FIG. 6 is another perspective view thereof;

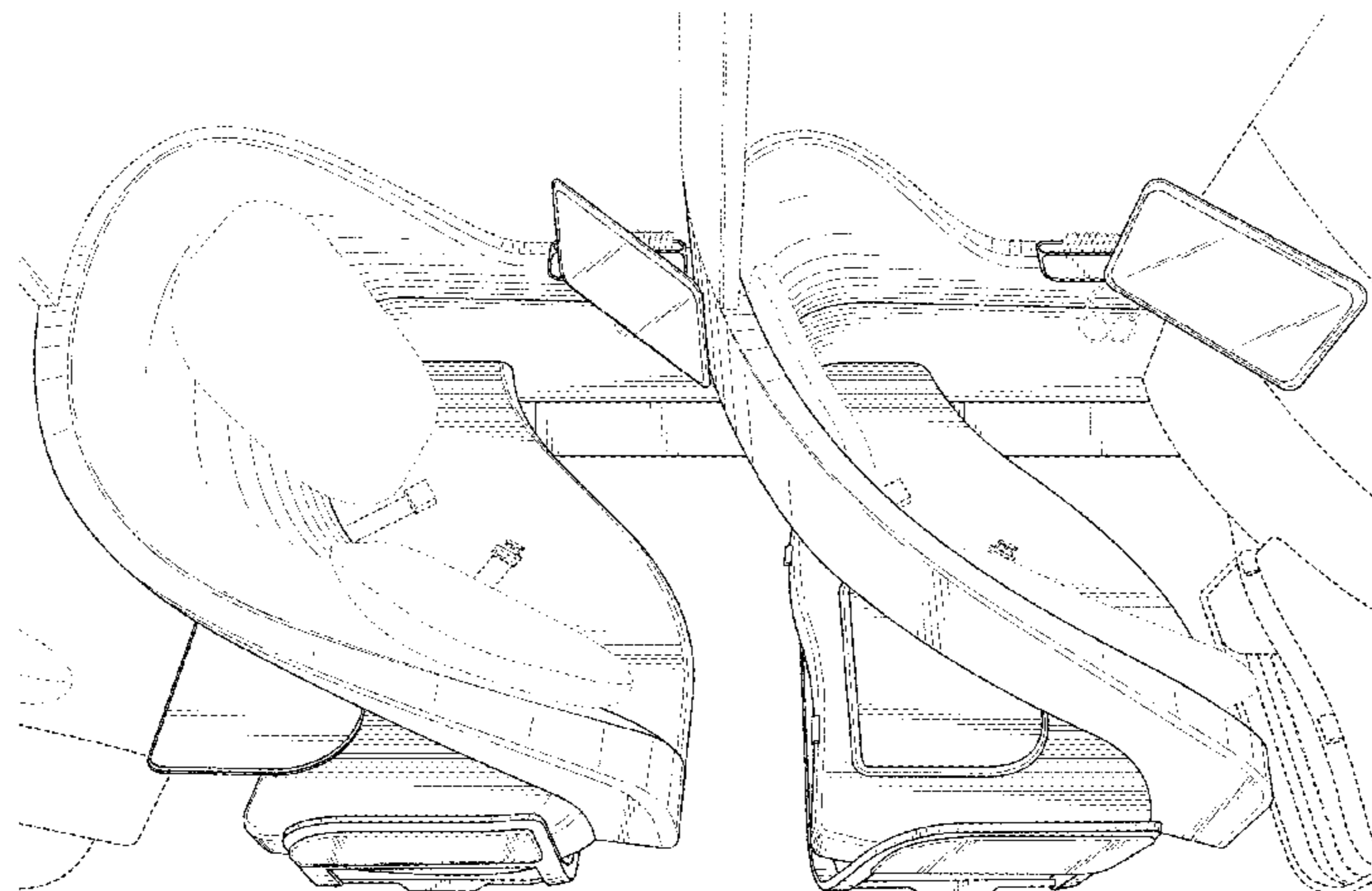
FIG. 7 is another perspective view thereof;

