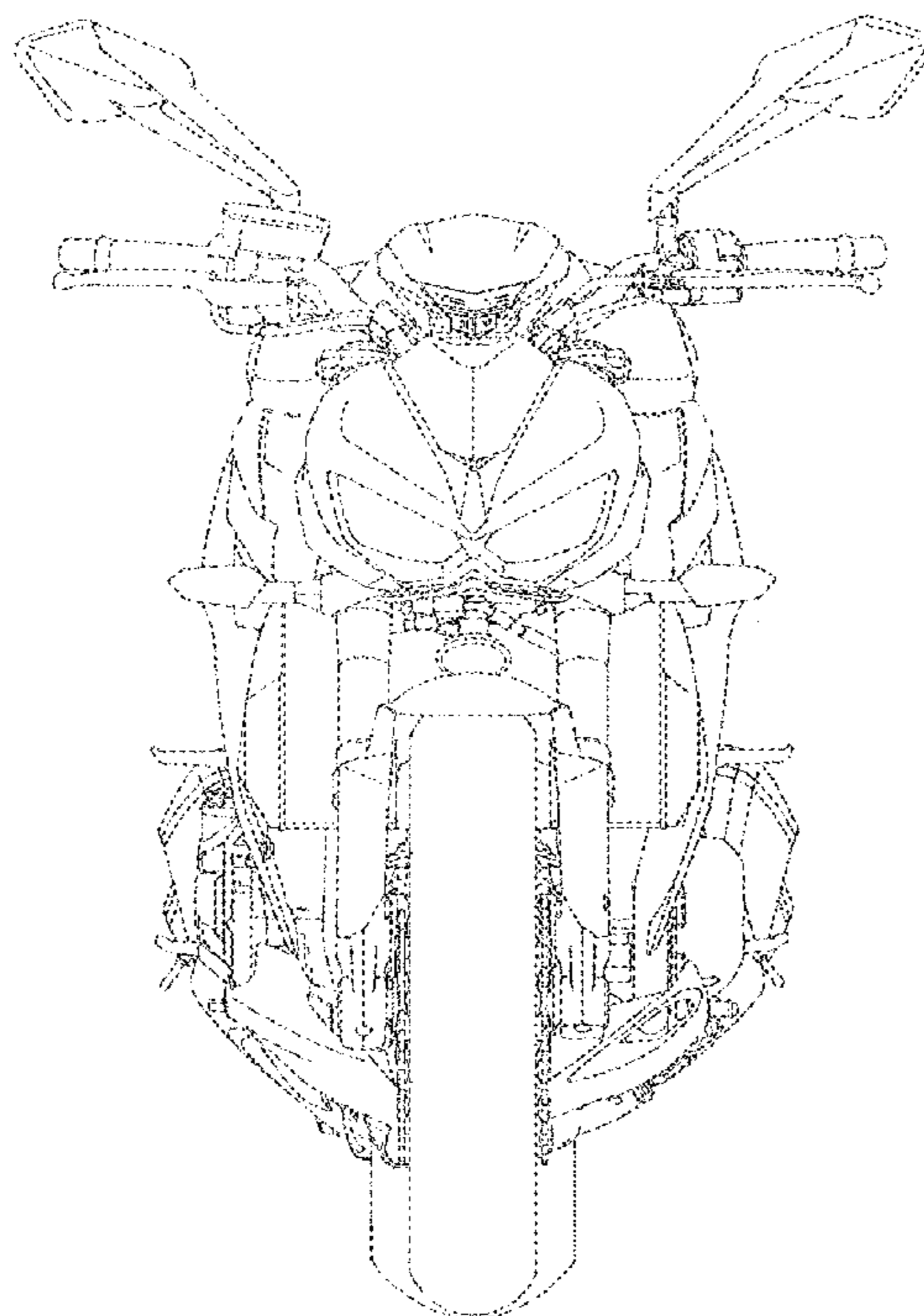
