FIG. 4 is a left view thereof;

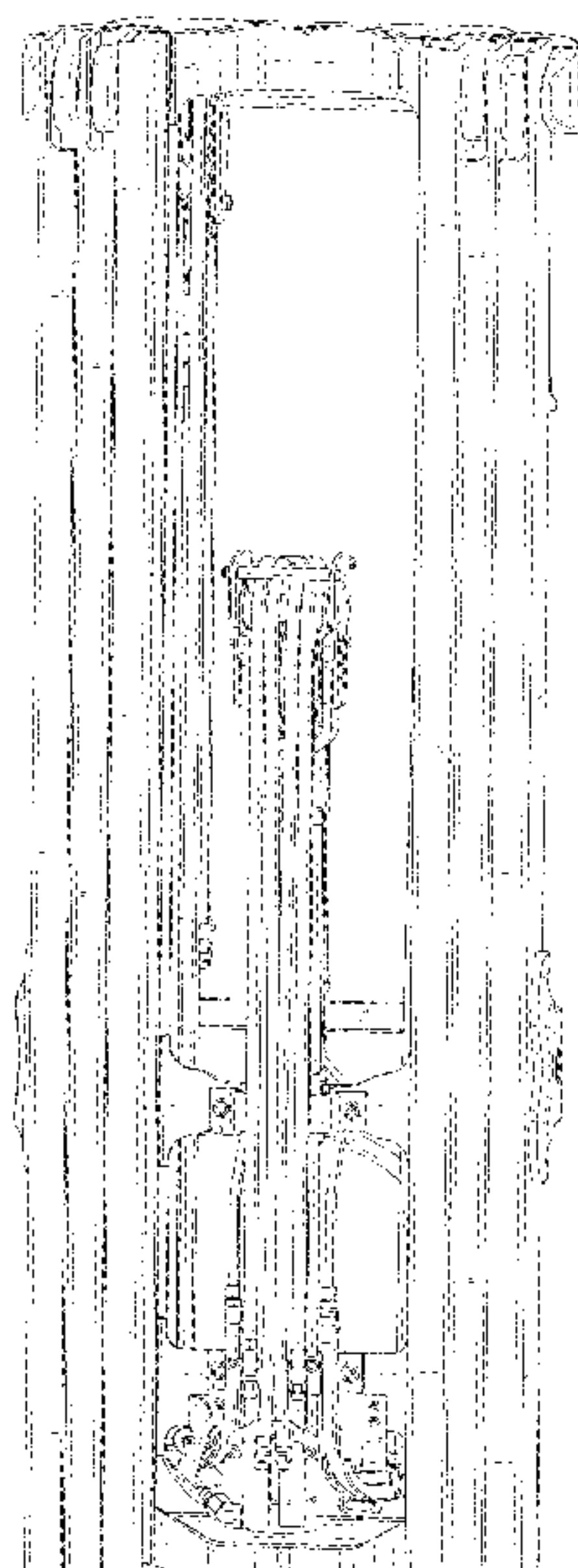