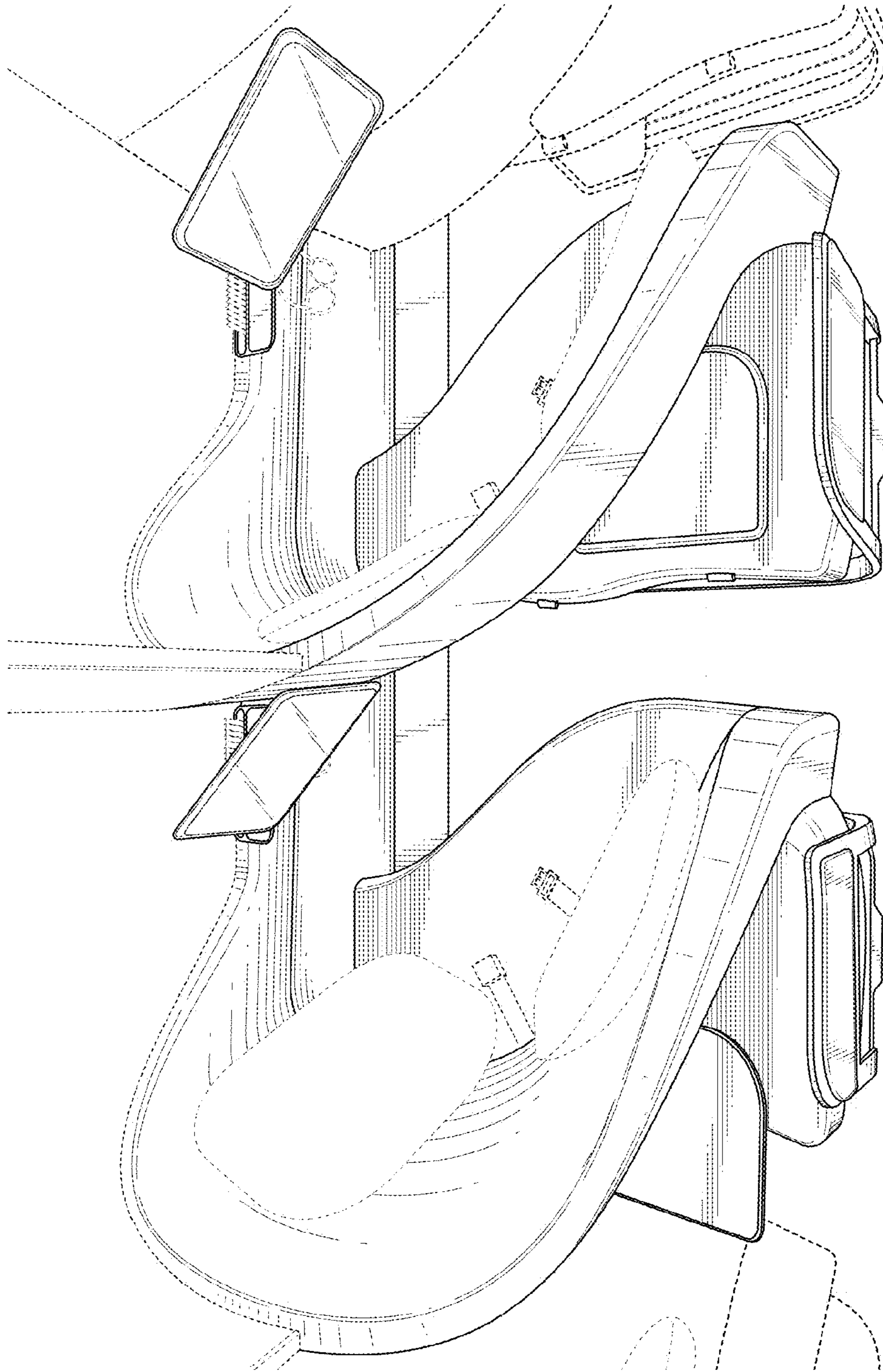

