eye massager.

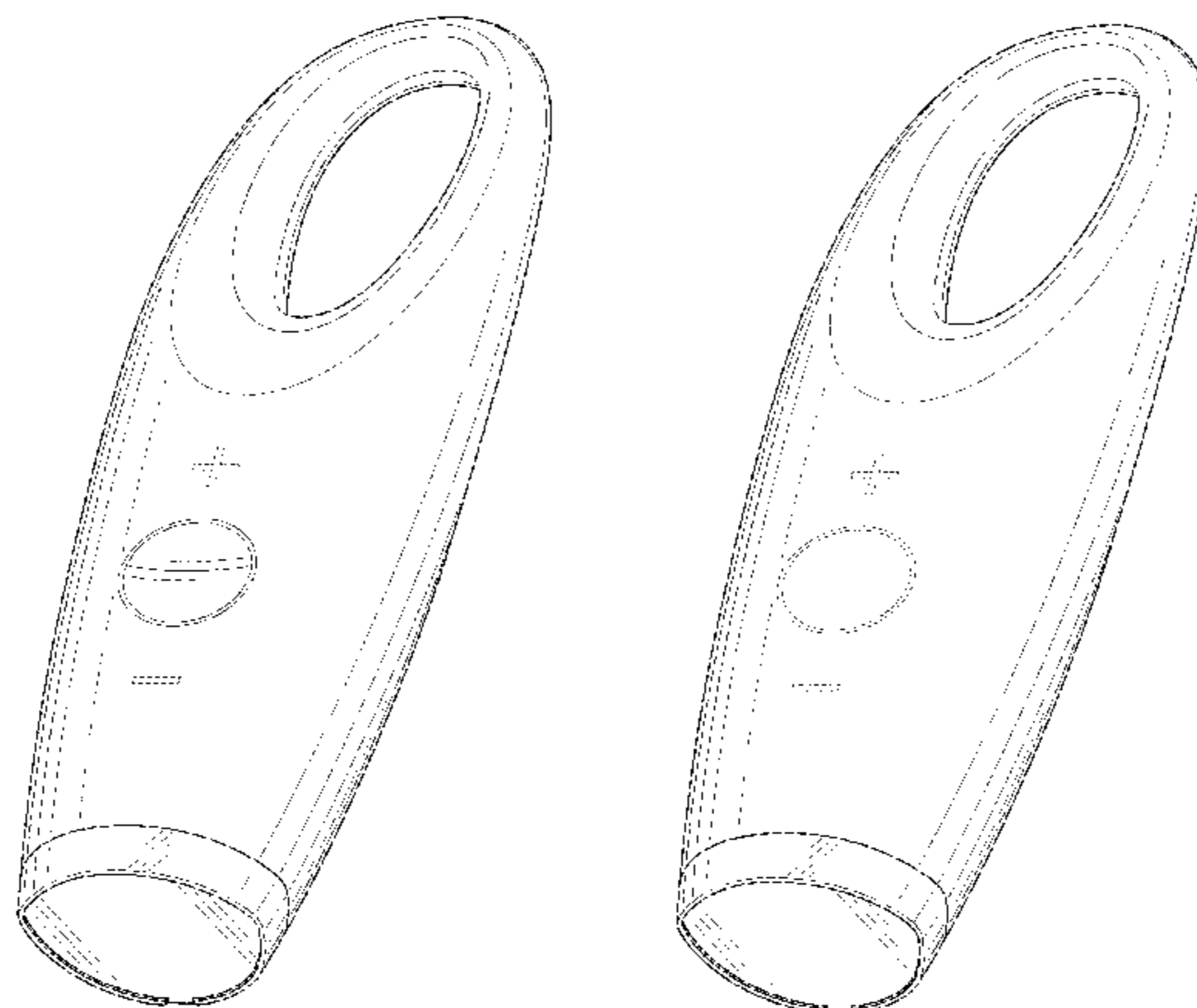
FIG. 12 is a left side view of the second embodiment of the