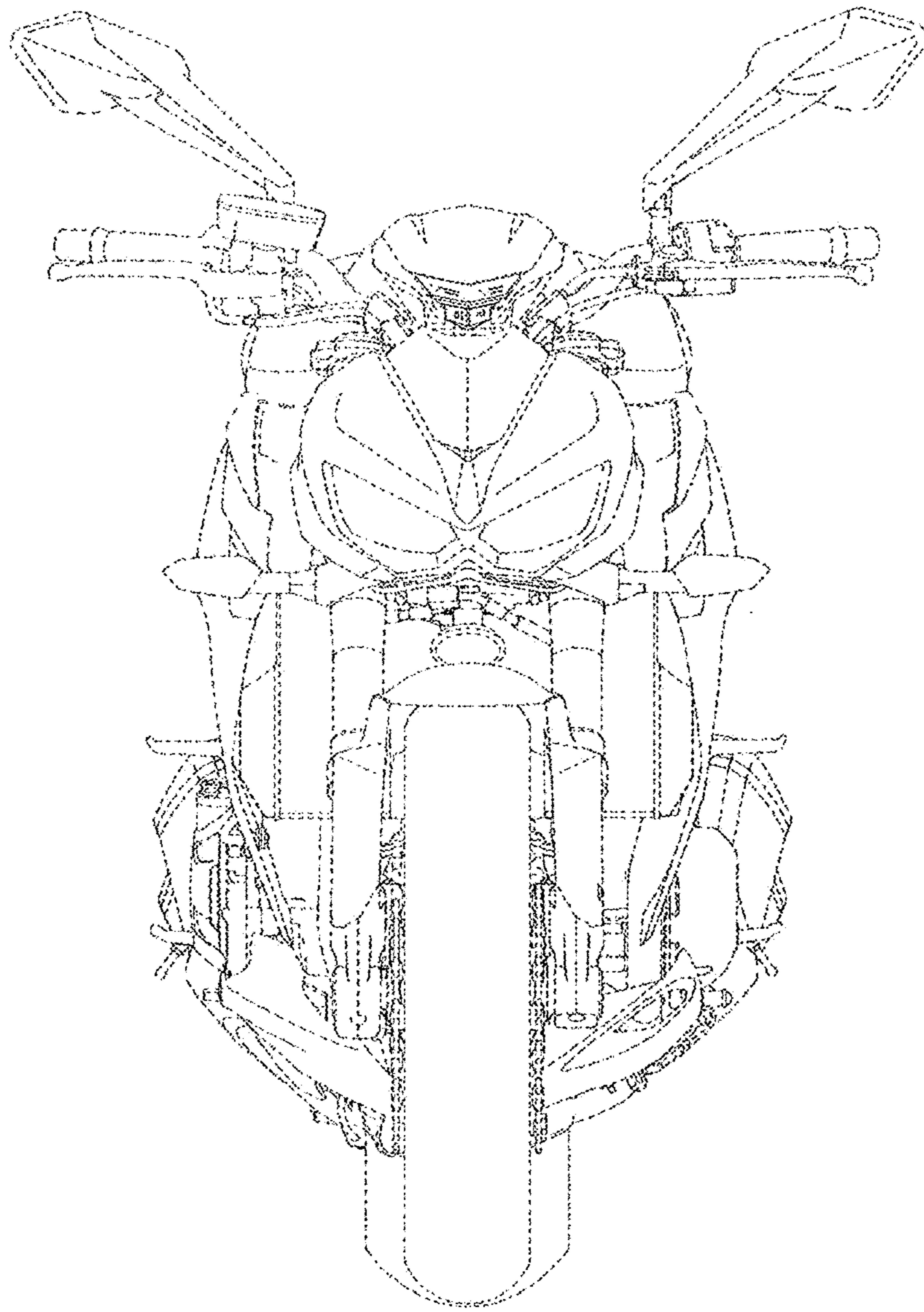

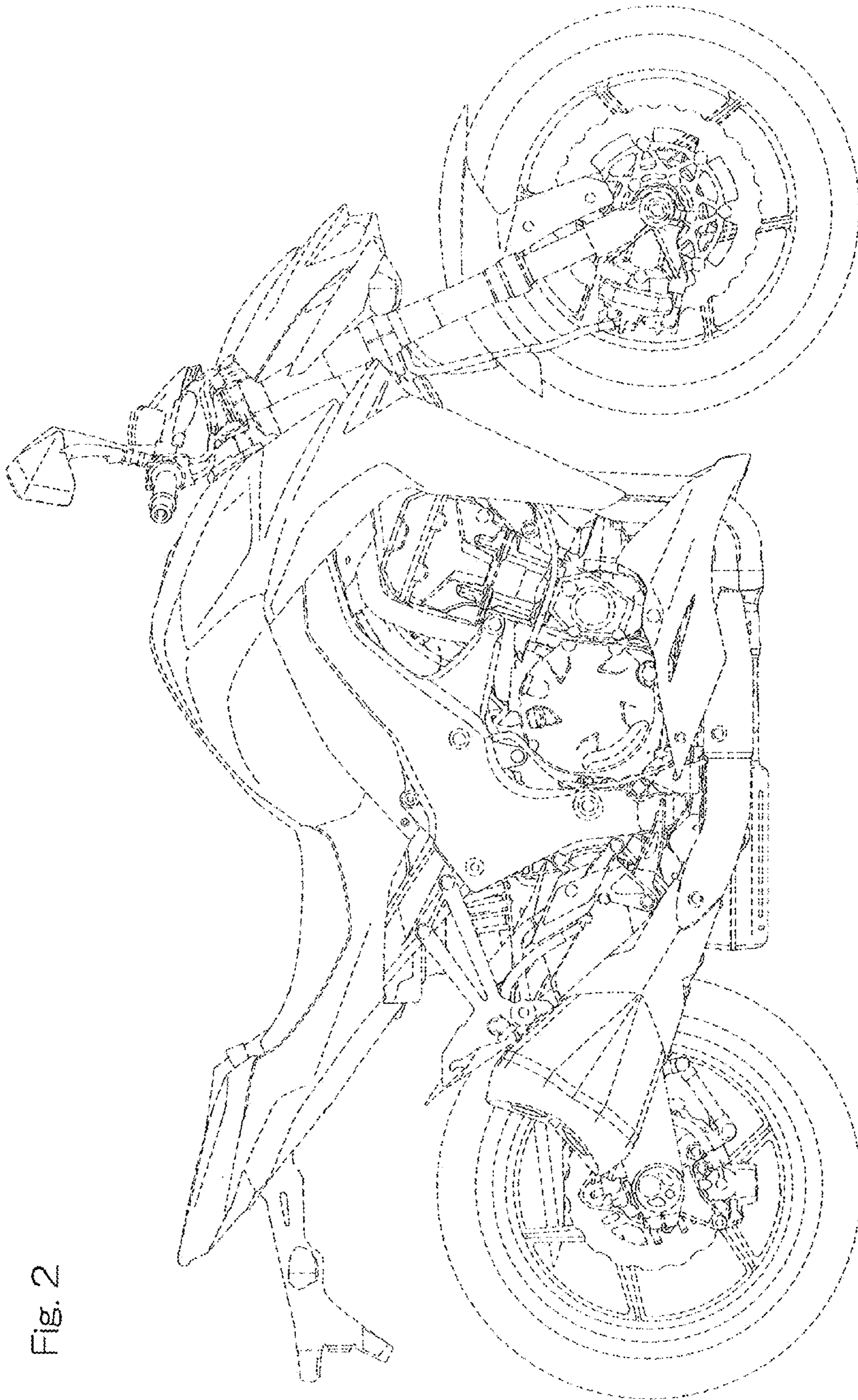