FIG. 5 is a right view thereof;

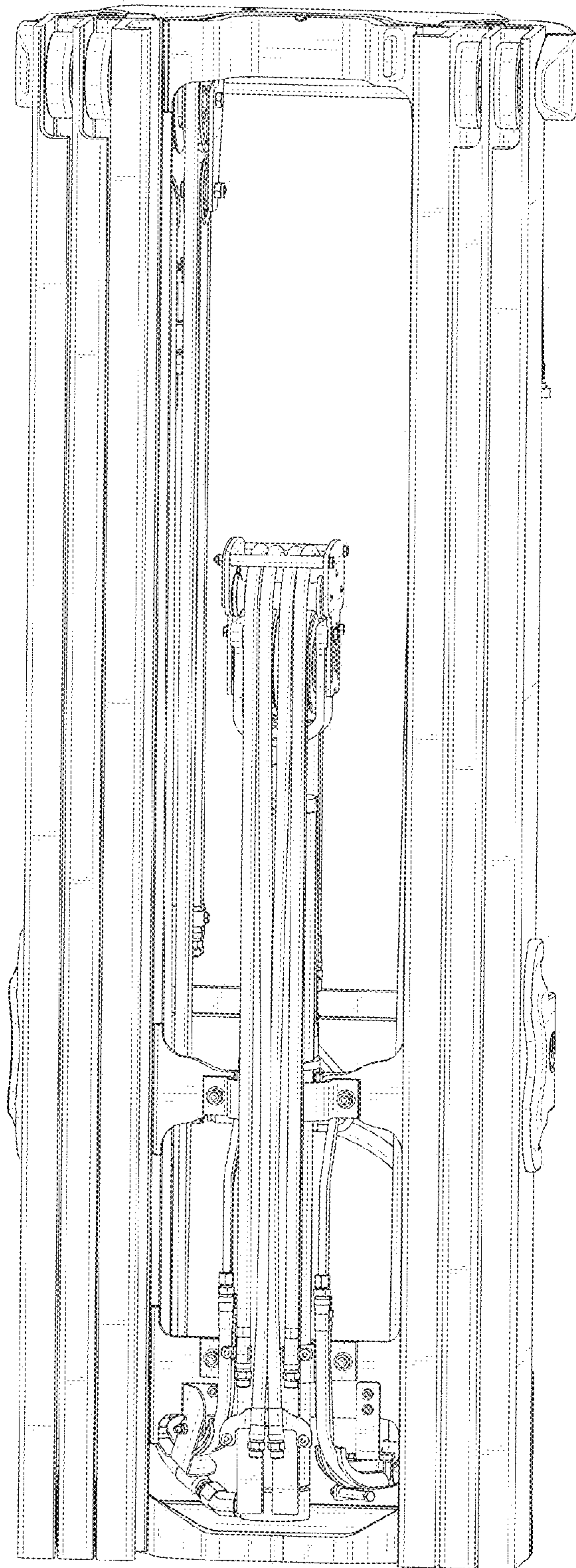

