The ornamental design for a shirt, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a shirt showing my  
new design in an in-use configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

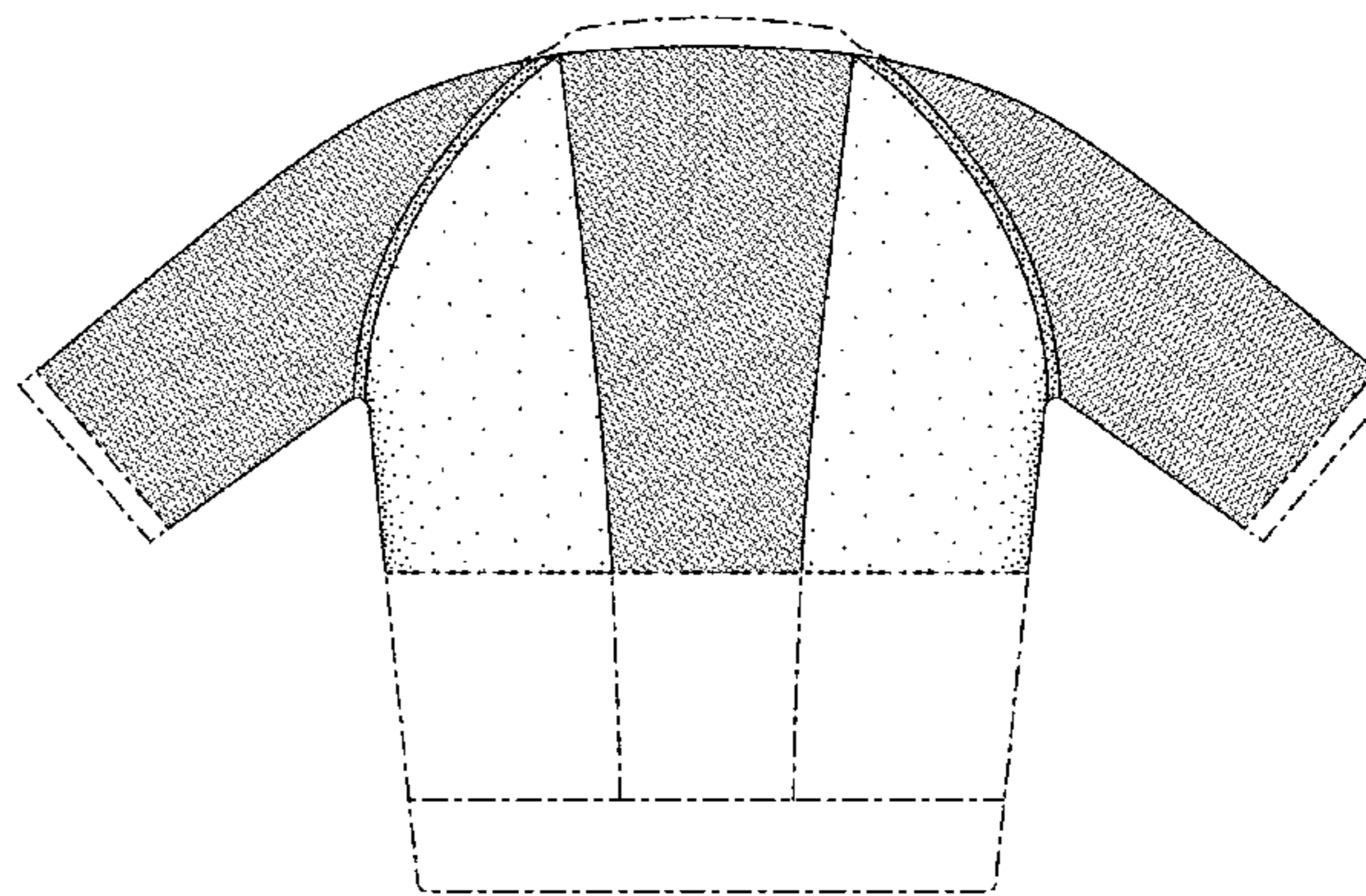
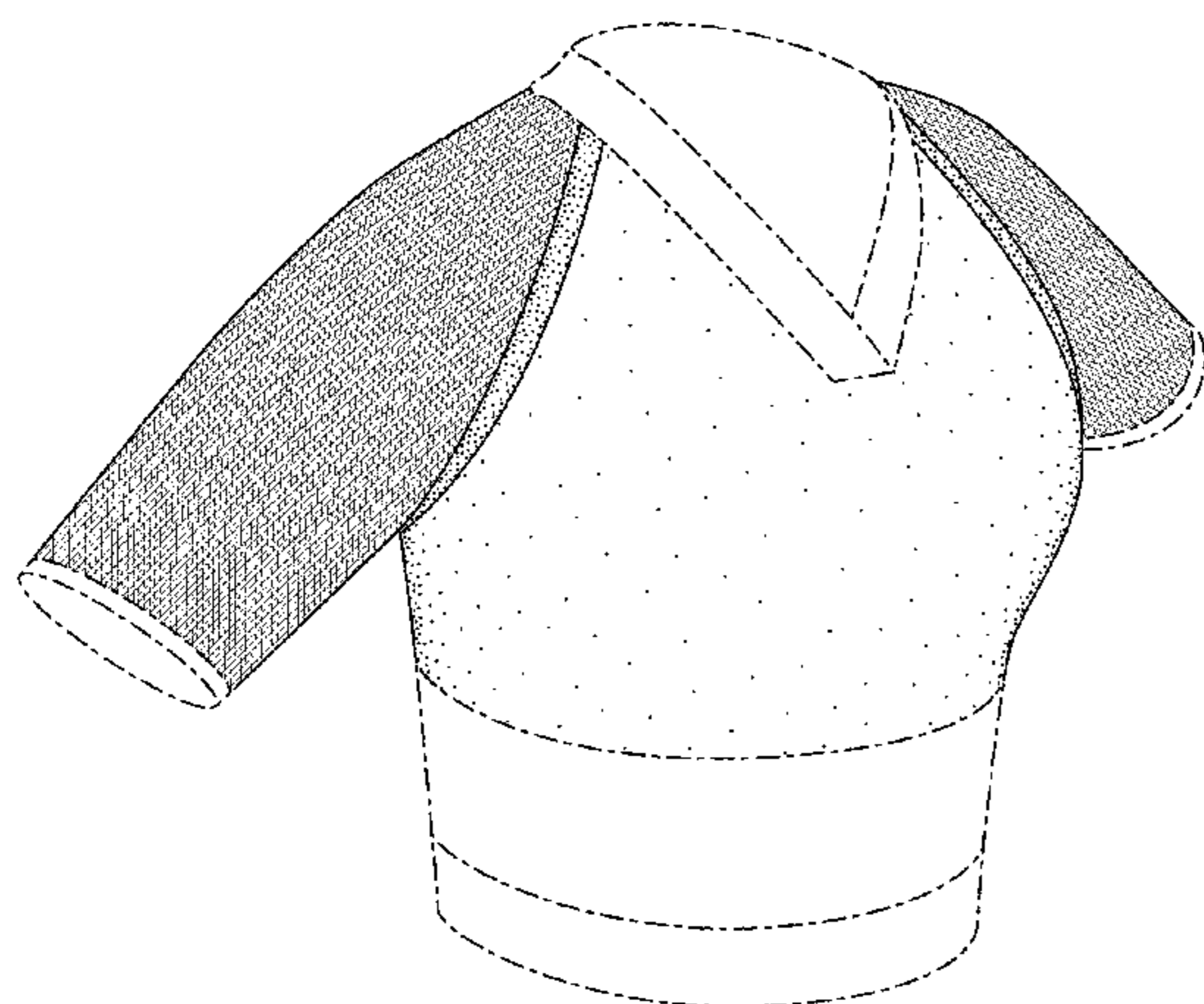
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

In the drawings, the hatched pattern represents the appear-  
ance of a diamond-shaped open mesh fabric. The broken  
lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area represent  
unclaimed boundaries of the design. The unshaded regions,  
demarcated by broken lines, represent unclaimed portions of  
the shirt and form no part of the claimed design. The contrast  
in stipple shading represents a contrast of appearance and  
does not represent any particular color, material or texture.