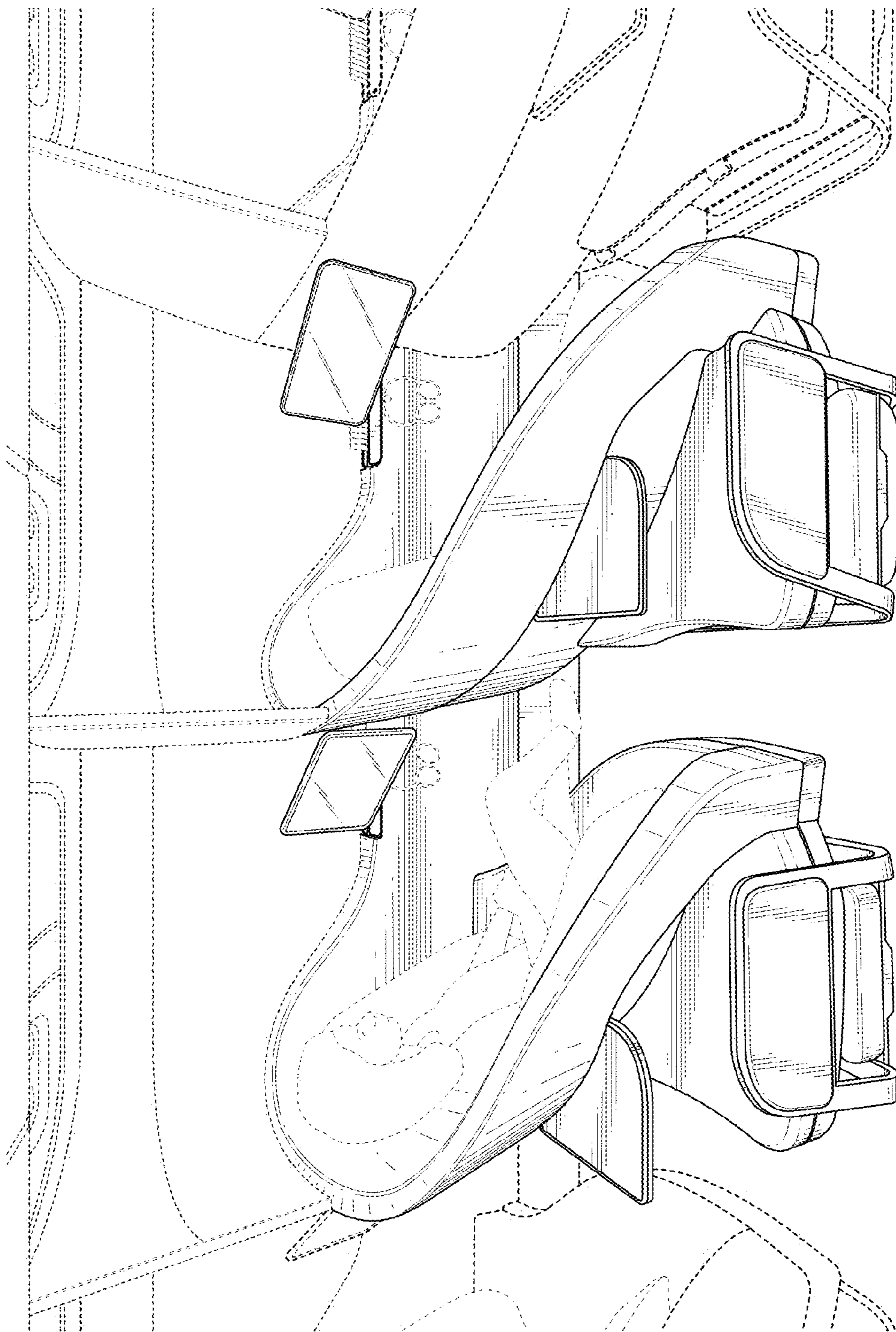

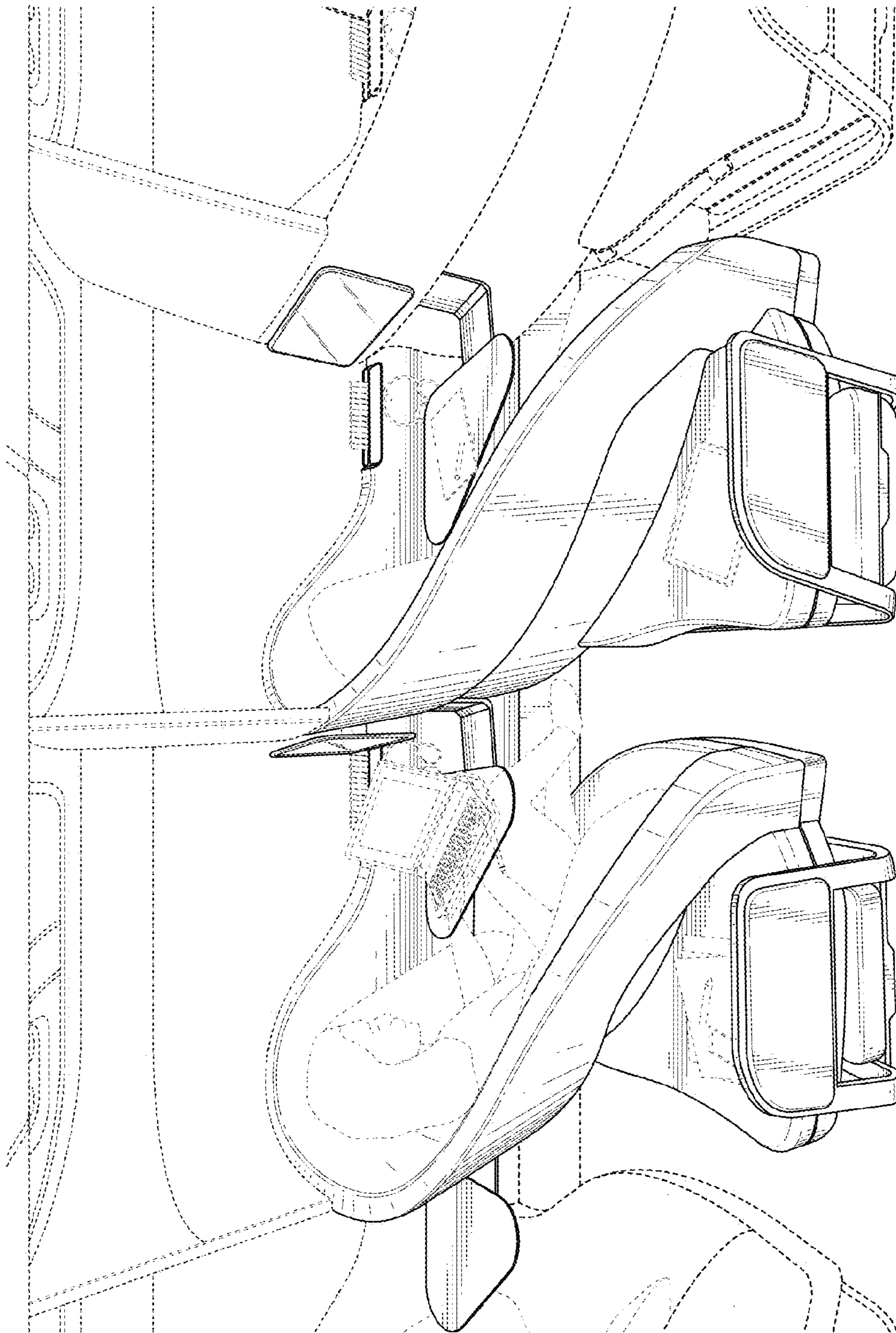

