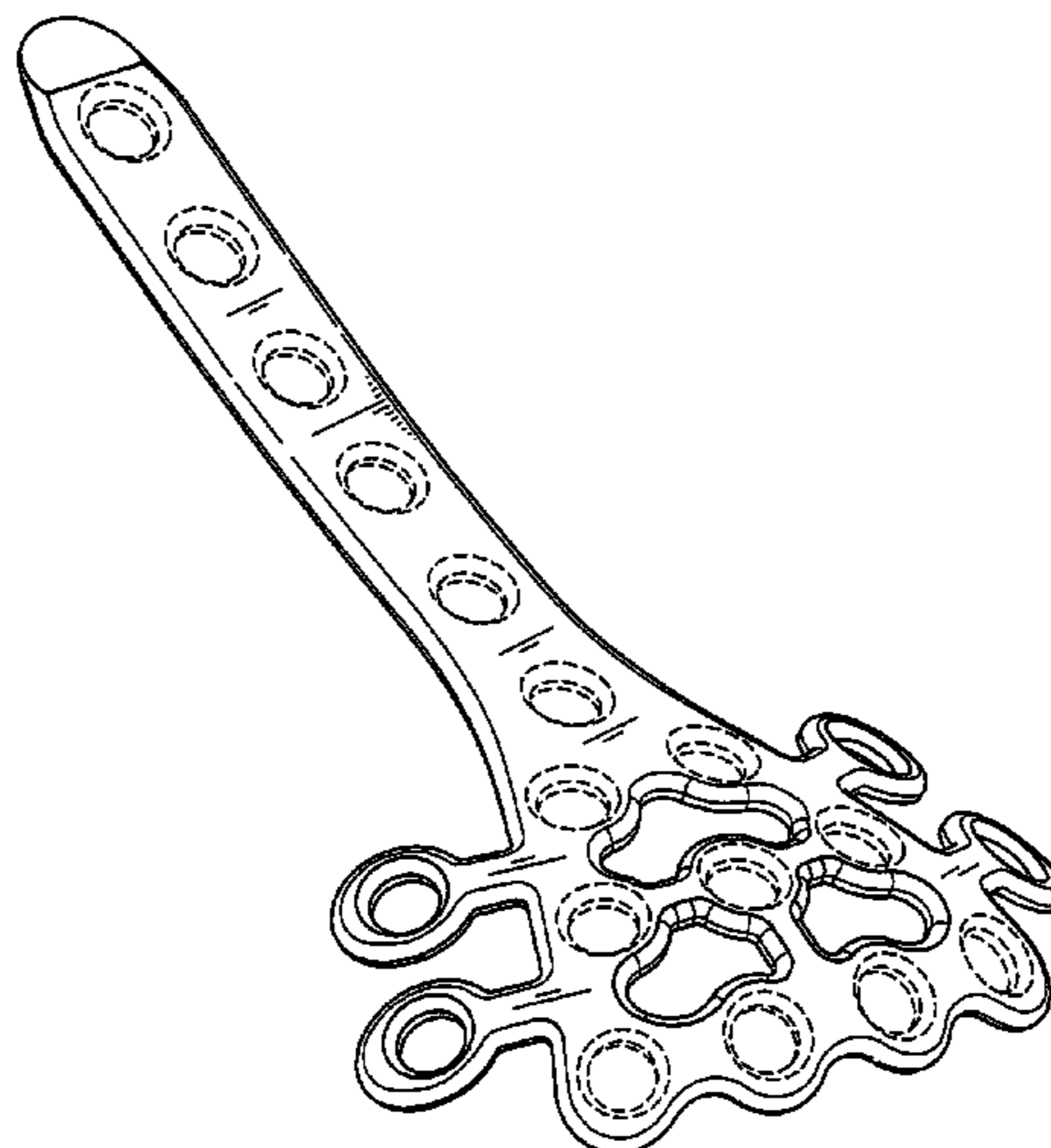

The ornamental design for an anterior tibia fracture plate, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**  
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the anterior tibia fracture plate;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a back view thereof.  