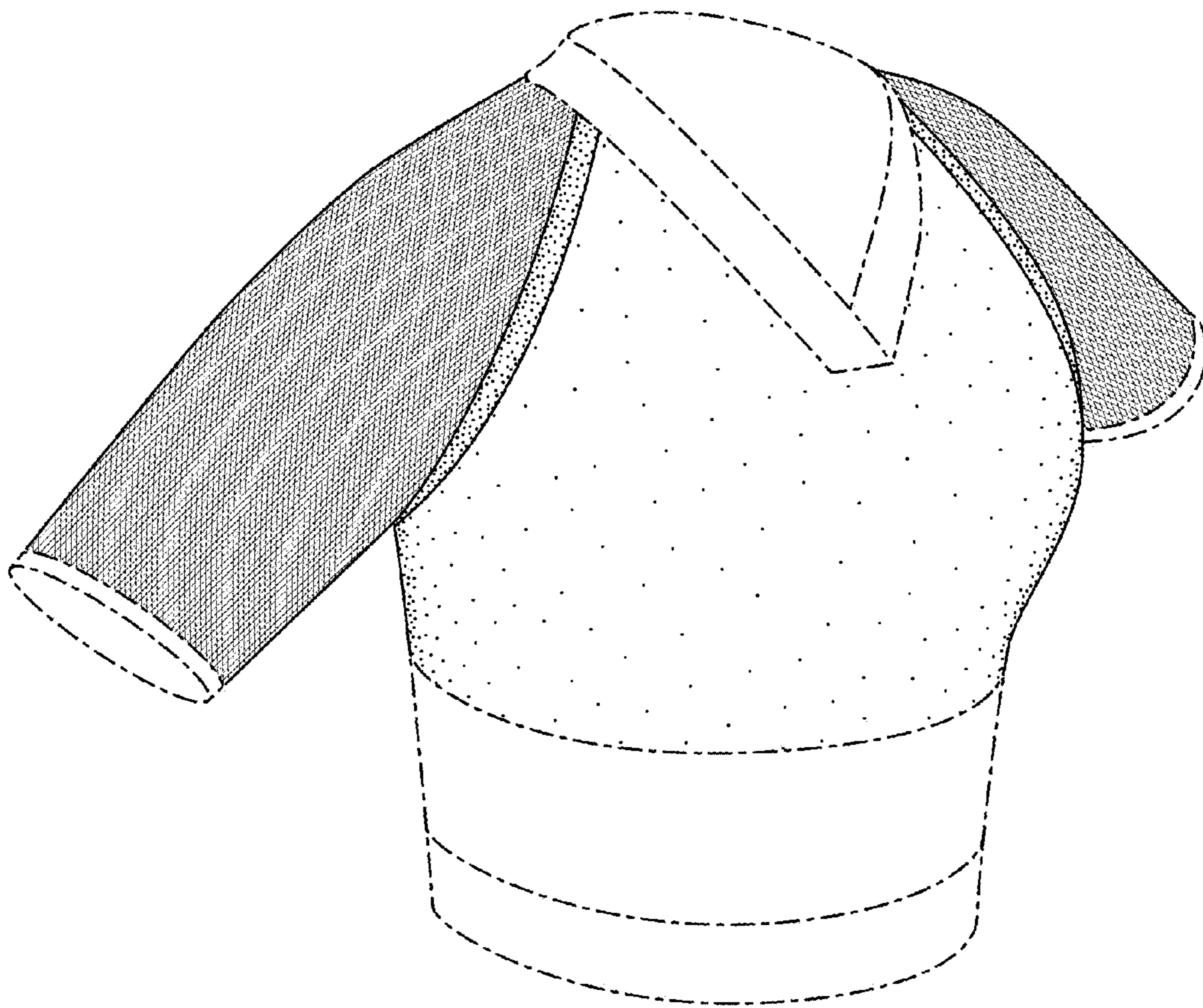

