(57) **CLAIM**

An ornamental design for a display device with initiating transfer animation for a user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view of the design at a first page according to the invention.

FIG. 2 is a view of the design transitioned from the first page to show a second page according to the invention.

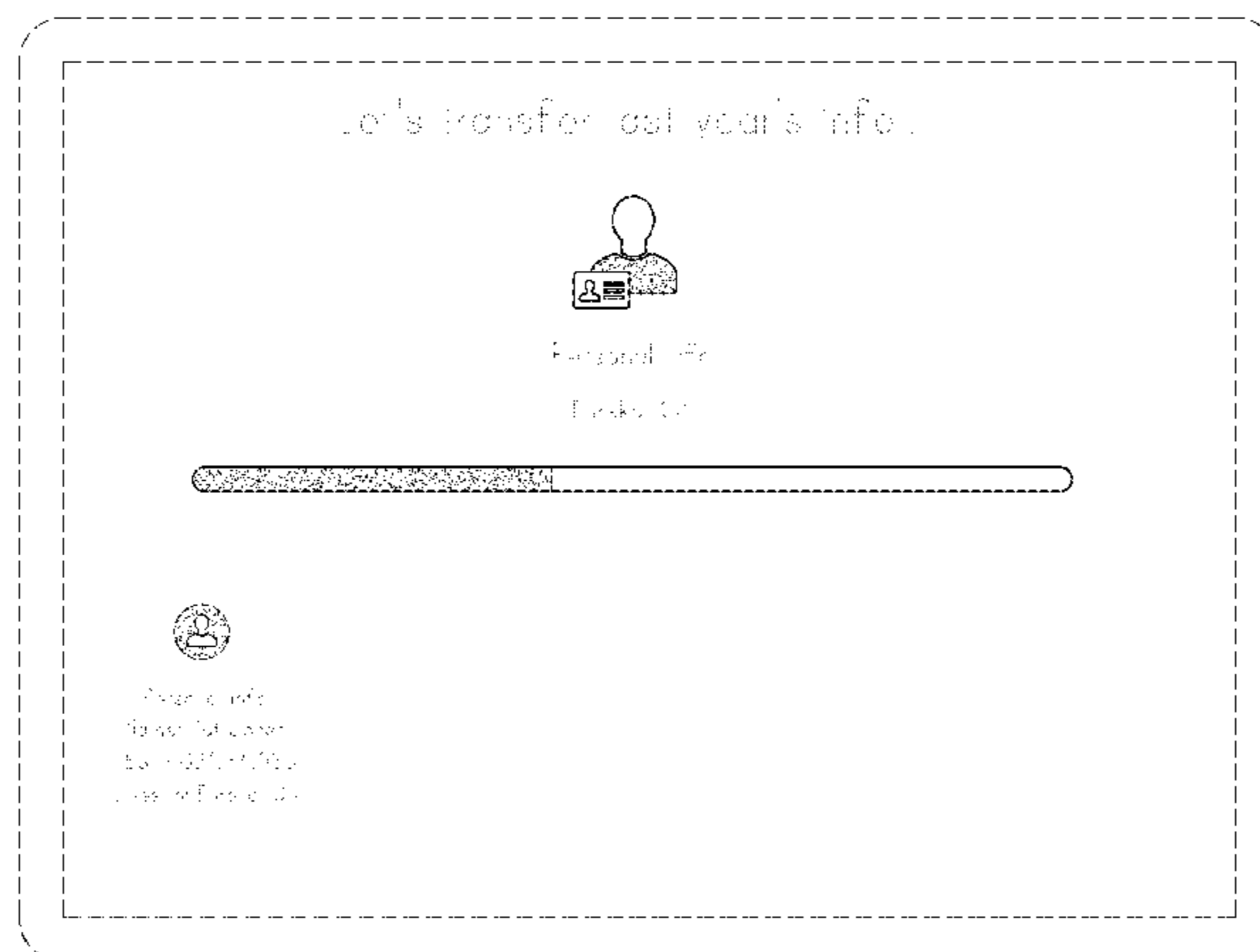
FIG. 3 is a view of the design transitioned from the second page to show a third page according to the invention; and, FIG. 4 is a view of the design transitioned from the third page to show a fourth page according to the invention.