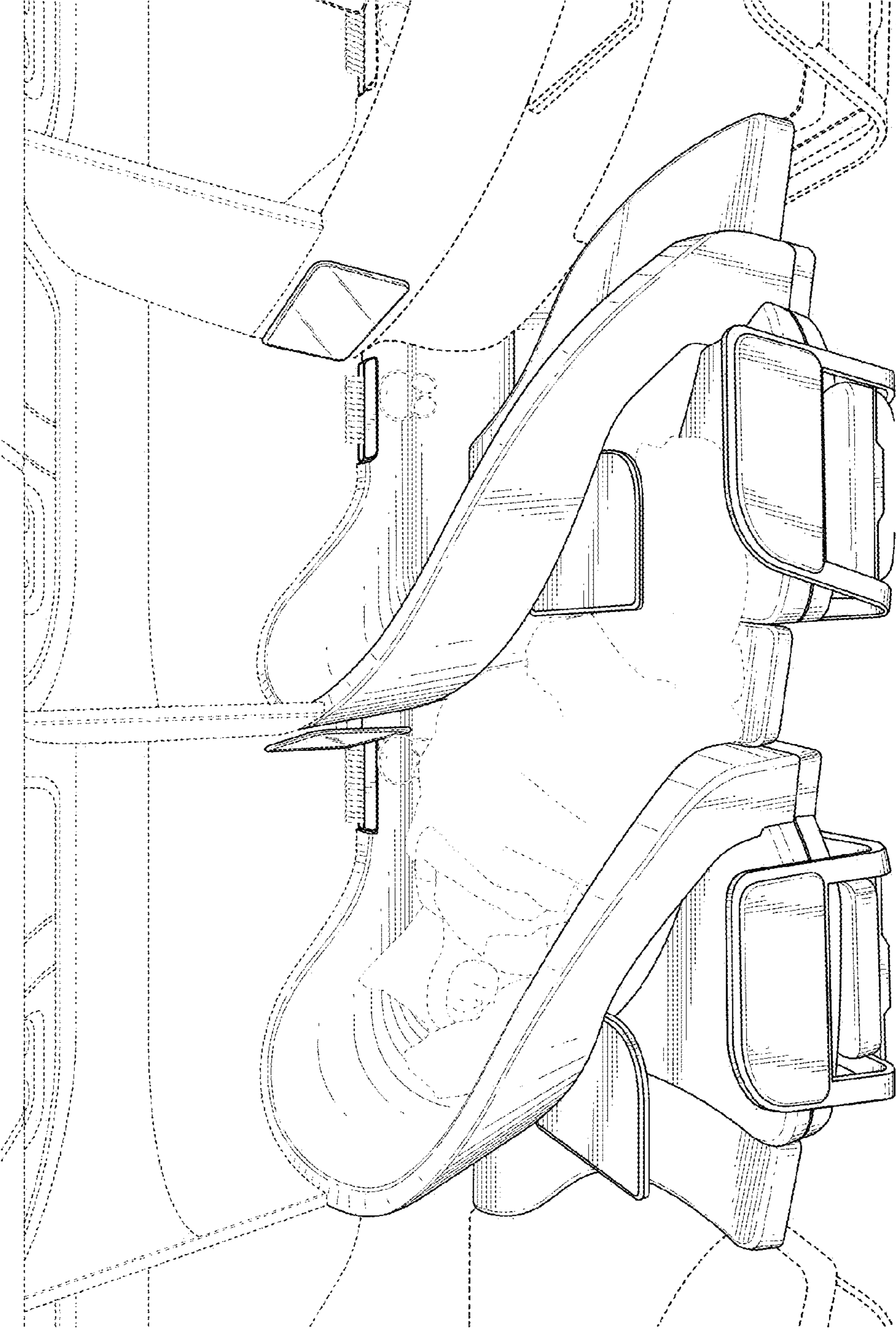