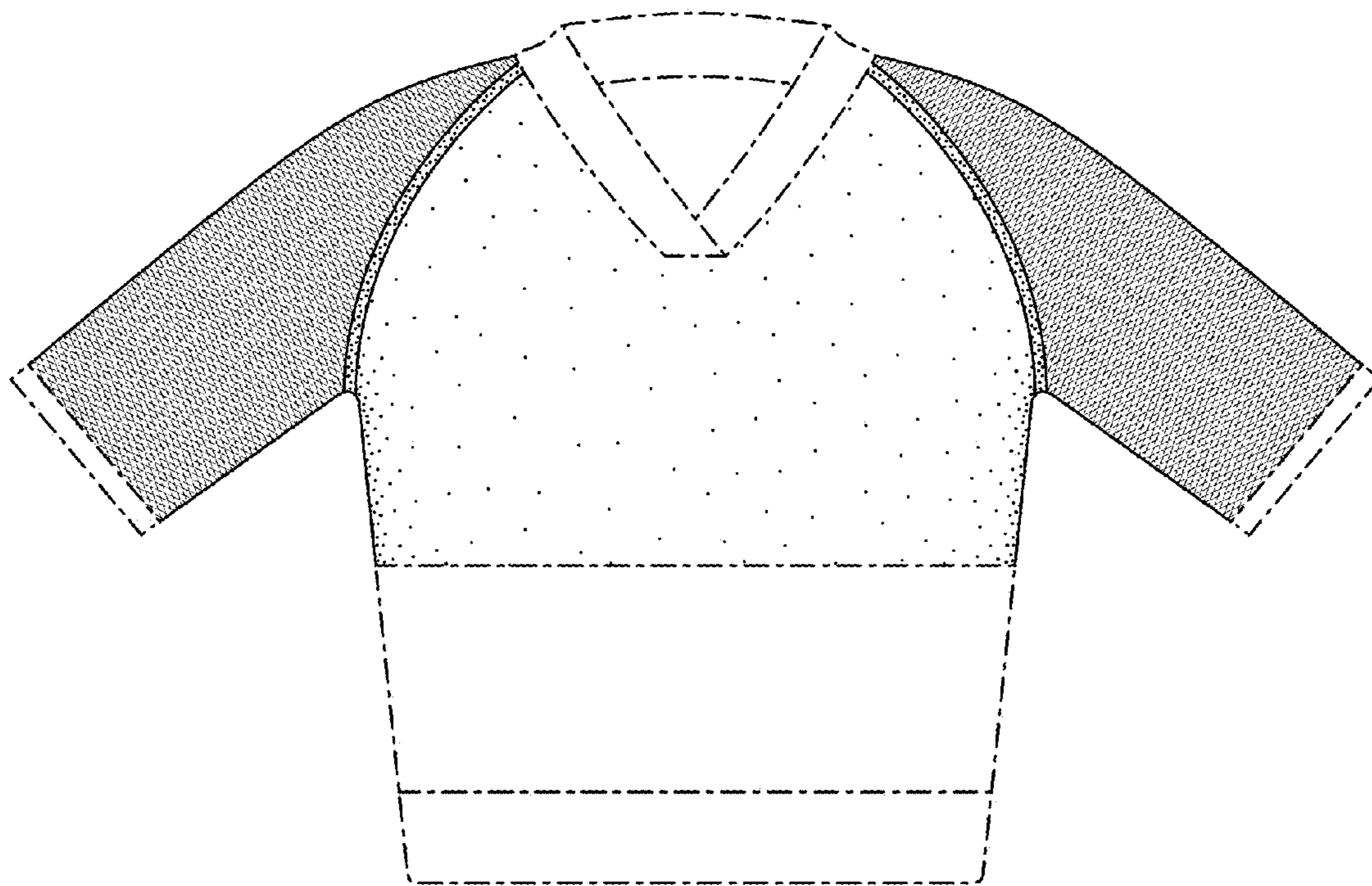