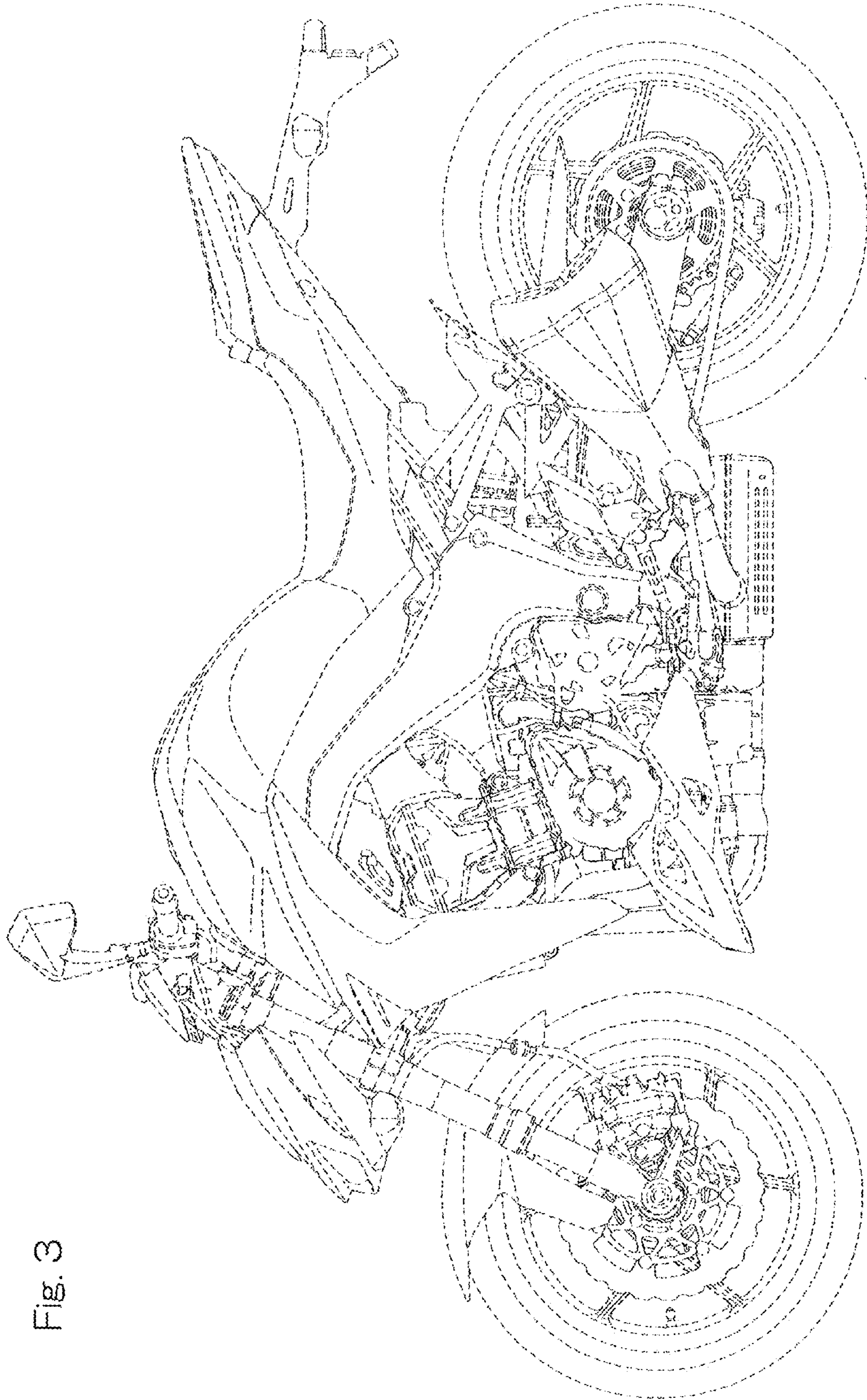
