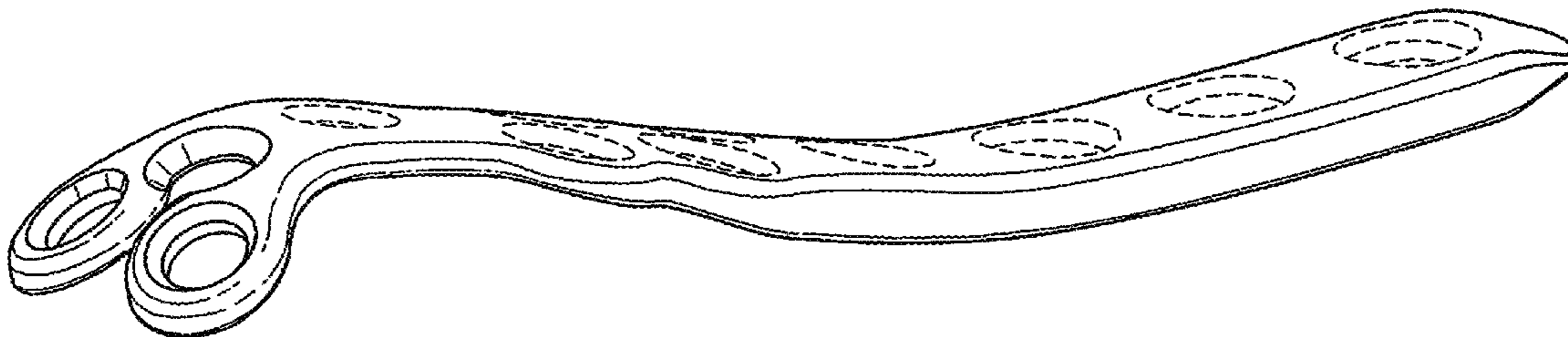
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the