The broken line showing of the electronic device and display screen is for the purpose of illustrating environment and forms no part of the claimed design.

The broken line showing of elements, including text, on the display screen illustrate portions of the article and form no part of the claimed design.

The appearance of the transitional image sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, and 4. The process or period in which one image transitions to another image forms no part of the claimed design.

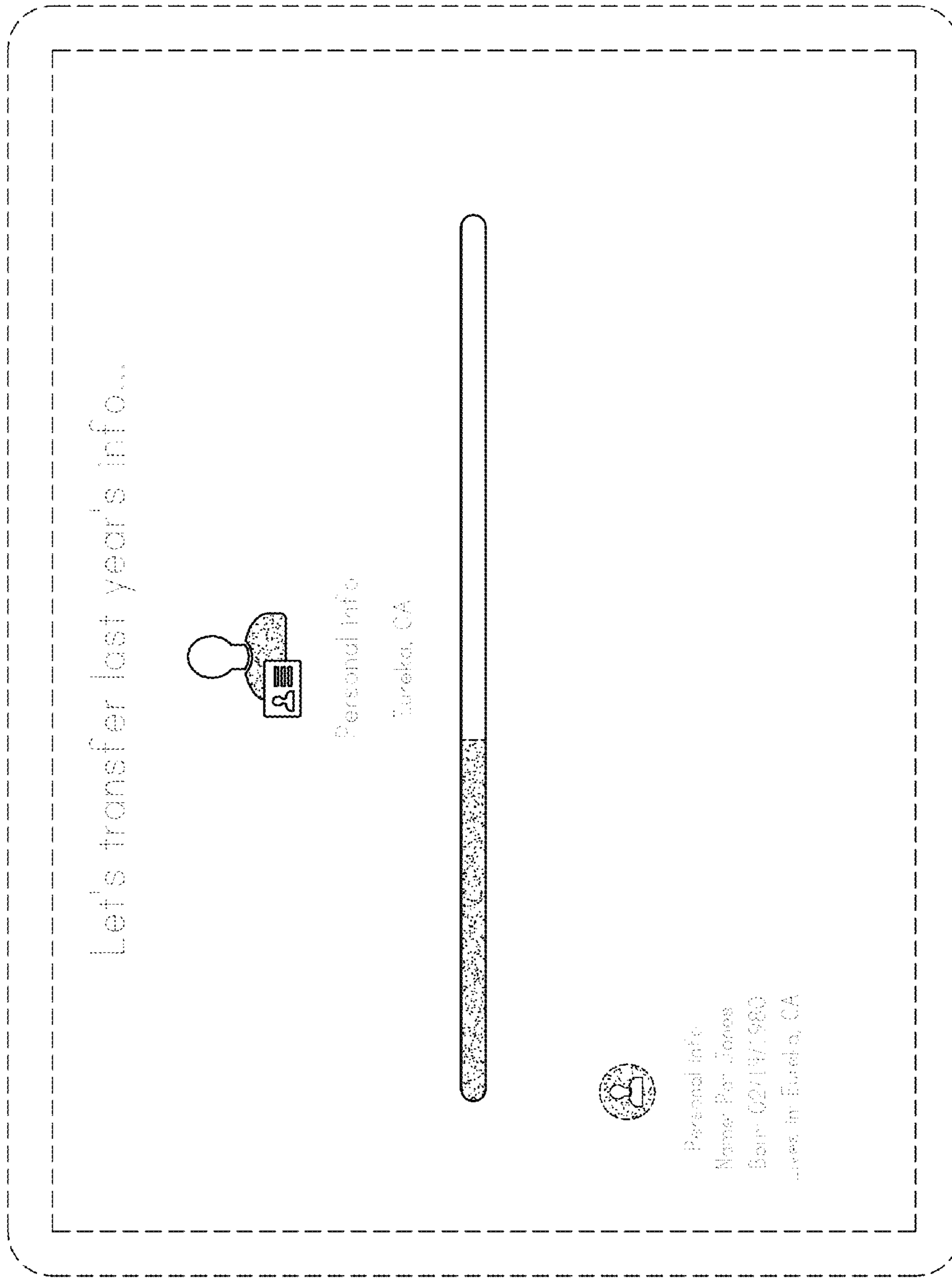

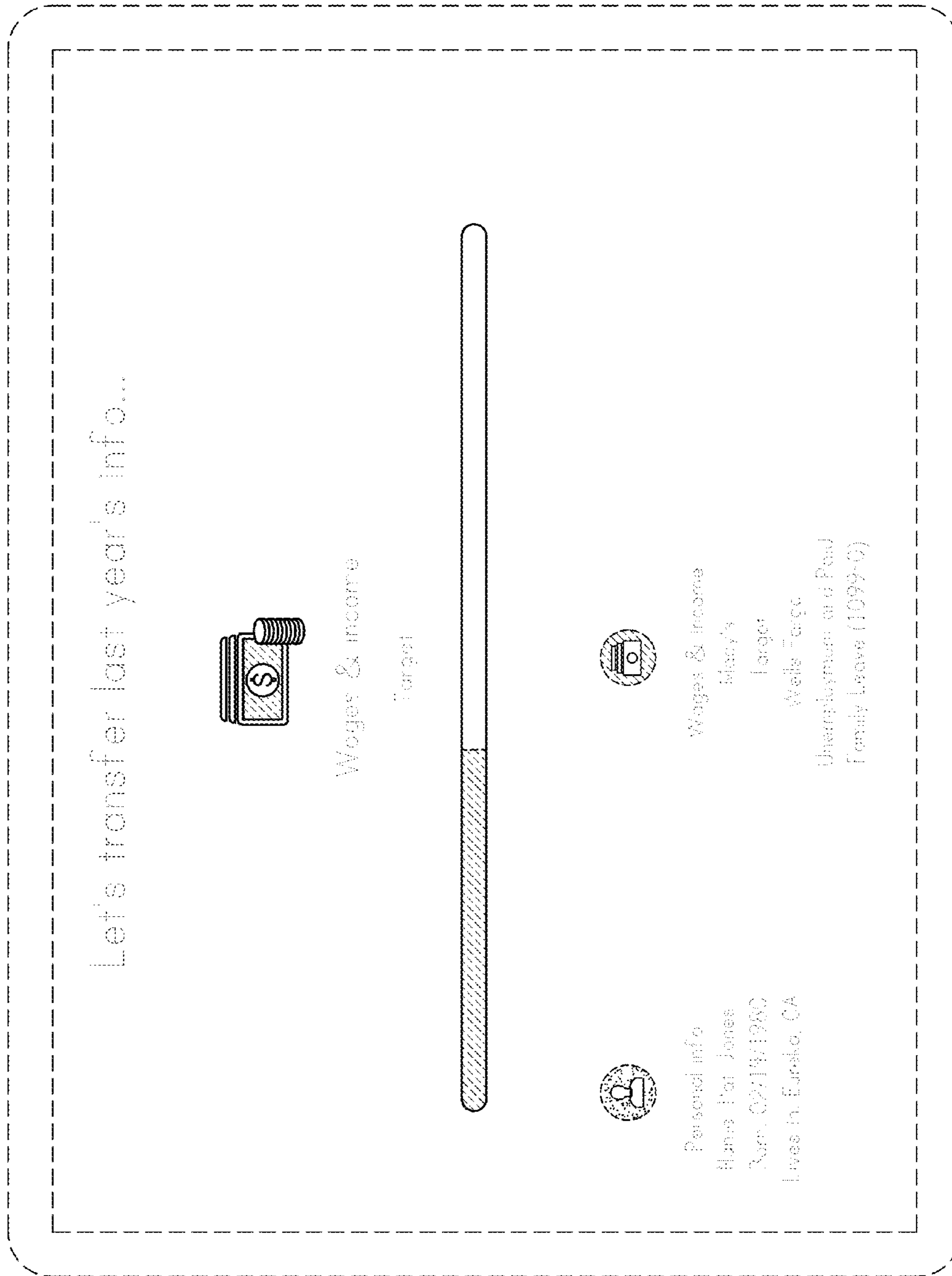

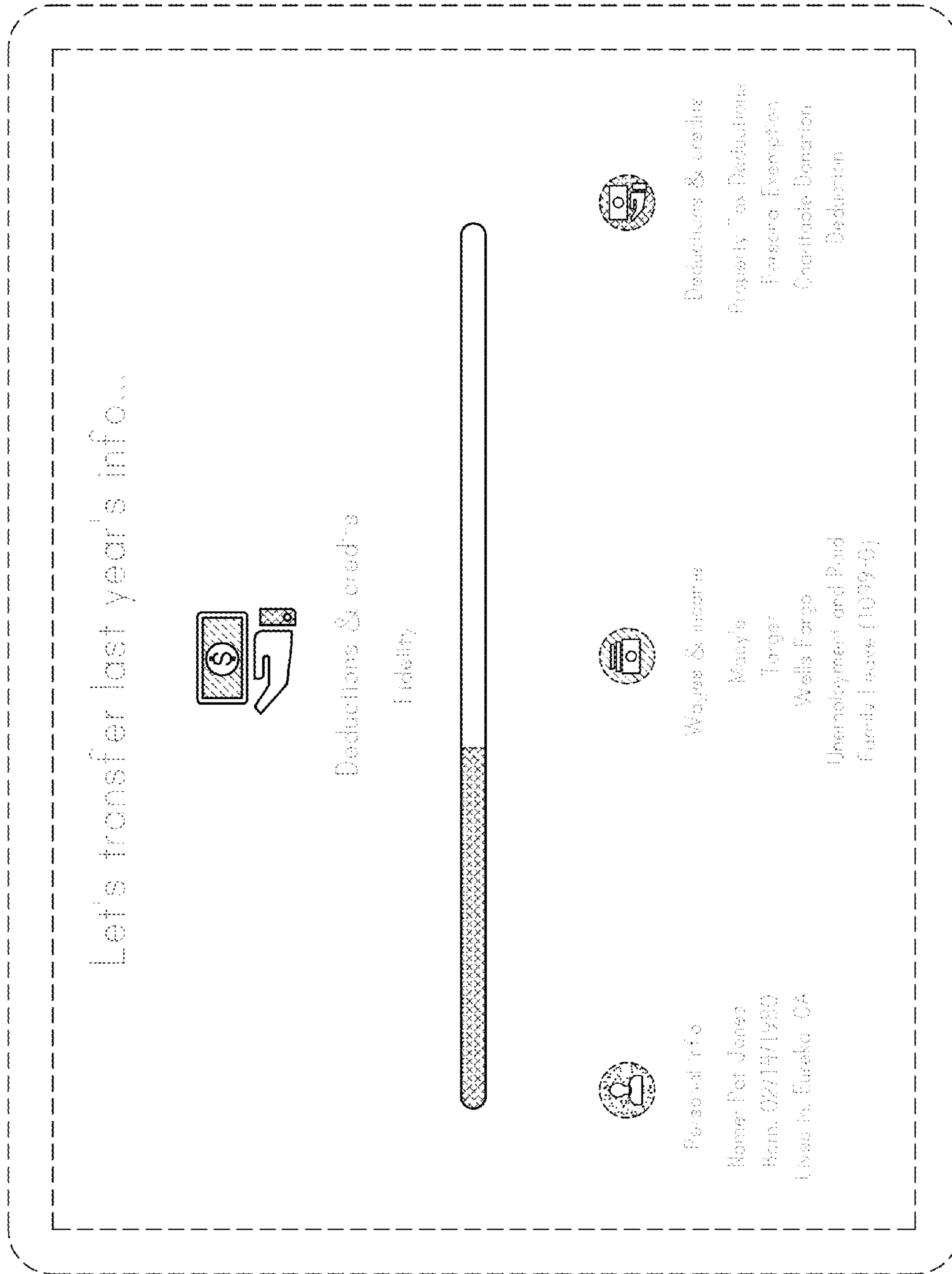

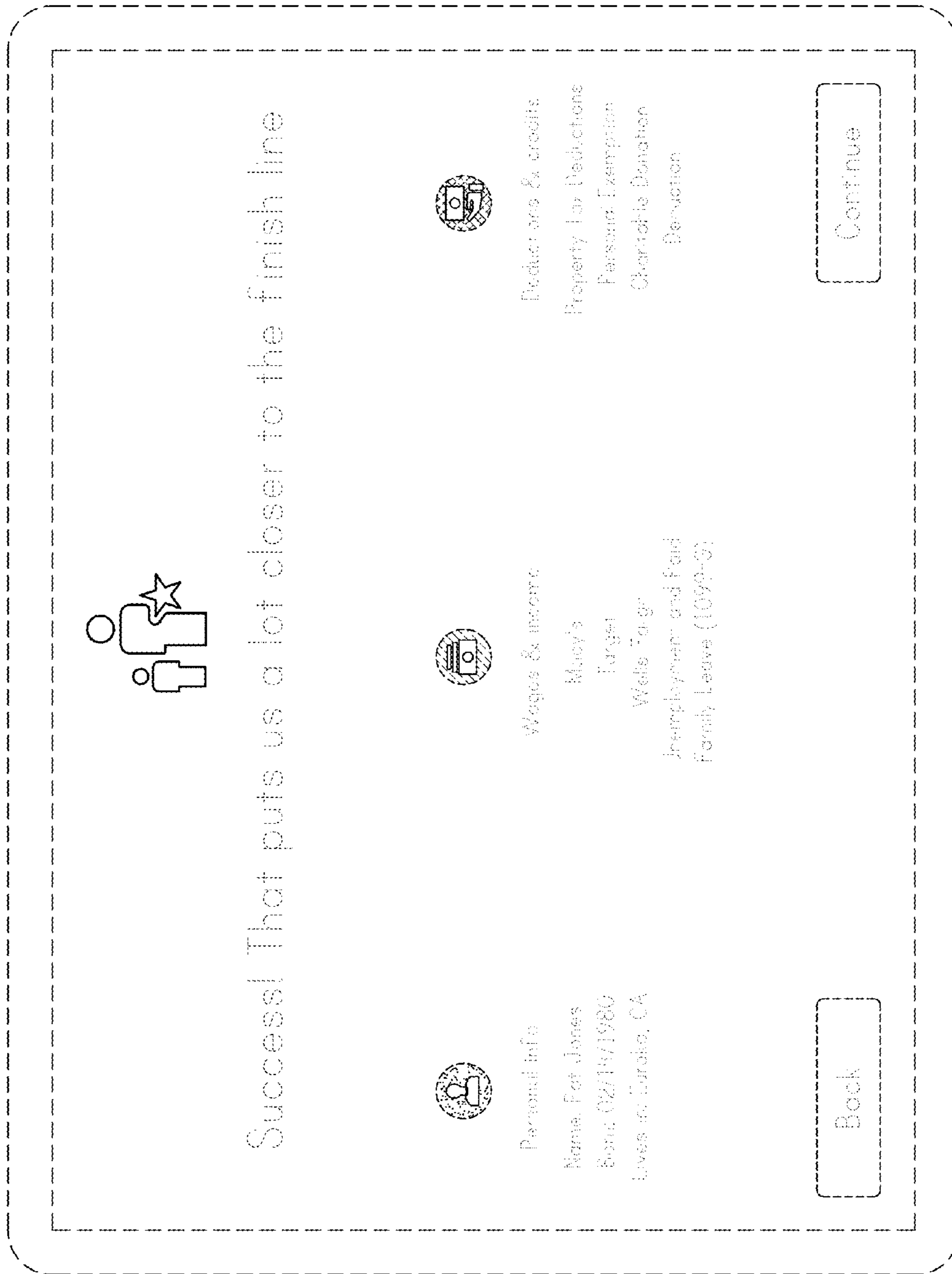