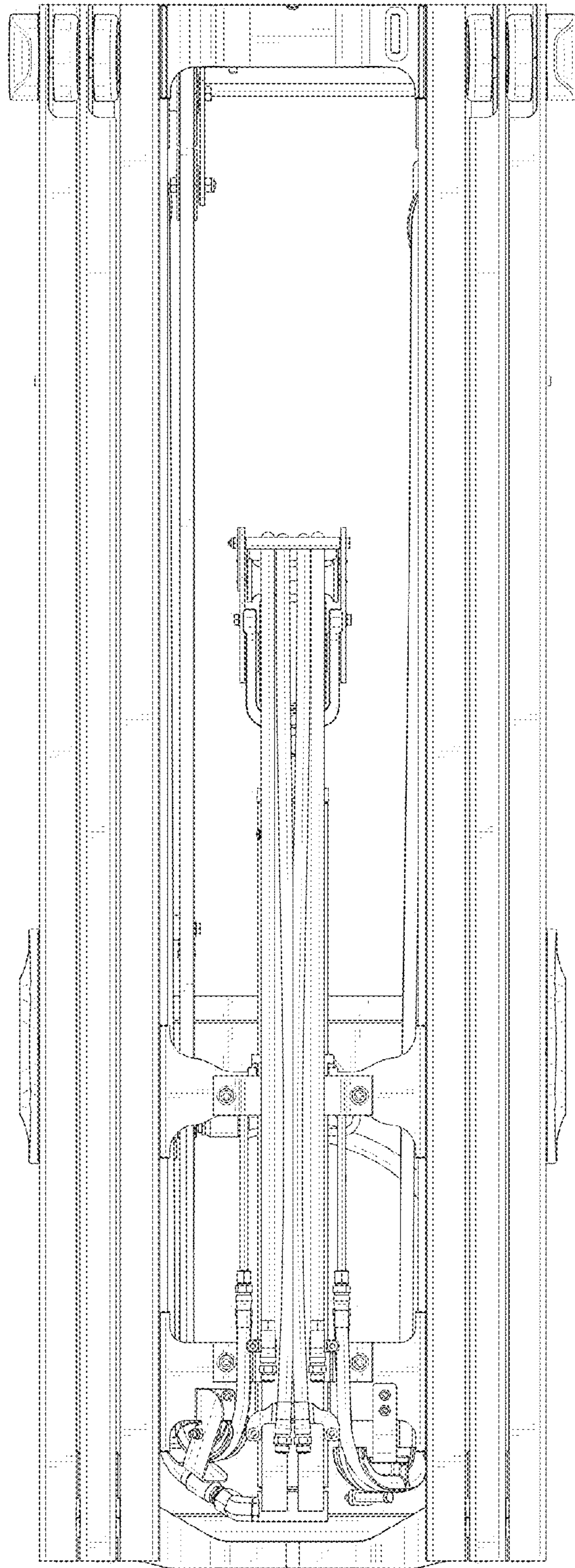