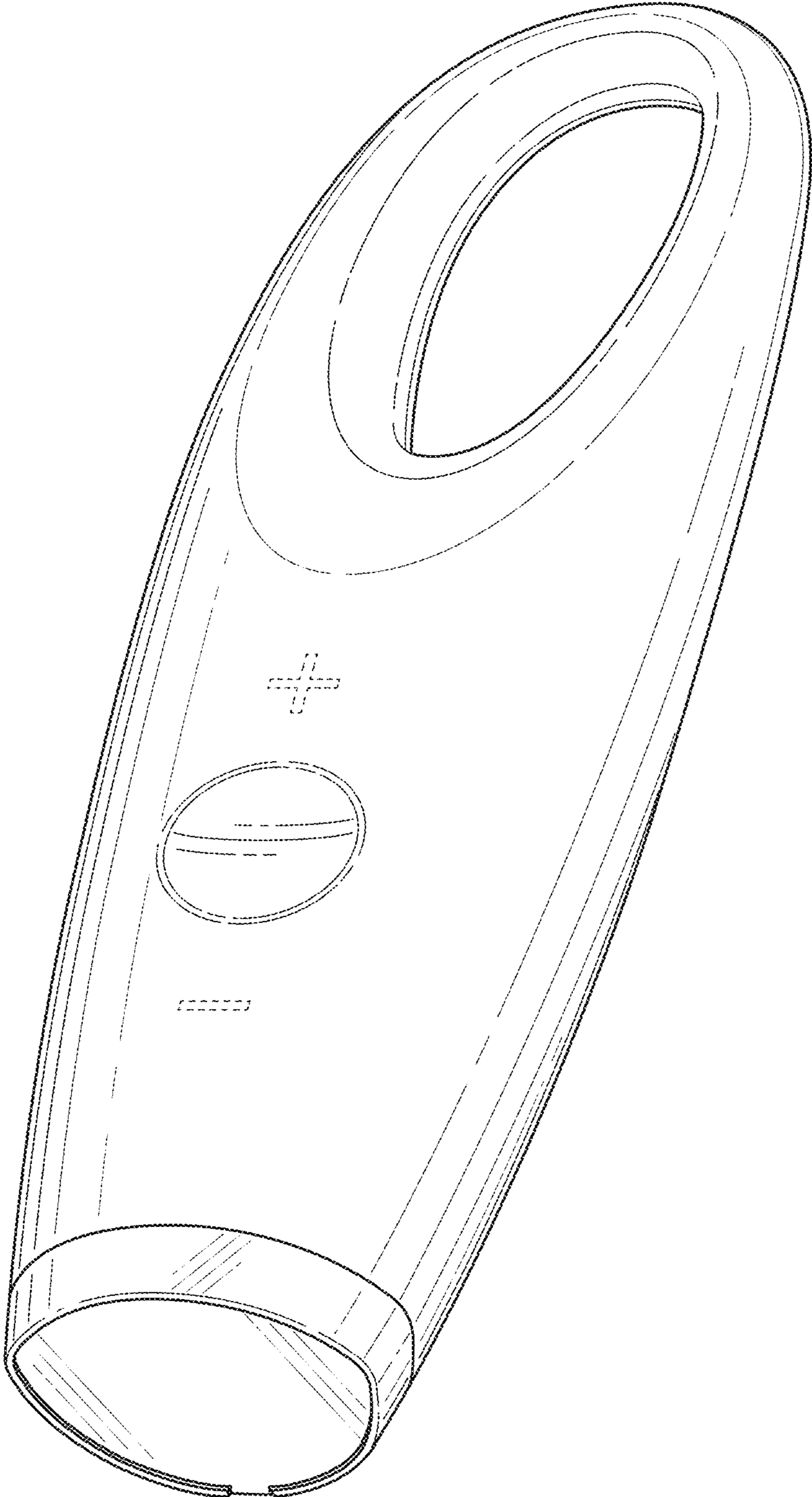

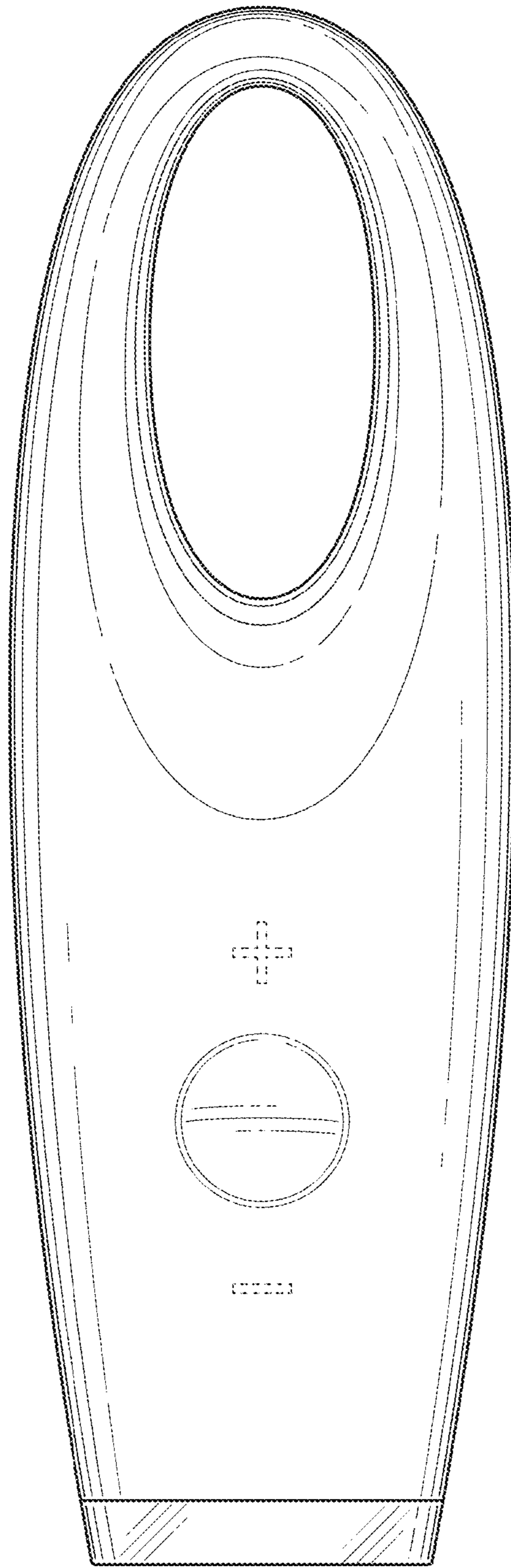