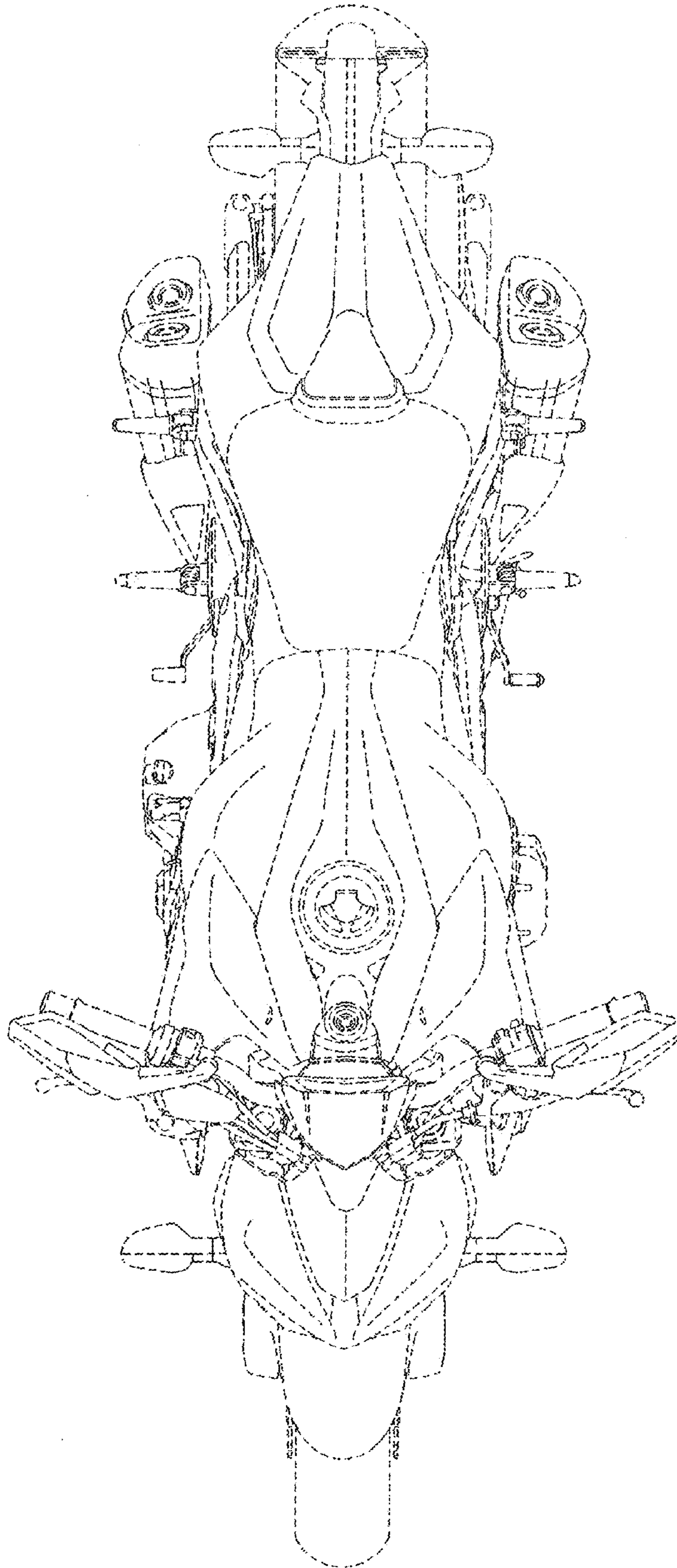