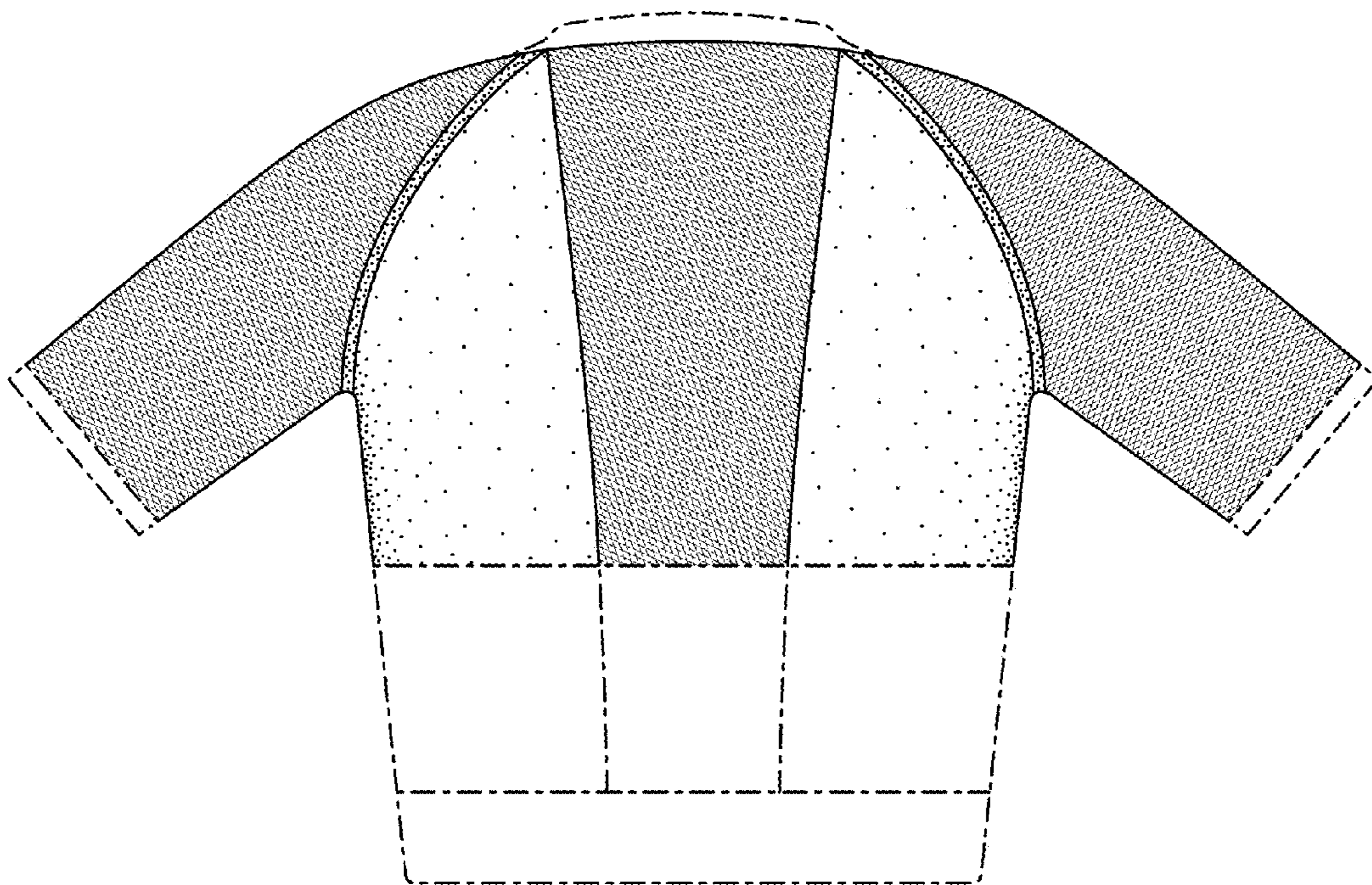