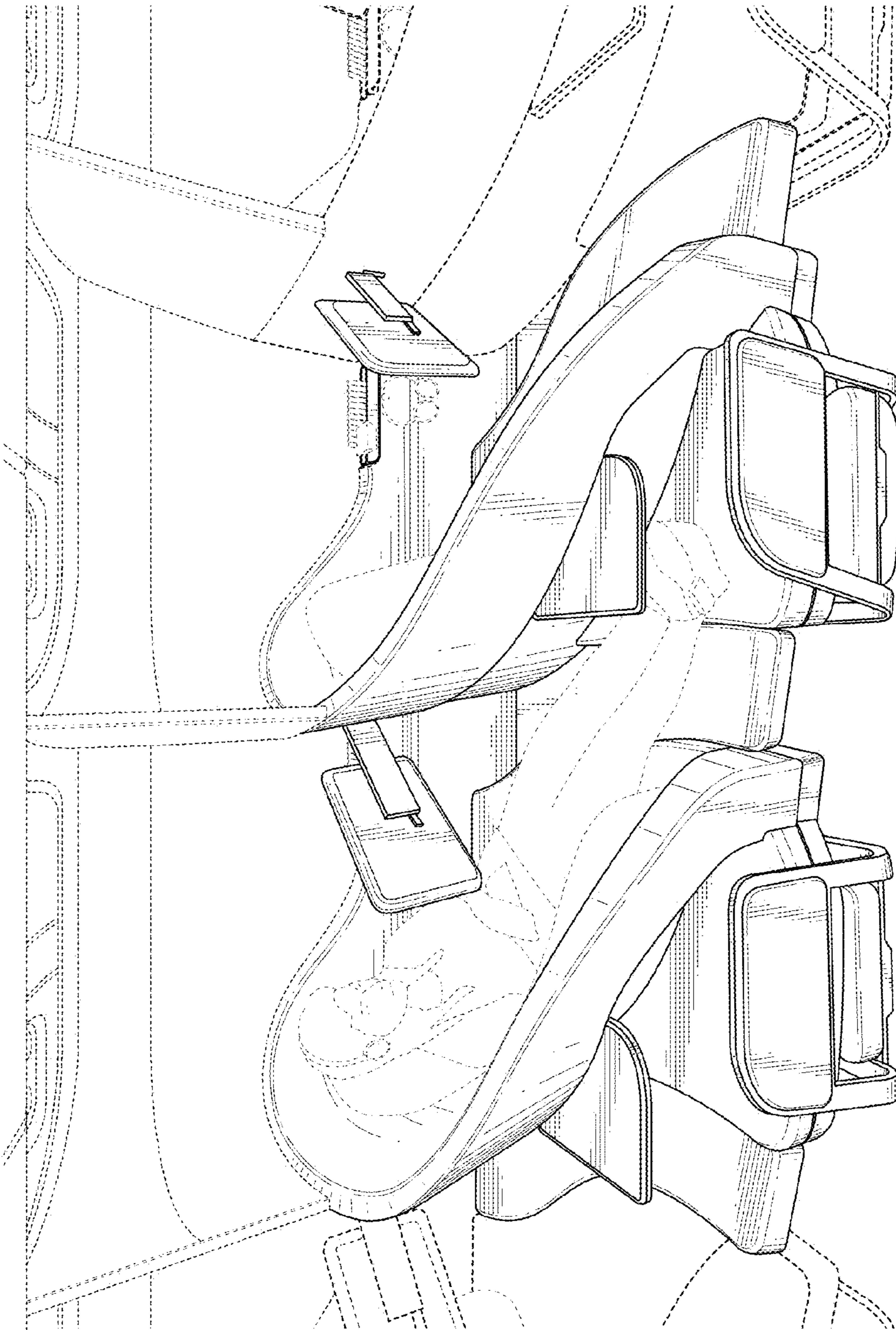

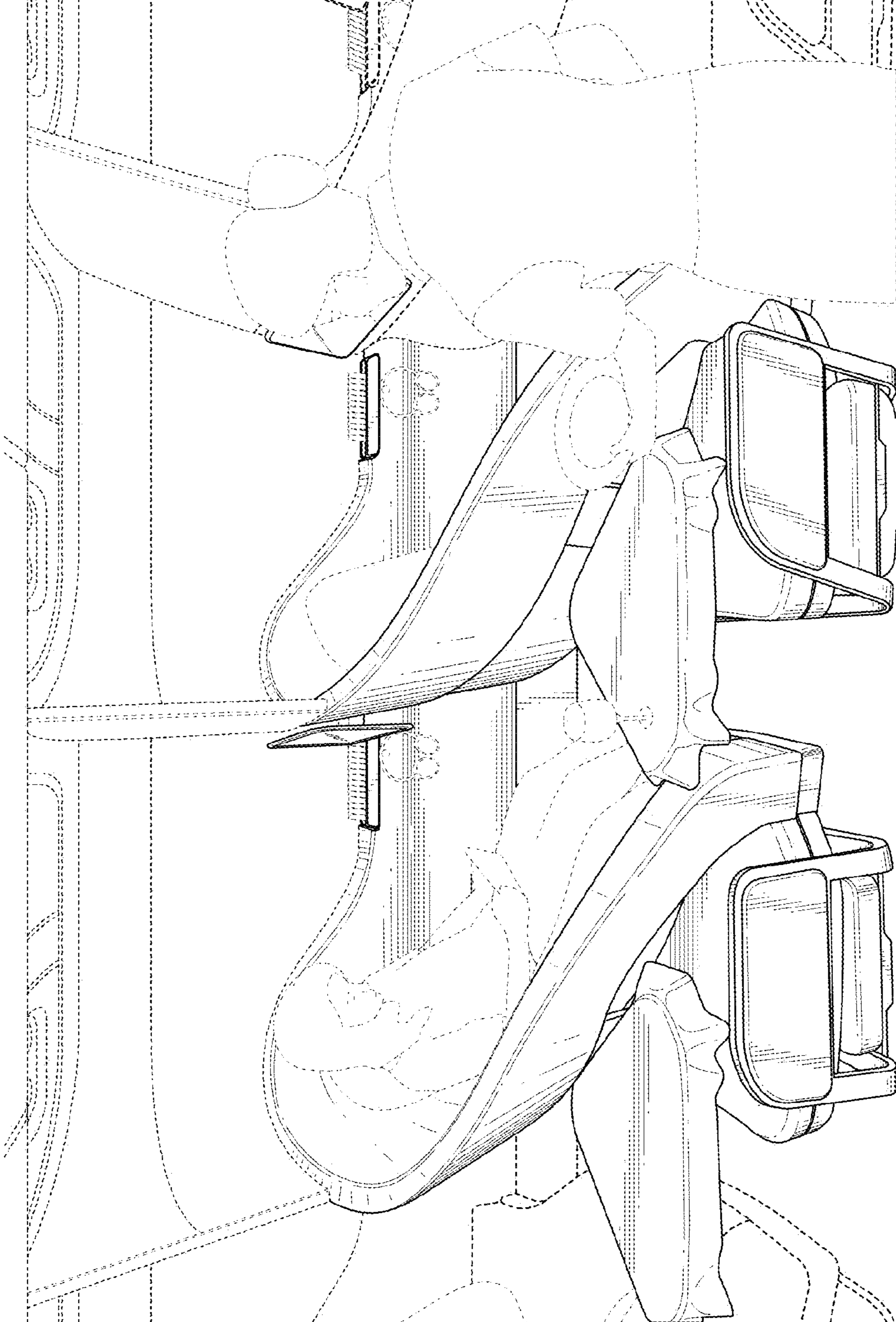