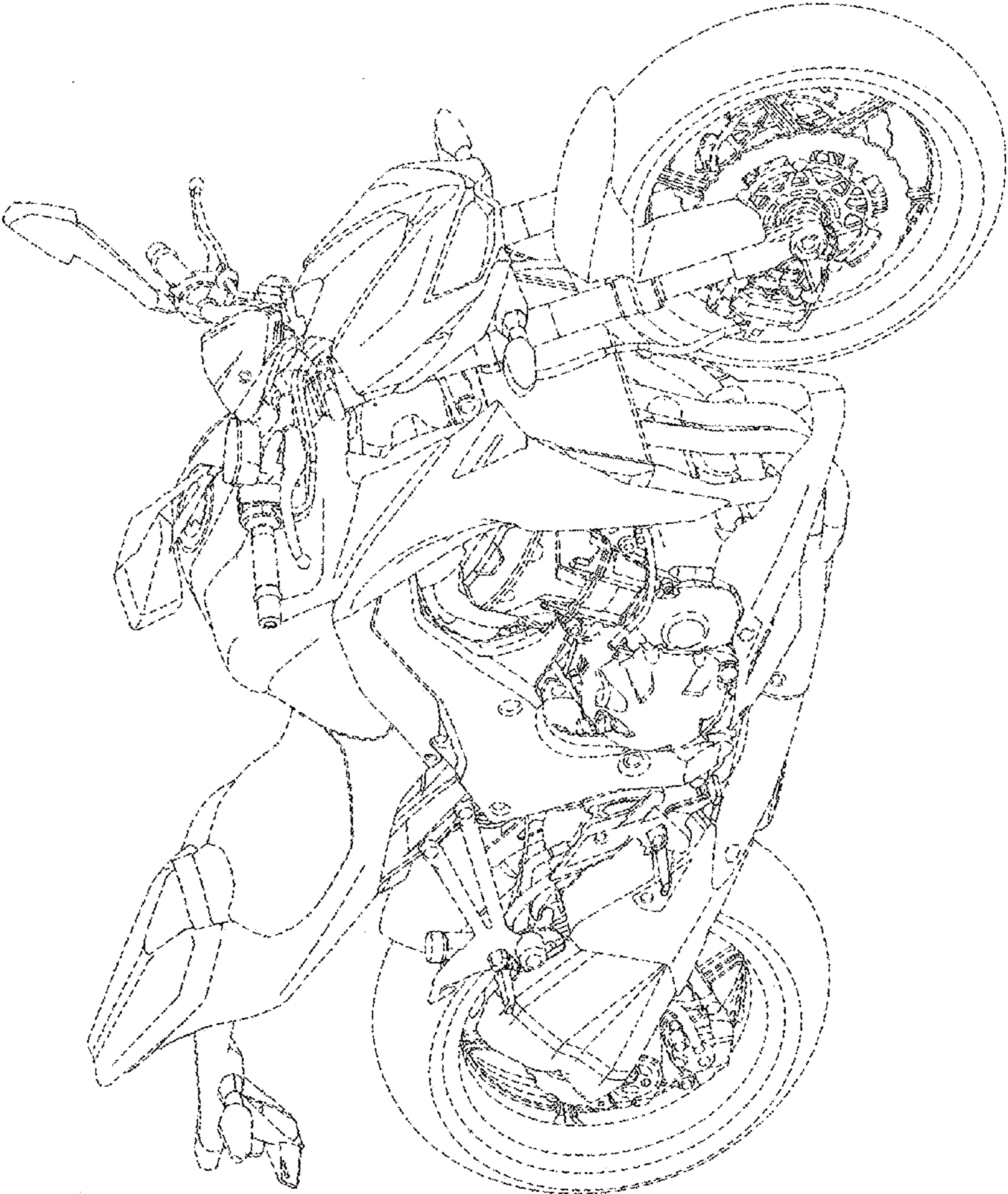