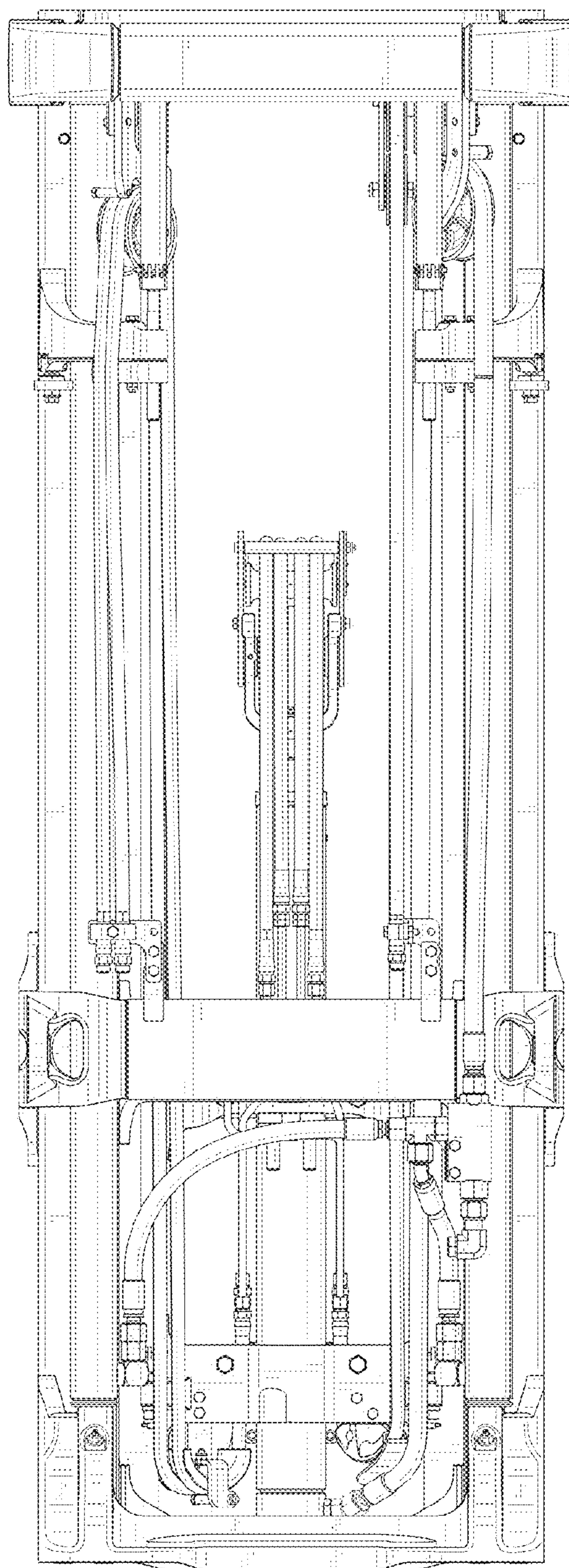

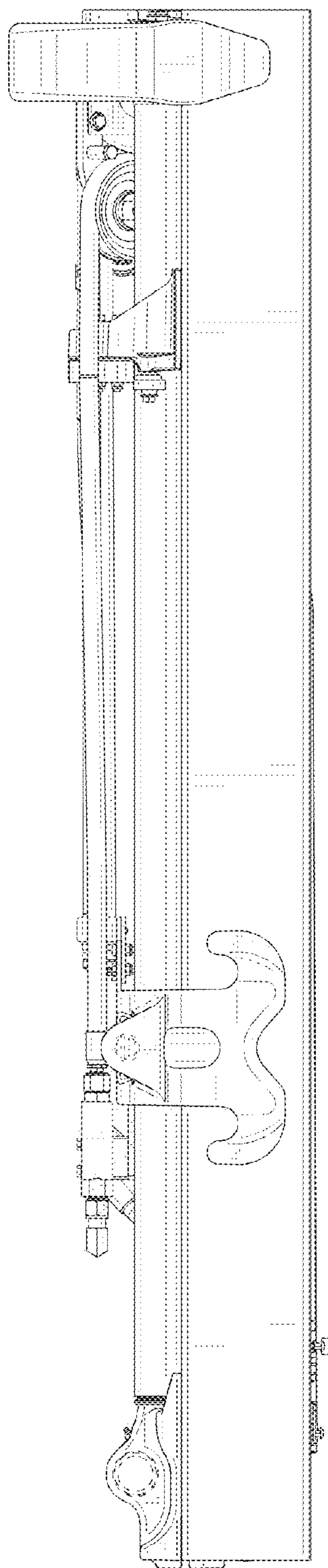