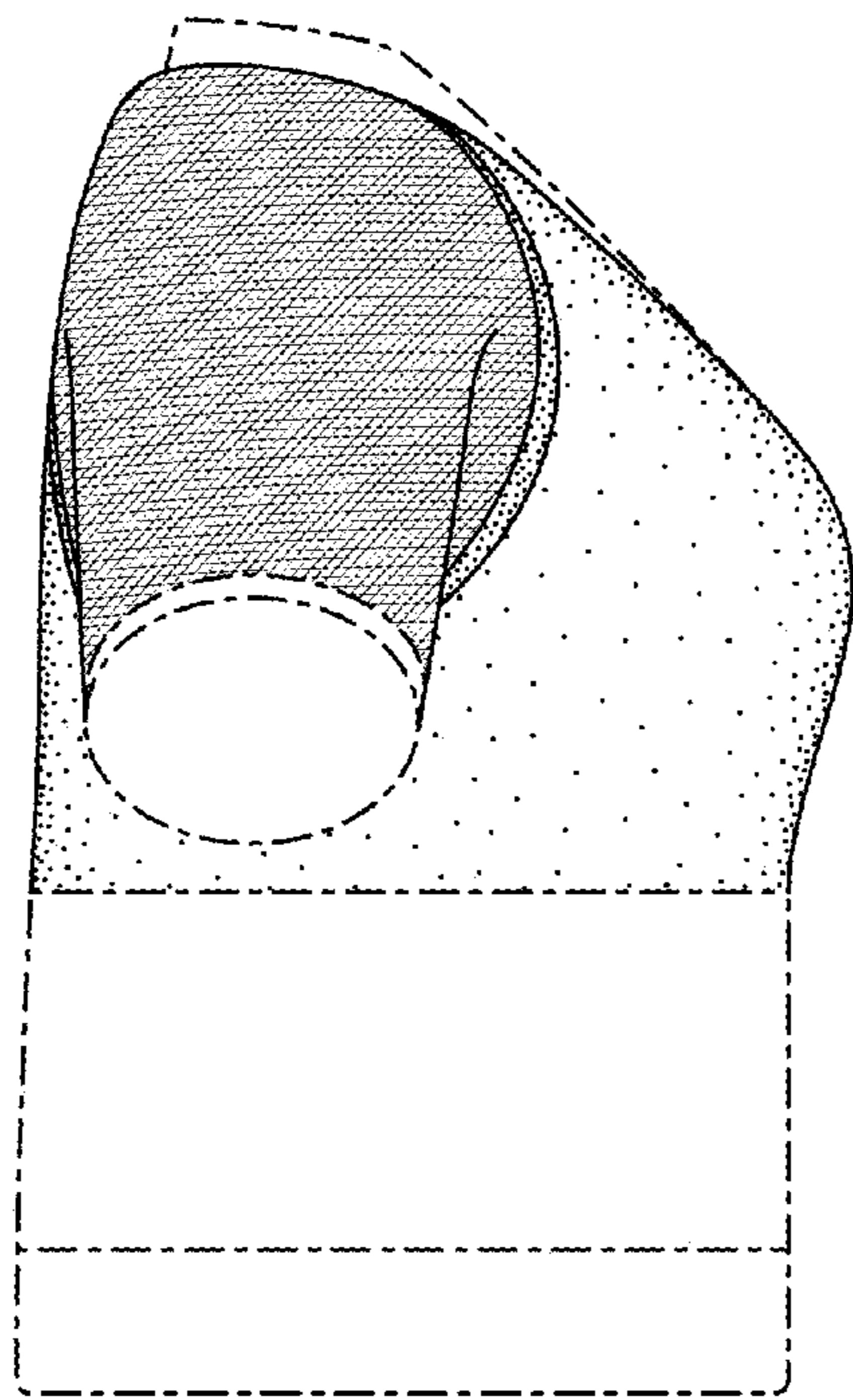

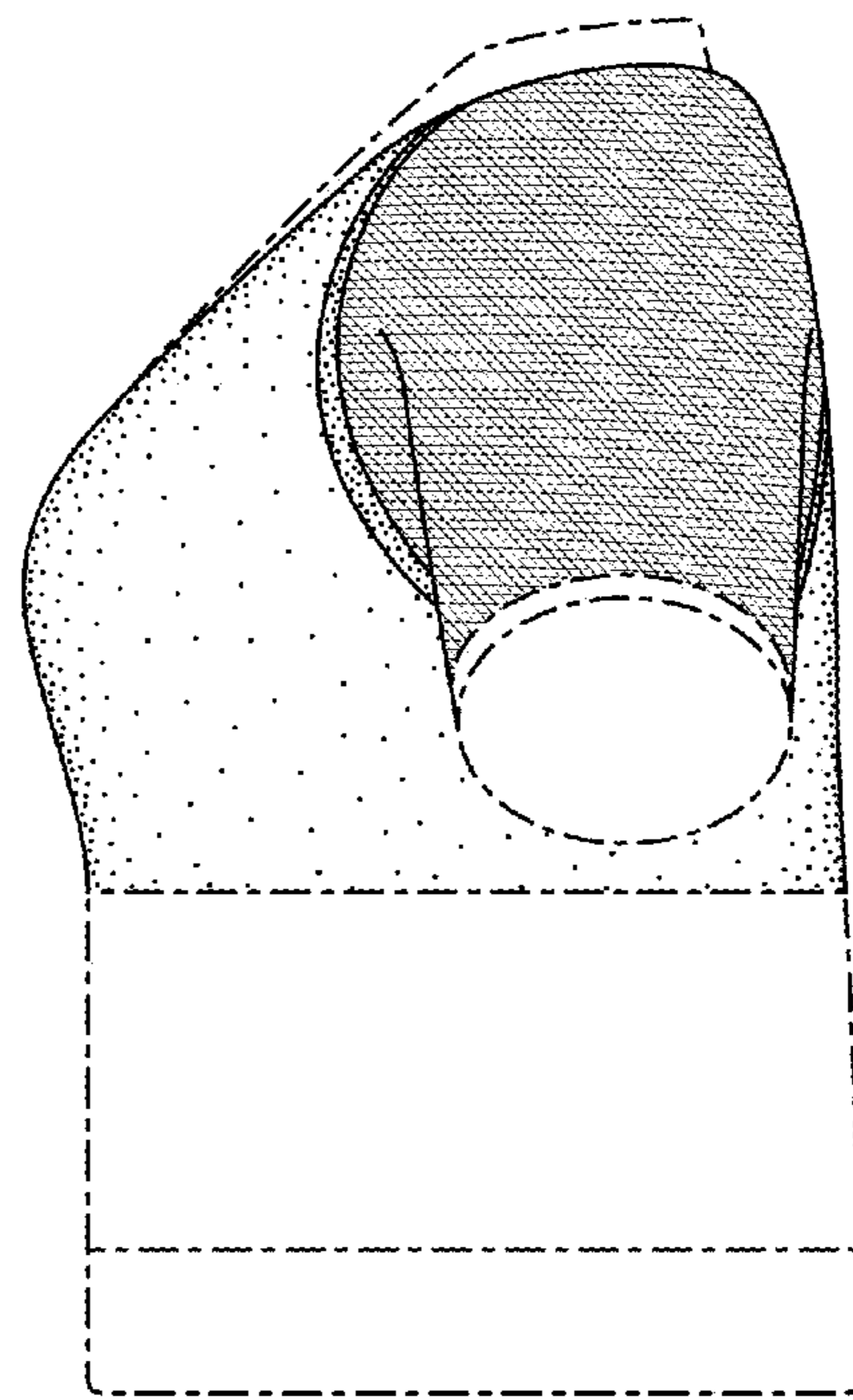