medial tibia fracture plate;

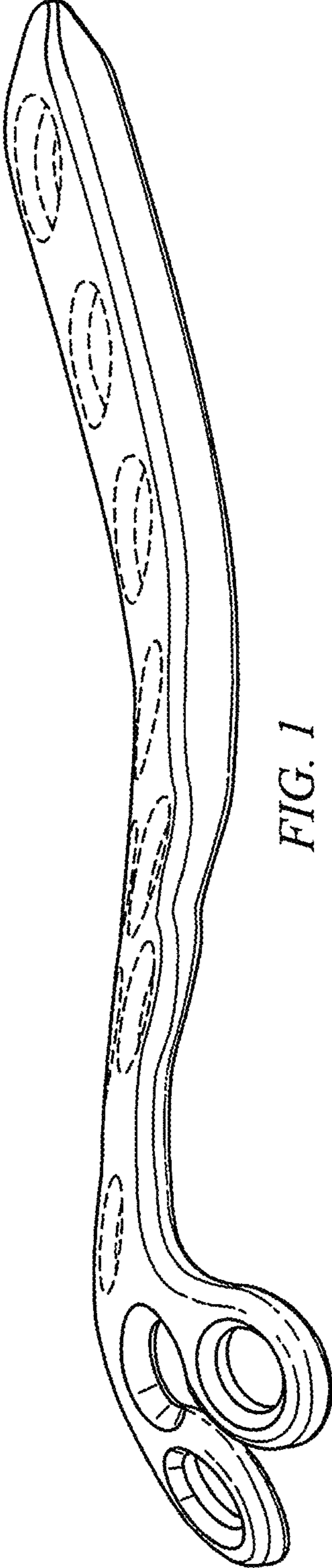