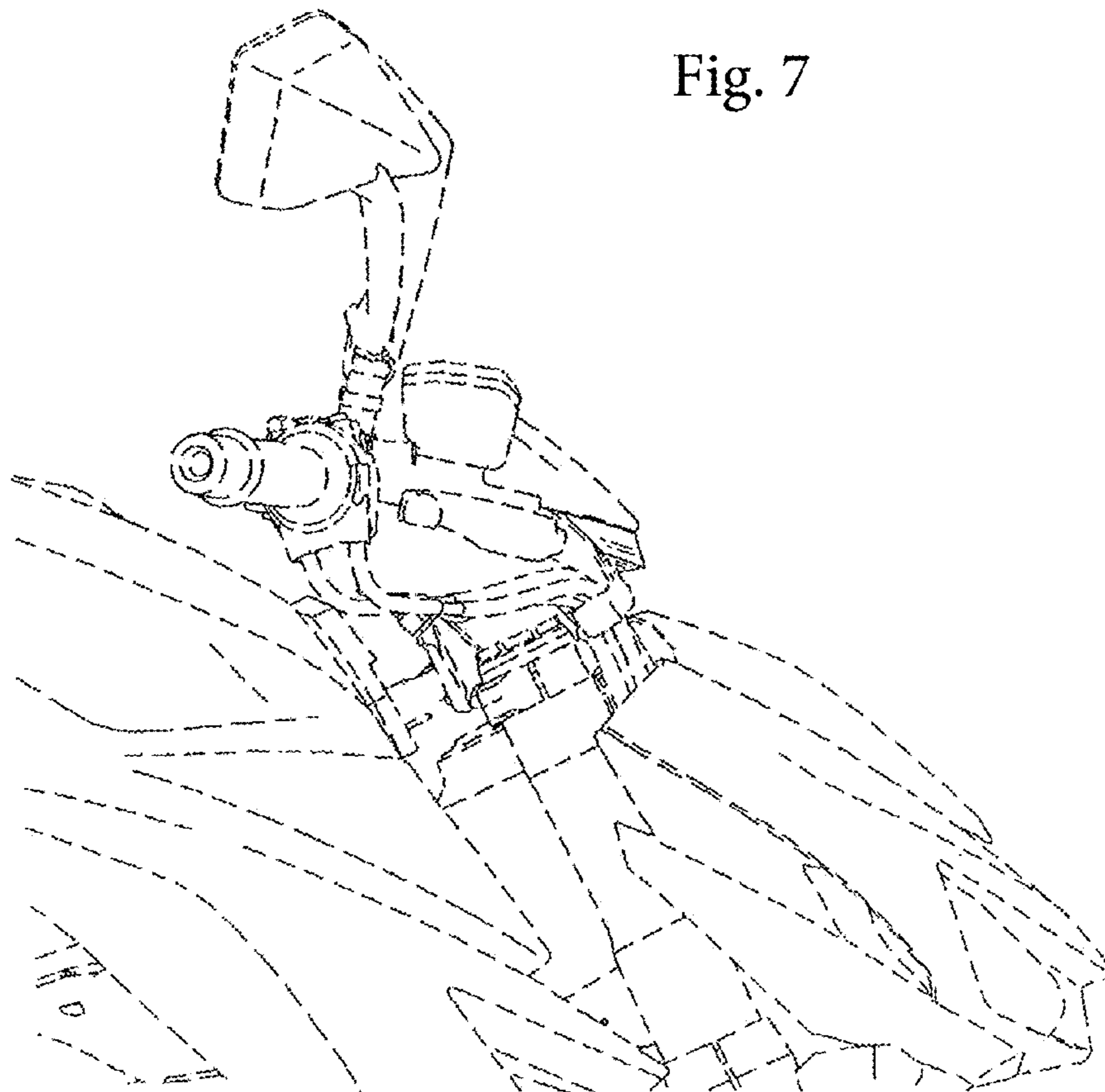
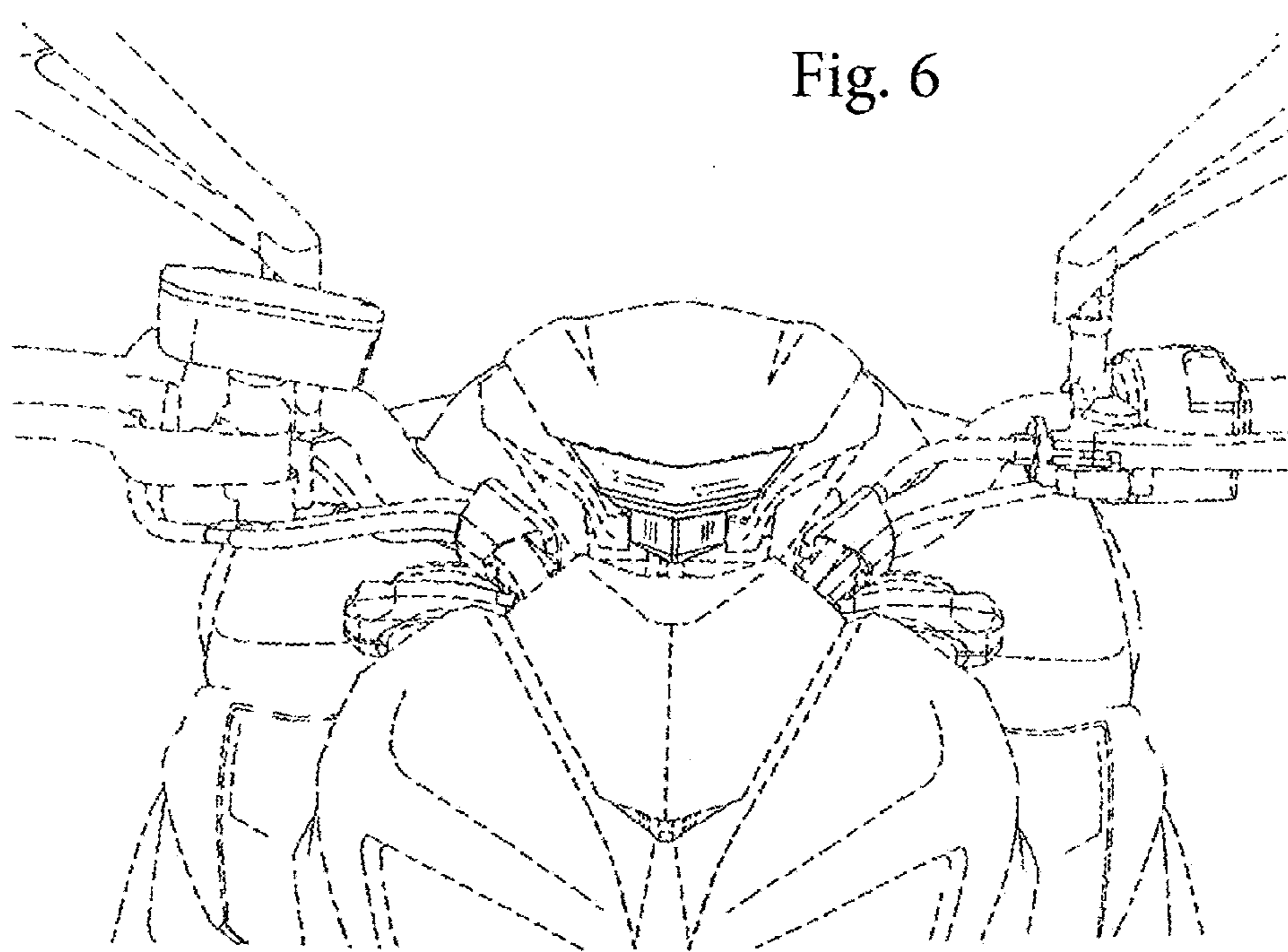