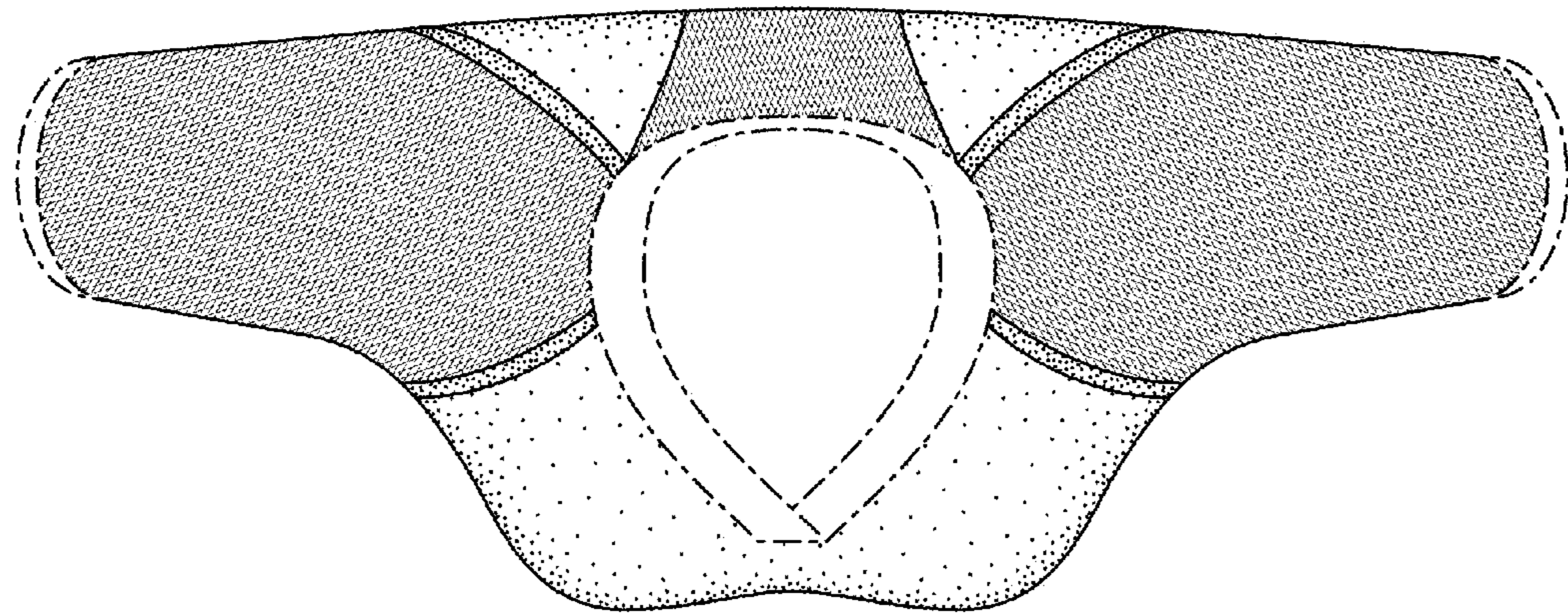