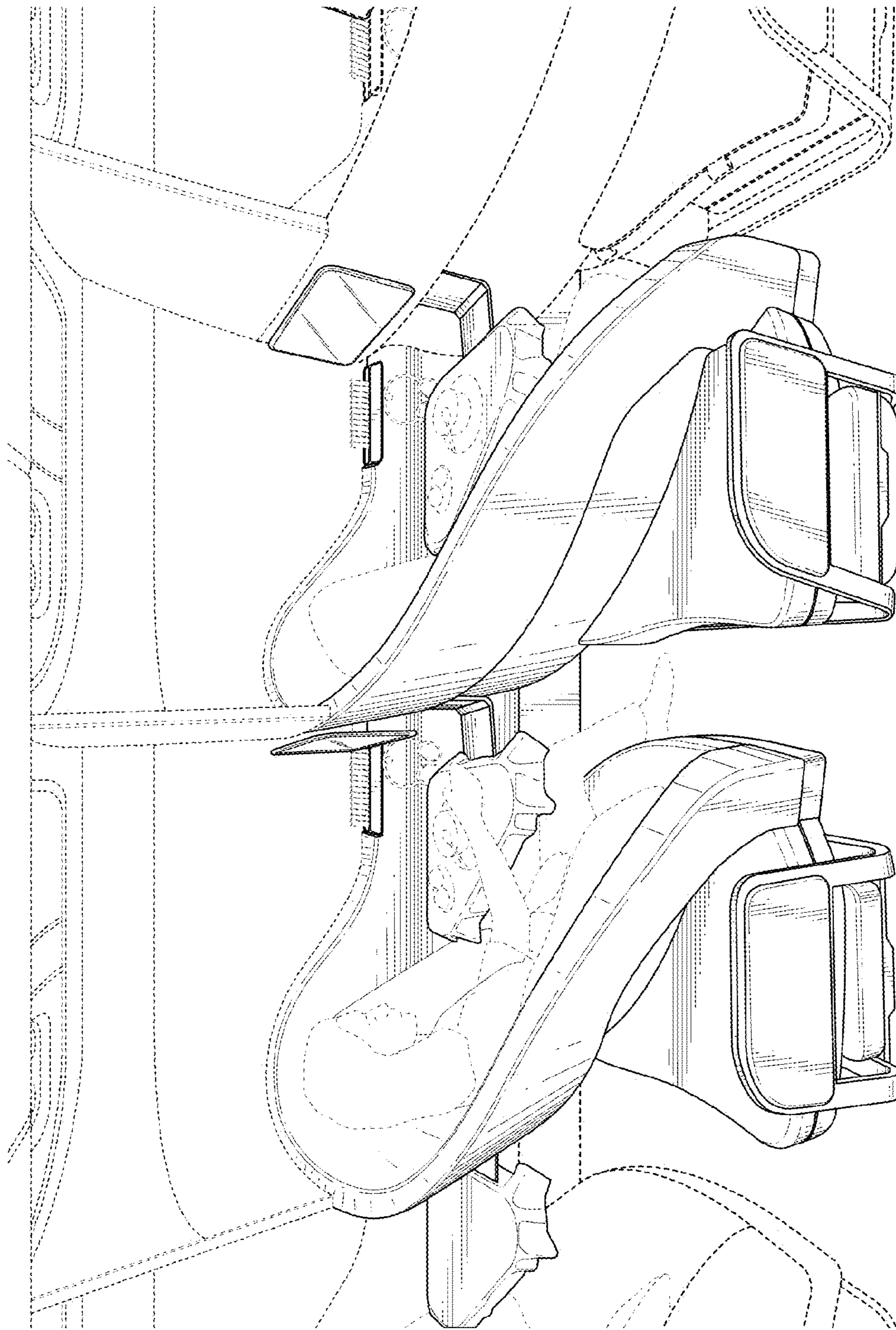