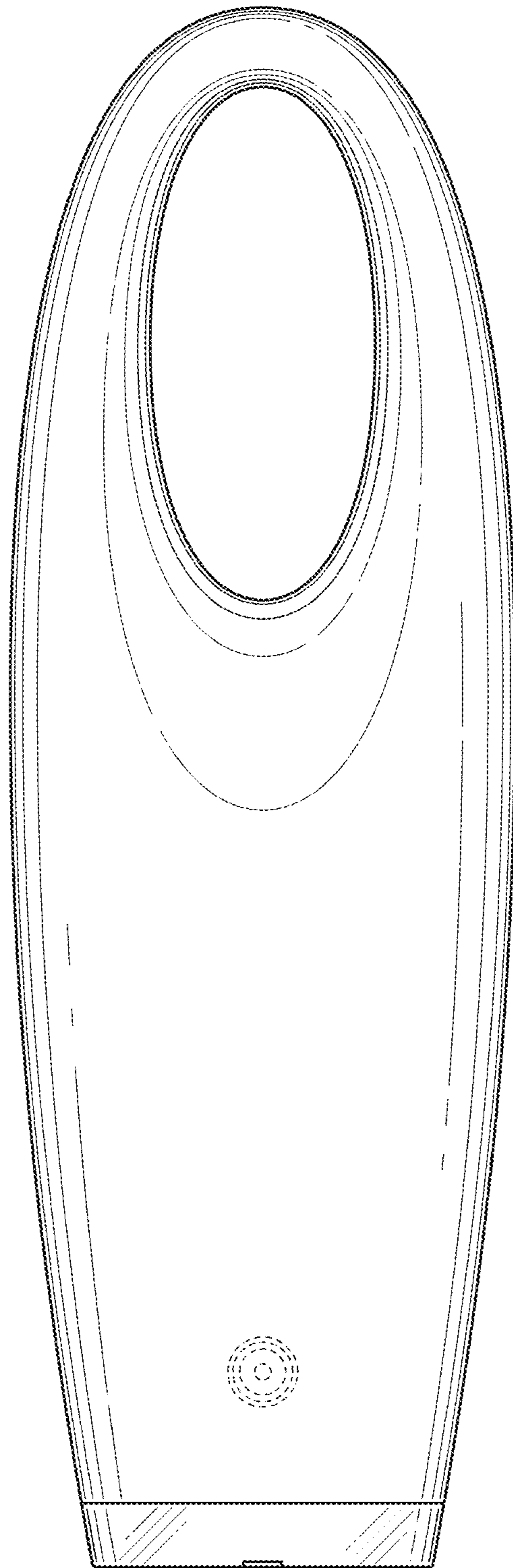

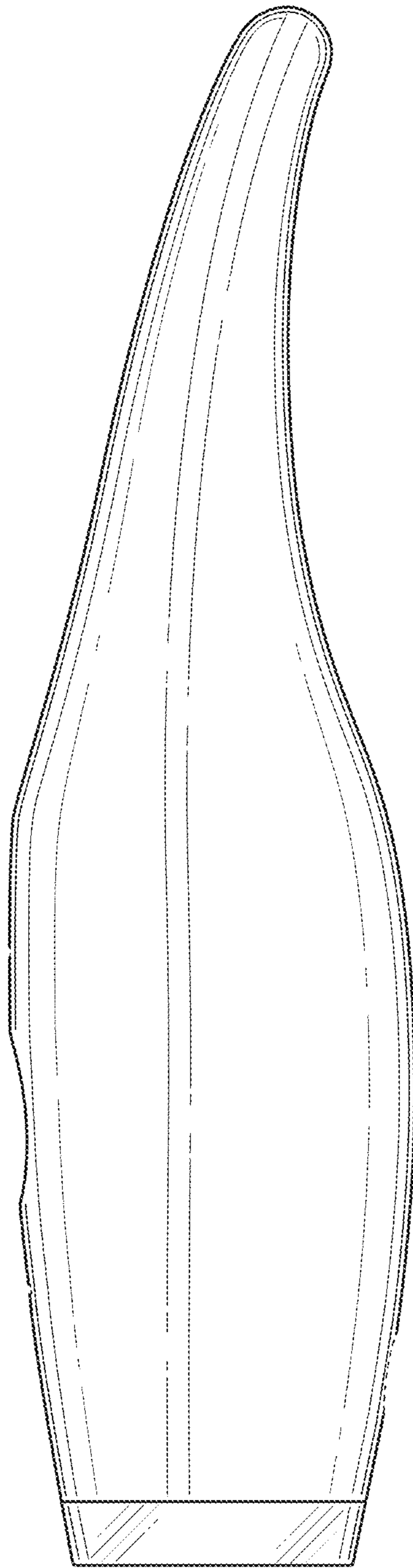