The broken lines showing on the anterior tibia fracture plate are for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

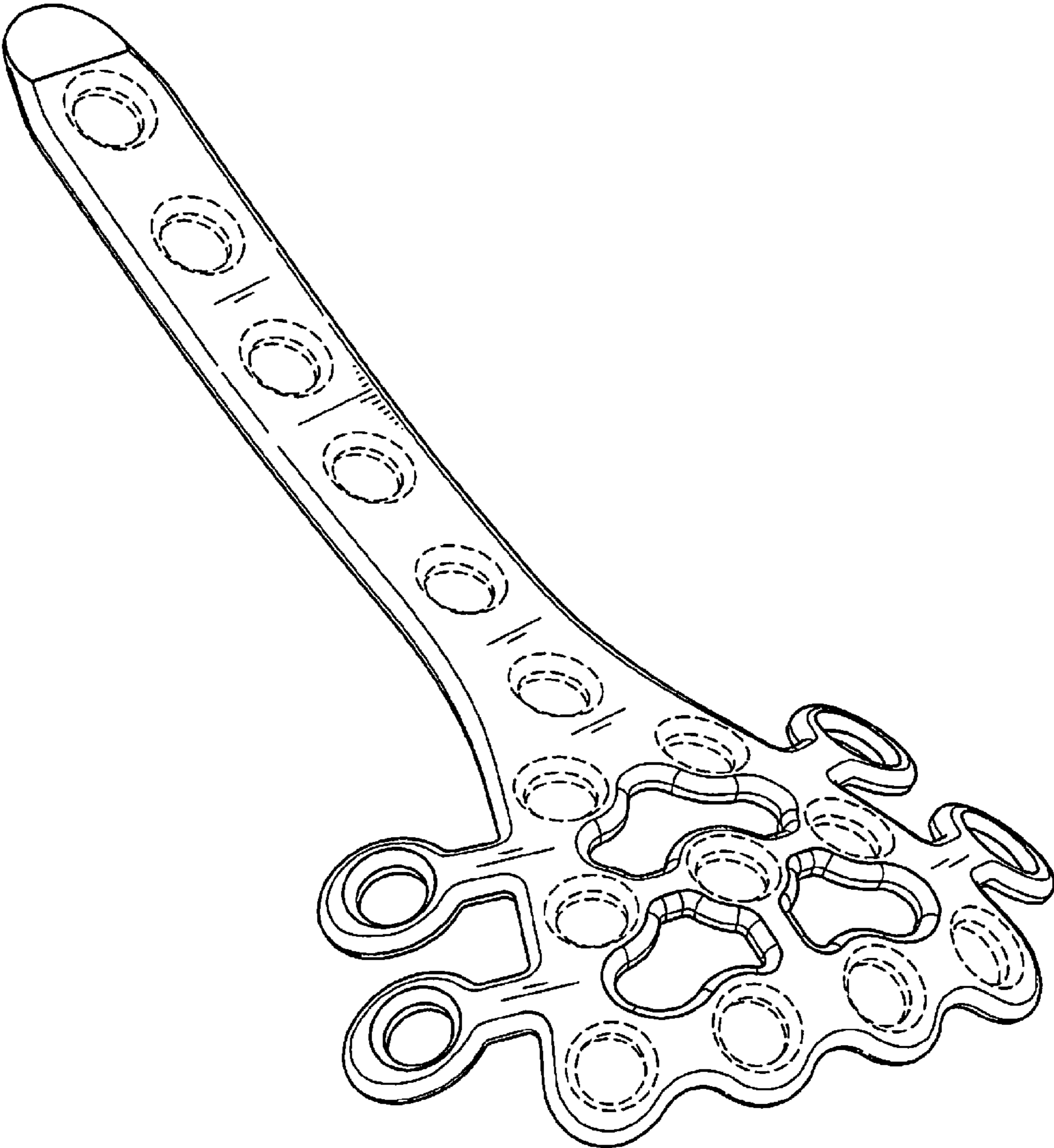

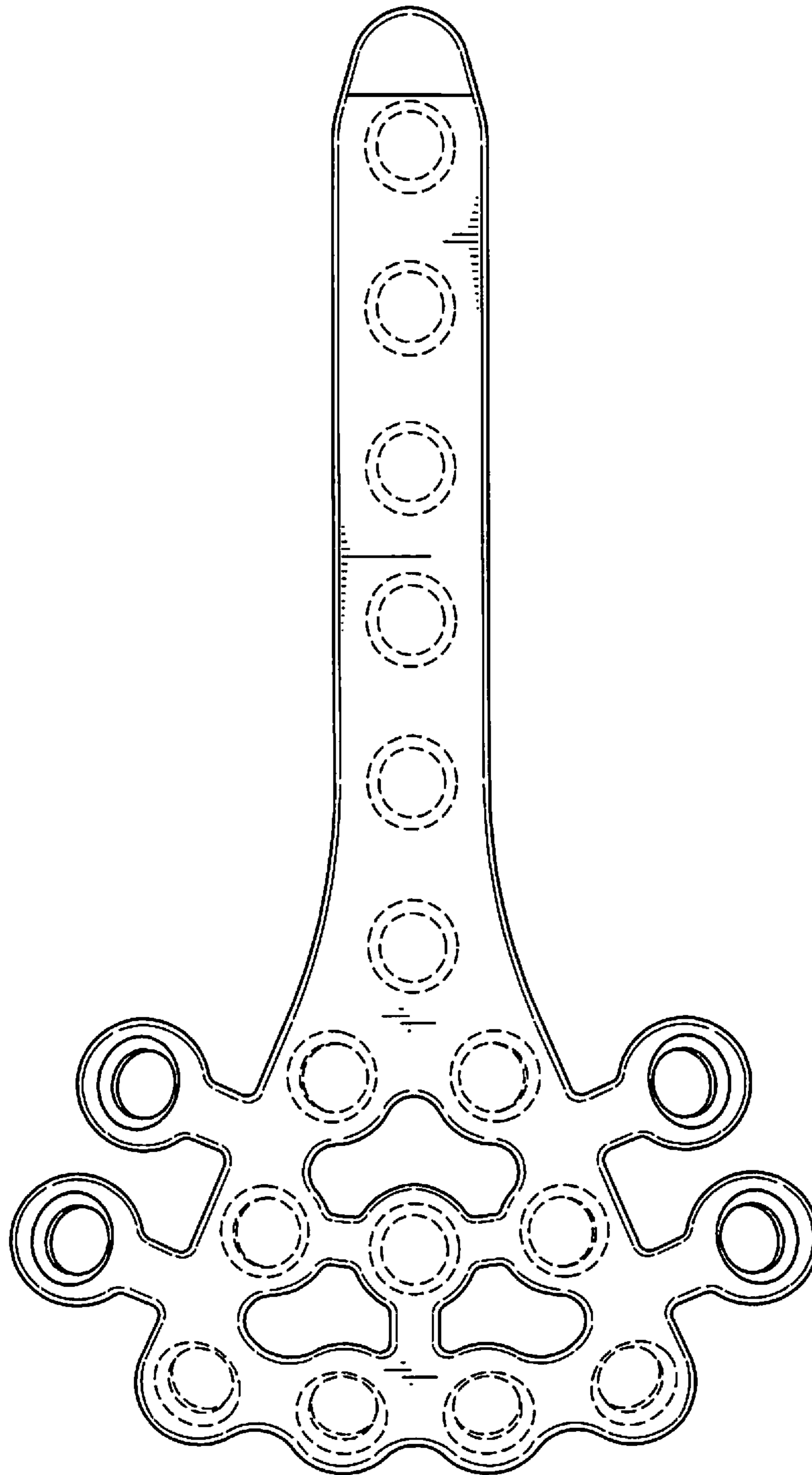