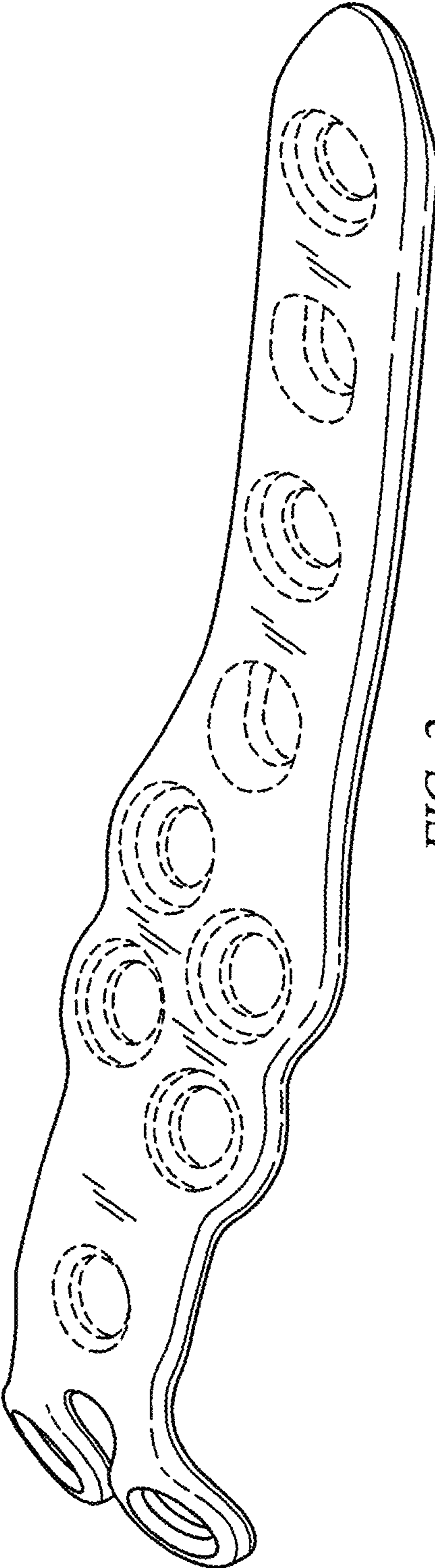

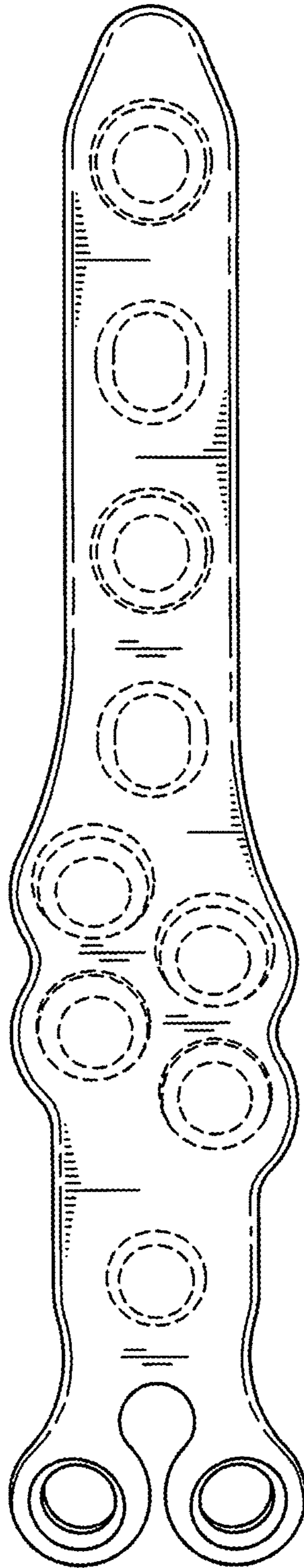

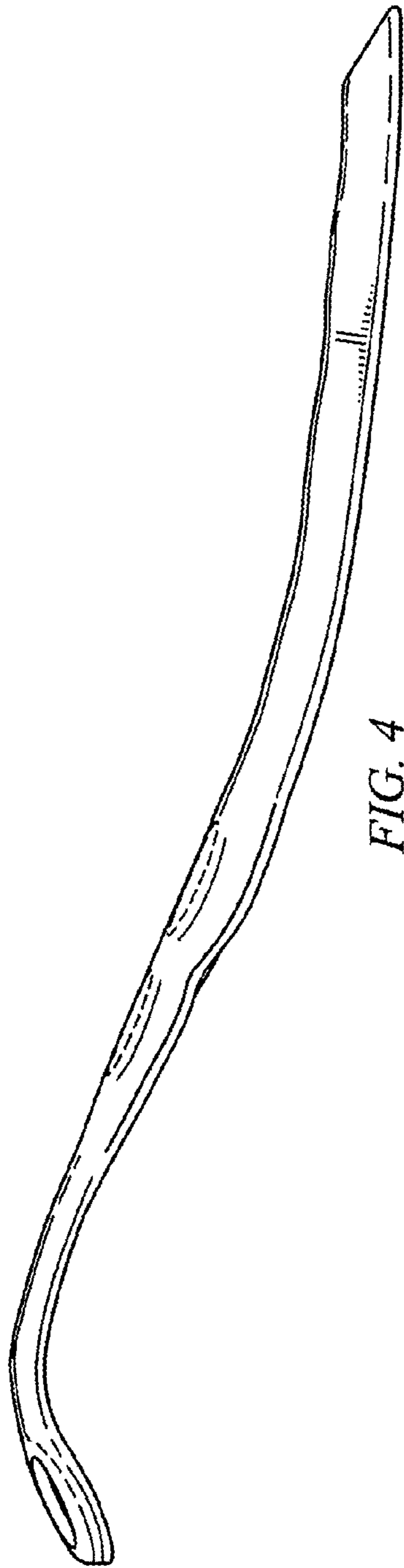