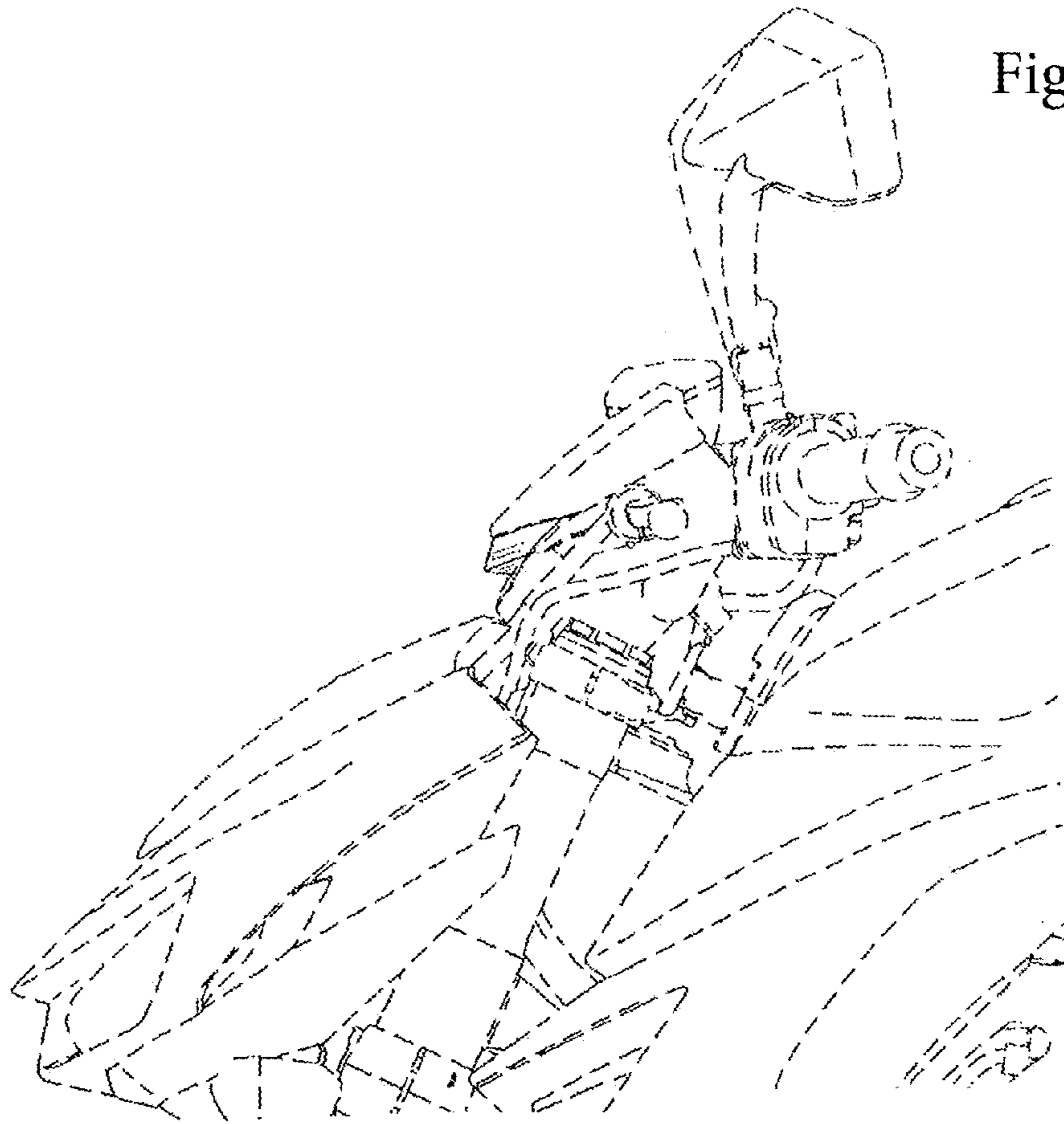