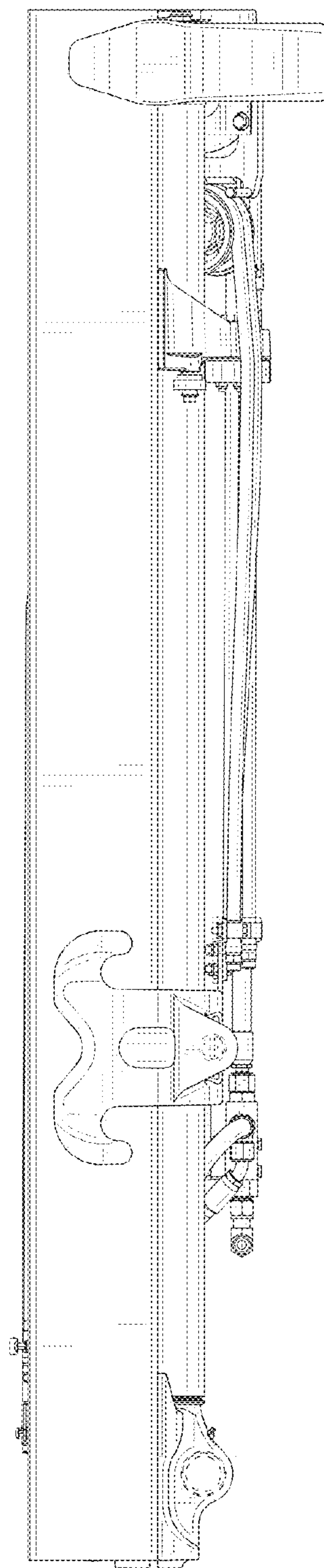