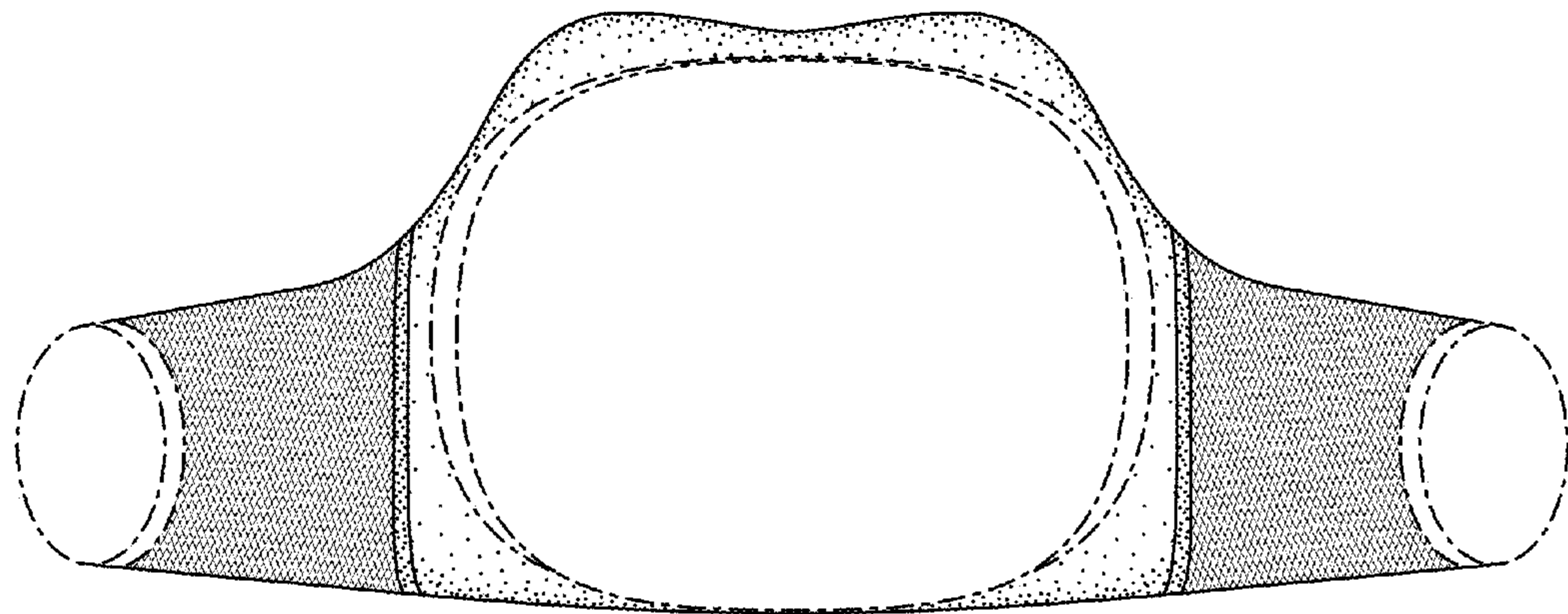