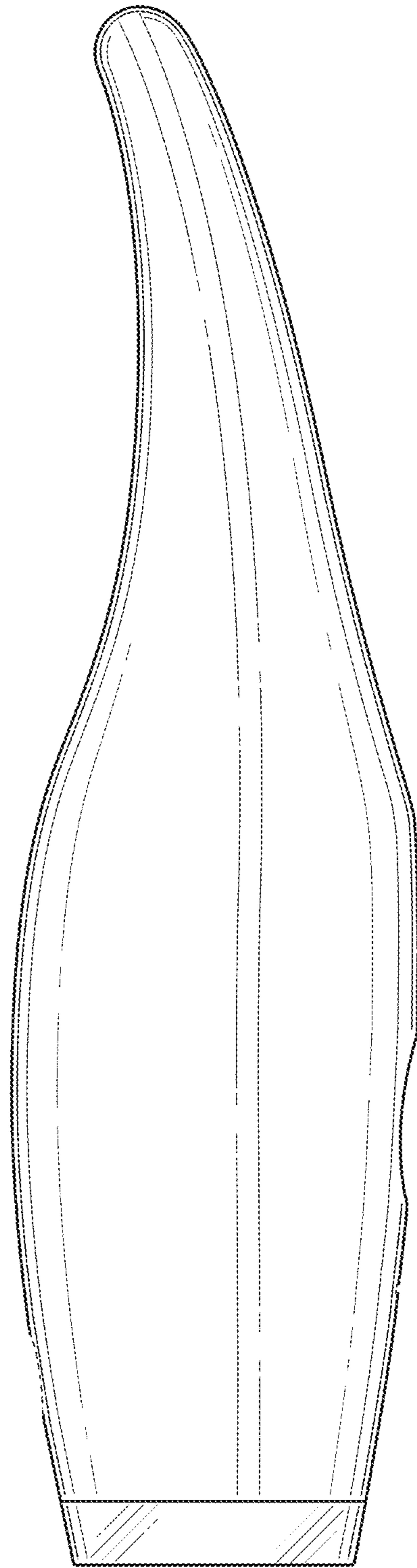

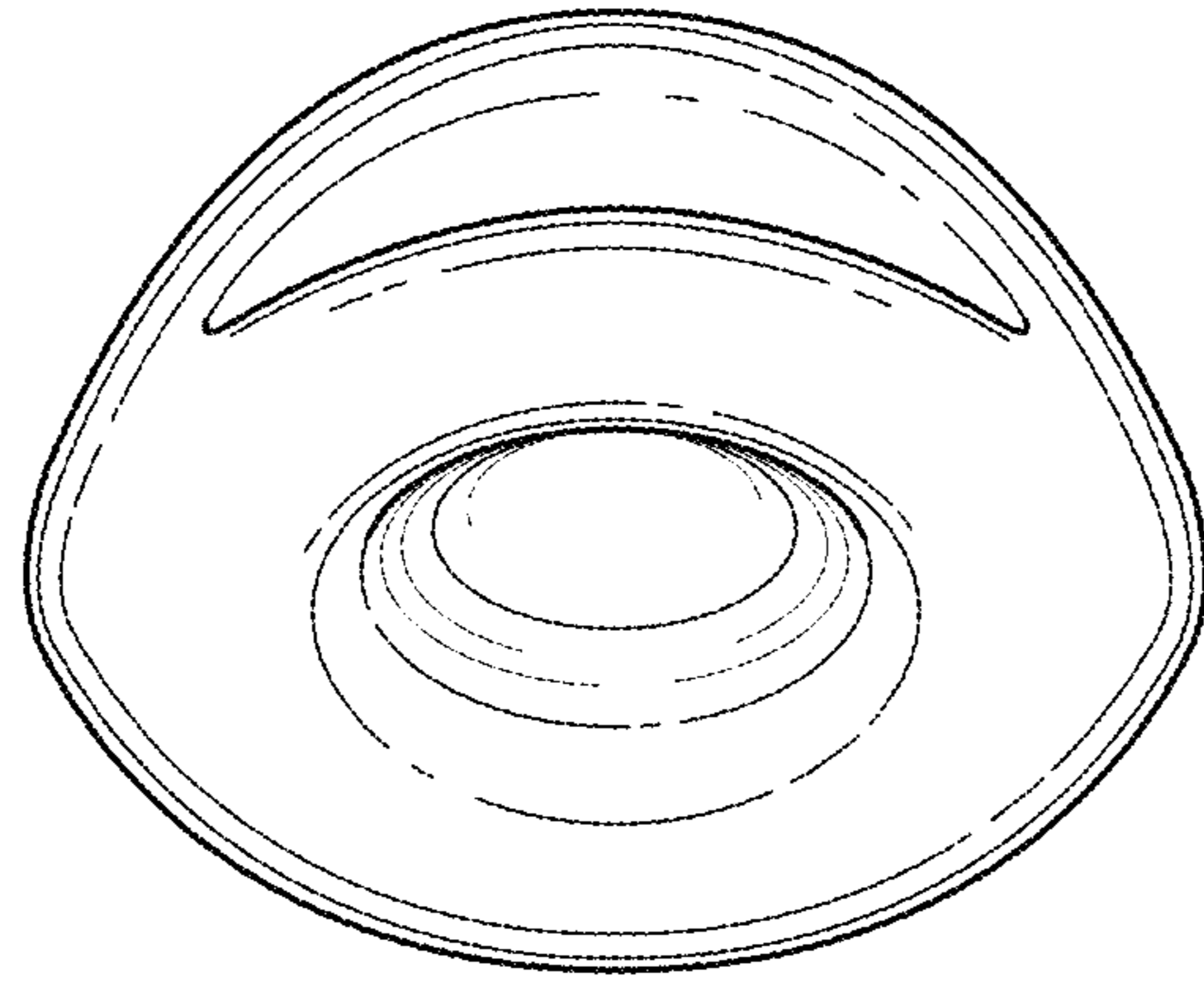