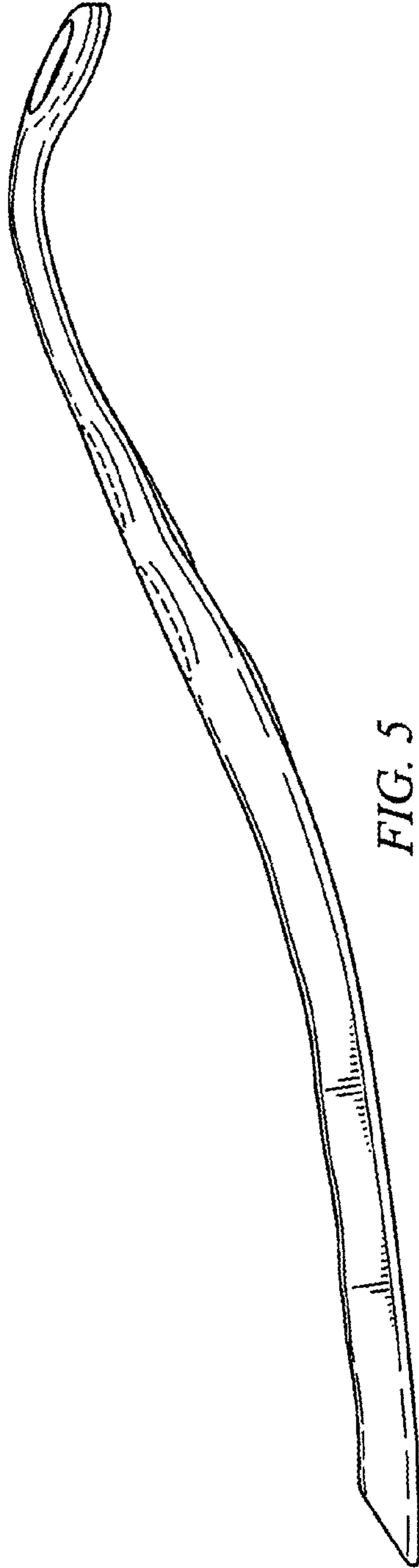

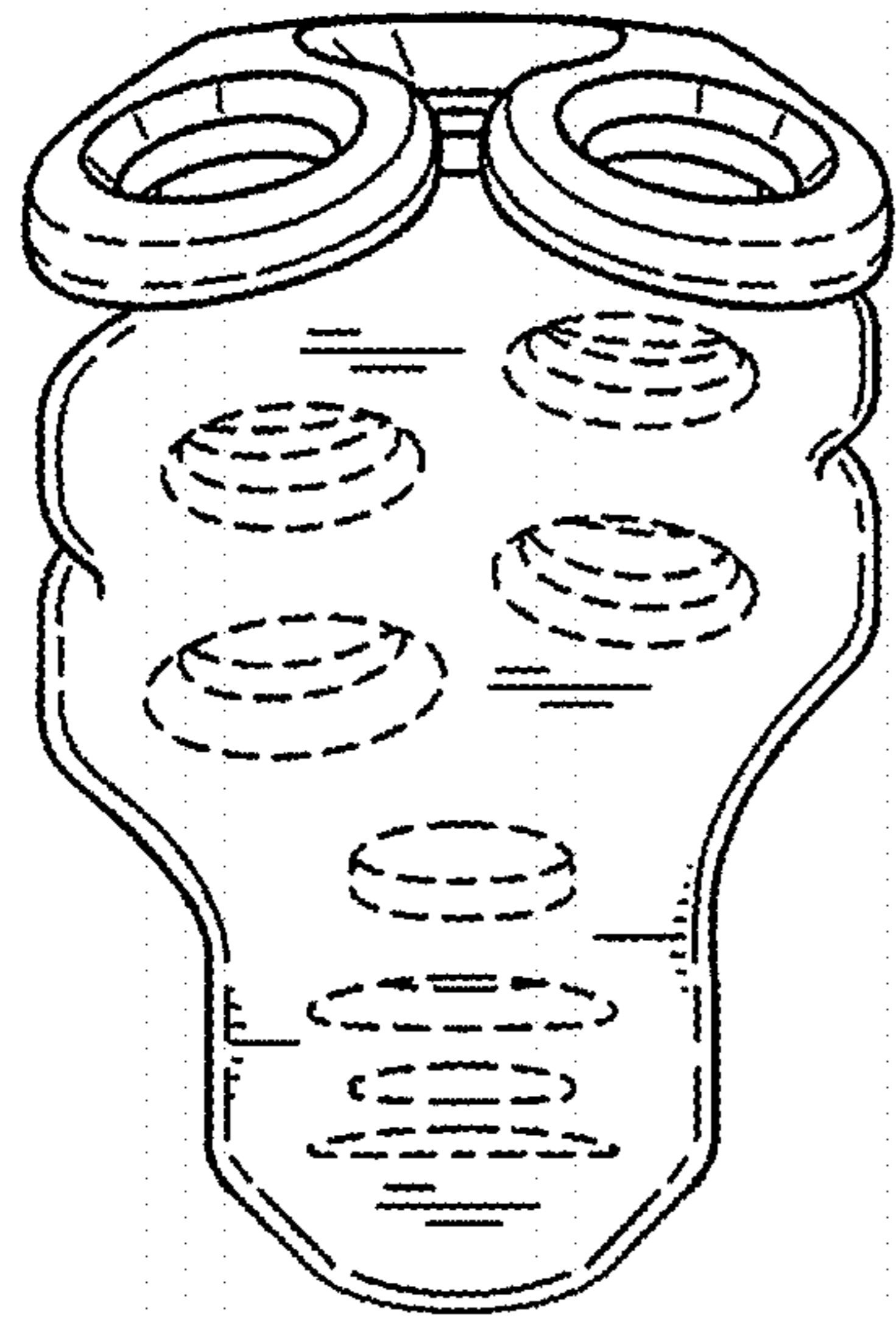