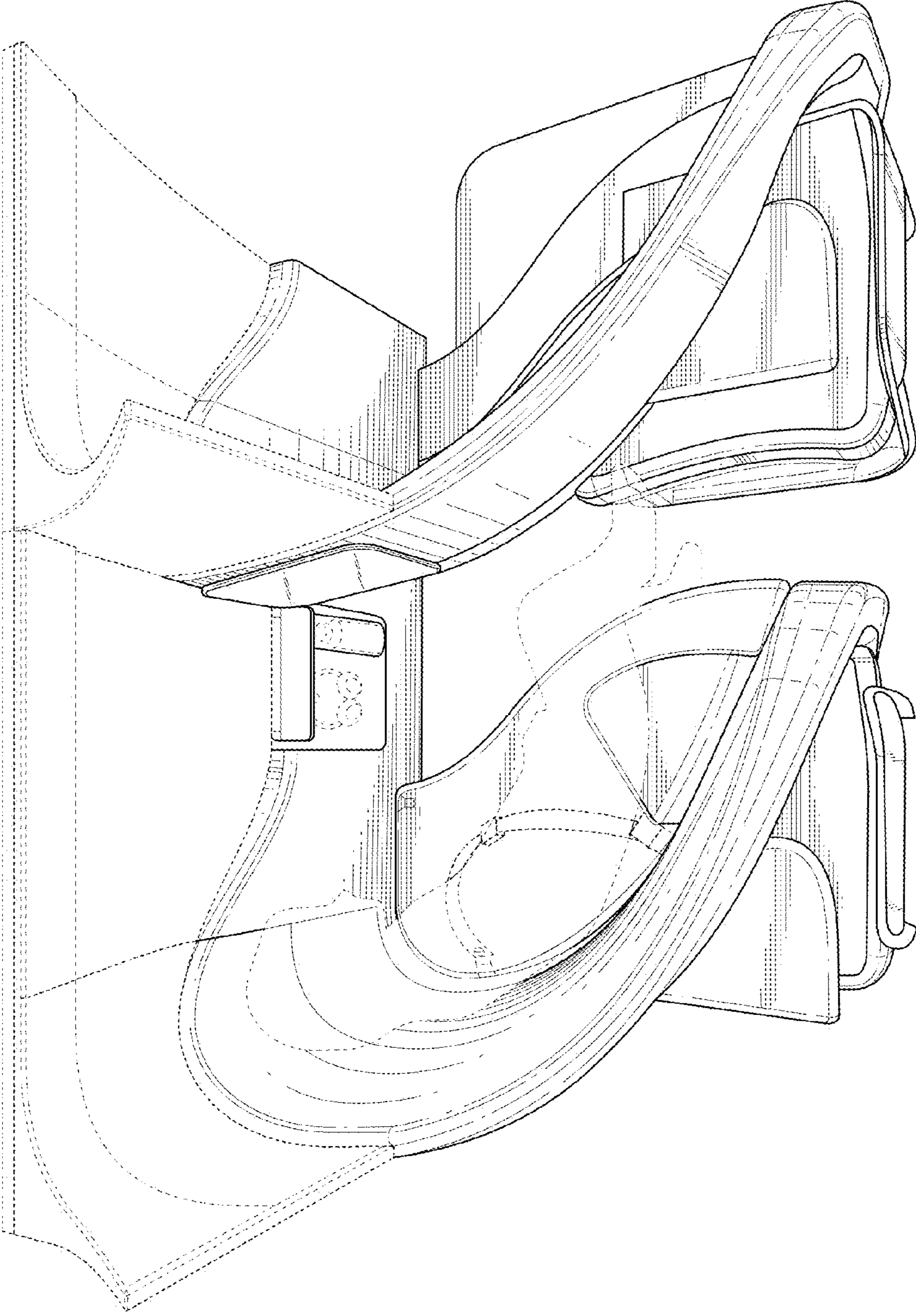

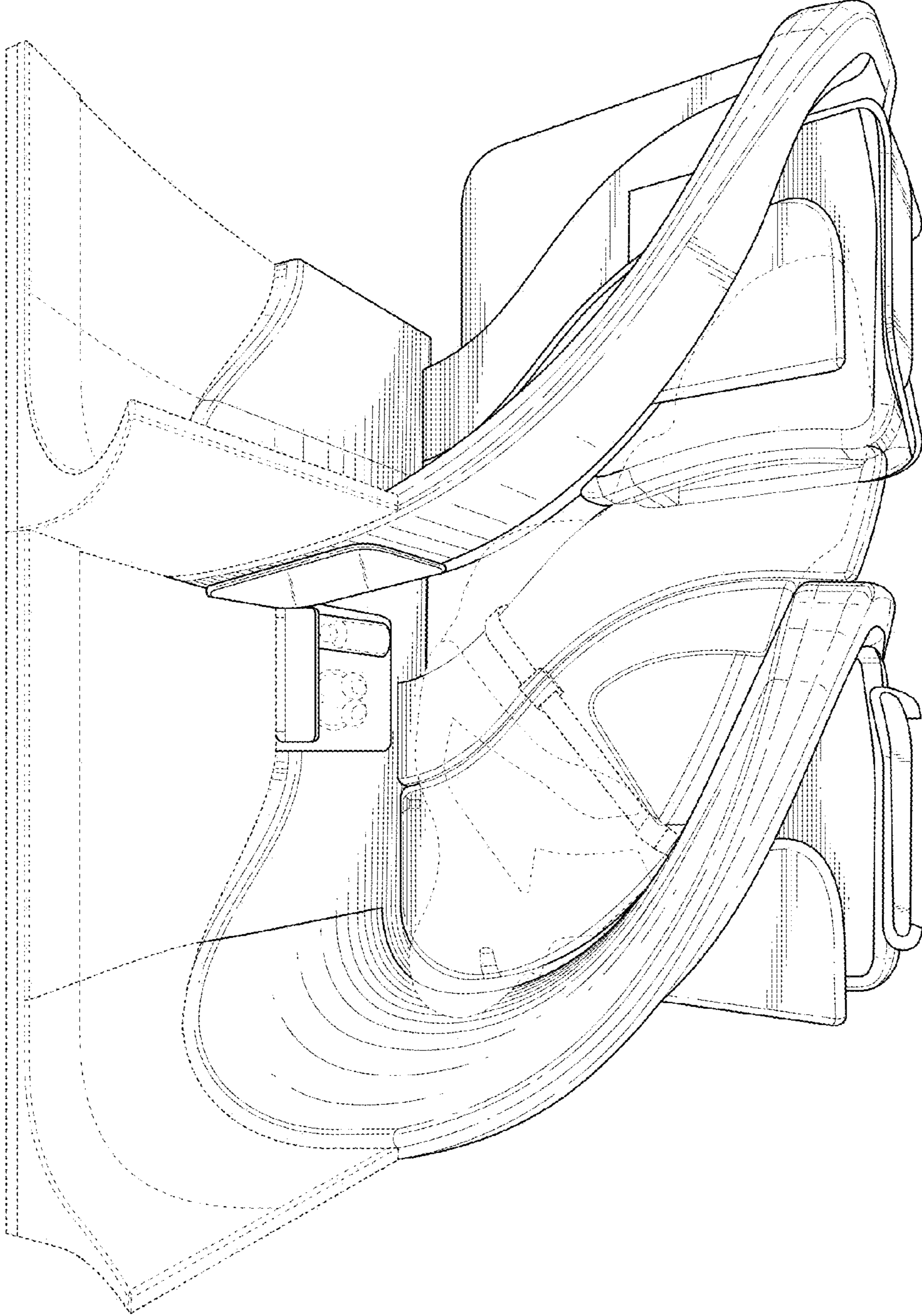