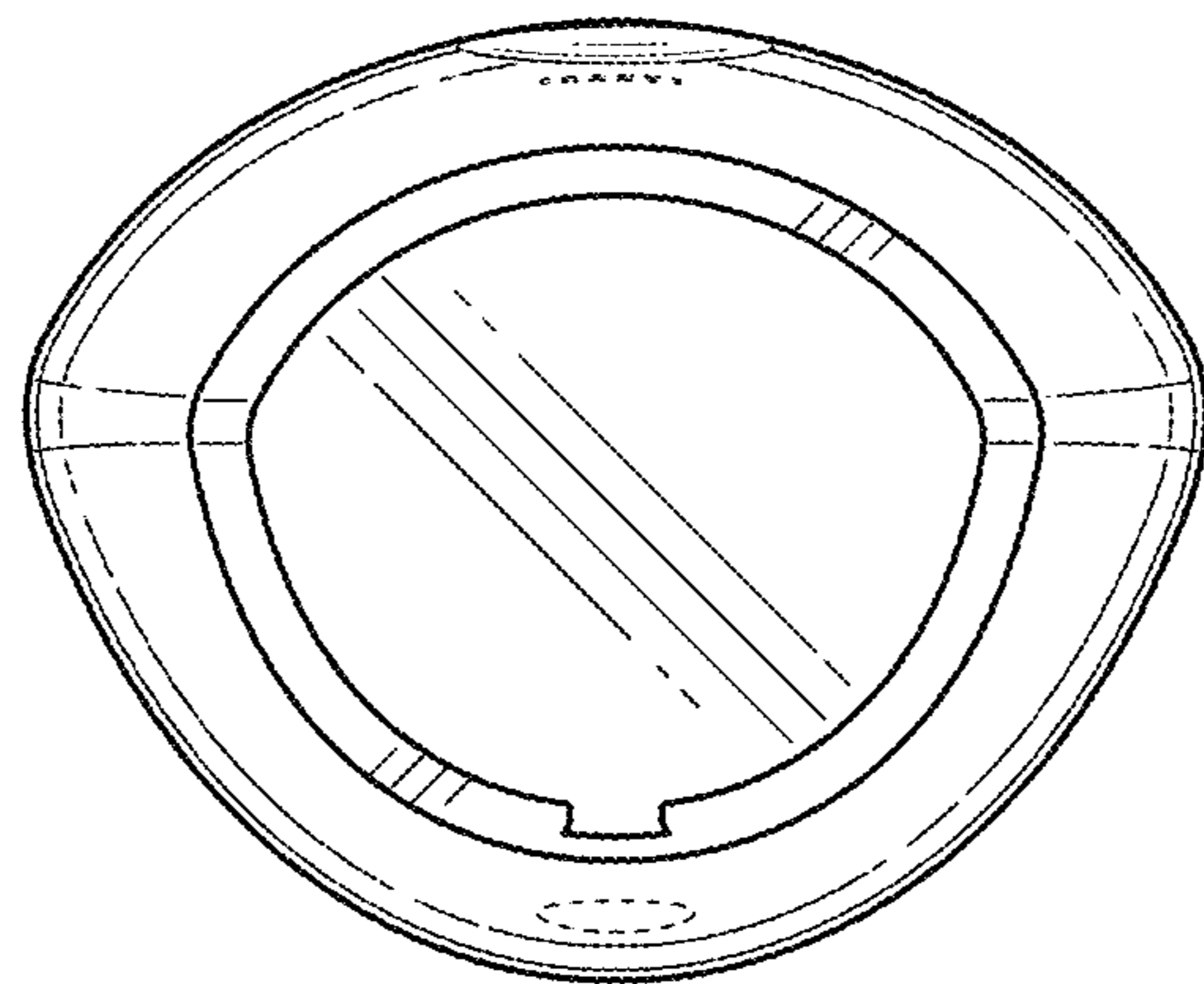

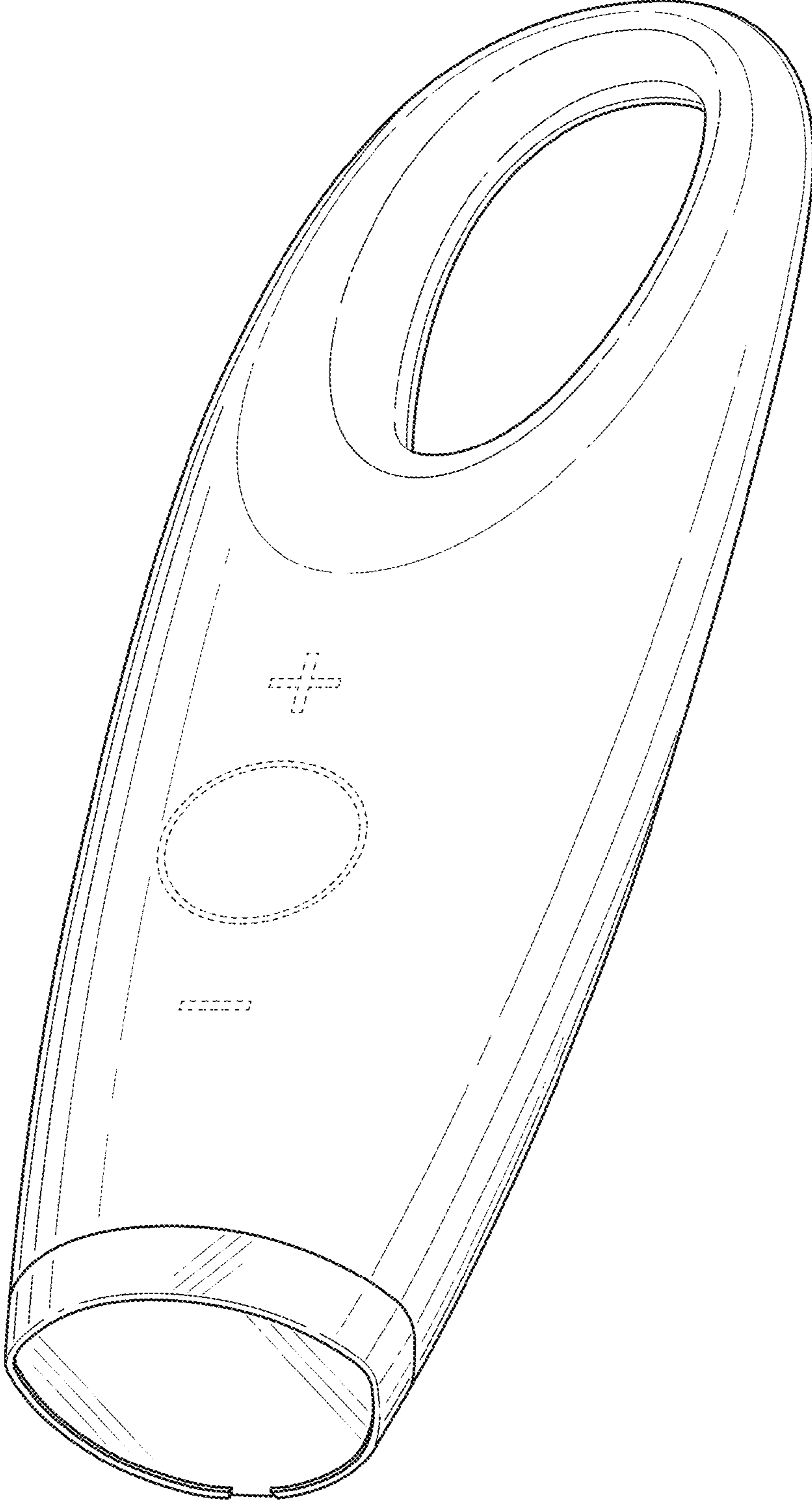