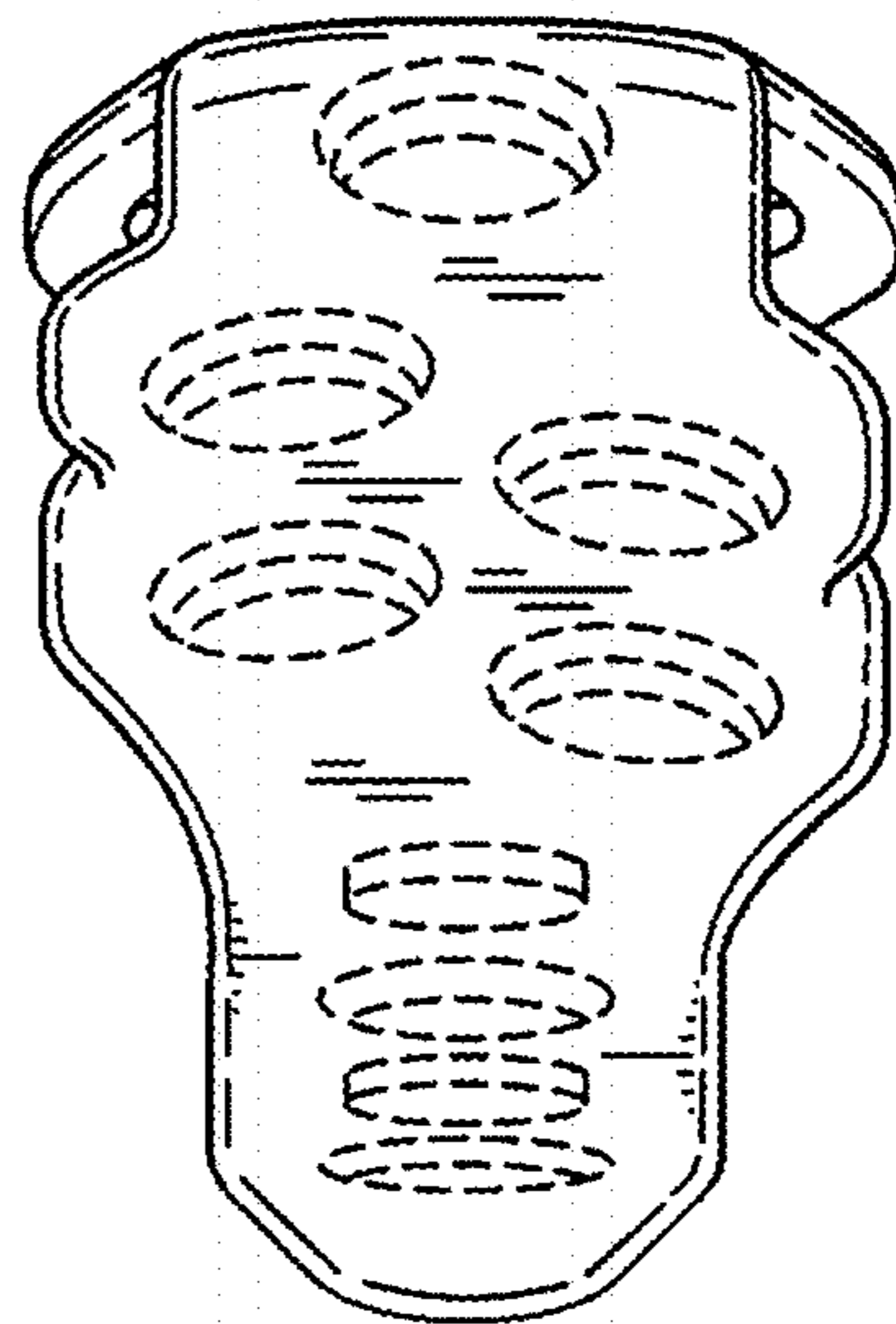

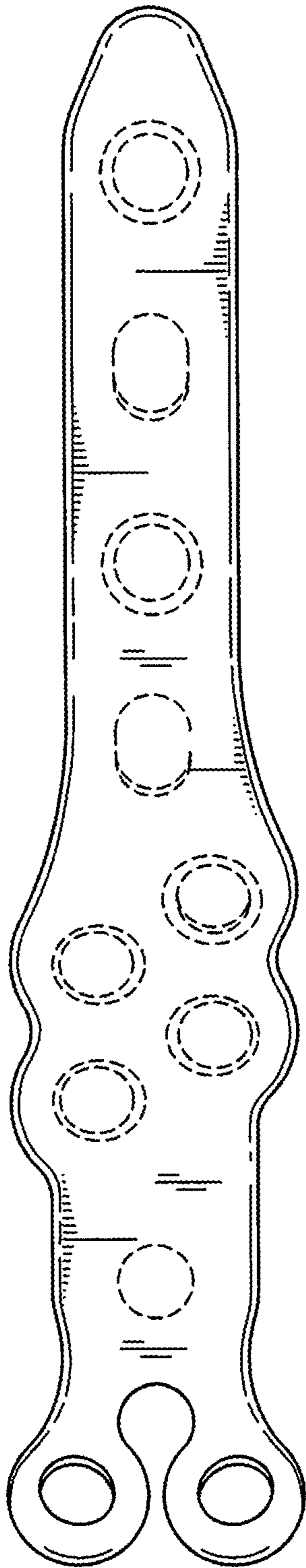