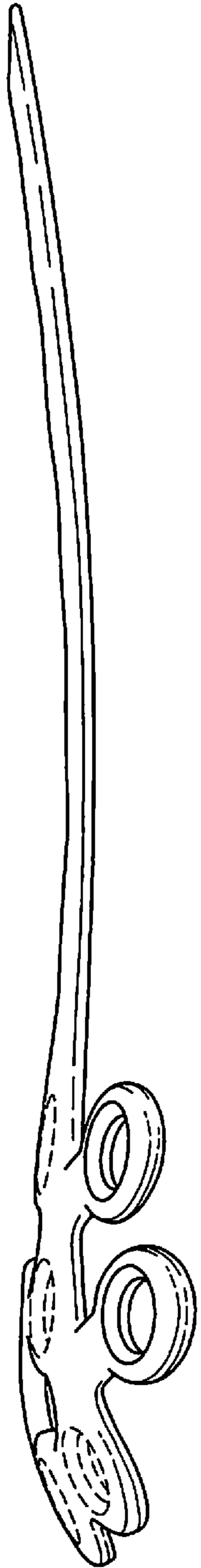

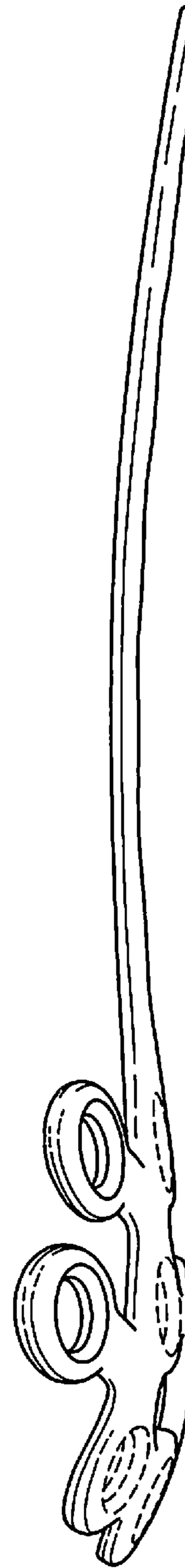

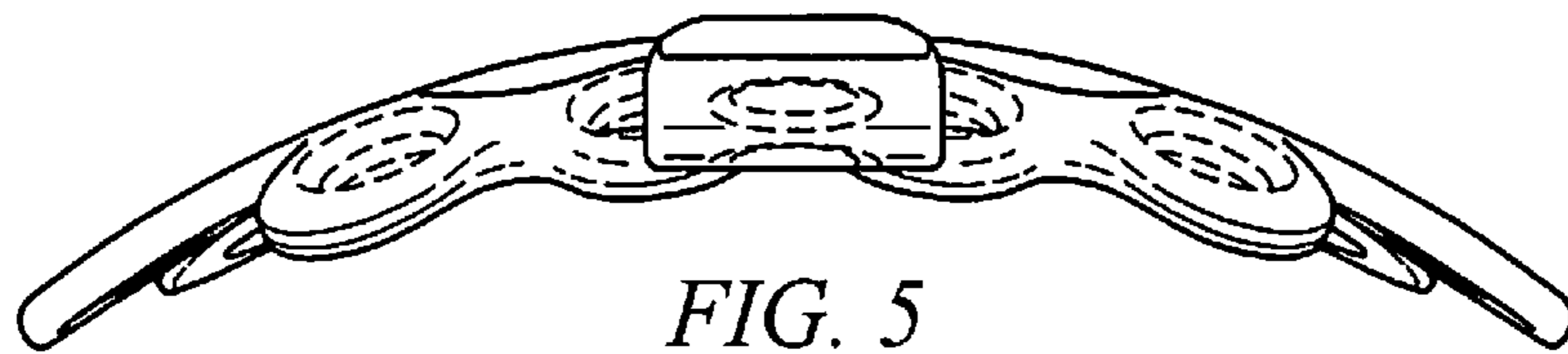