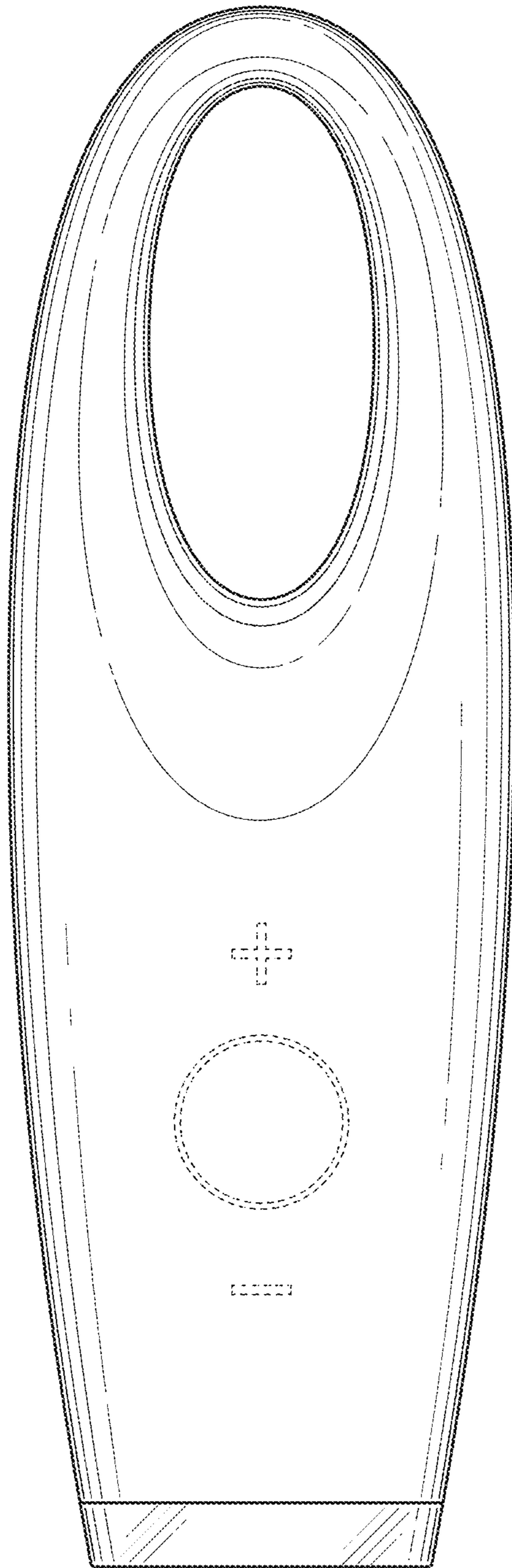

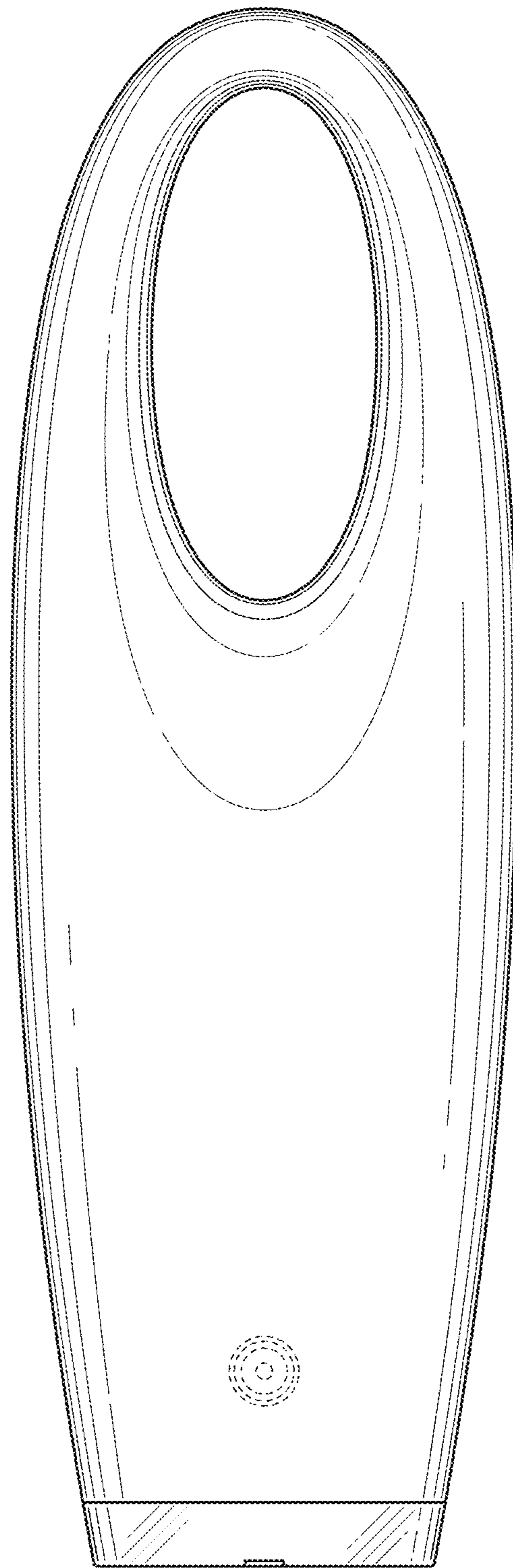