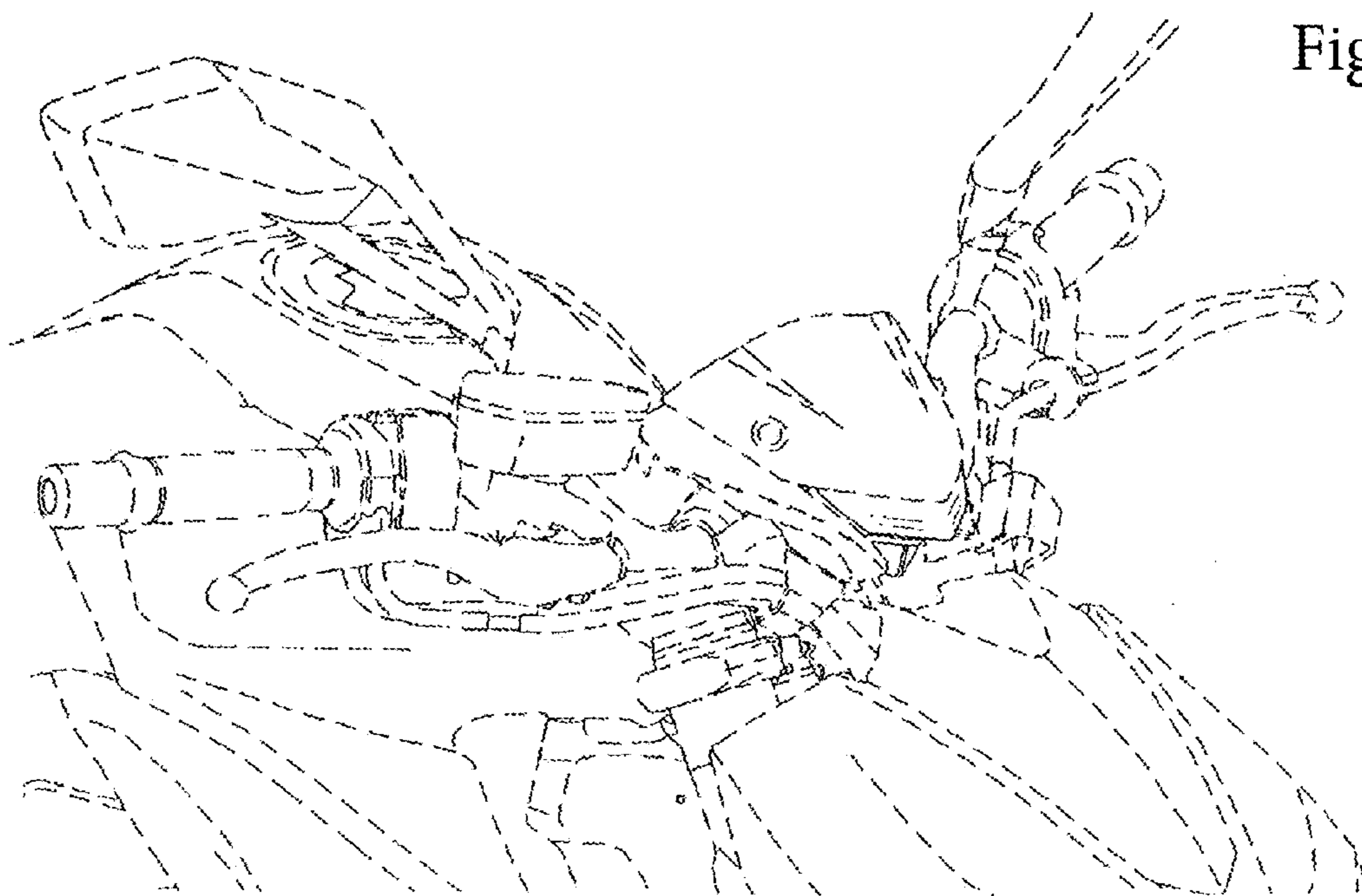