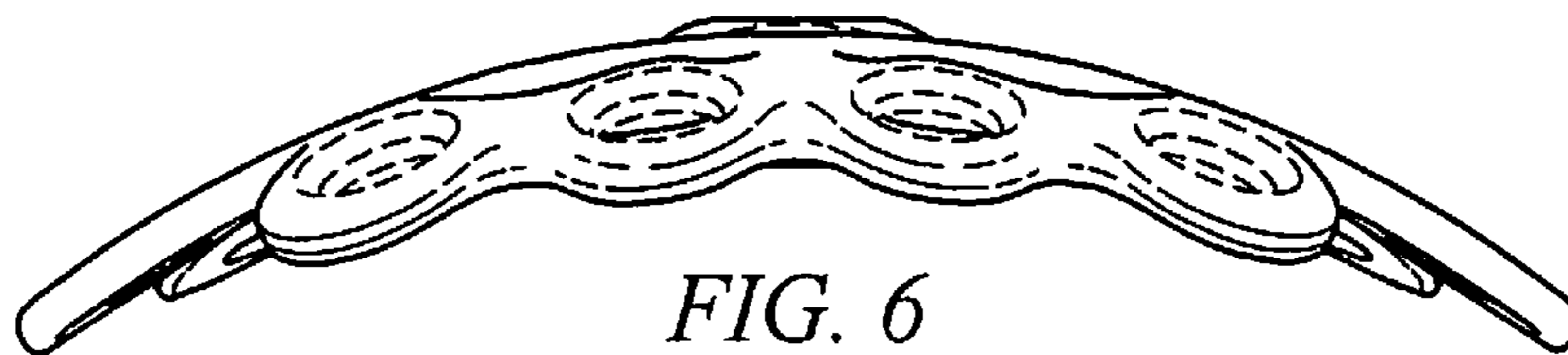

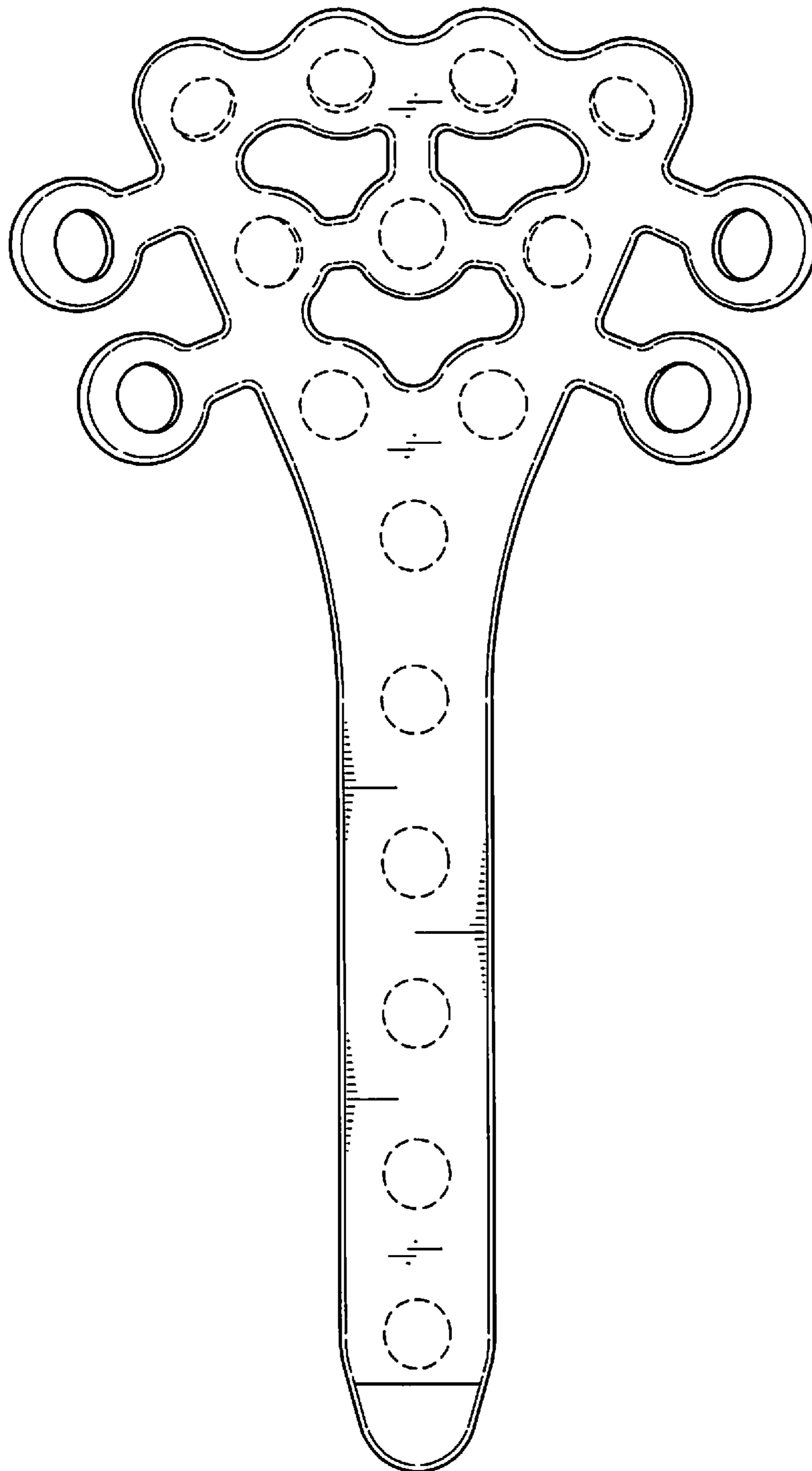