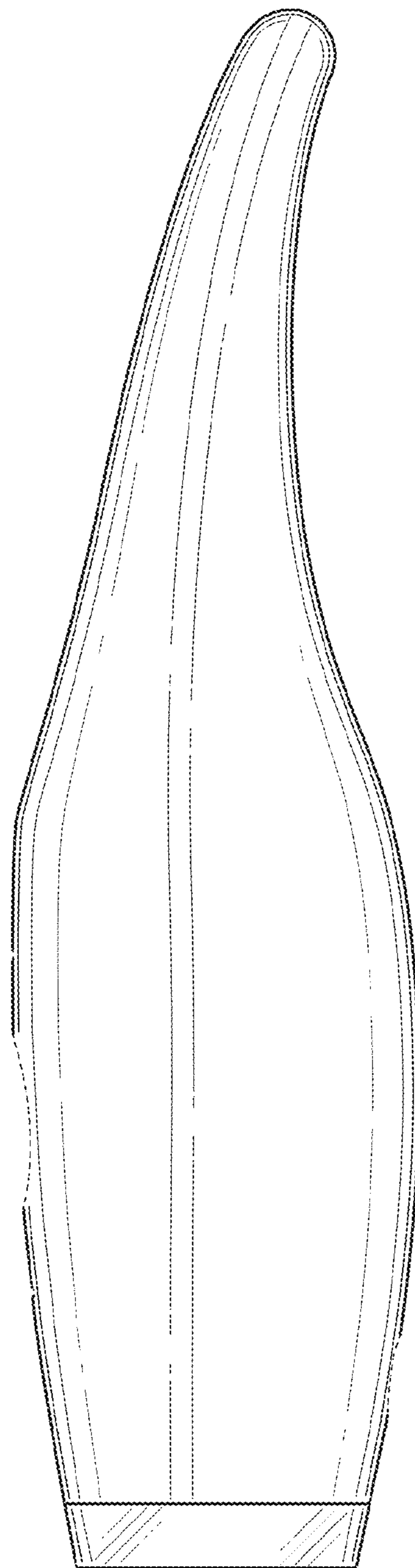

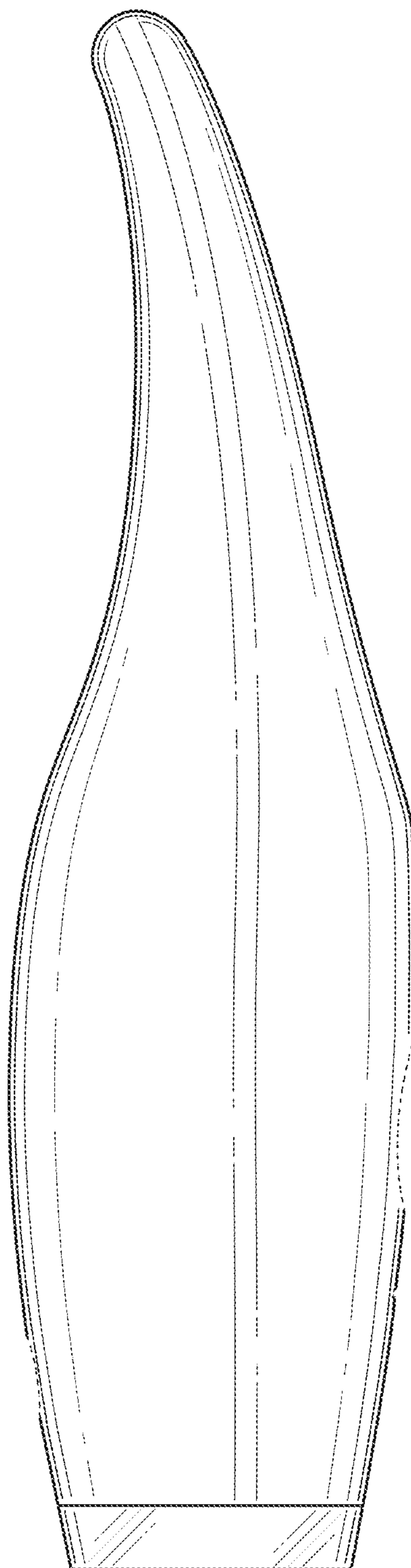