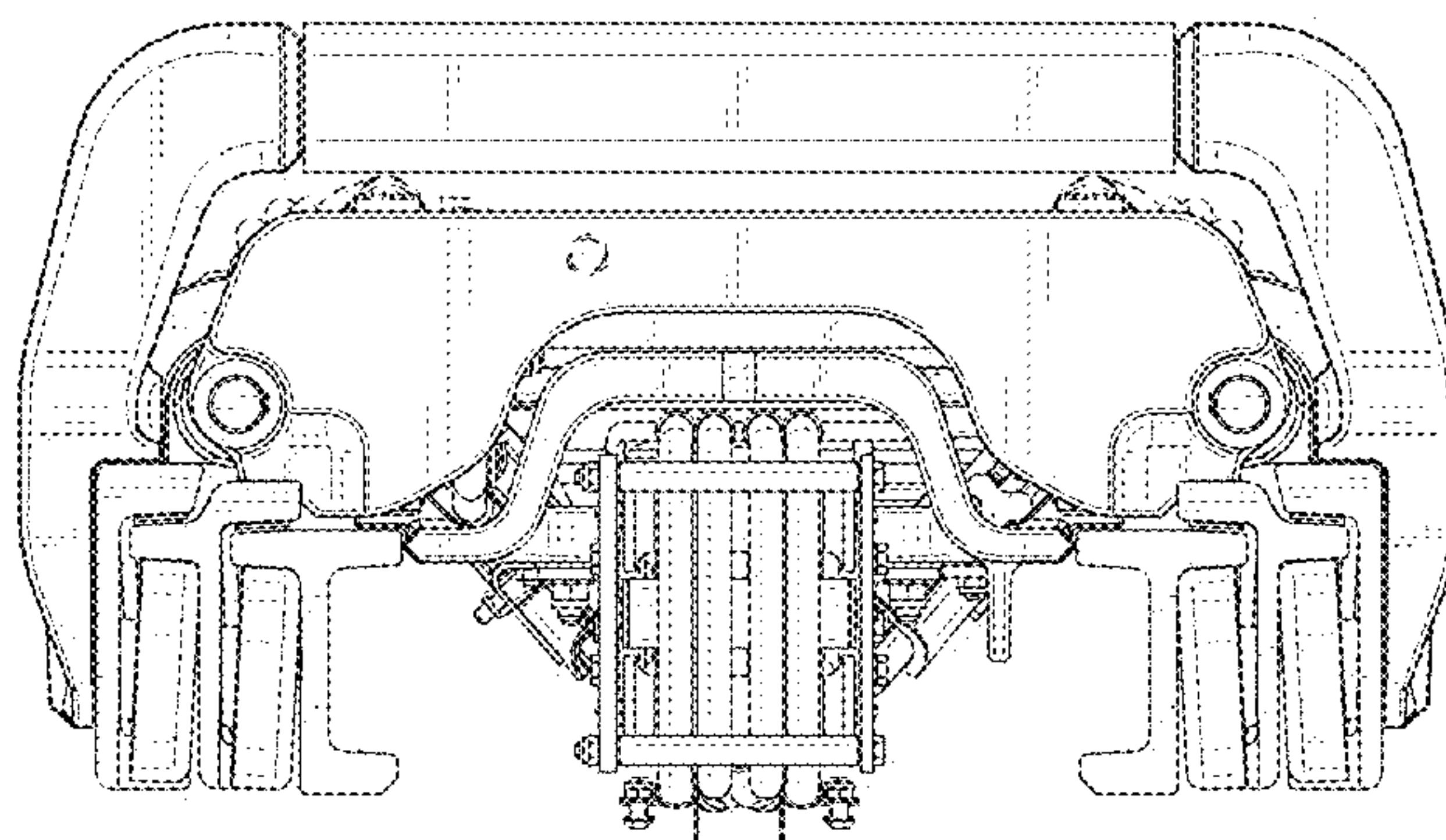

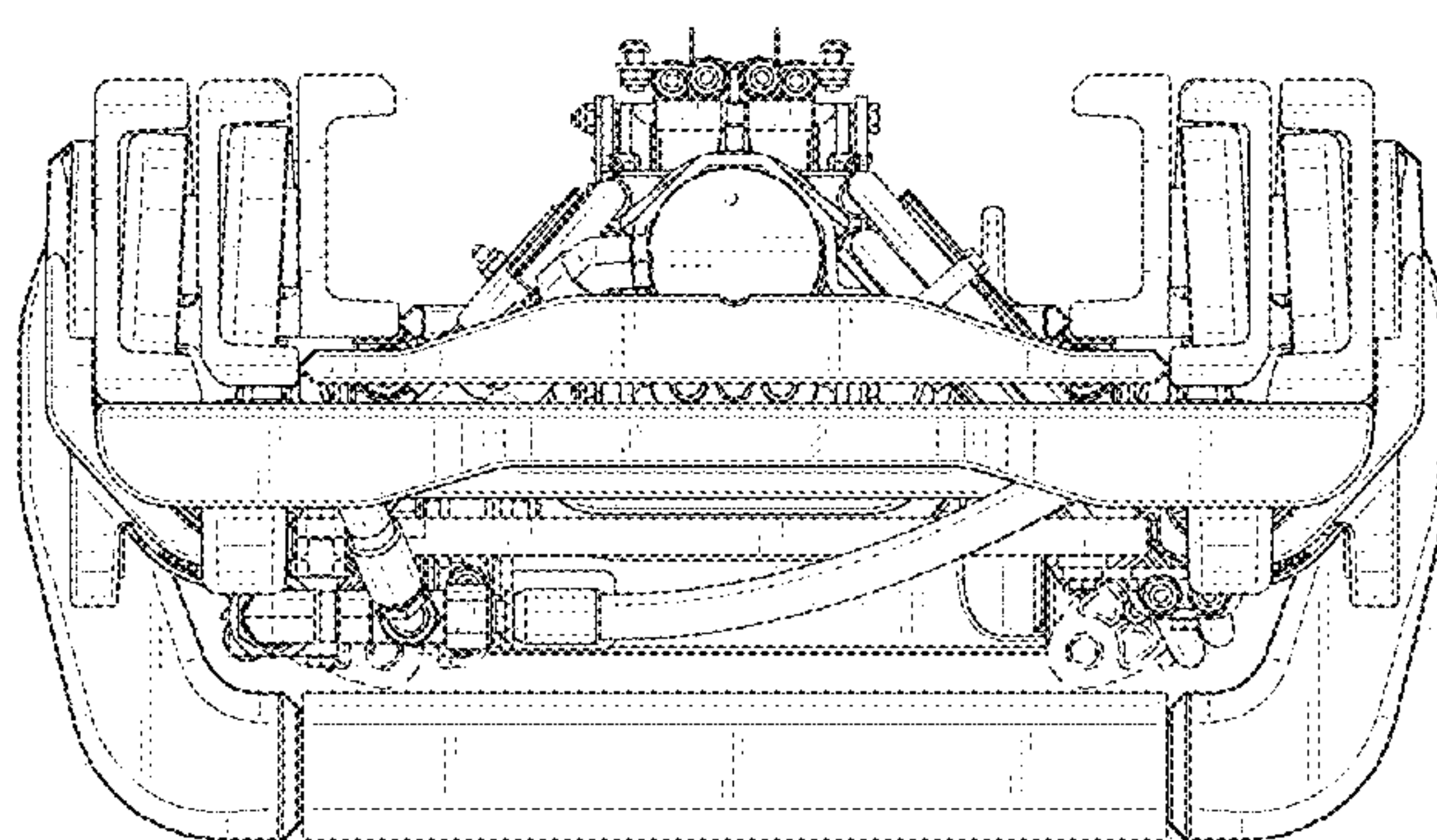