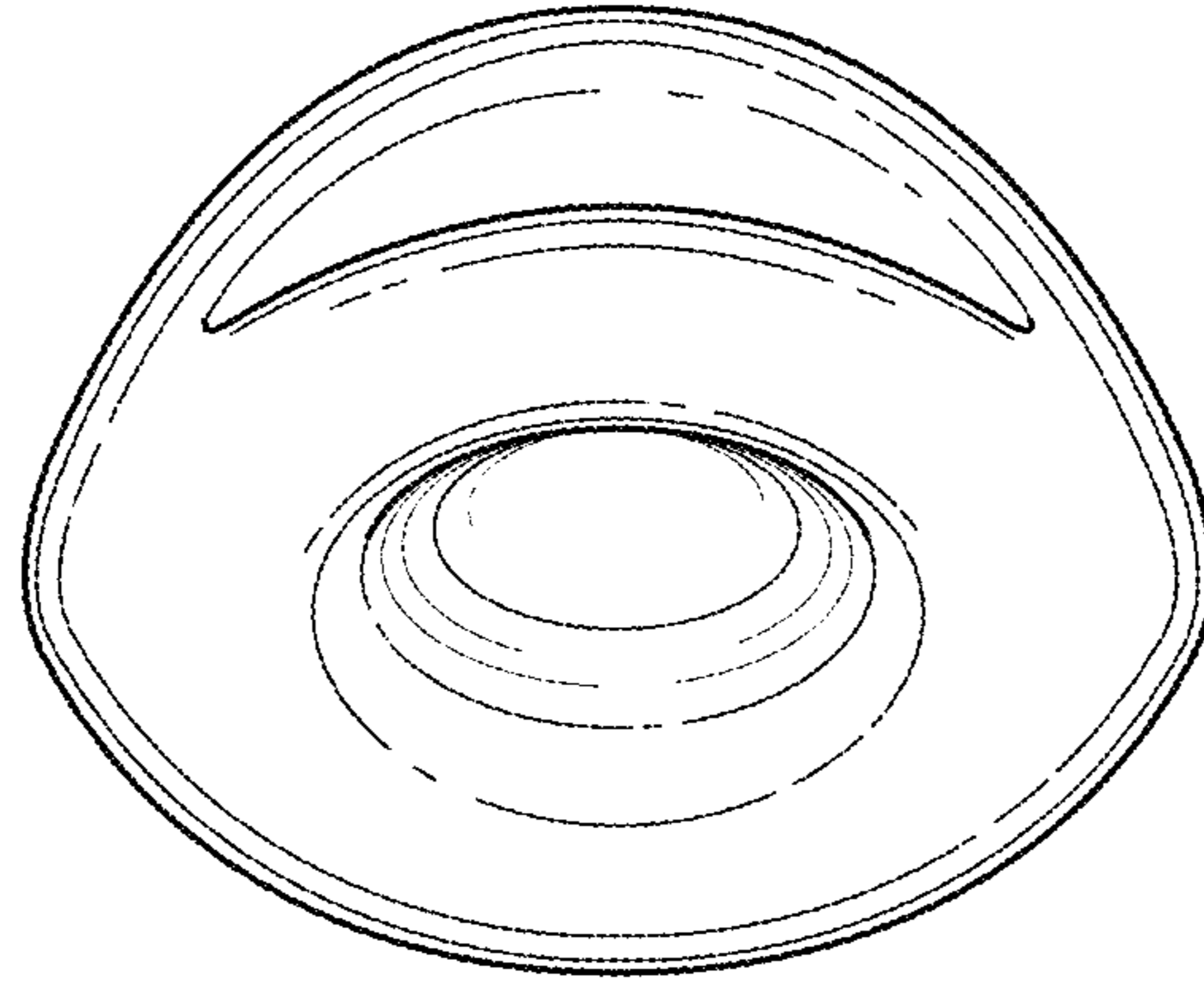

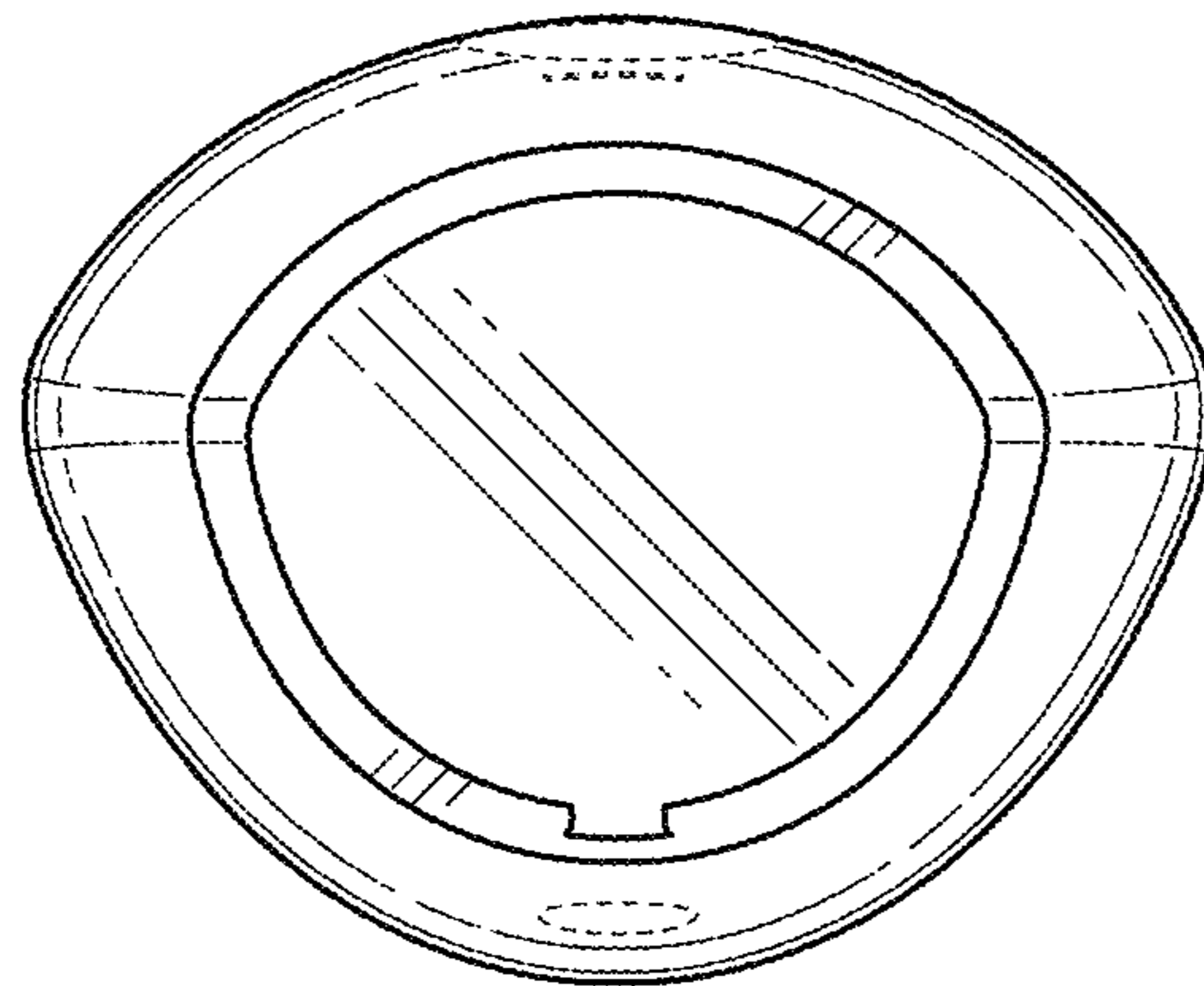
